The ornamental design for a diaper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a diaper fastening tape strip with comfort corners, showing my new design;

The broken line showing in all the views is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

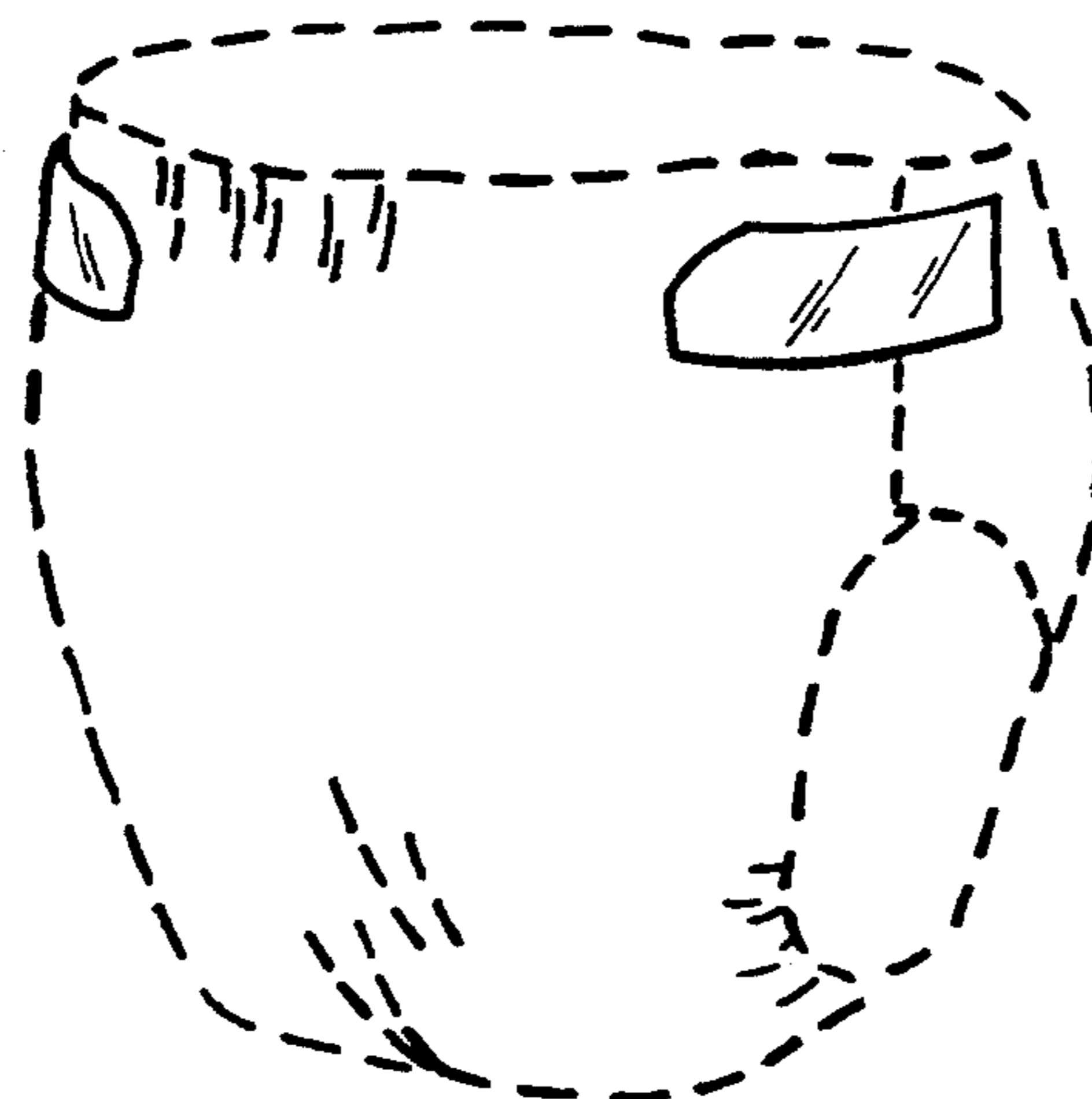

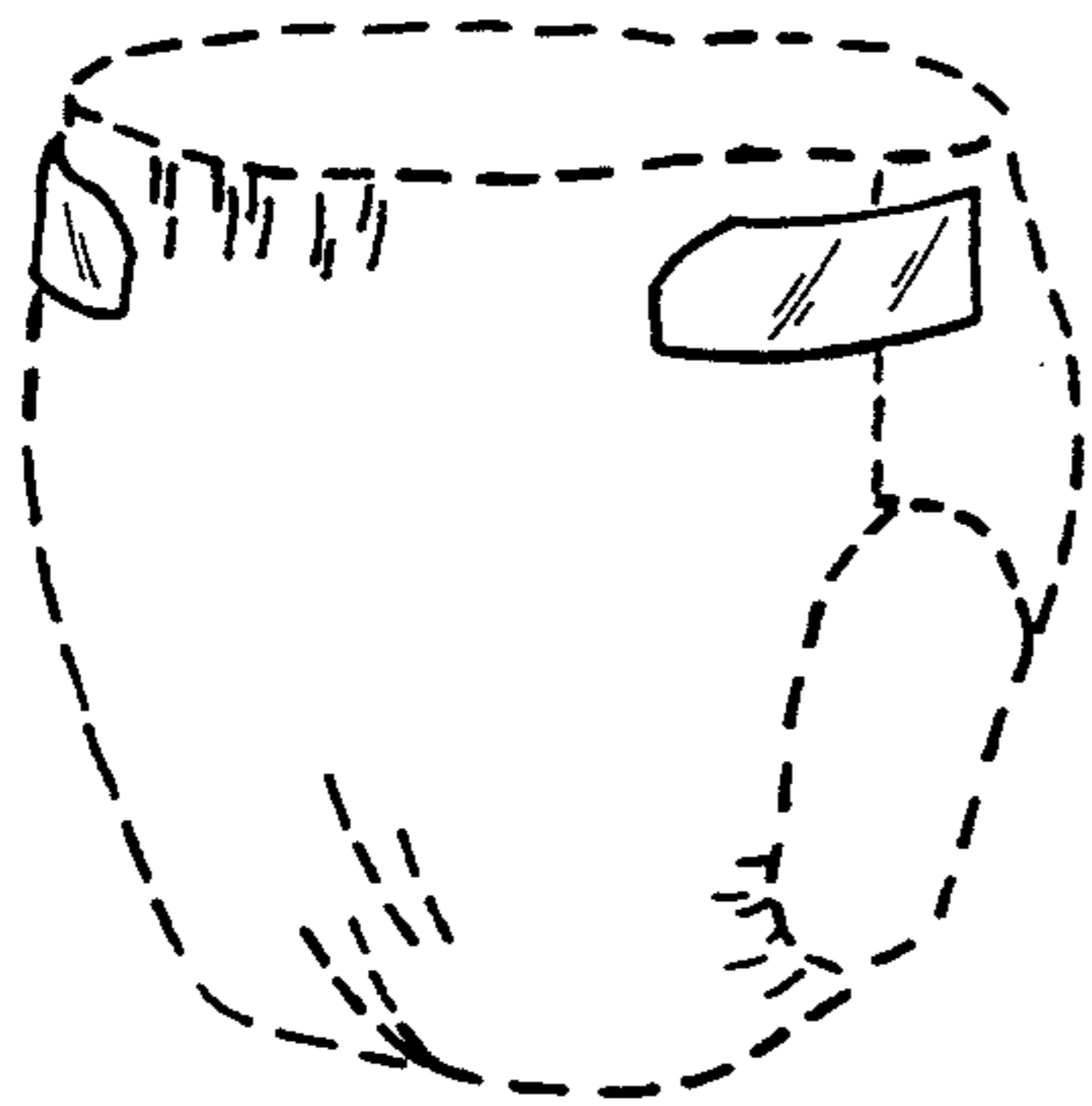

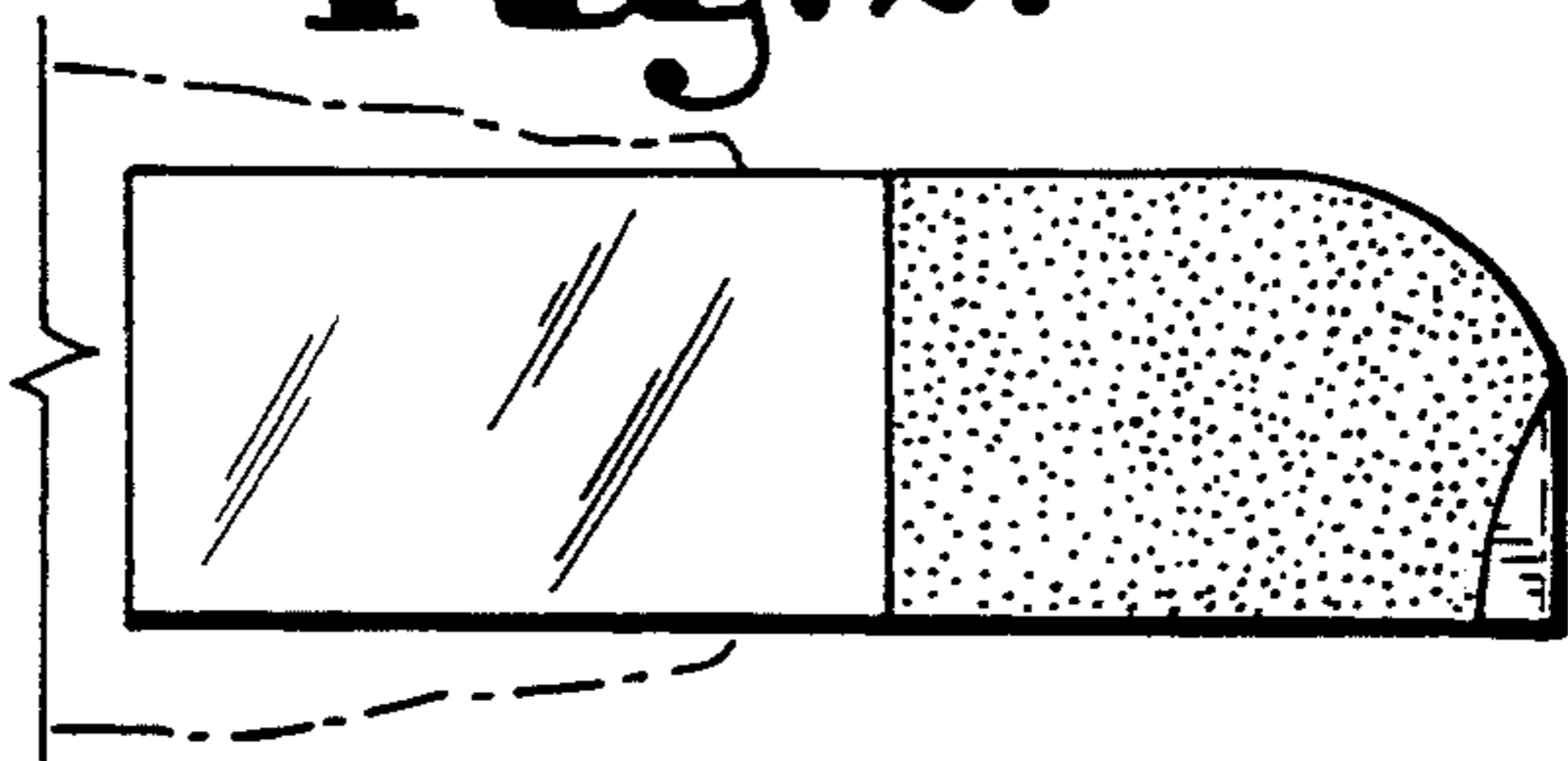

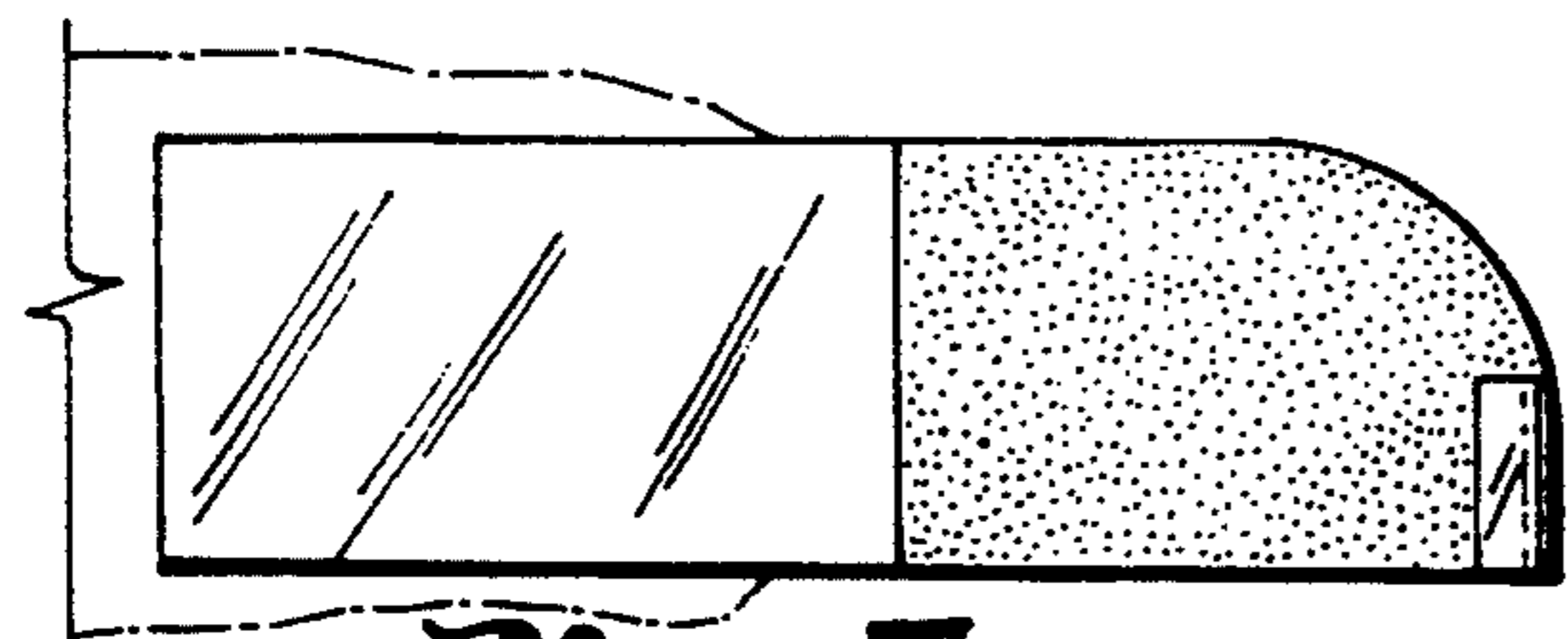
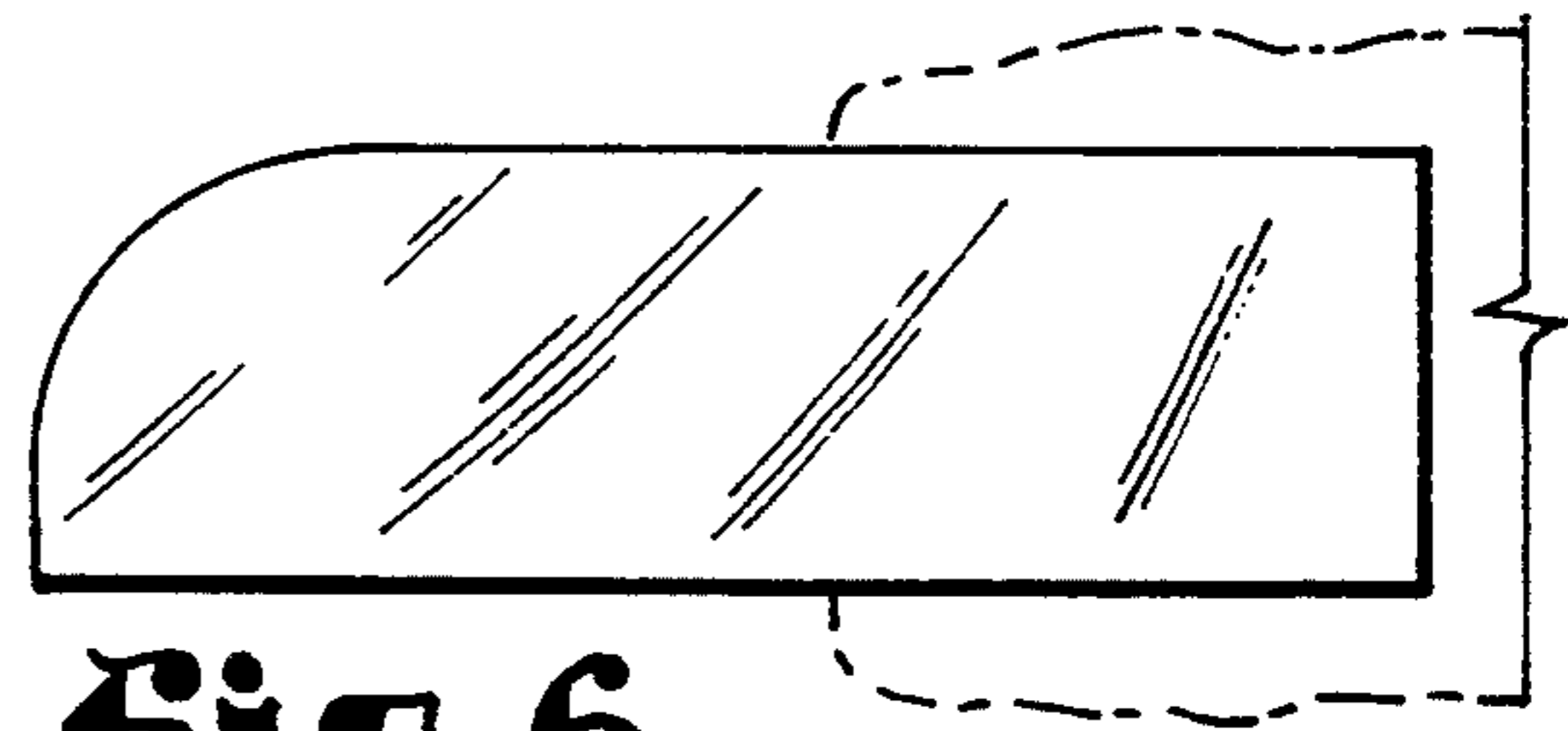

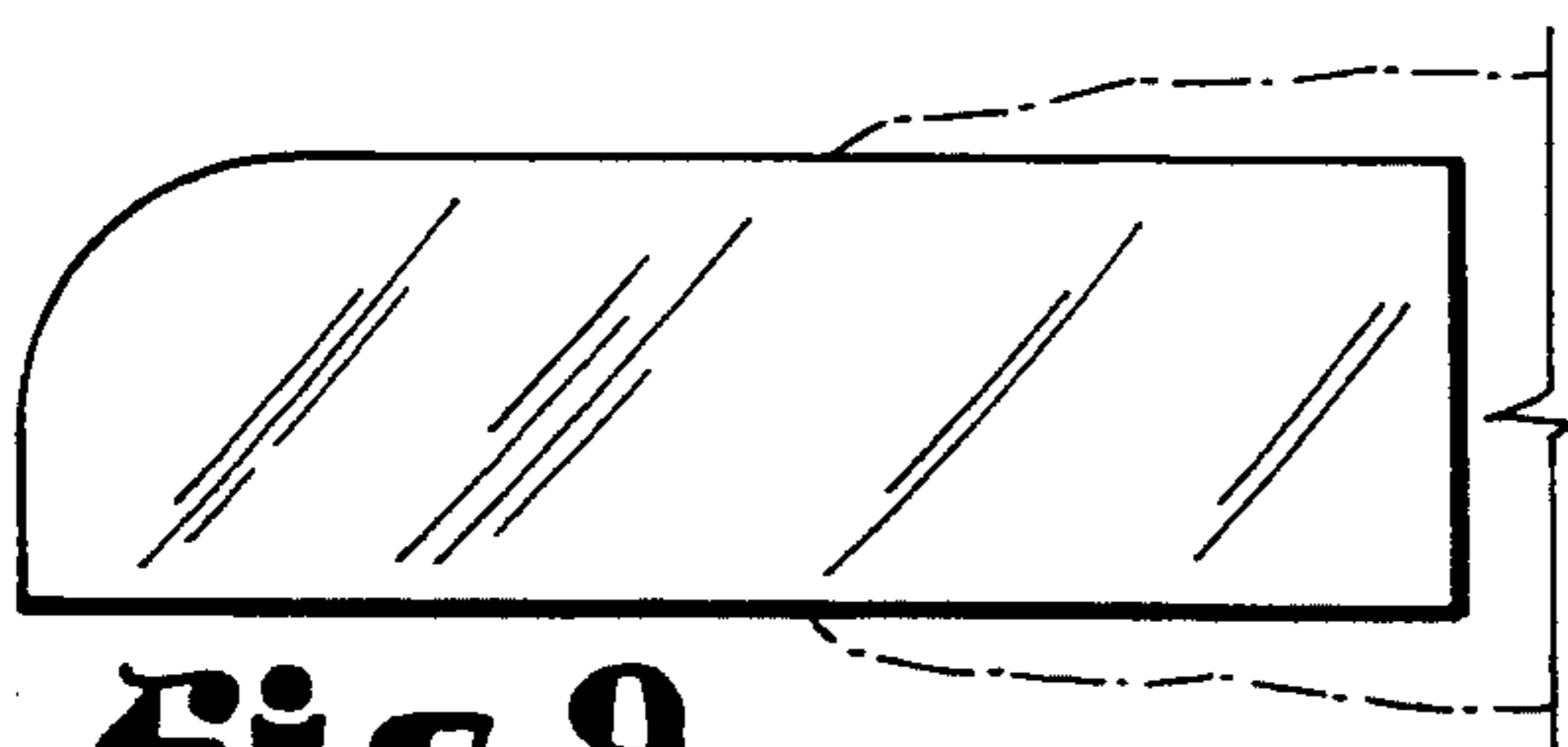

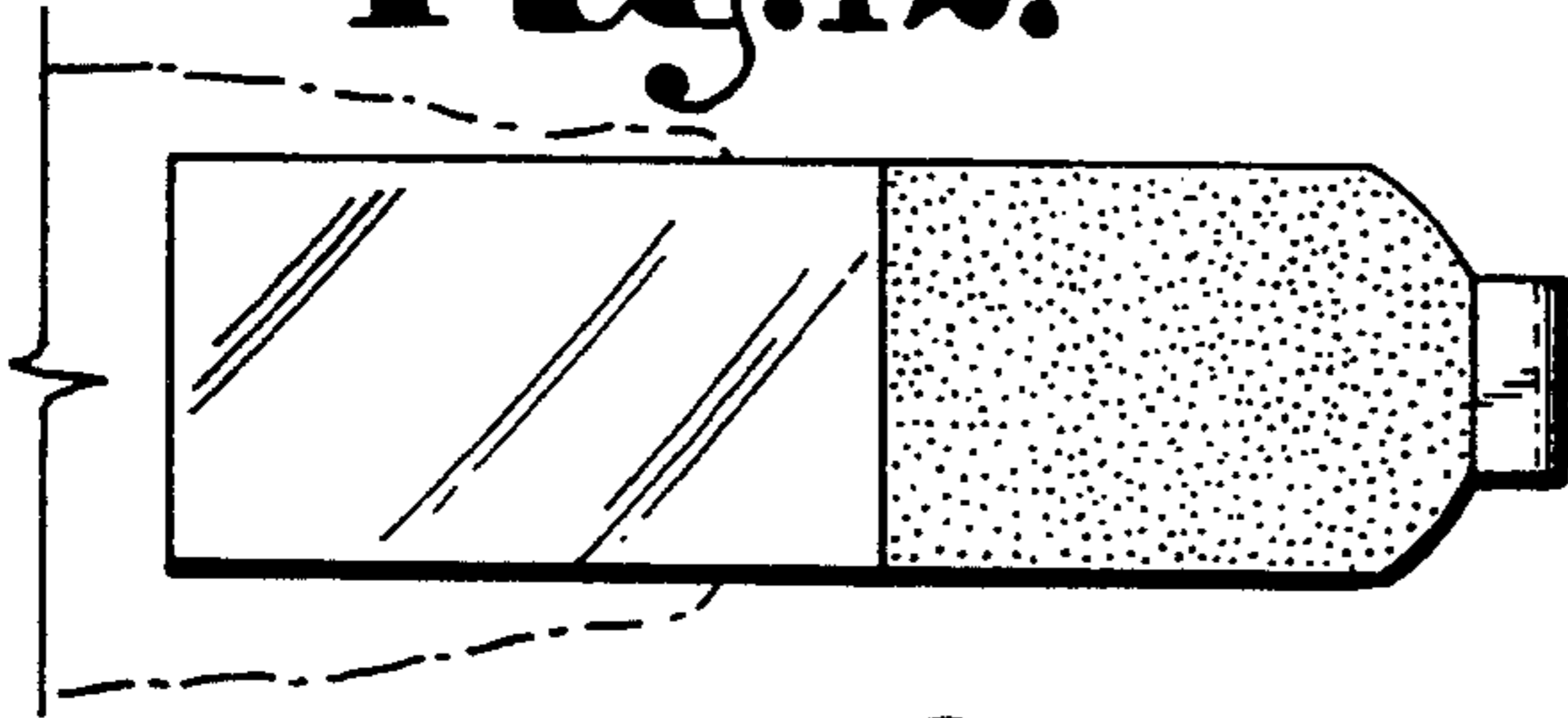

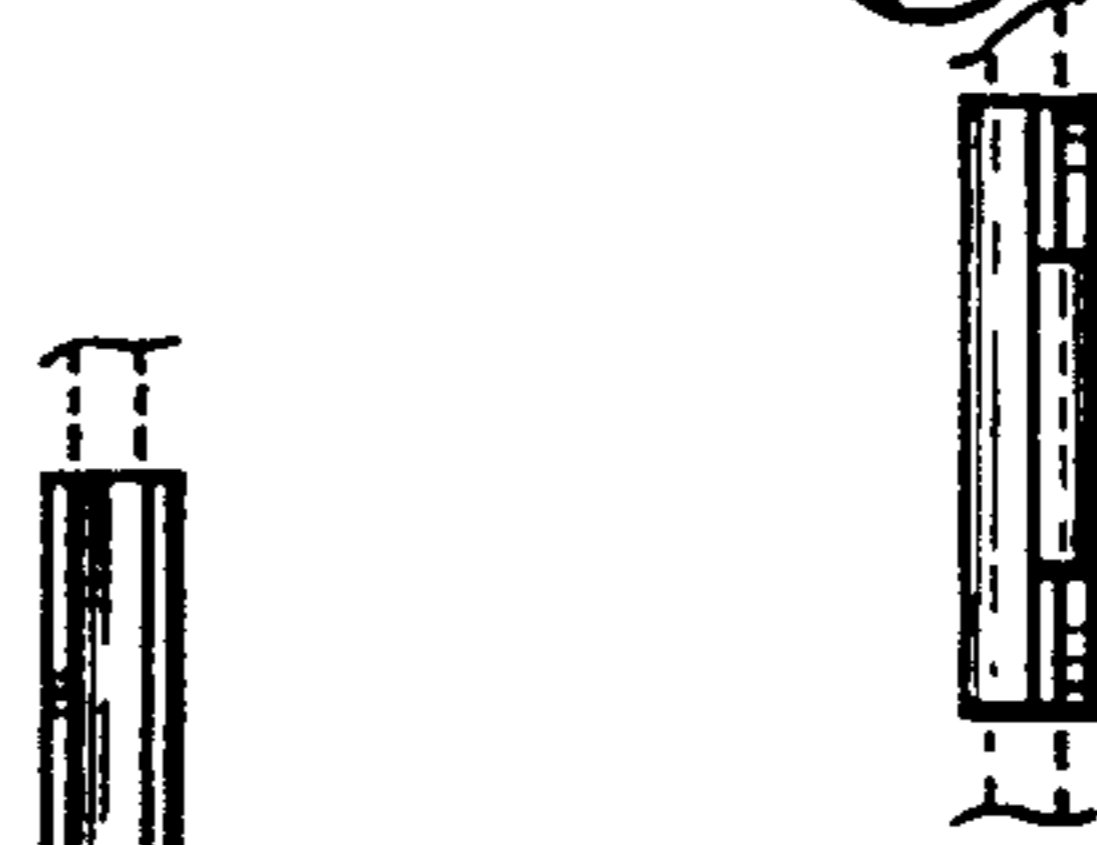

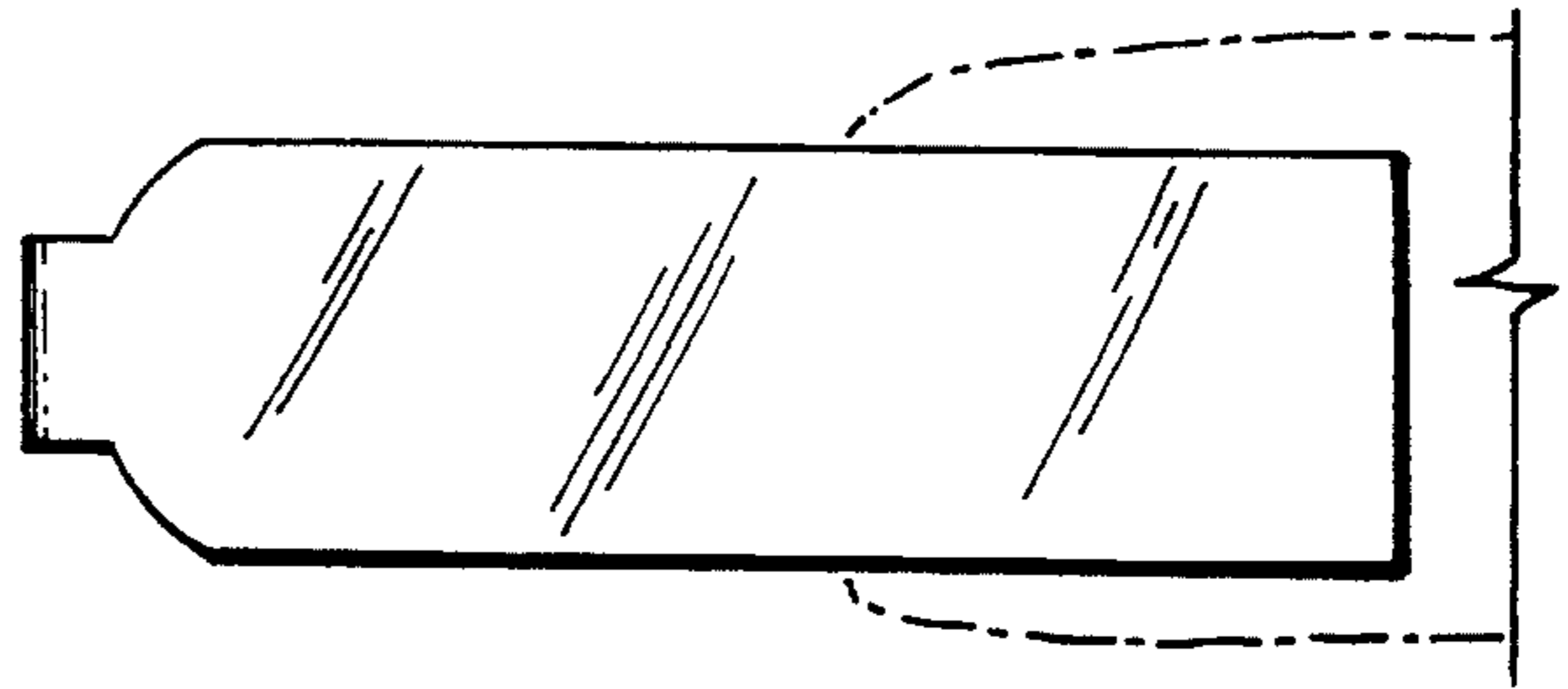

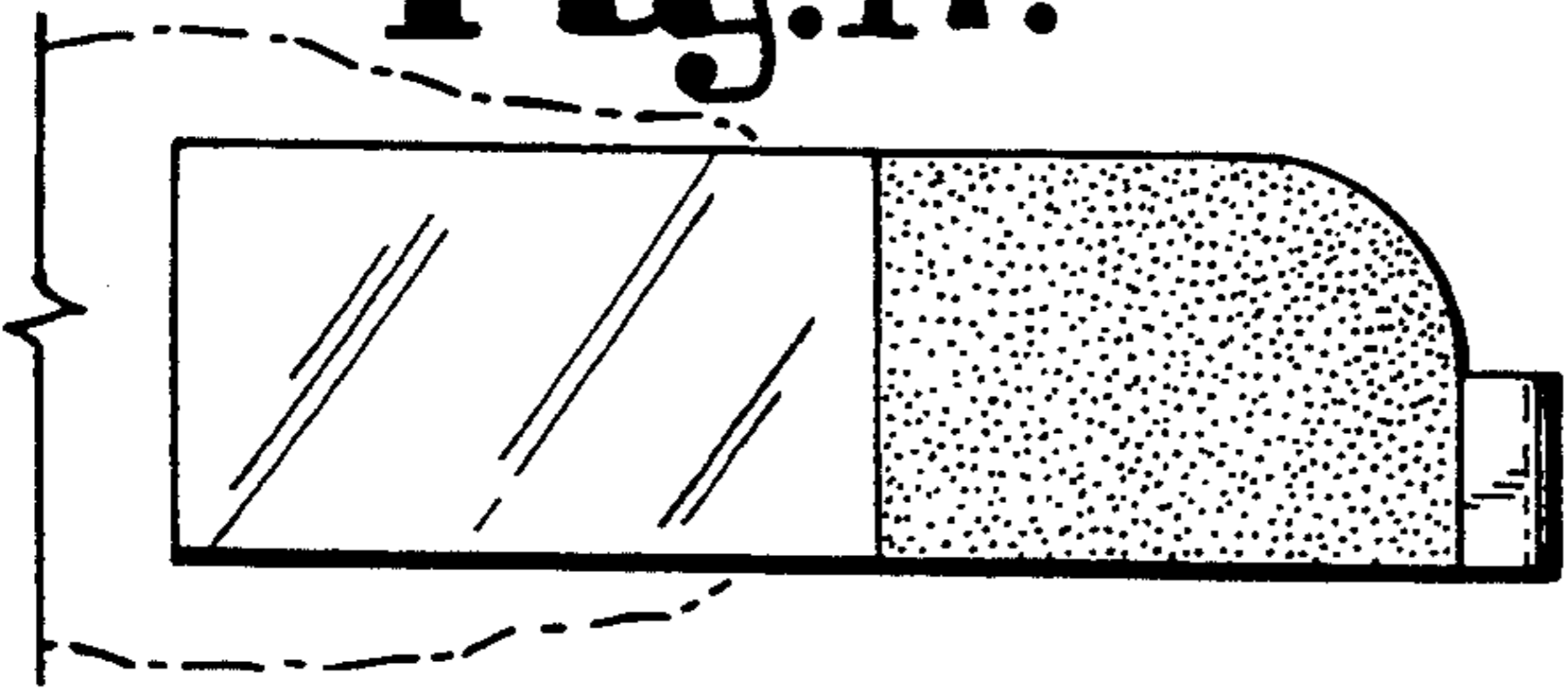

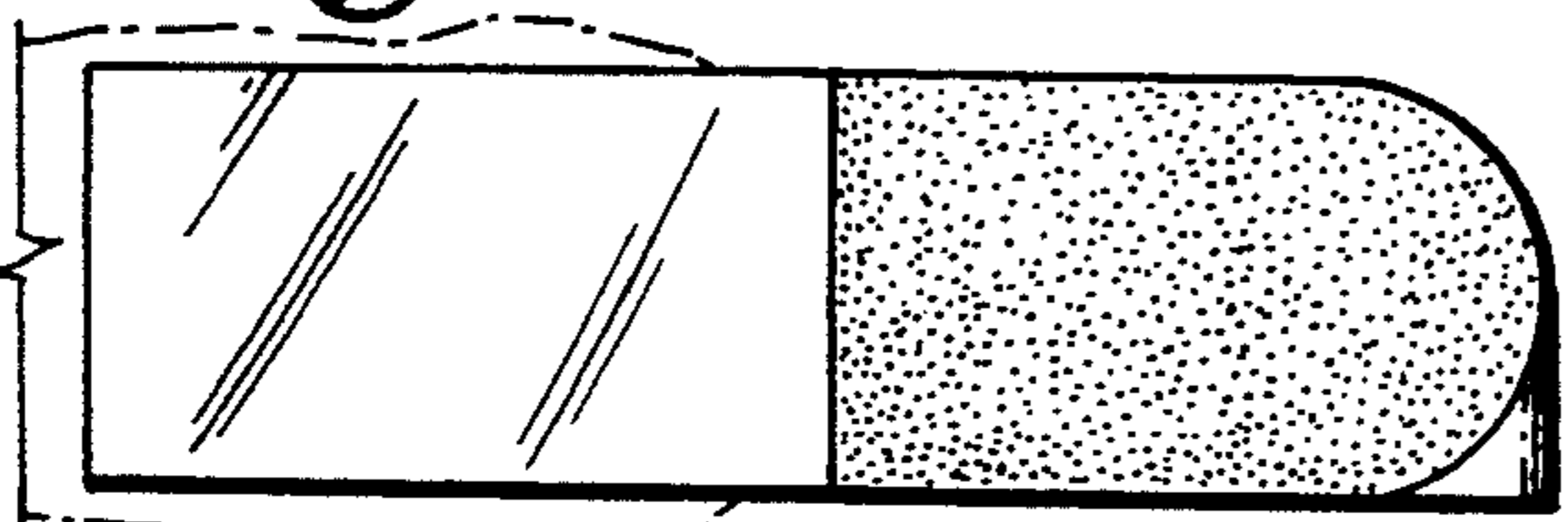

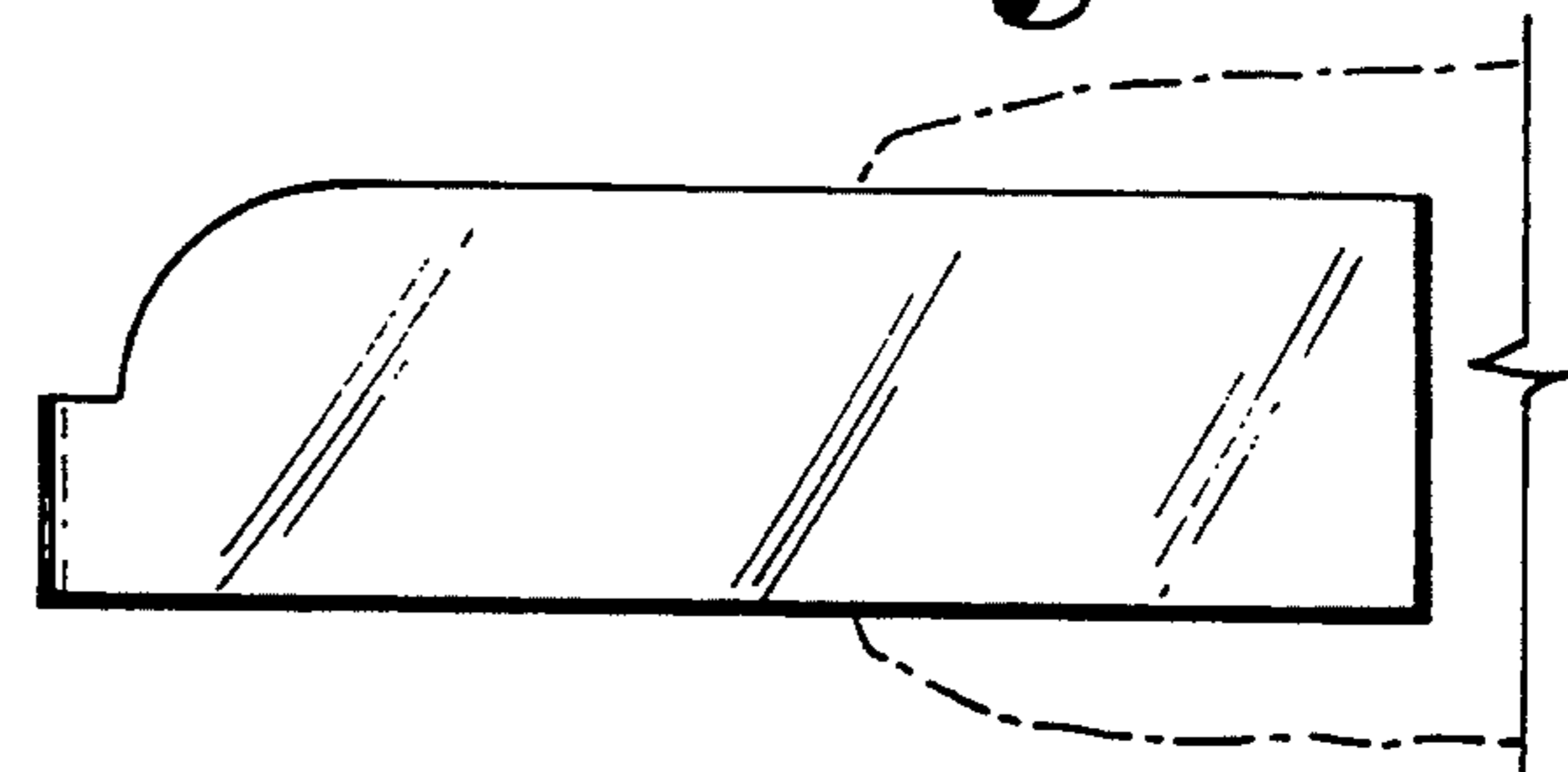

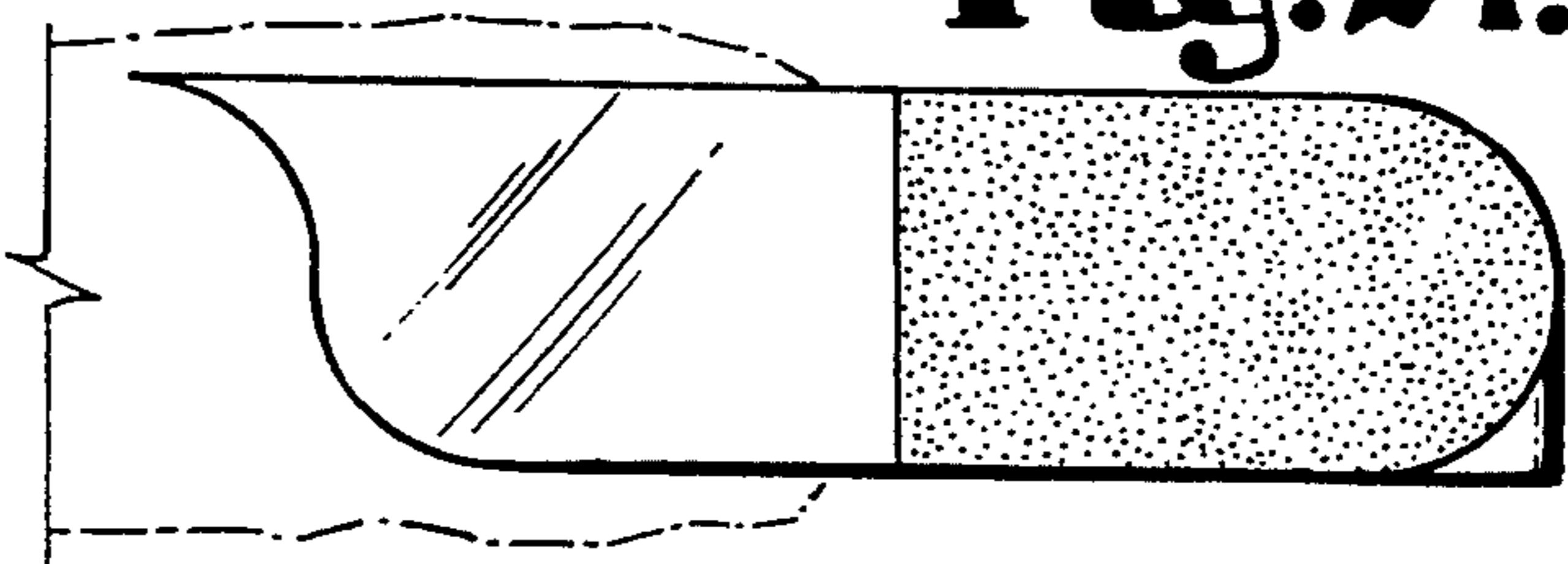

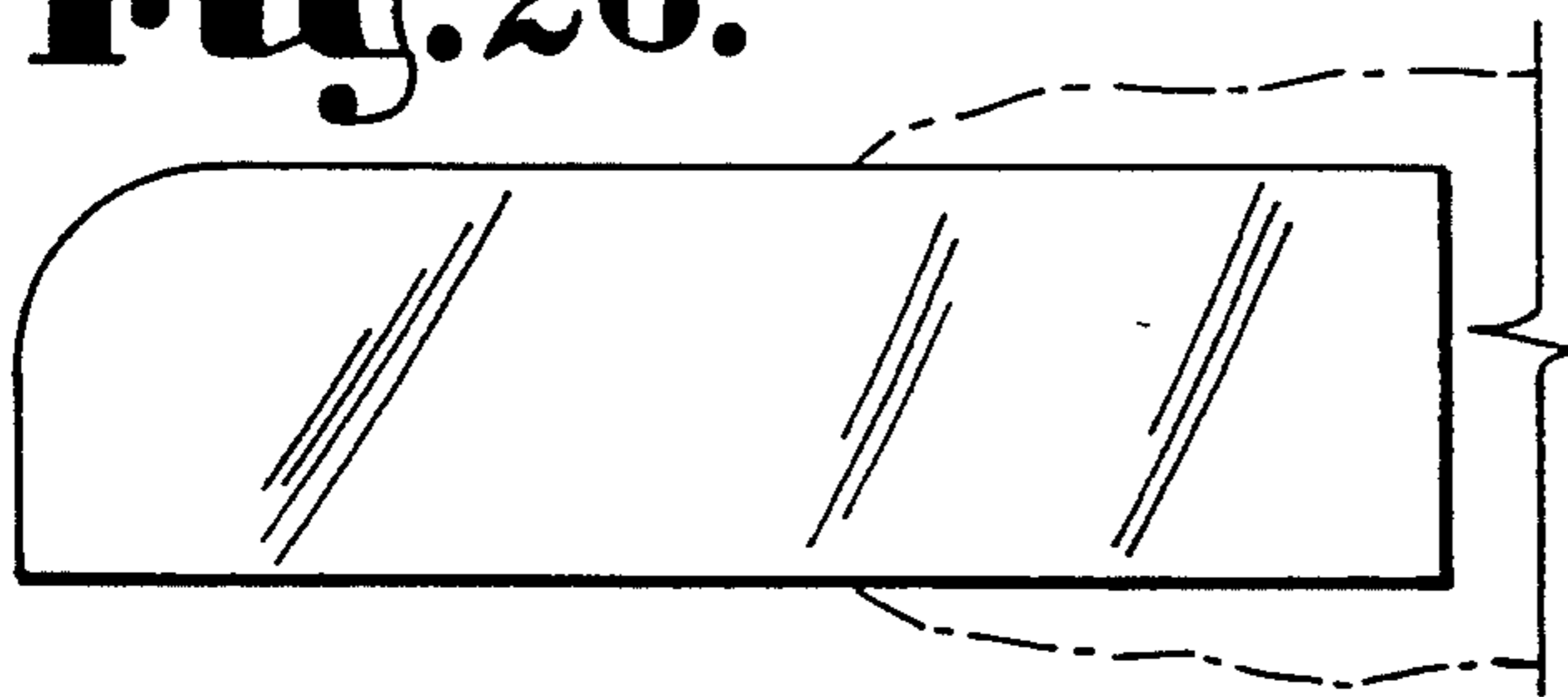

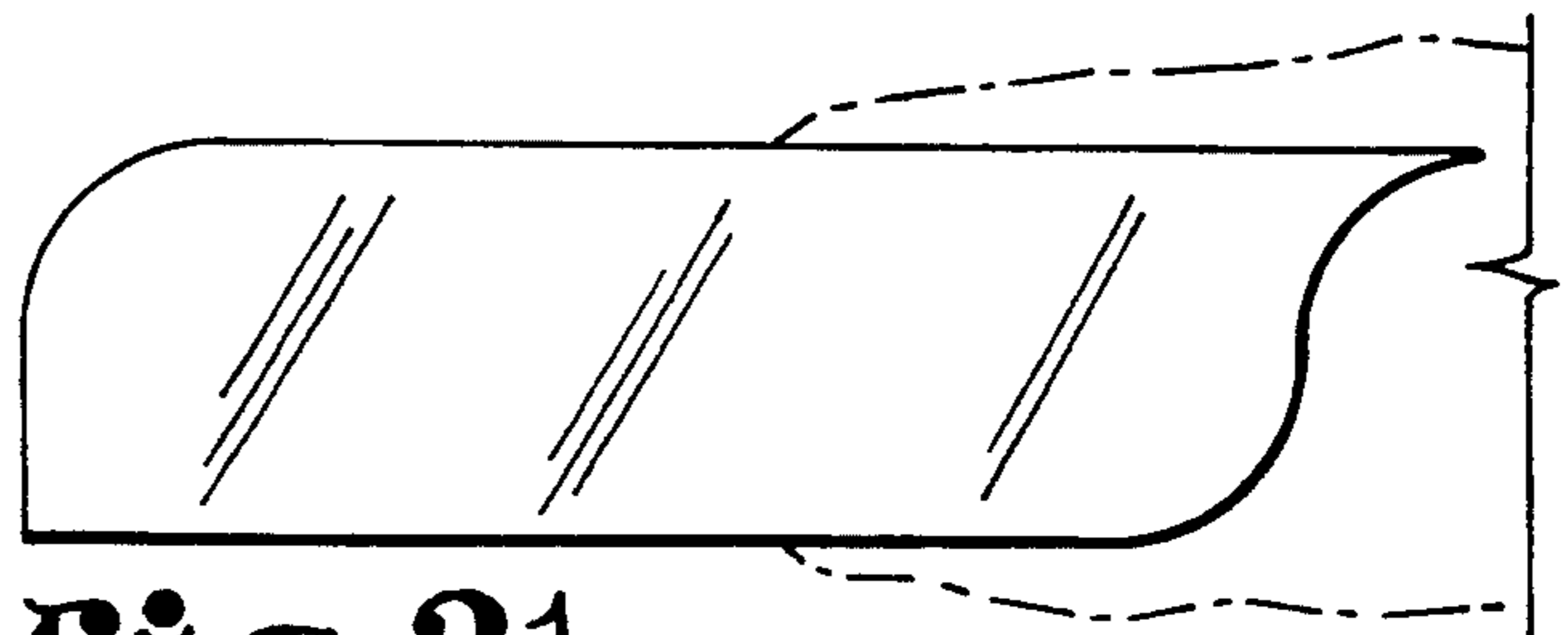
