FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chest showing my new design;

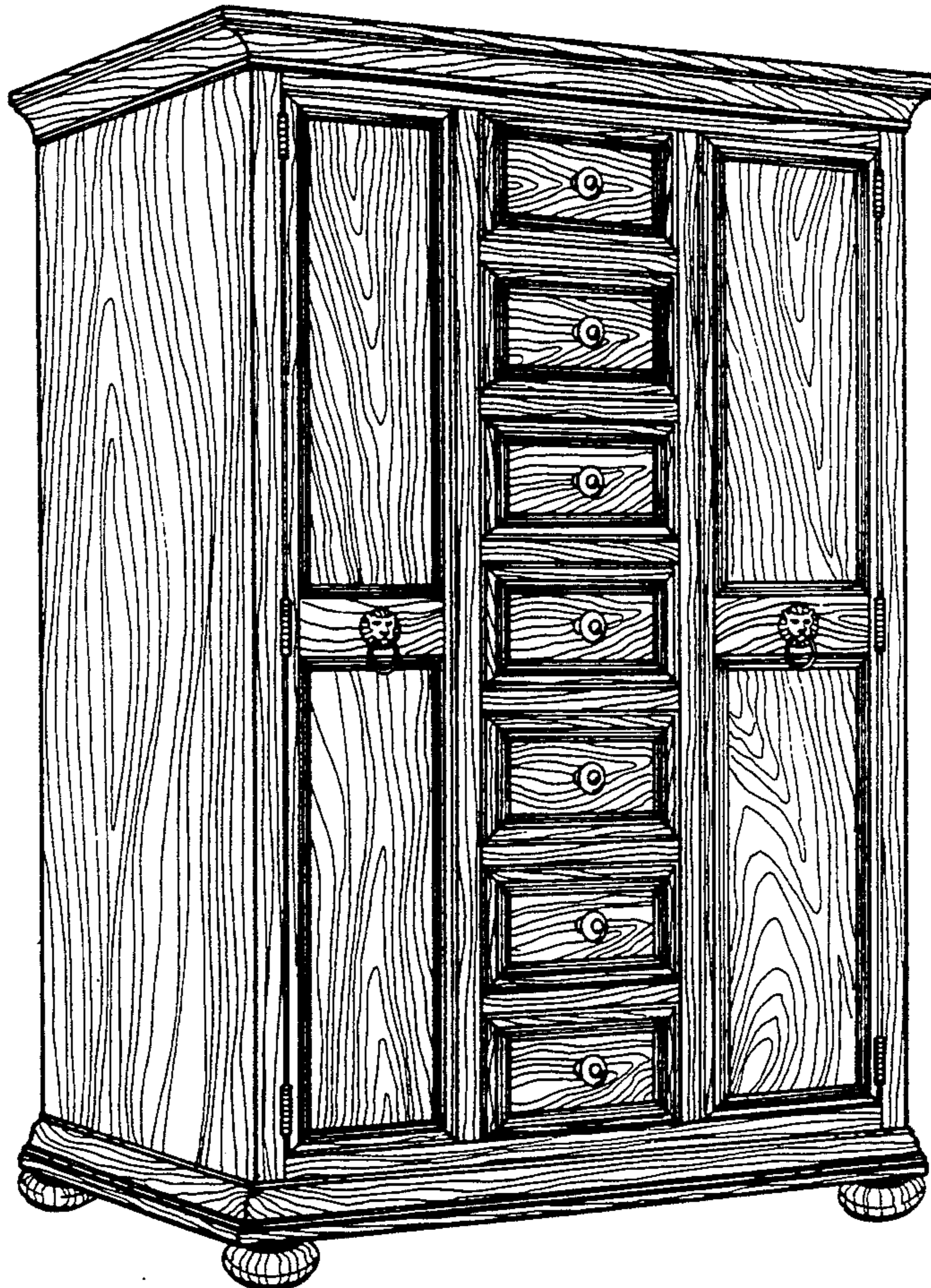
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

The rear of the chest is flat and unornamented.



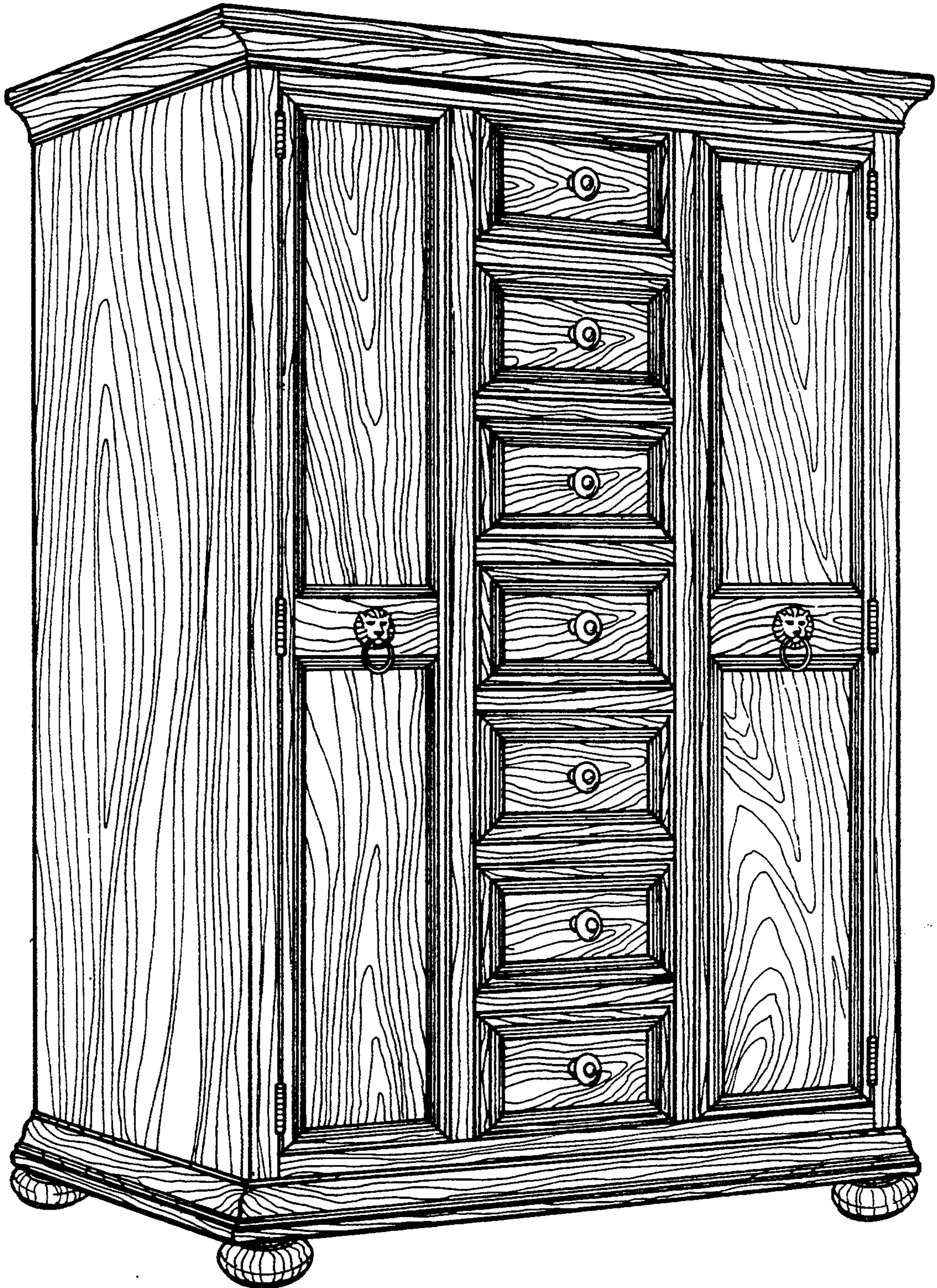

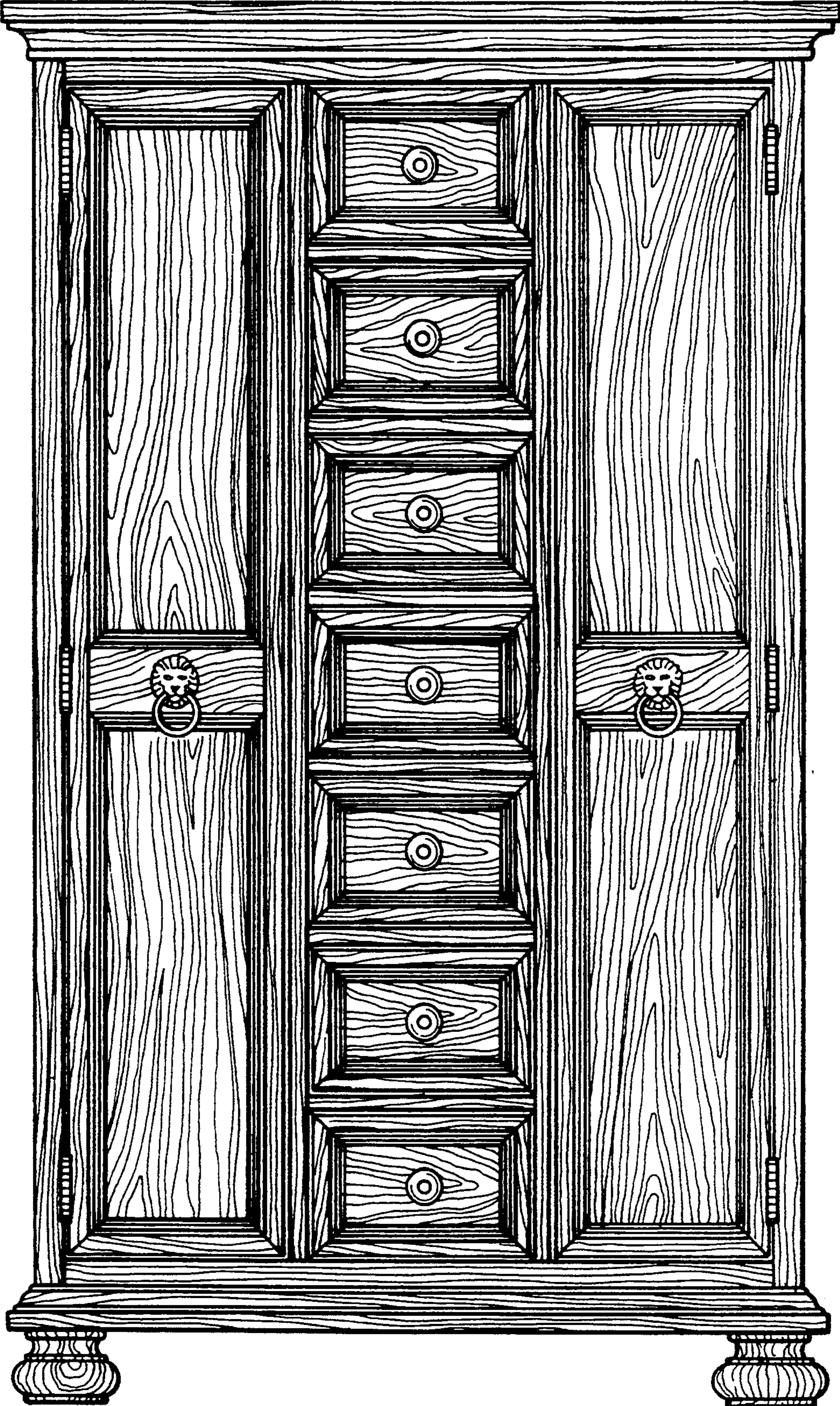

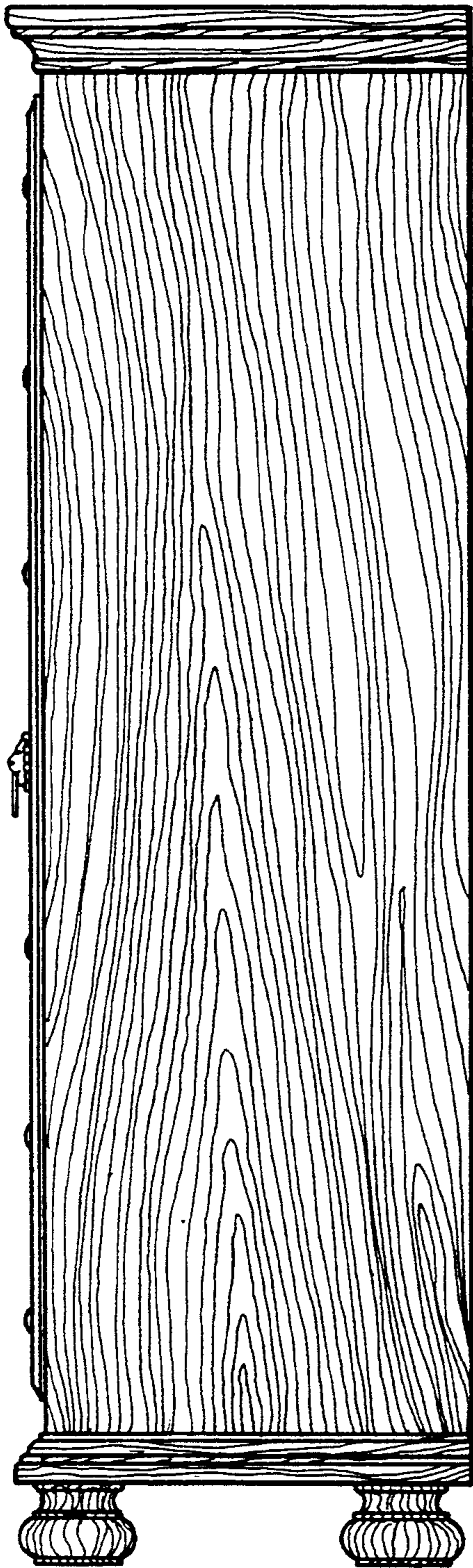

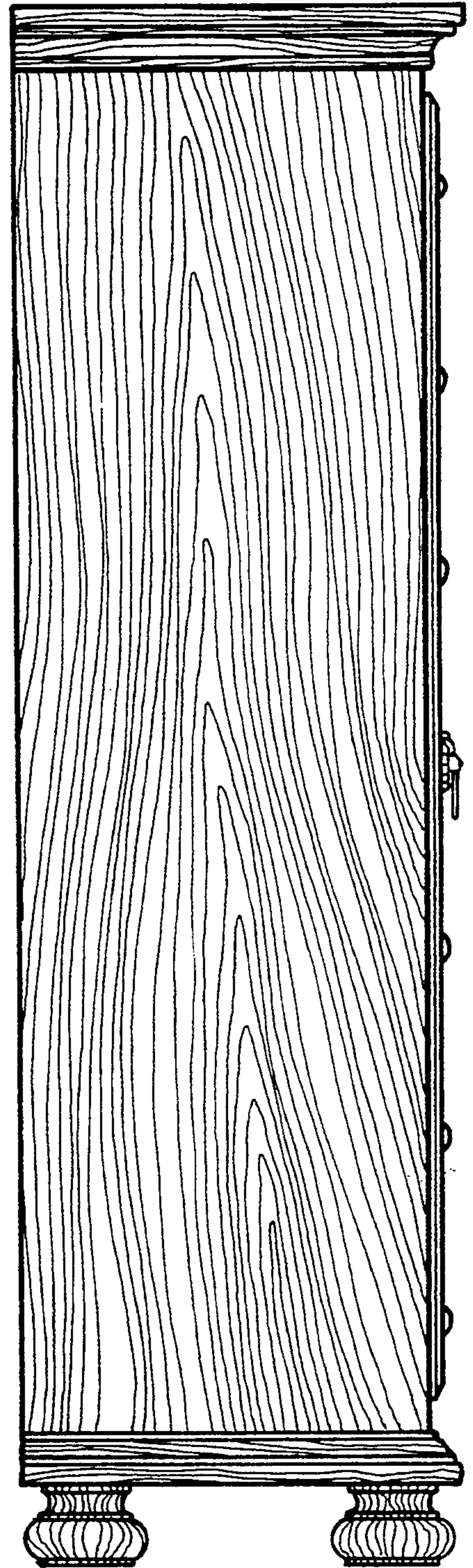
