FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the chandelier;

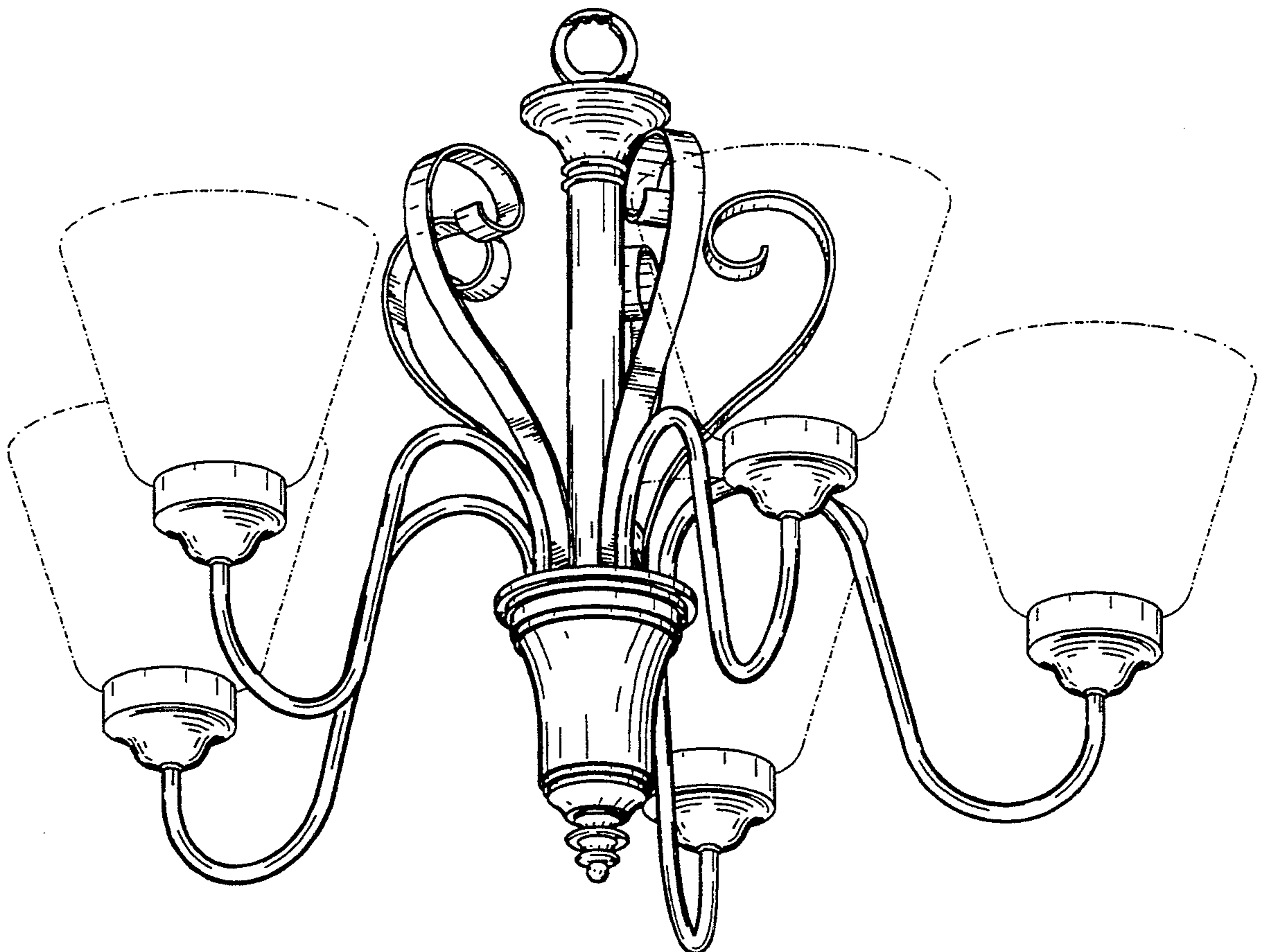
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the chandelier;

Lamp shades are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



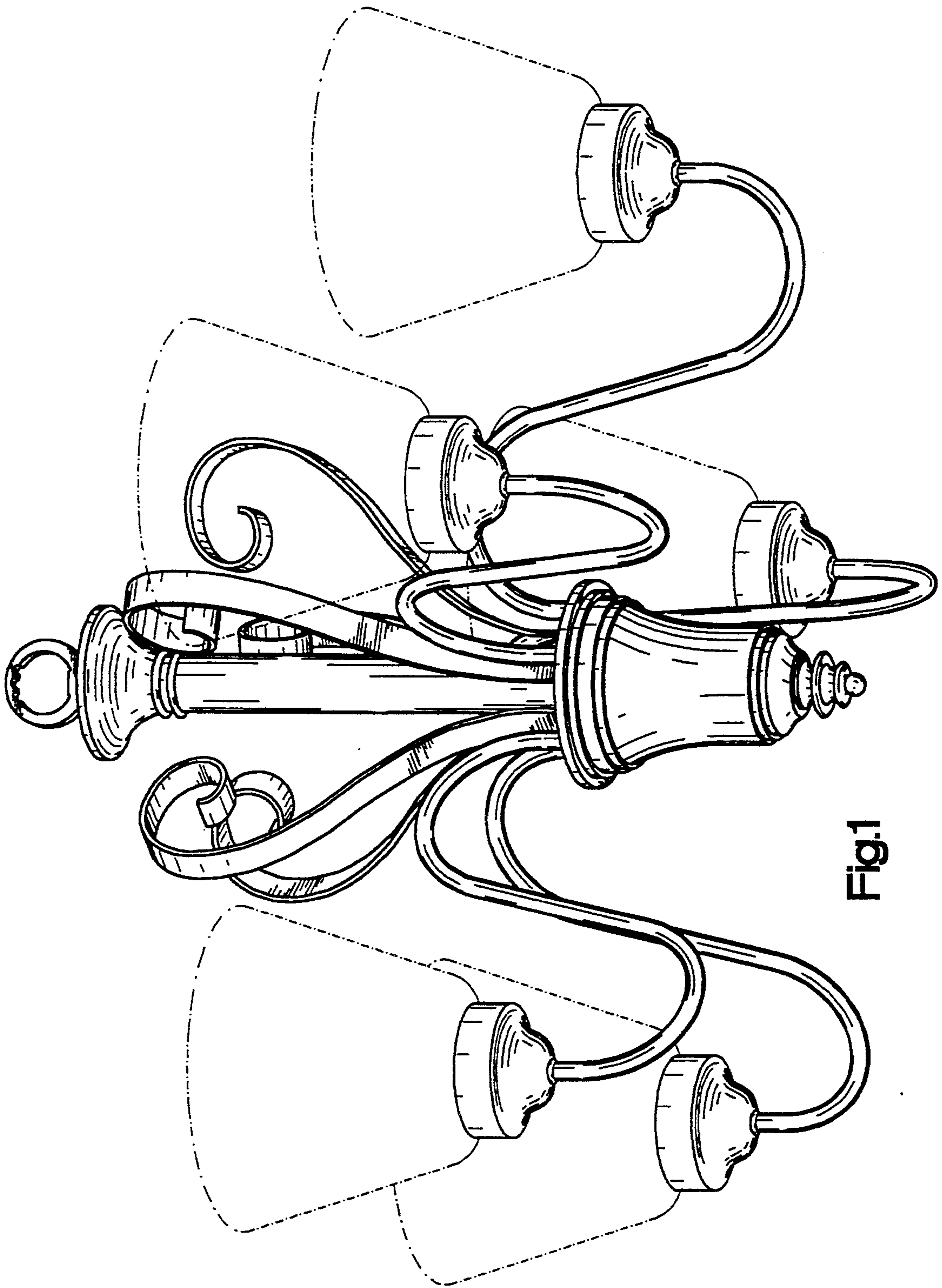

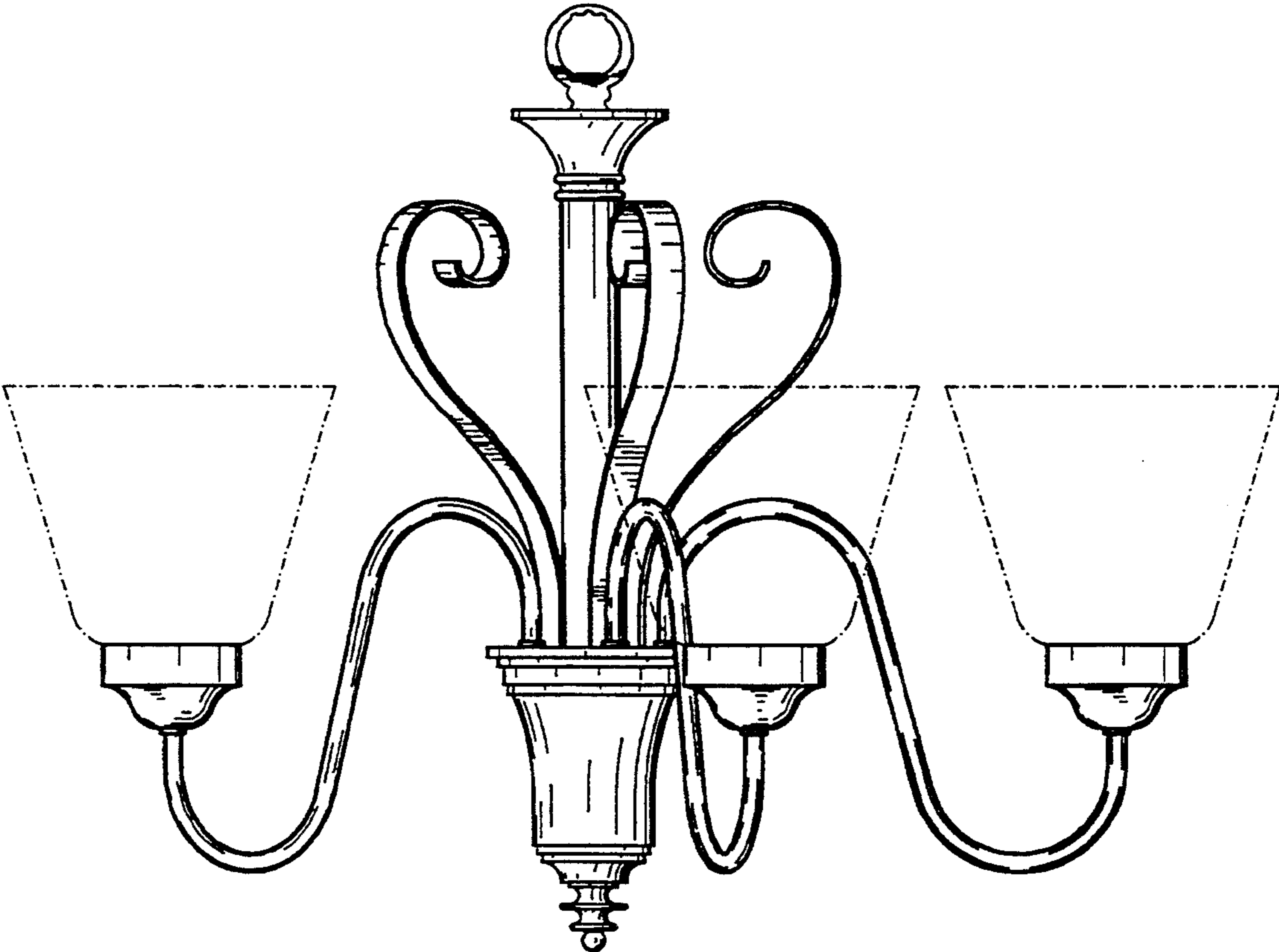

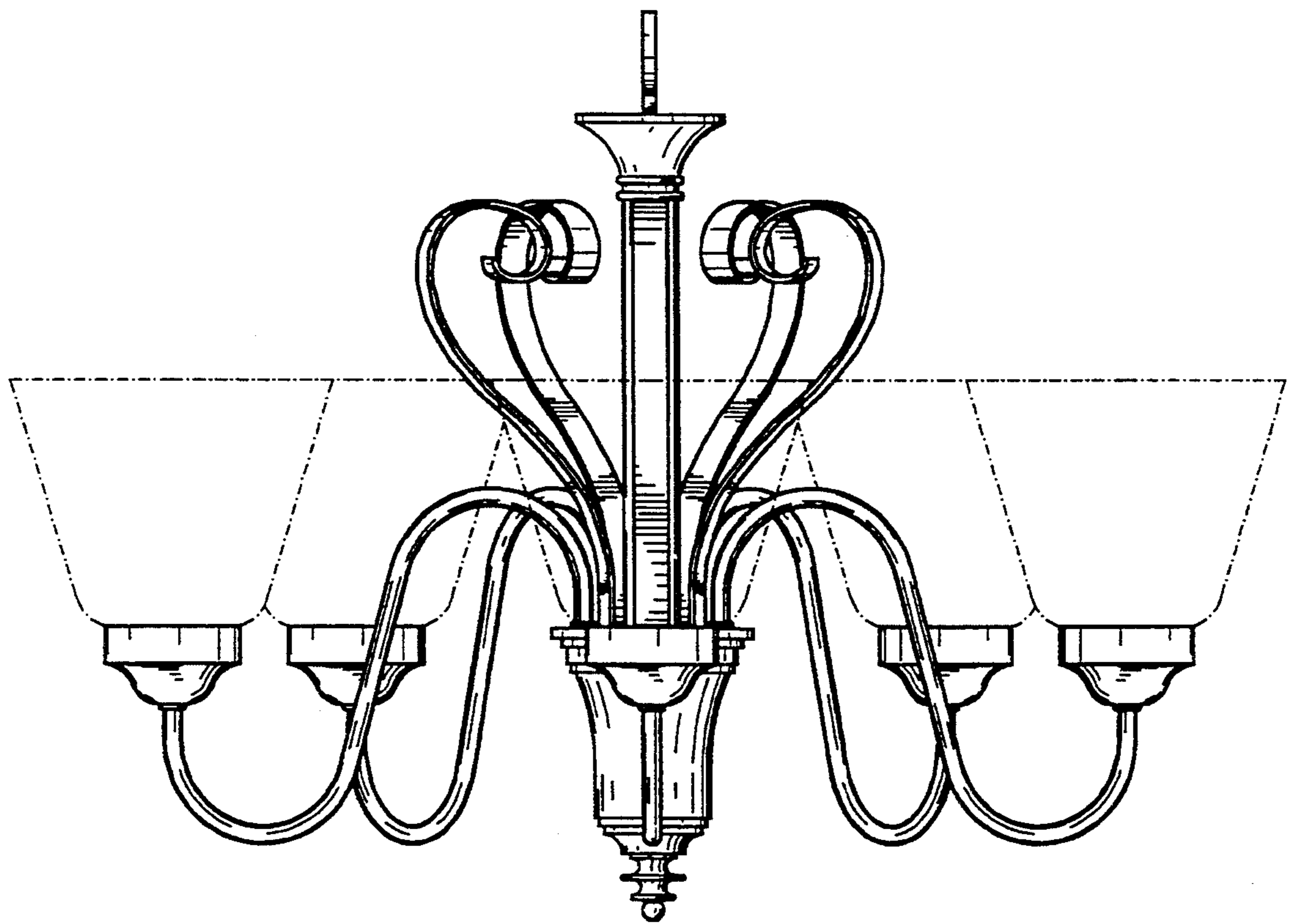

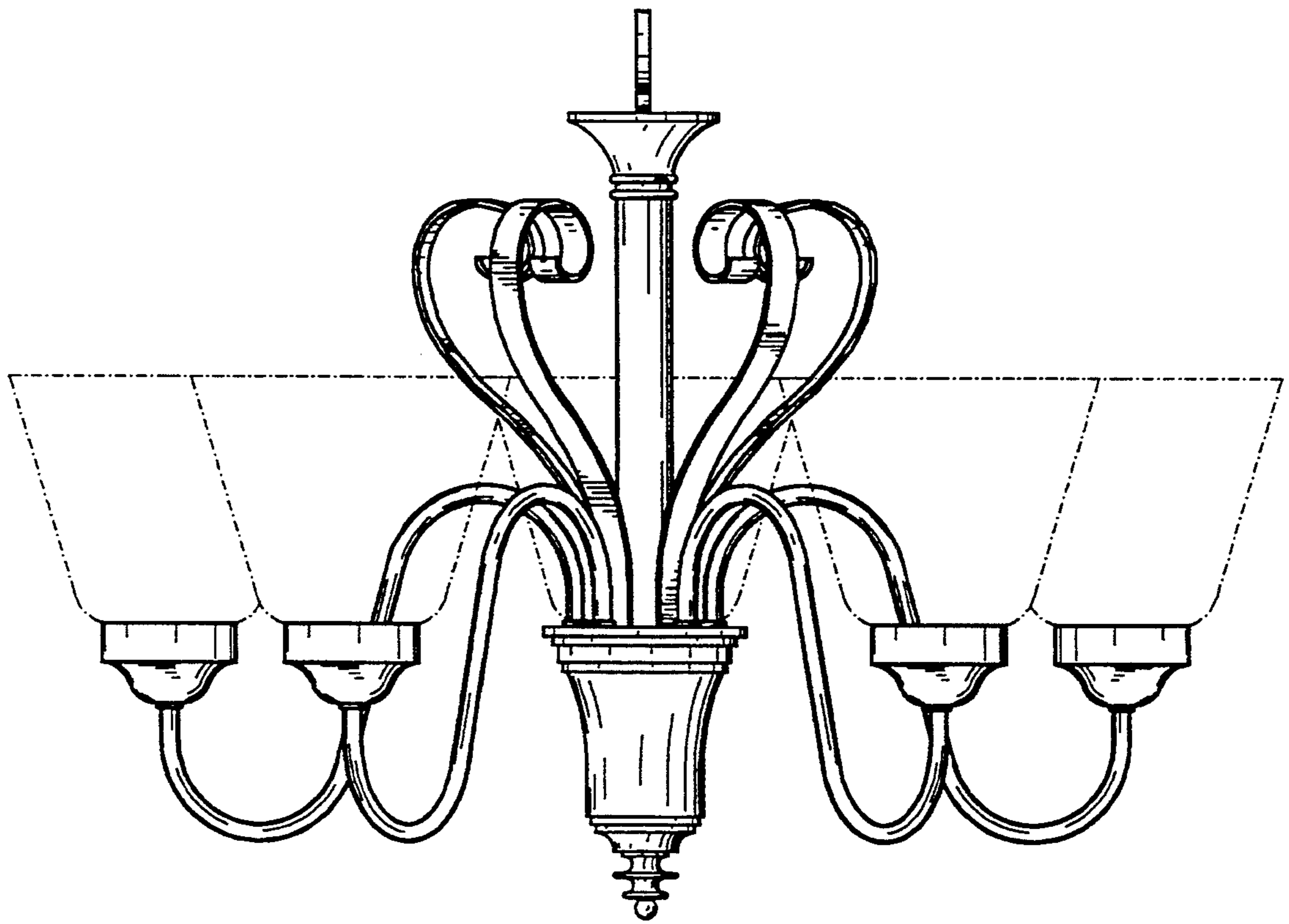

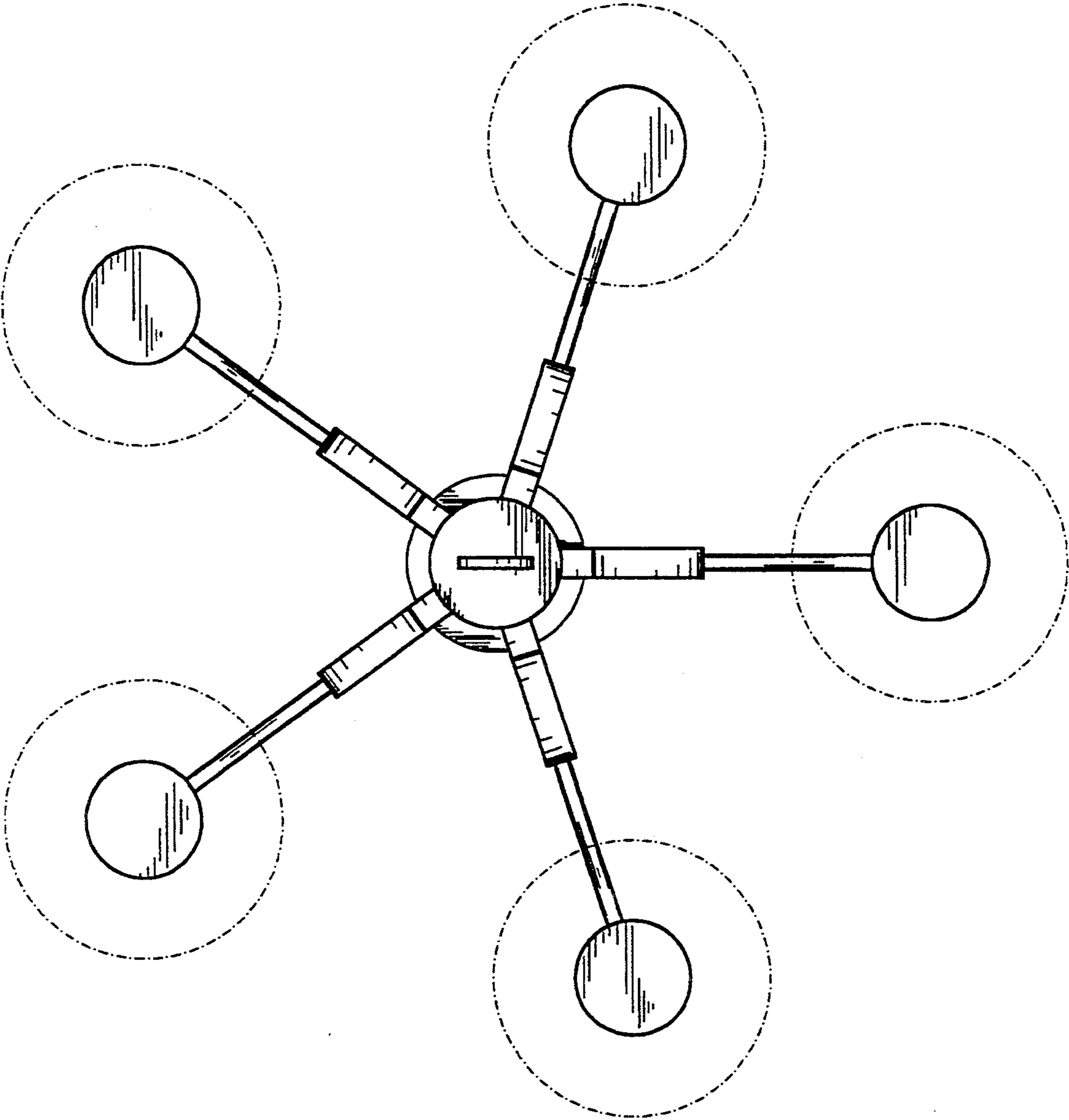

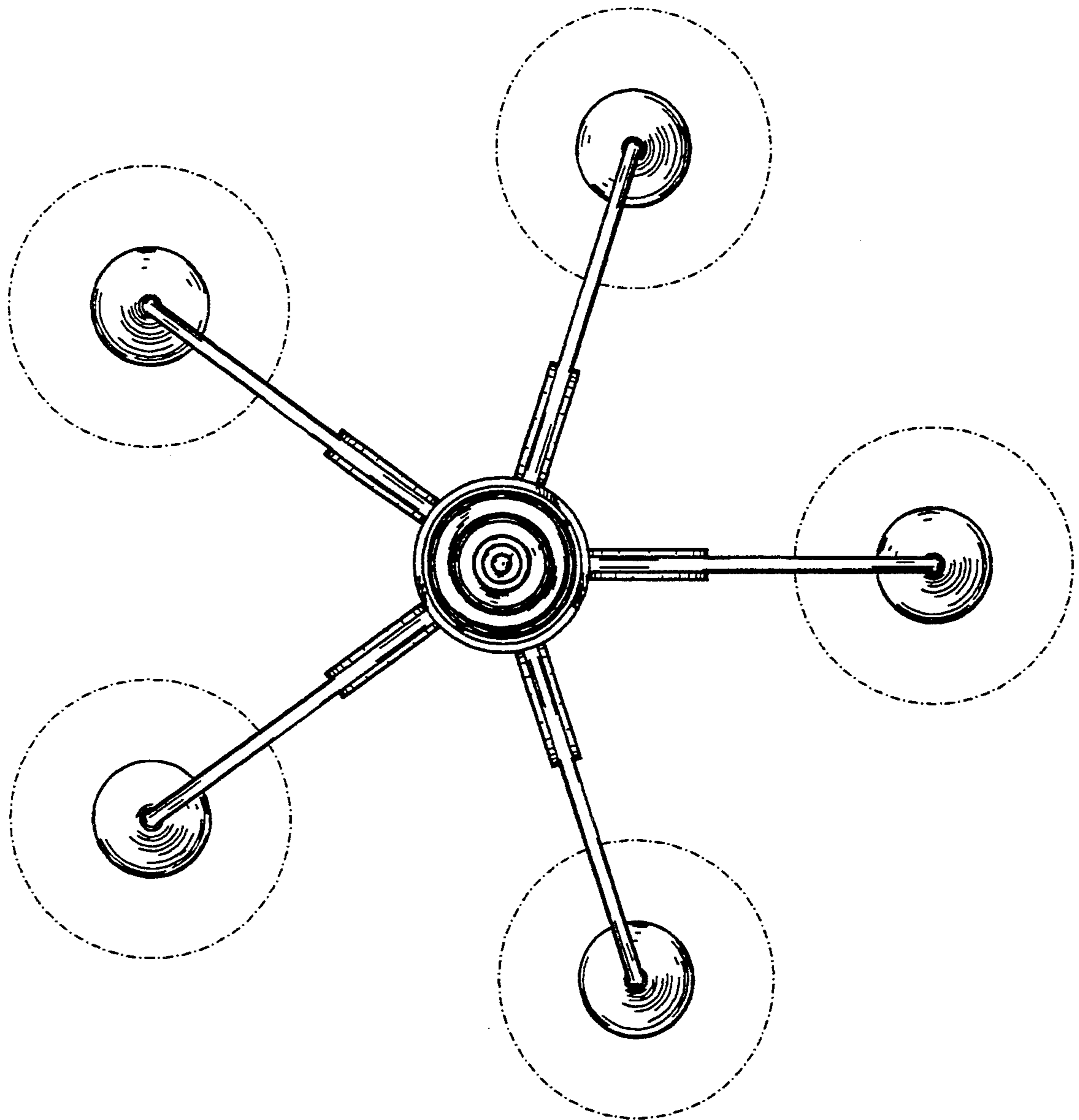
