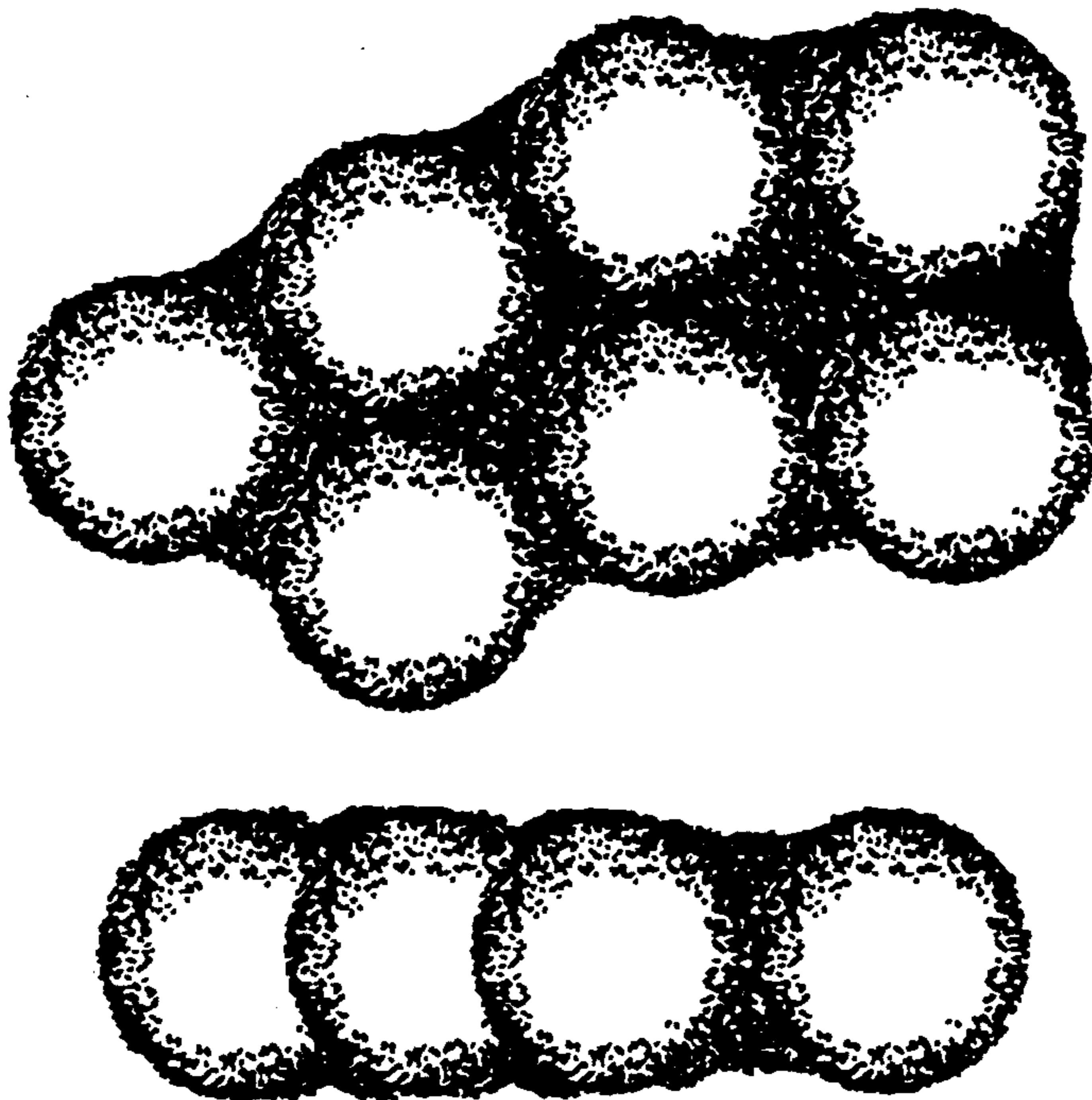

FIG. 5 is a fourth side elevational side directly opposing said third side elevational side view.



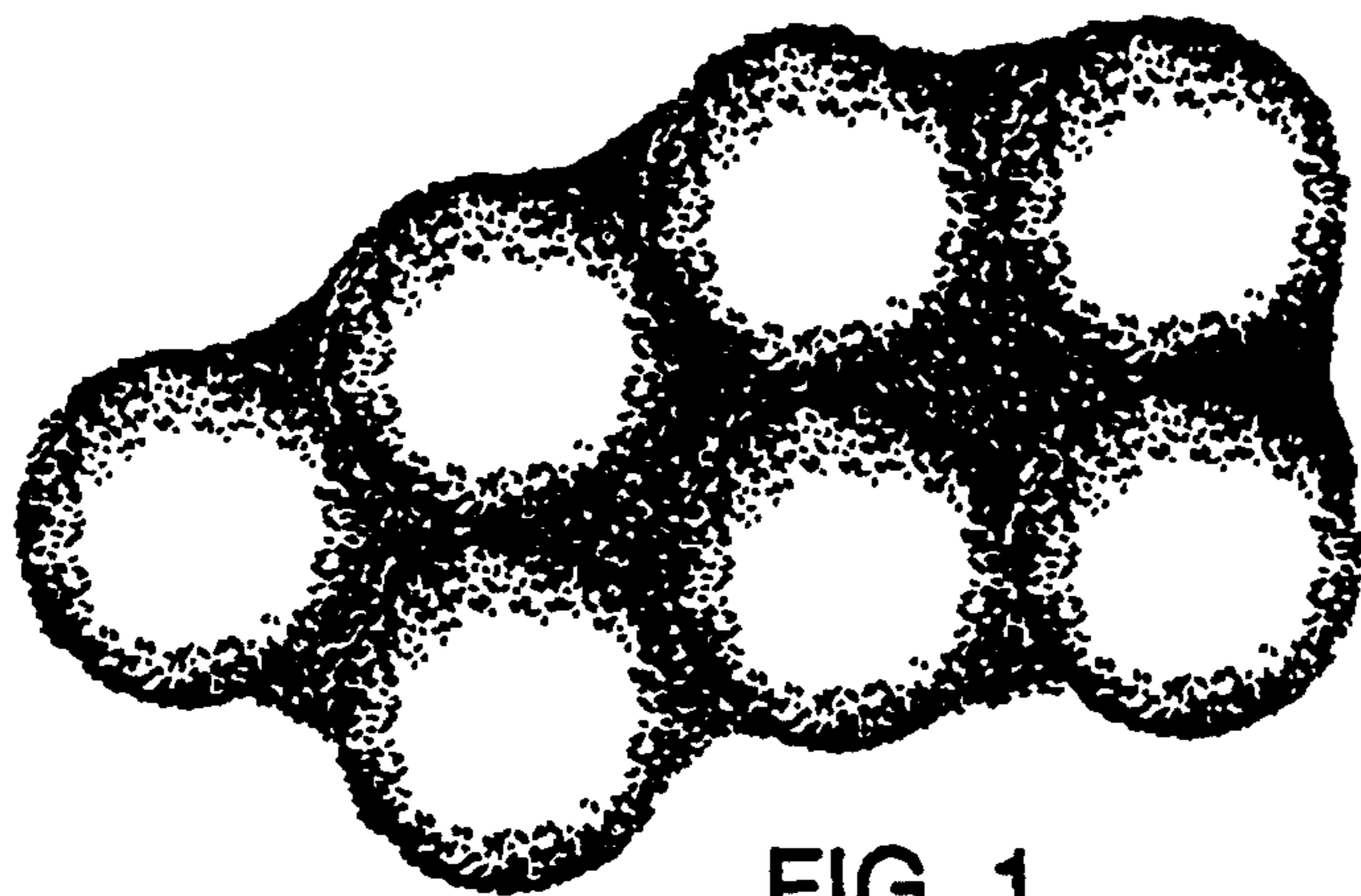

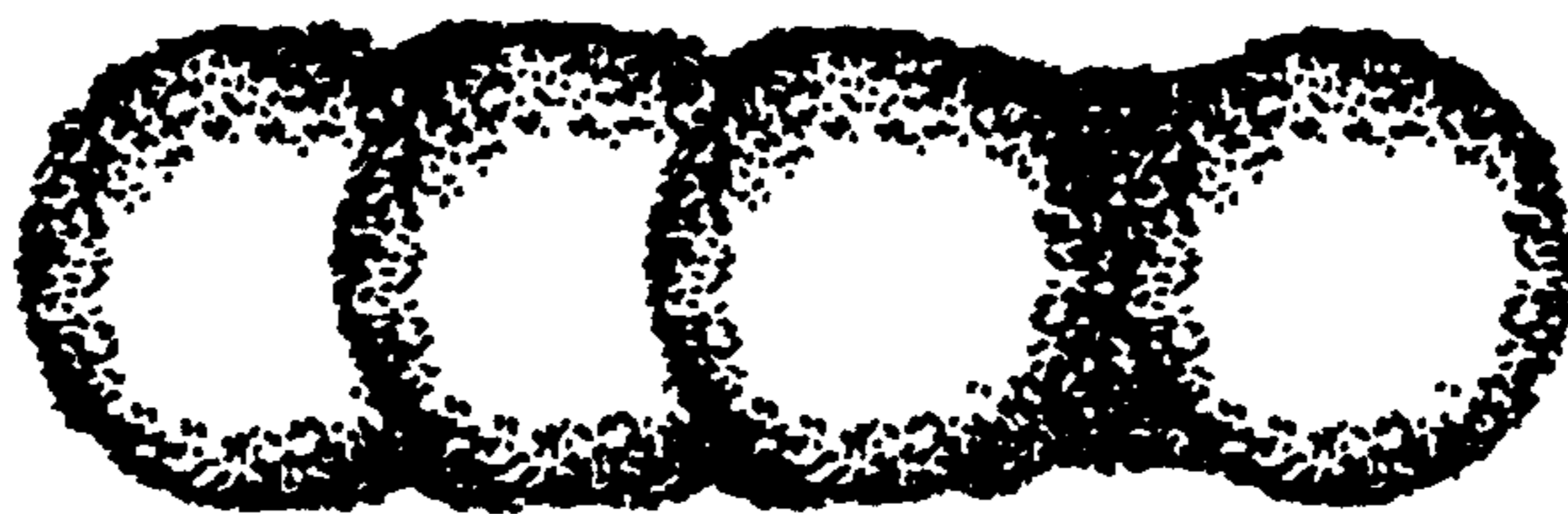

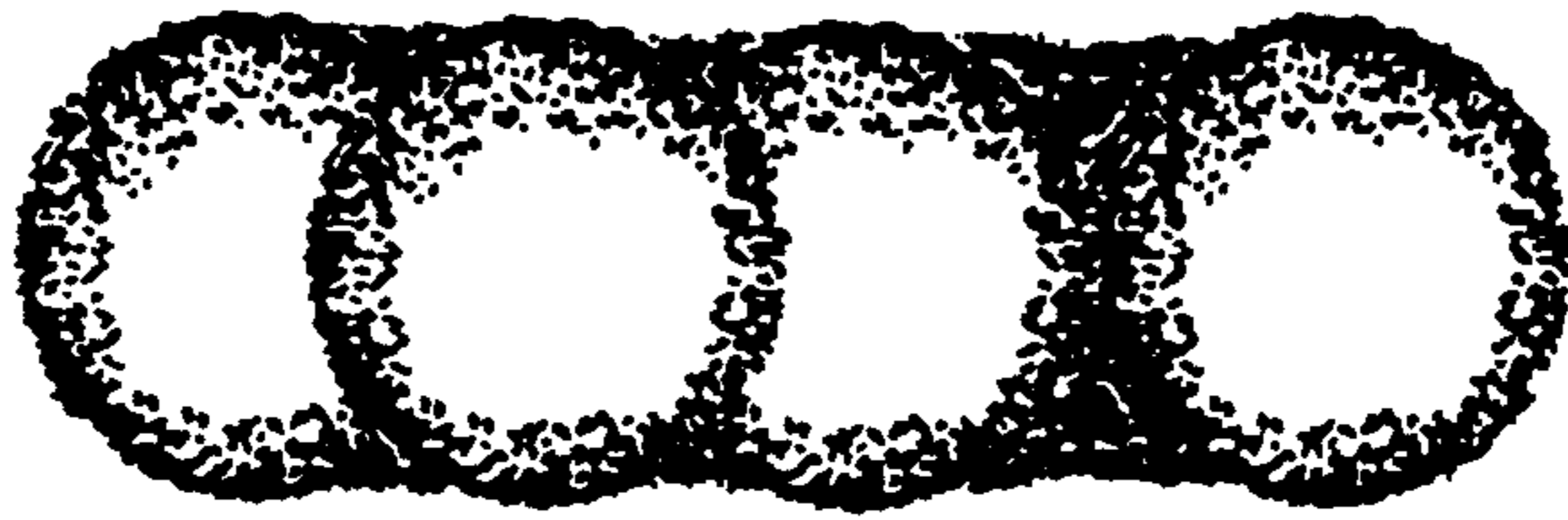

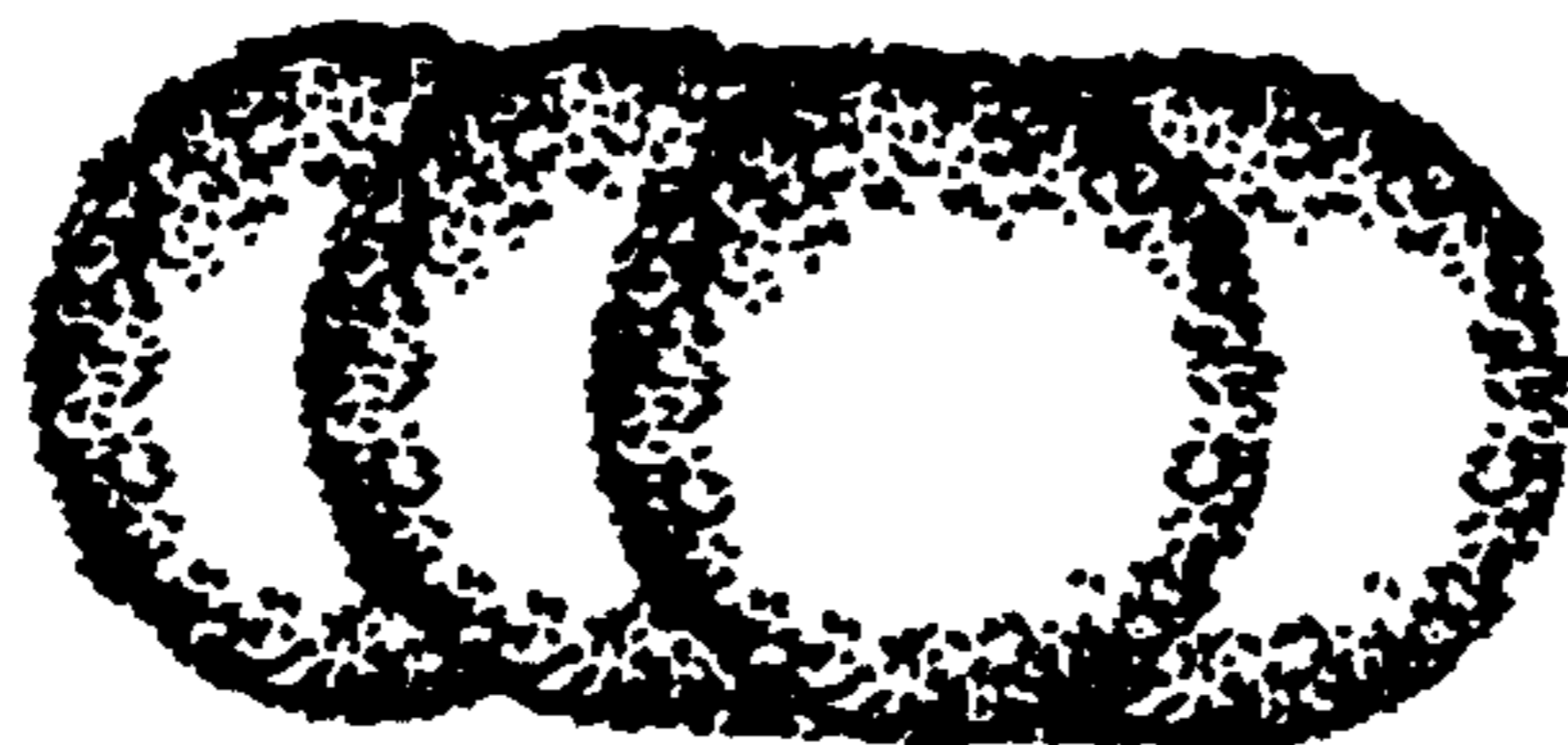
