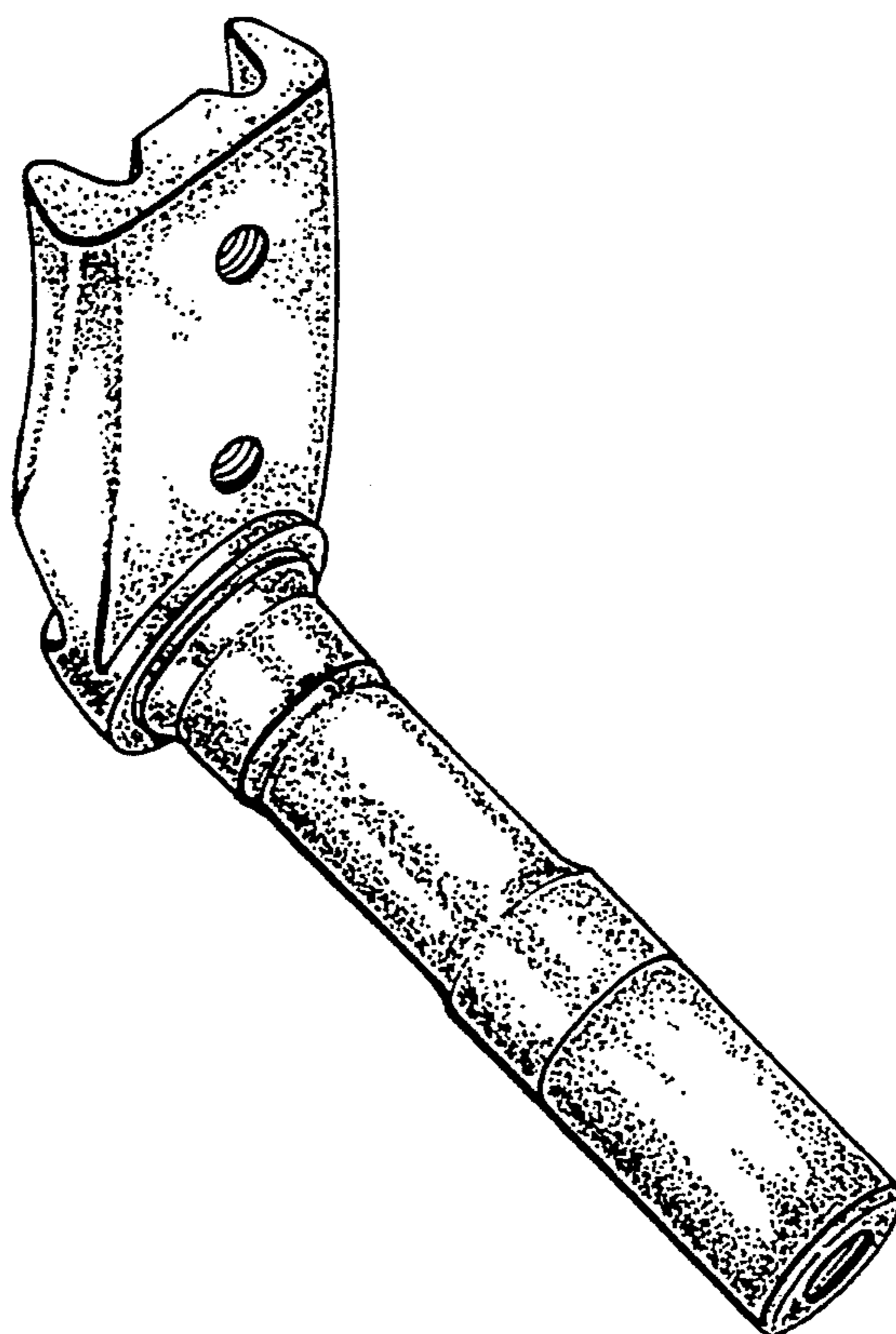

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a holder for a debarking tool showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof.



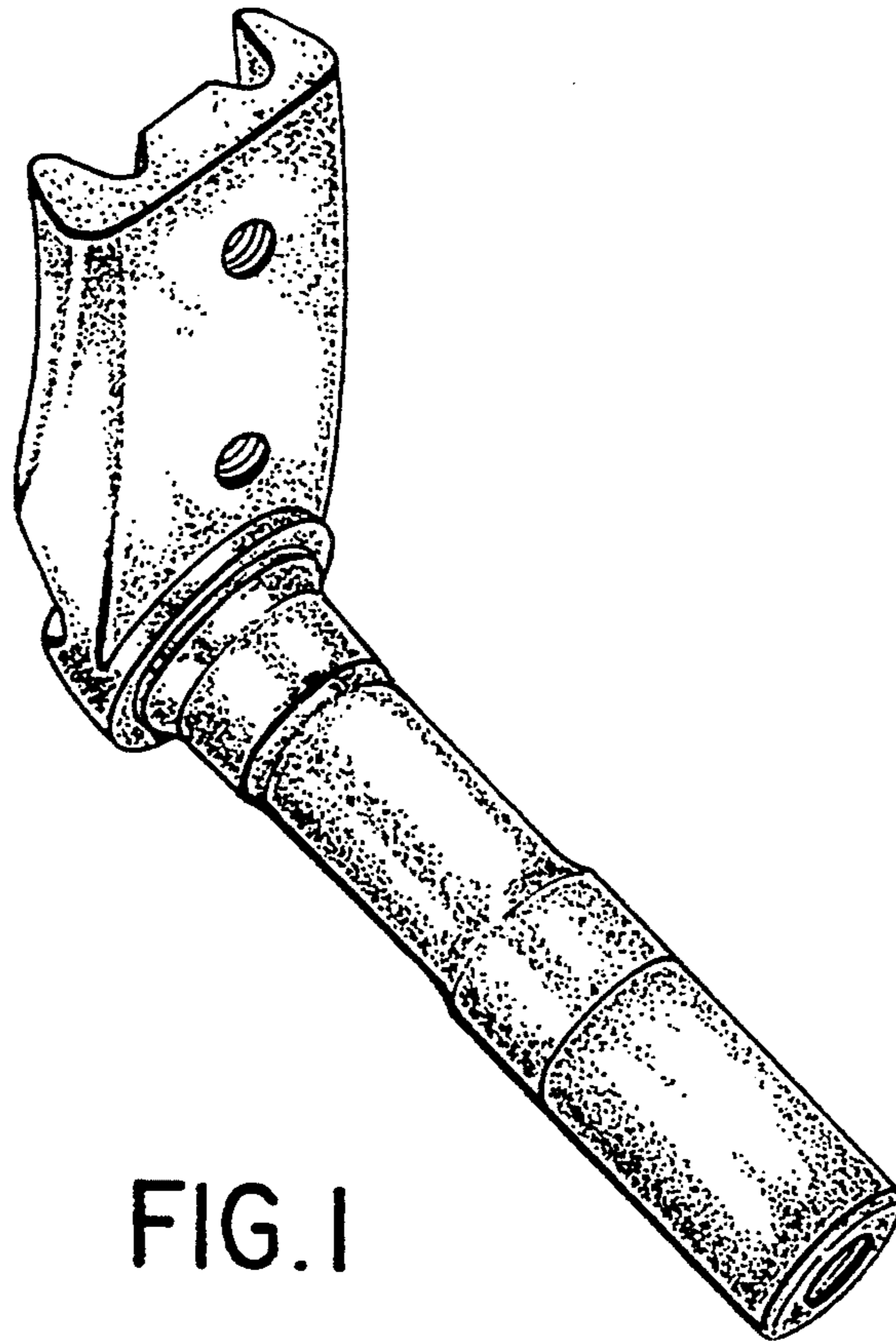

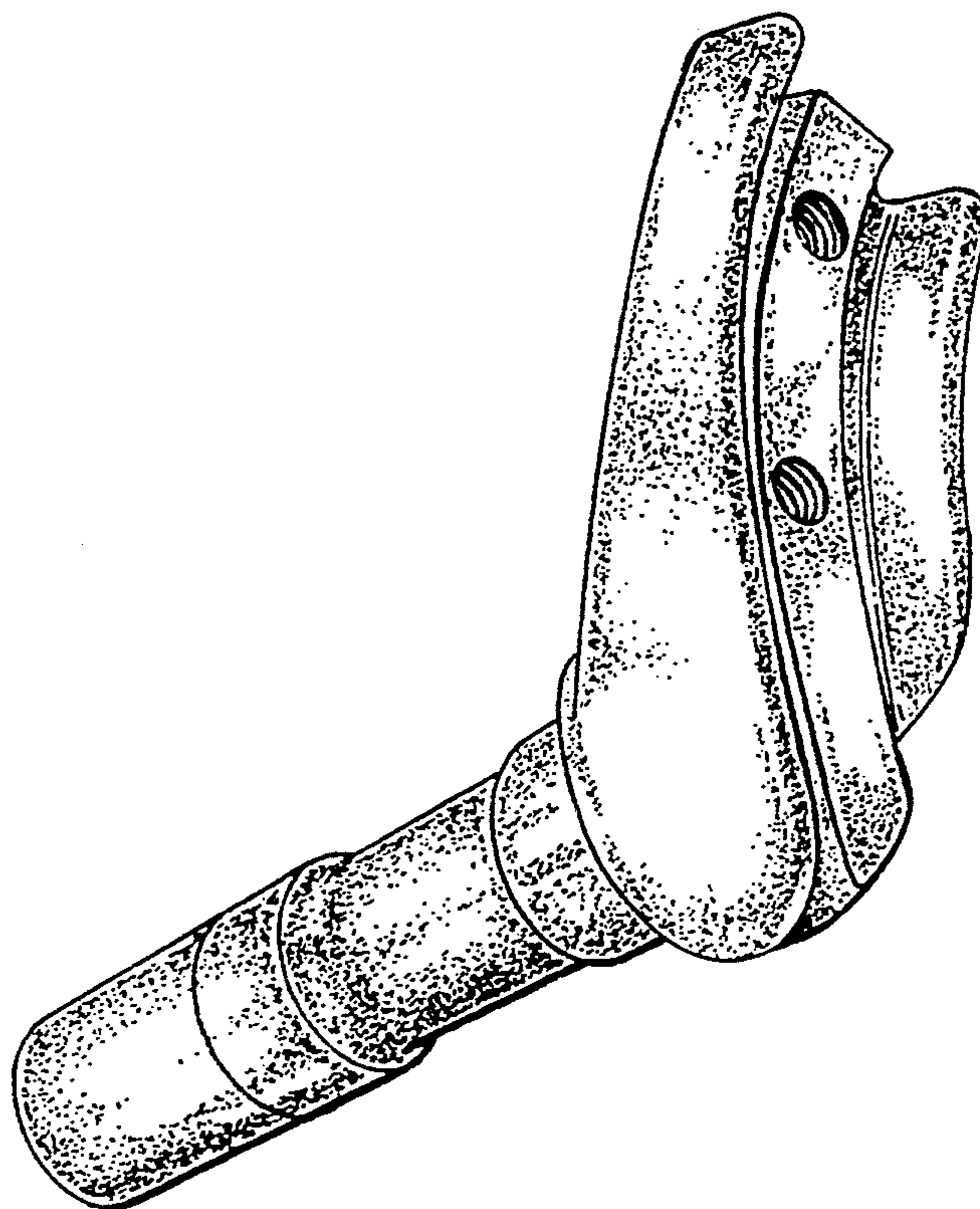
