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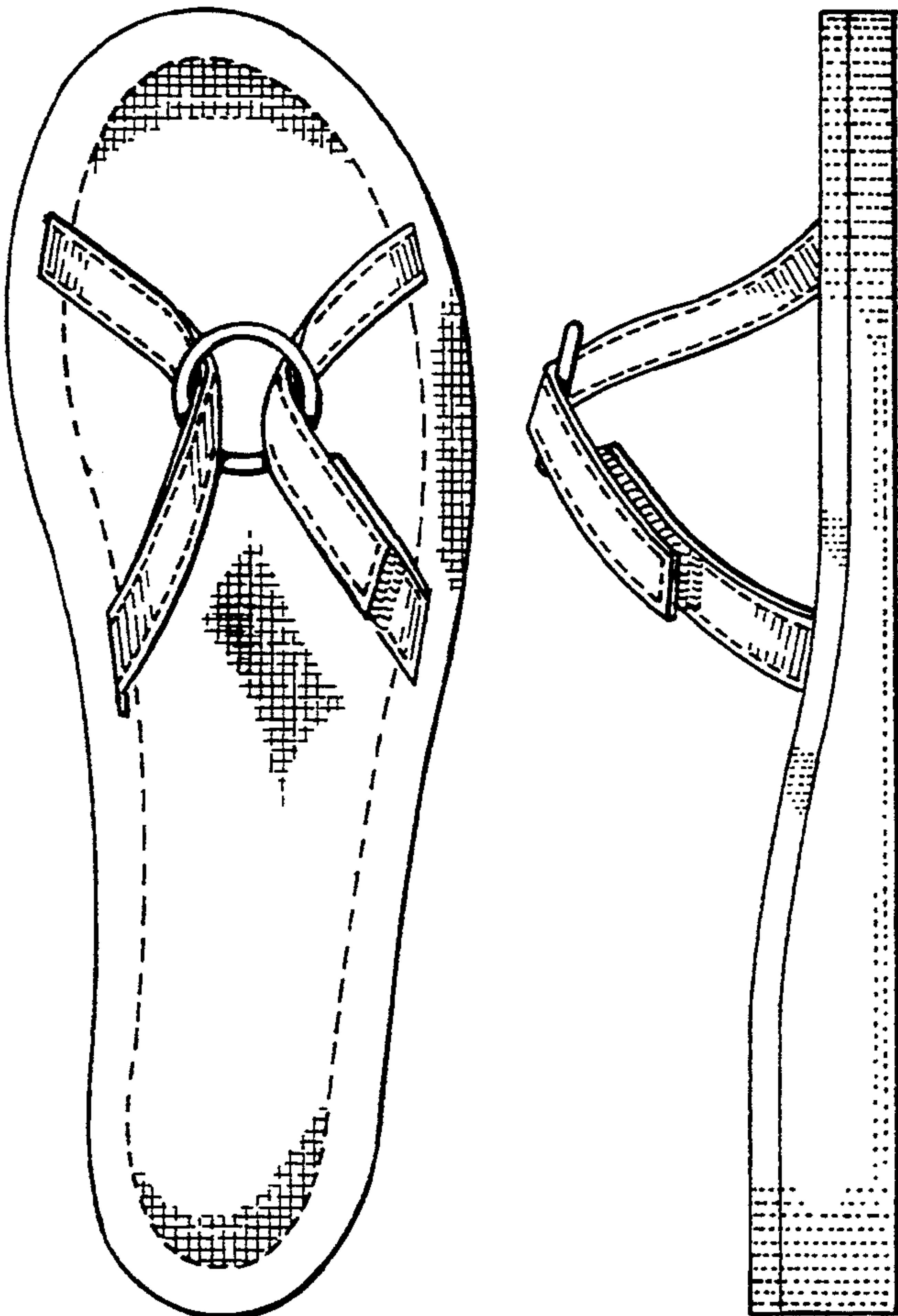

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the pedicure slipper showing the left foot embodiment of our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a pedicure slipper showing the right foot embodiment of our new design, the slippers being mutual mirror images;
FIG. 3 is a right side view of the right foot slipper thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the right foot slipper thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of the right foot slipper thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the right foot slipper thereof.



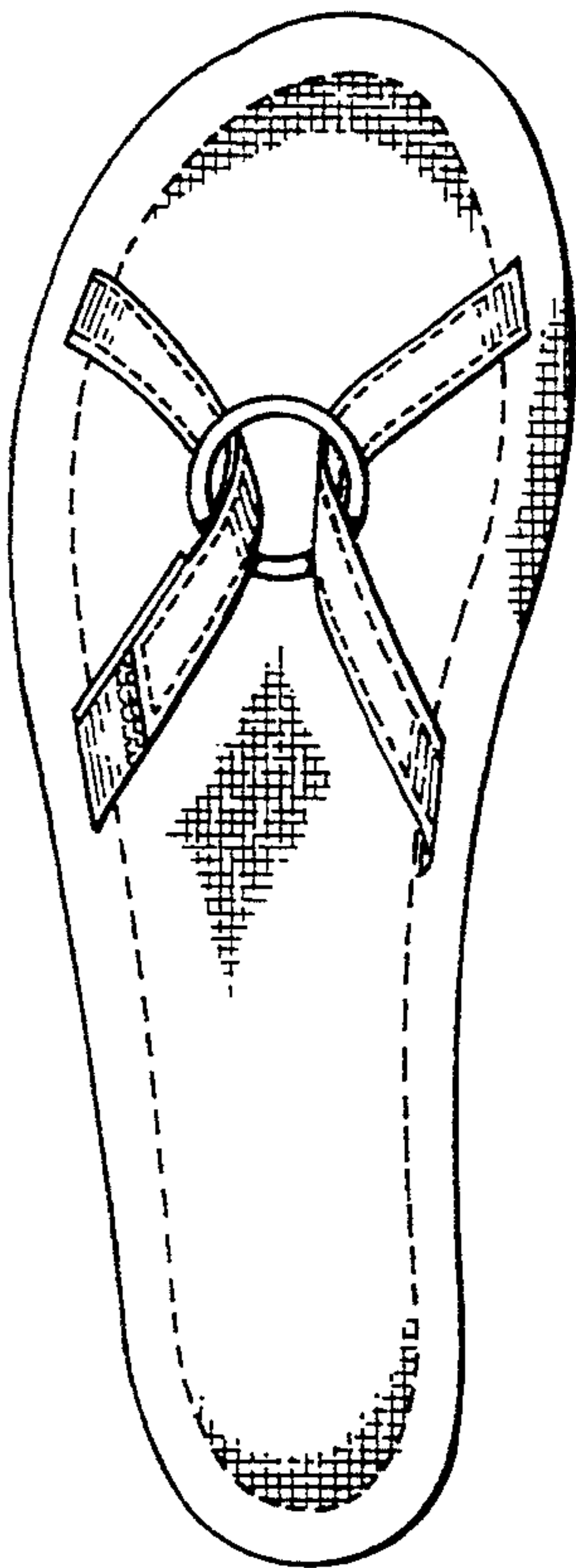

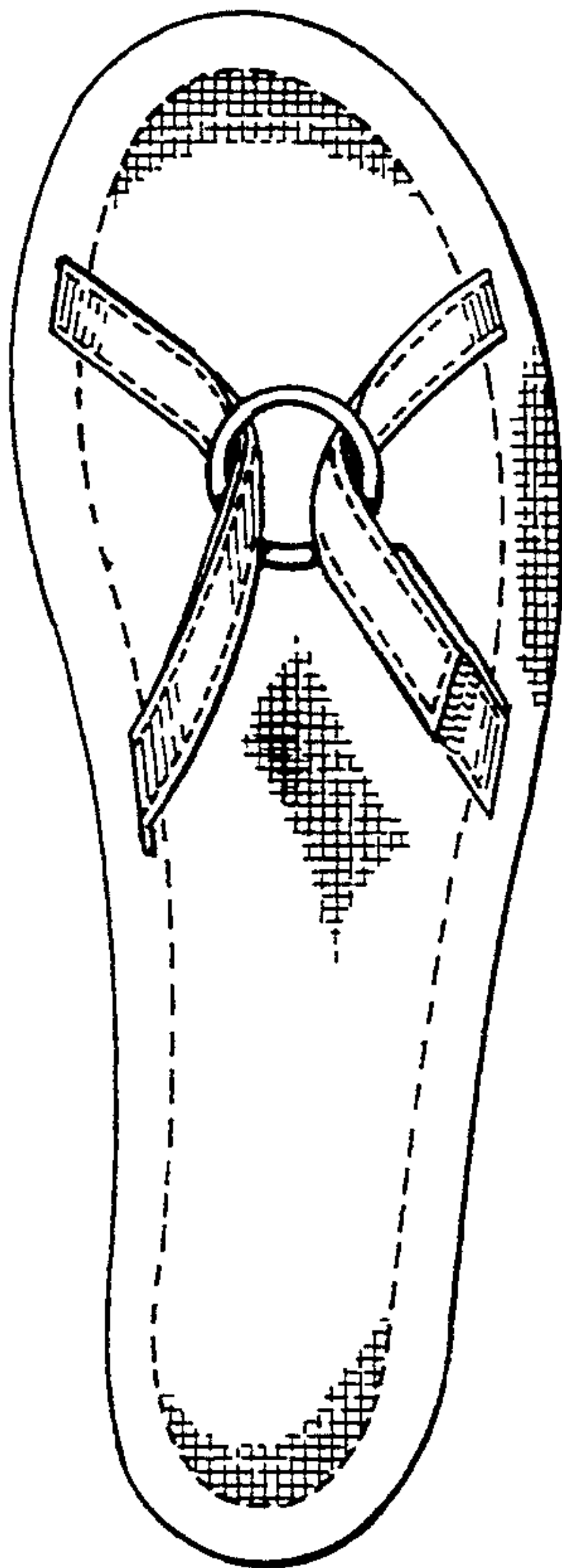

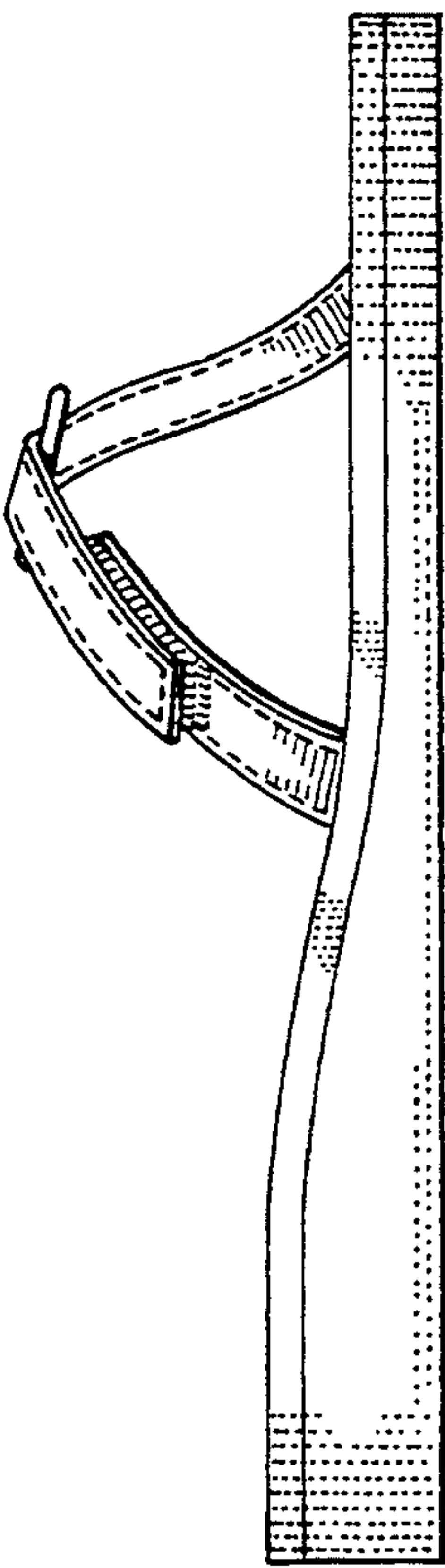

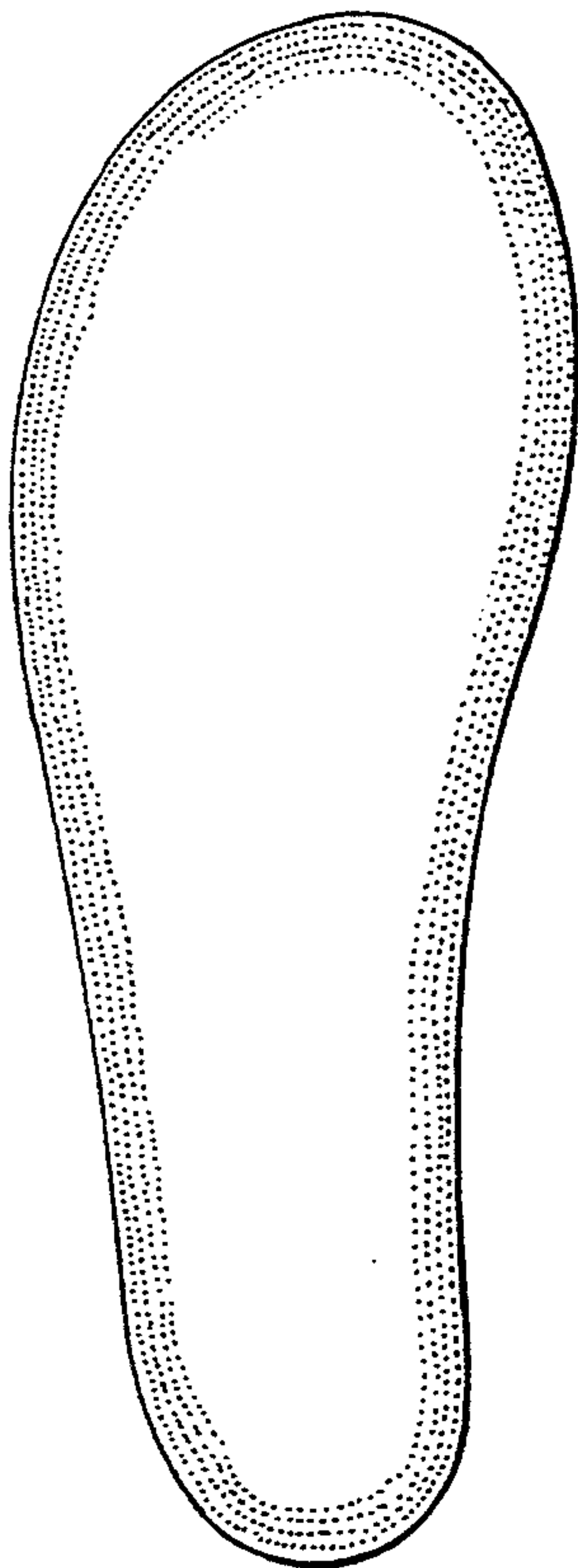

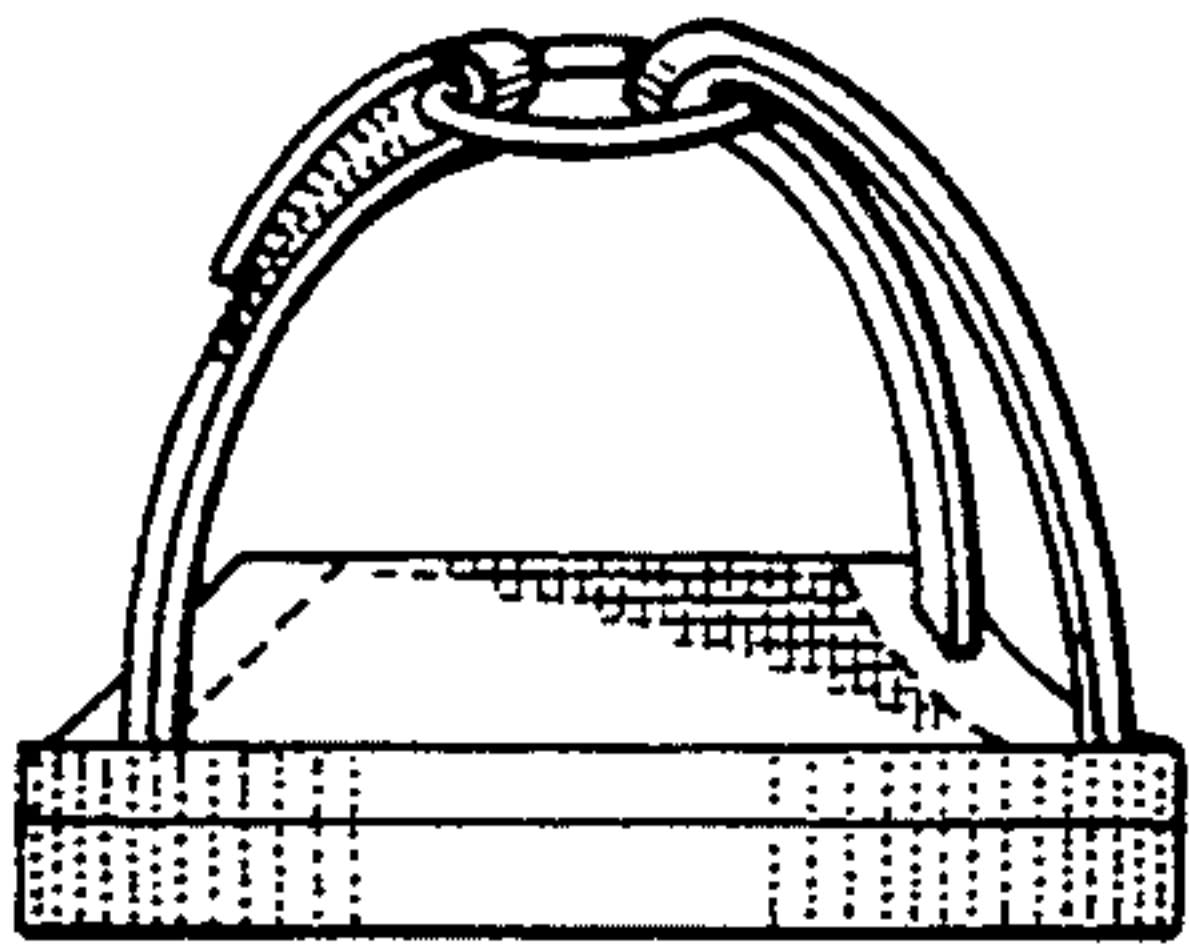

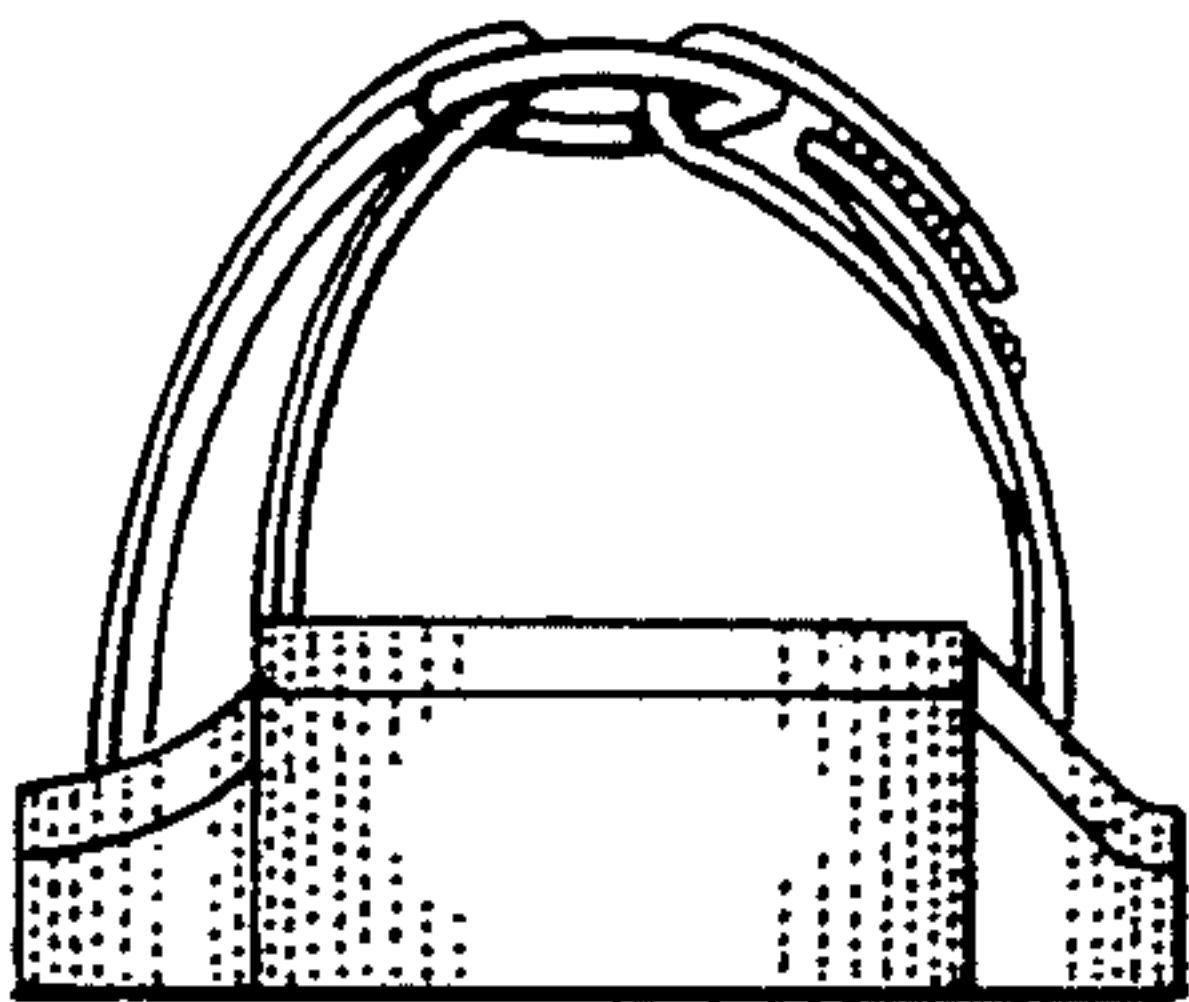
