[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a compact disc storage unit, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a compact disc storage unit with the doors in two different open positions showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof with the doors in closed position;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof with the doors in closed position;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof with the doors in closed position;

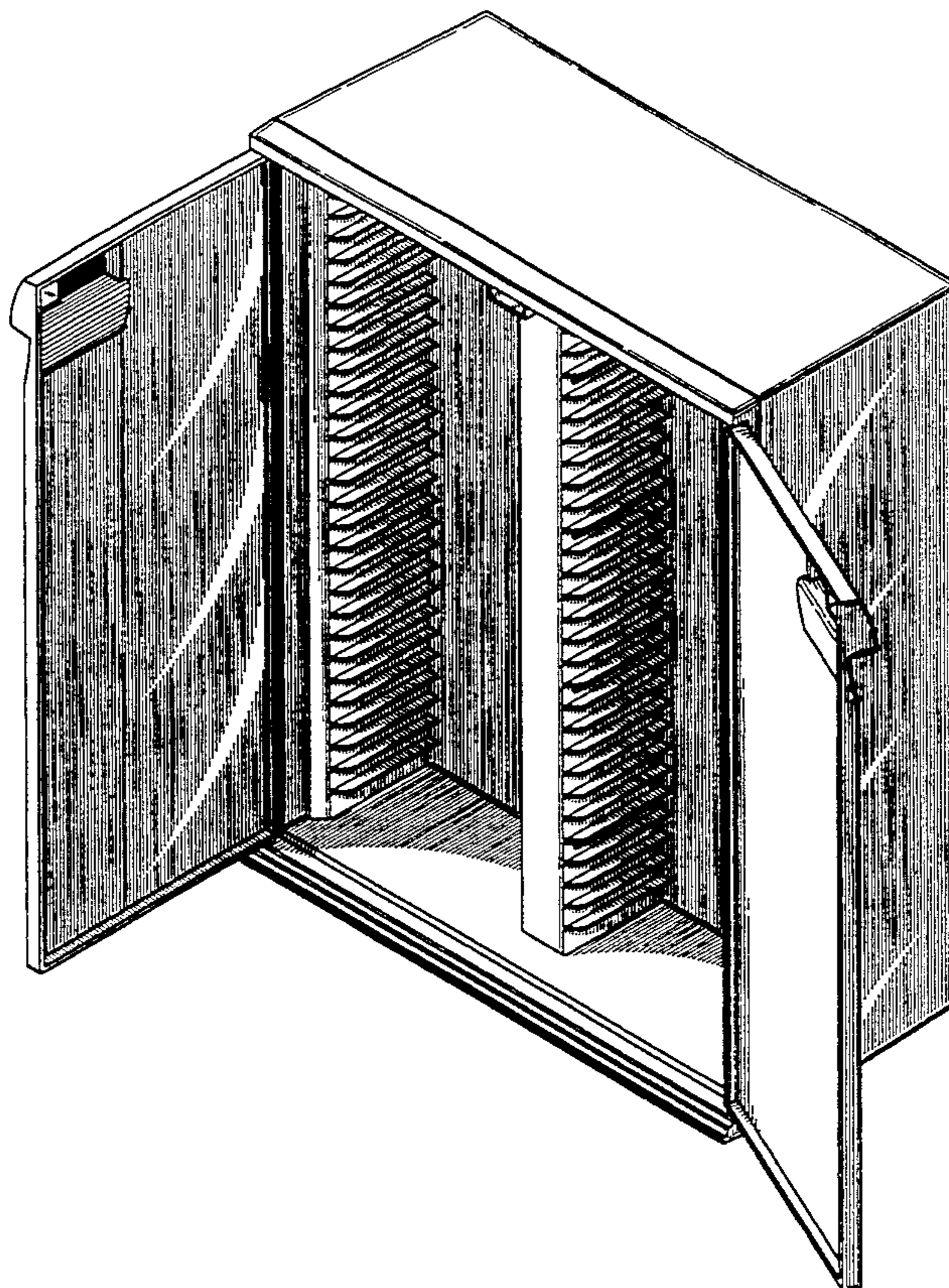
FIG. 5 is a right hand side elevational view thereof with the doors in closed position, the left being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 6 is a back elevational view thereof with the doors in closed position;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof with the doors in open position;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view with the doors in open position; and,

FIG. 9 is a right hand side elevational view thereof with the doors in open position, the left being a mirror image thereof.



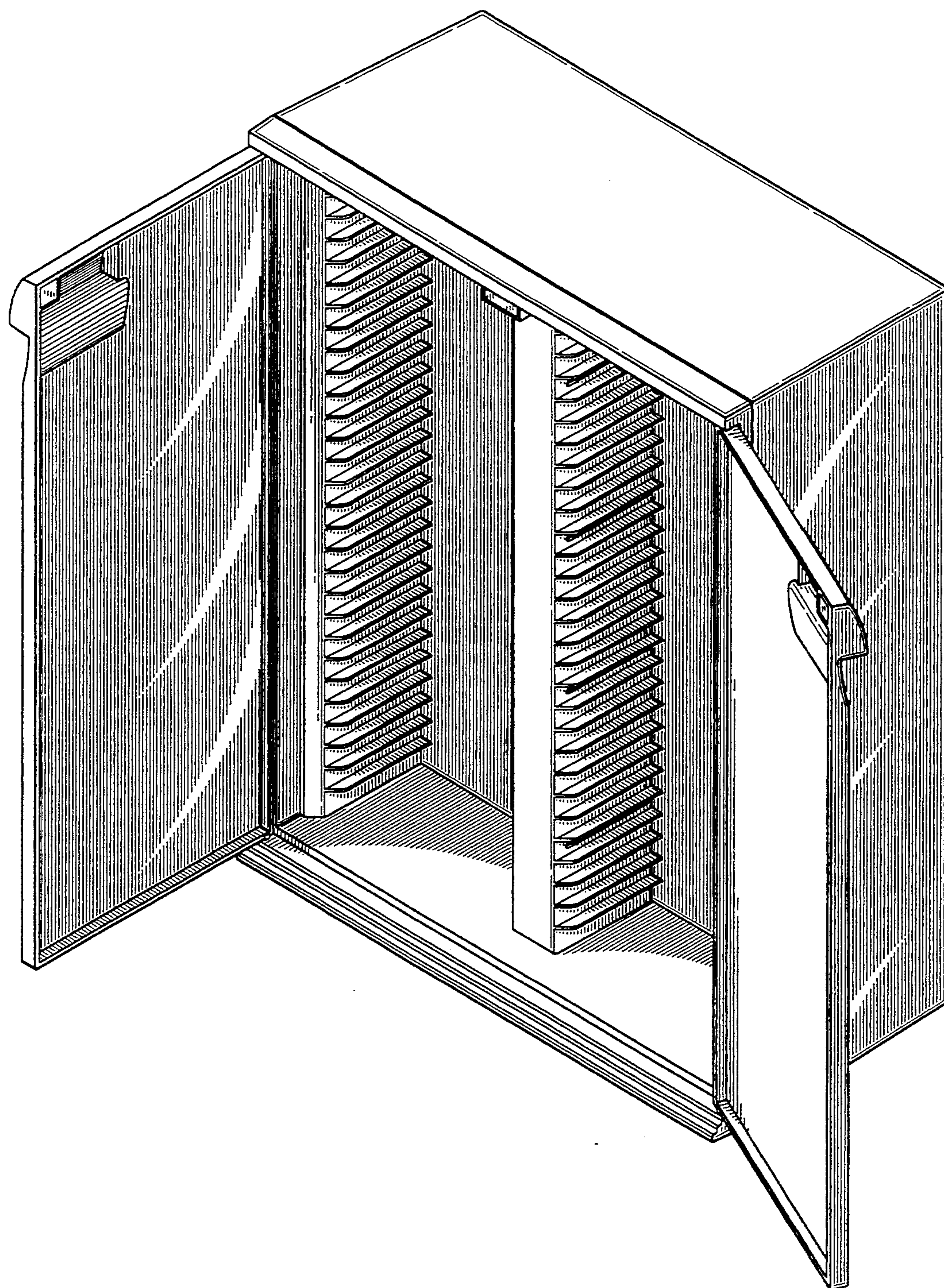

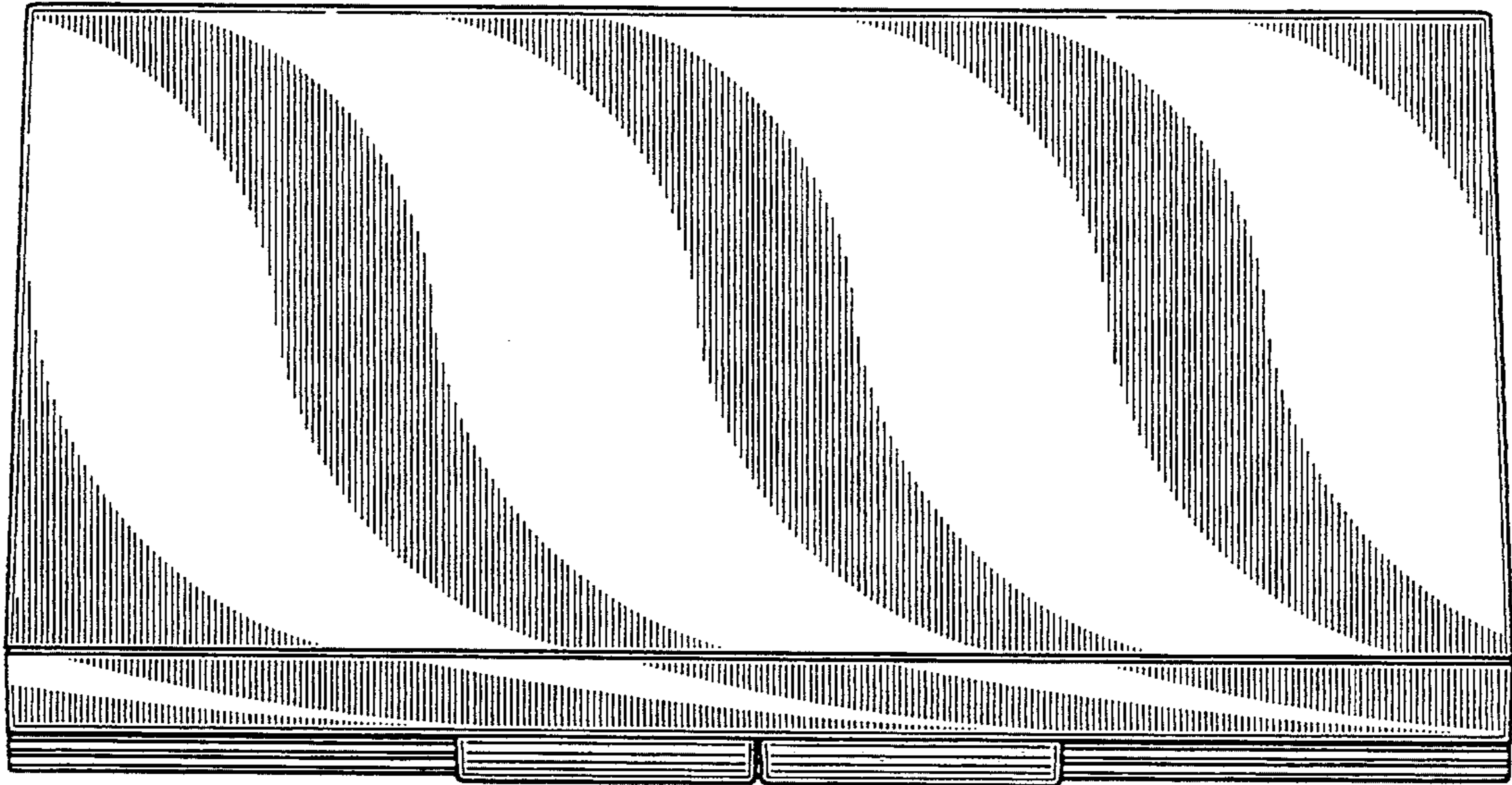

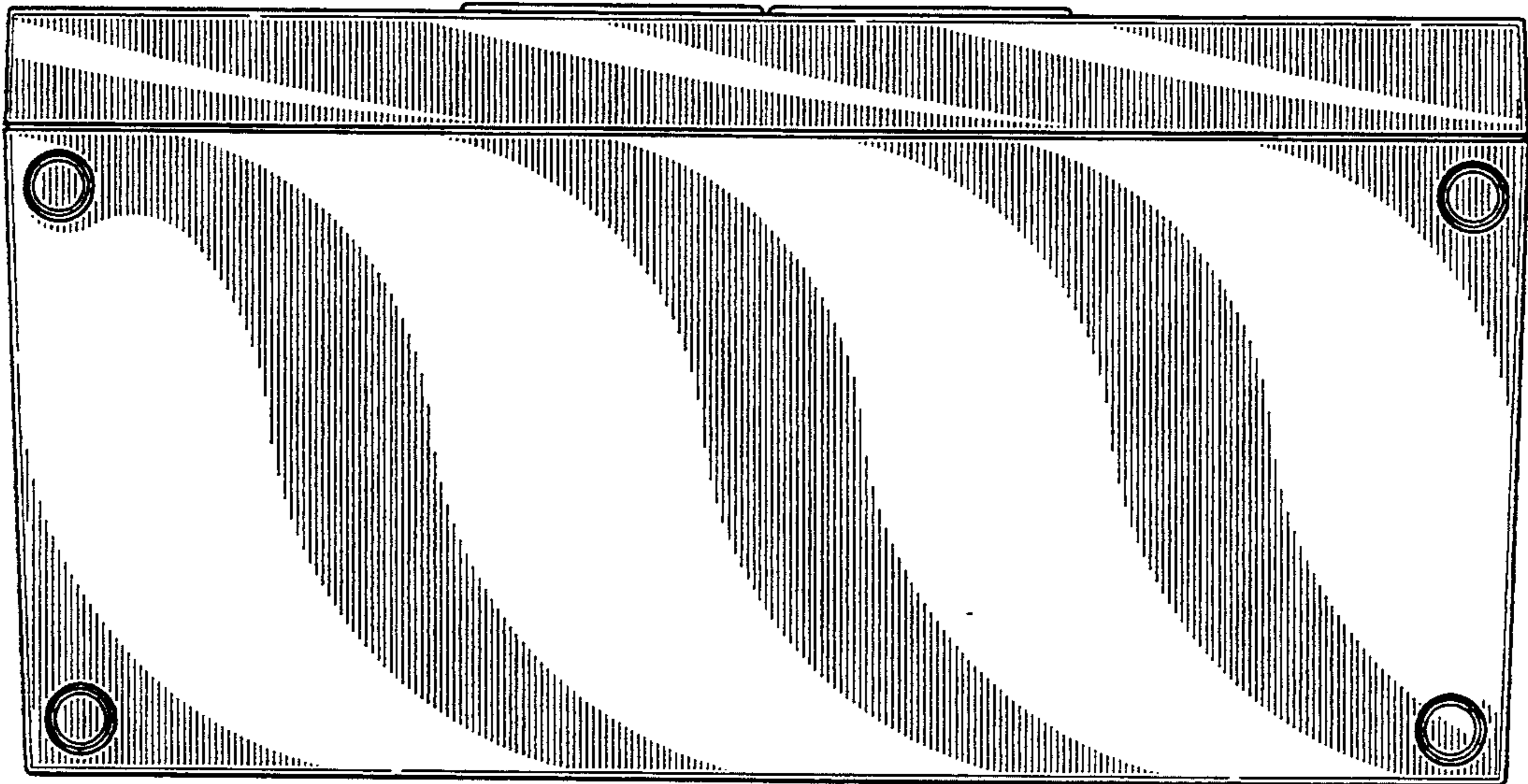

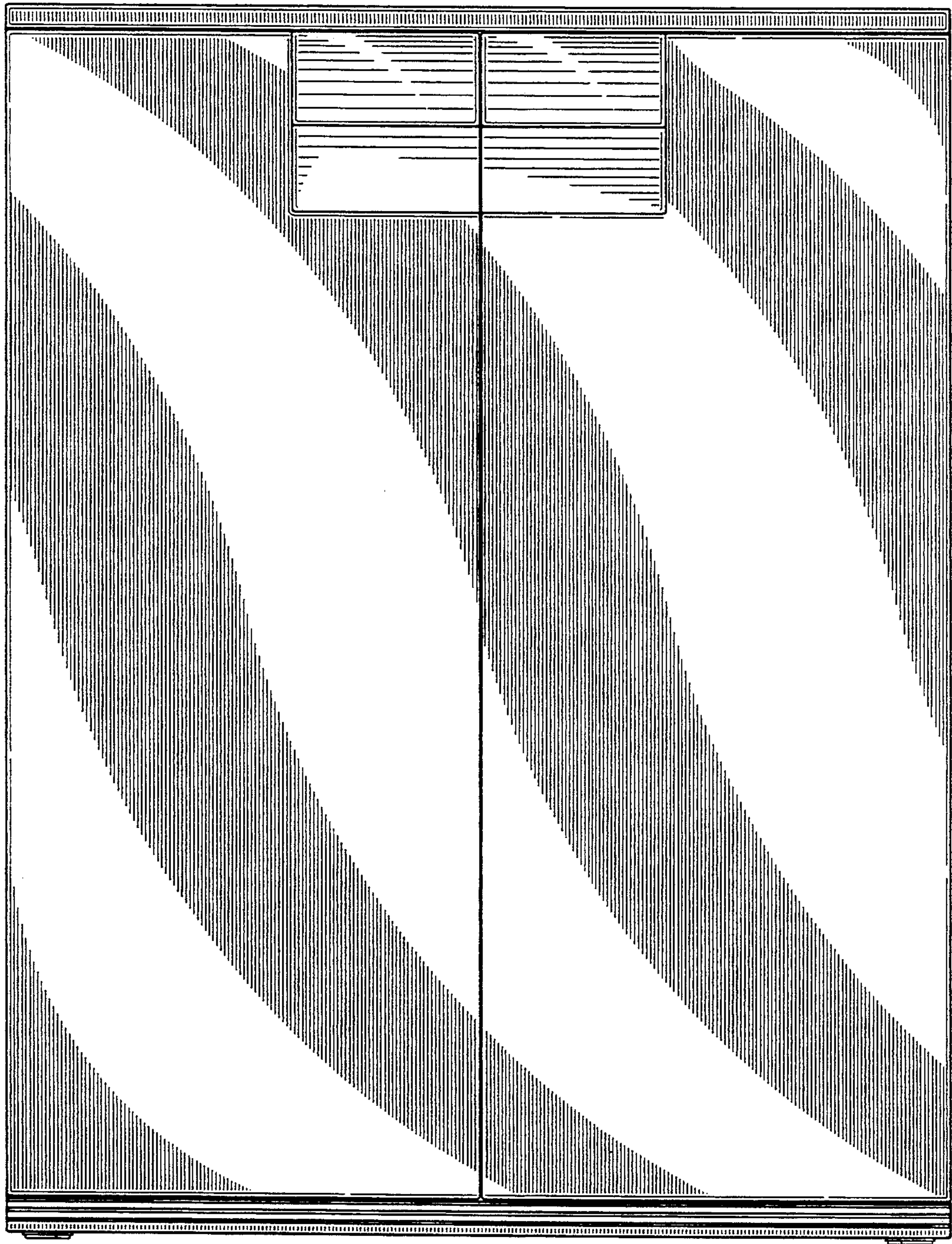

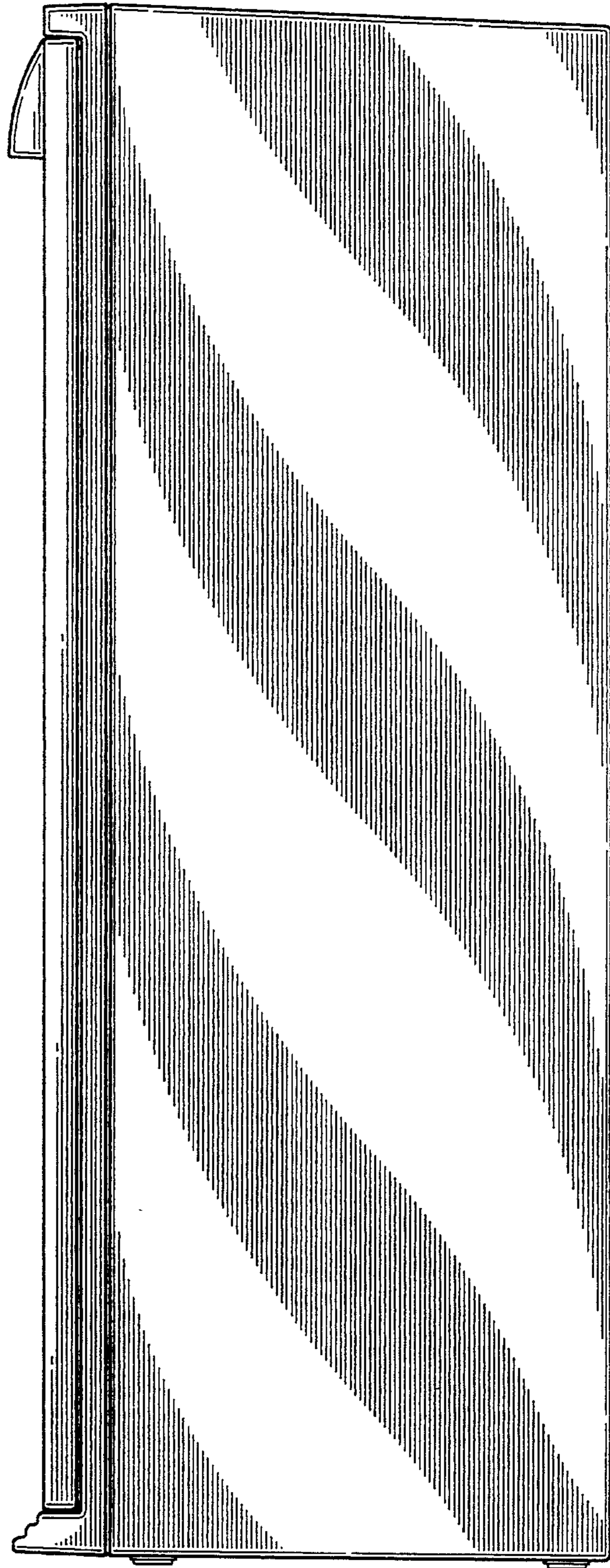

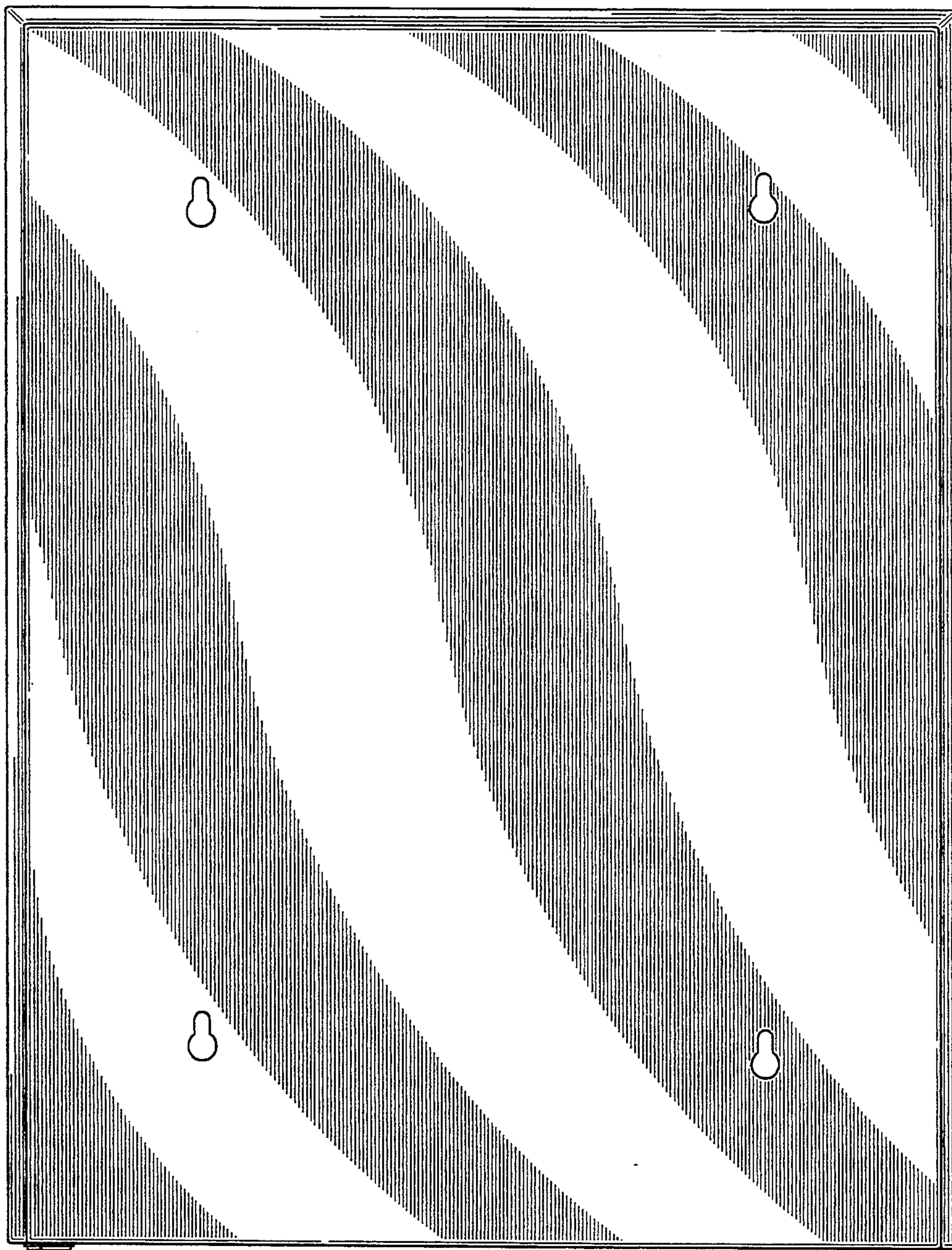

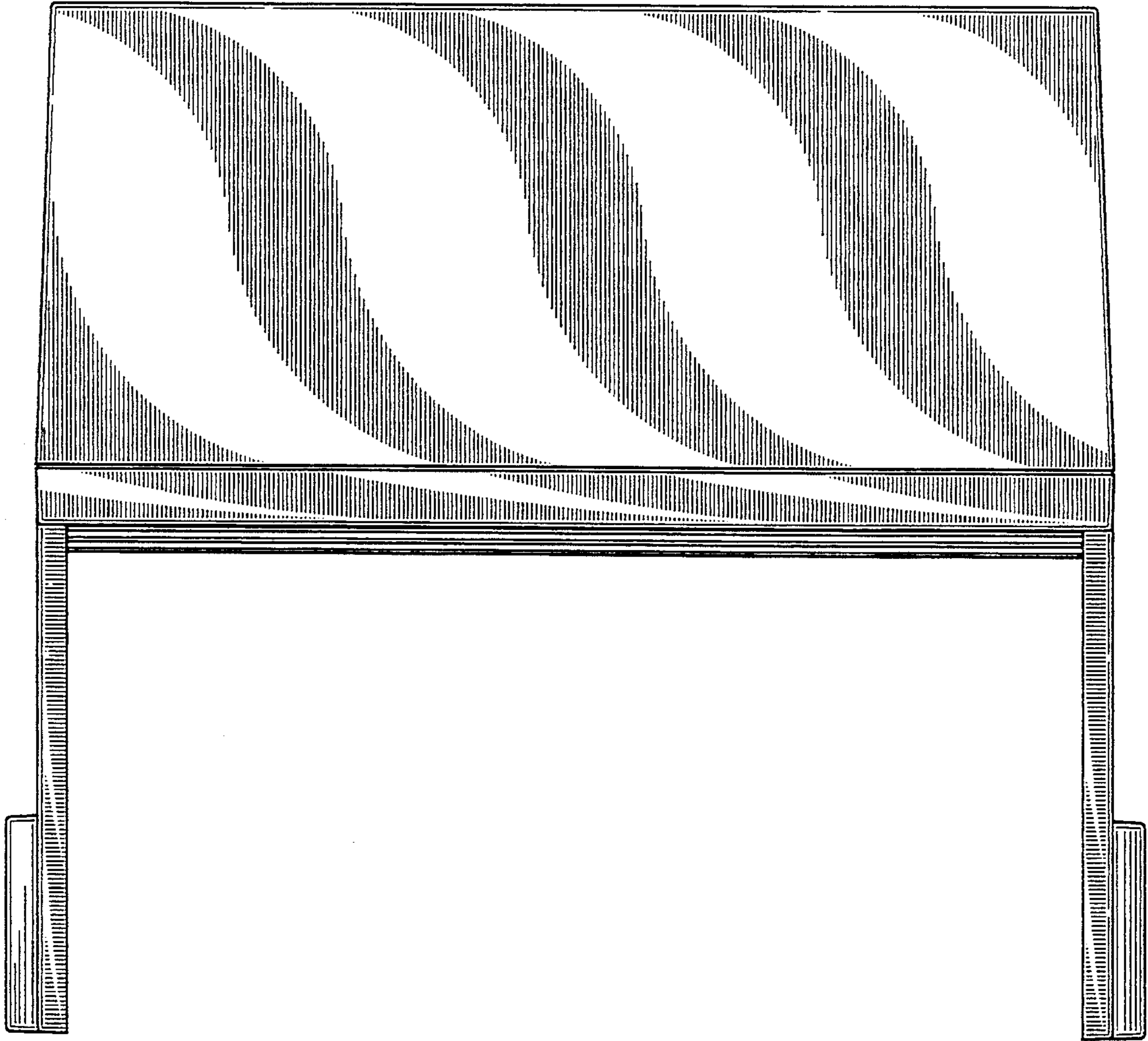

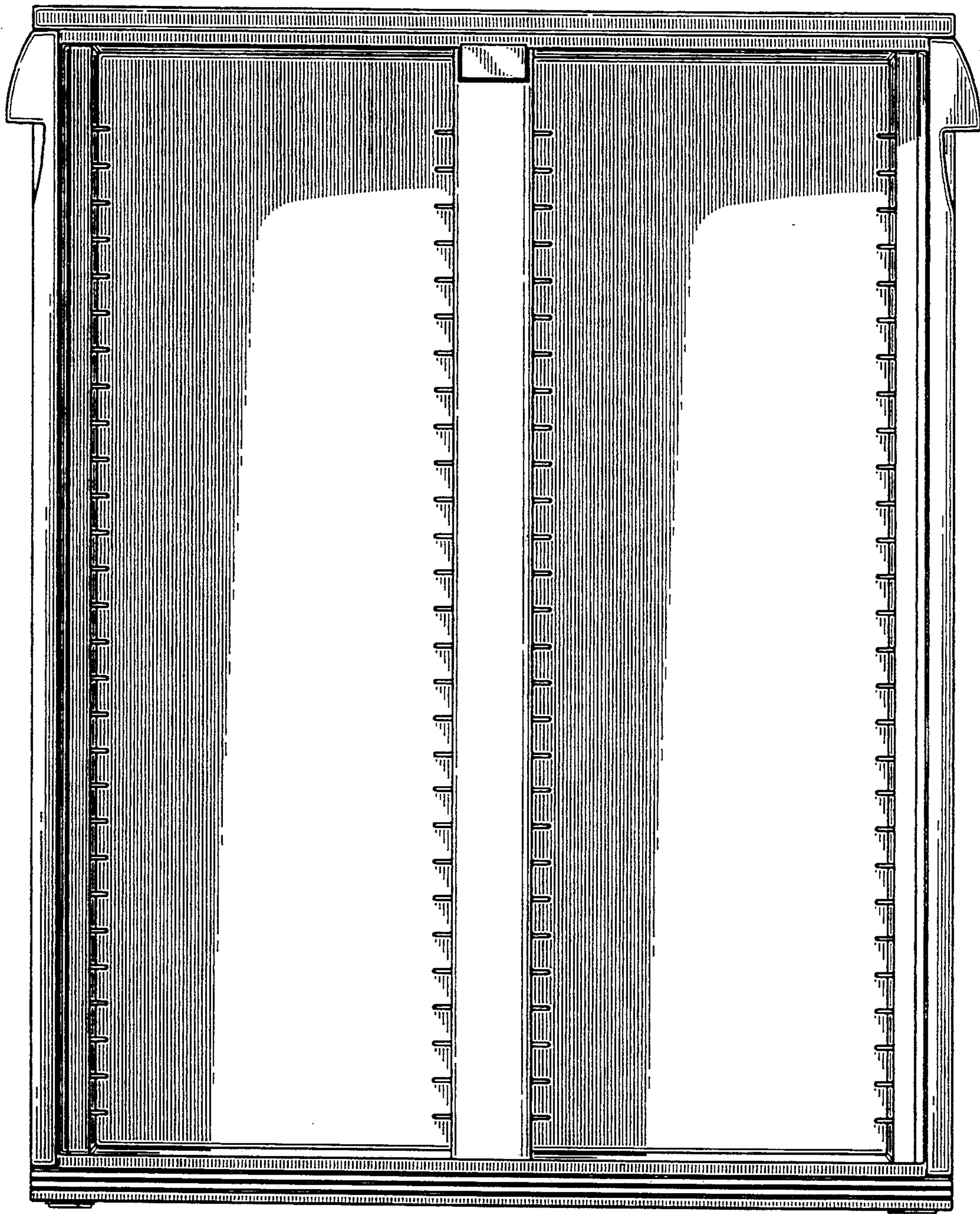

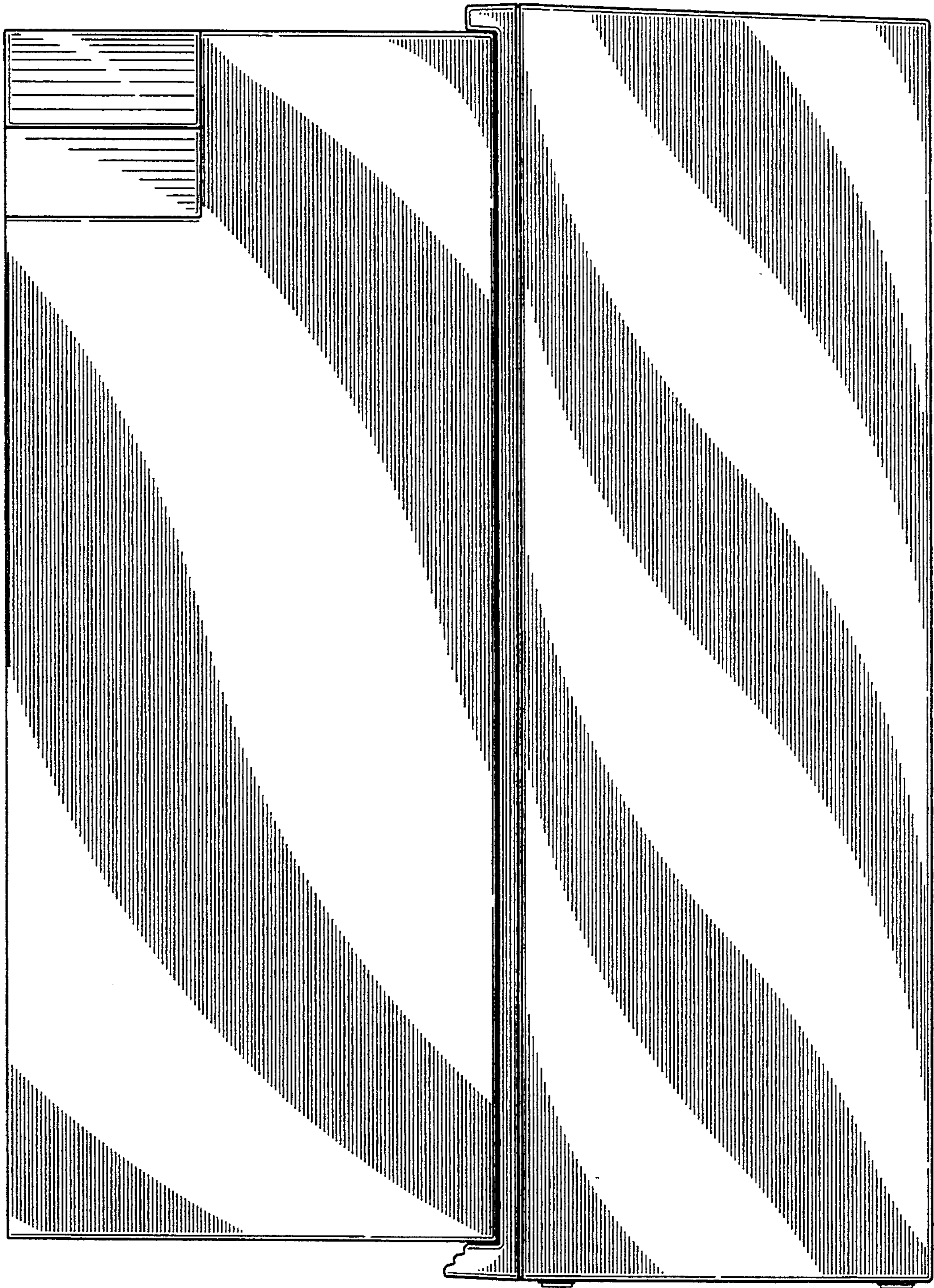
