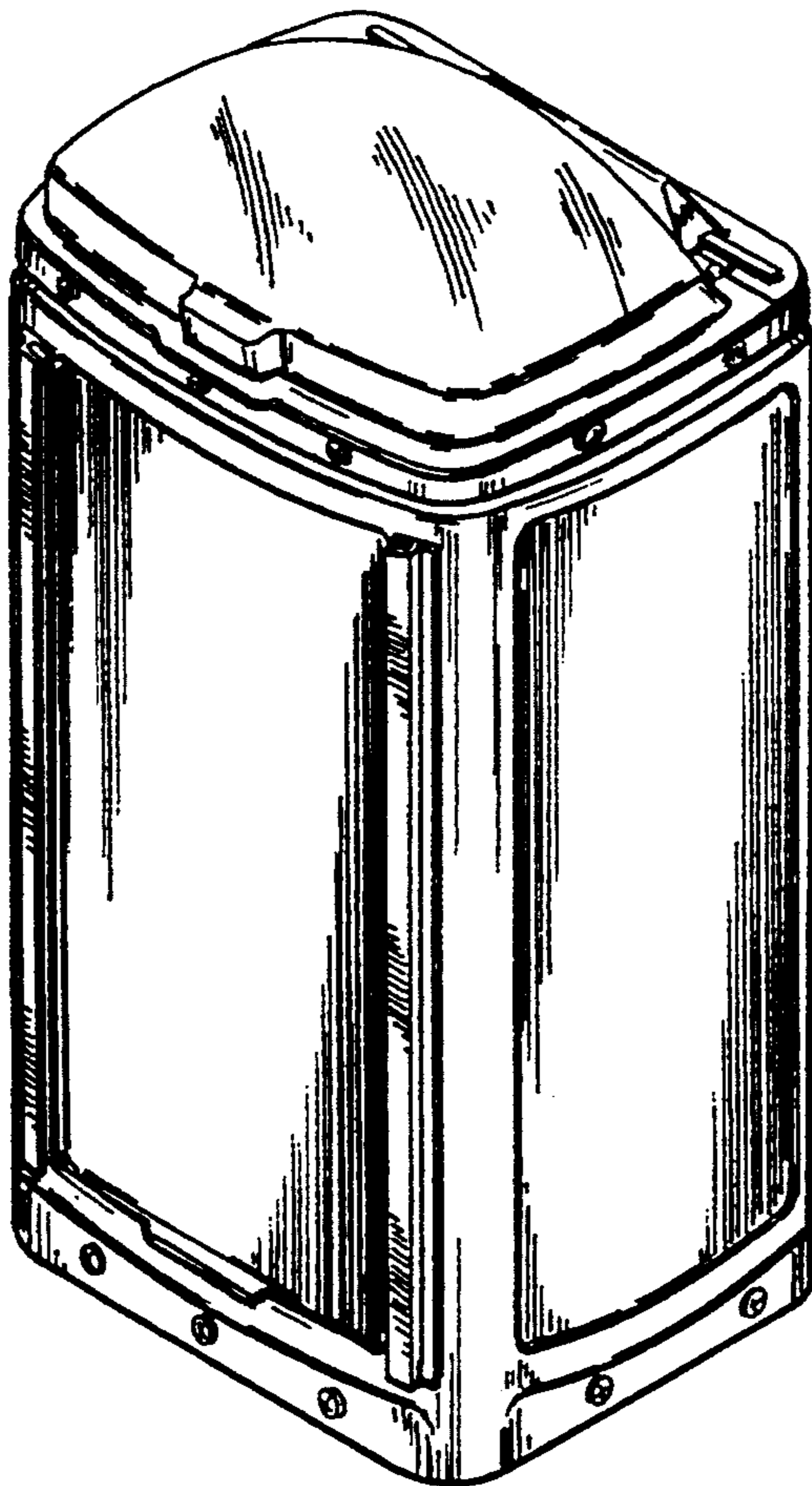
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a merchandising cooler showing my new design;

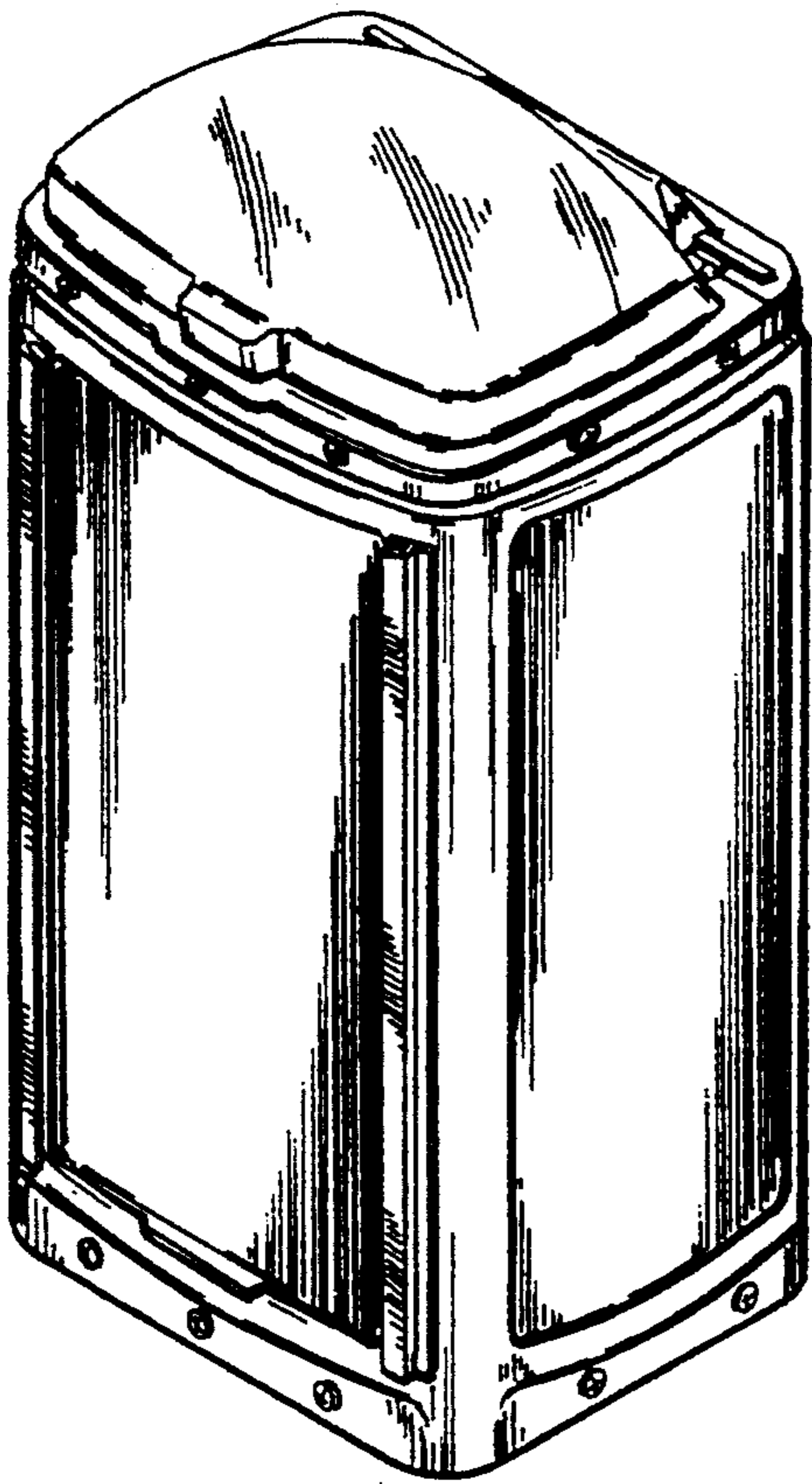

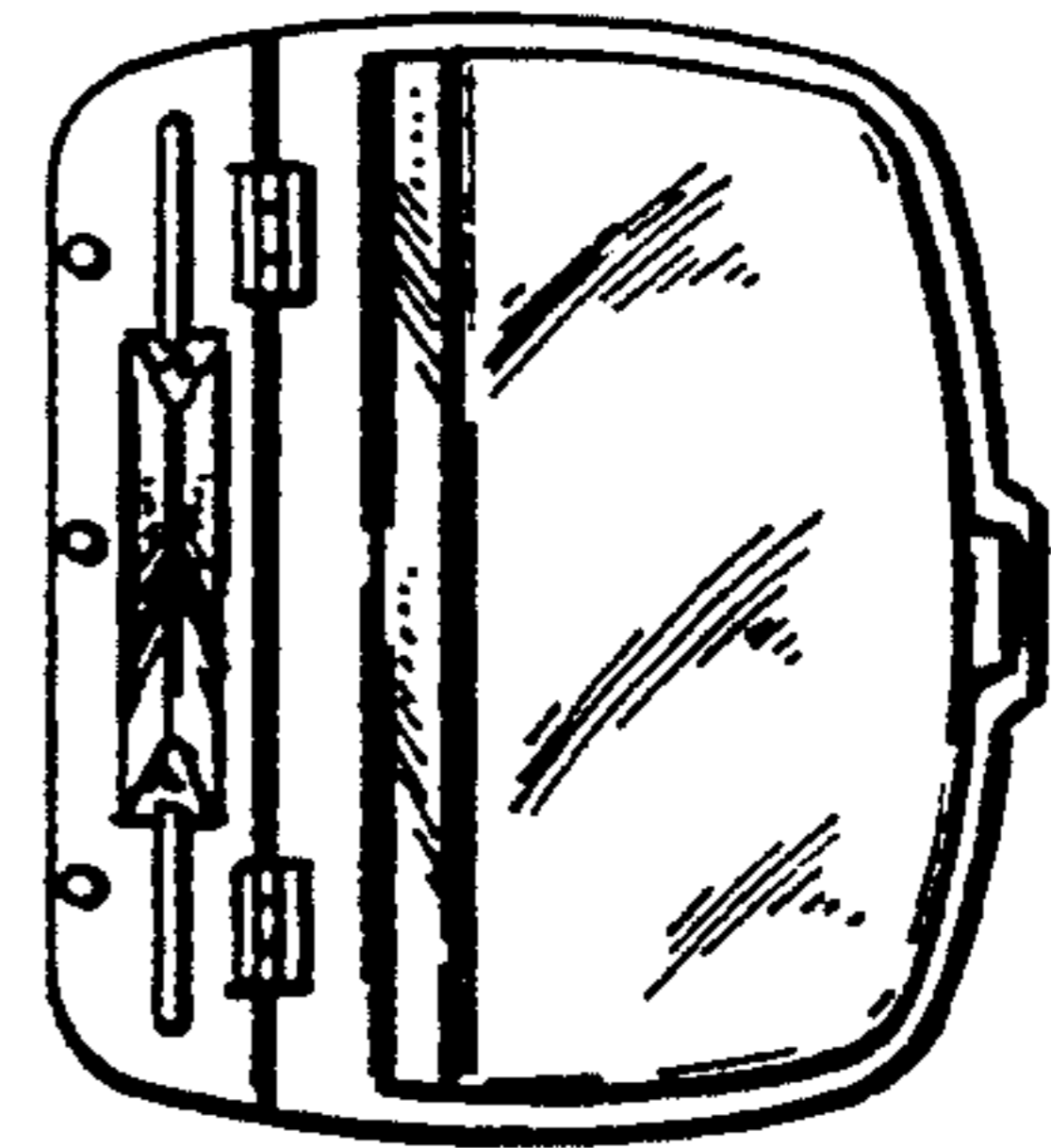

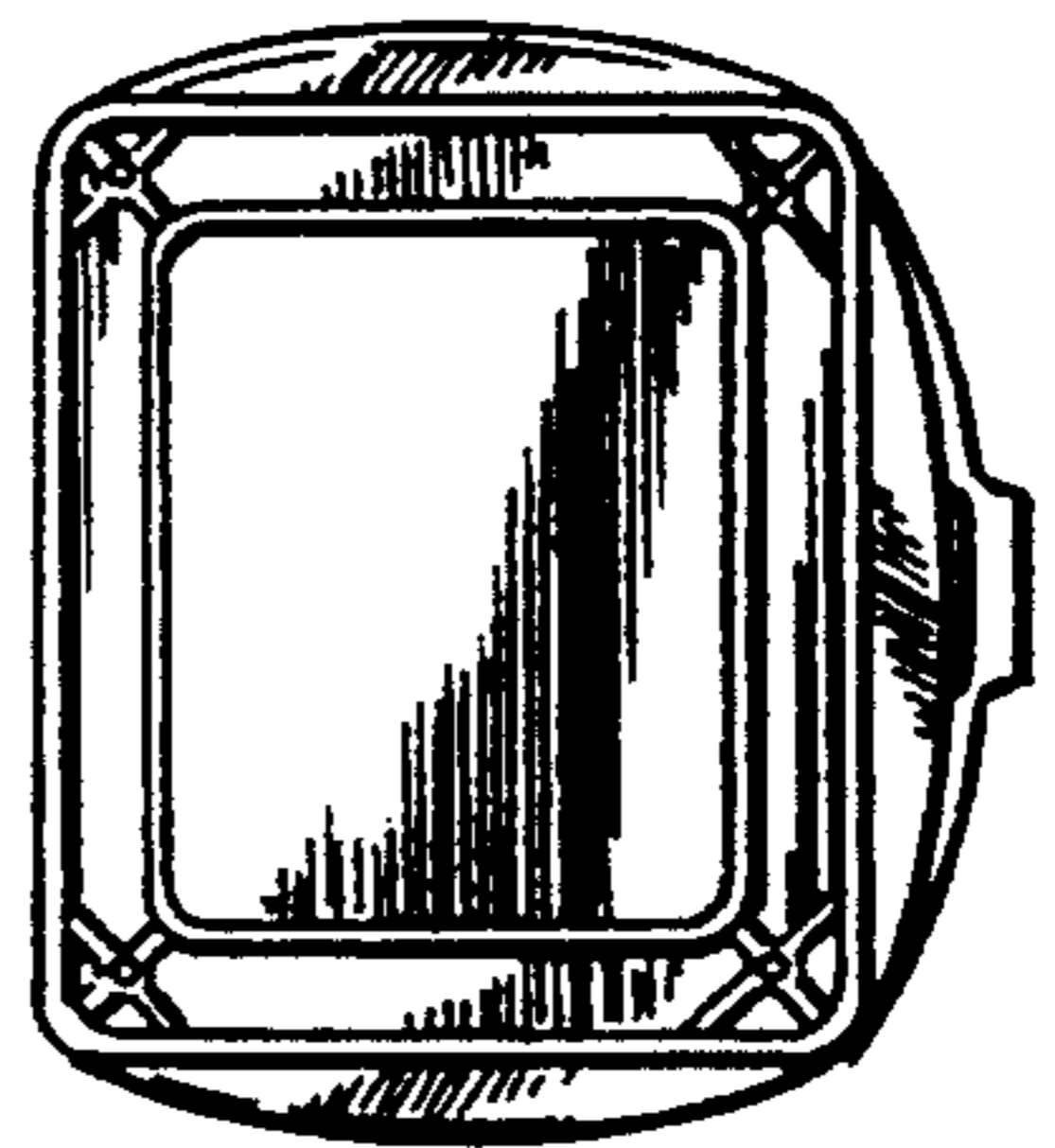

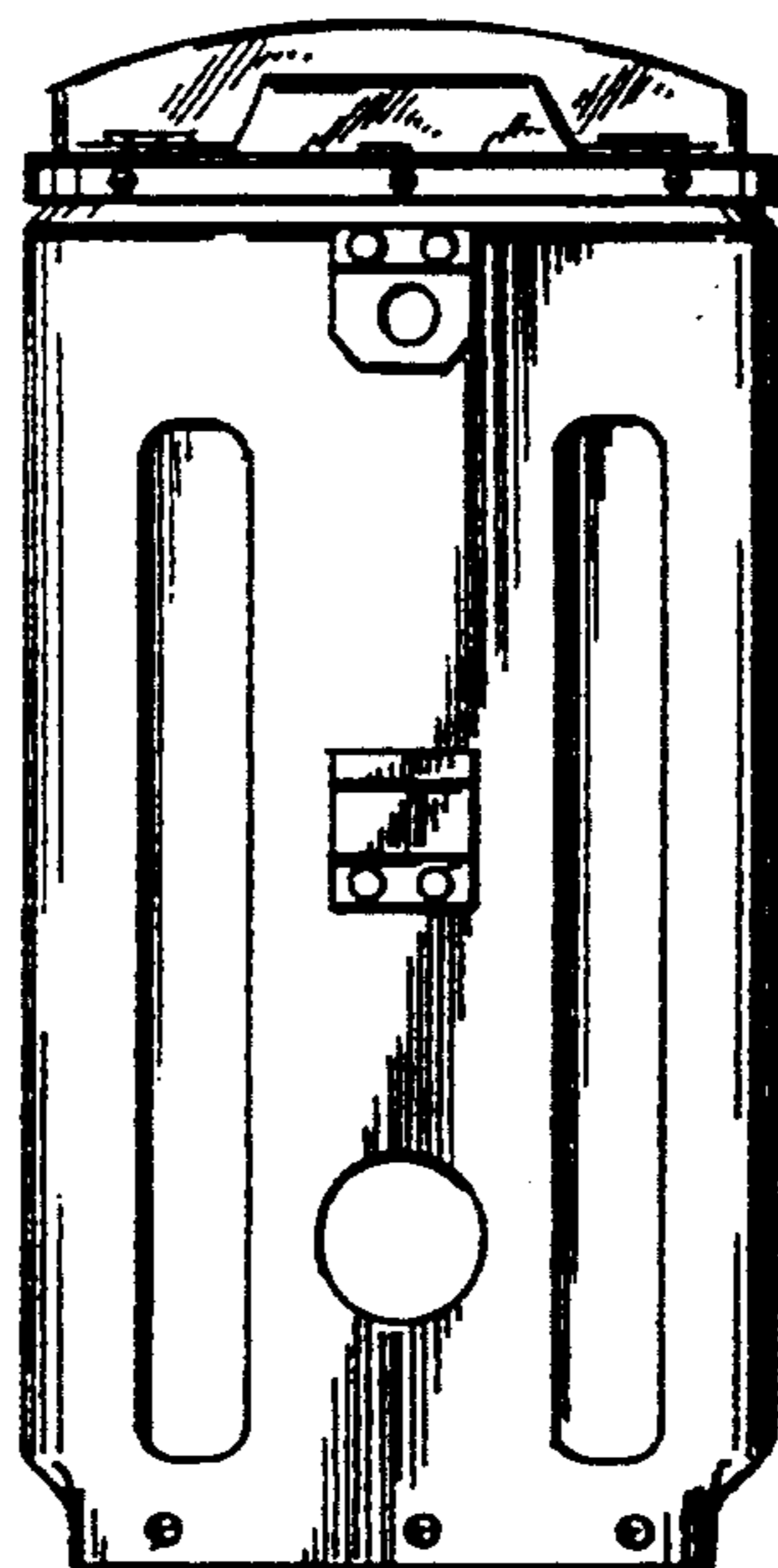
