## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for the low profile housing for an electrical plug, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a low profile housing for an electrical plug;  
 FIG. 2 is a rear view of the low profile housing of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 3 is a front view of the low profile housing of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 4 is a top view of the low profile housing of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 5 is a left side view of the low profile housing of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the low profile housing of FIG. 1; and,  
 FIG. 7 is a right side view of the low profile housing of FIG. 1.

The broken line showing of the prongs in FIGS. 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7 of the electrical cable in FIGS. 1, 2 and 7 is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure only and forms no part of the claimed design.
