[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a personal computer with printer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right front and top perspective view of the personal computer with printer in the opened position; FIG. 2 is a right front and top perspective view of the personal computer with printer in the closed position; FIG. 3 is a right front and top perspective view of the personal computer with printer in the opened position, with the keyboard raised to expose the paper entry slot, and with the front paper guide extended;

FIG. 4 is a right front and top perspective view of the personal computer with printer in the opened position with the front paper guide extended;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the personal computer with printer in the opened position;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of the personal computer with printer in the closed position;

FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 15 is a right side elevational view thereof.

FIGS. 5, 7, 11 and 12 are drawn on an enlarged scale.

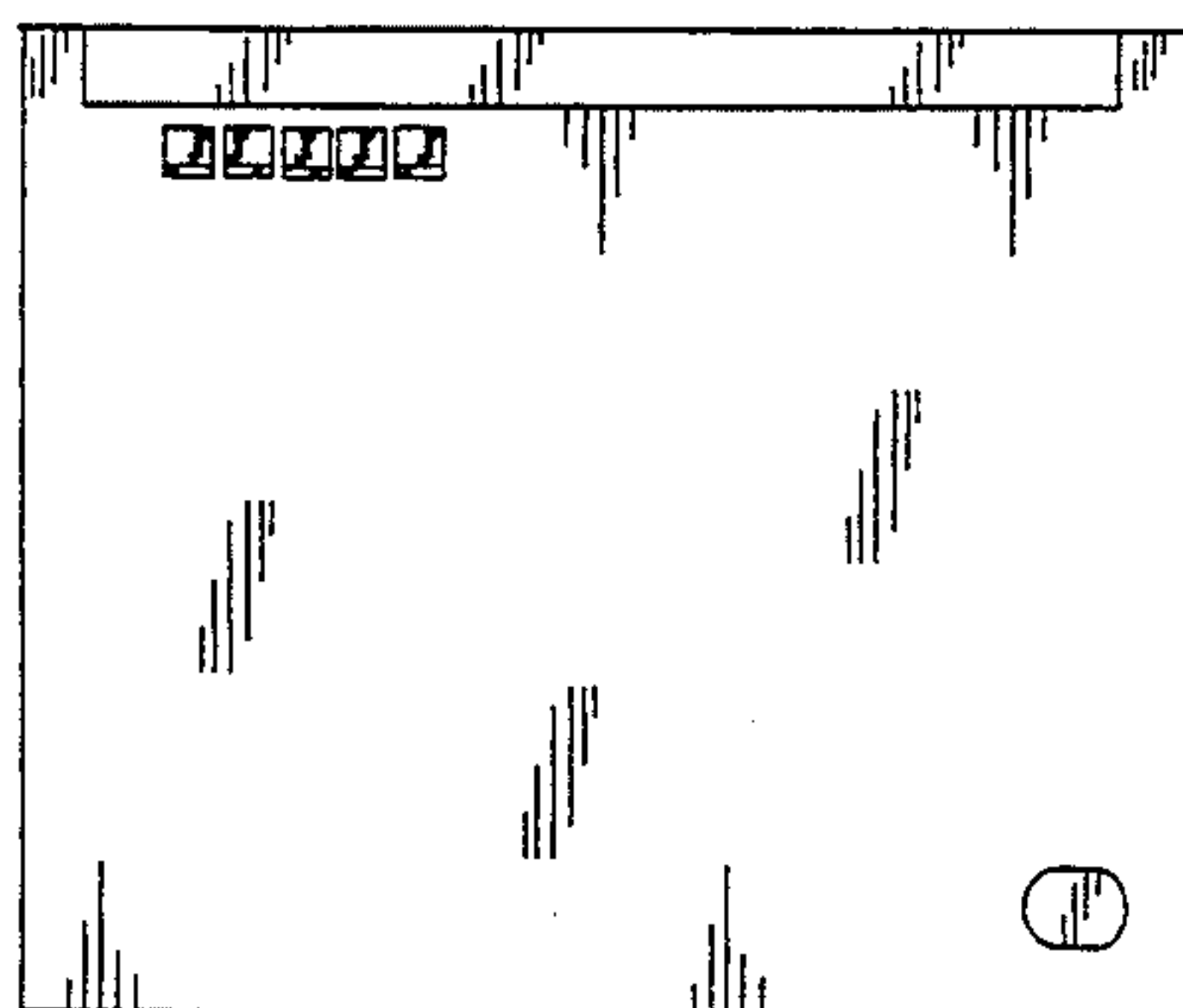
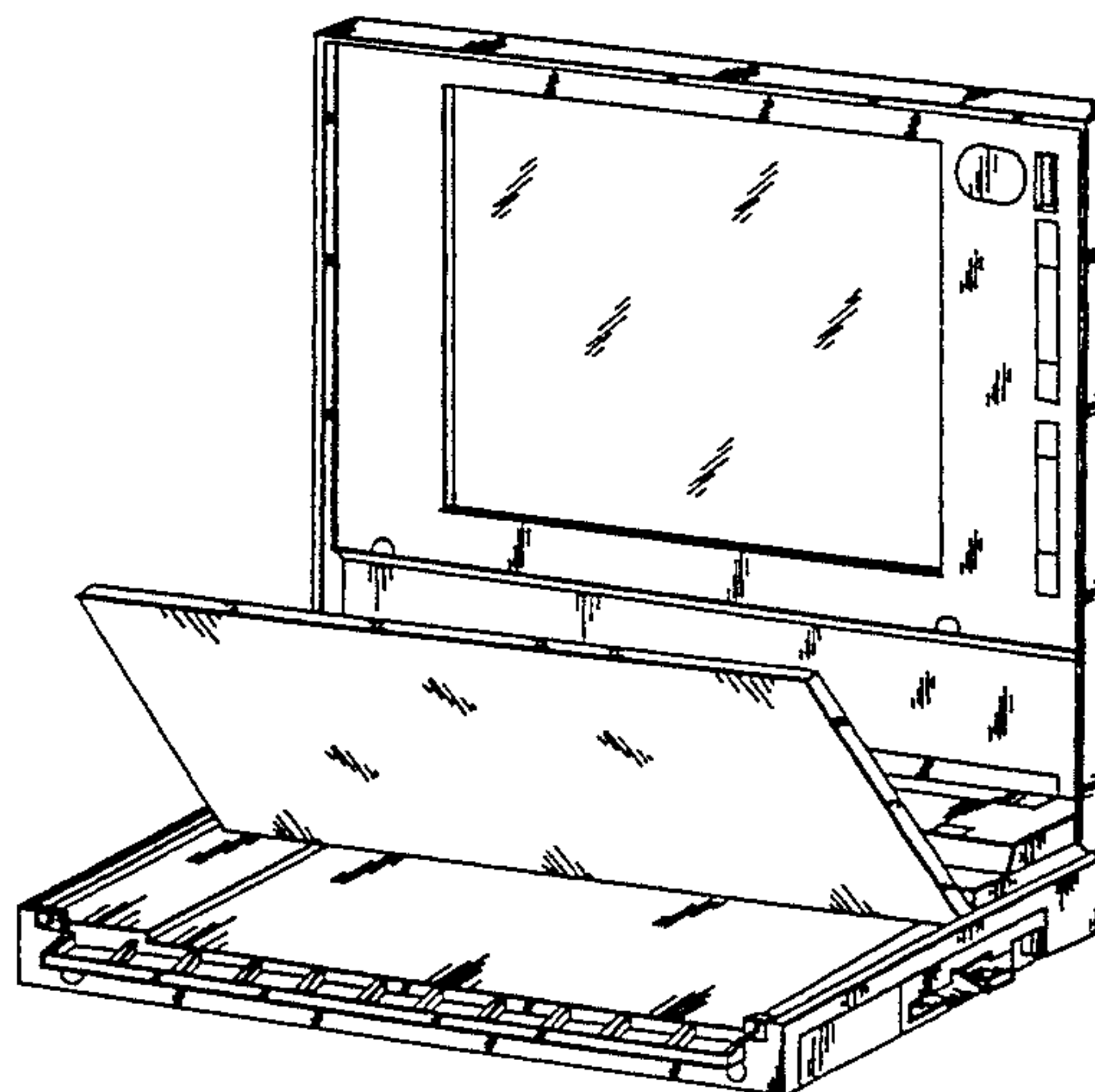
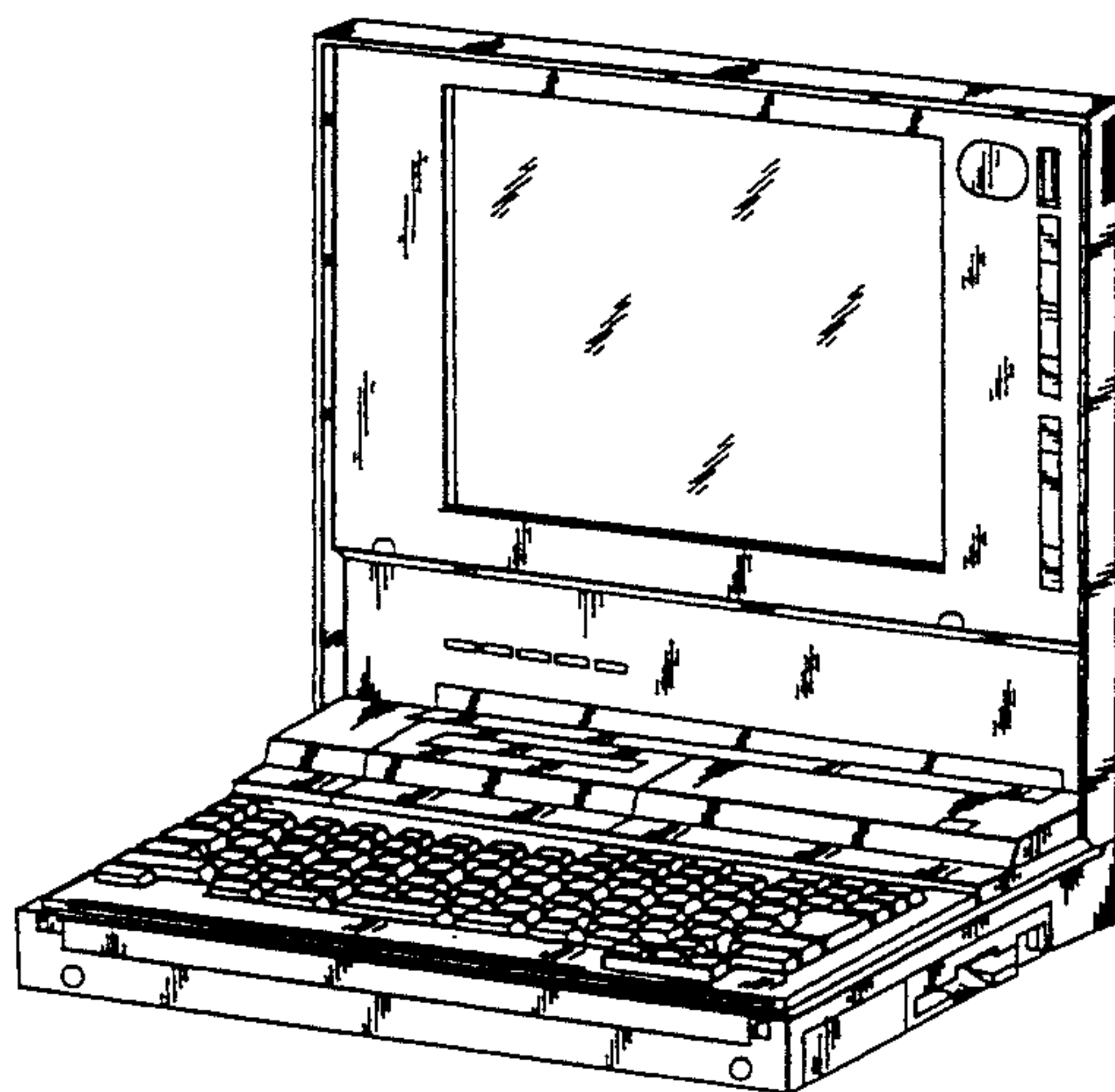

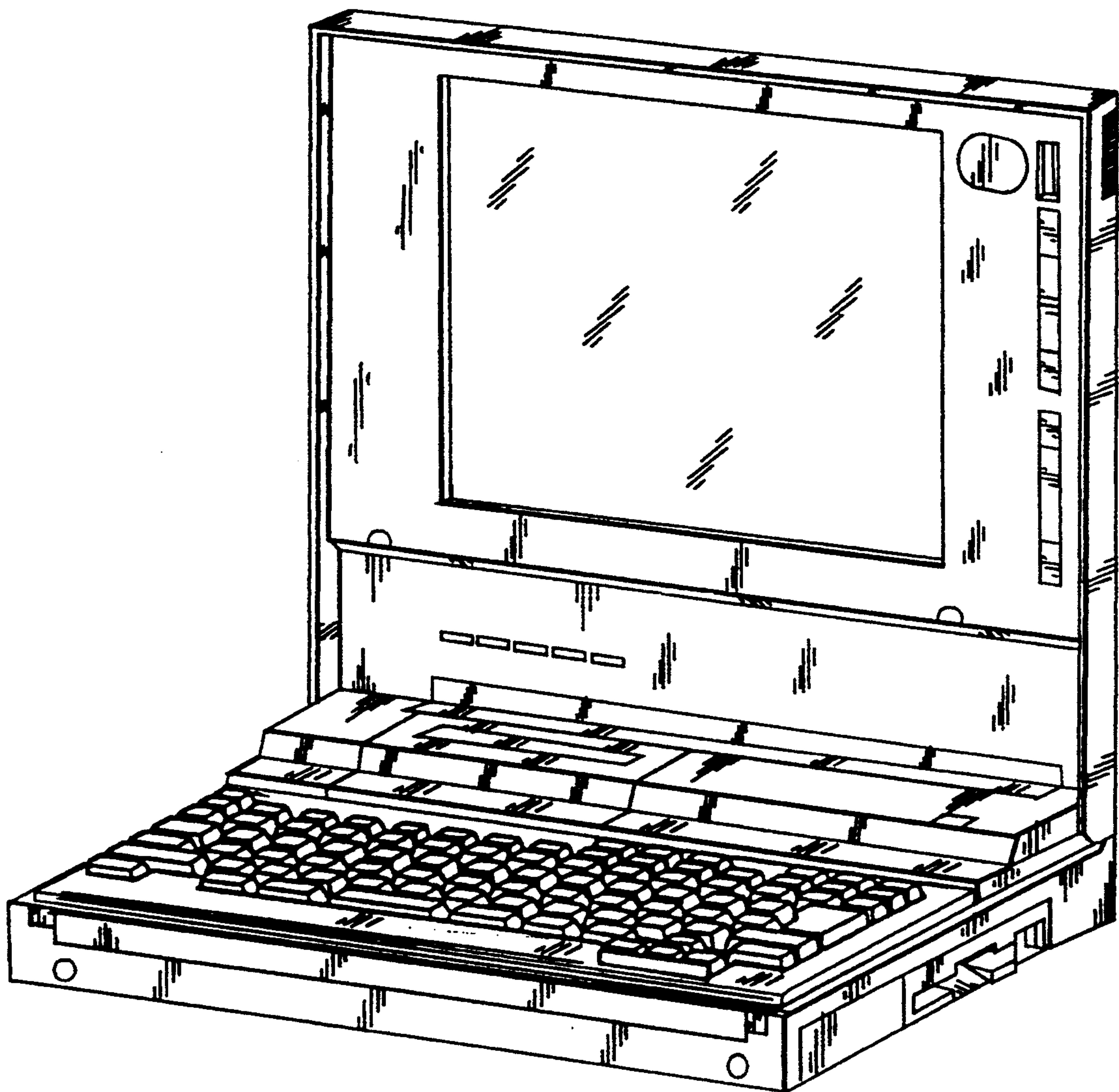

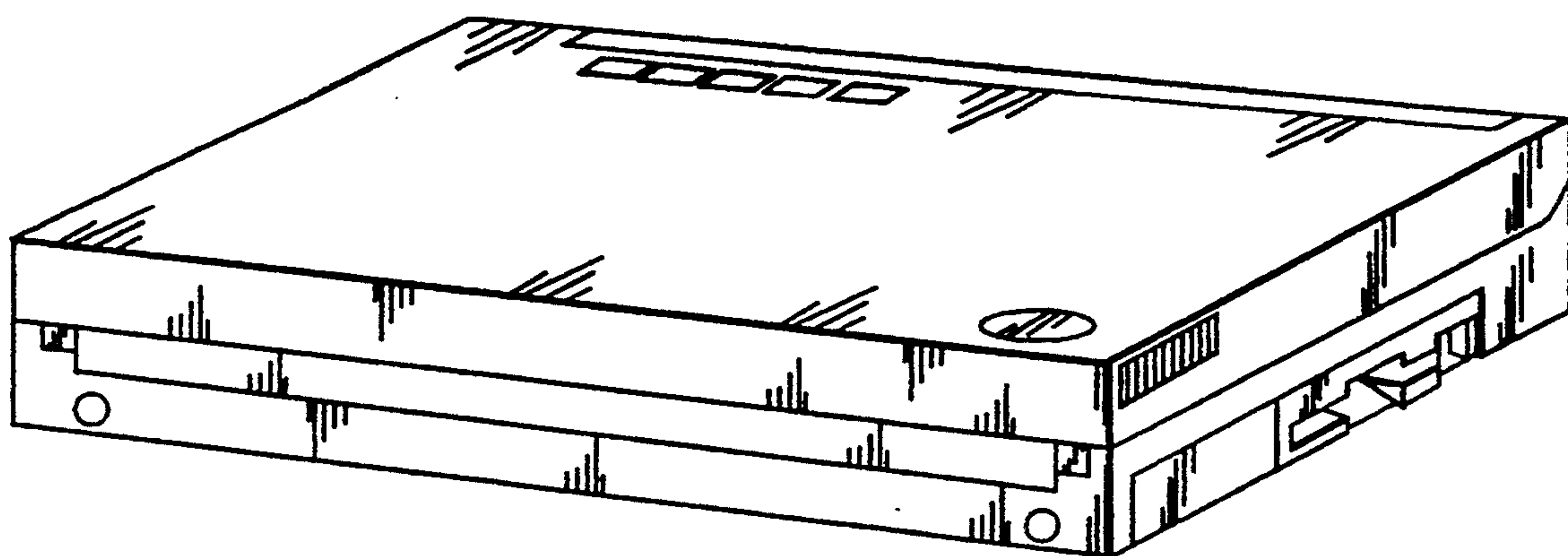

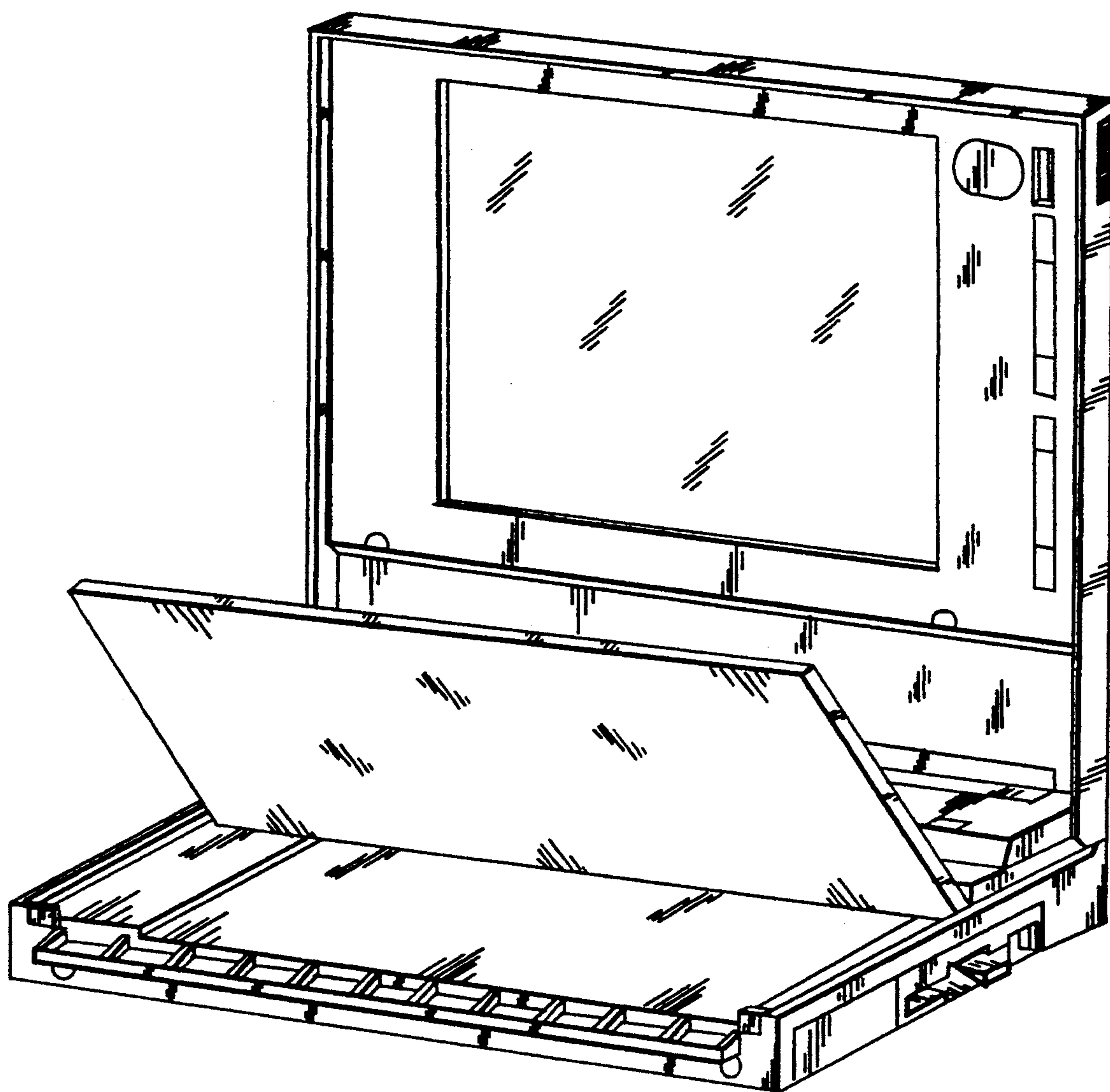

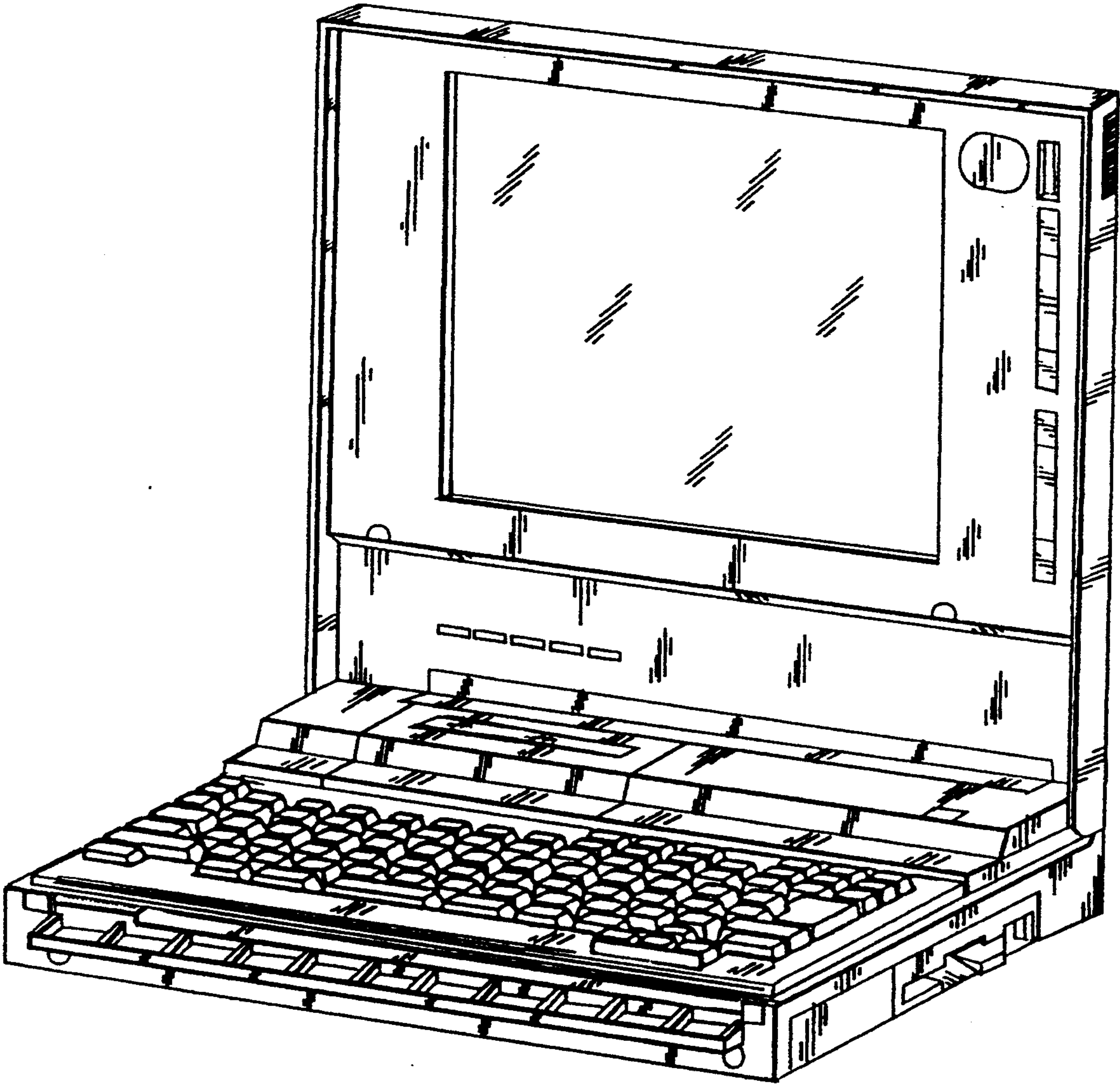

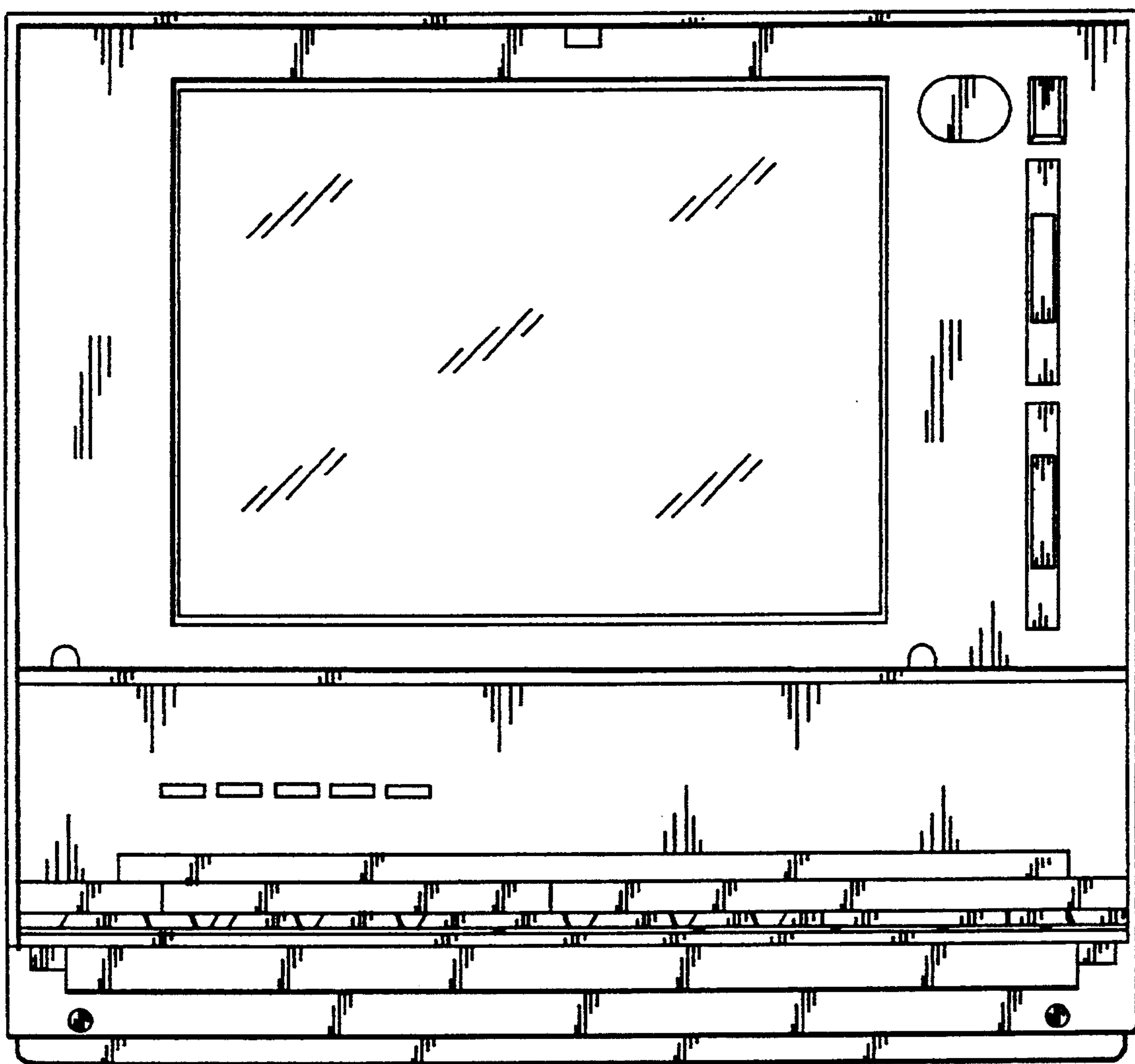

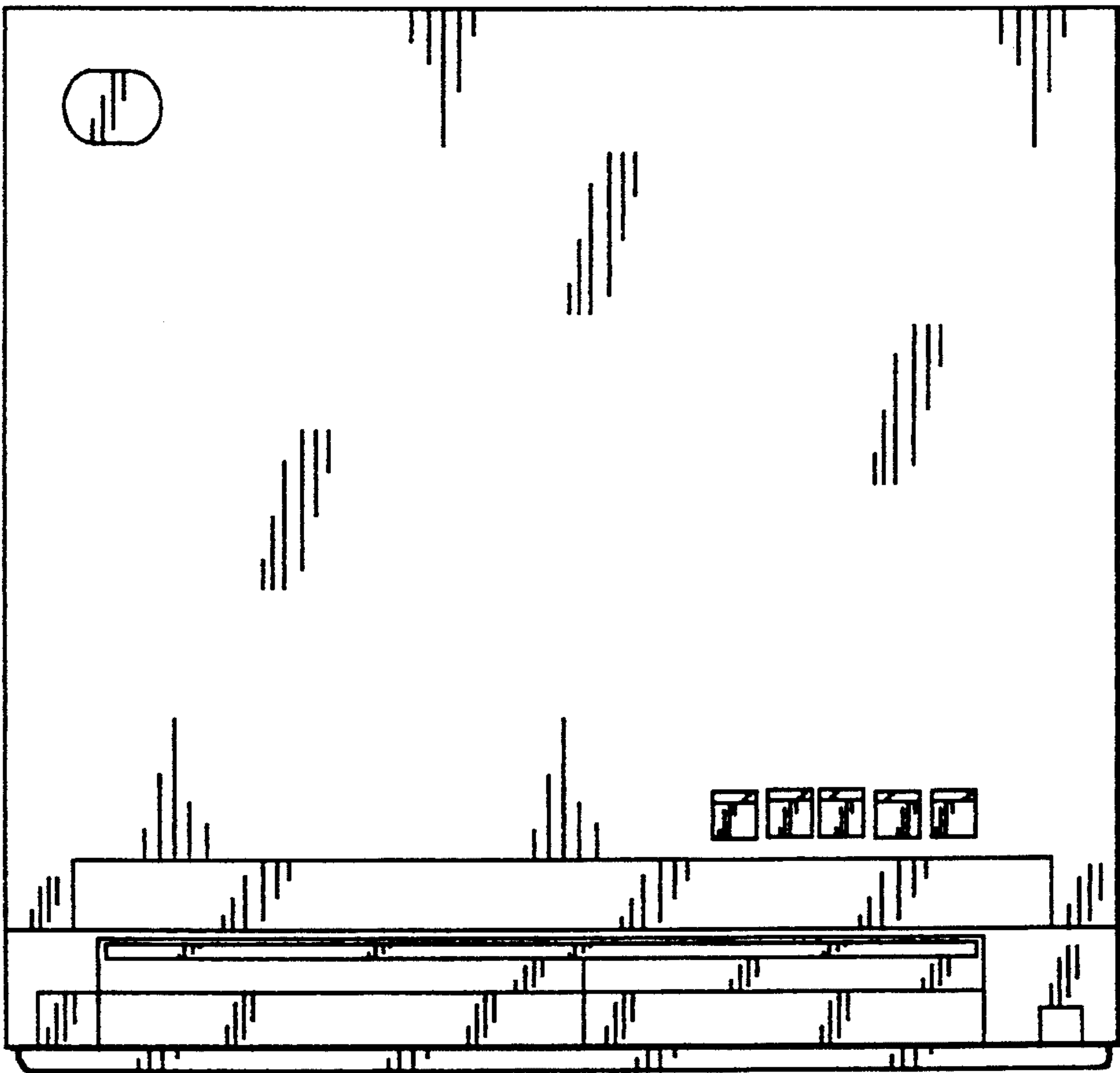

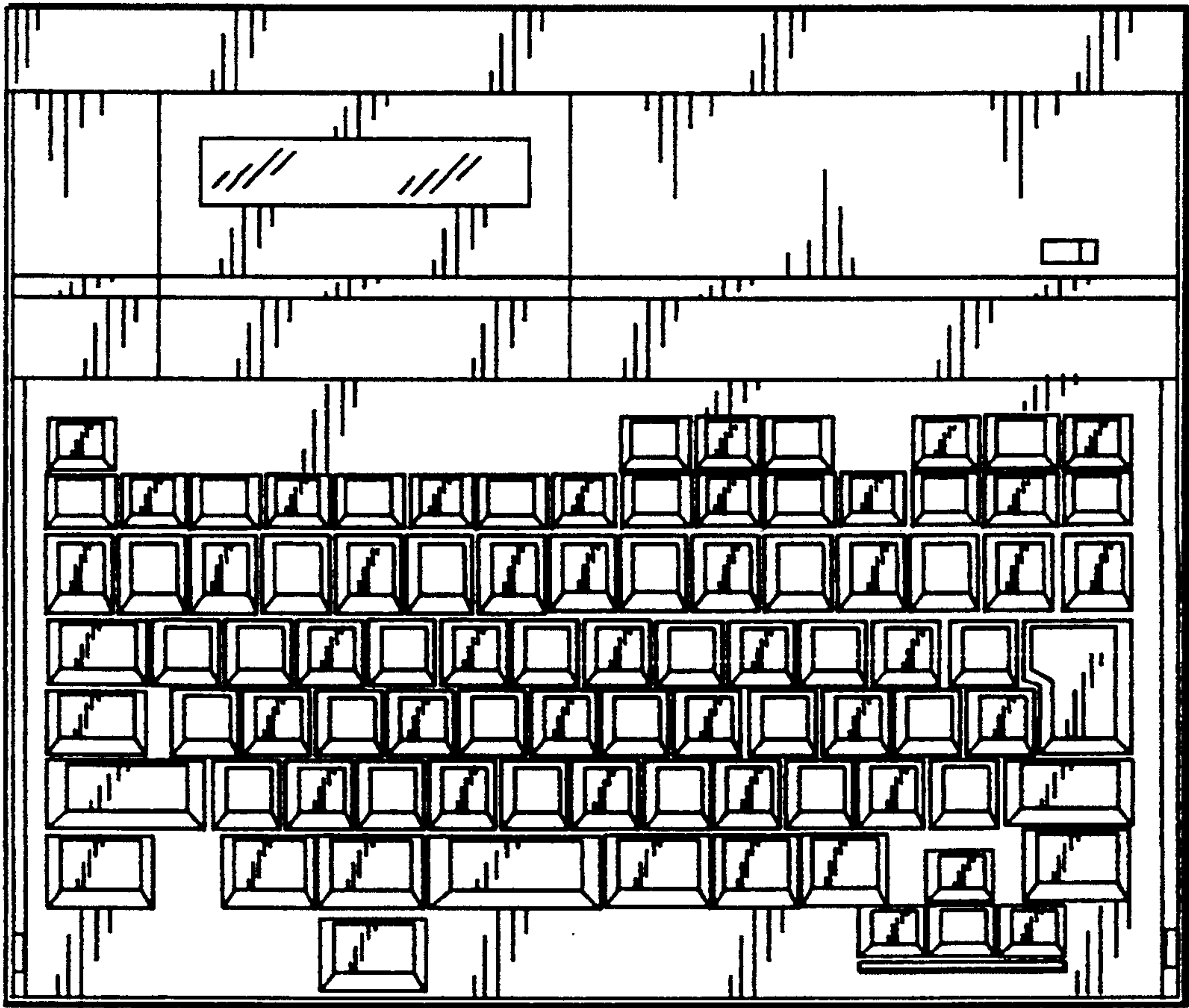

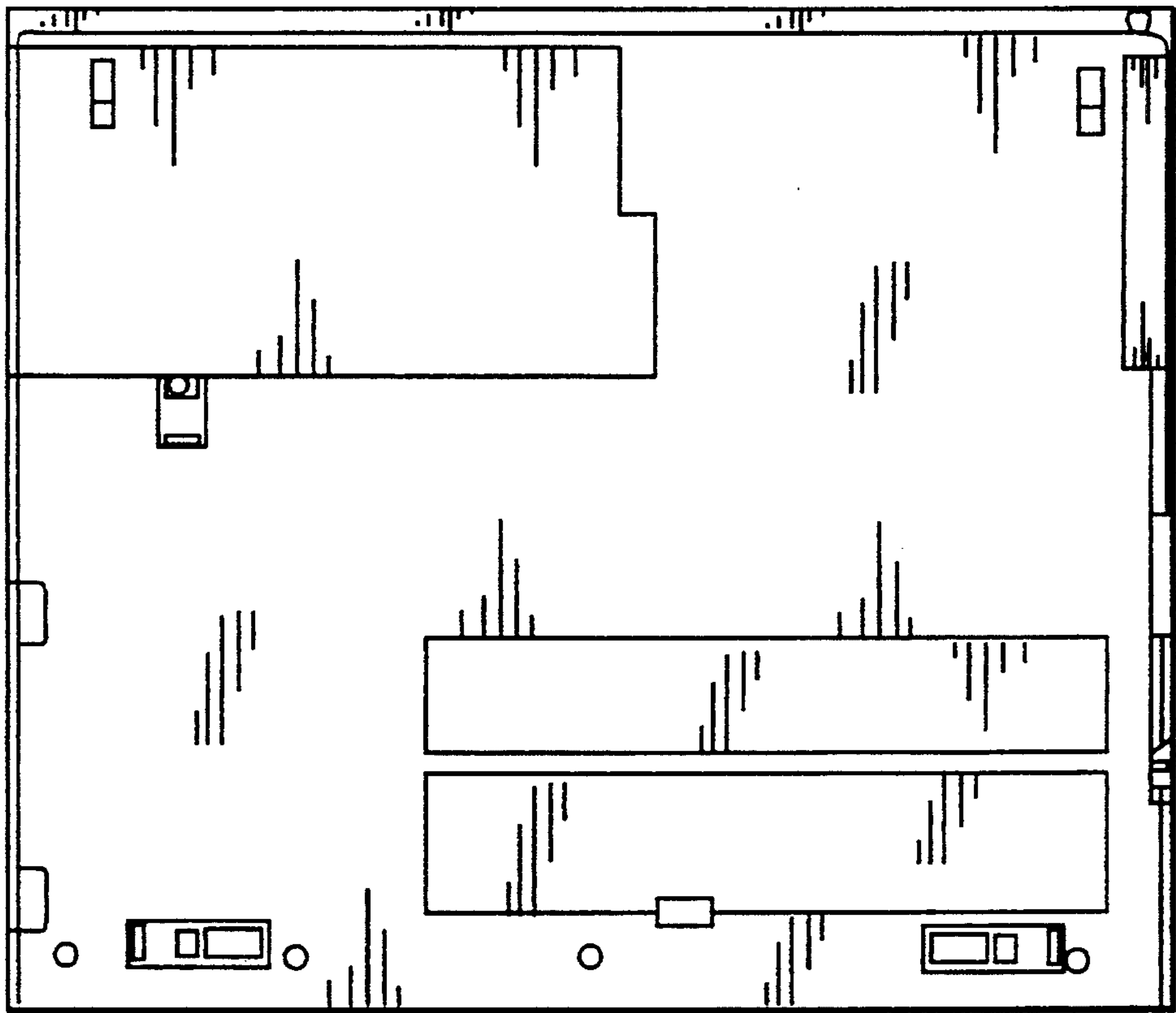

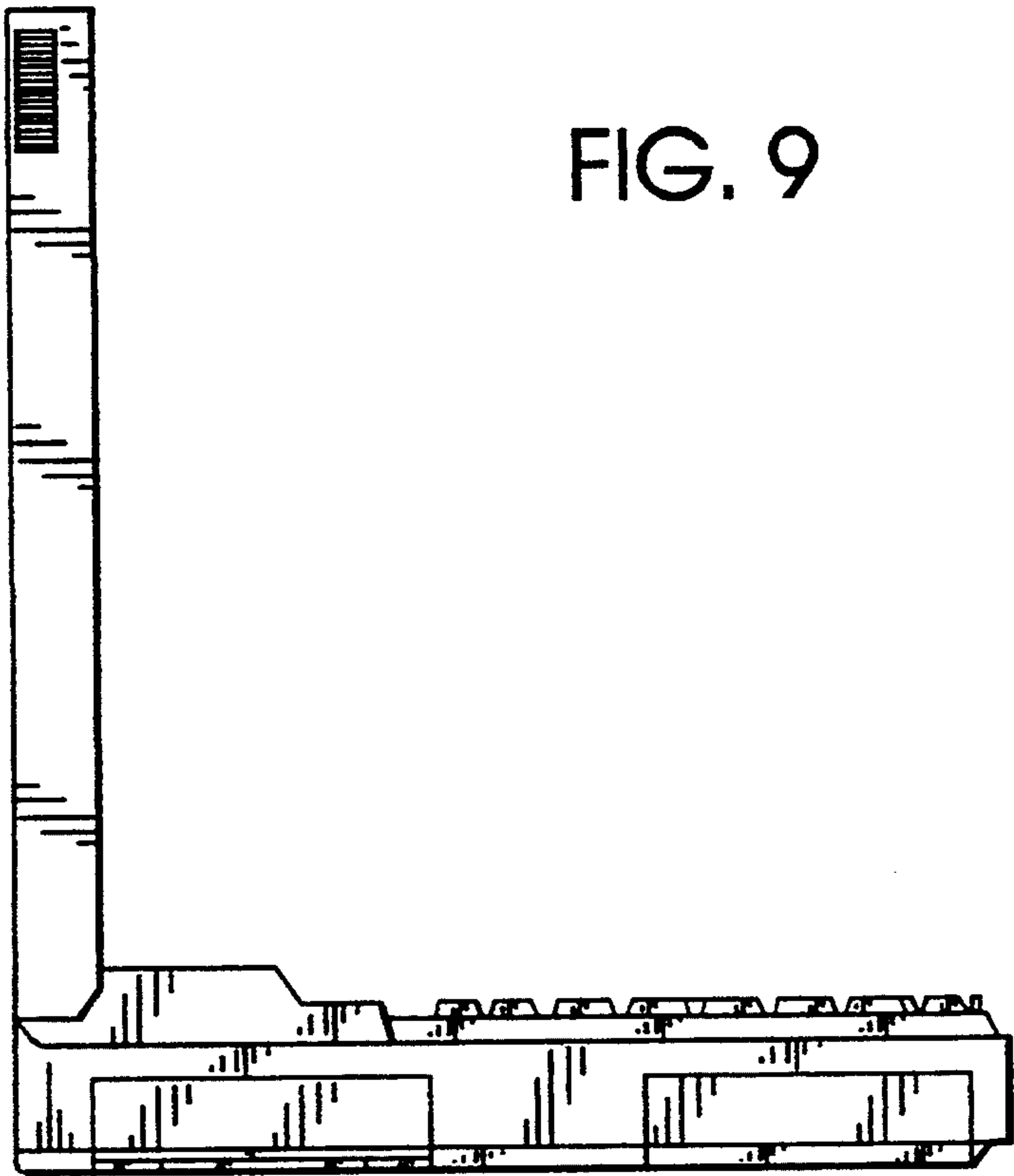

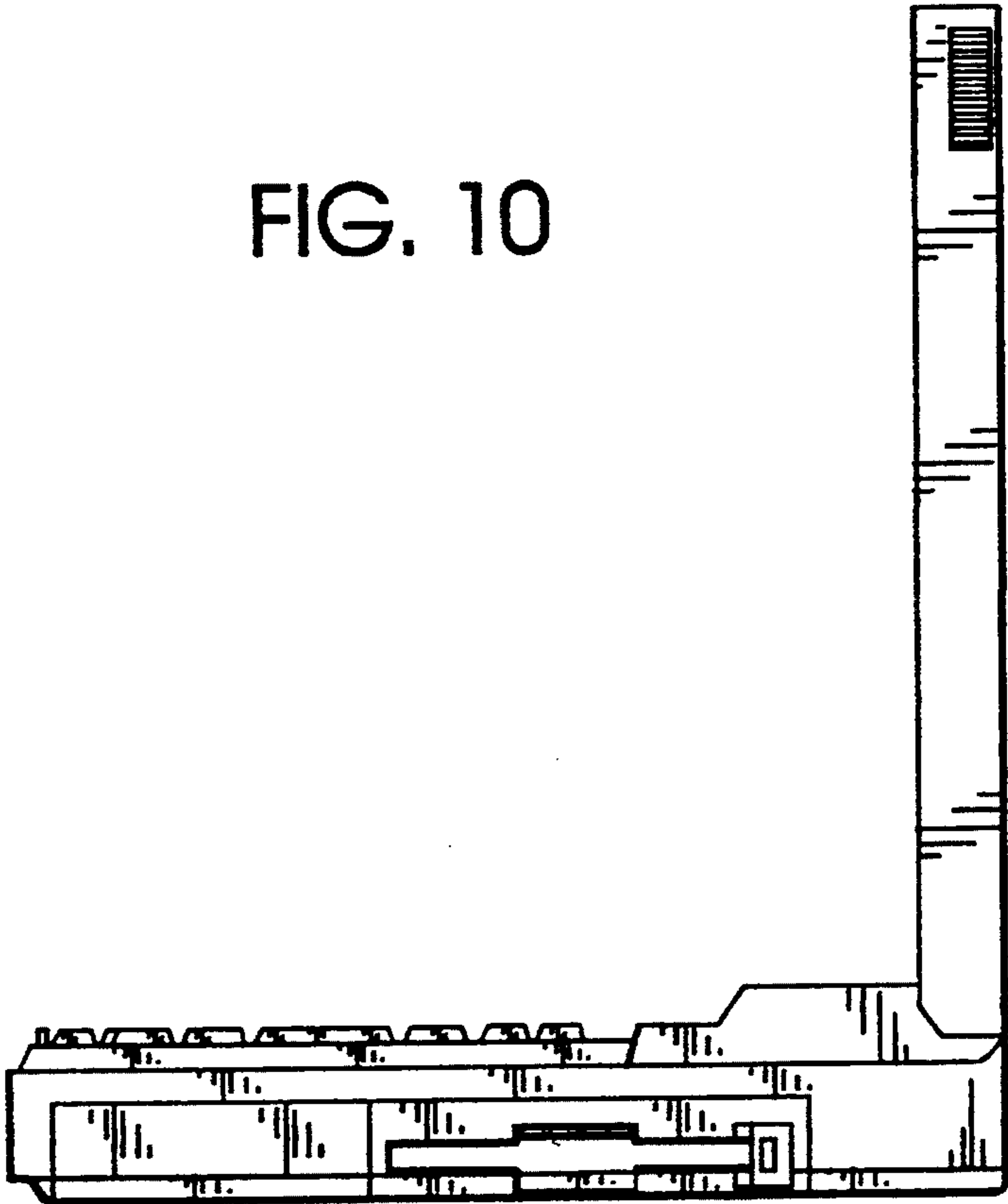

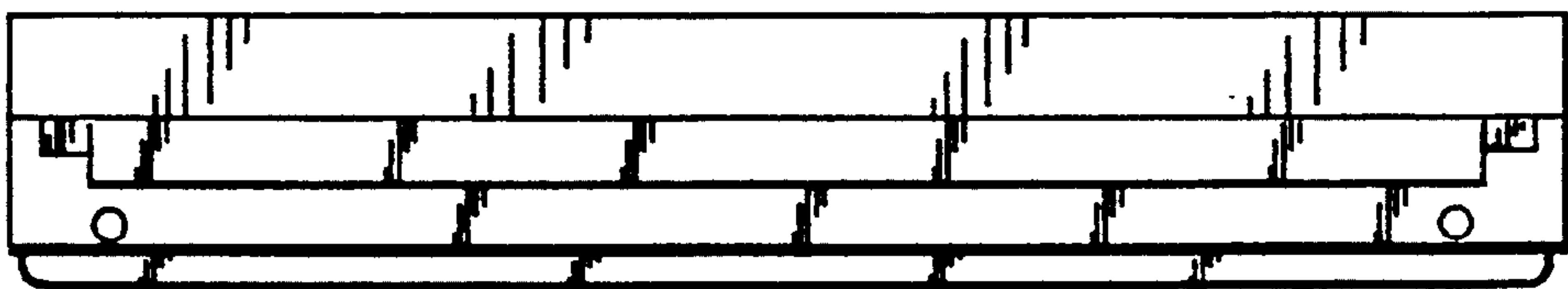

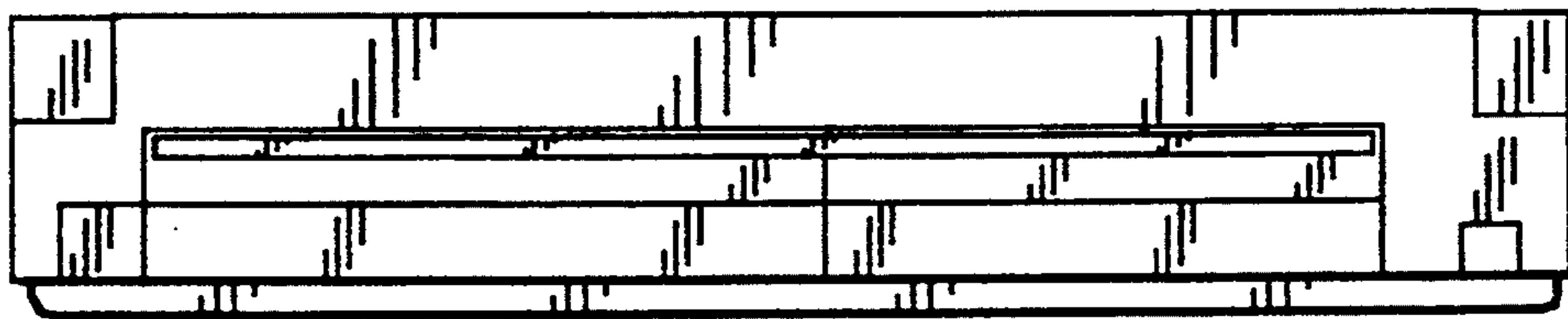

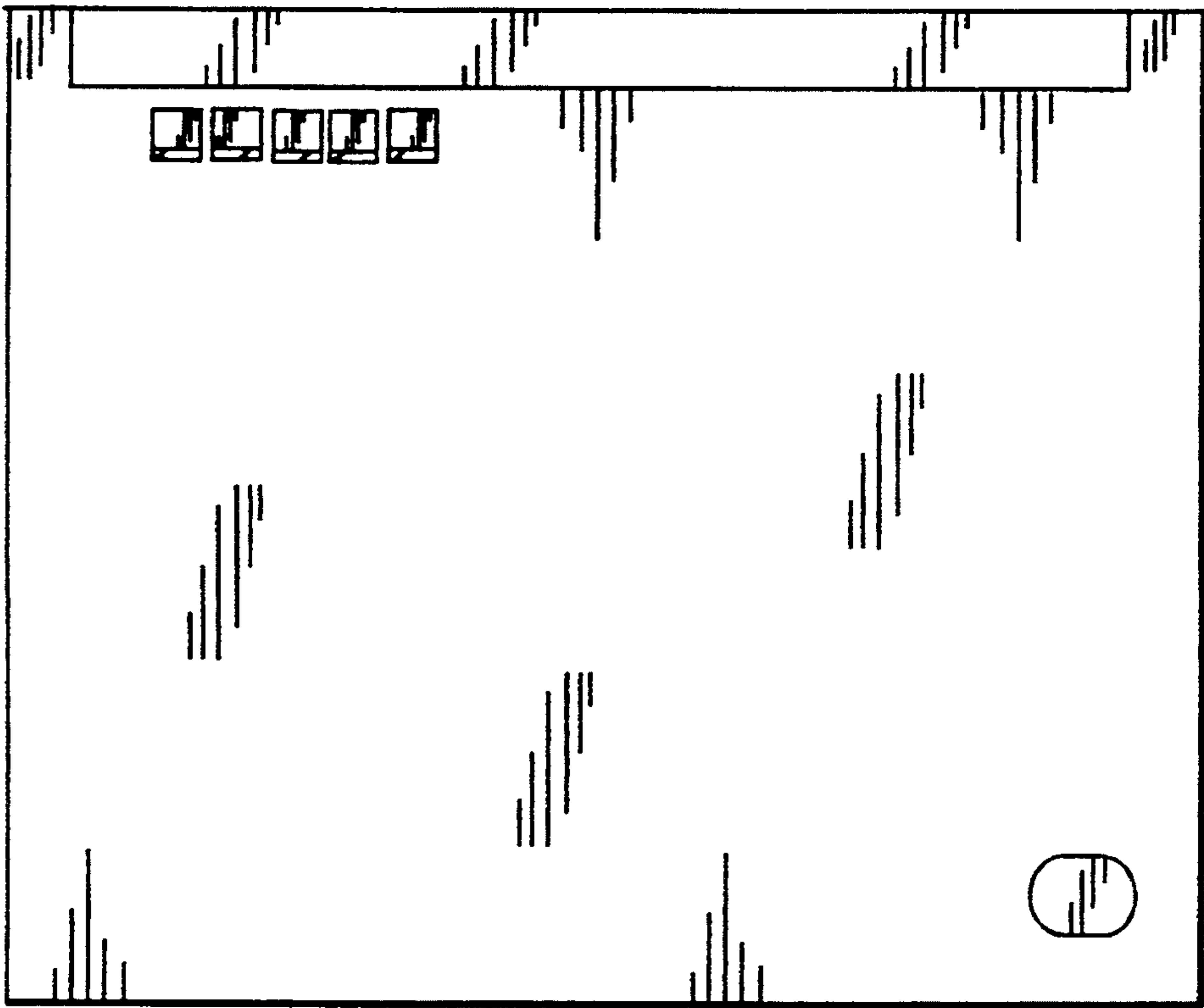

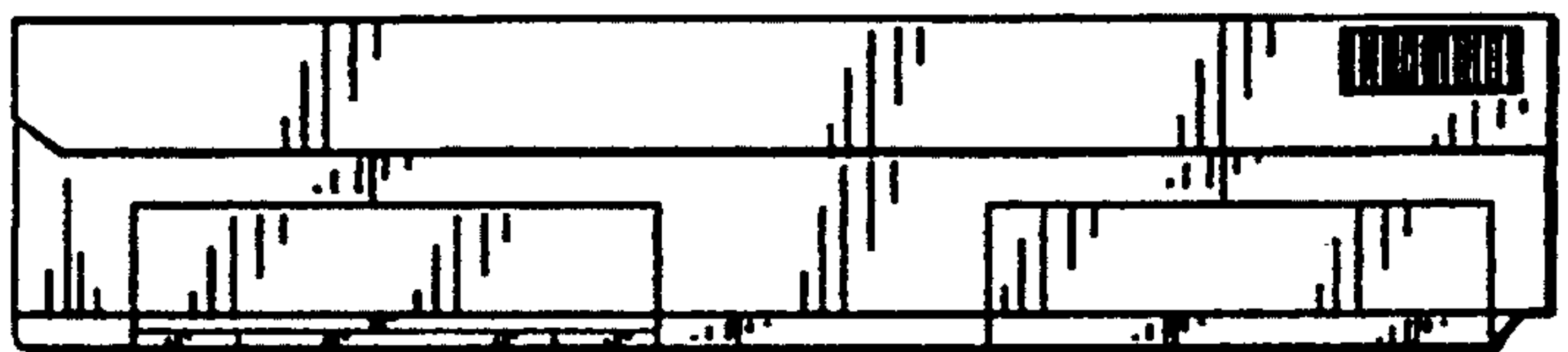
