DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the potholder of the invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the potholder shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the potholder shown in FIG. 1;

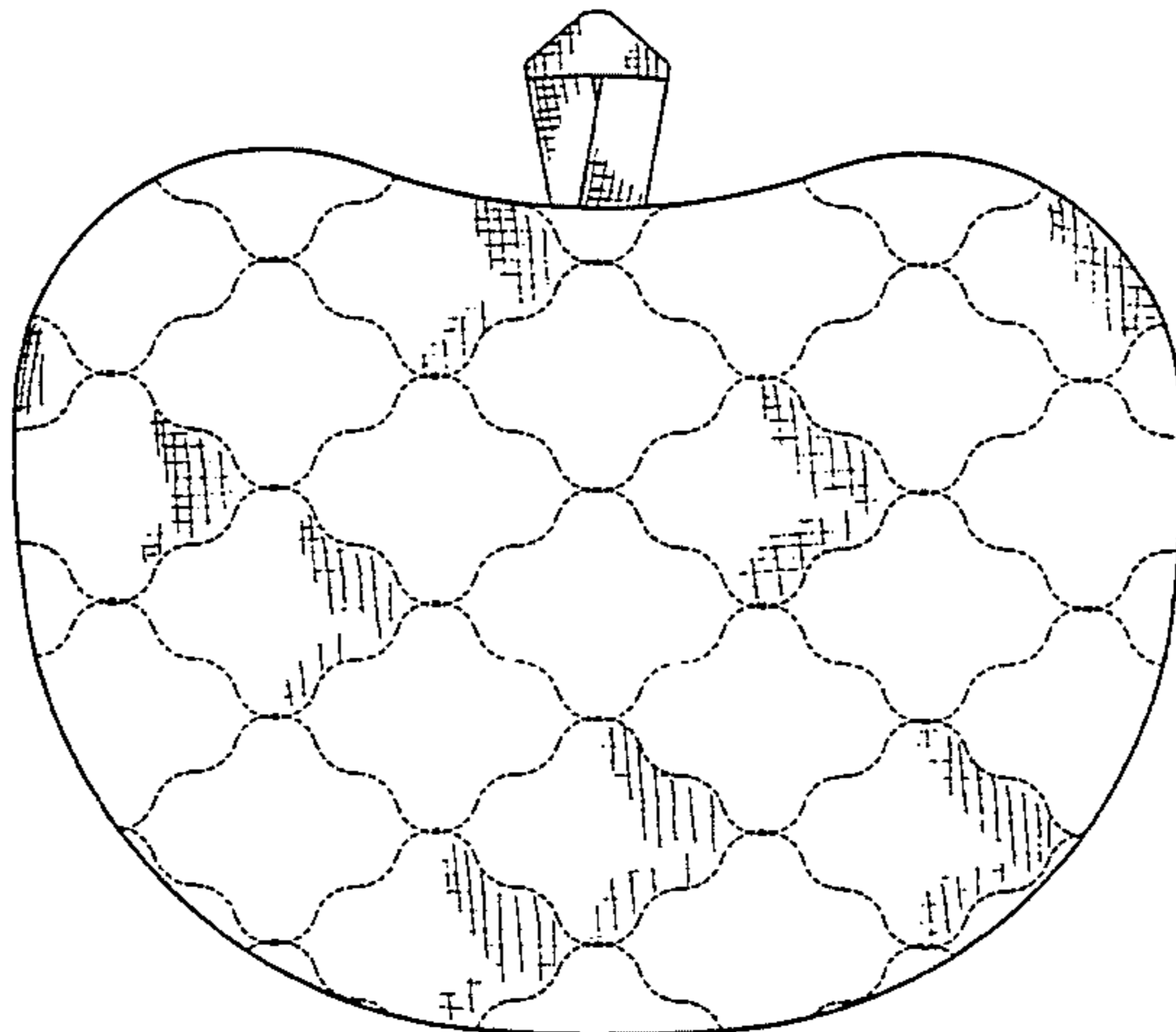
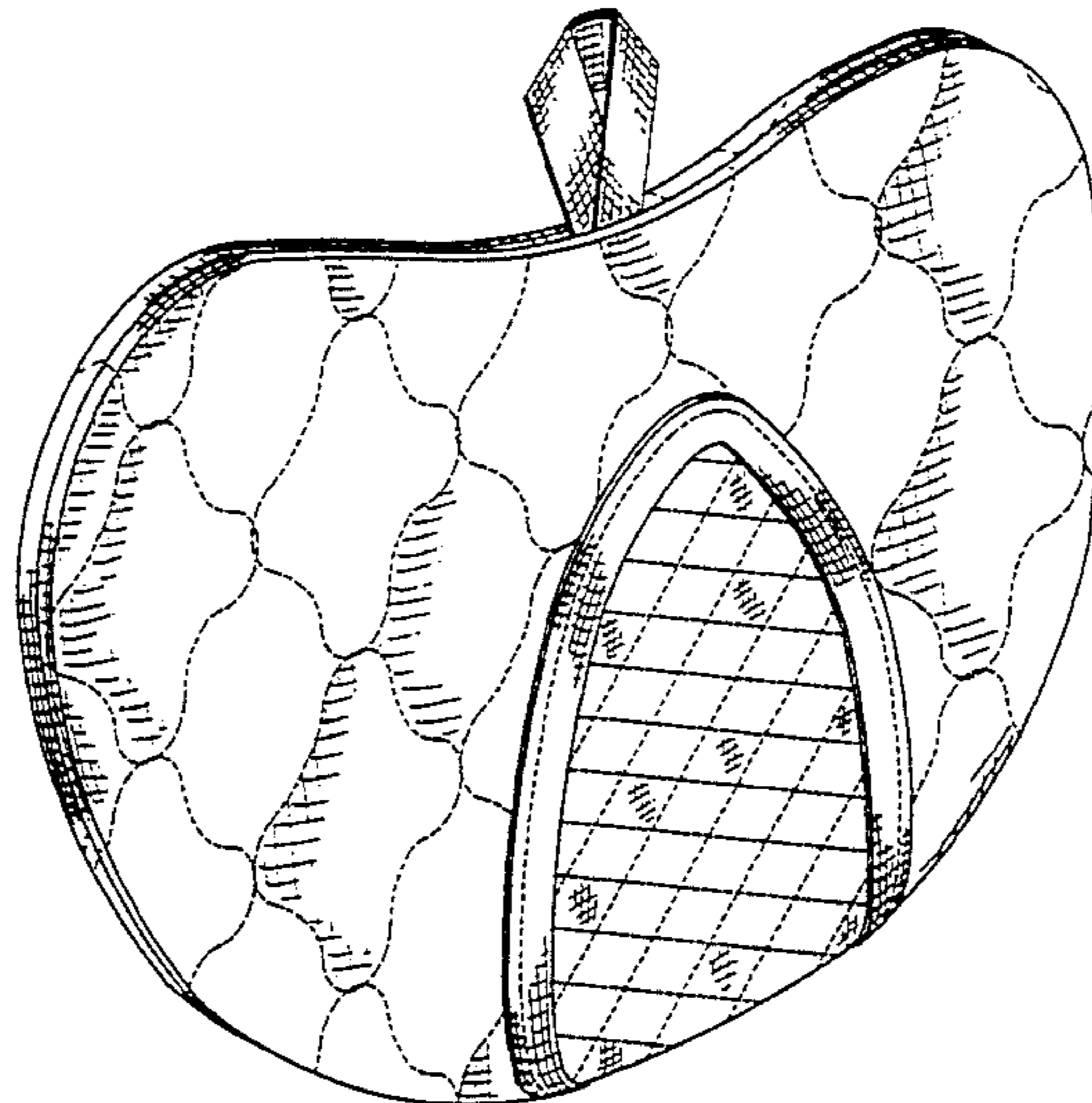
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the potholder shown in FIG. 1;

The cross-hatching represents conventional shading and is understood to extend throughout the areas represented. The broken lines represent conventional stitching.



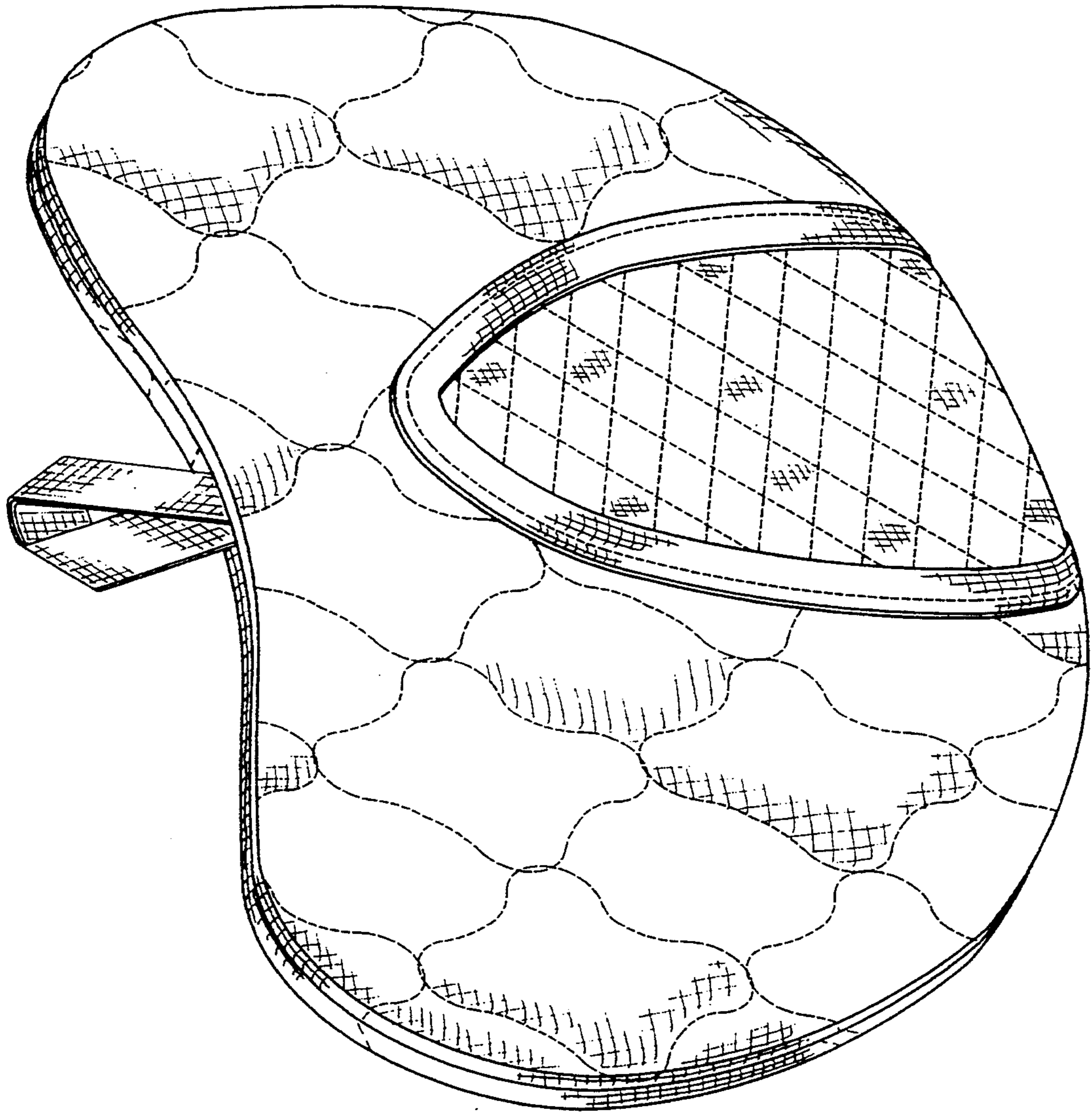

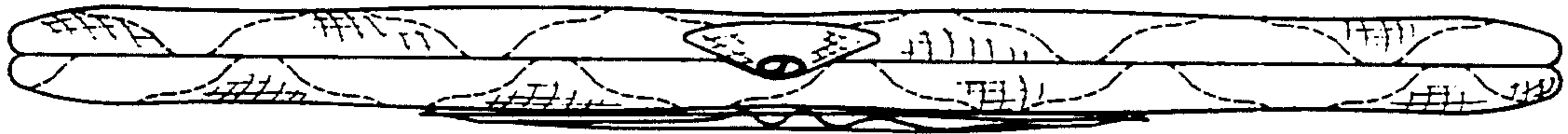

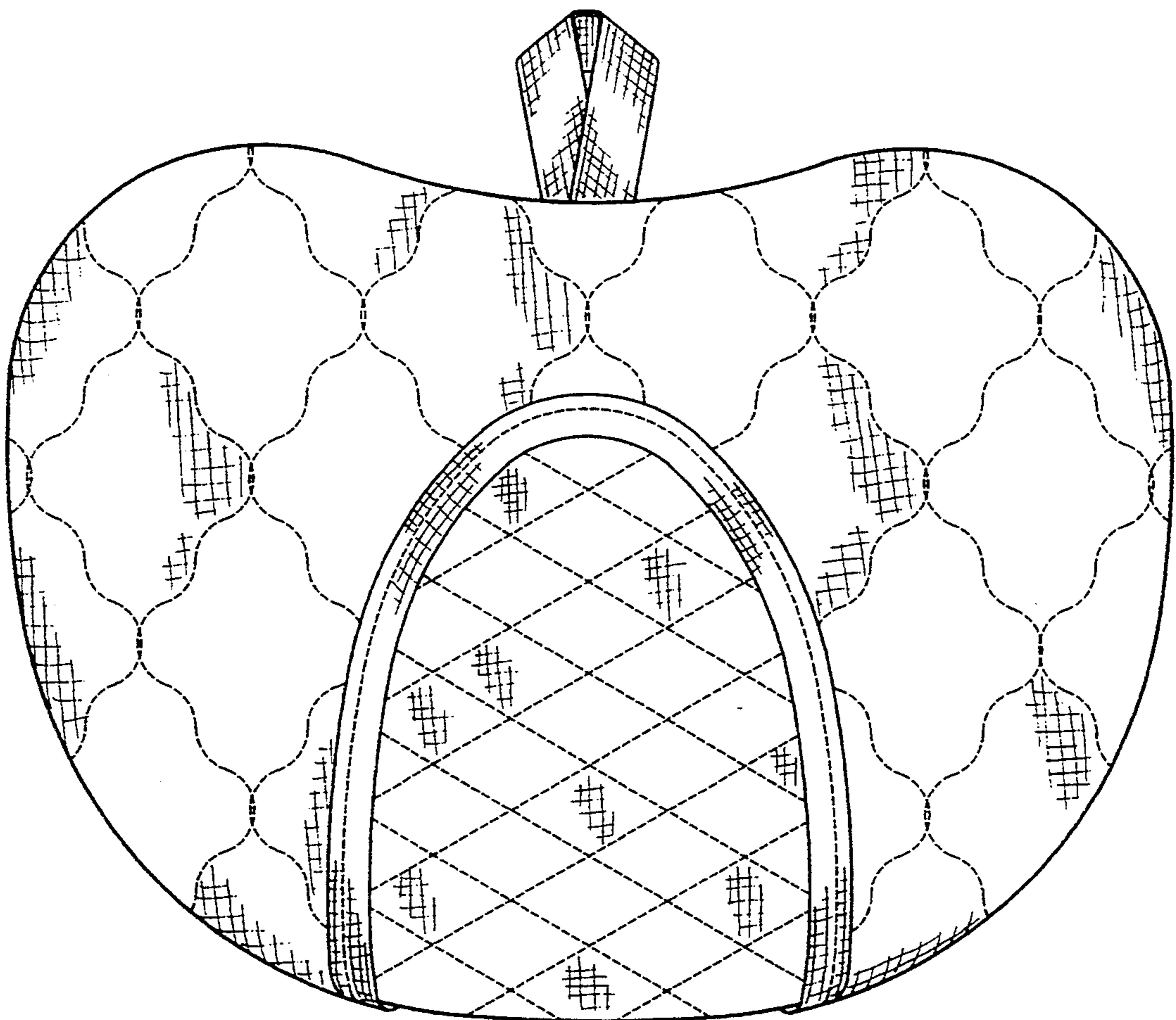

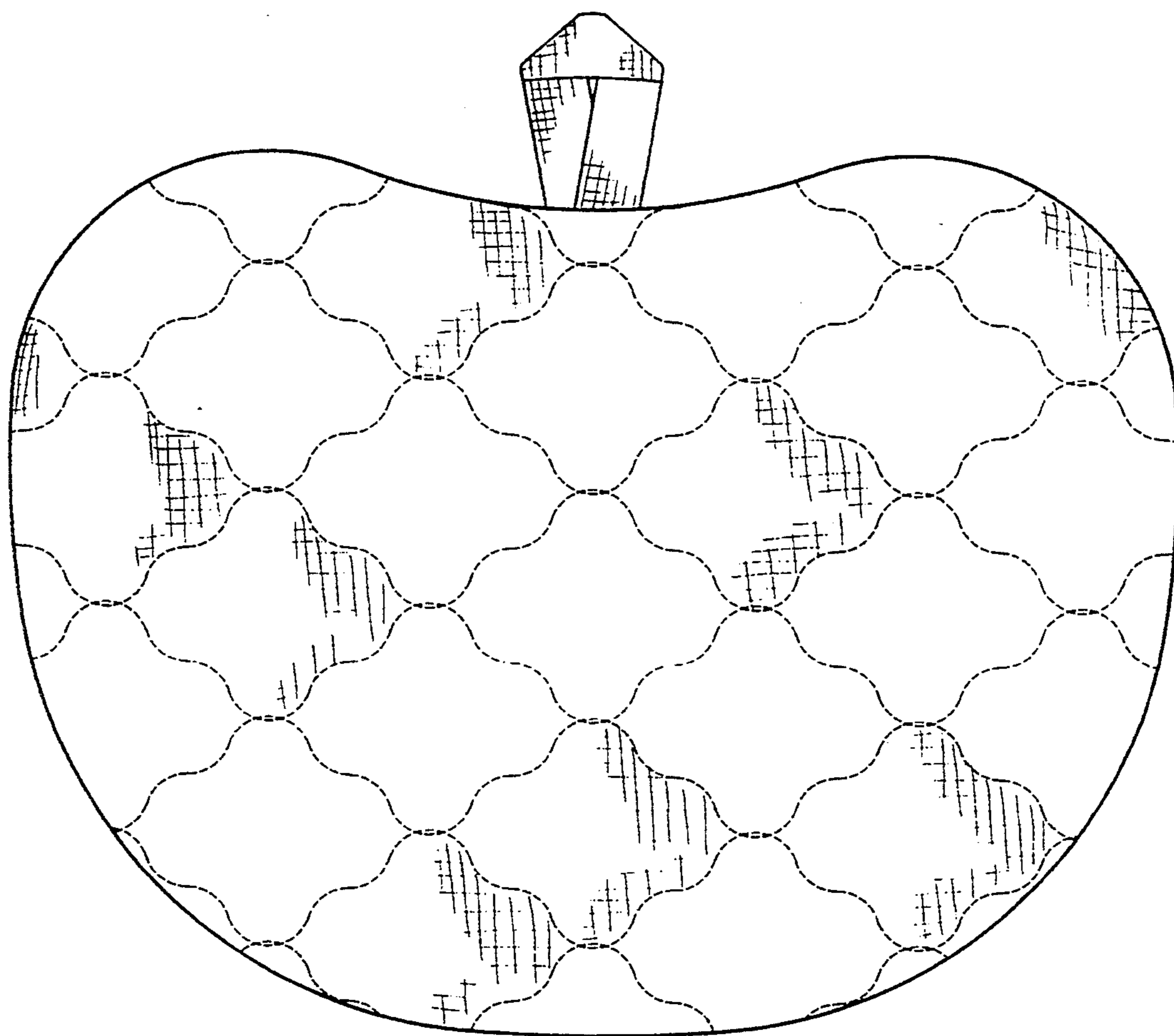
