FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

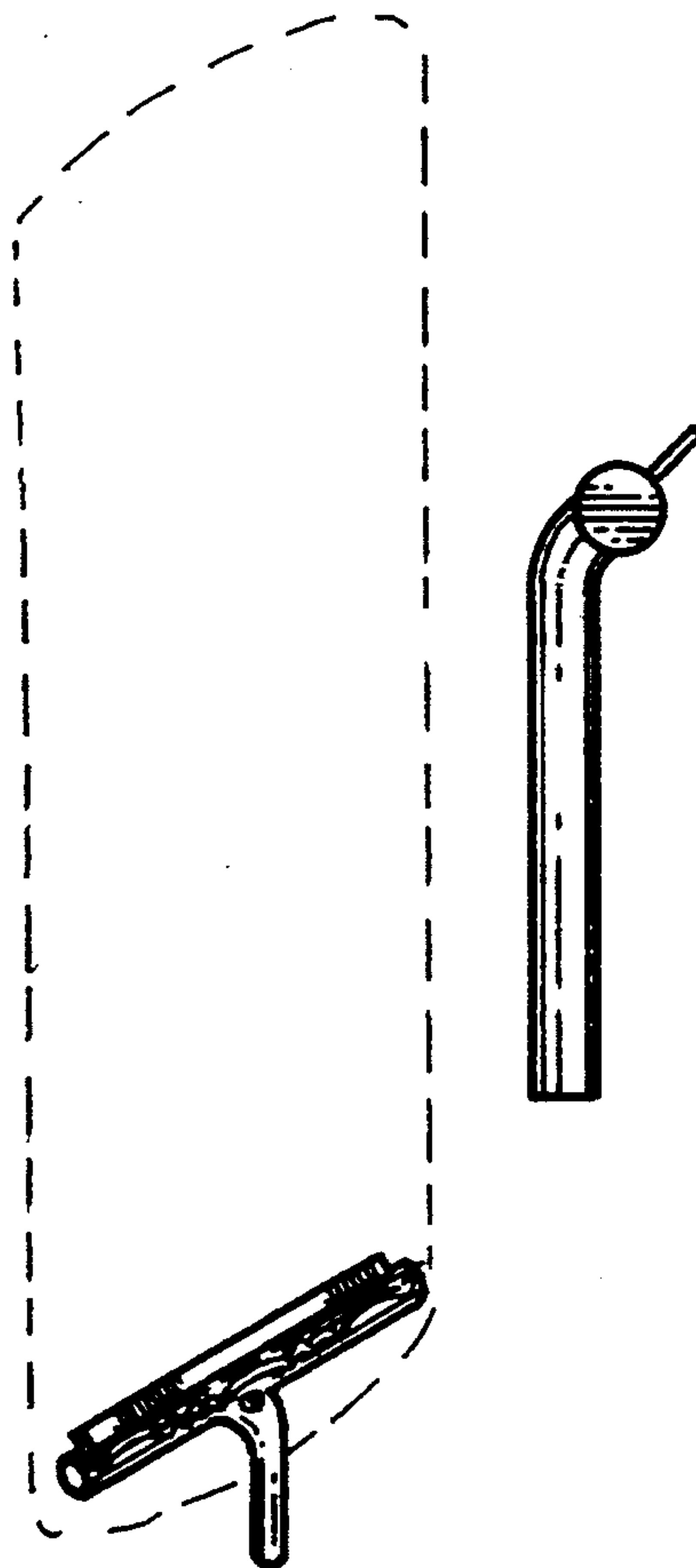
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof;

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



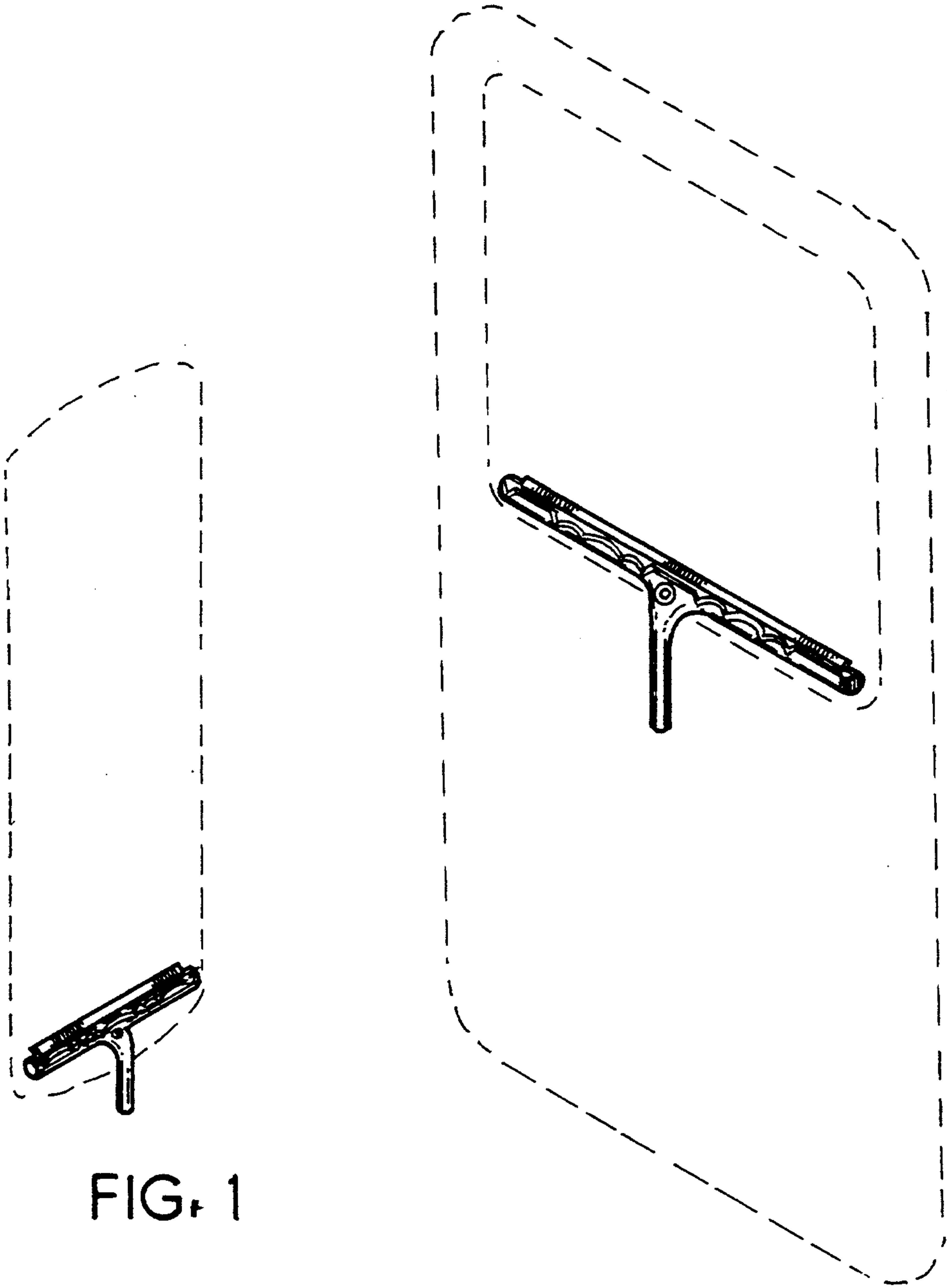
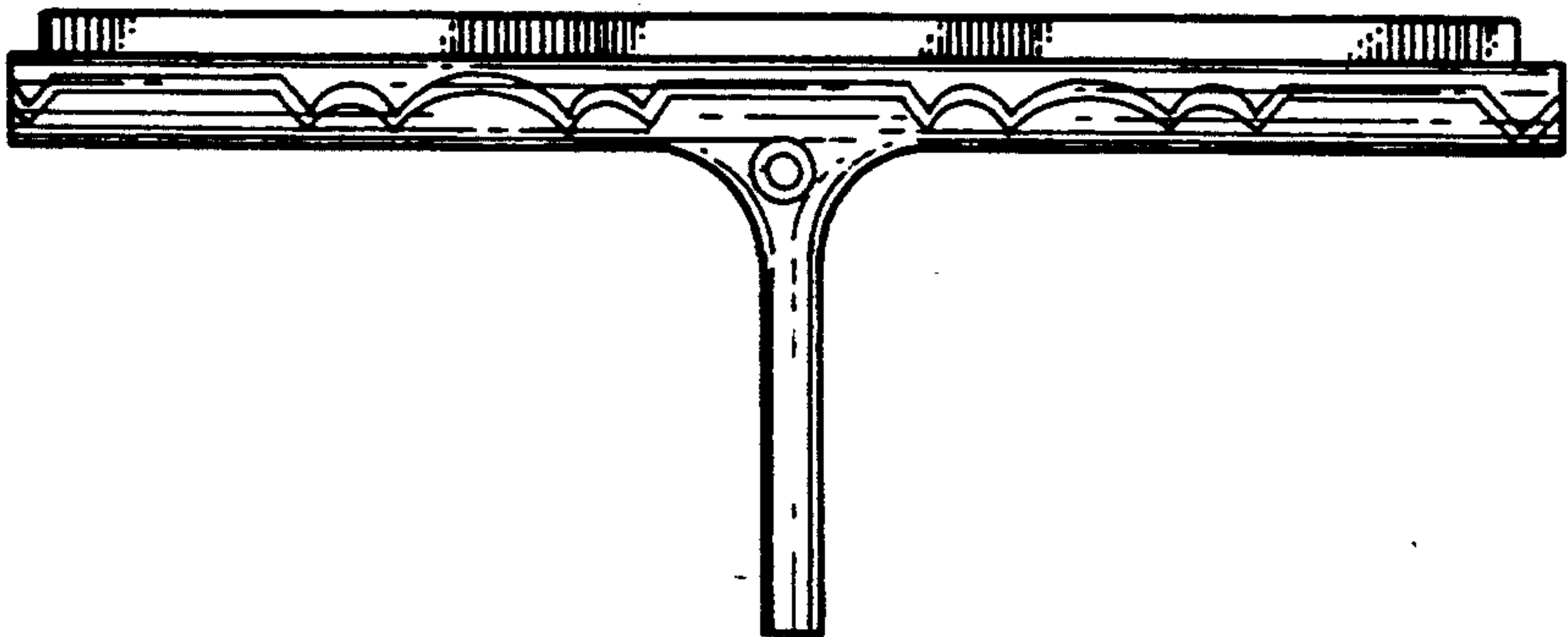

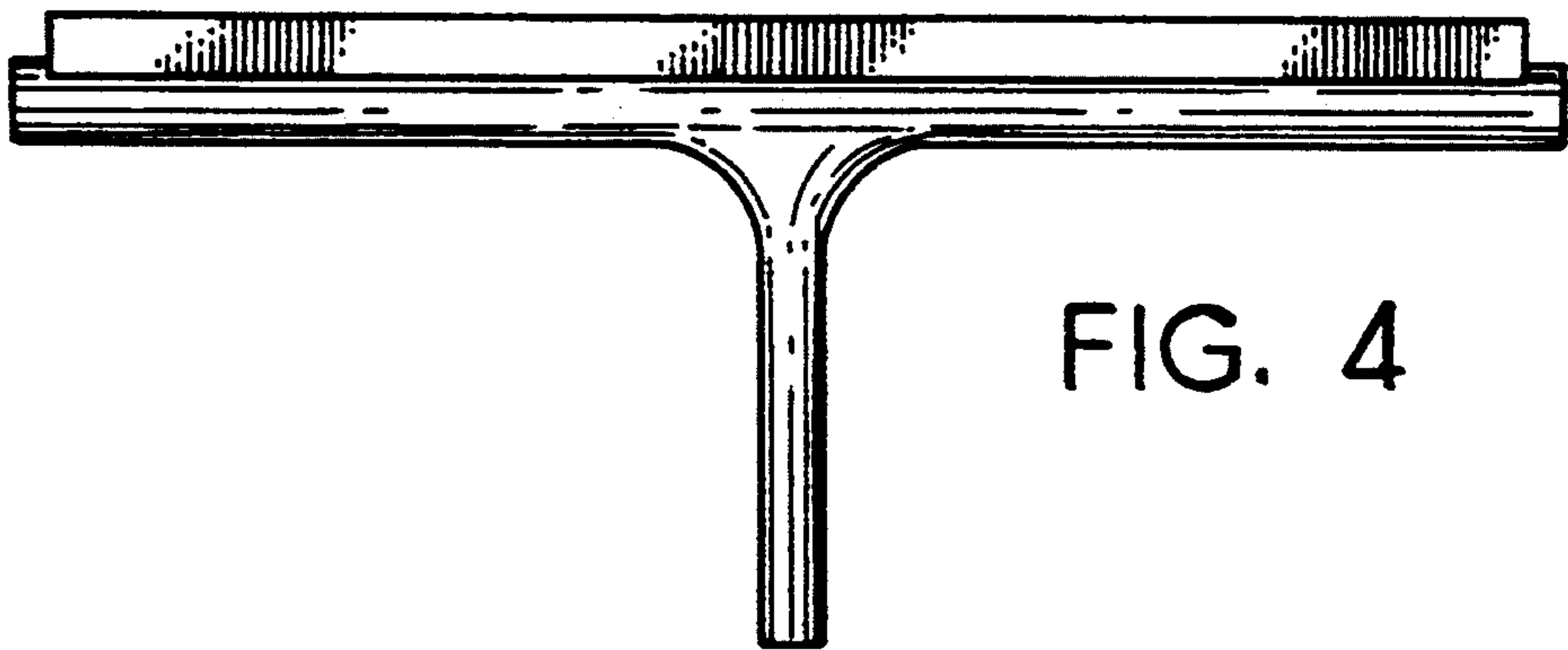
