### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cosmetic organizer, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an axonometric view of a cosmetic organizer showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;  
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view, the organizer in an open position;  
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 5; and,  
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 5, the net removed and the lid partially broken away for clarity of illustration.

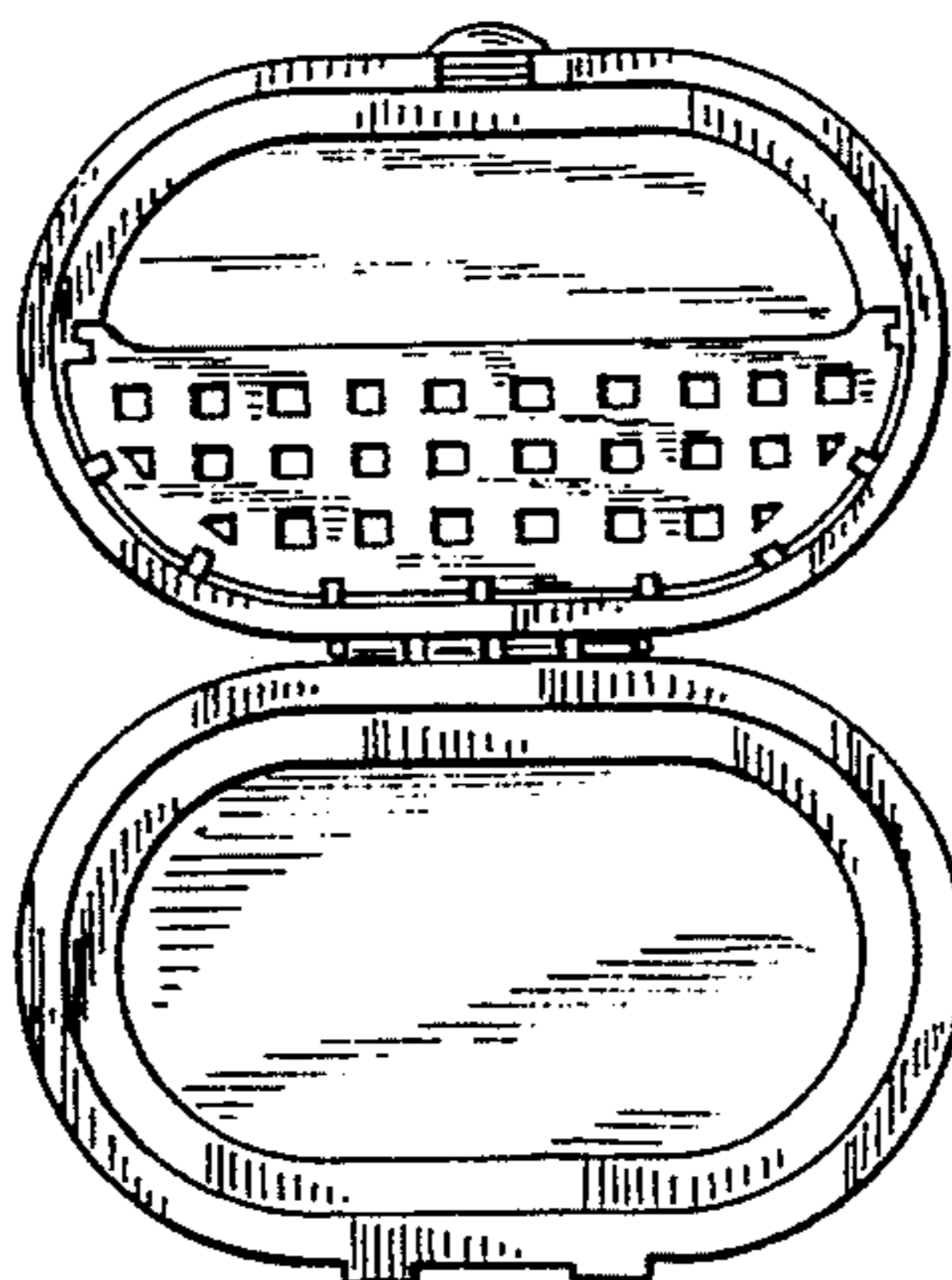
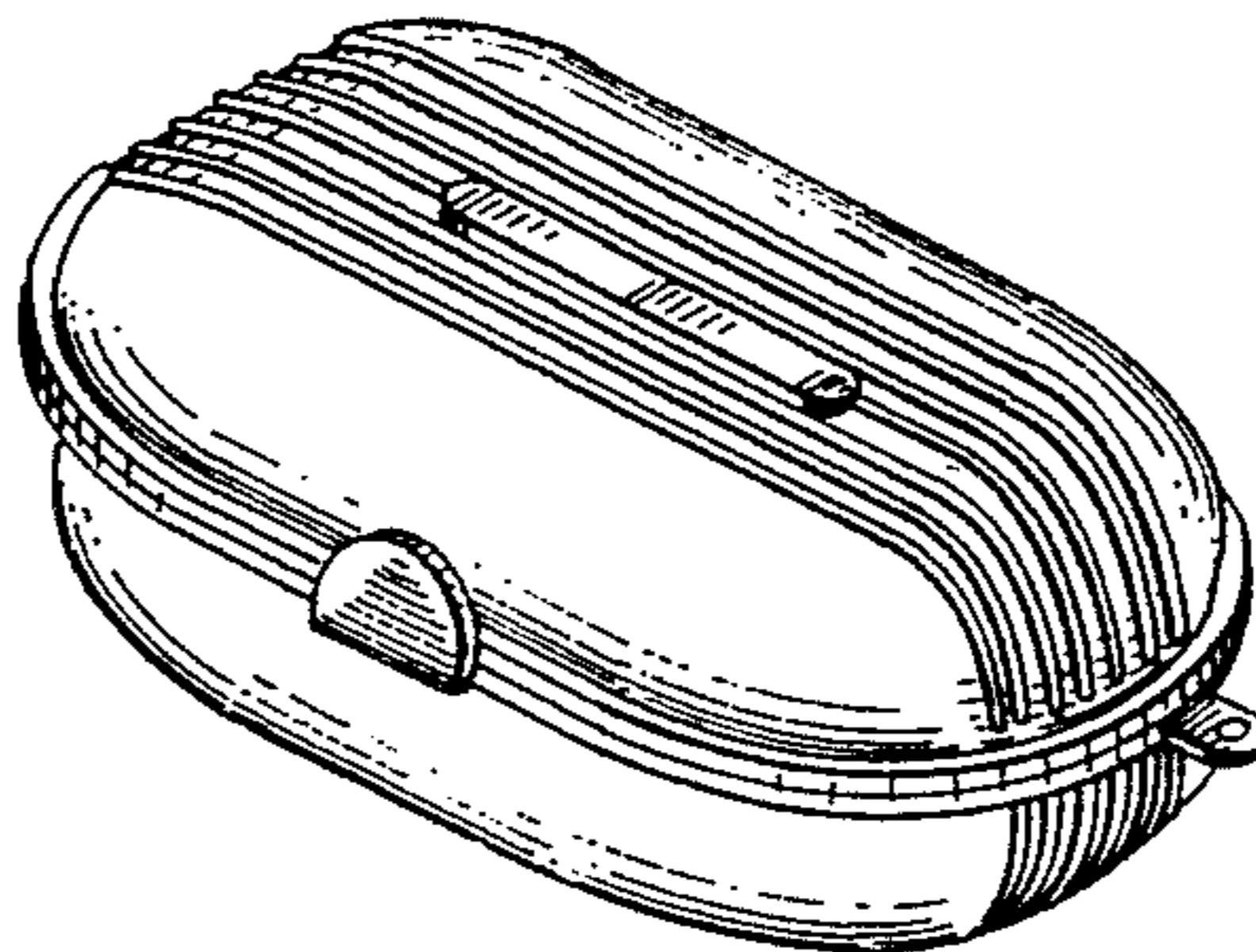

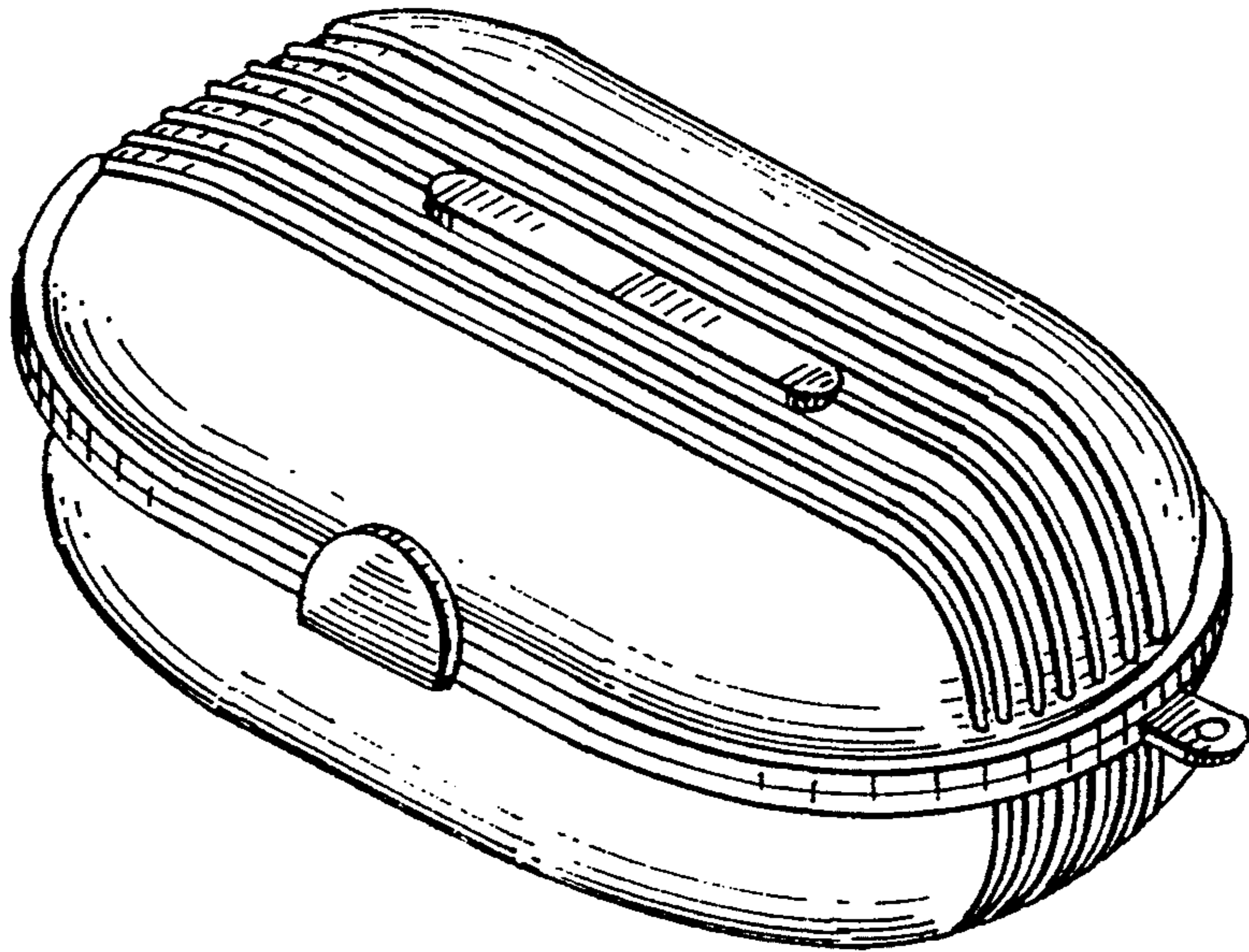

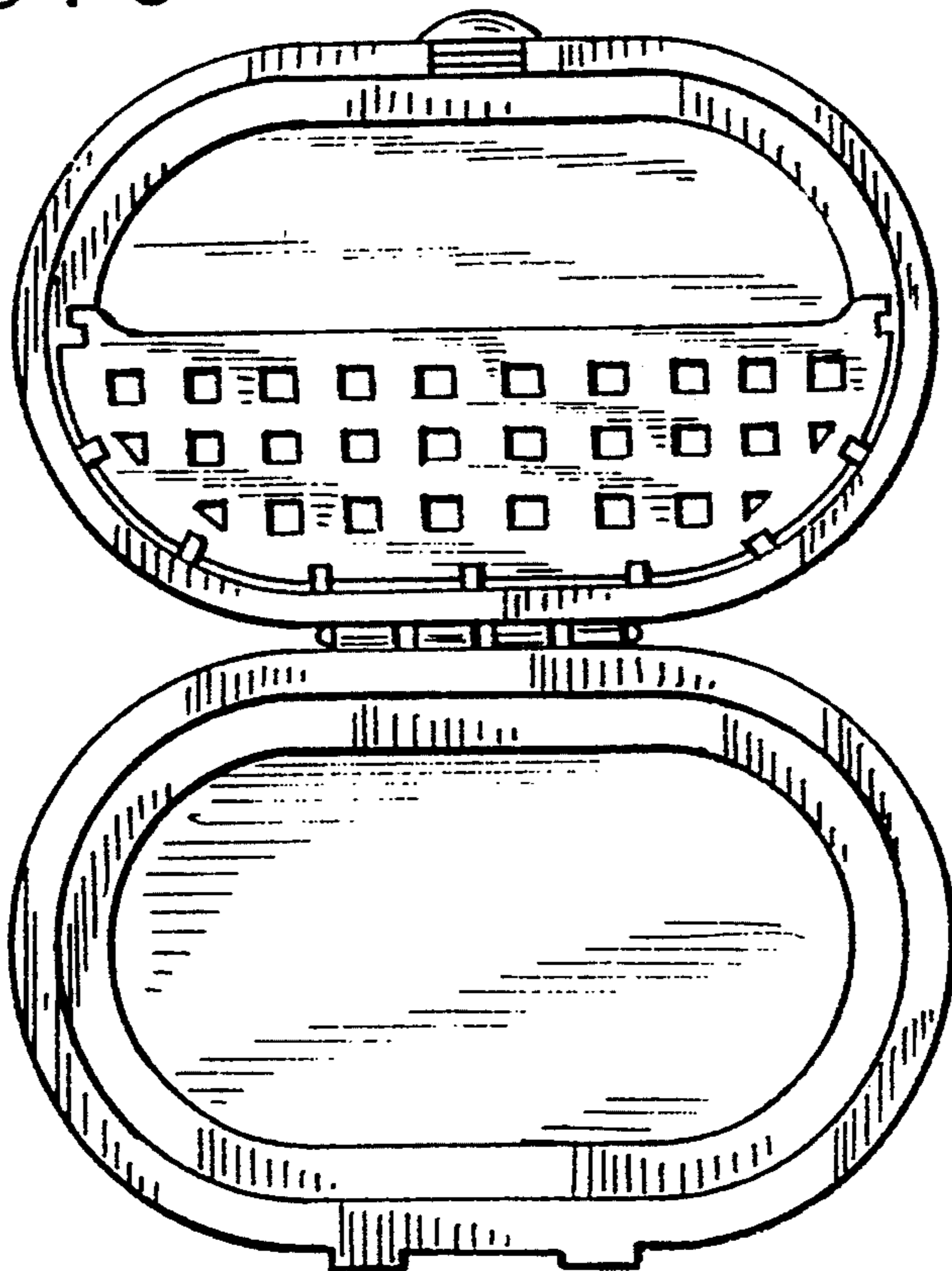

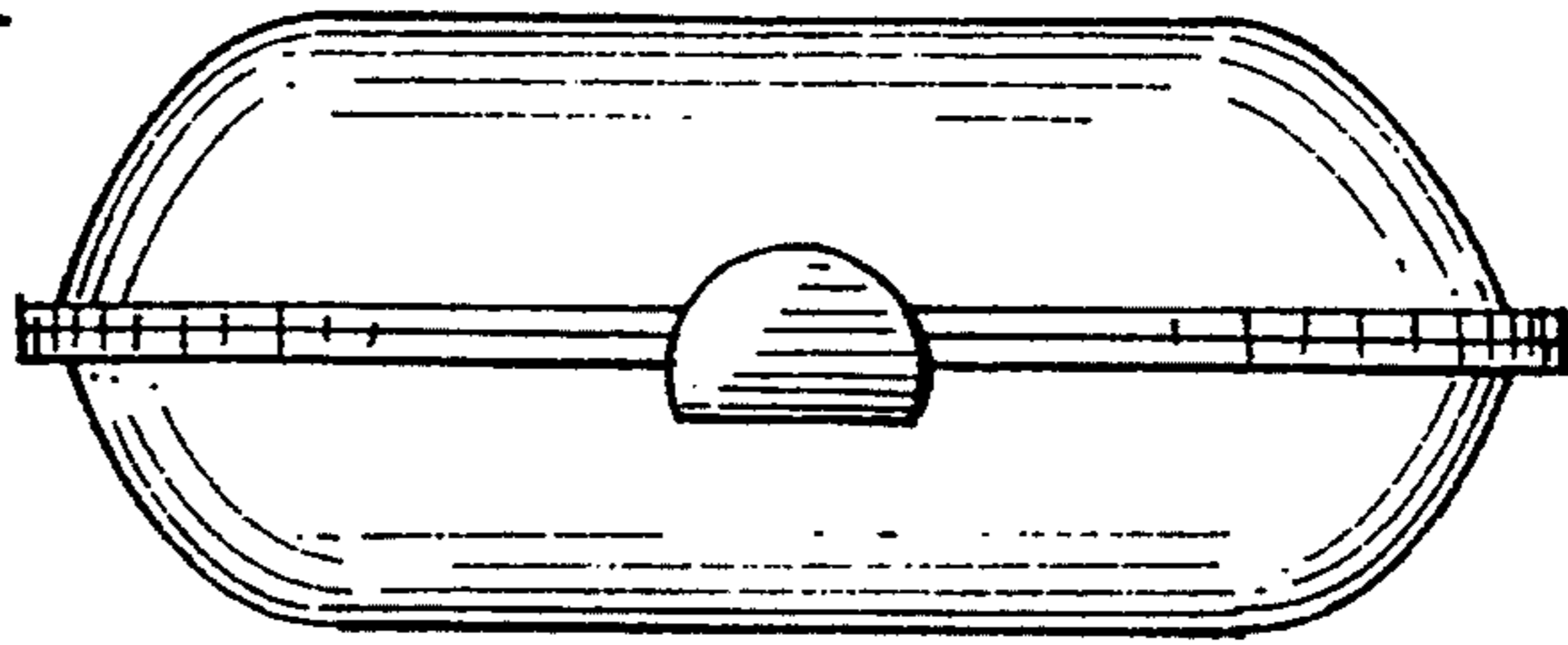

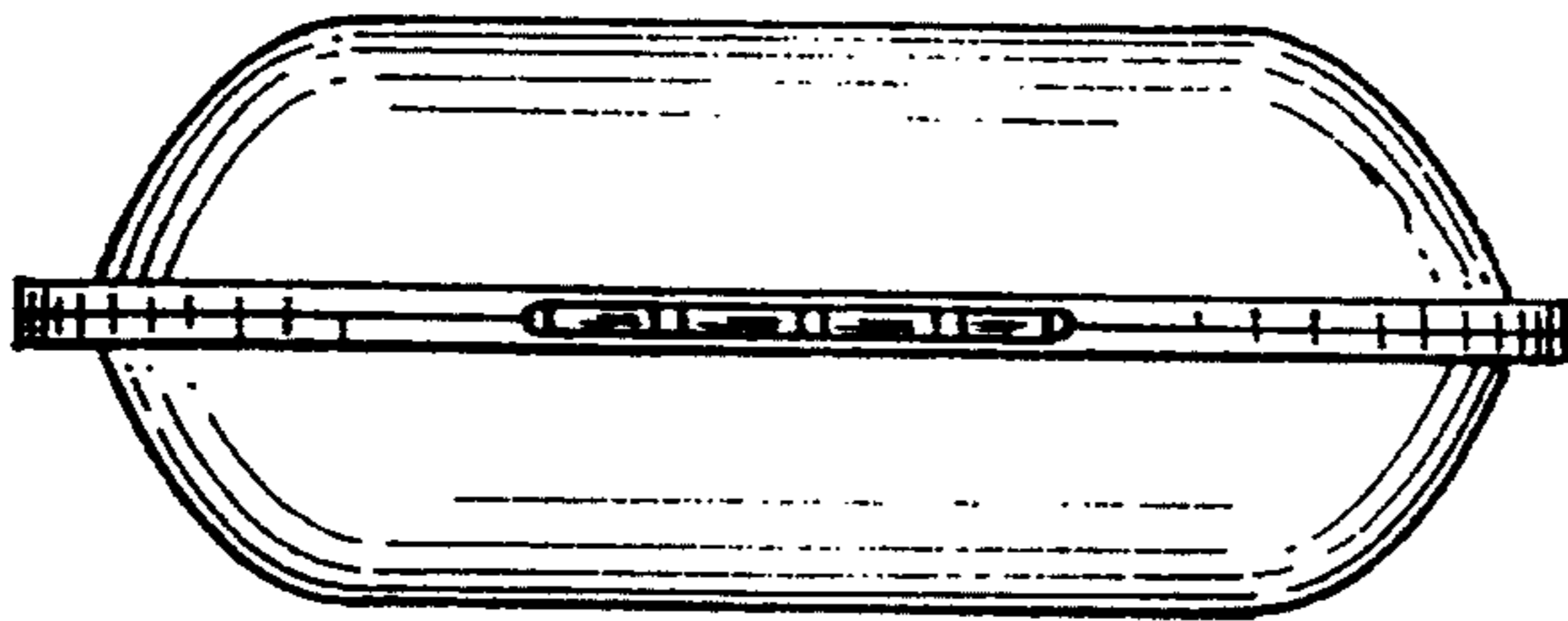

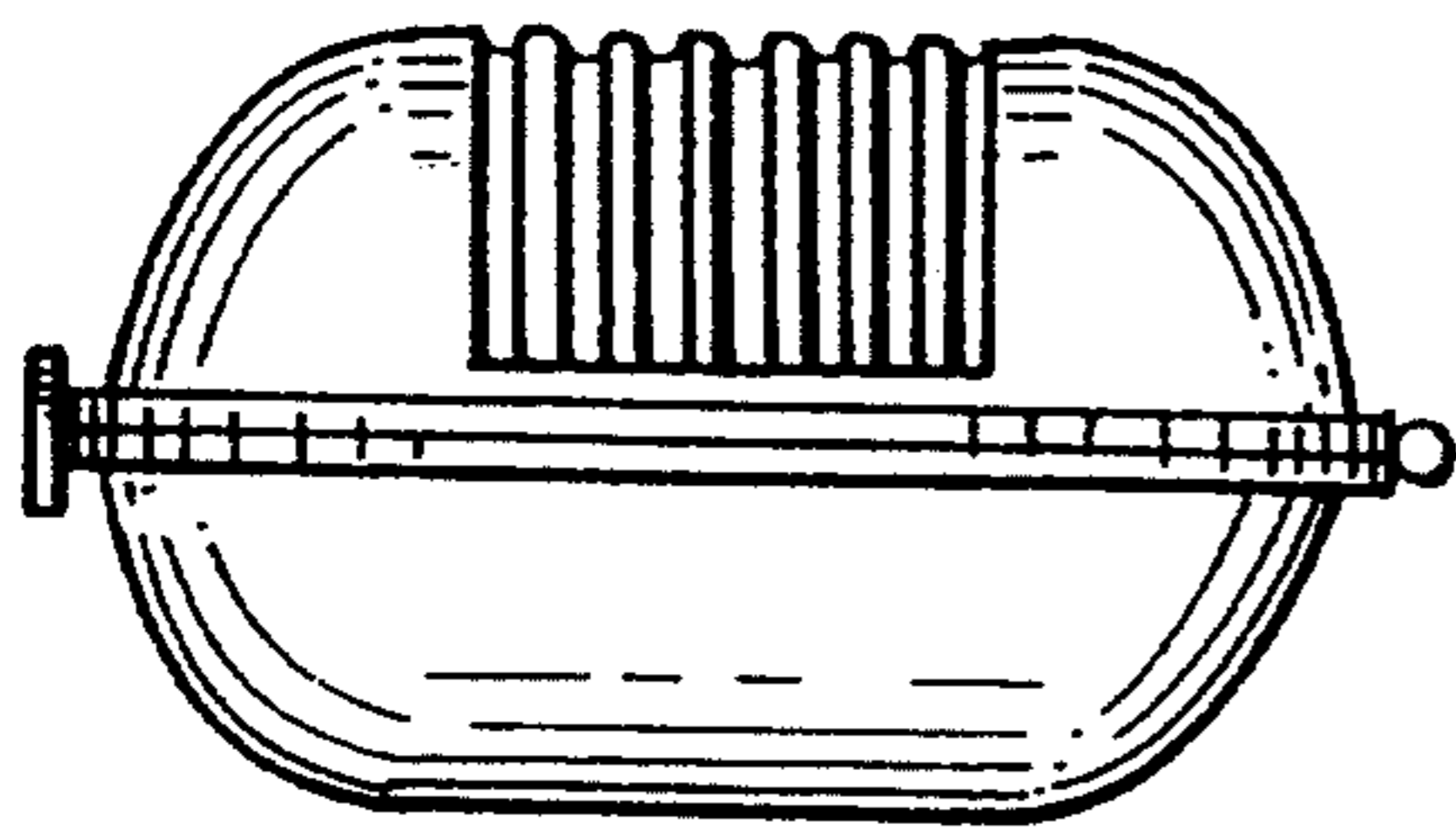

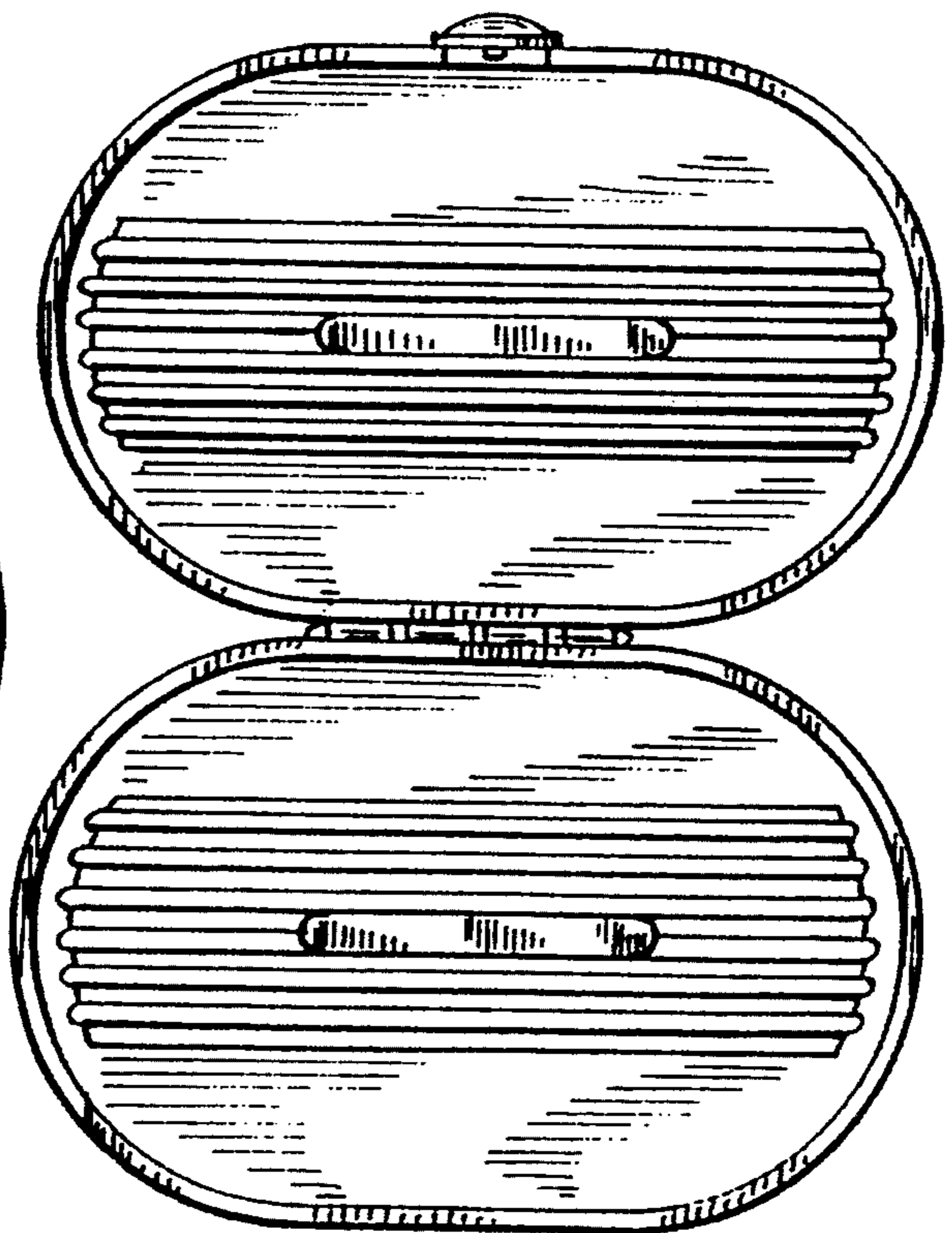
