### [57] CLAIM

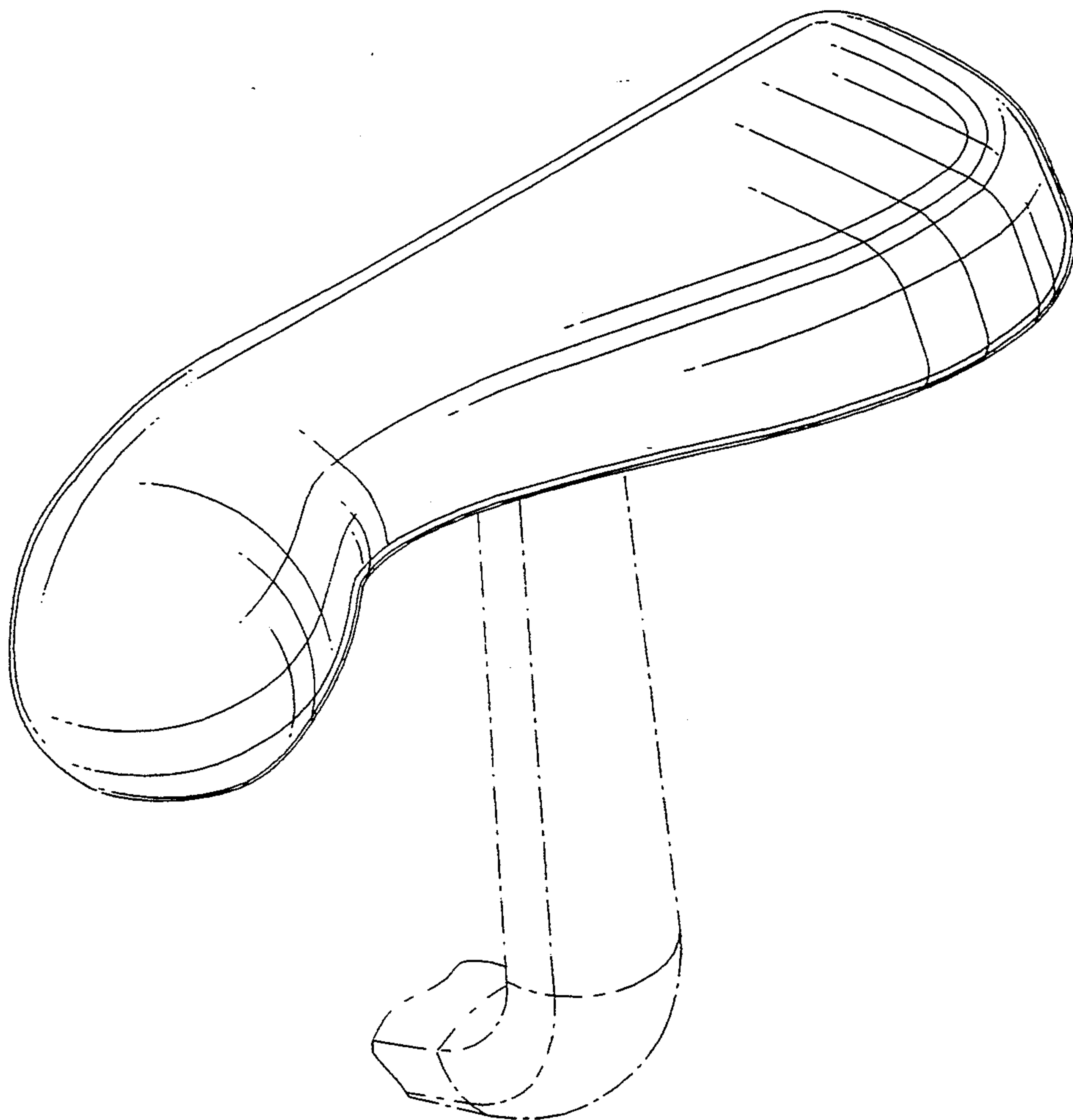
The ornamental design for a pad for a chair armrest, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pad for a chair armrest showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

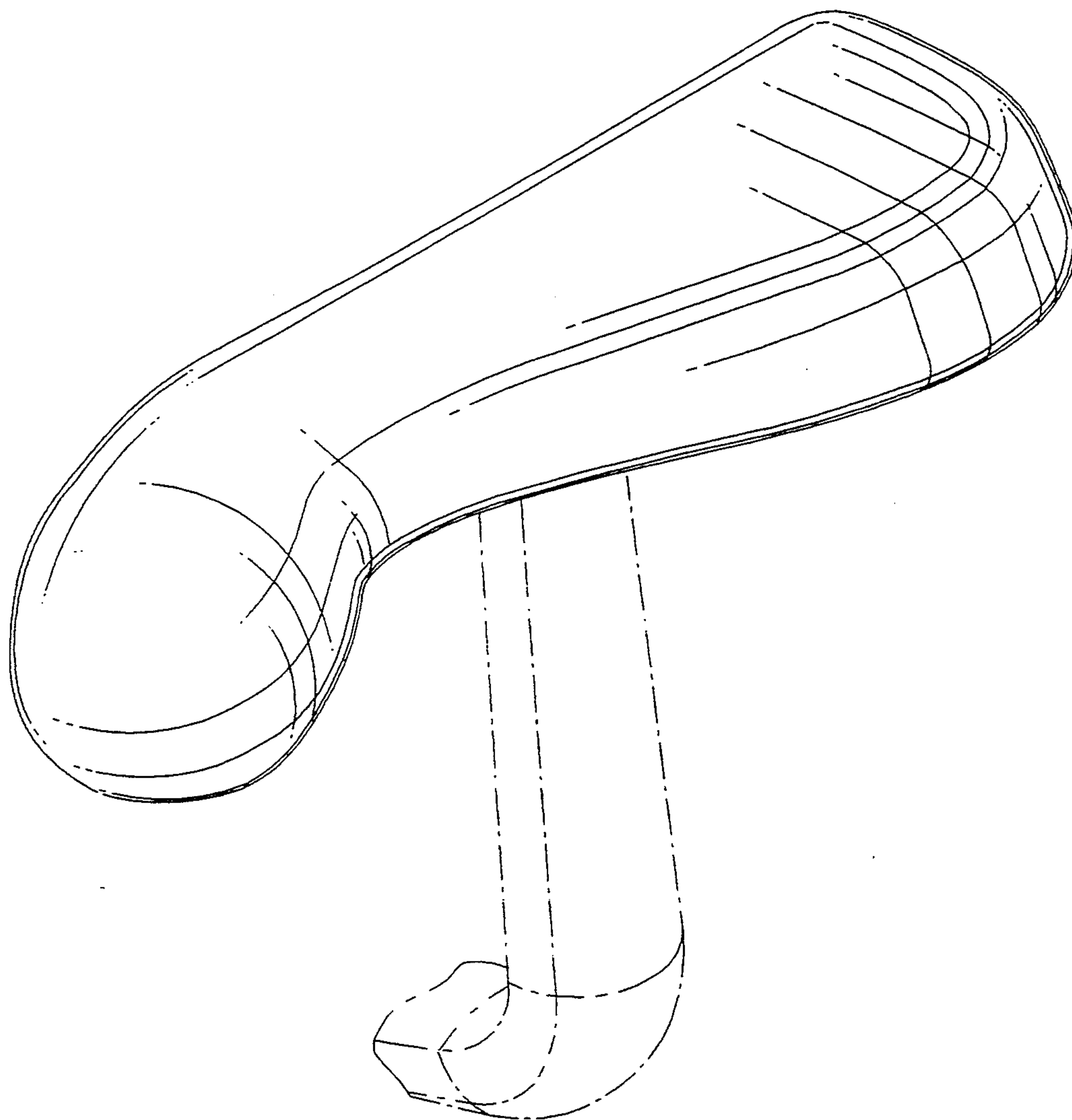

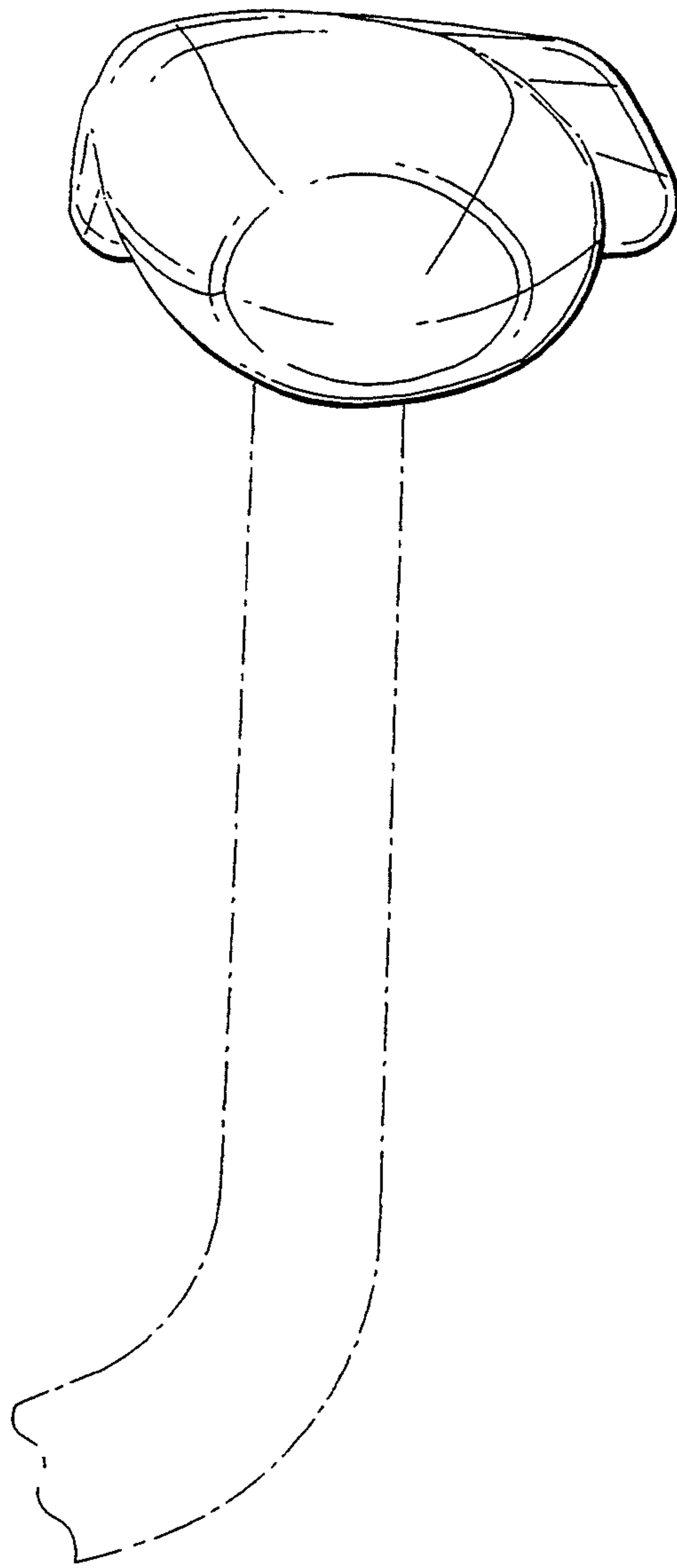

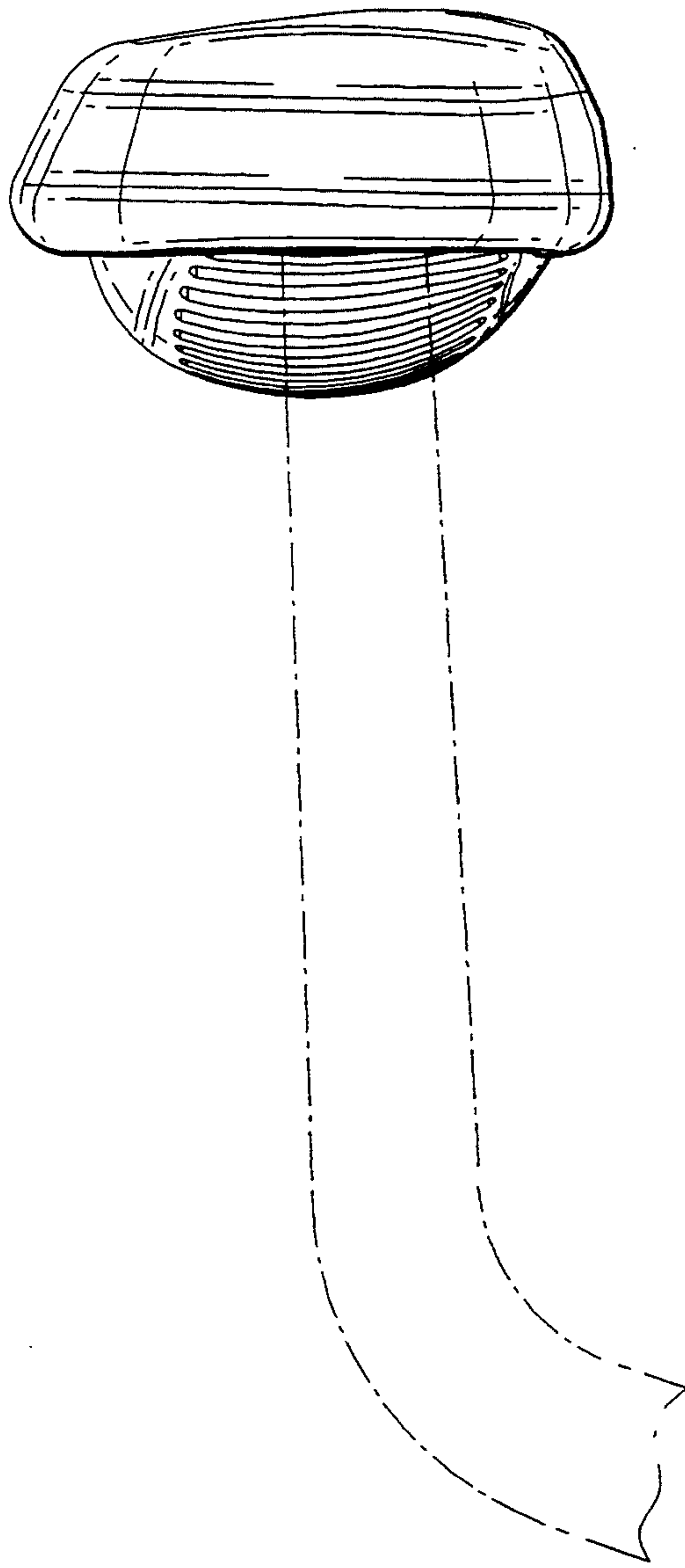

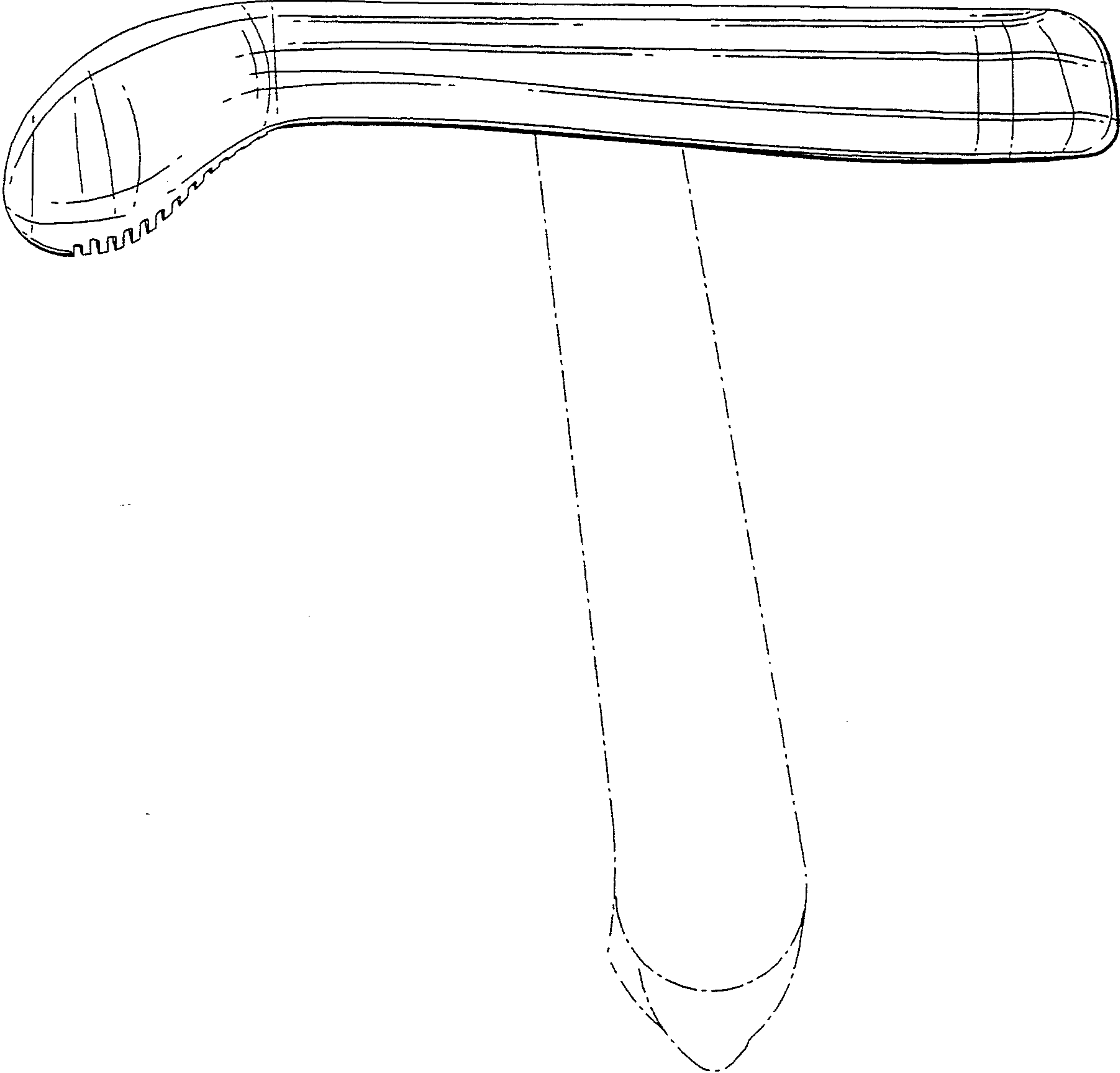

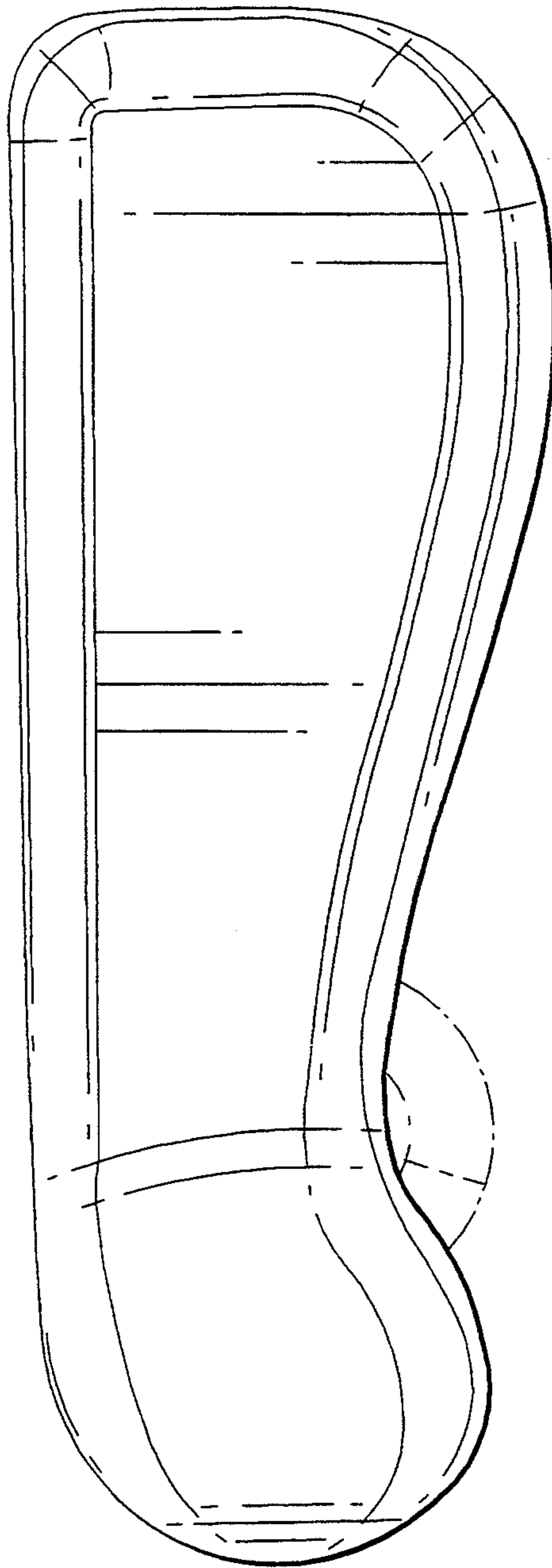

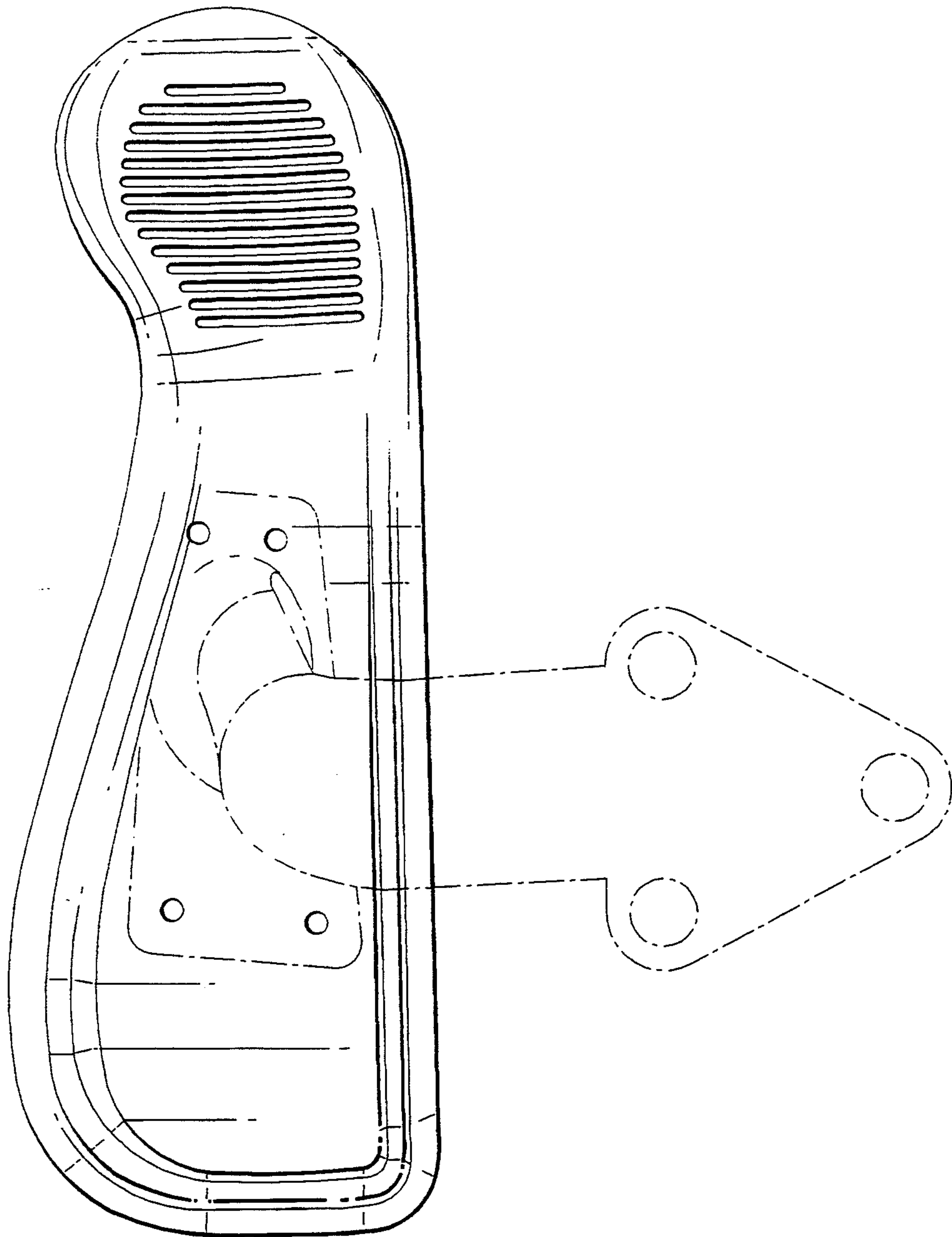
