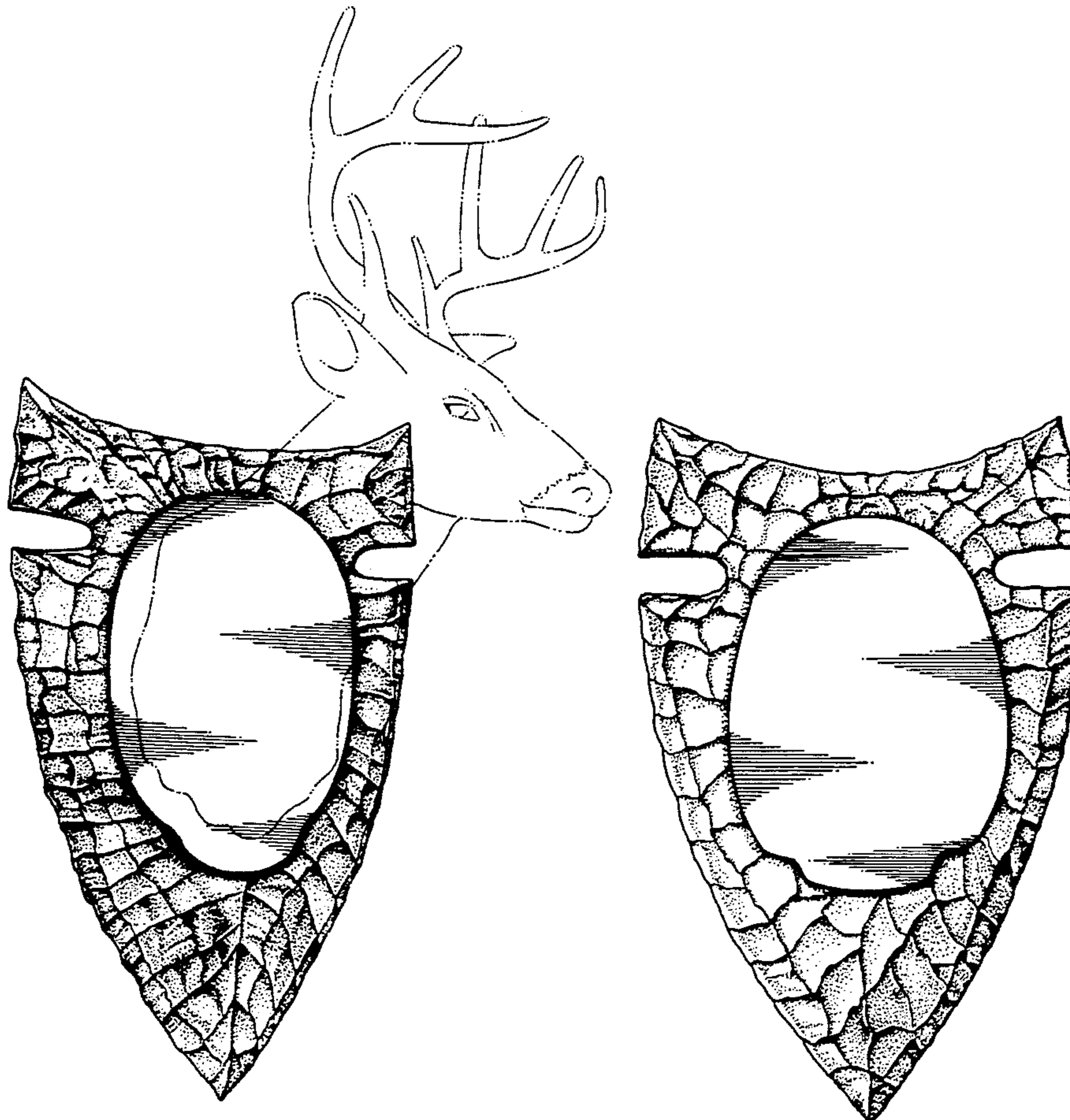

The ornamental design for a trophy mount, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a trophy mount showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view with the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.
The broken line showing of a deer in FIG. 1 and a clock in FIG. 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



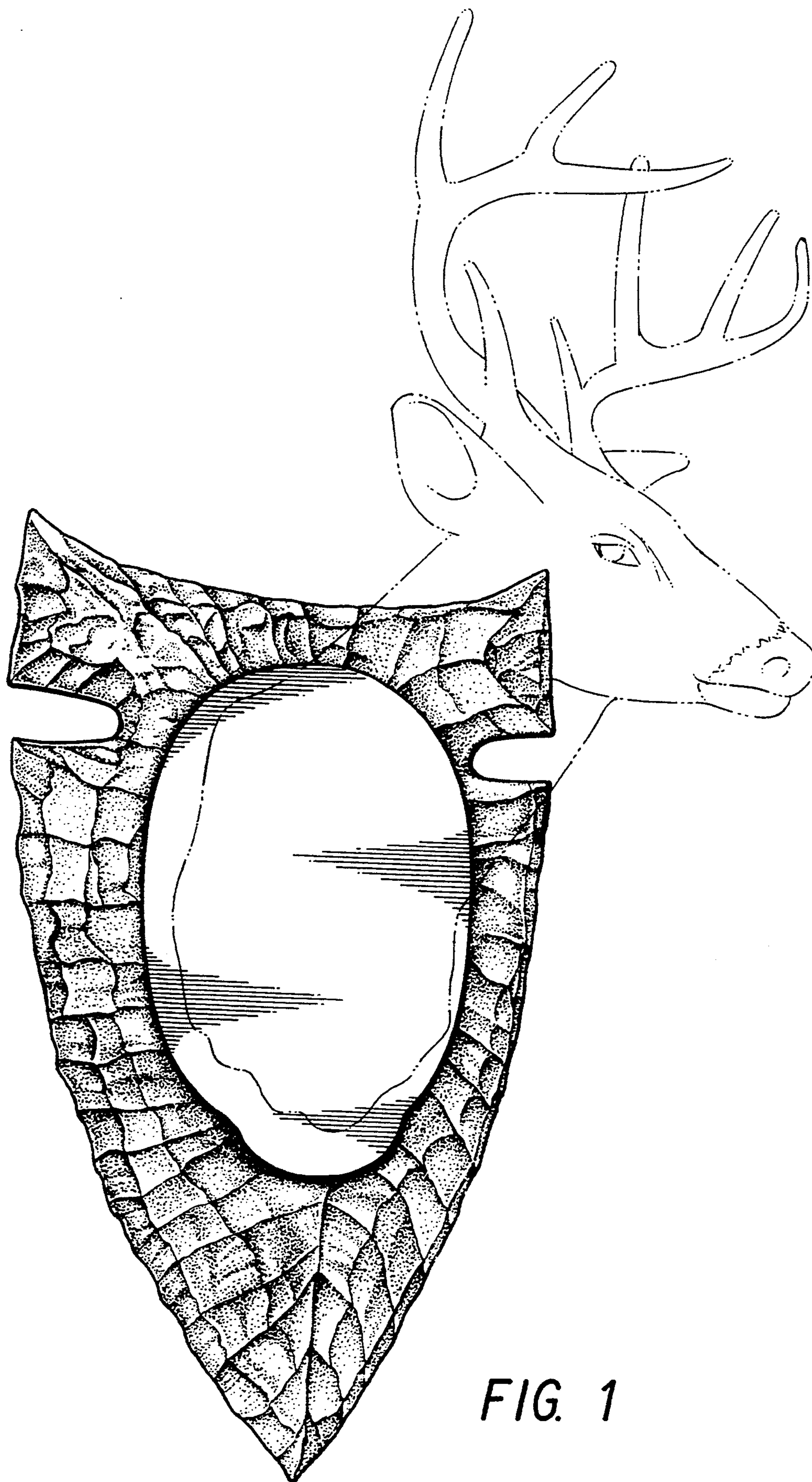

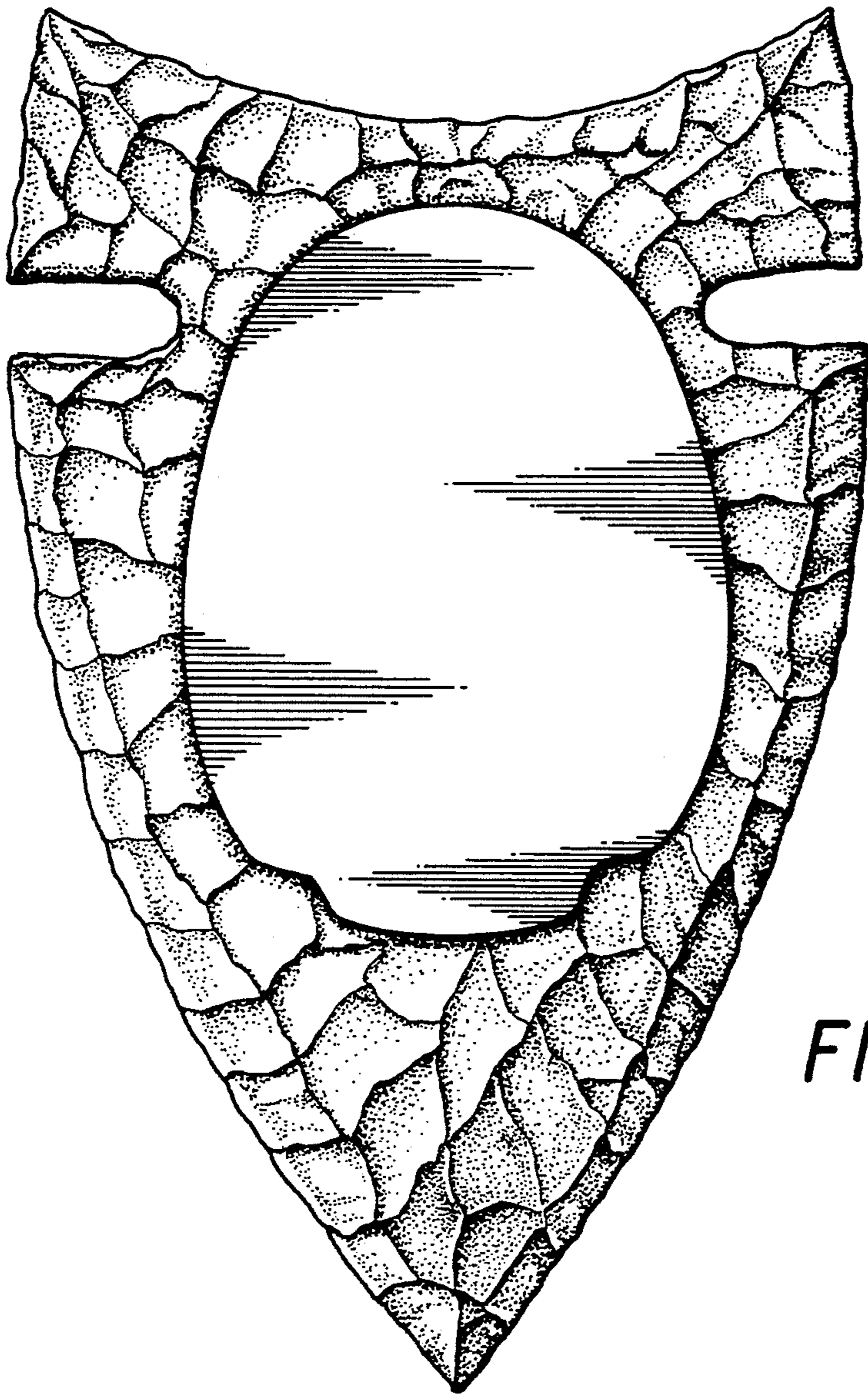

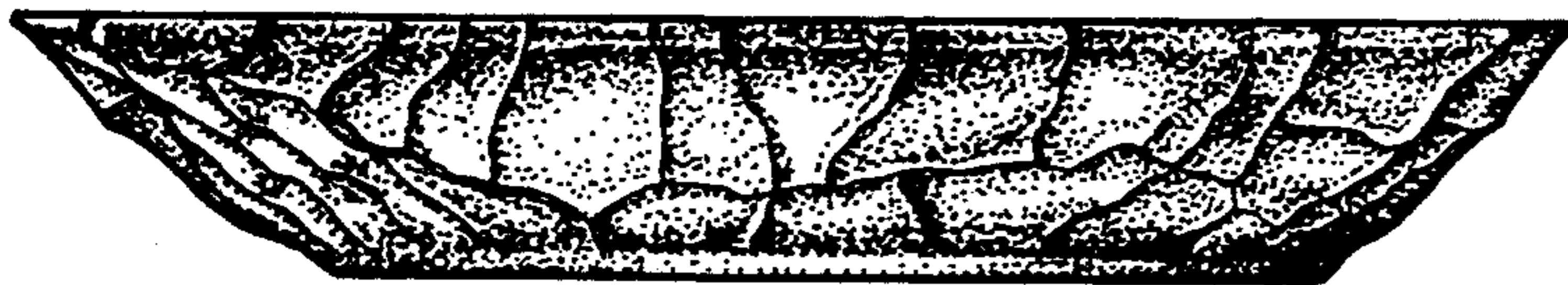
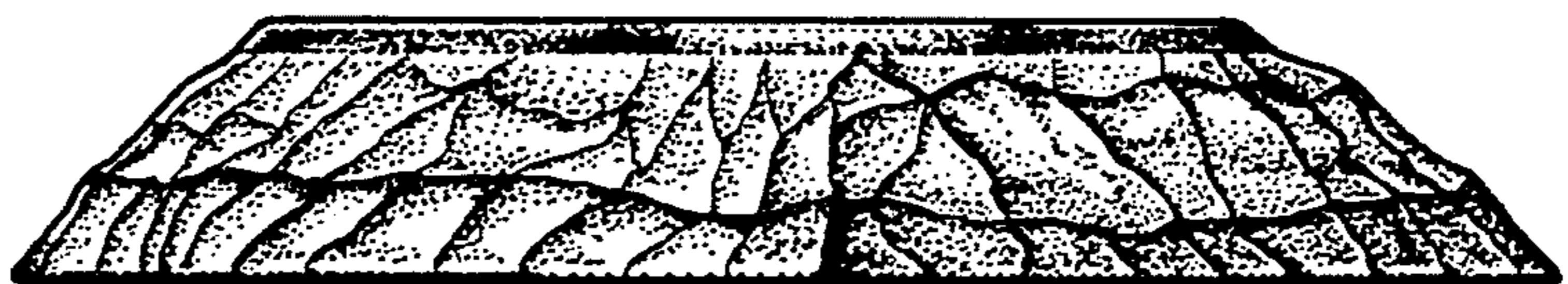

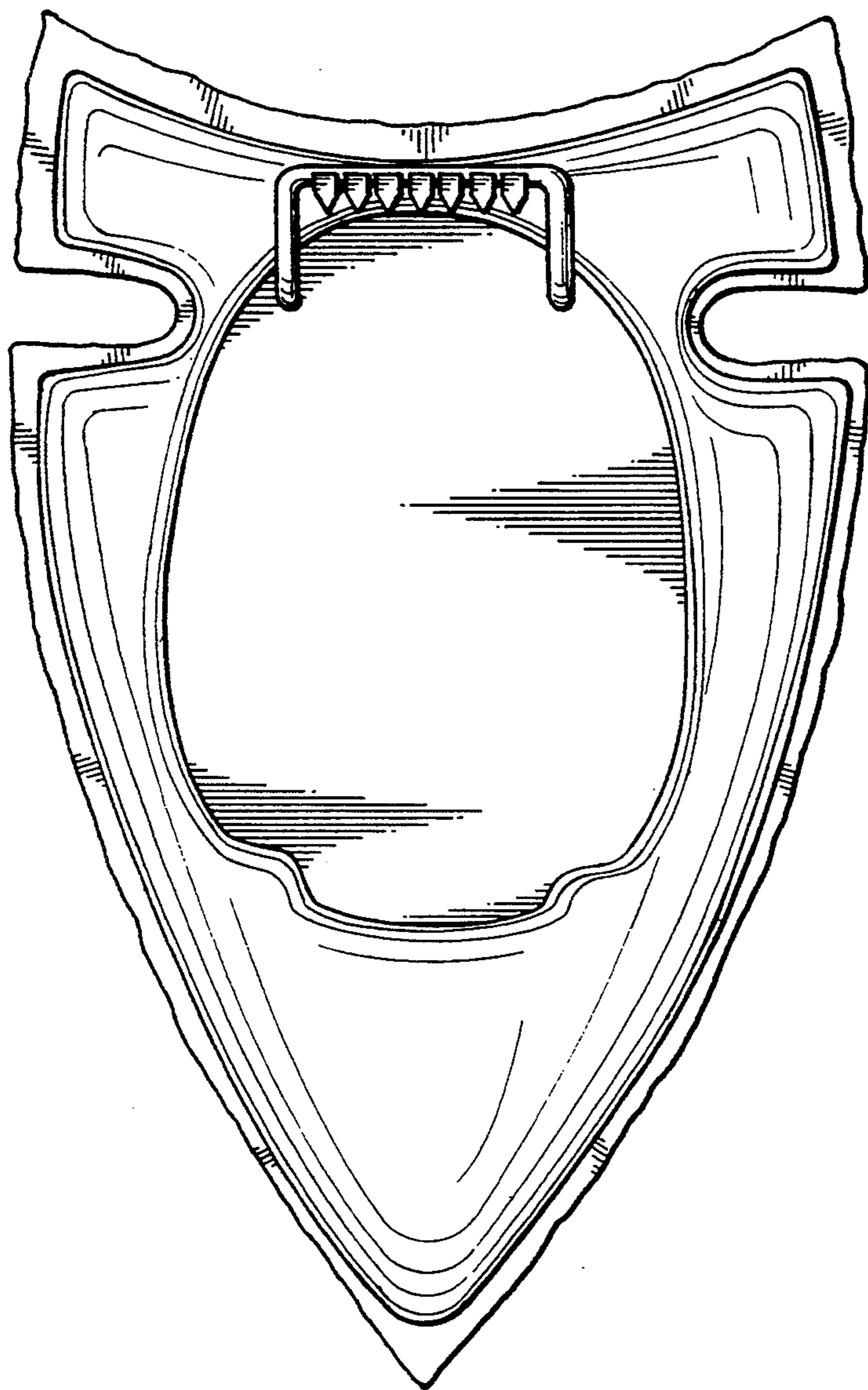

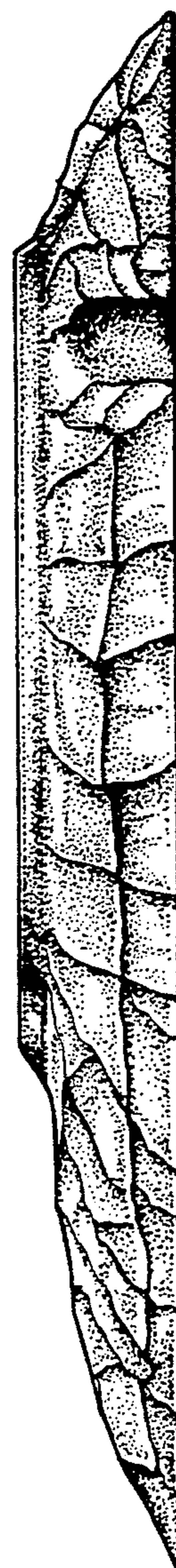

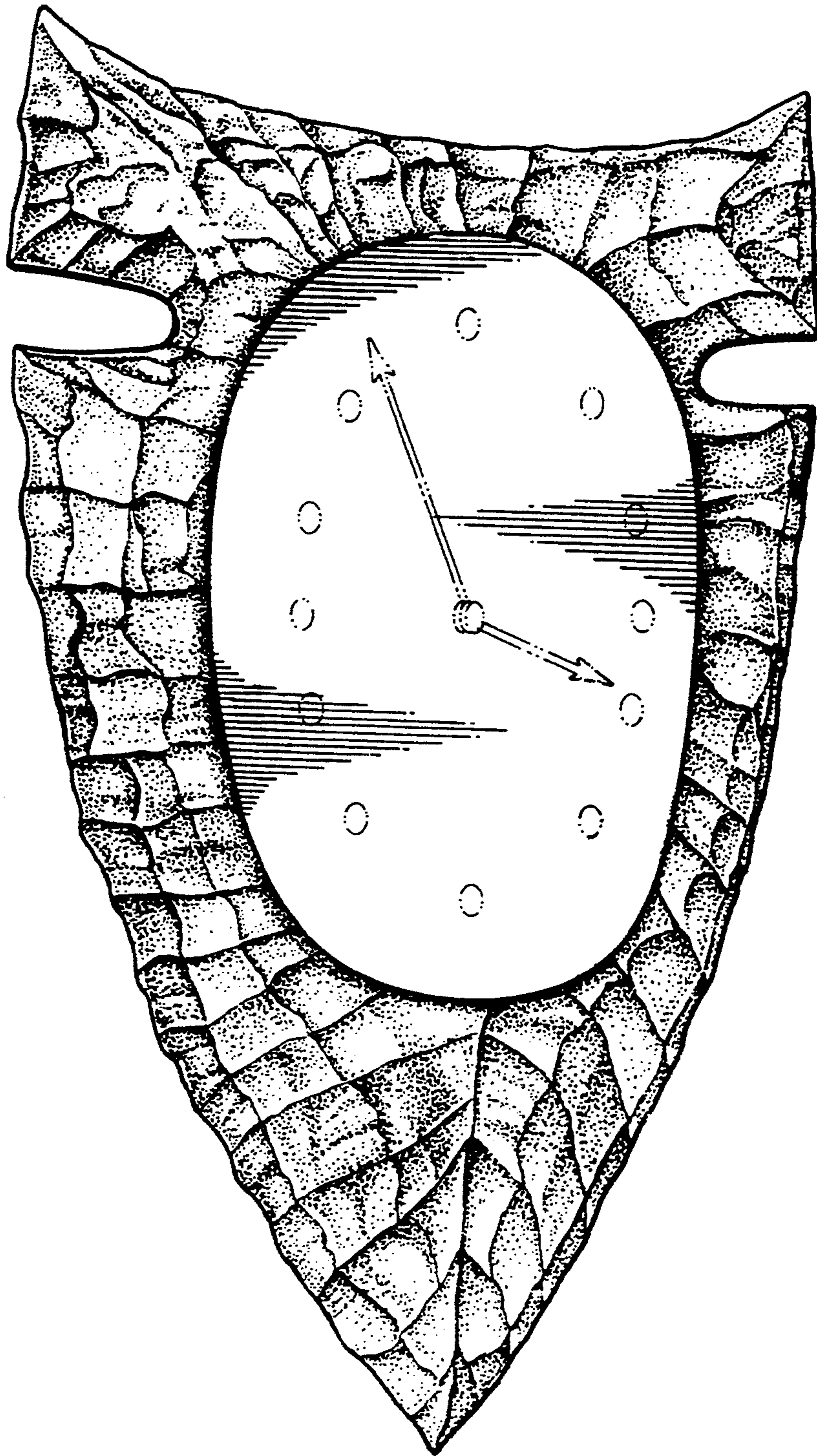
