The ornamental design for a writing instrument, as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a writing instrument incorporating my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 4 is a left side, elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 5 is a top view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 7 is perspective view of a writing instrument incorporating a second embodiment of my new design;  
 FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 10 is a left side, elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 11 is a top view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 12 is a bottom view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;  
 FIG. 13 is a perspective view of a writing instrument incorporating a third embodiment of my new design;

 FIG. 19 is a bottom view of the writing instrument of FIG. 13;  
 FIG. 20 is a perspective view of a writing instrument incorporating a fourth embodiment of my new design;  
 FIG. 21 is a left side elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 20 in an exploded condition;  
 FIG. 22 is a front elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 20;  
 FIG. 23 is a rear elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 20;  
 FIG. 24 is a left side, elevational view of the writing instrument of FIG. 20;  
 FIG. 25 is a top view of the writing instrument of FIG. 20; and,  
 FIG. 26 is a bottom view of the writing instrument of FIG. 20.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the particularly configured clip member in combination with the writing instrument body shown, as best illustrated, in FIGS. 1, 7, and 20.













































