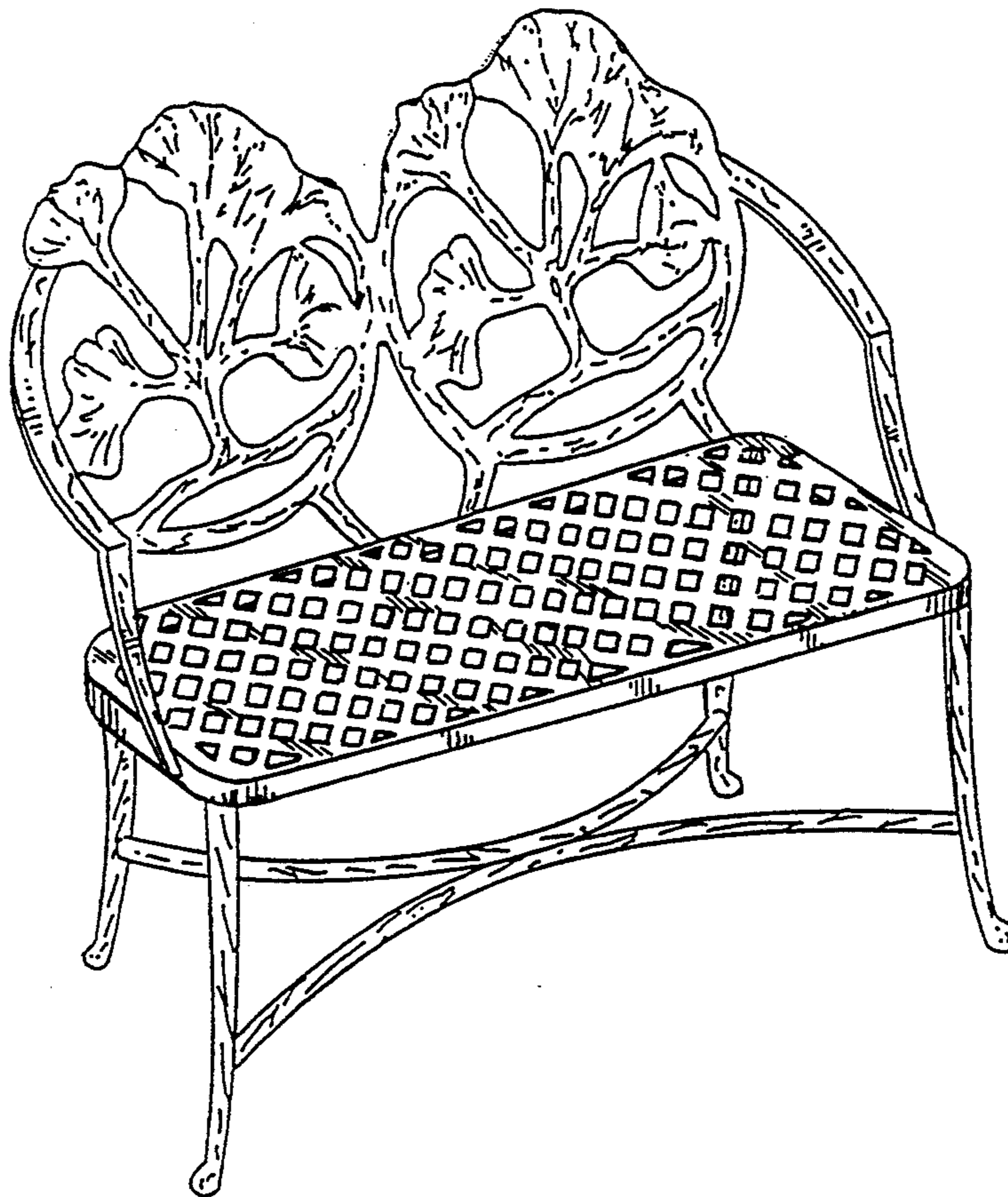

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the patio loveseat of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the patio loveseat of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the patio loveseat of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of the patio loveseat of FIG. 1.



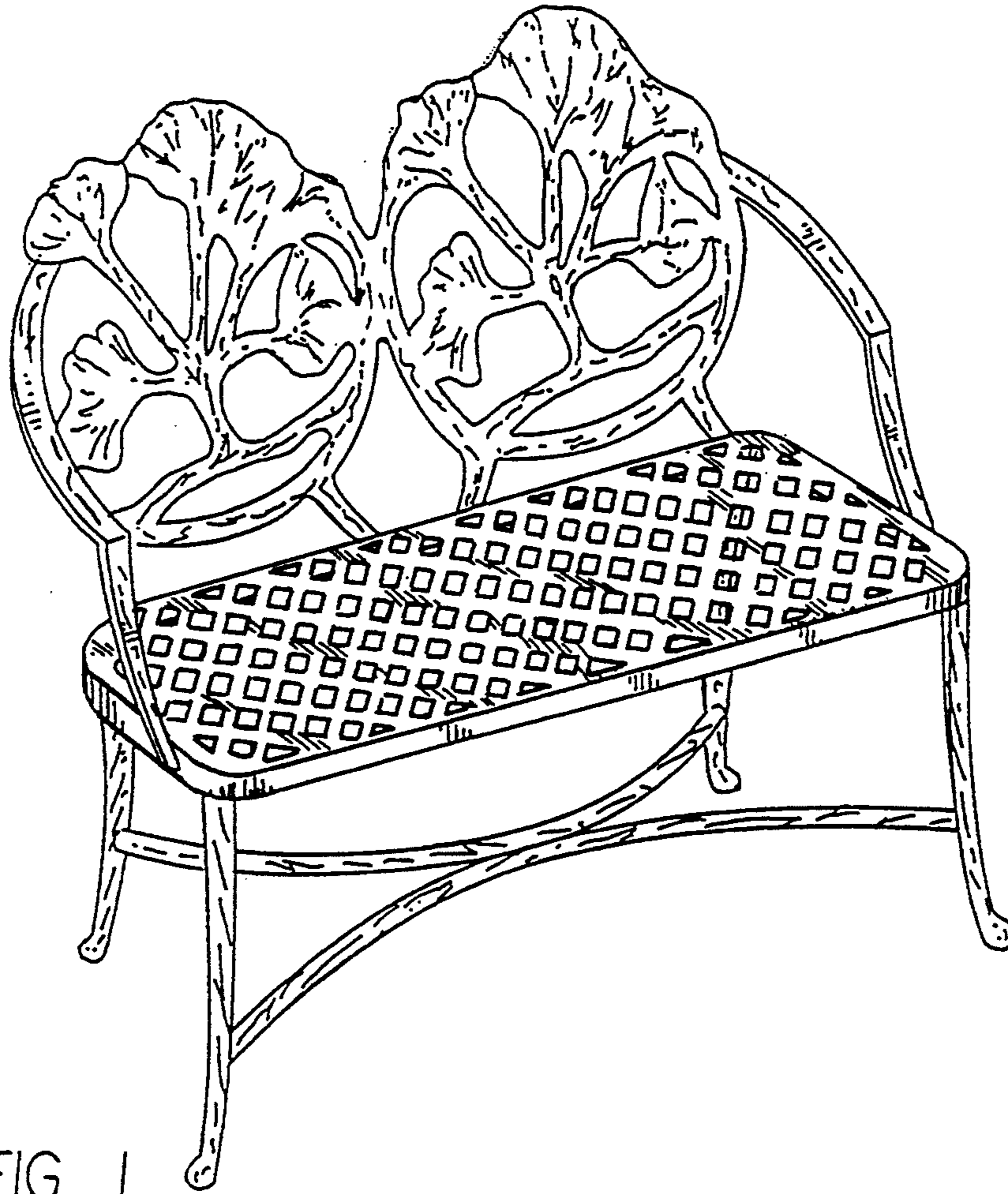

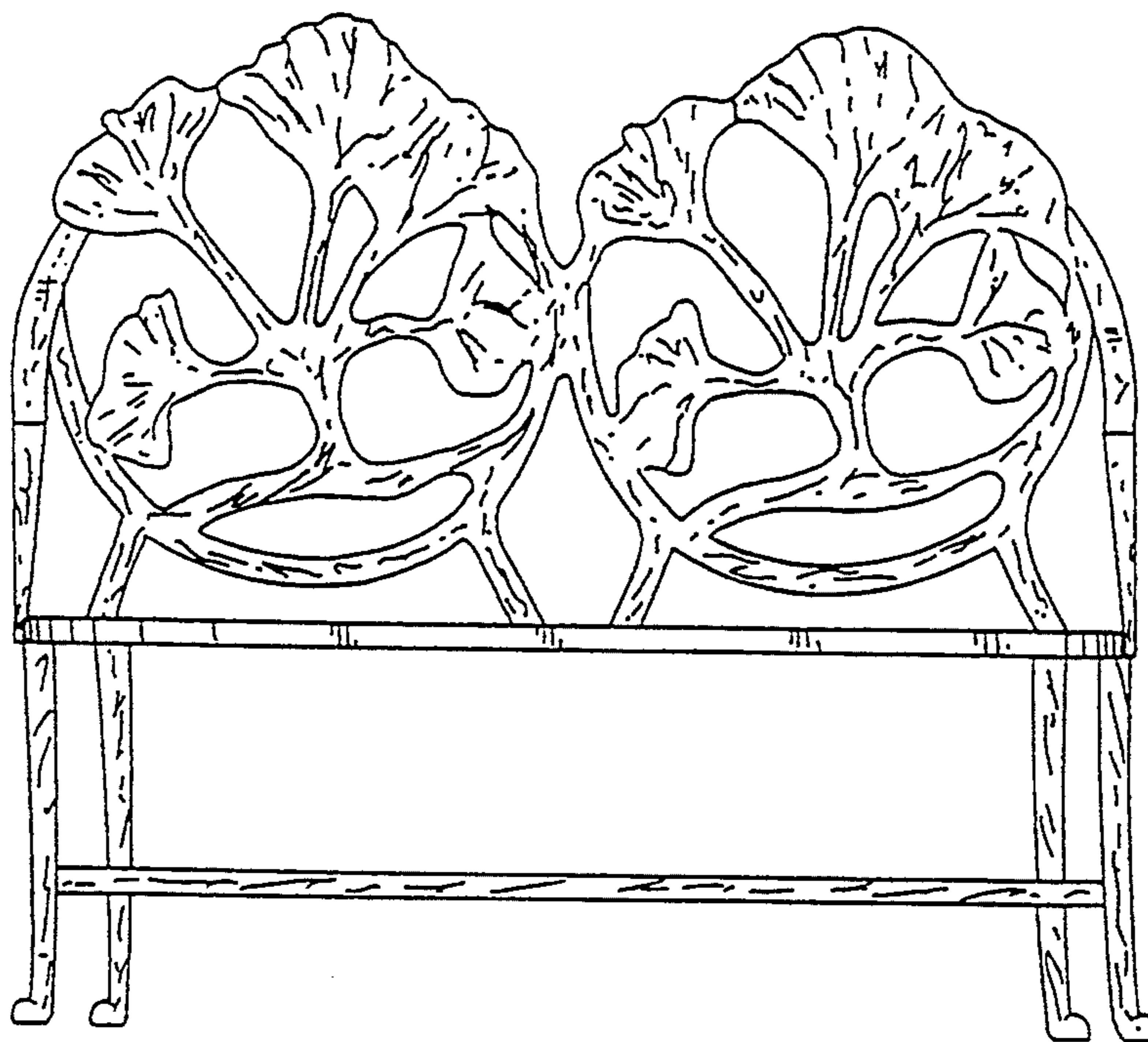

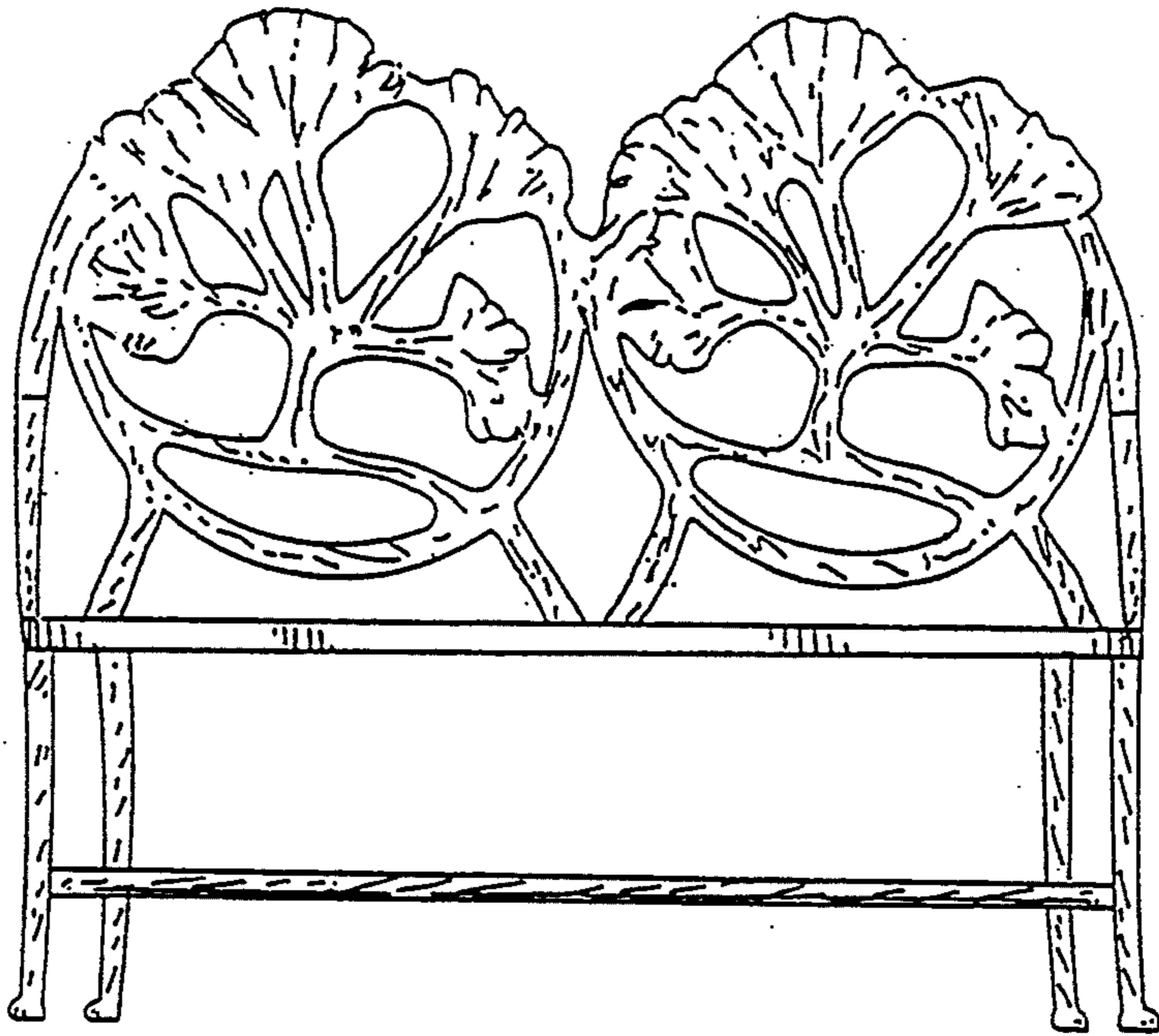

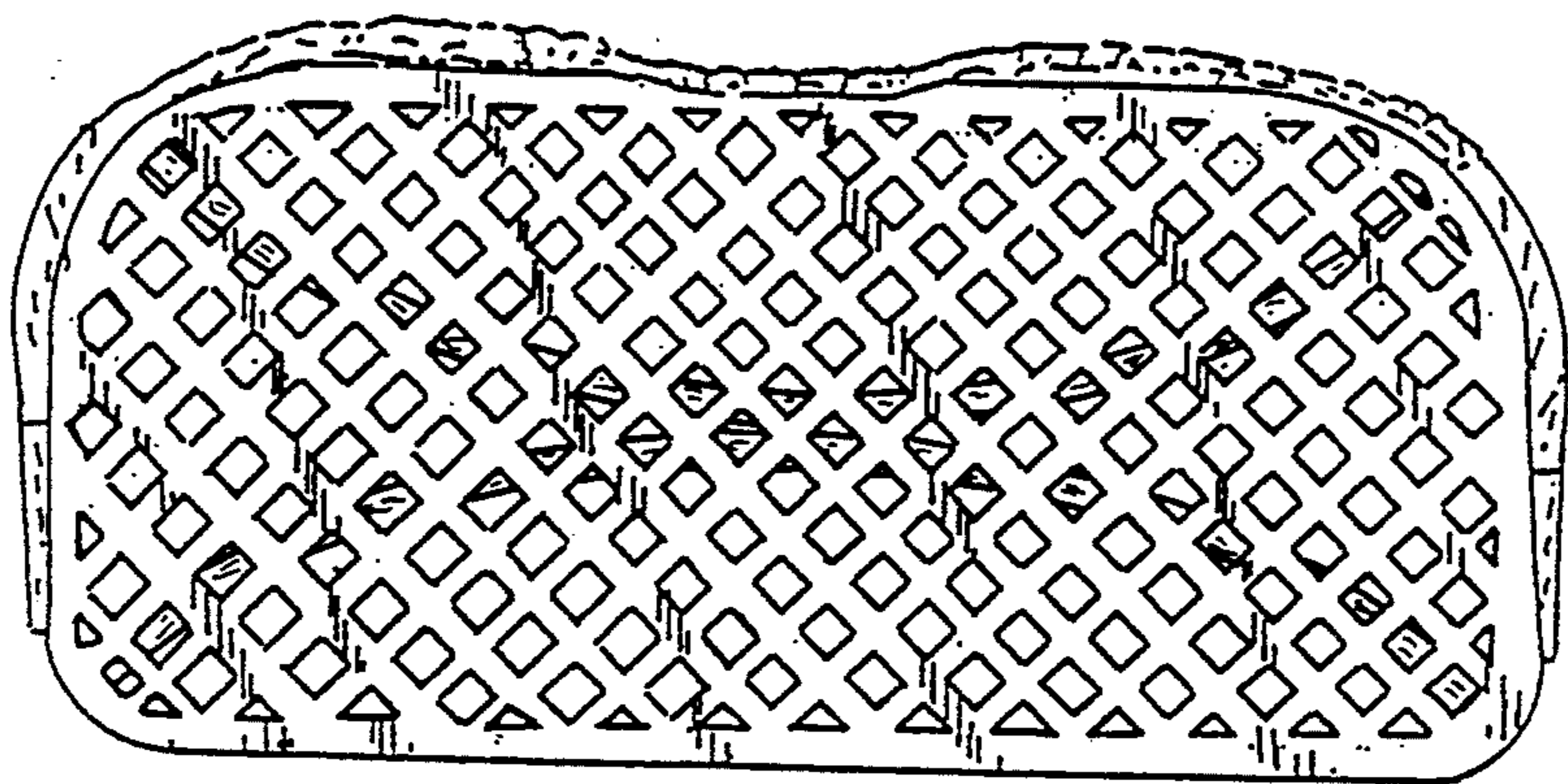

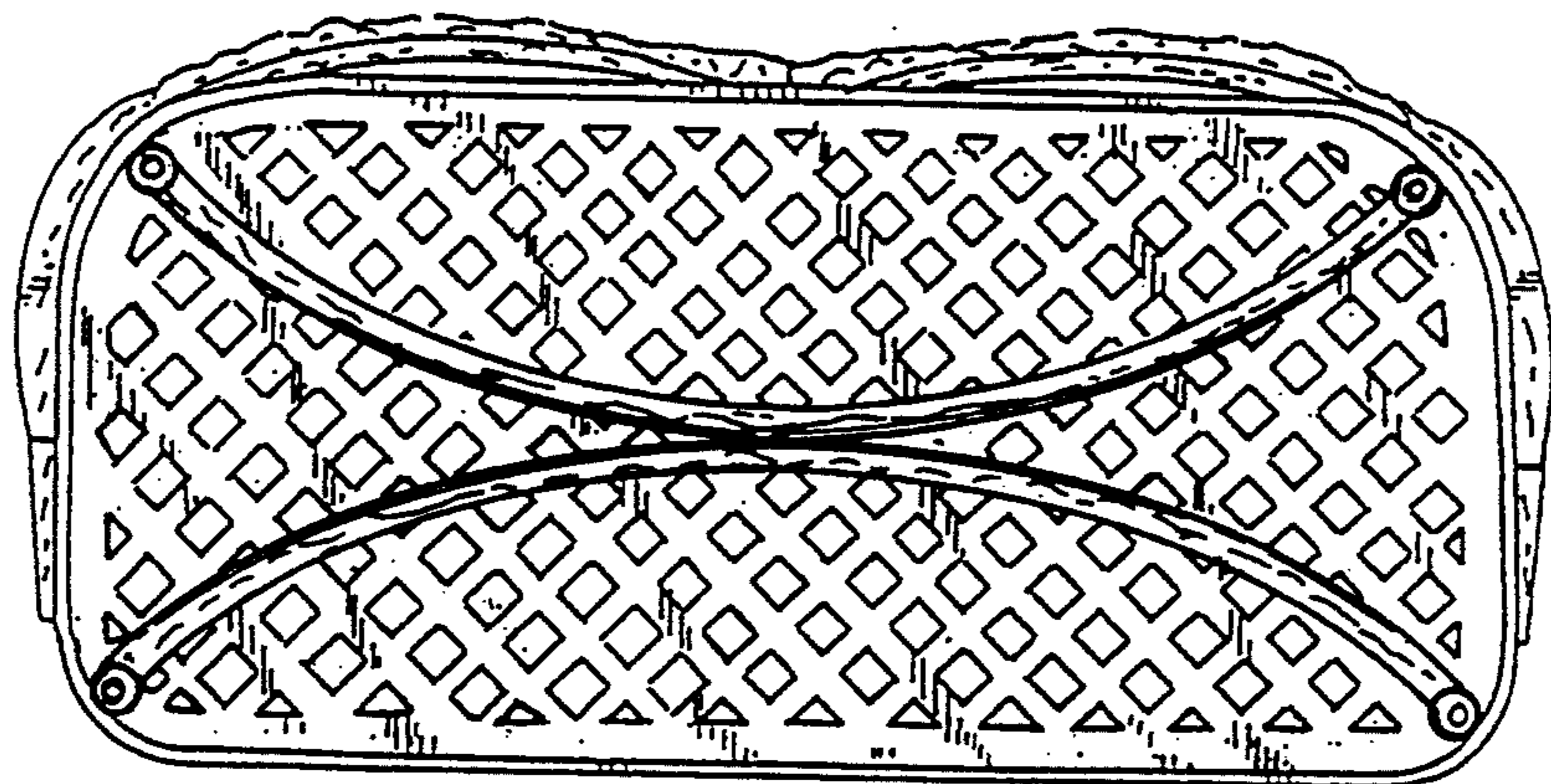

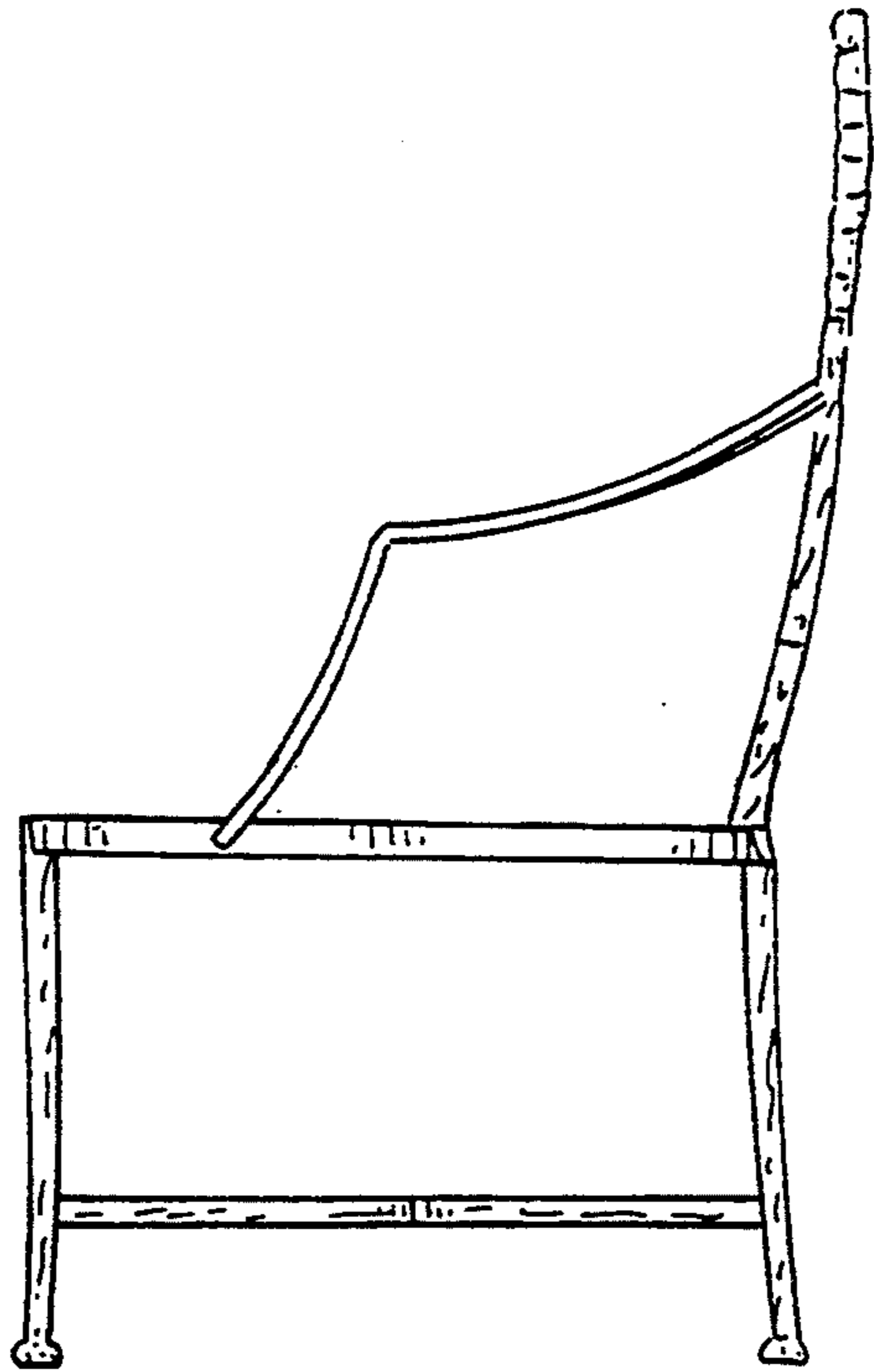

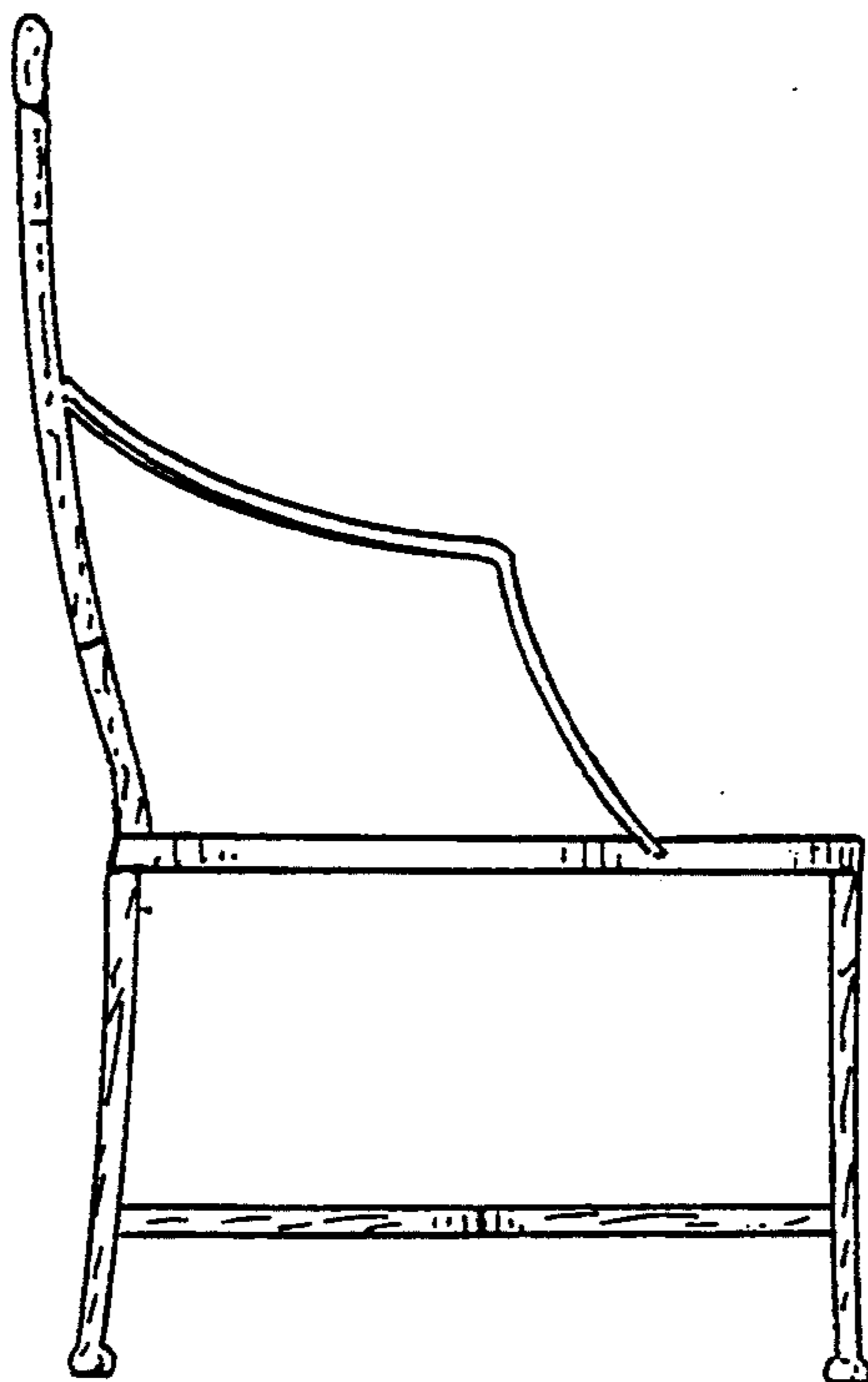
