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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combination multimedia storage case and removable inserts, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combination multimedia storage case and removable inserts showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a reduced perspective view thereof shown in an open position;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of FIG. 7, the inserts being removed; and,

FIG. 9 is an enlarged top plan view of FIG. 8 in a closed position.

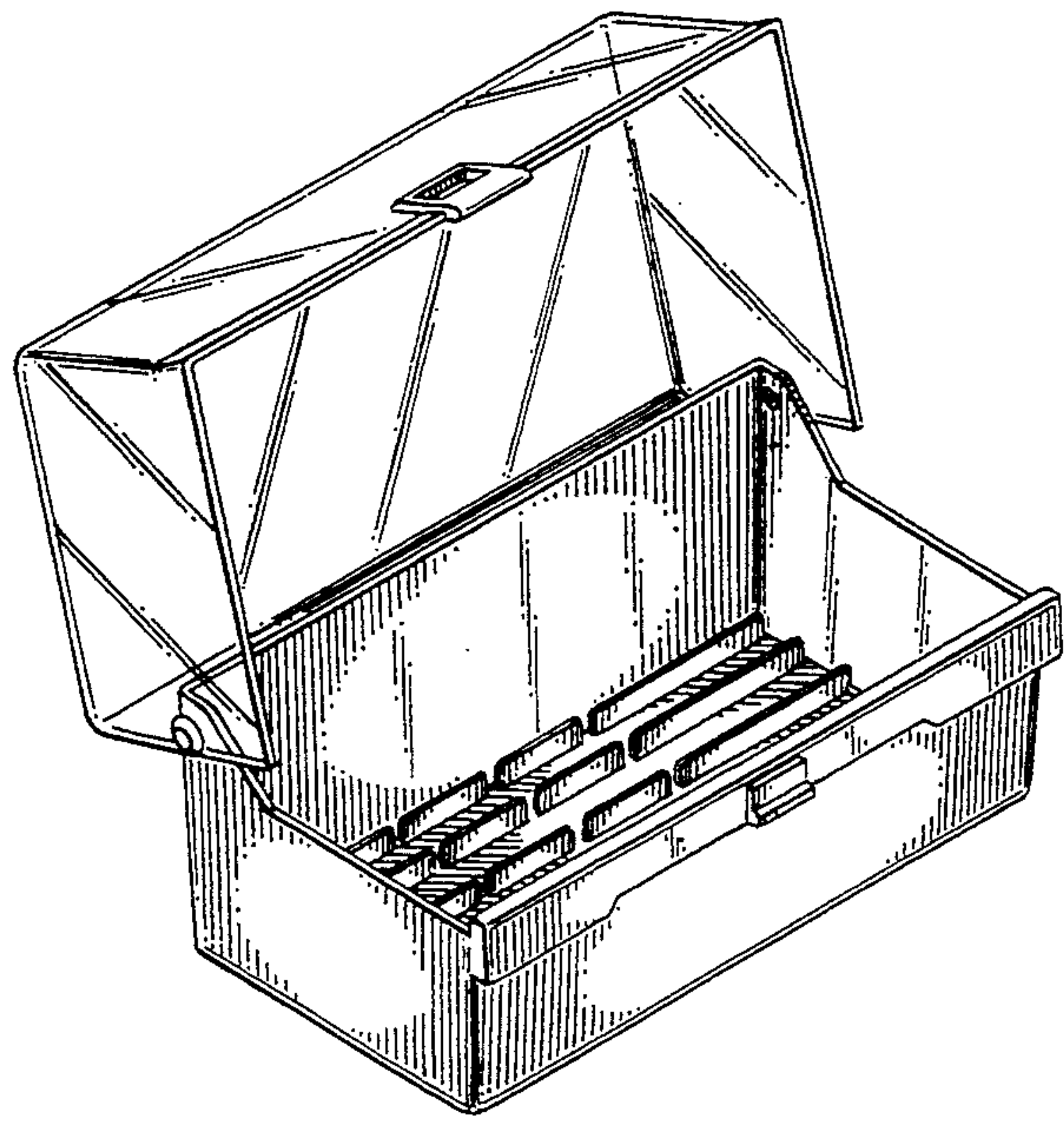
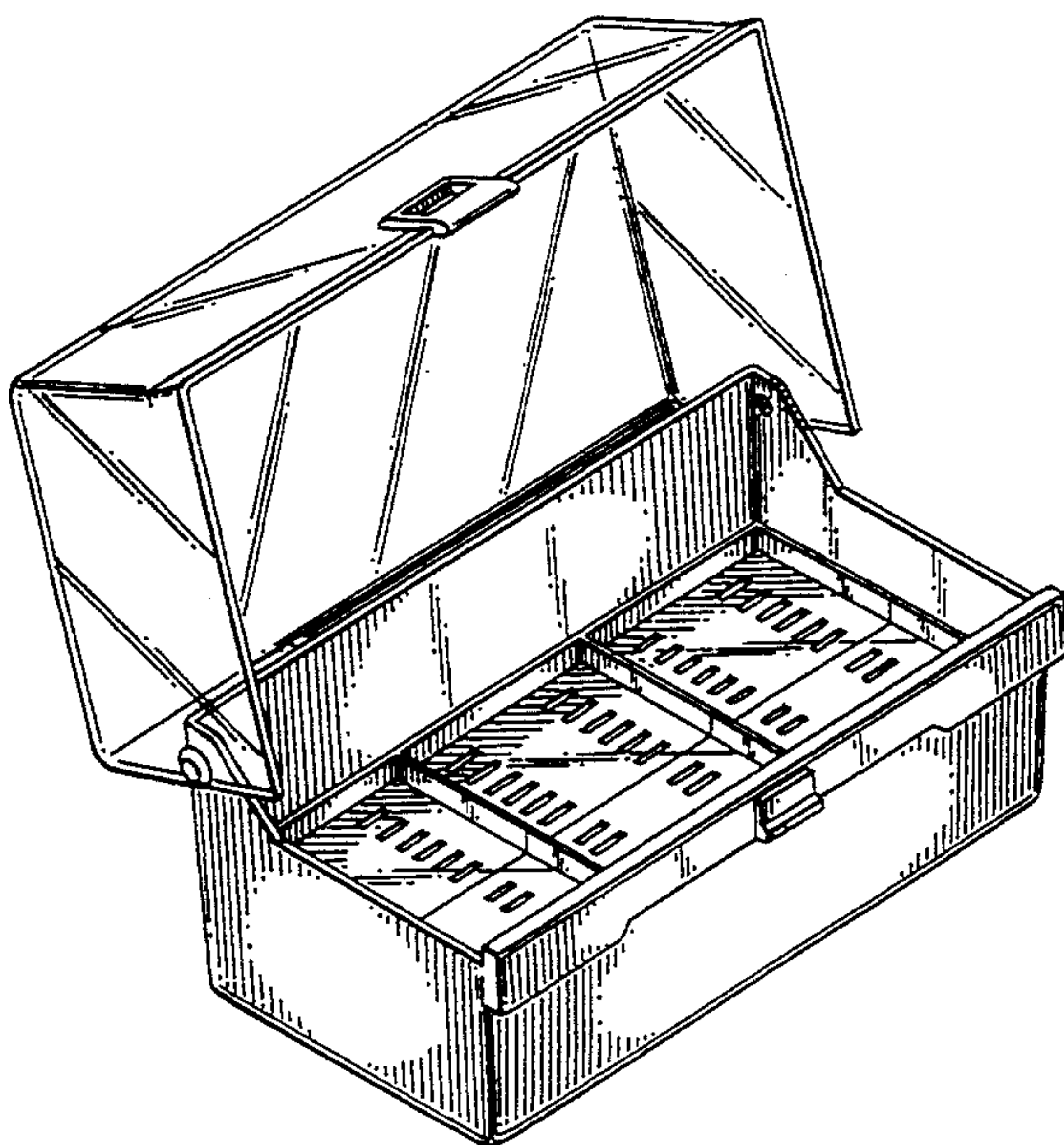

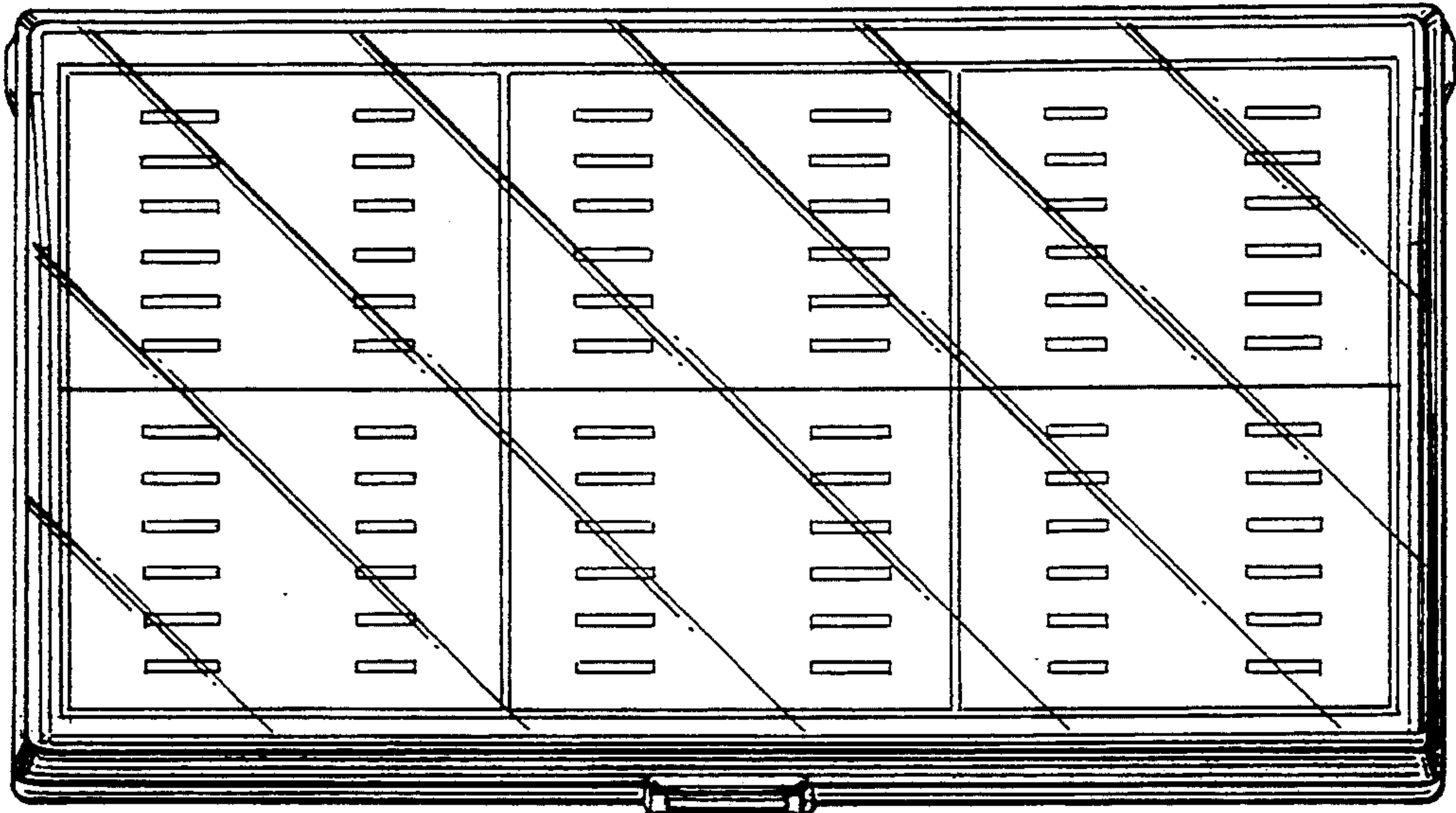

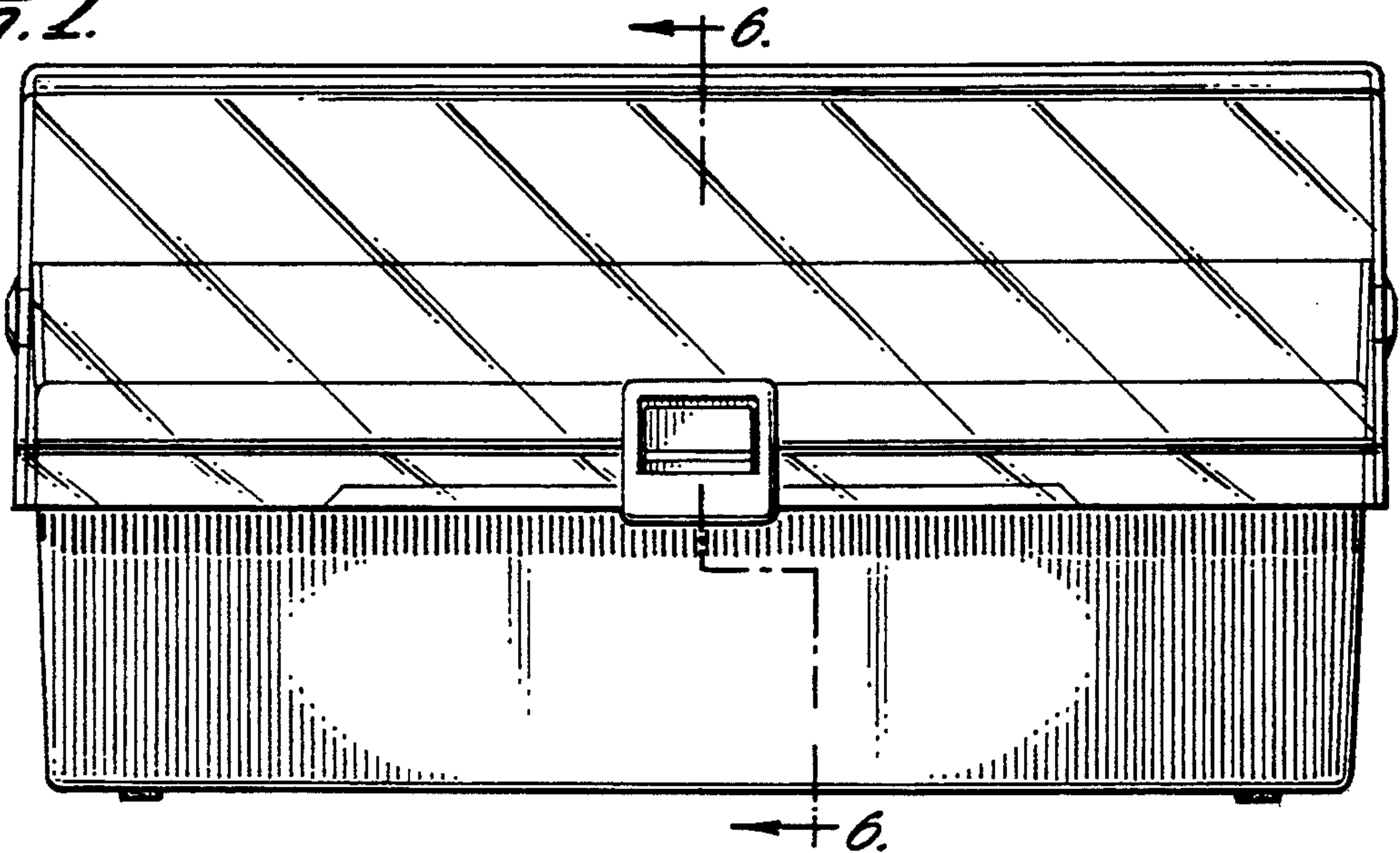

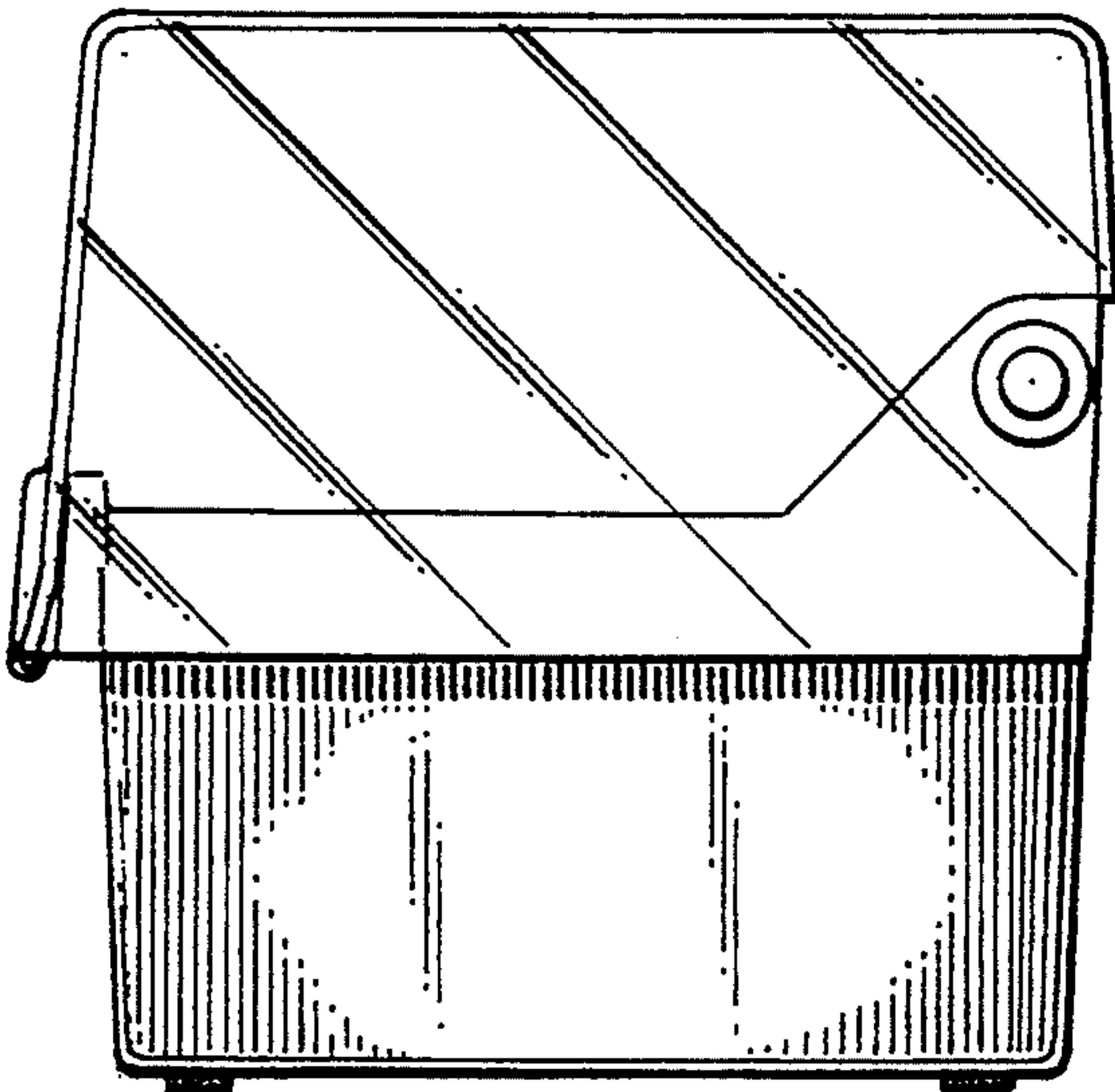

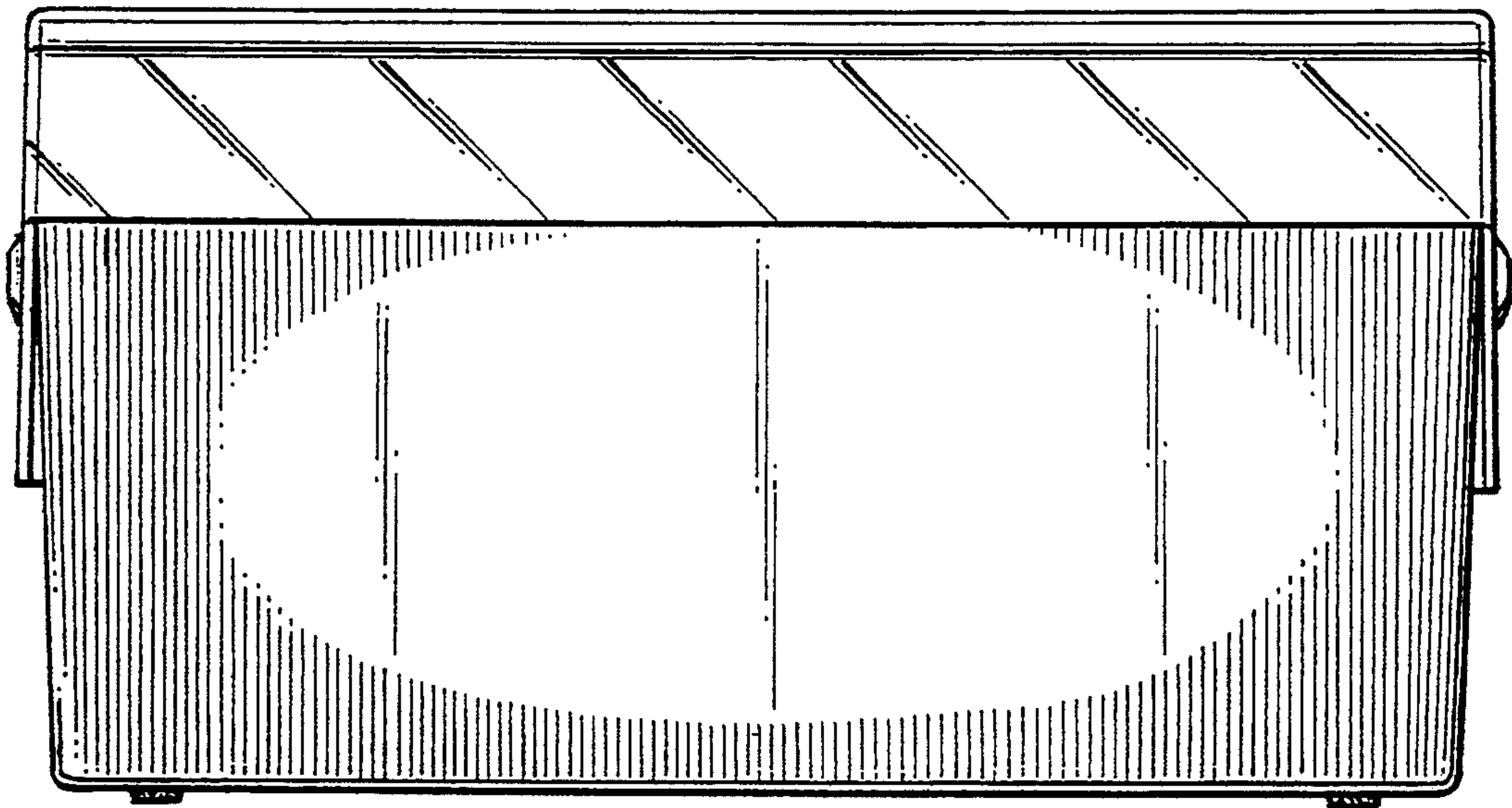

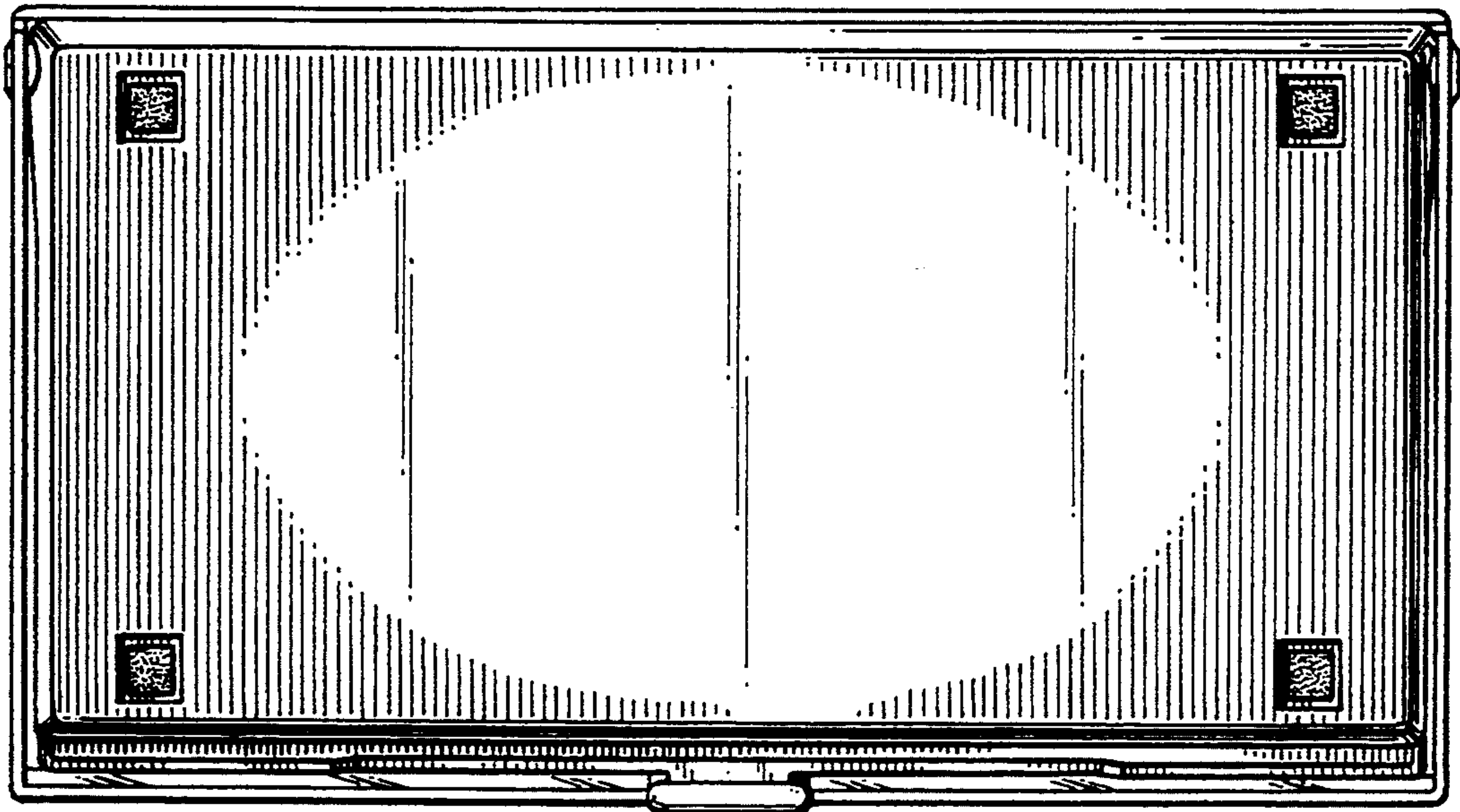

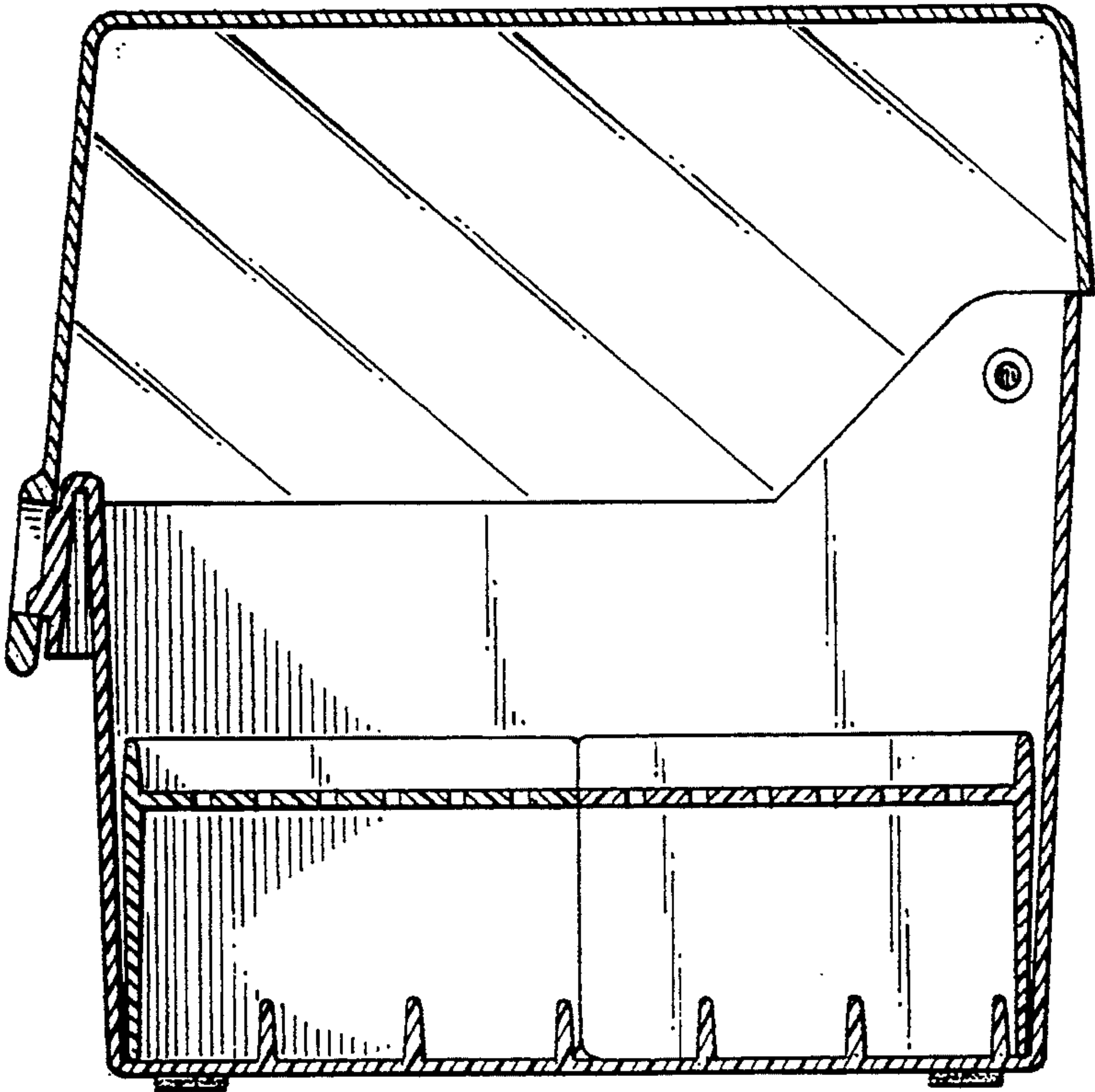

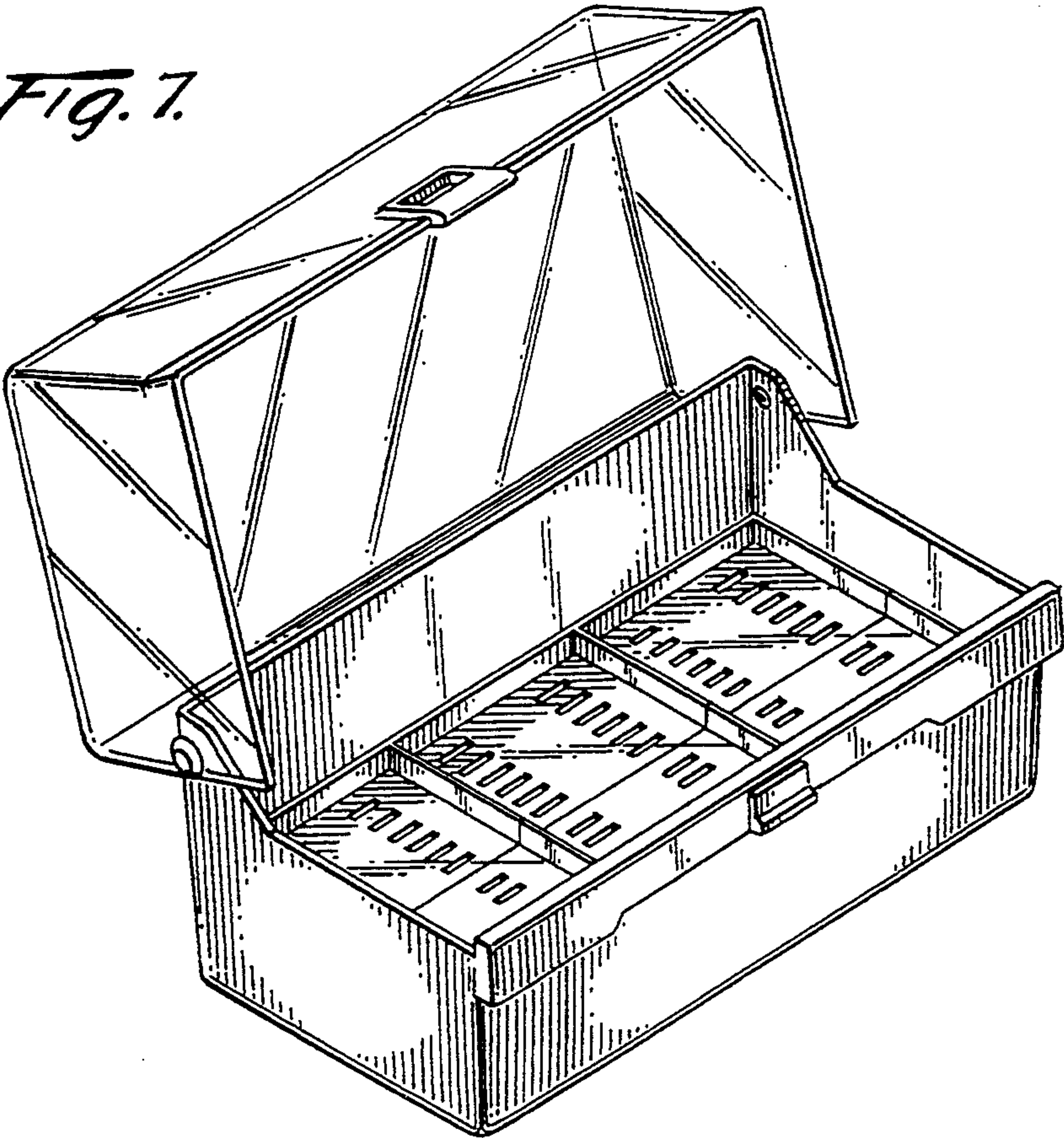

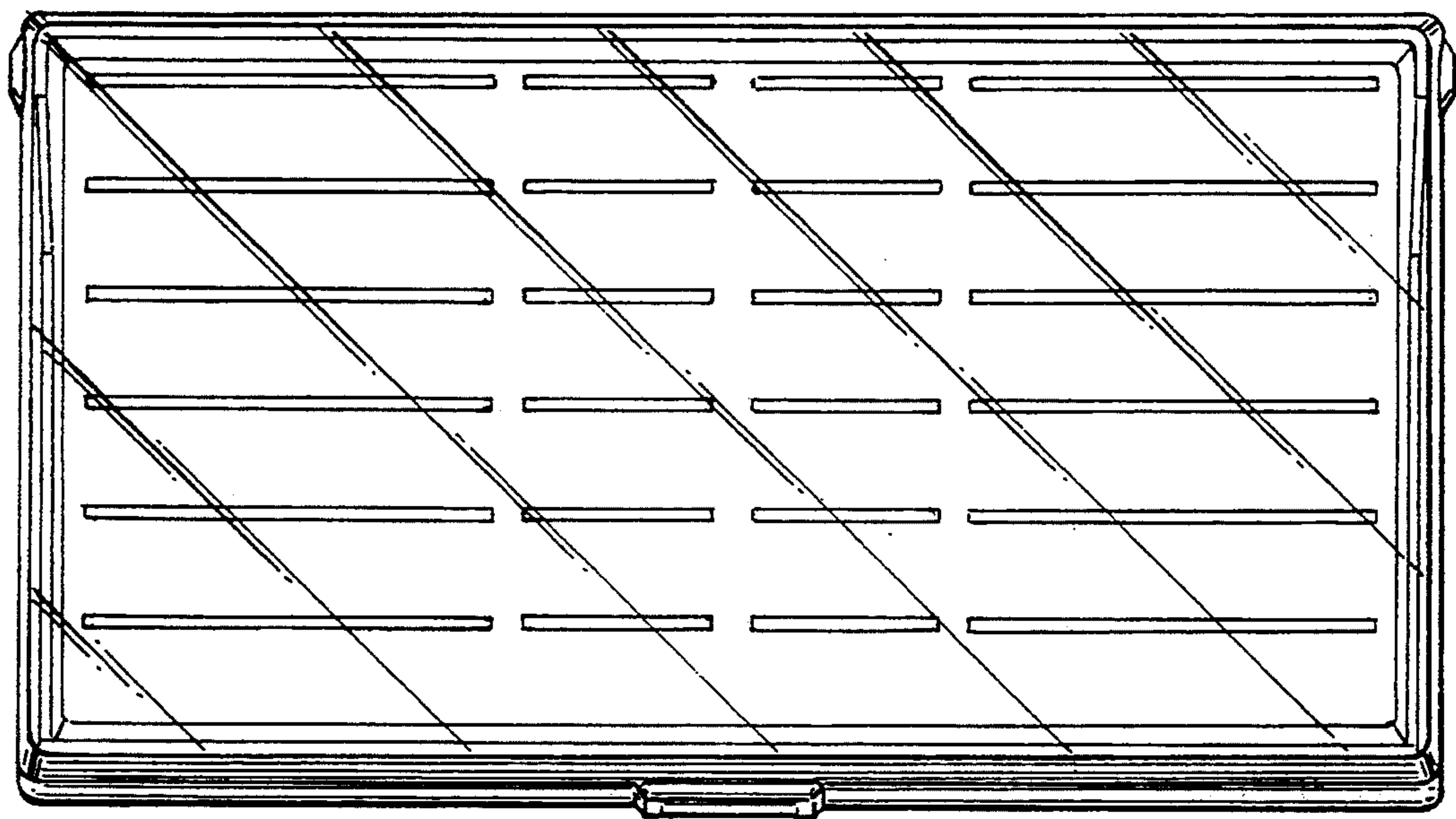
