### CLAIM

The ornamental design for a guitar pick holder, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced front perspective view of a guitar pick holder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of my first embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 3 is an end elevation view of my first embodiment of my pick holder with the other end view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of my first embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of my first embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of my first embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 7 is a reduced front perspective view of a second embodiment of the guitar pick holder;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of my second embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 9 is a an end elevation view of my second embodiment of my pick holder with the other end view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 10 is a front elevation view of my second embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of my second embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 12 is a rear elevation view of my second embodiment of my pick holder;

FIG. 13 is a reduced front perspective view of the third embodiment of the guitar pick holder;

FIG. 14 is a top plan view of my third embodiment of my pick holder;


FIG. 15 is an end elevation view of my third embodiment of my pick holder with the other end view being a mirror image thereof;

The broken lines showing the guitar neck, the tuning pegs and the picks are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.









