[57] **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a chess piece head, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chess piece head, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a reduced right side elevational view thereof, the broken line showing of the base is for illustrative purposes only, and forms no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 3 is a reduced top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a reduced front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a reduced left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a reduced rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a reduced bottom plan view thereof.














