DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a telephone handset showing our new design wherein its adjustable extendable portion is retracted;
FIG. 2 is a bottom, front and left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image;
FIG. 6 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a telephone handset showing our new design wherein its adjustable extendable portion is extended;
FIG. 7 is a bottom, front and left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 10 is a right side elevation thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image.
The broken line showings in FIGS. 2 and 7 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

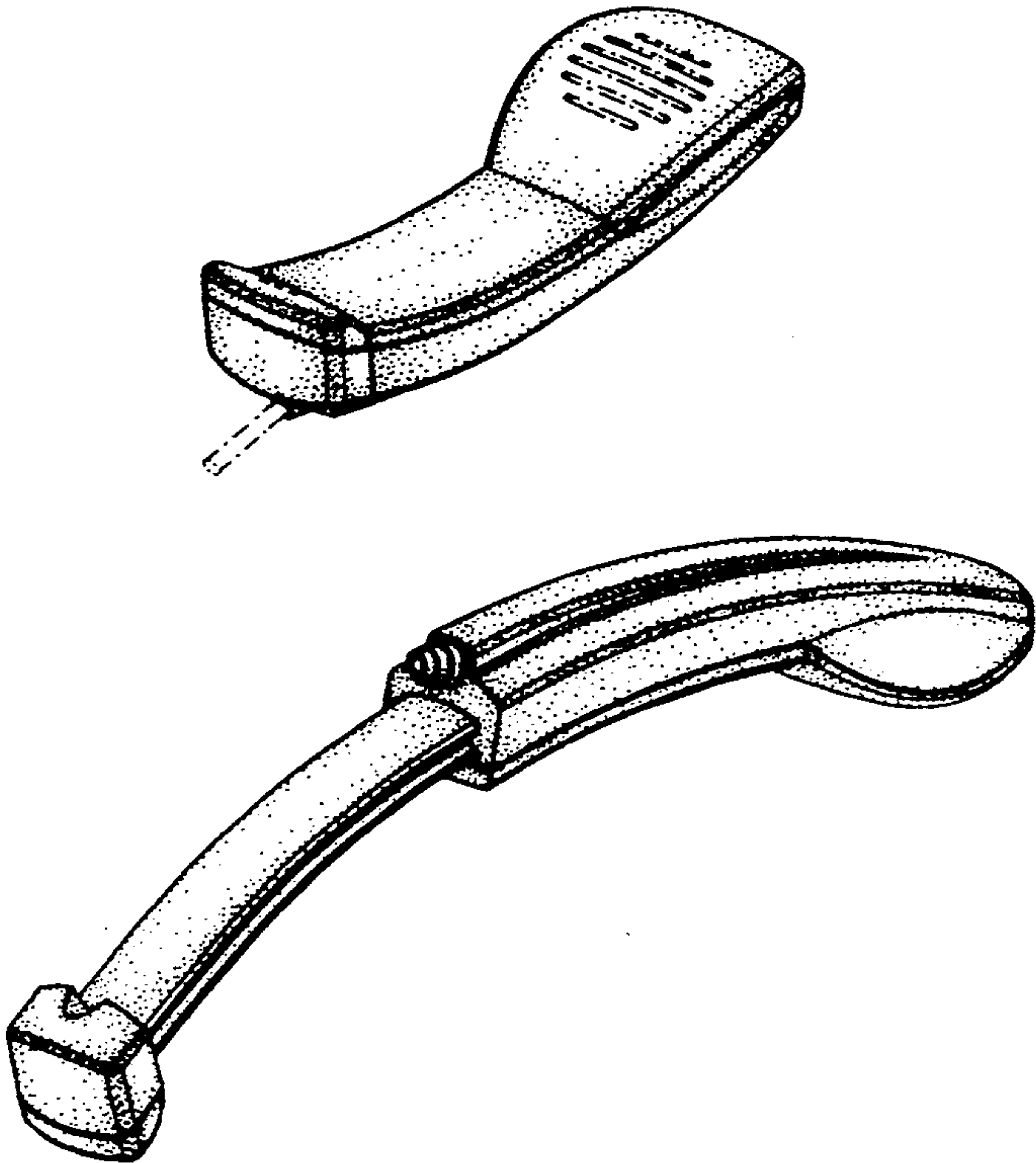

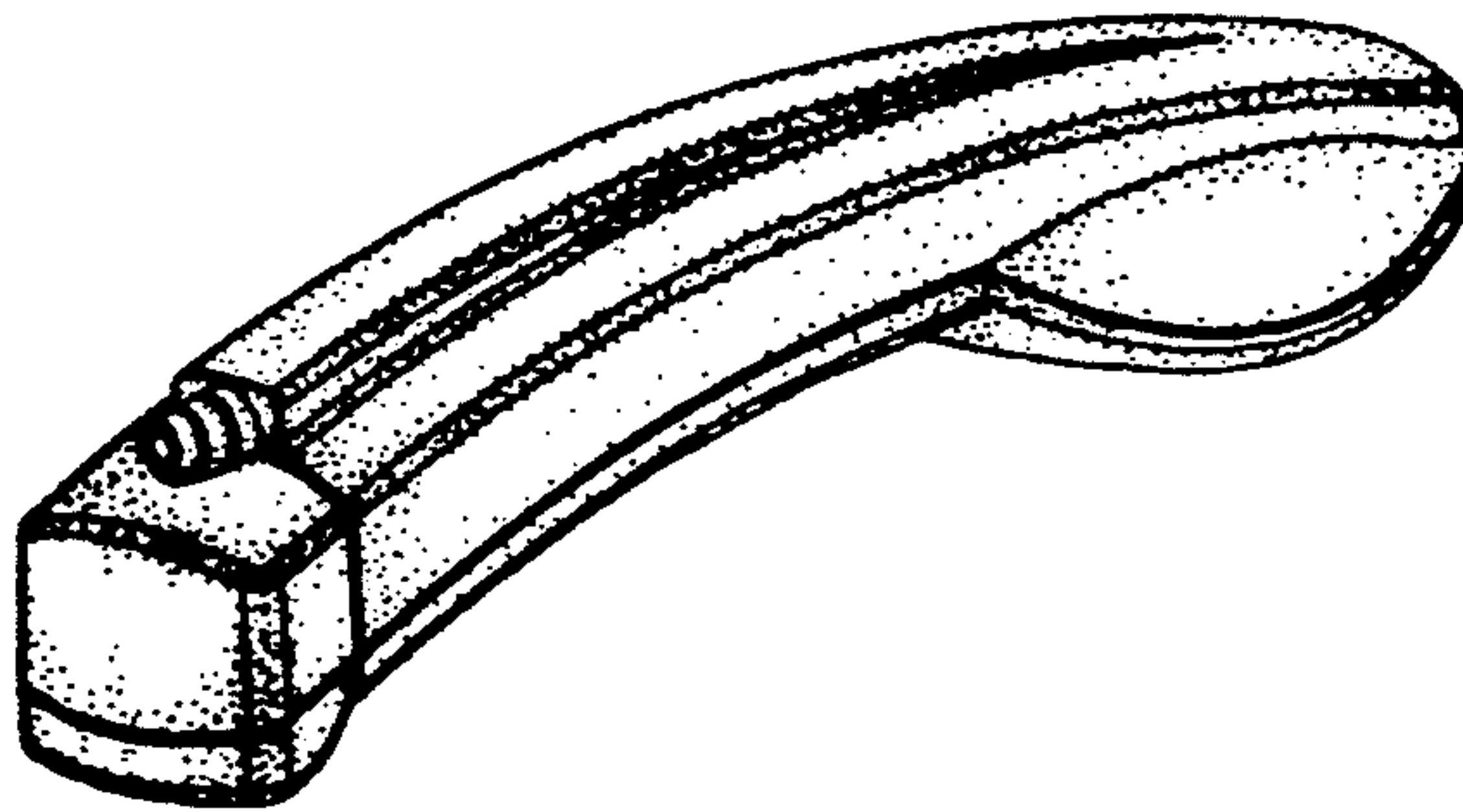

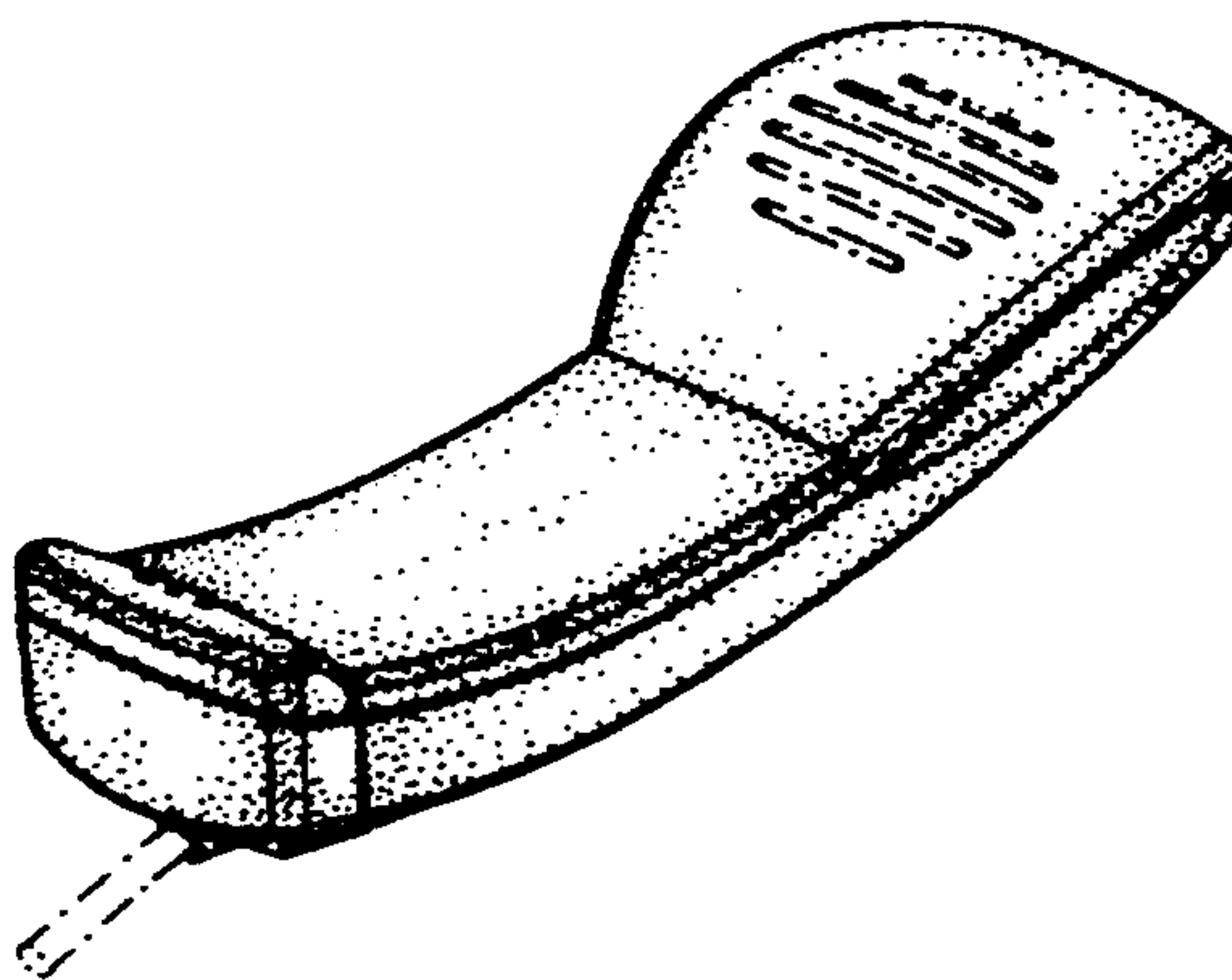

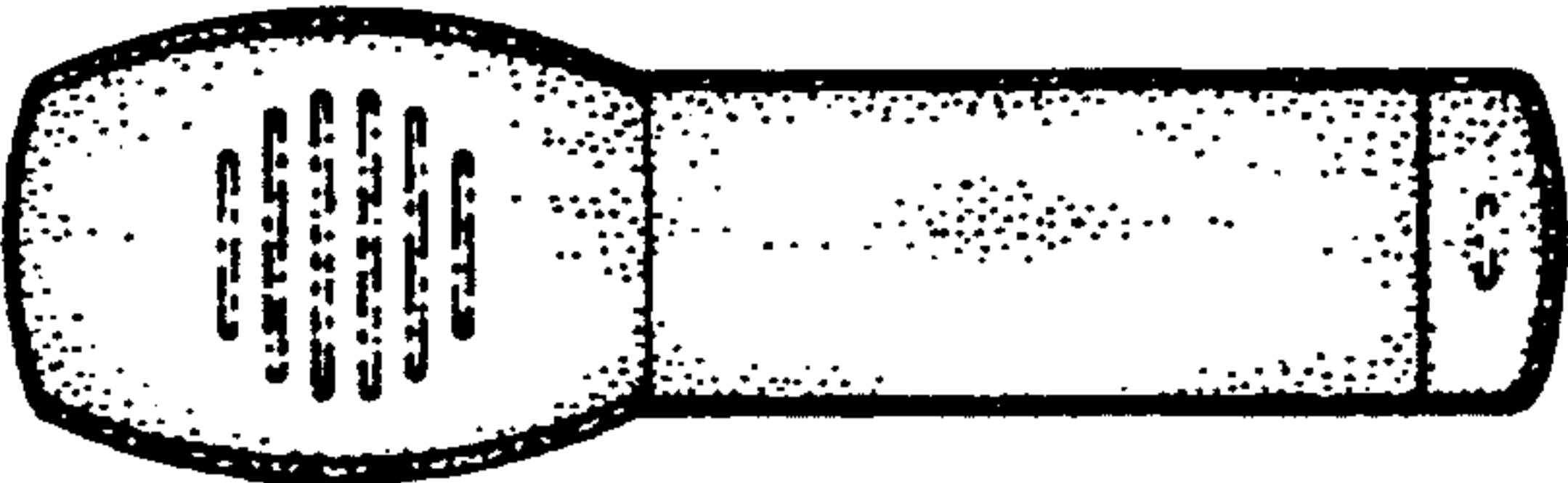

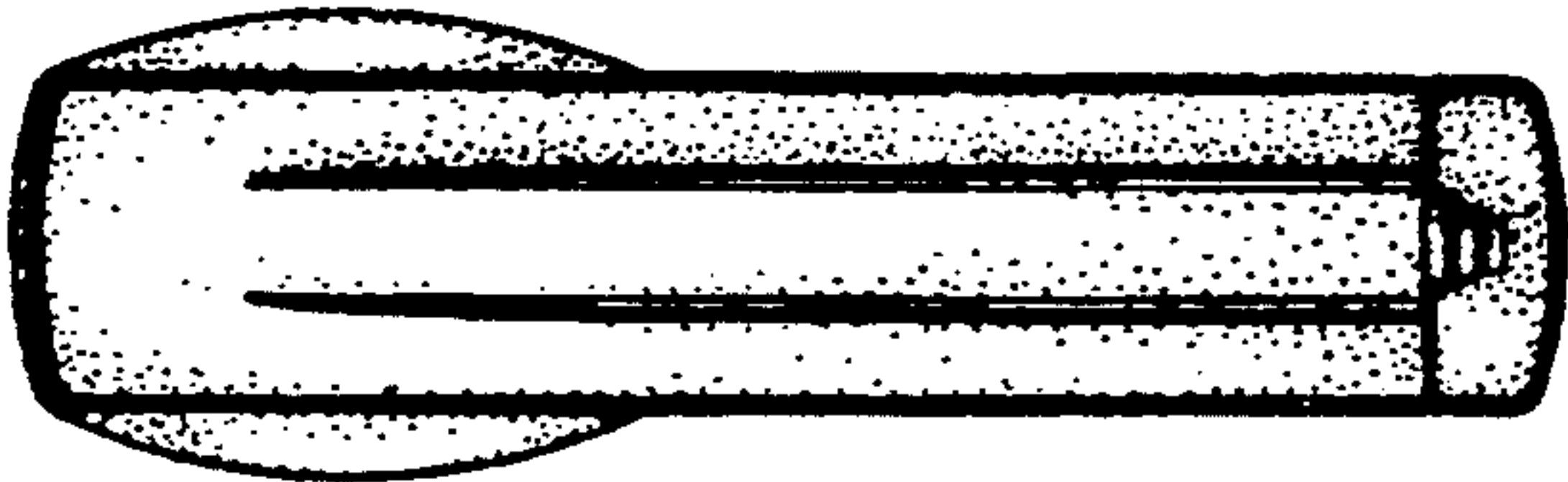

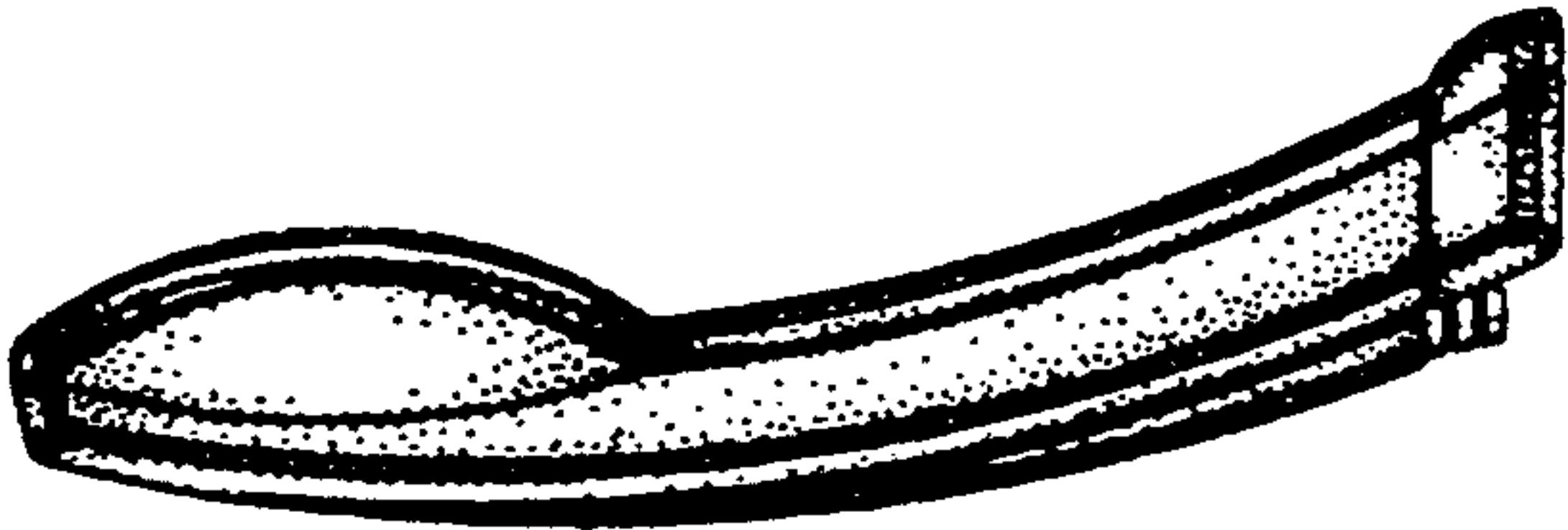

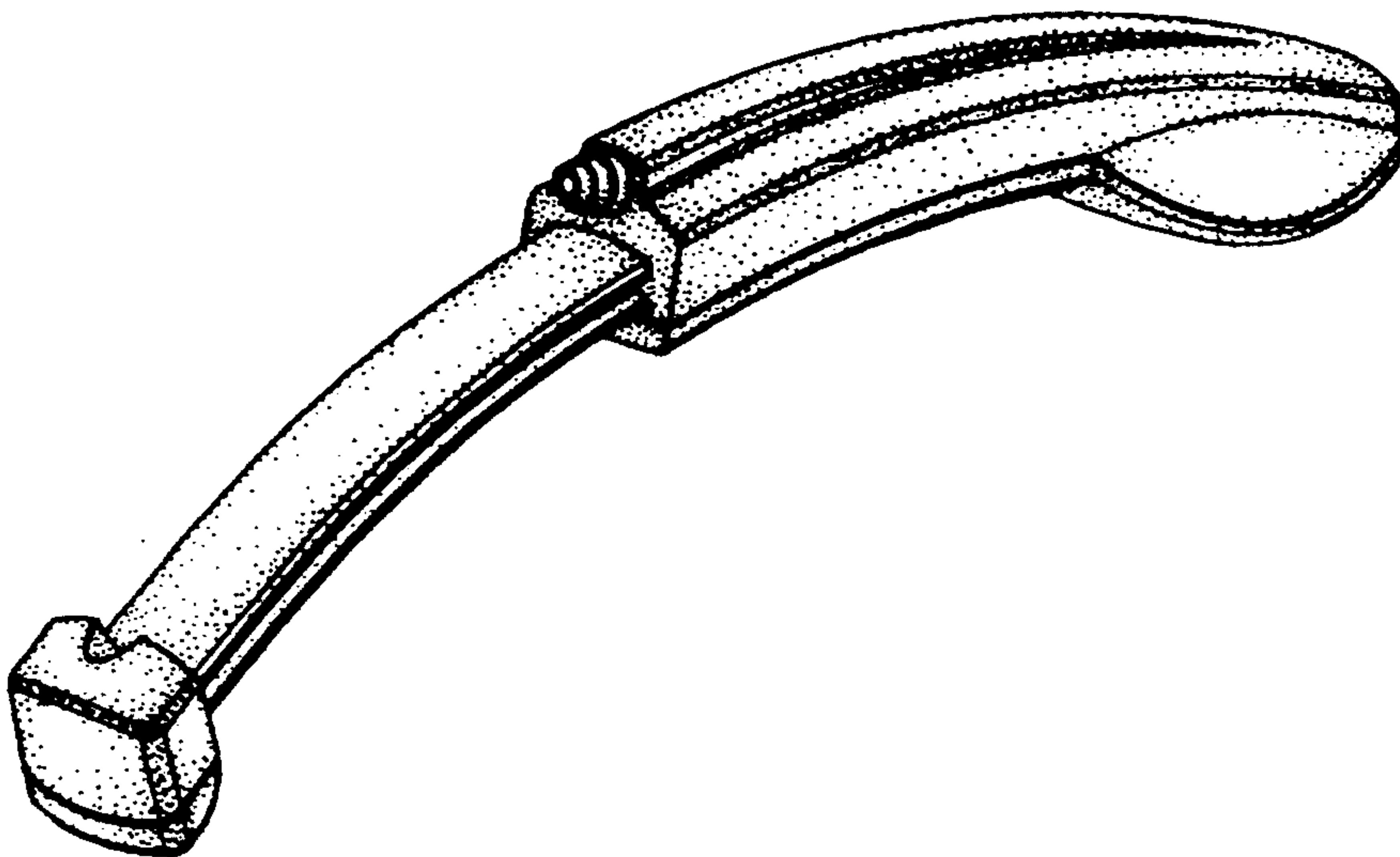

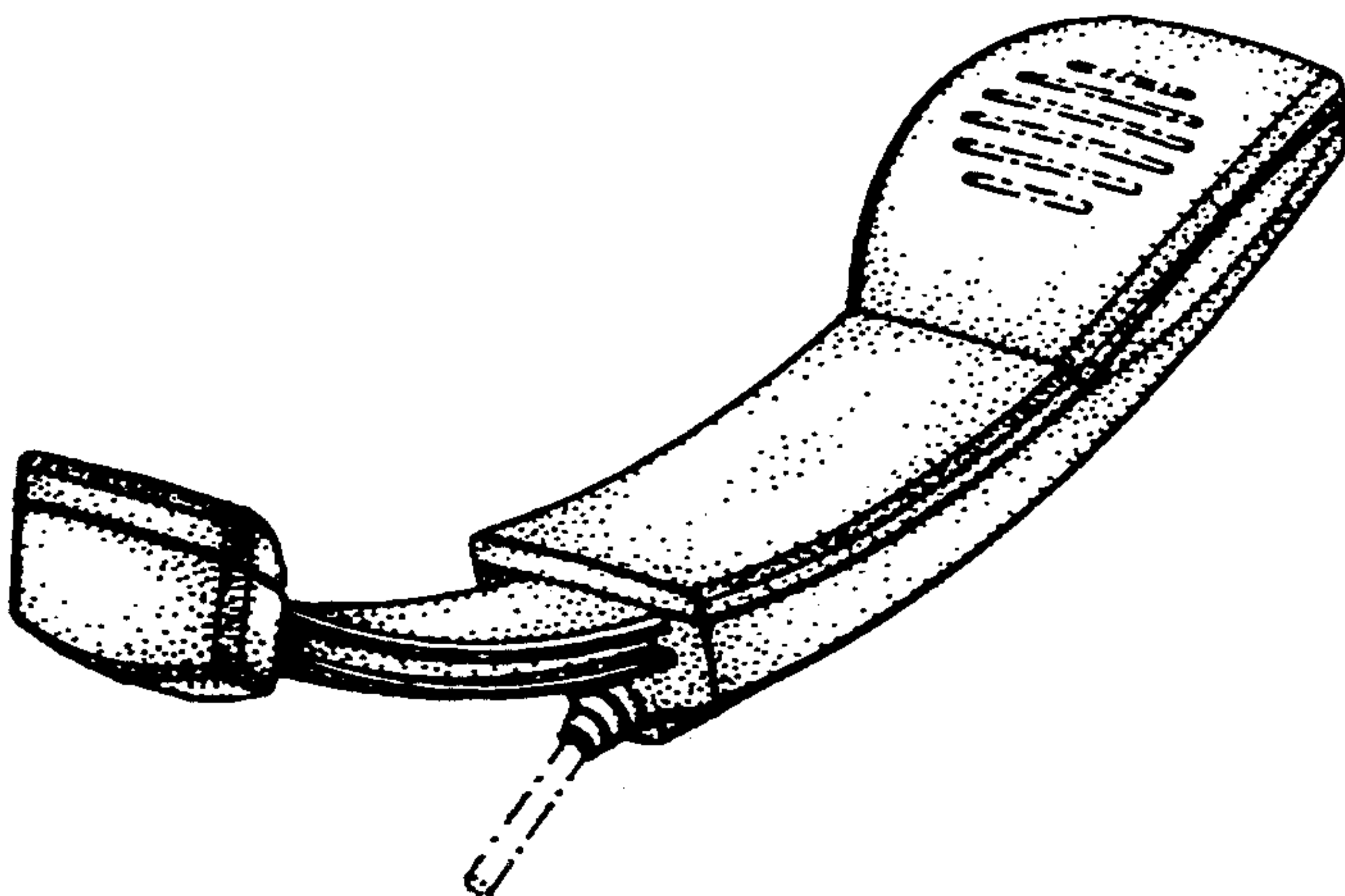

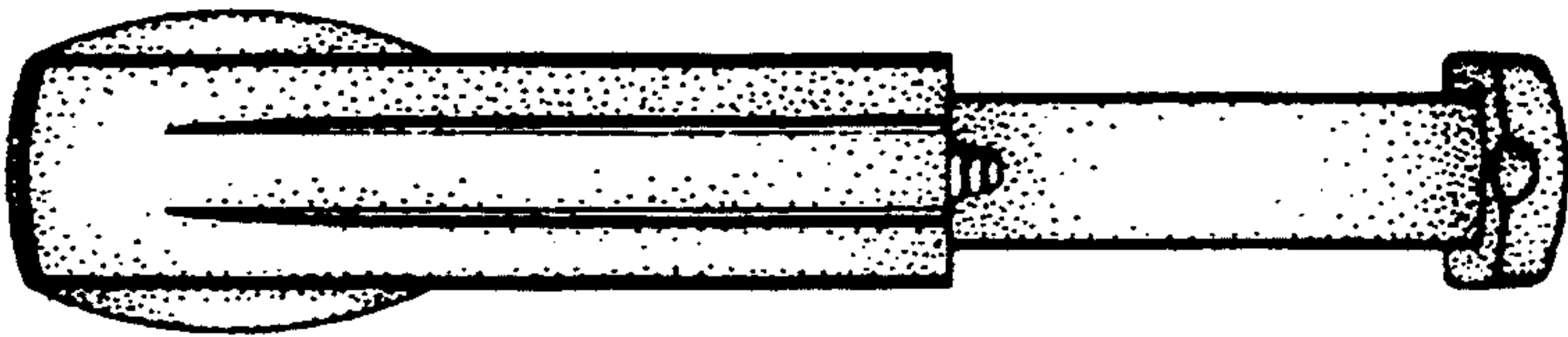
