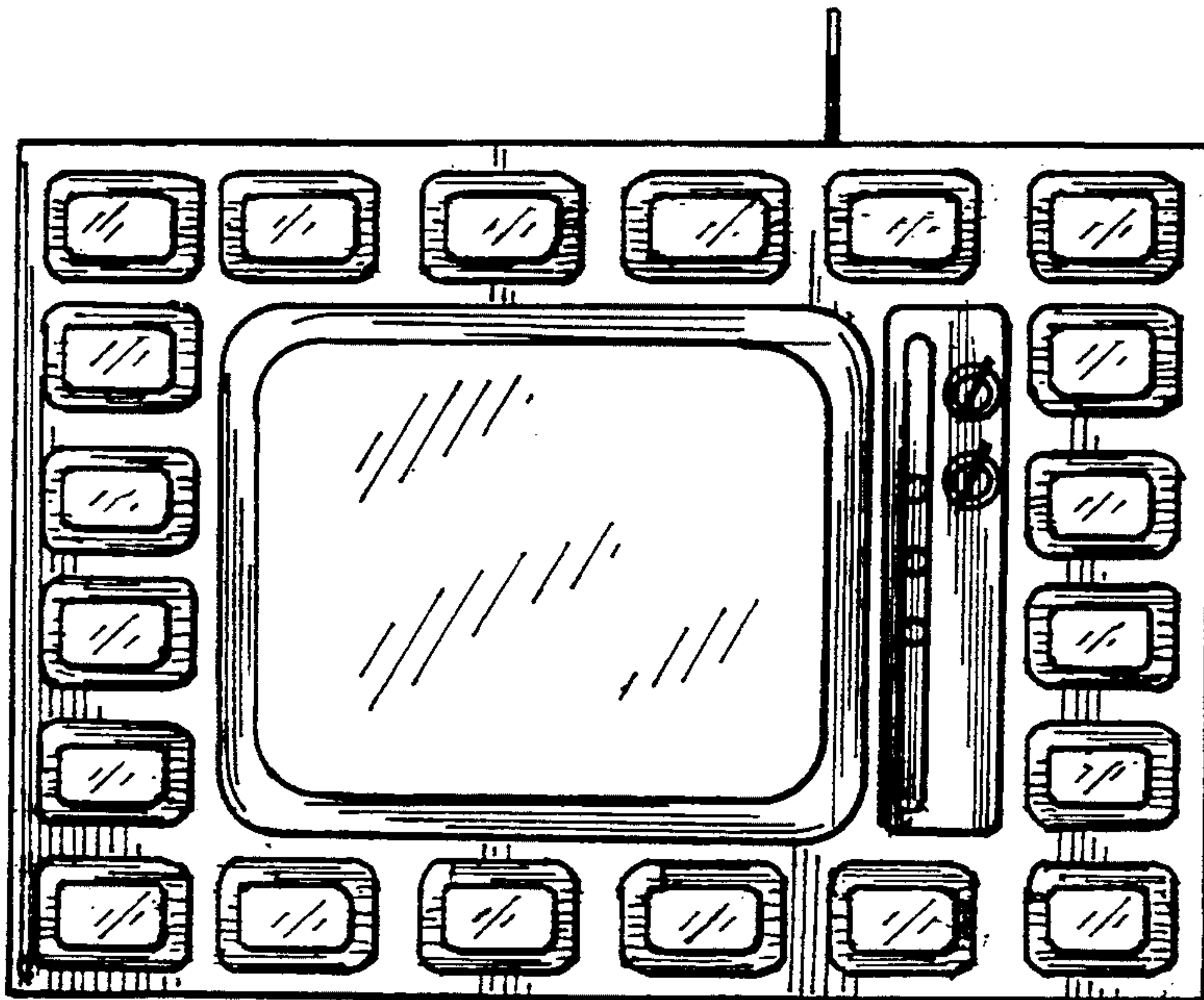
DESCRIPTION

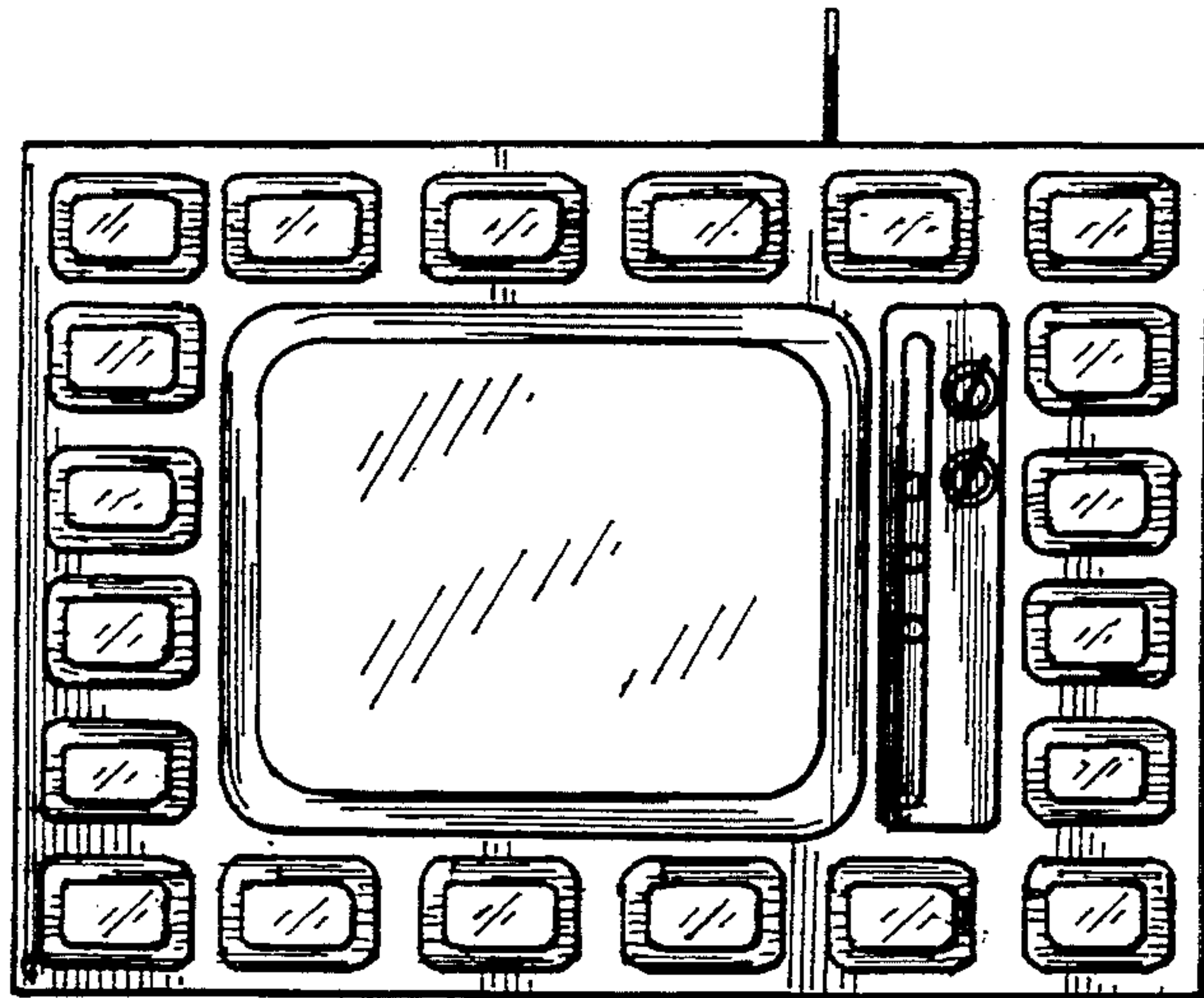

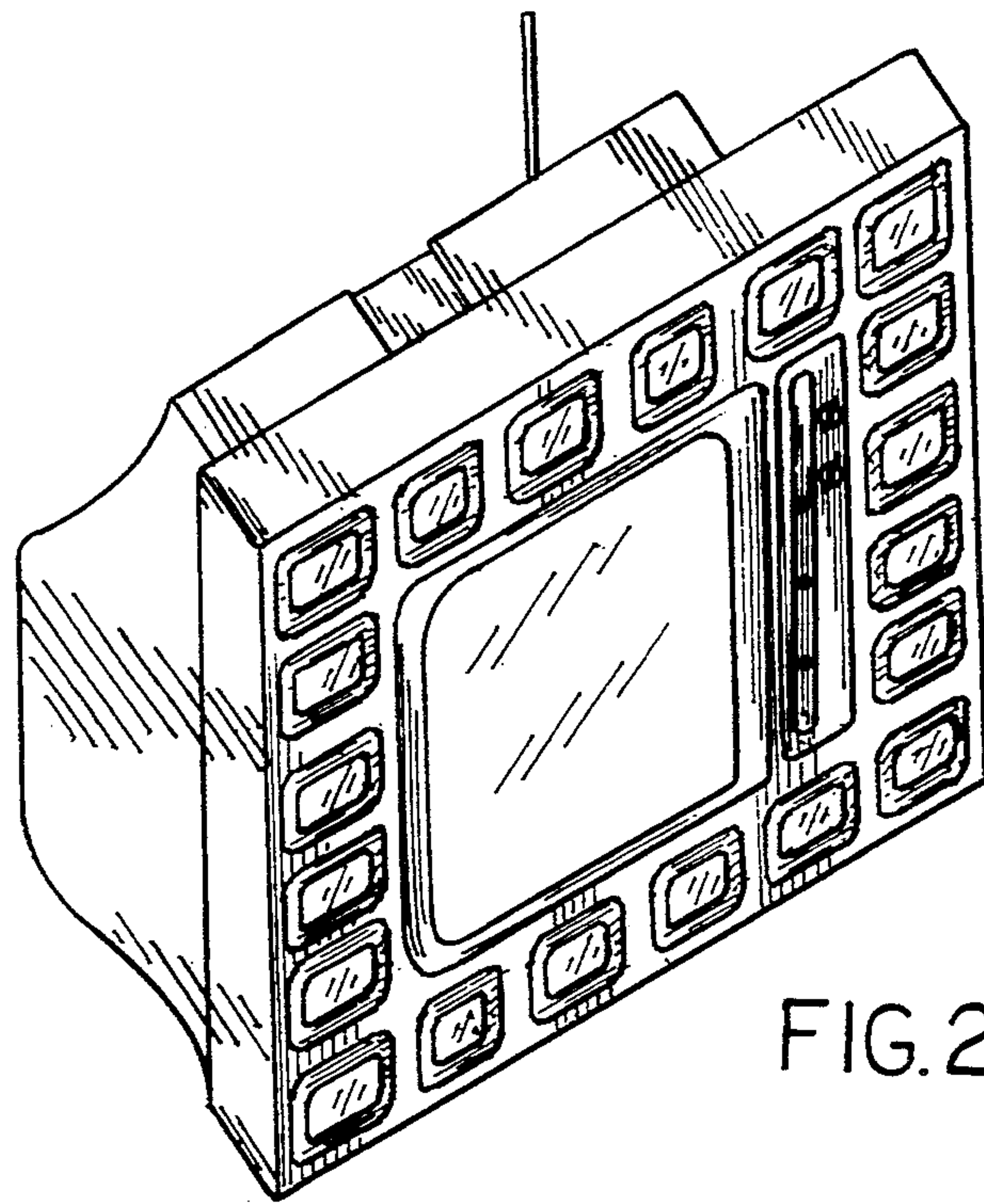

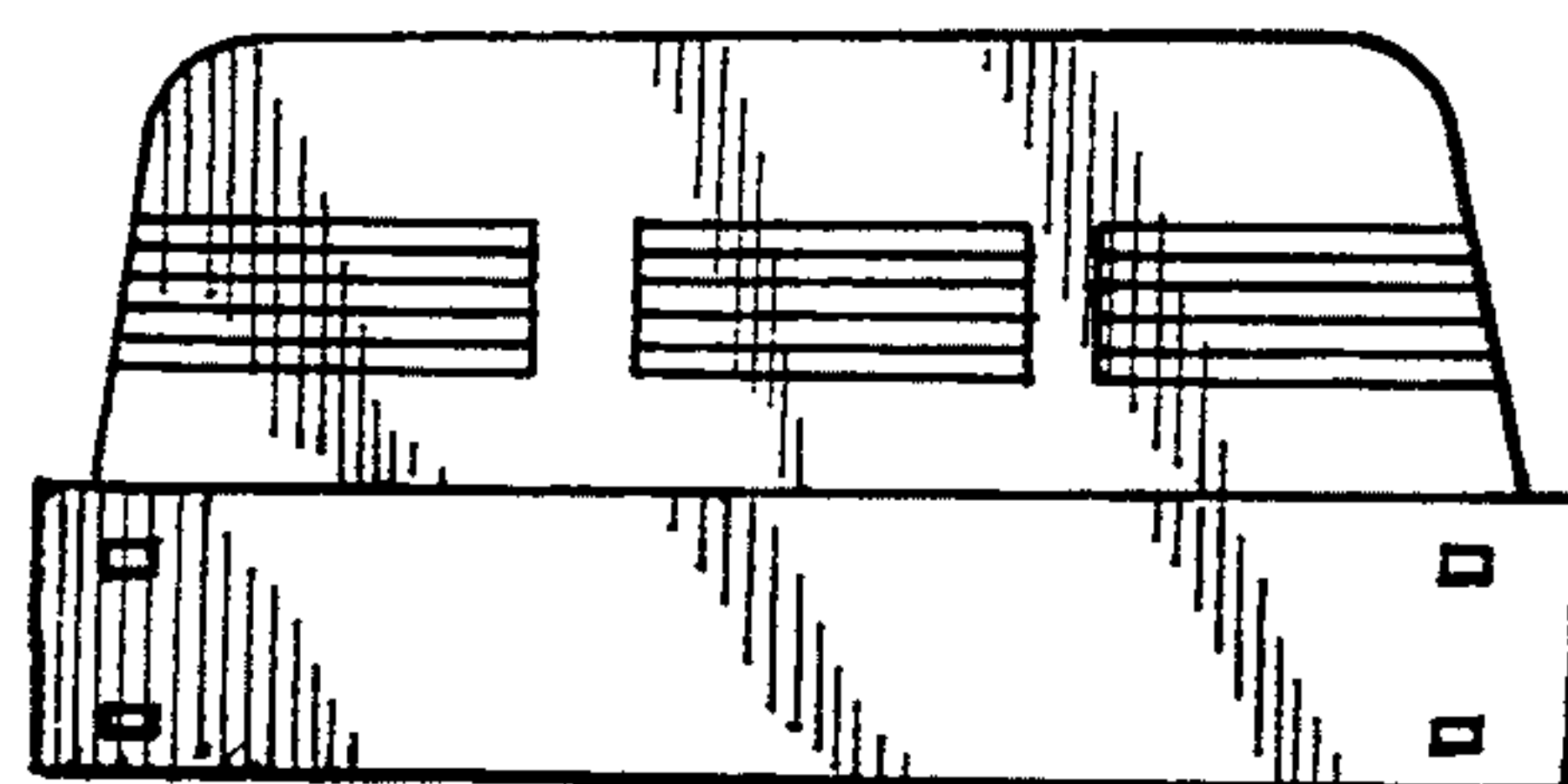

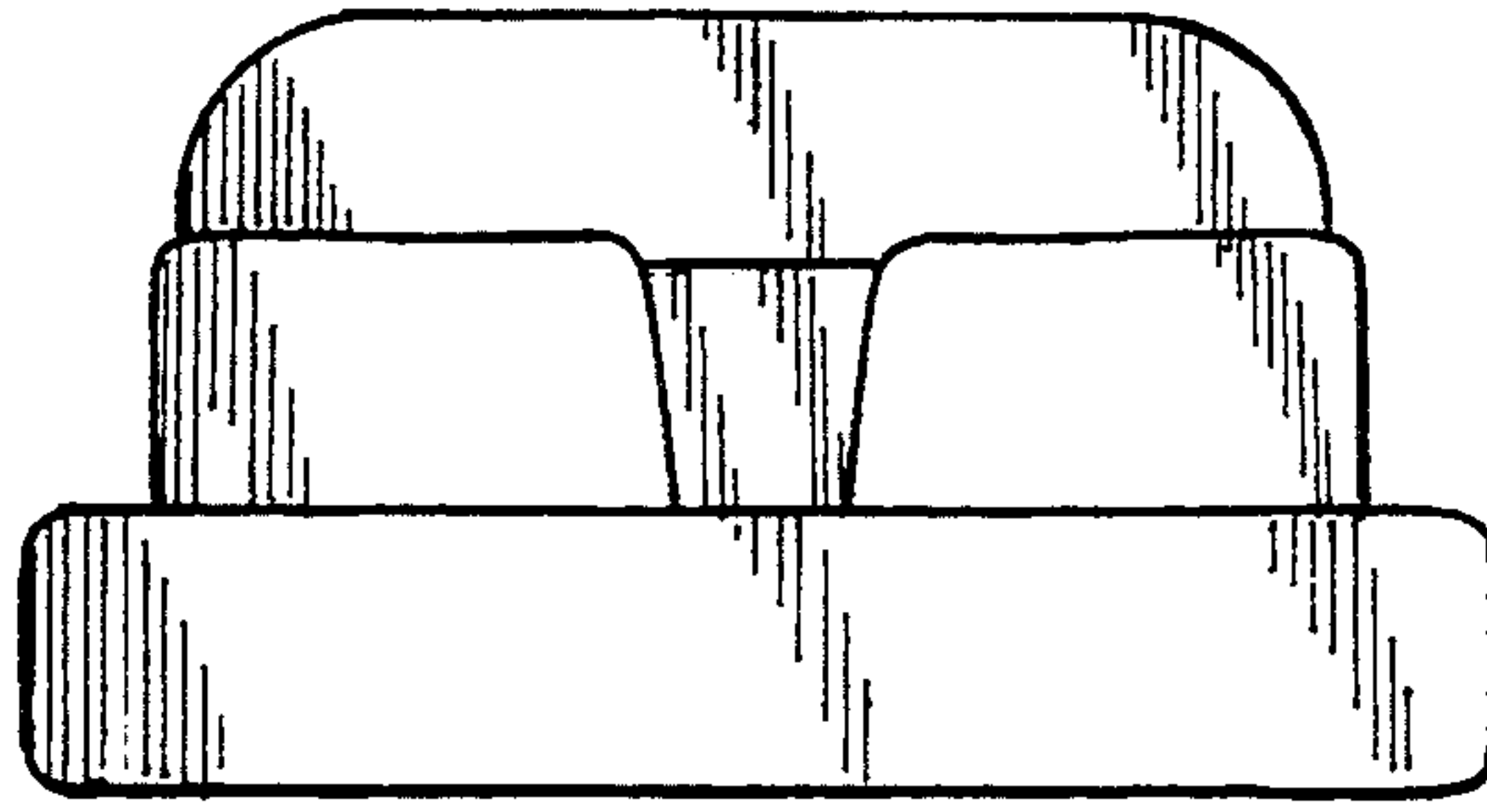

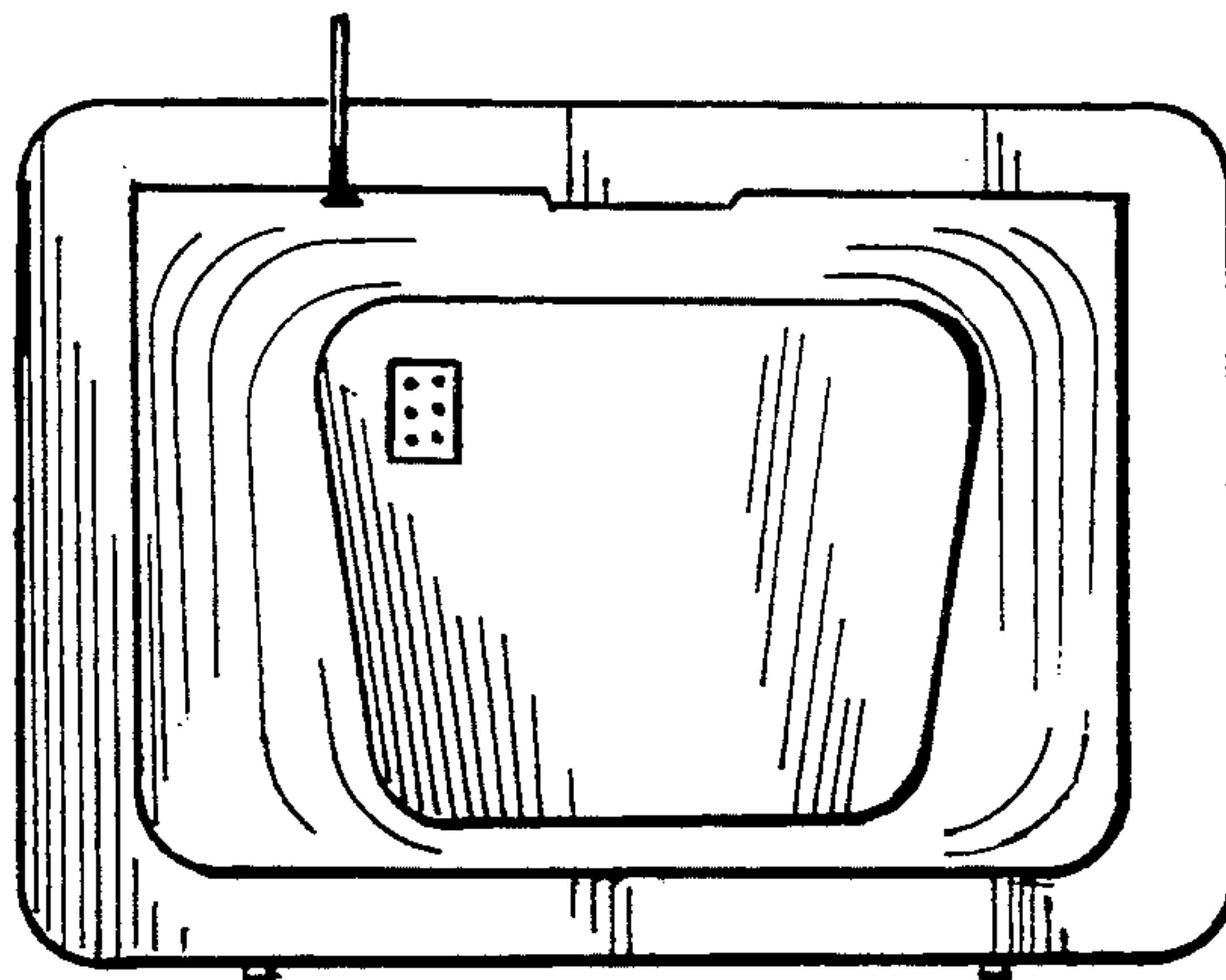

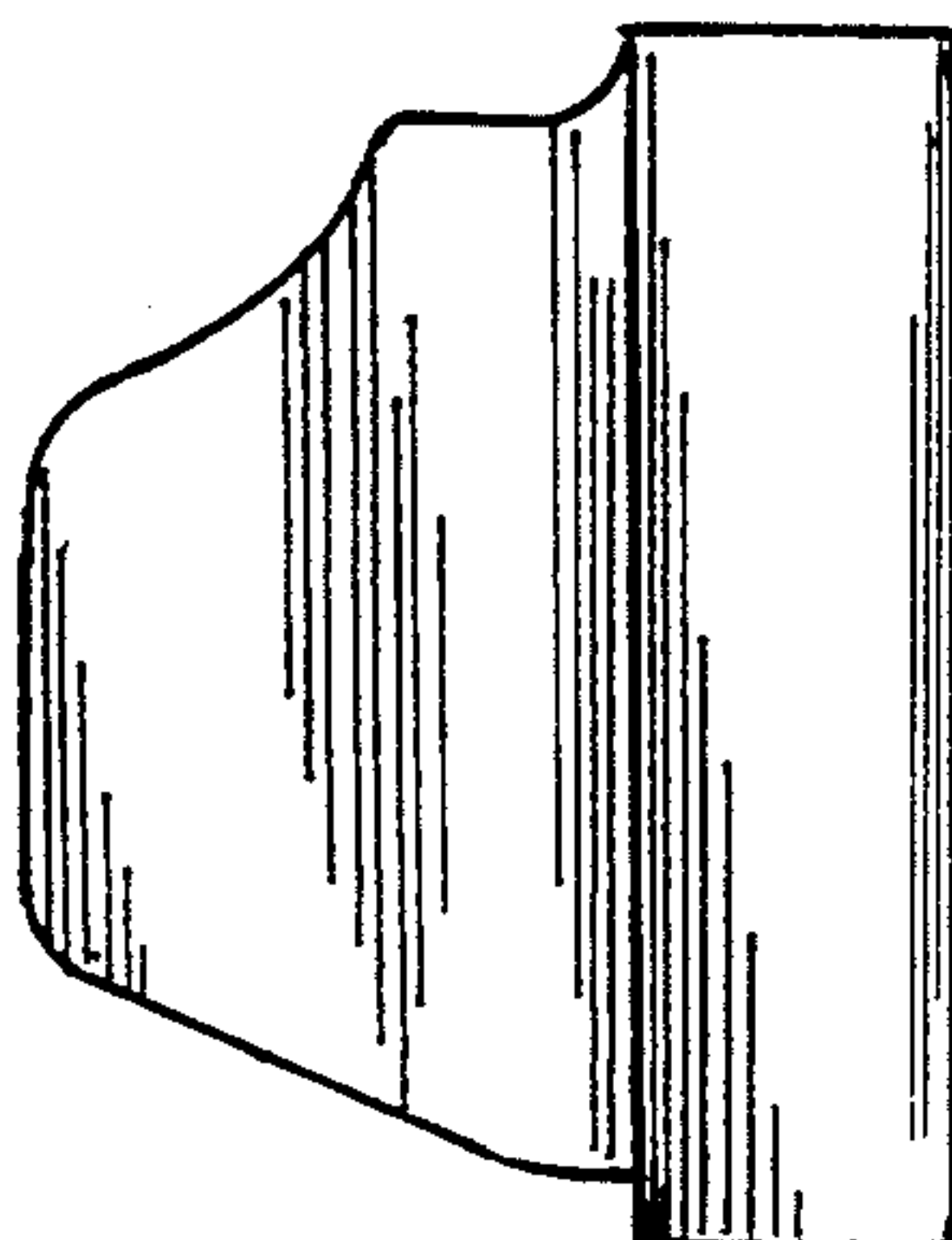
