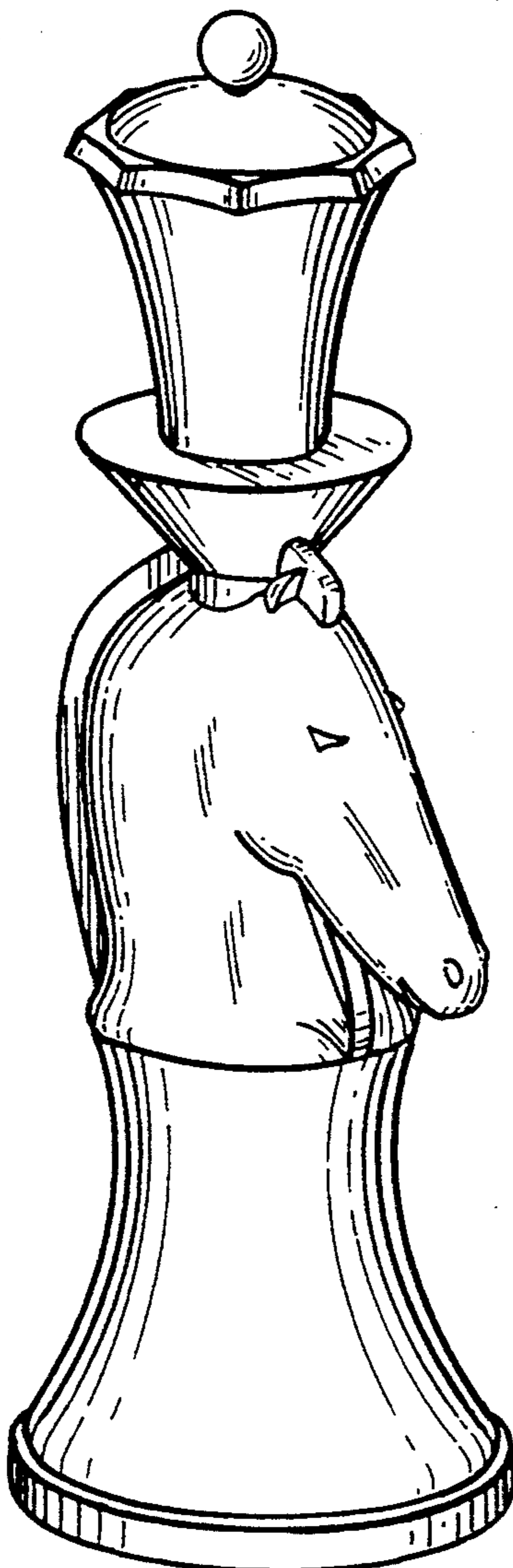

FIG. 4 is an enlarged perspective view of the chess piece.



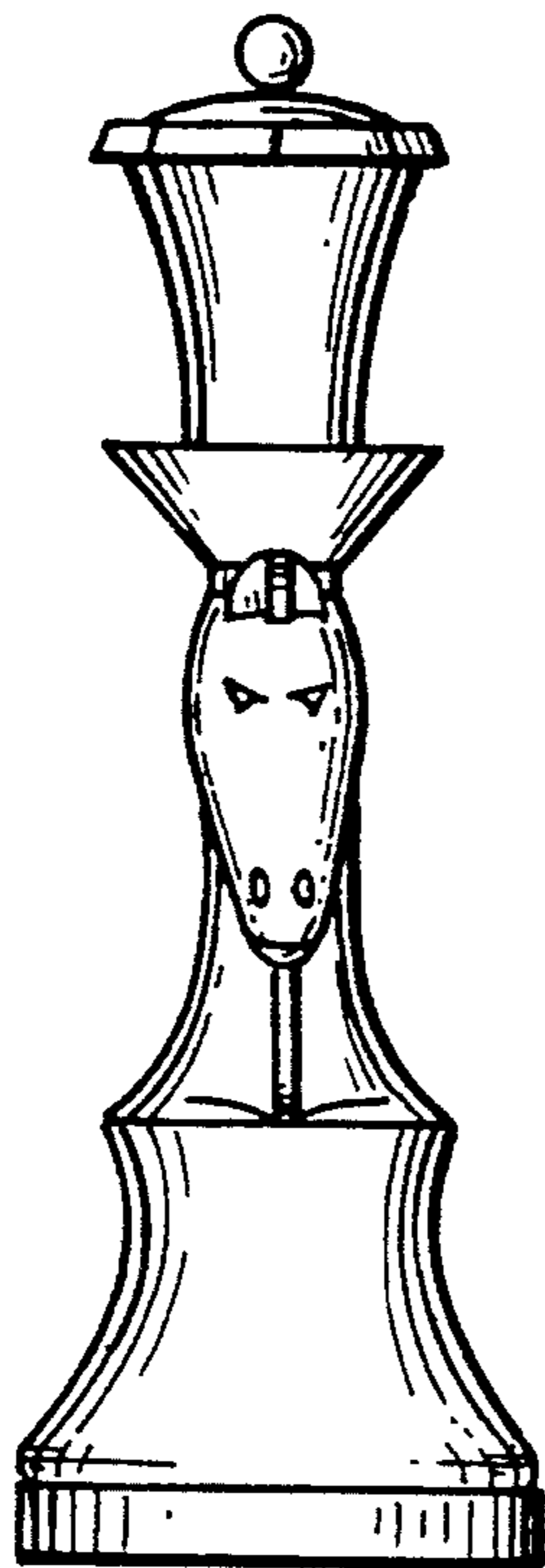

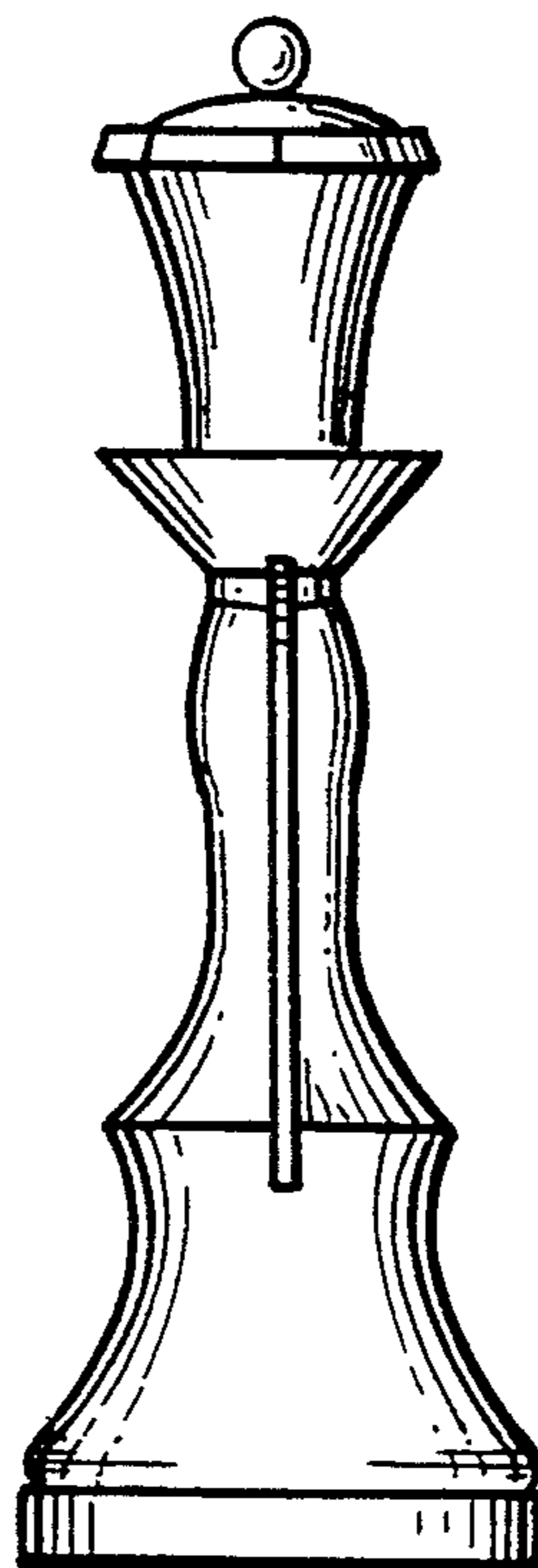

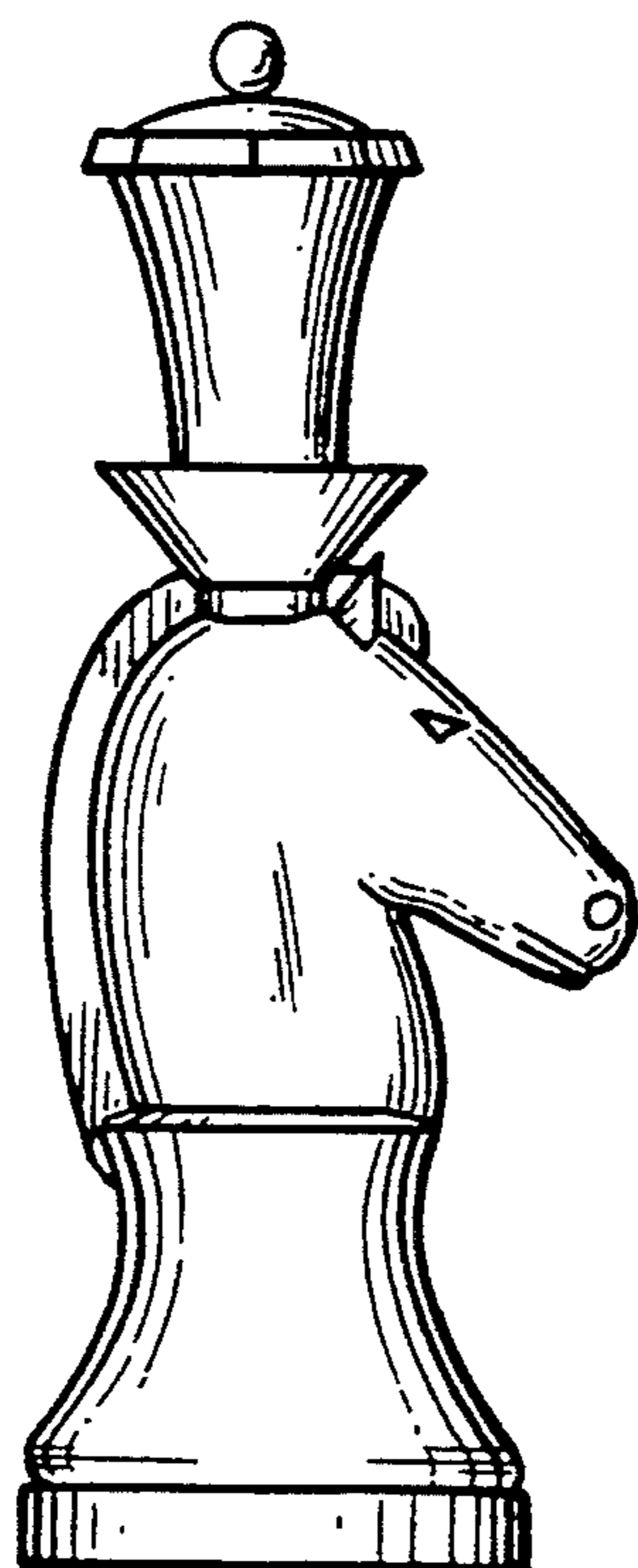

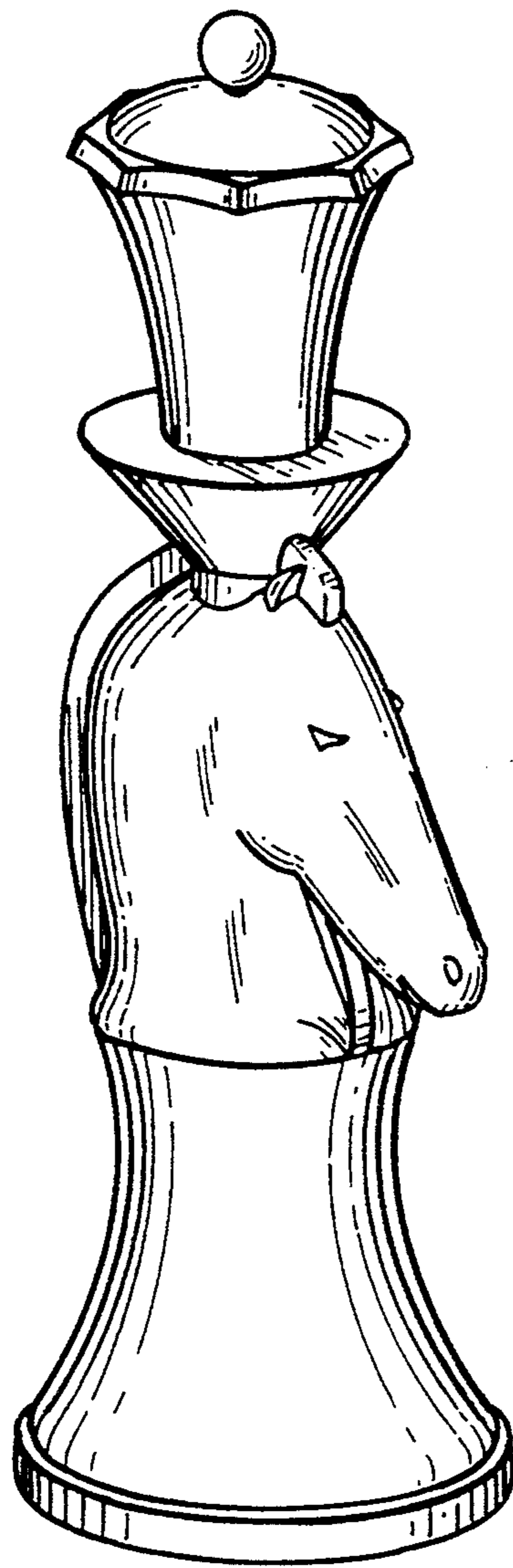
