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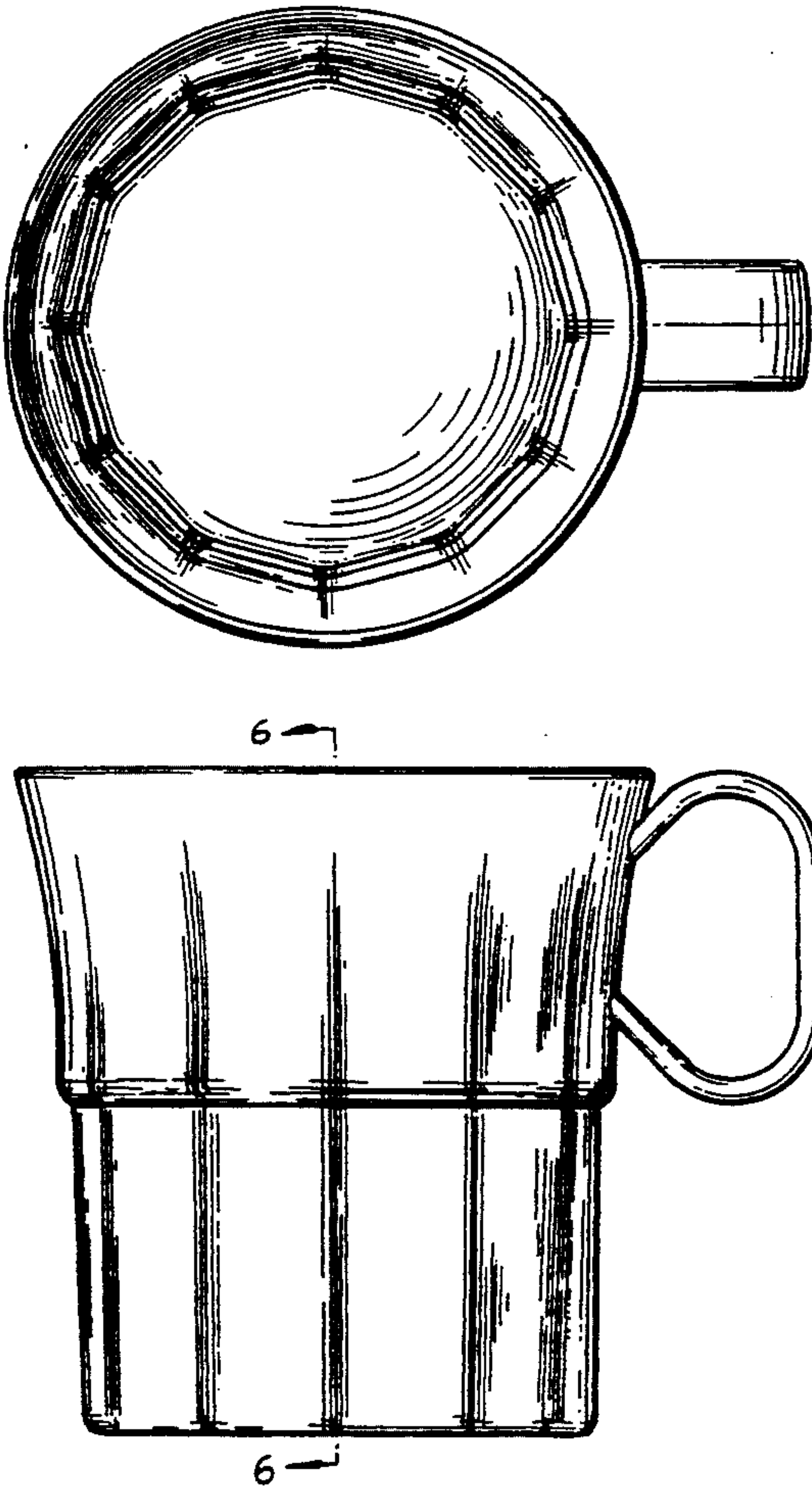
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a faceted mug showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof;

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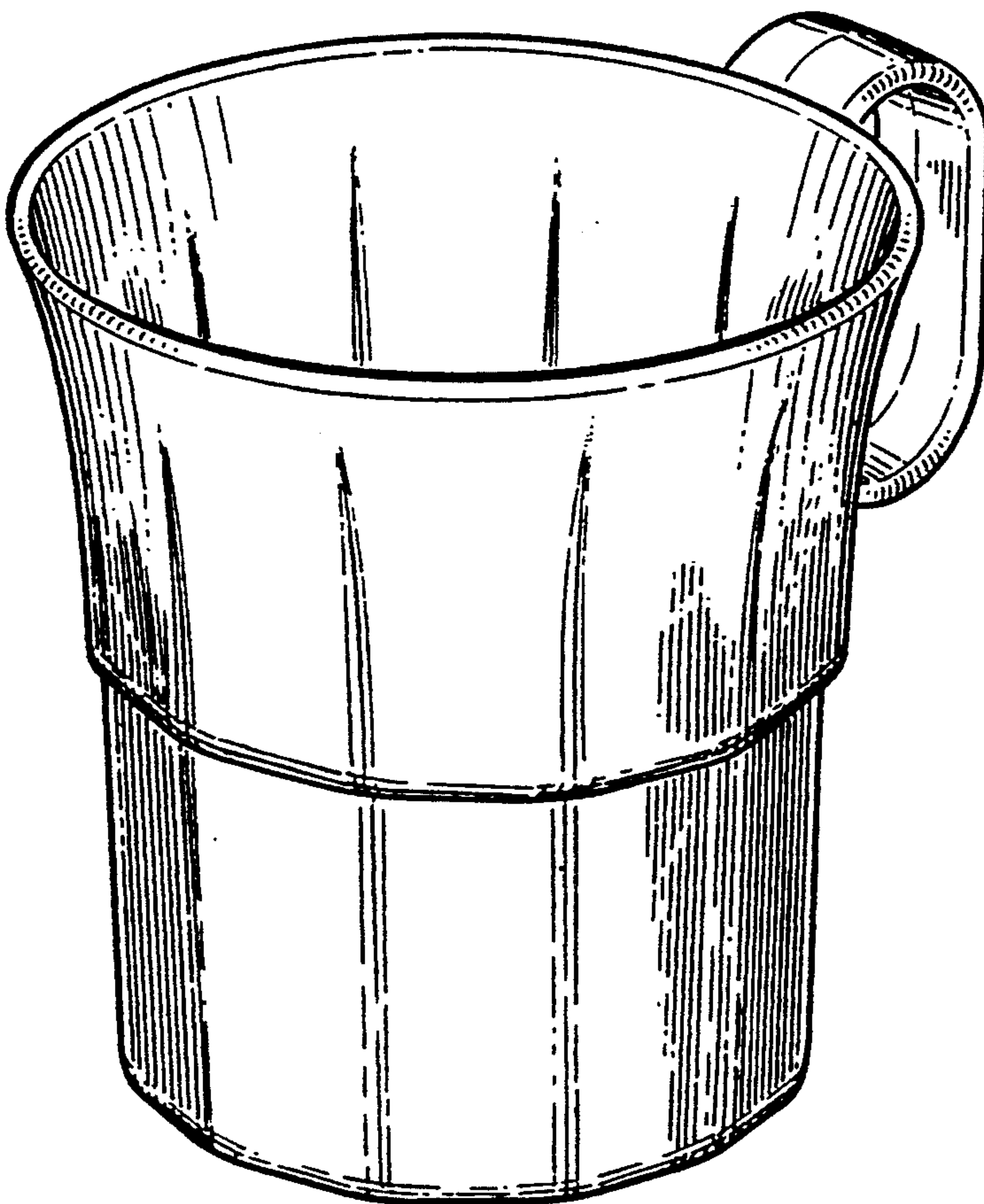

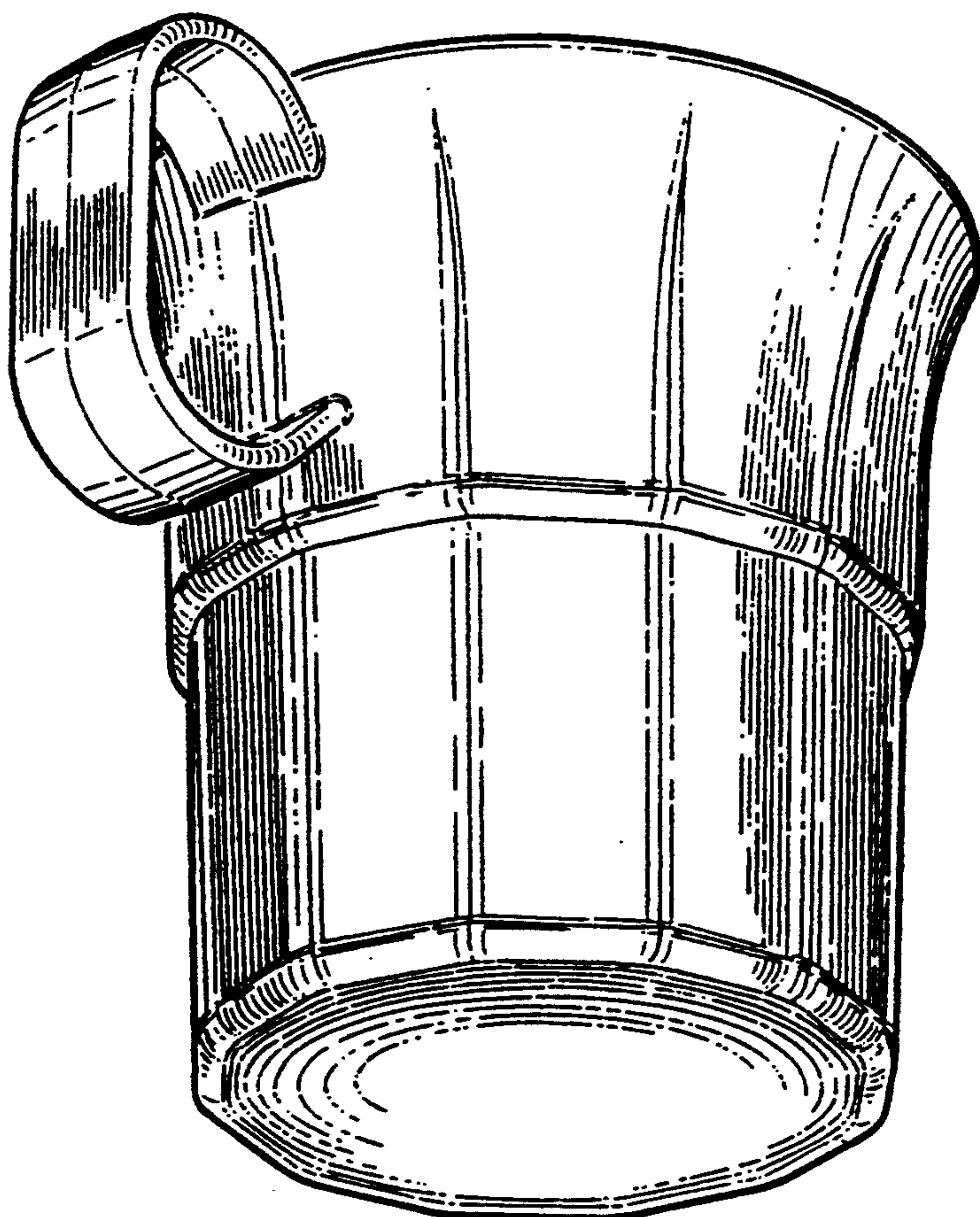

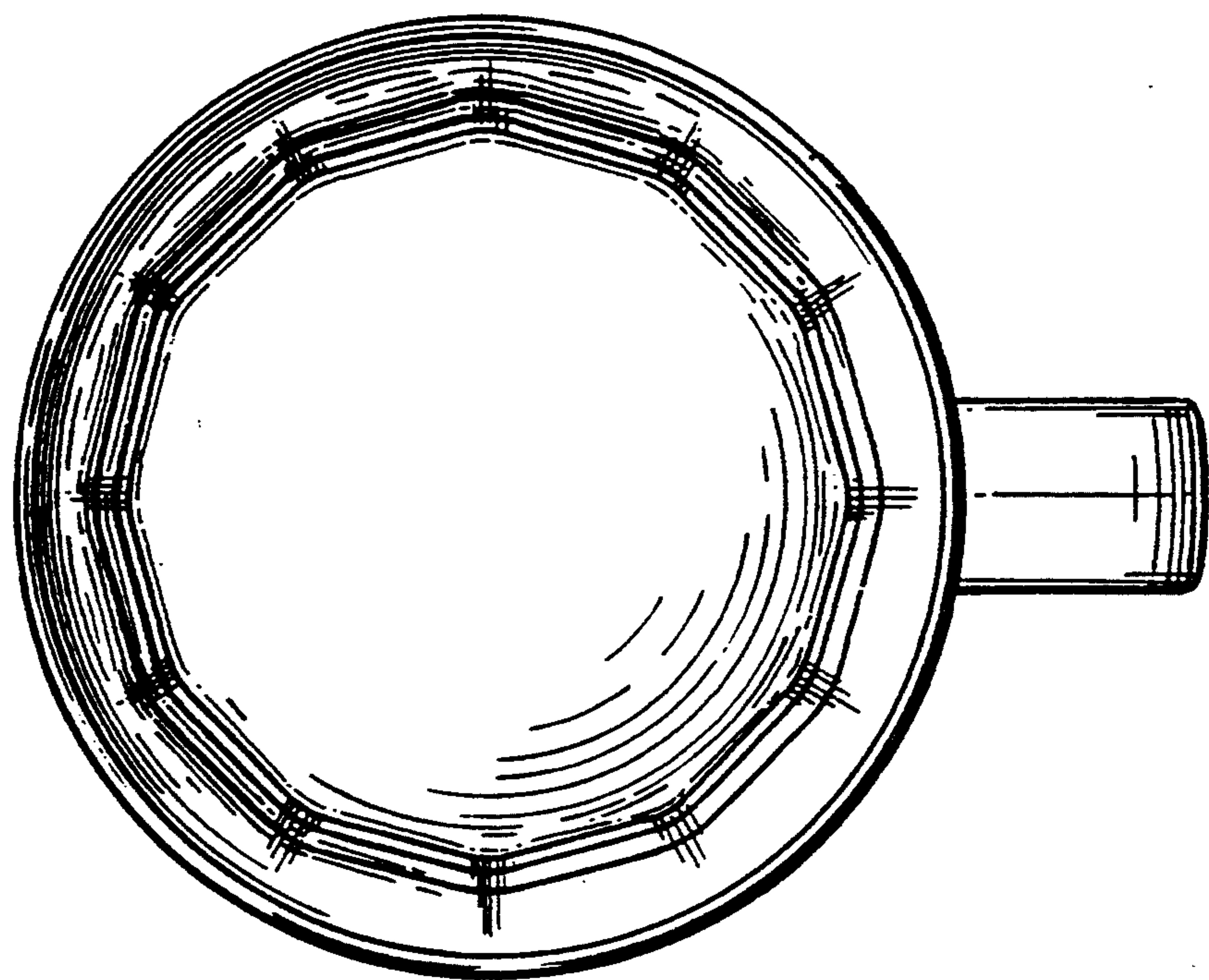
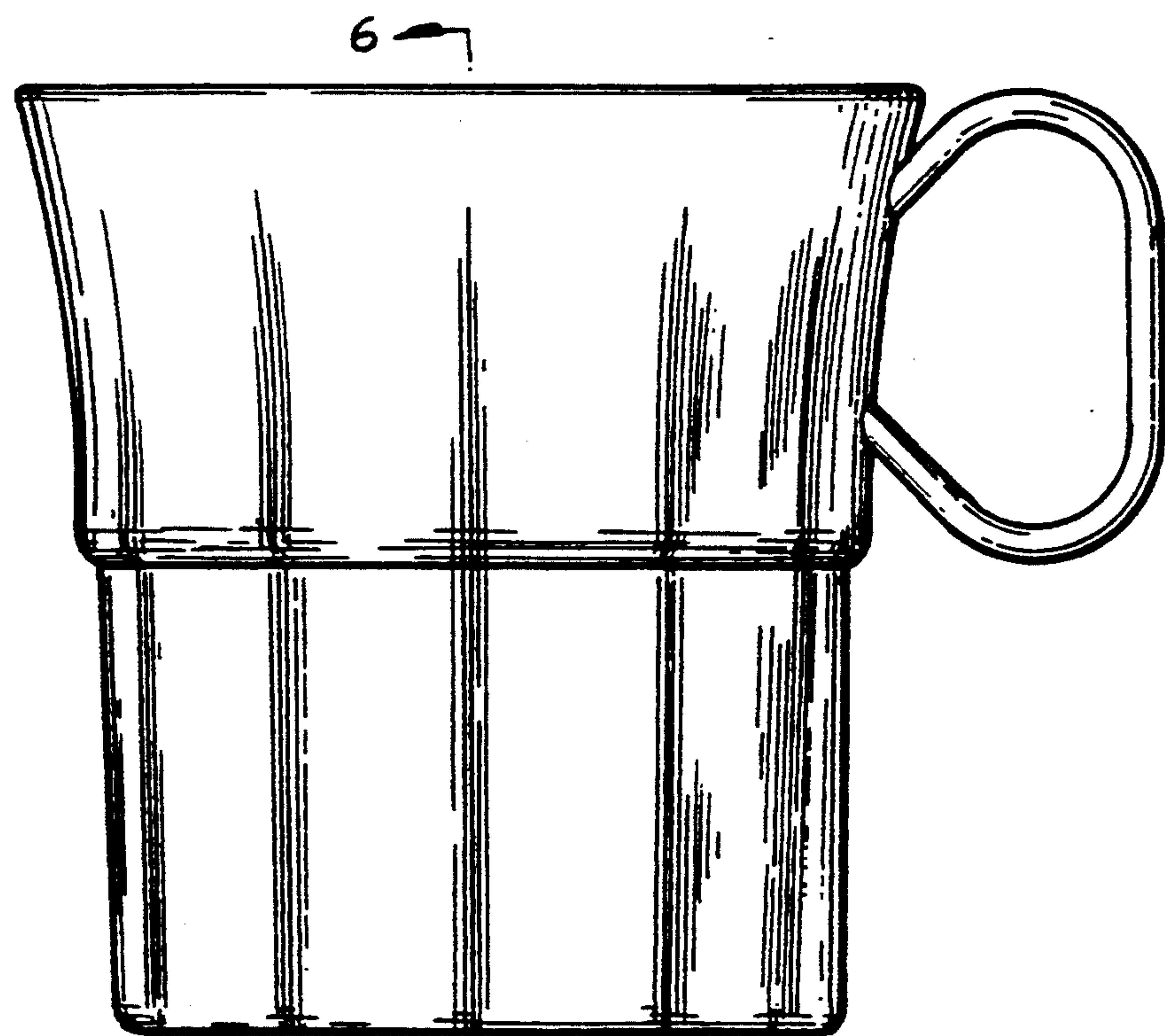

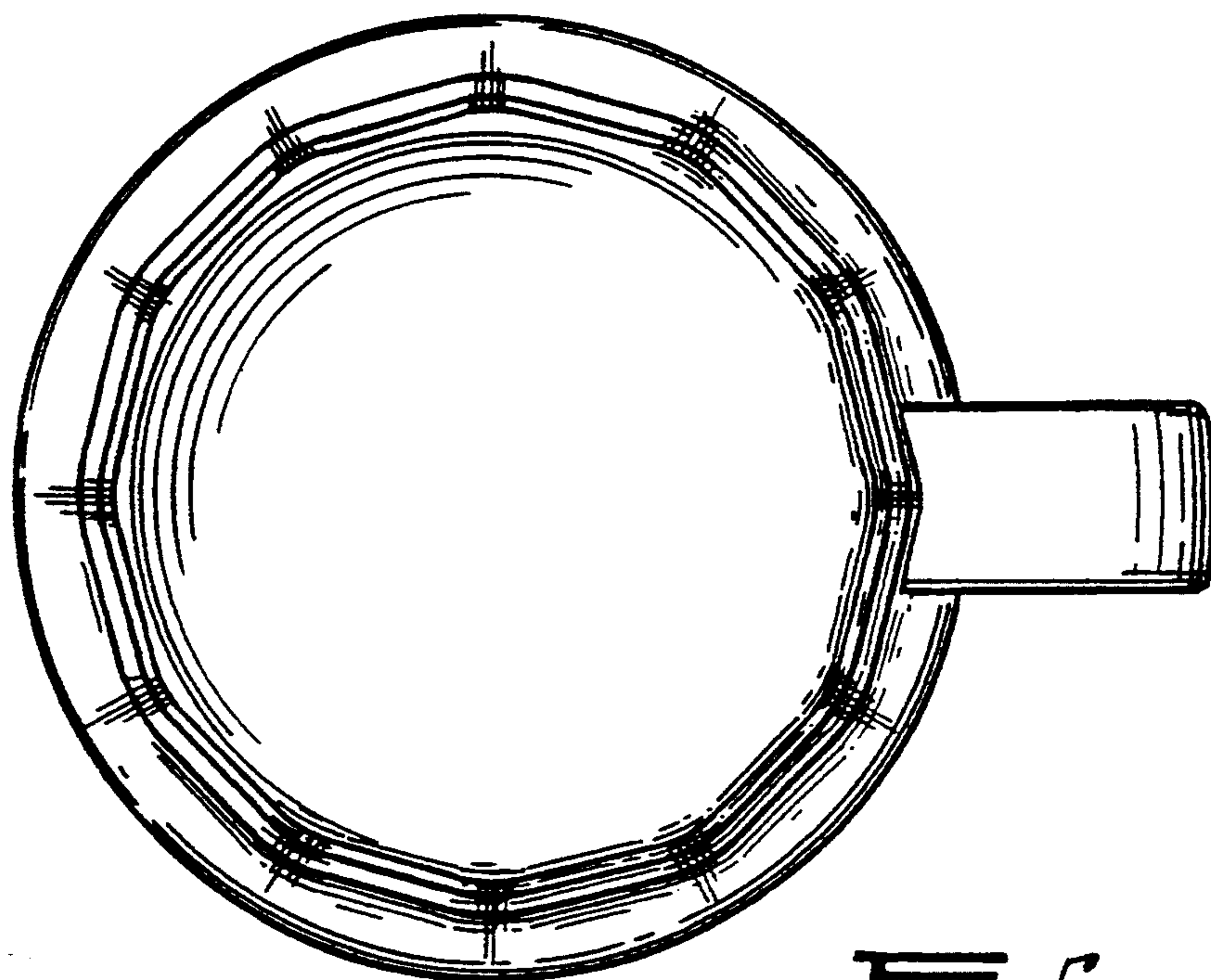

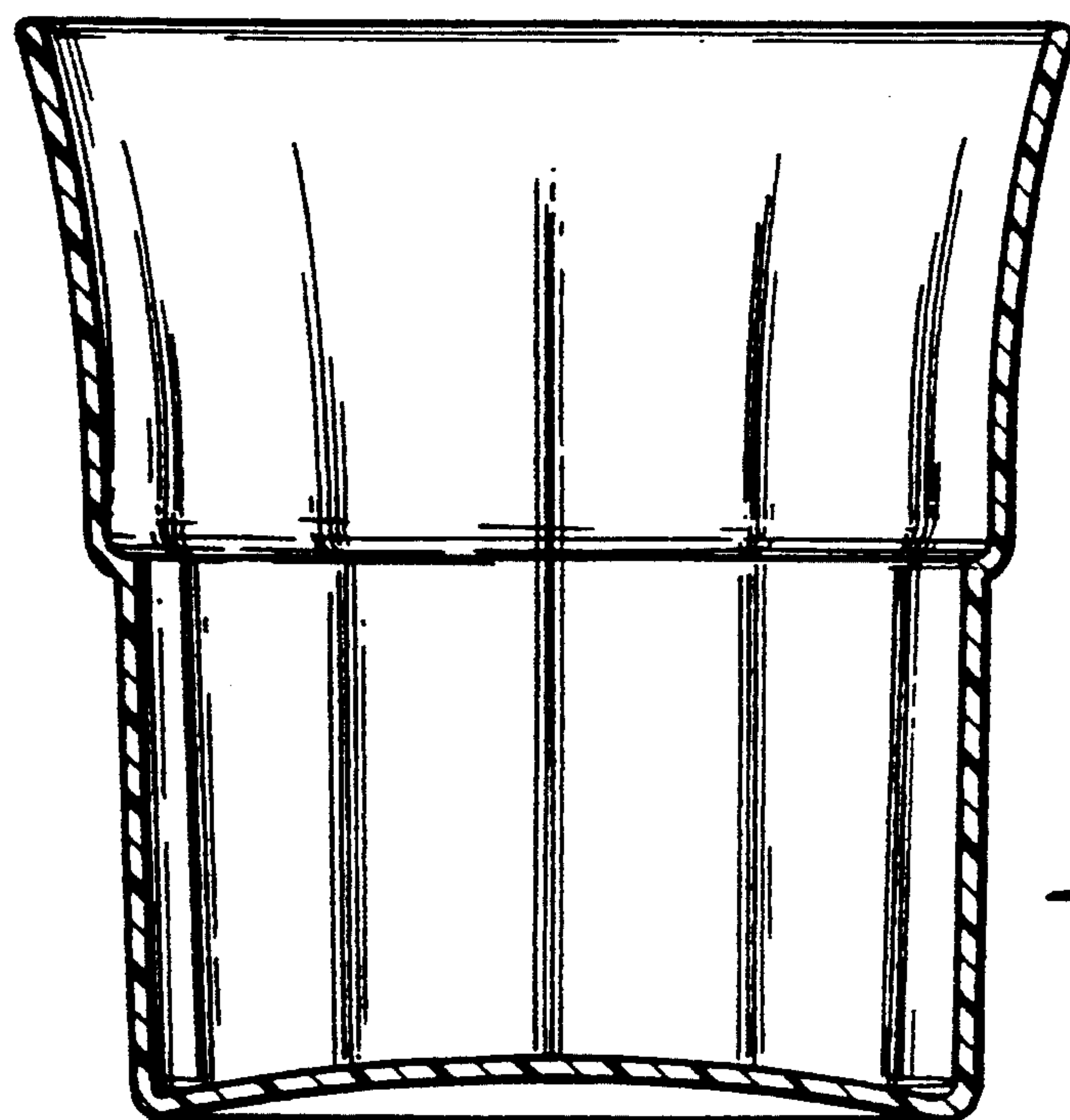
