**DESCRIPTION**

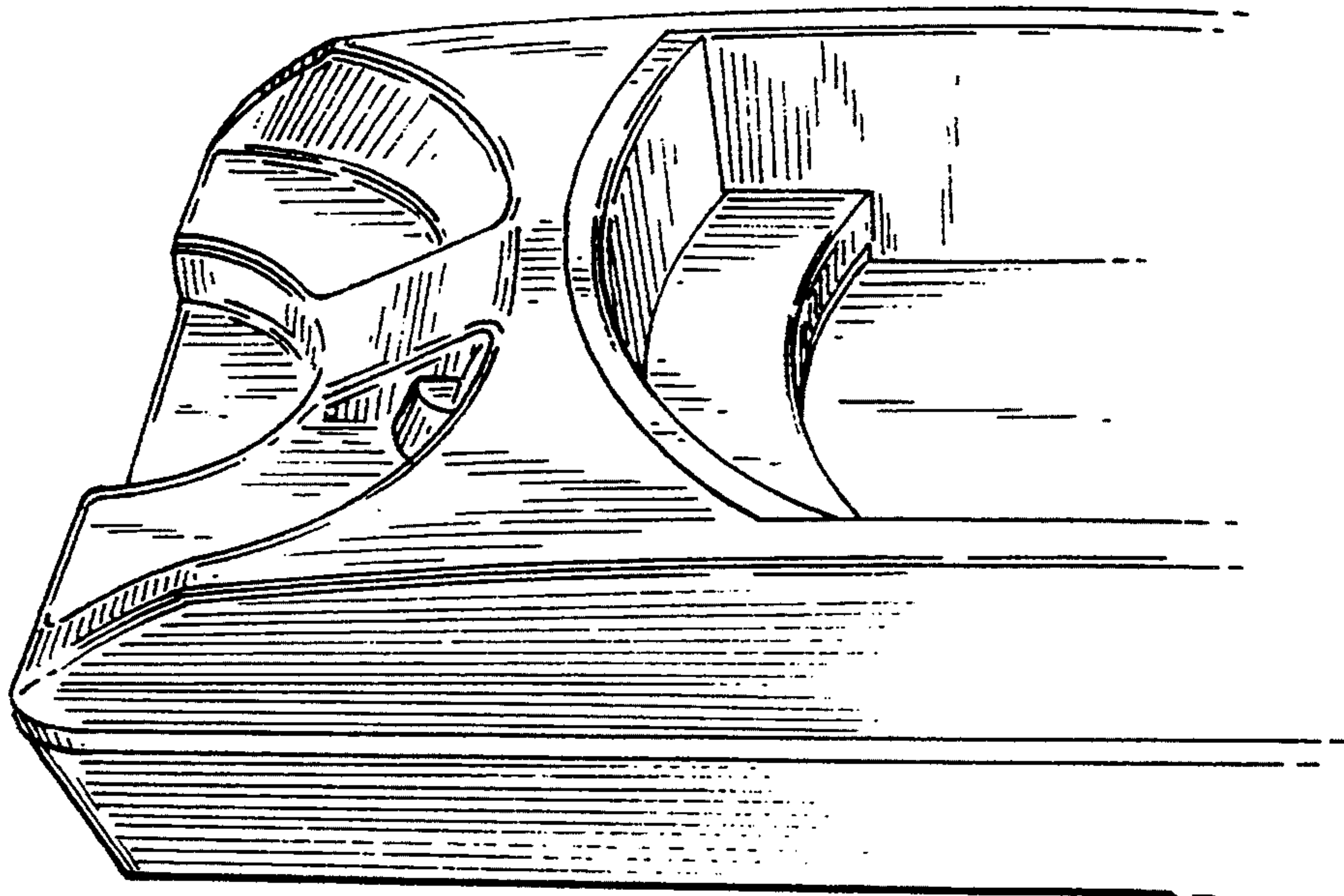

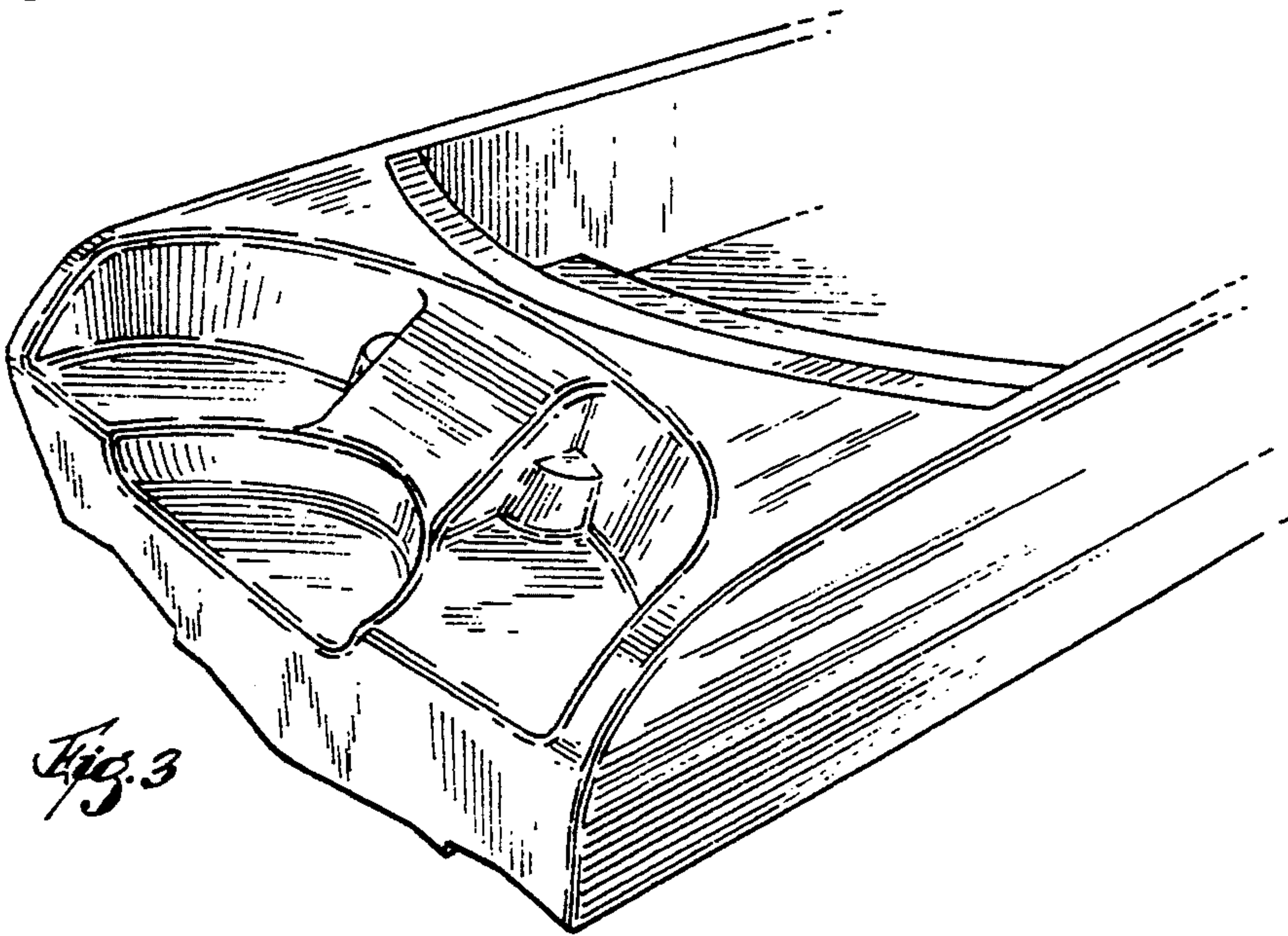
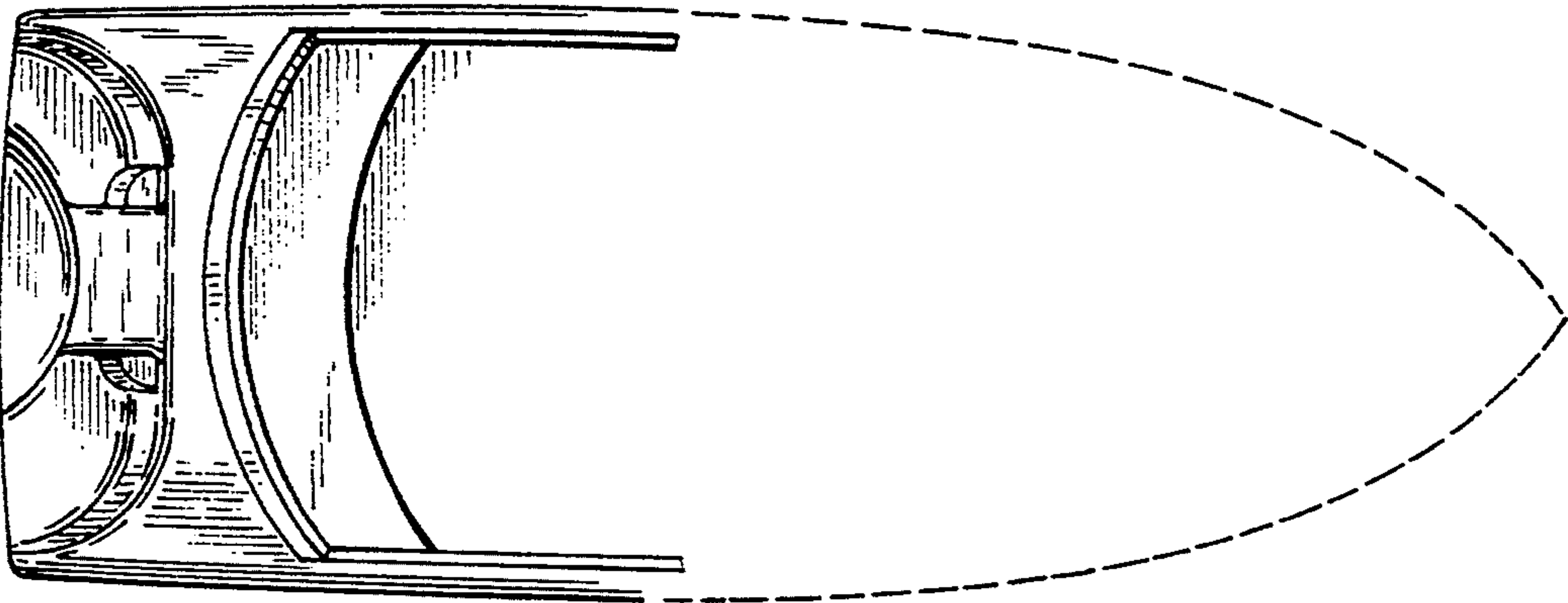
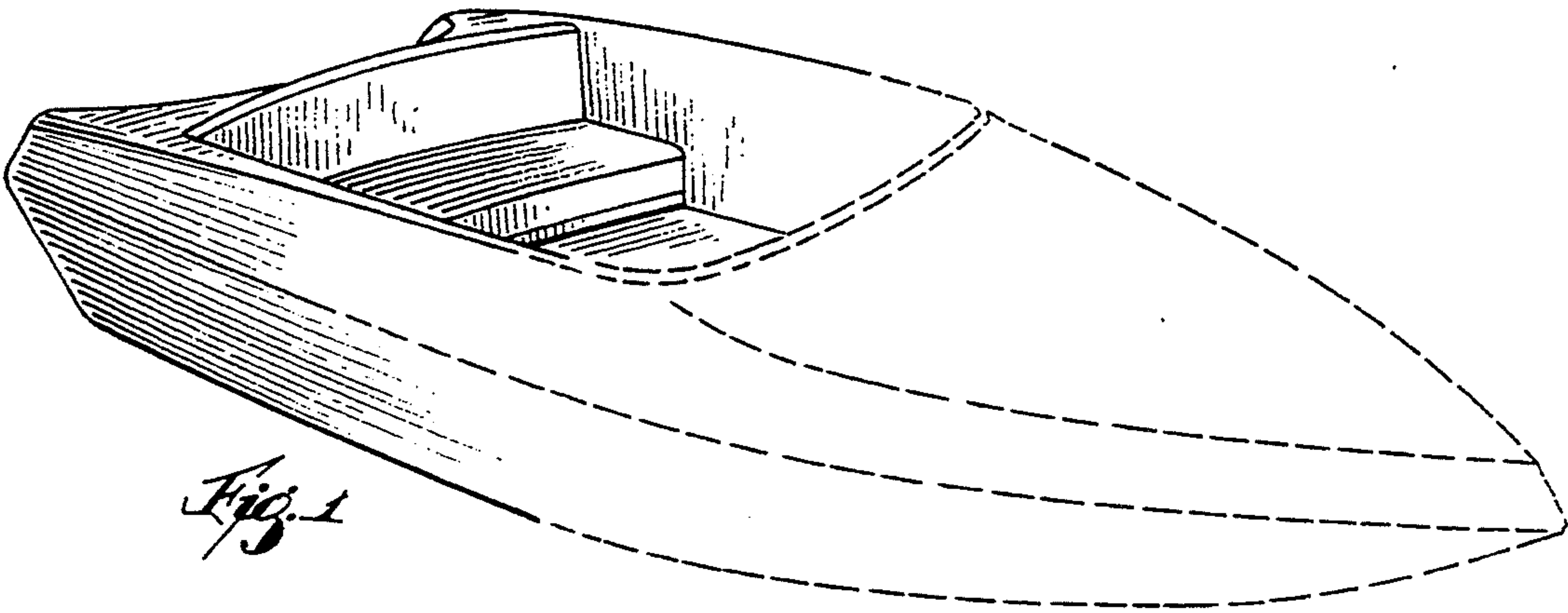
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

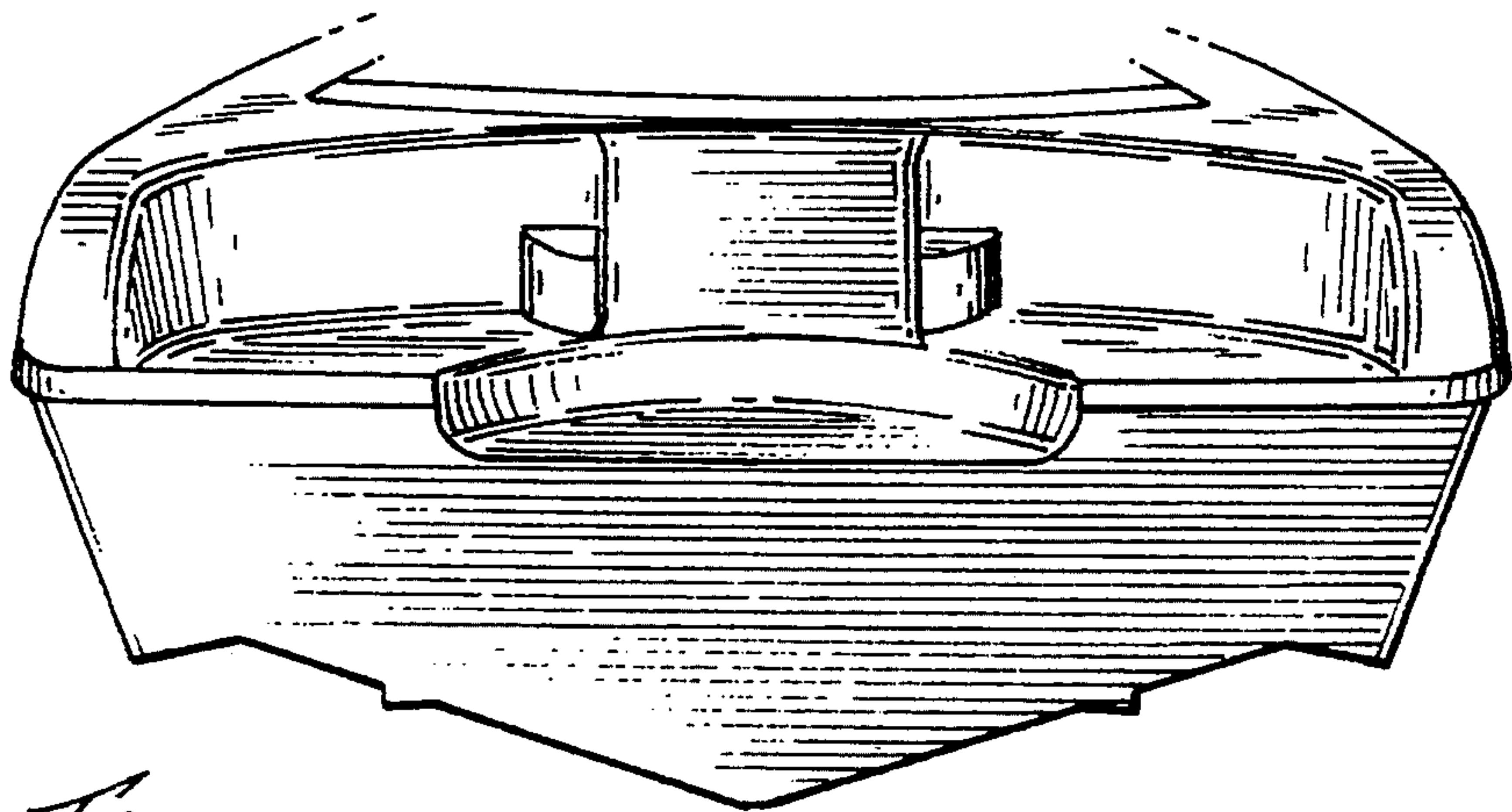
FIG. 3 is a top and rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

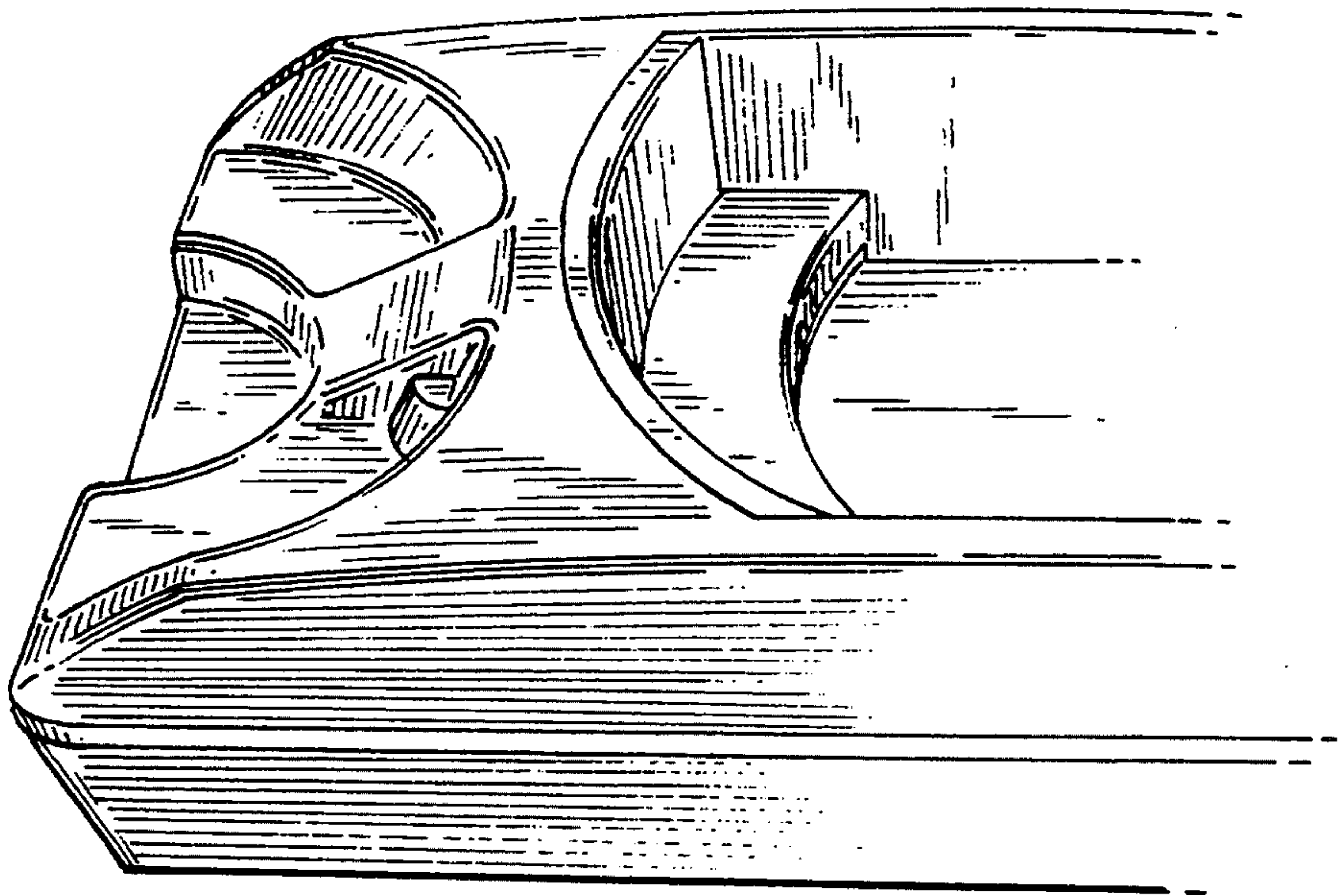
FIG. 5 is a side and rear perspective view thereof.
