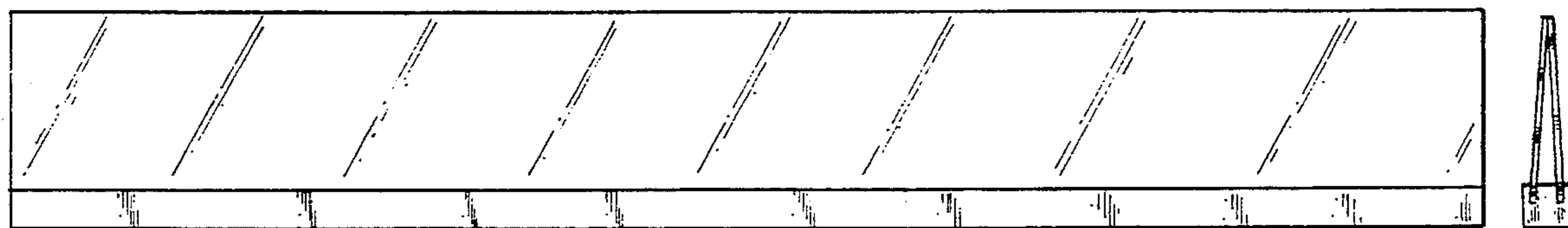

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is front elevational view of the invention which is a mirror image of the rear elevational view; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the invention; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the invention; and, FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the invention which is a mirror image of the opposite side.



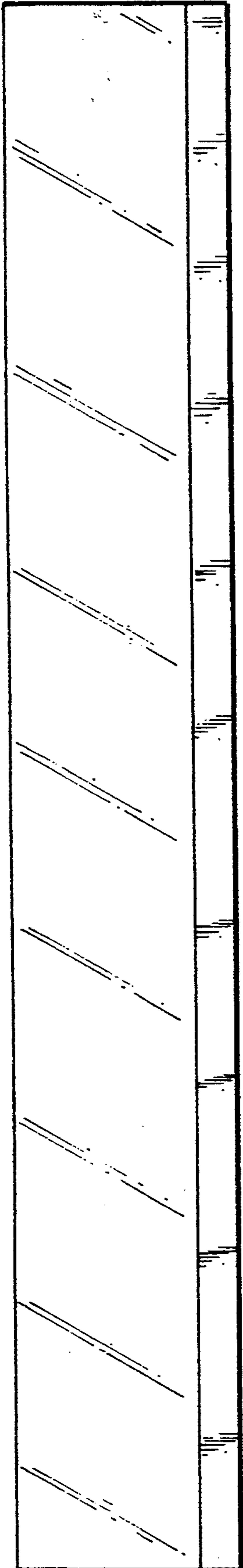

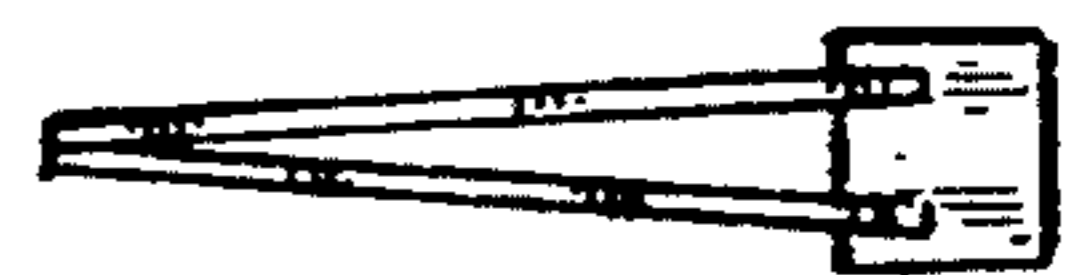
