[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bath enclosure, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a bathing enclosure embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 13—13 of FIG. 10;

FIG. 14 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 14—14 of FIG. 13;

FIG. 15 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 15—15 of FIG. 10; and,

FIG. 16 is a left side elevational view thereof.

The fragmentary broken line representations of a wall and a floor in FIGS. 1 and 9 and of grab bars in FIGS. 1, 2, 5, 6, 9, 10, 13, 14 are for the purpose of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.






























