FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

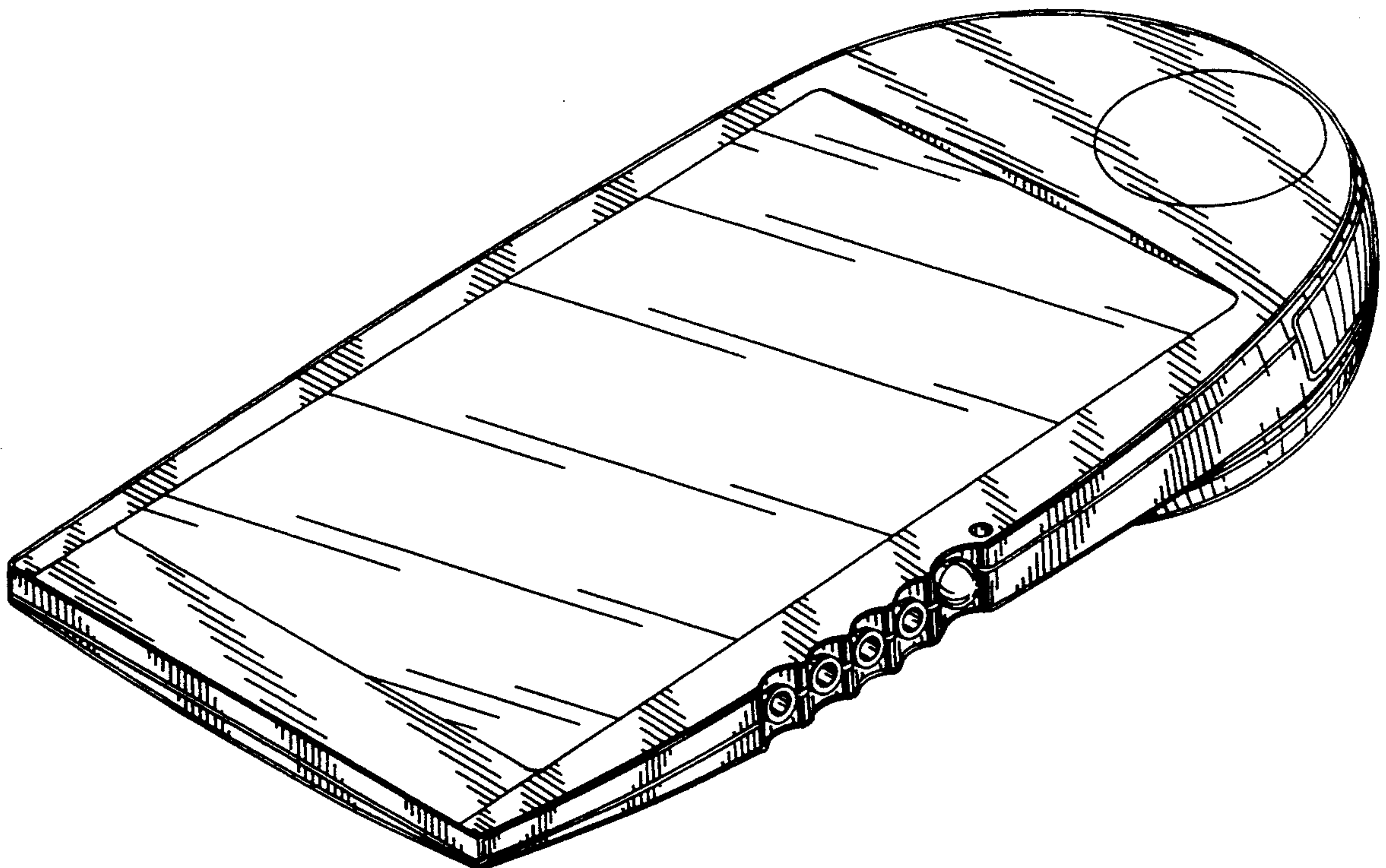
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;

The pattern partially shown in the figure for ease of illustration represents a conventional material and it is understood to continue uniformly across the indicated surface.



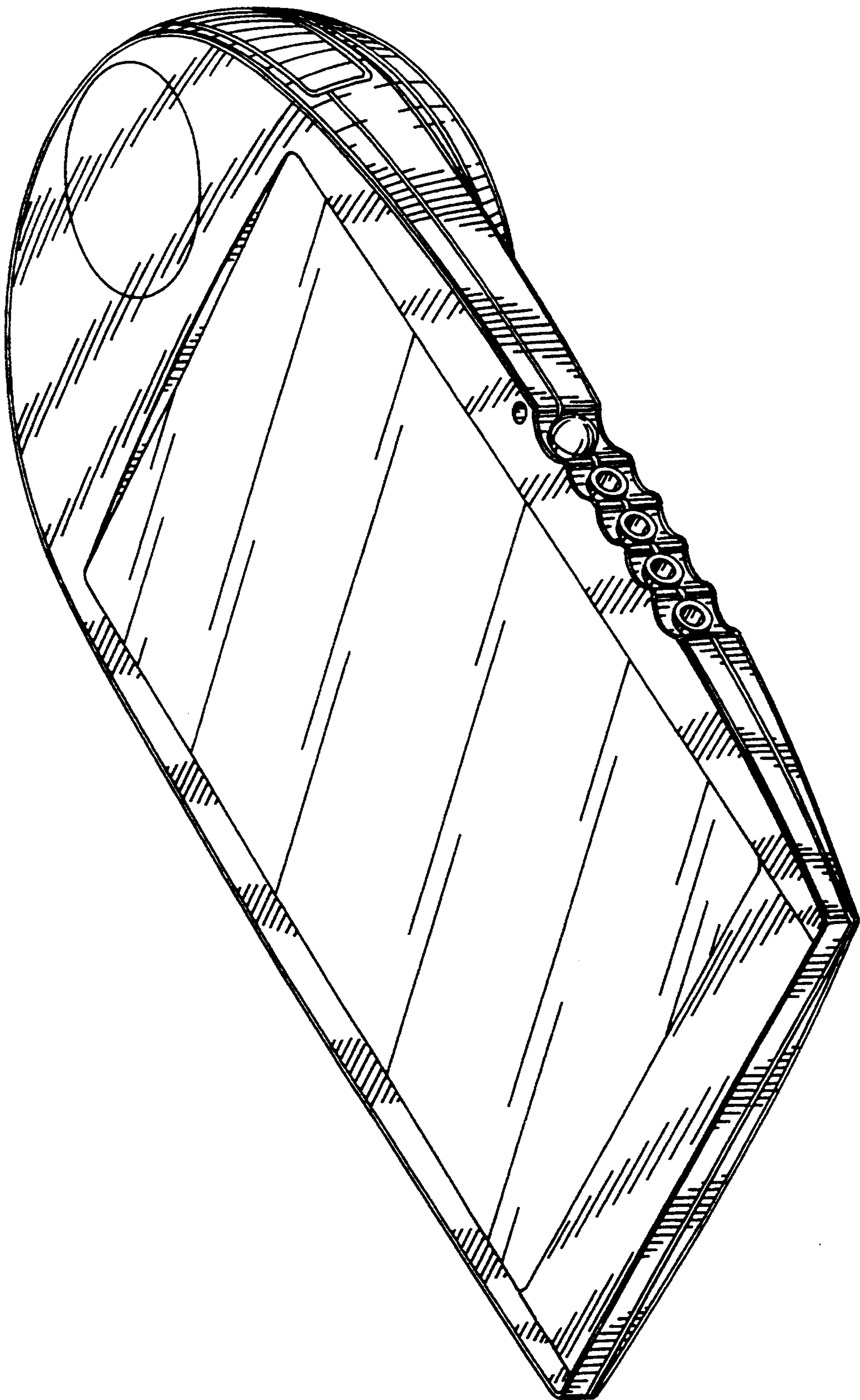

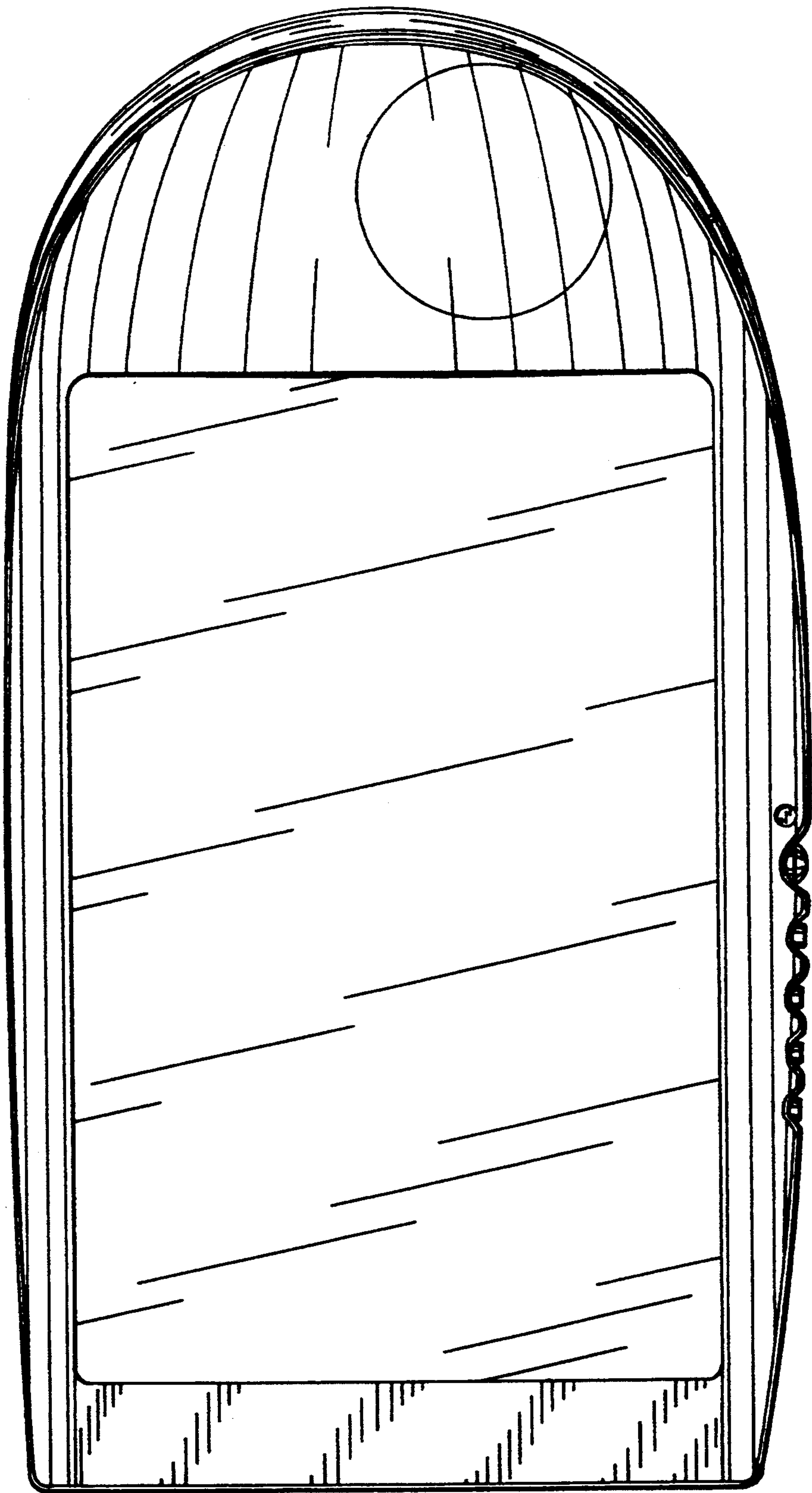

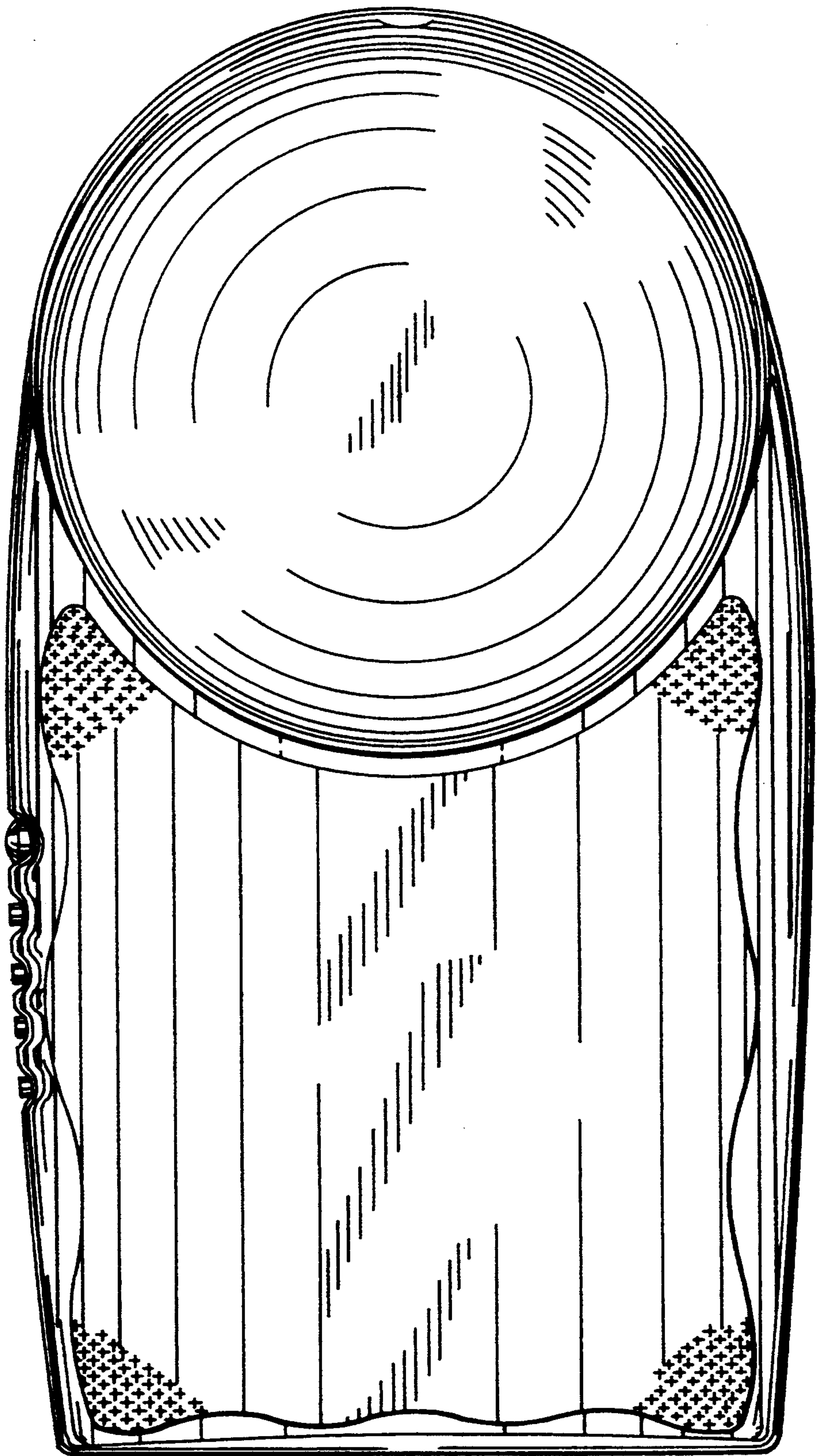

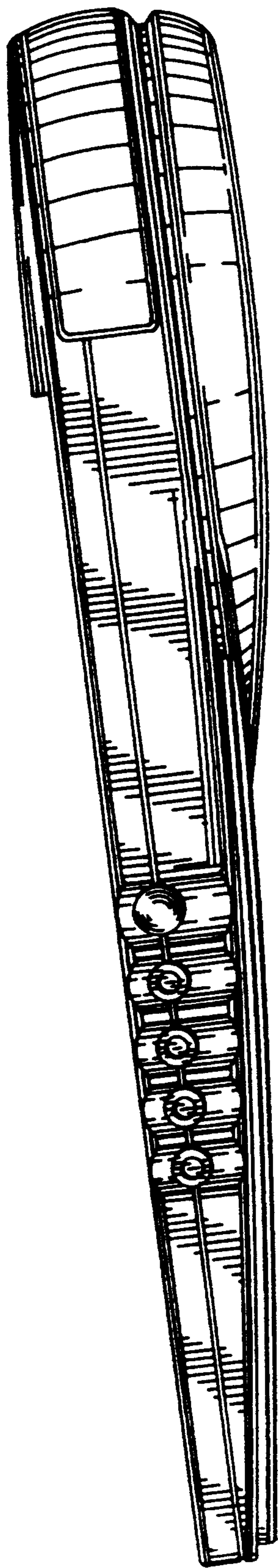

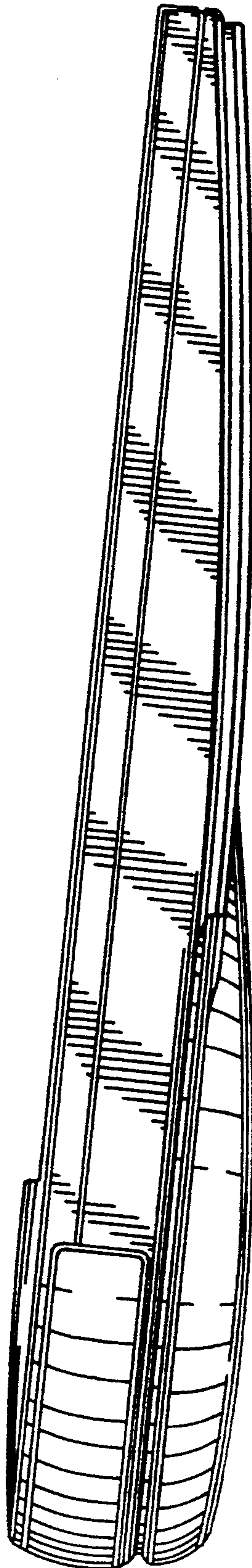

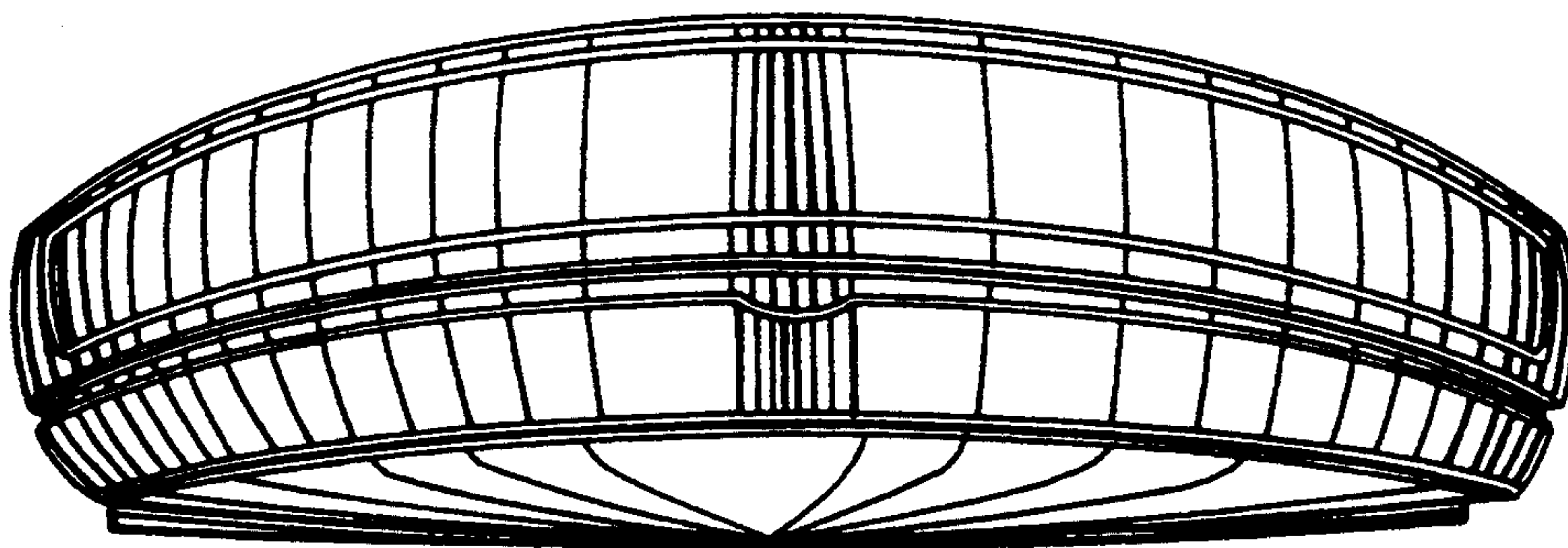

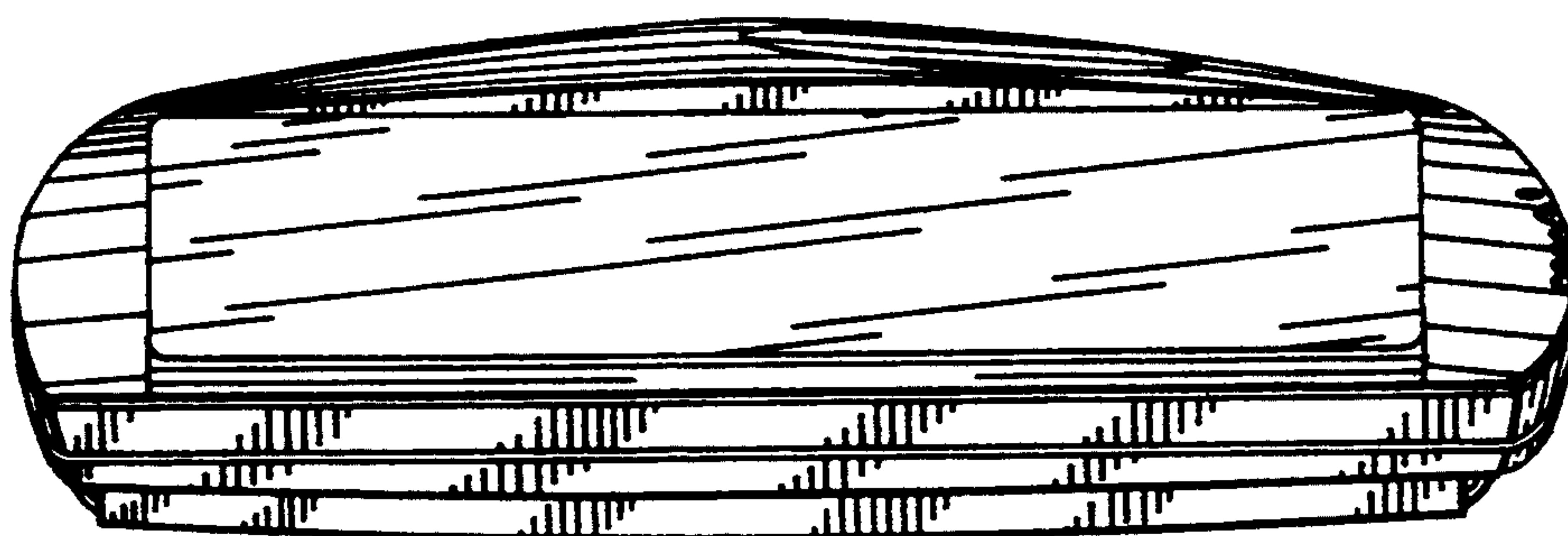
