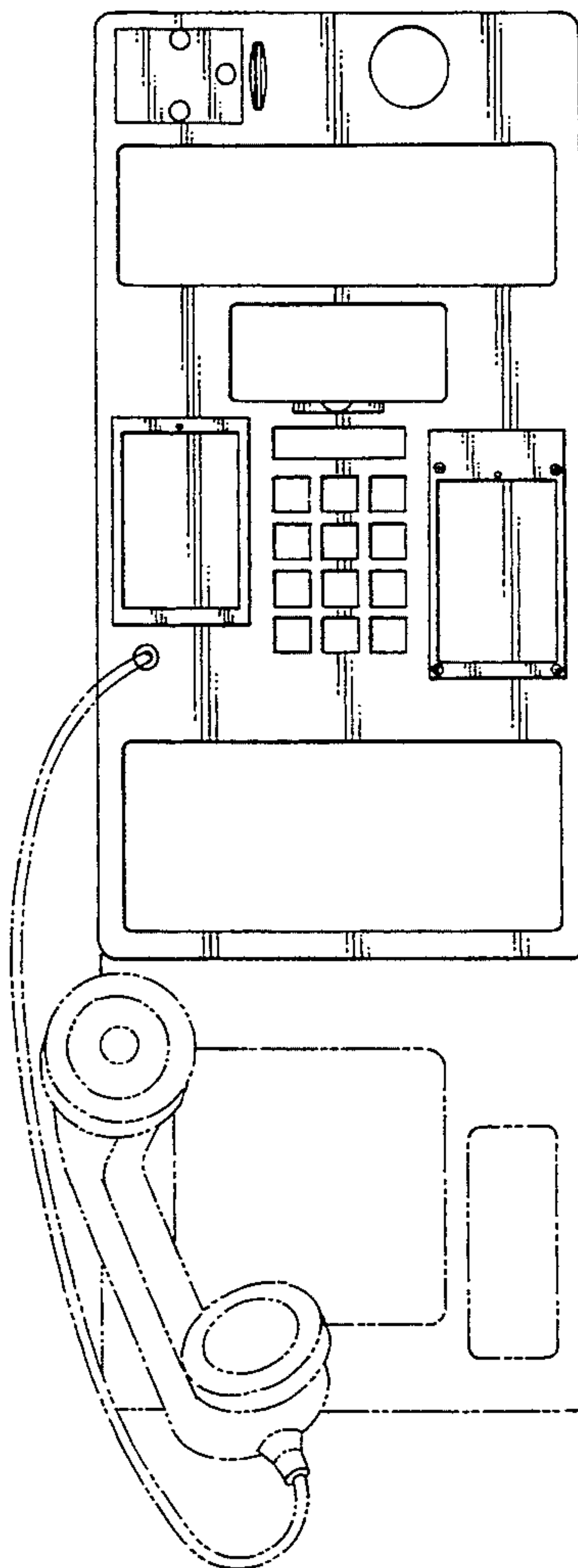

 FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image; and,
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof, the top view being a mirror image.
 The broken line showings of FIG. 1 are for illustrative puropes only and form no part of the claimed design.



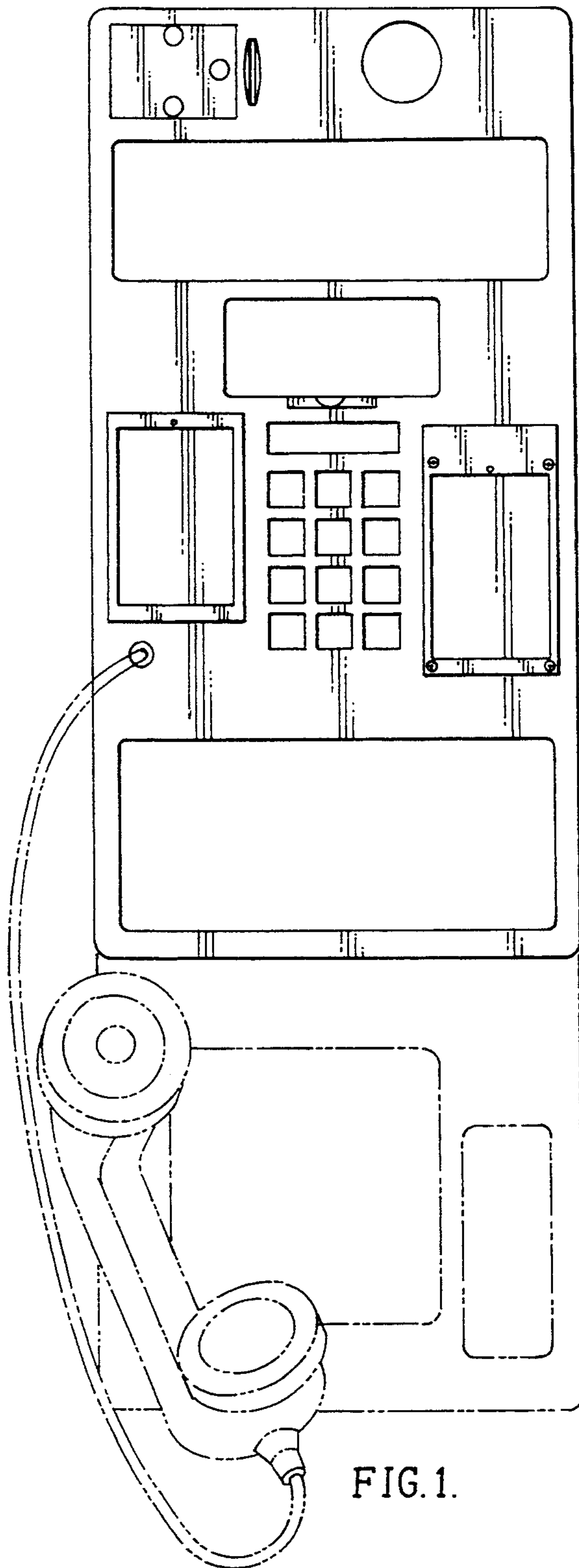

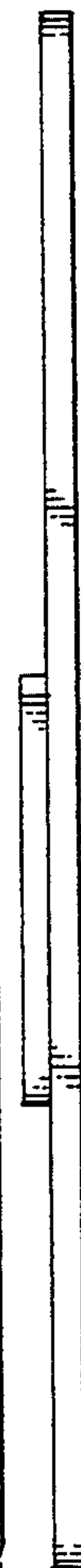

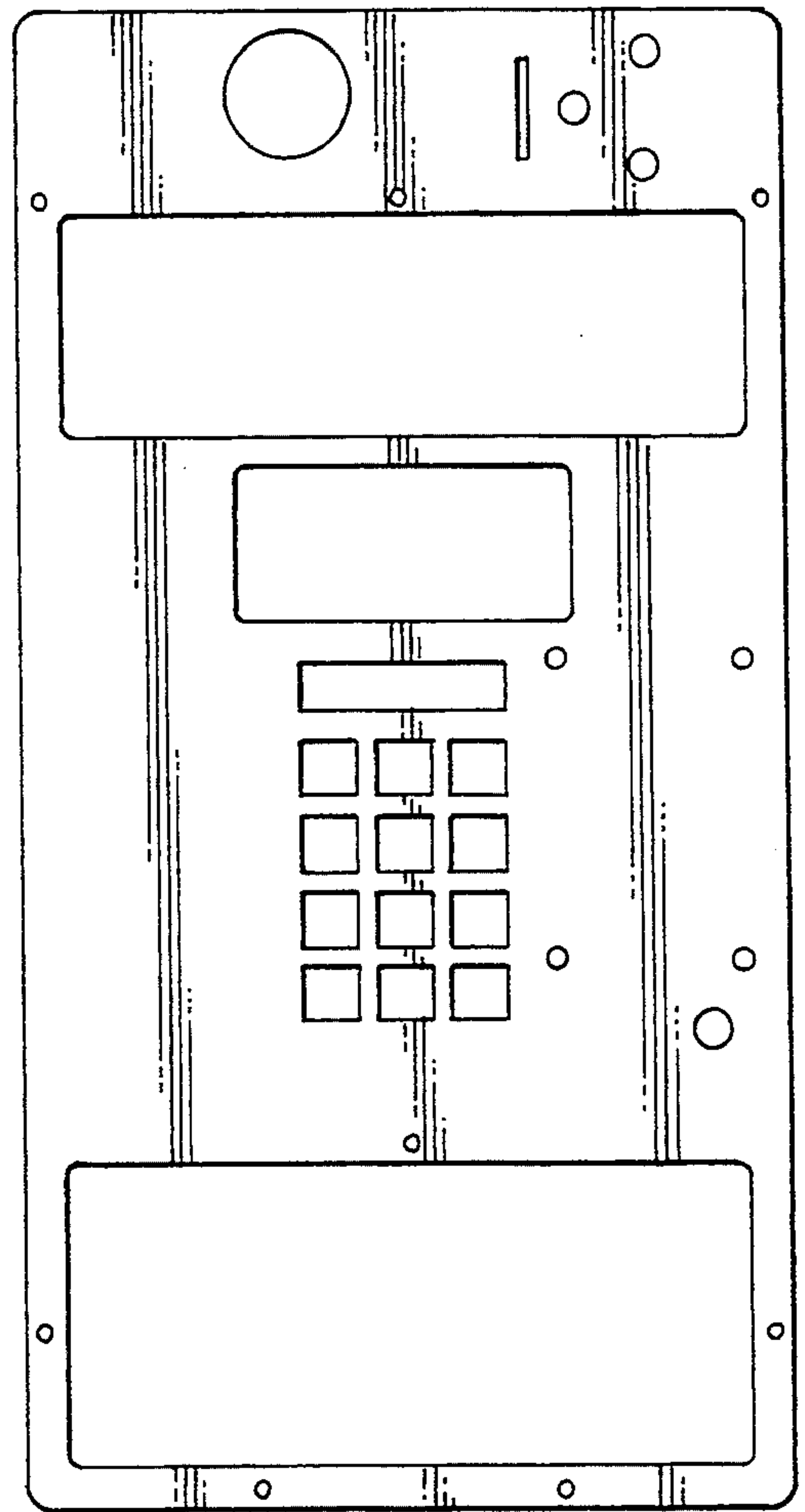
