shown and described.

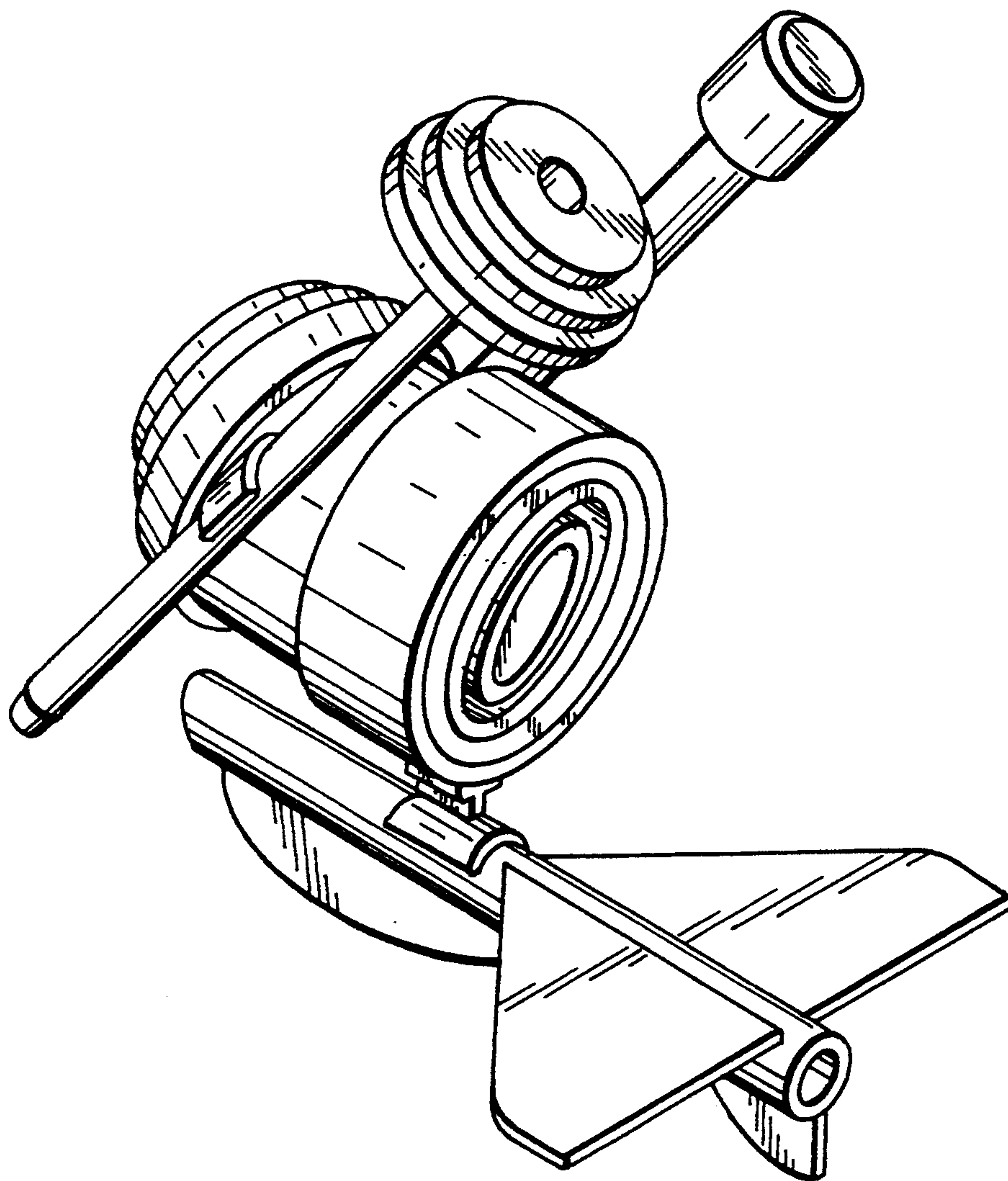
DESCRIPTION

showing our new design;

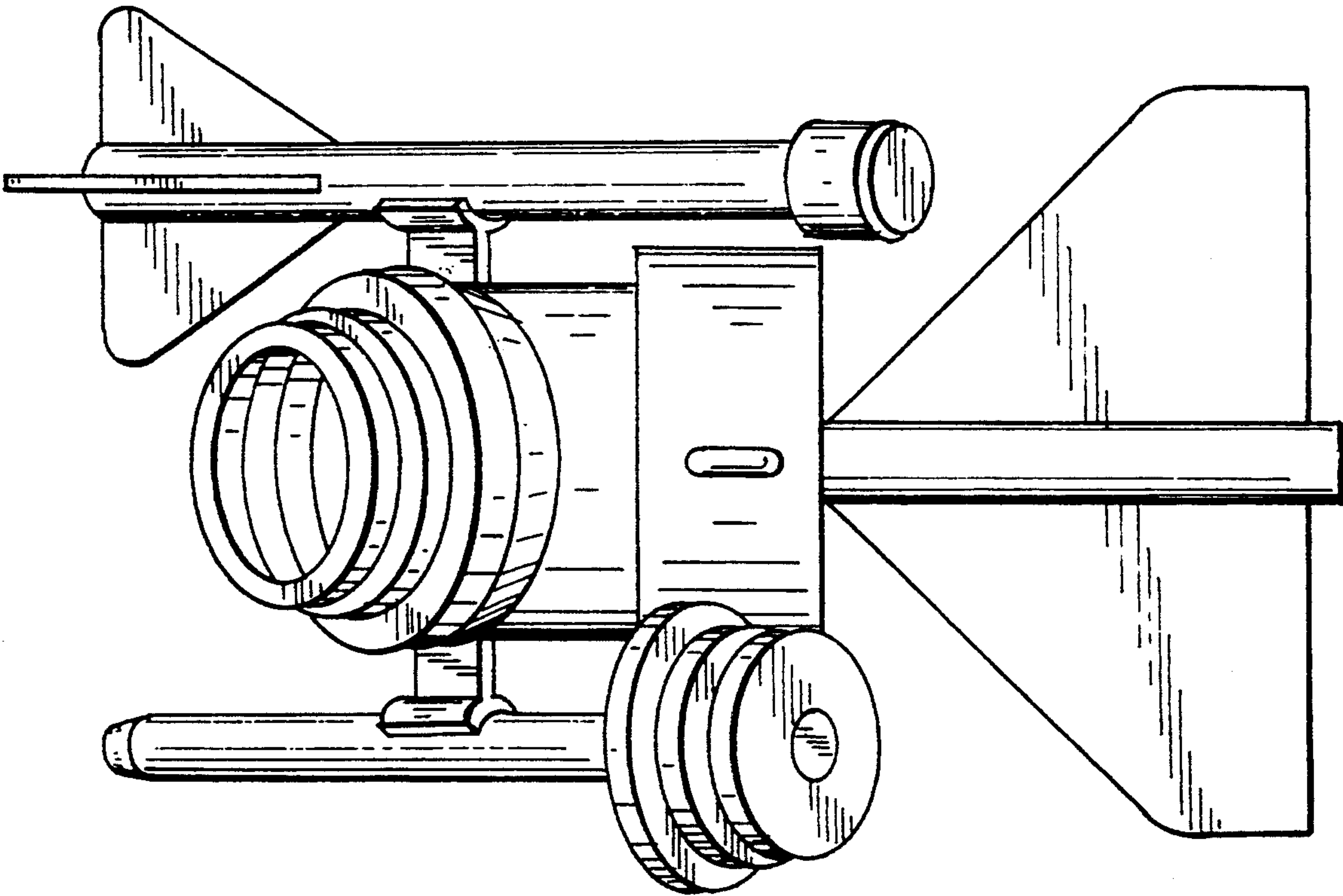
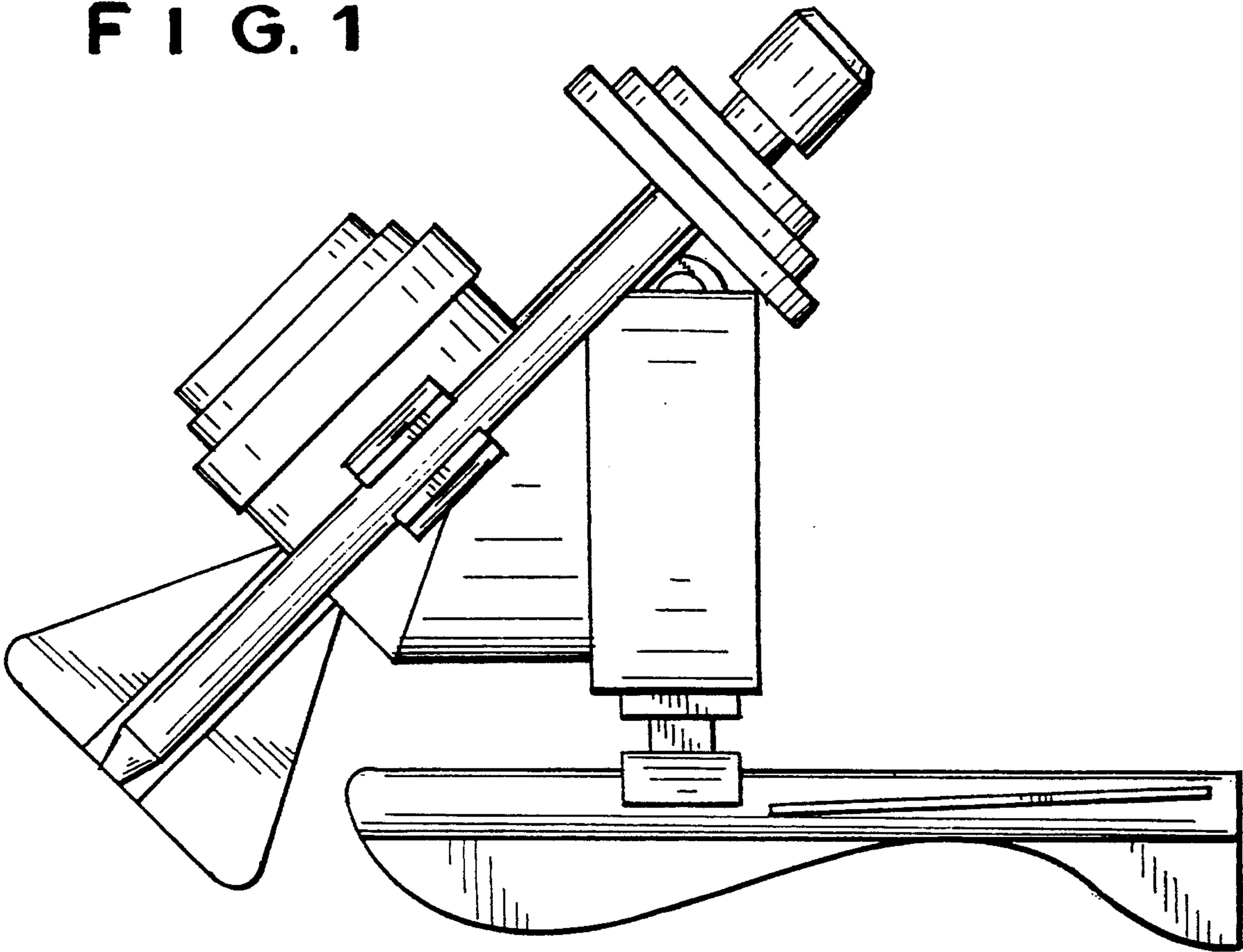
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

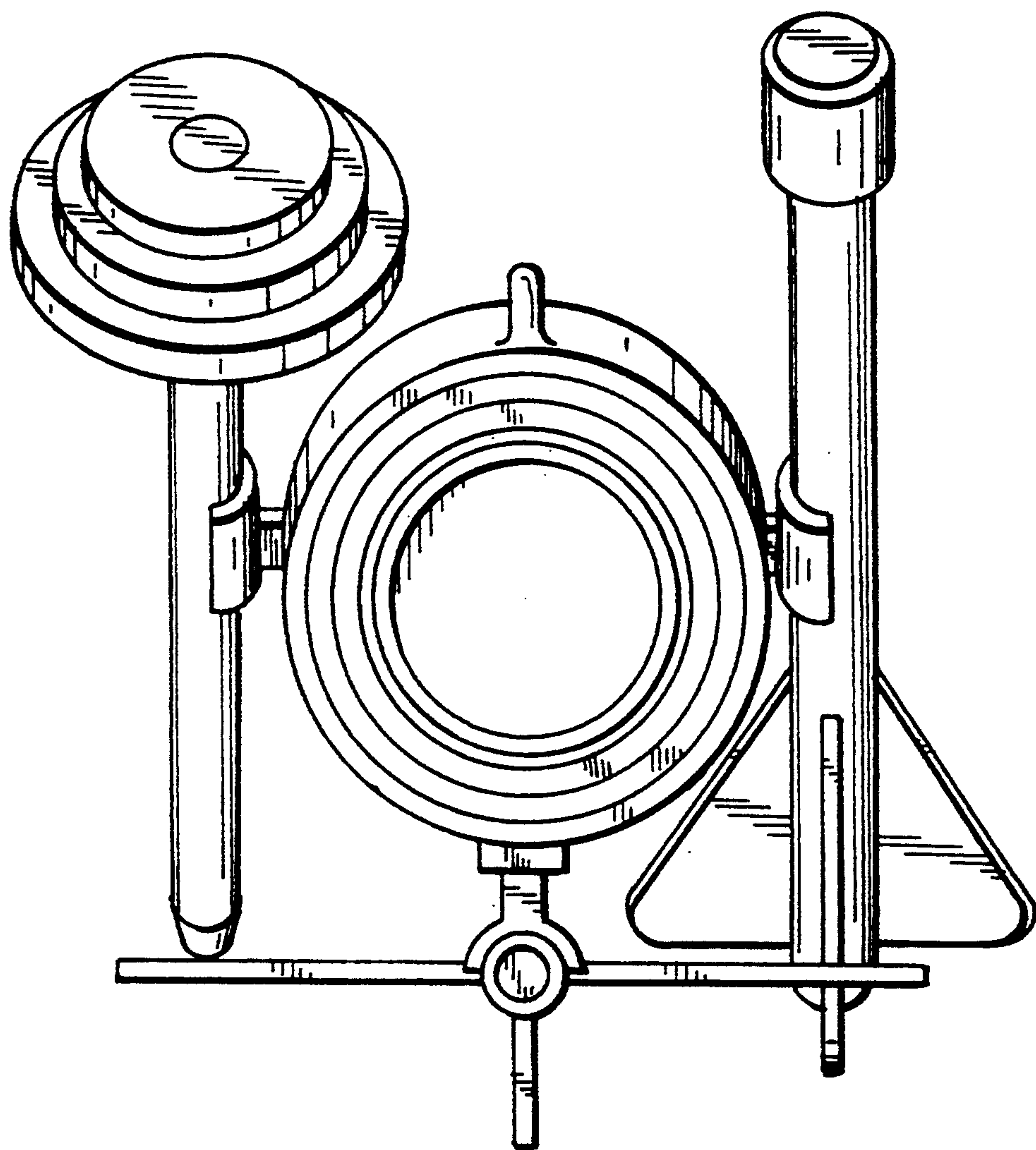
