FIG. 4 is a front side elevational view thereof;

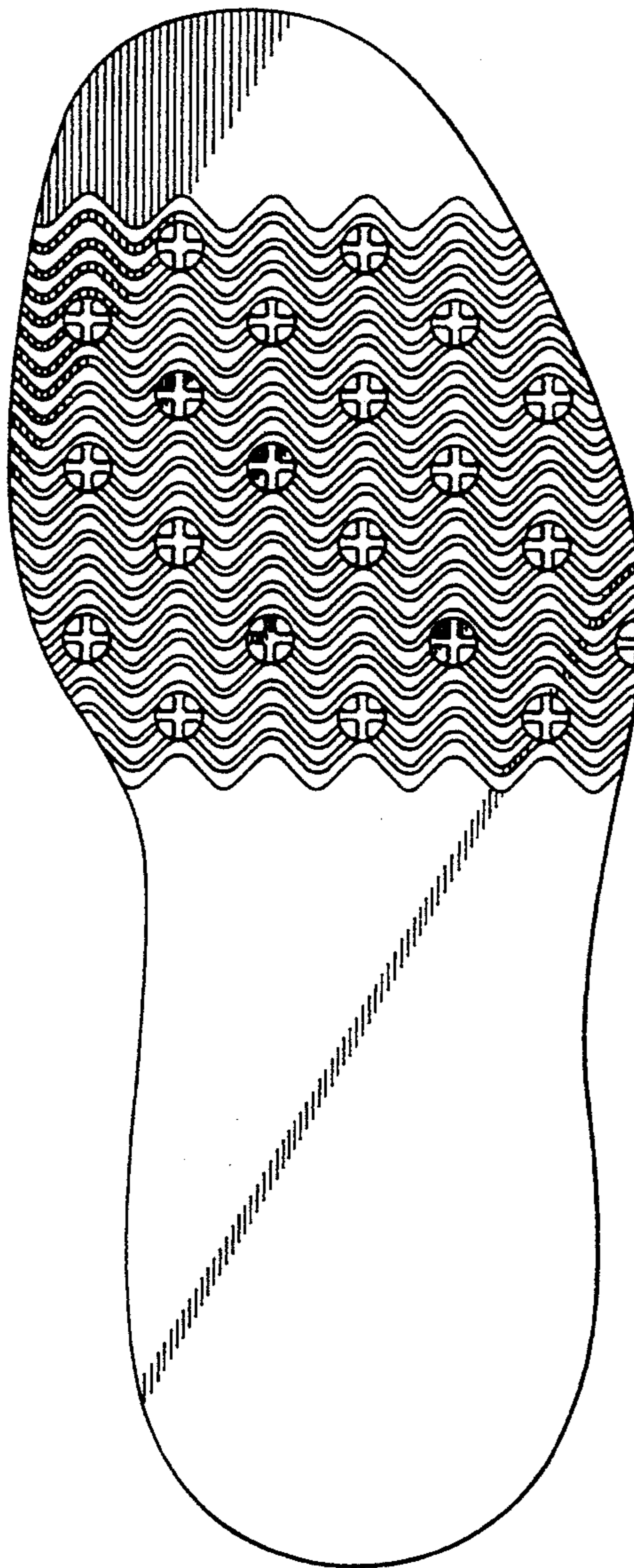
FIG. 5 is a rear side elevational view thereof; and,

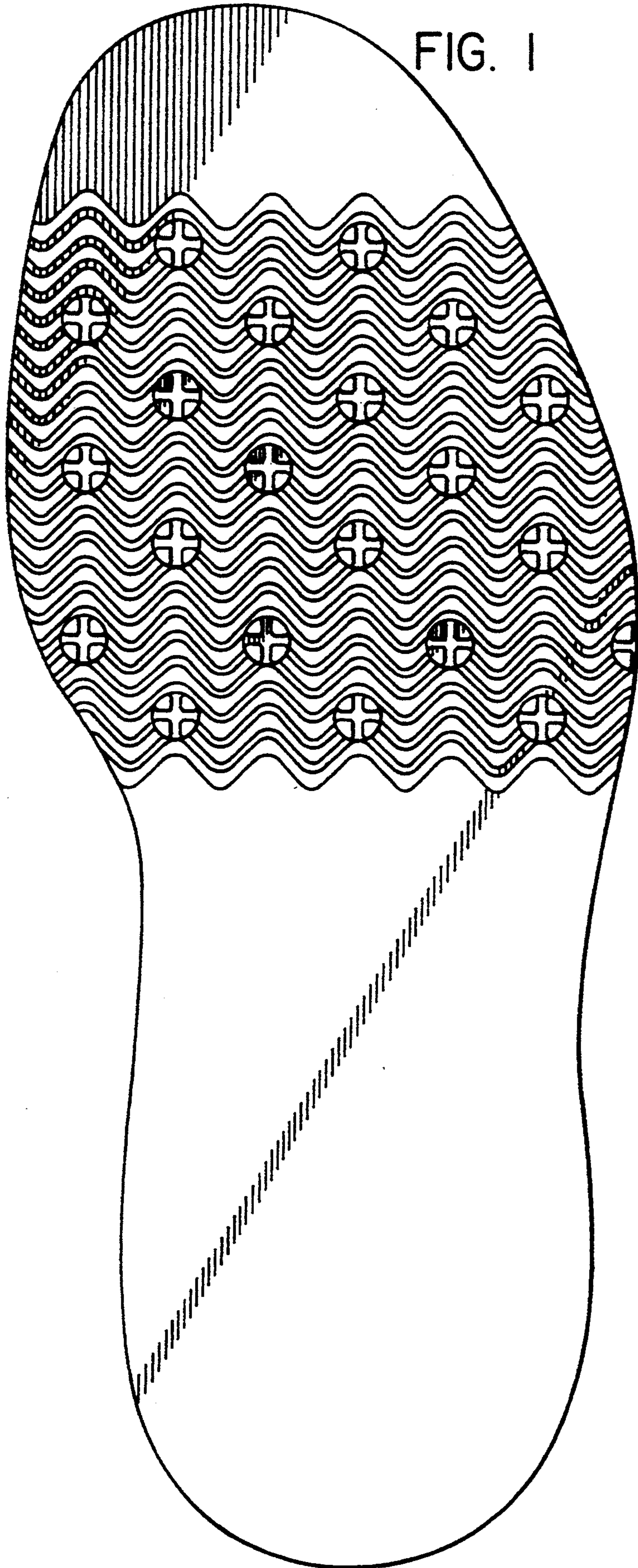

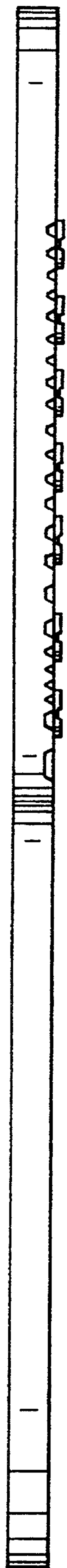

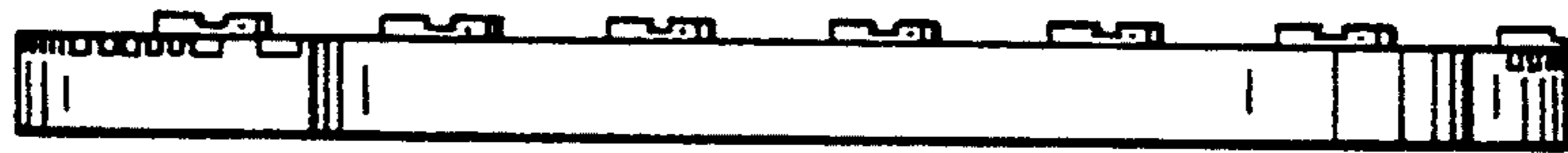

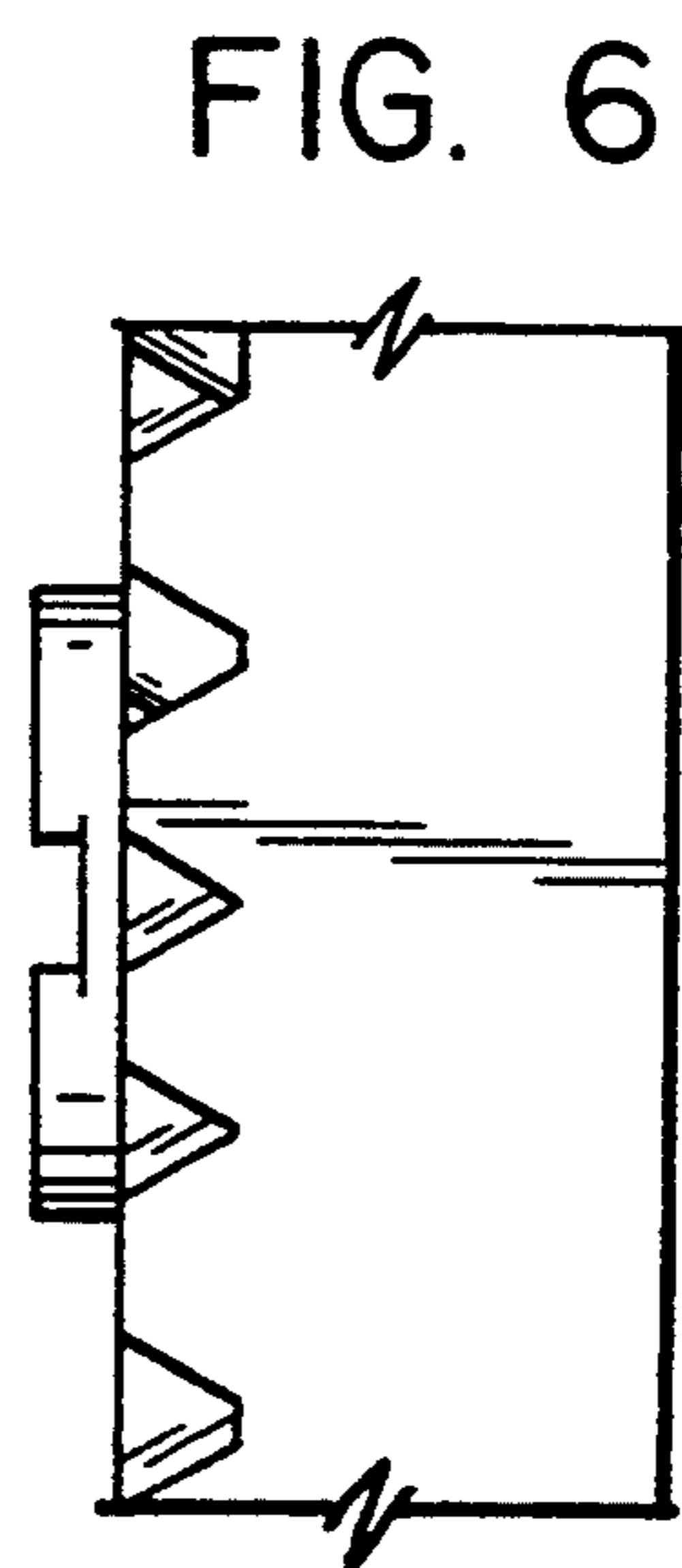
