FIG. 9 is an elevational view showing the outside of the booklet slip cover in open position;

FIG. 10 is an elevational view showing the inside of the booklet slip cover in open position with a booklet mounted therein shown in broken lines;

FIG. 11 is an enlarged left edge elevational view of the booklet slip cover in open position with a booklet mounted therein shown in broken lines;

FIG. 12 is an enlarged right edge elevational view of the booklet slip cover in open position with a booklet mounted therein shown in broken lines;

FIG. 13 is an enlarged top plan view of the booklet slip cover in open position with a booklet mounted therein shown in broken lines; and,

FIG. 14 is an enlarged bottom plan view of the booklet slip cover in open position with a booklet mounted therein shown in broken lines.

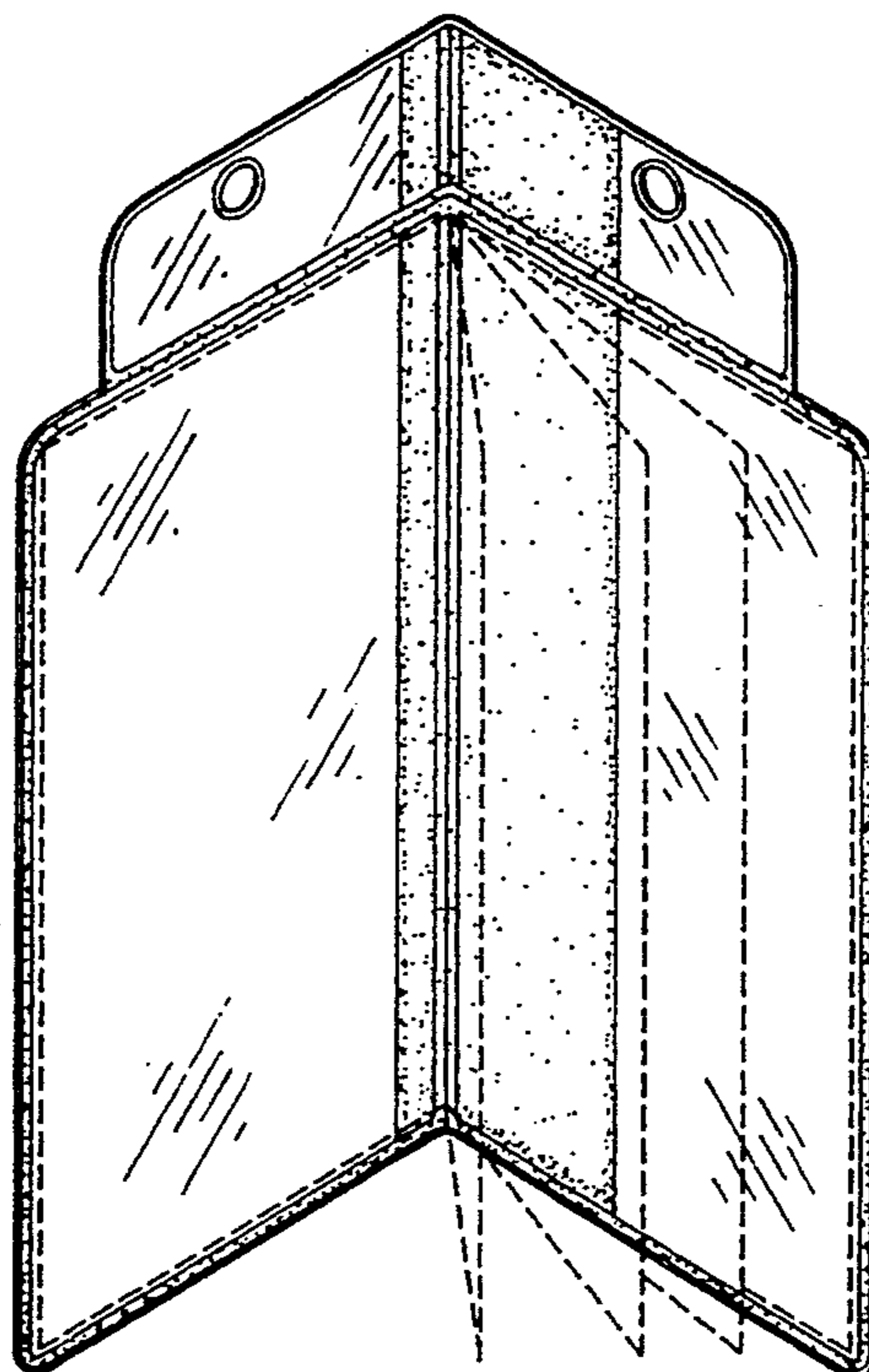

The portions shown in broken lines in FIGS. 8 and 10 through 14 are for informational purposes only and form no part of the instant design.



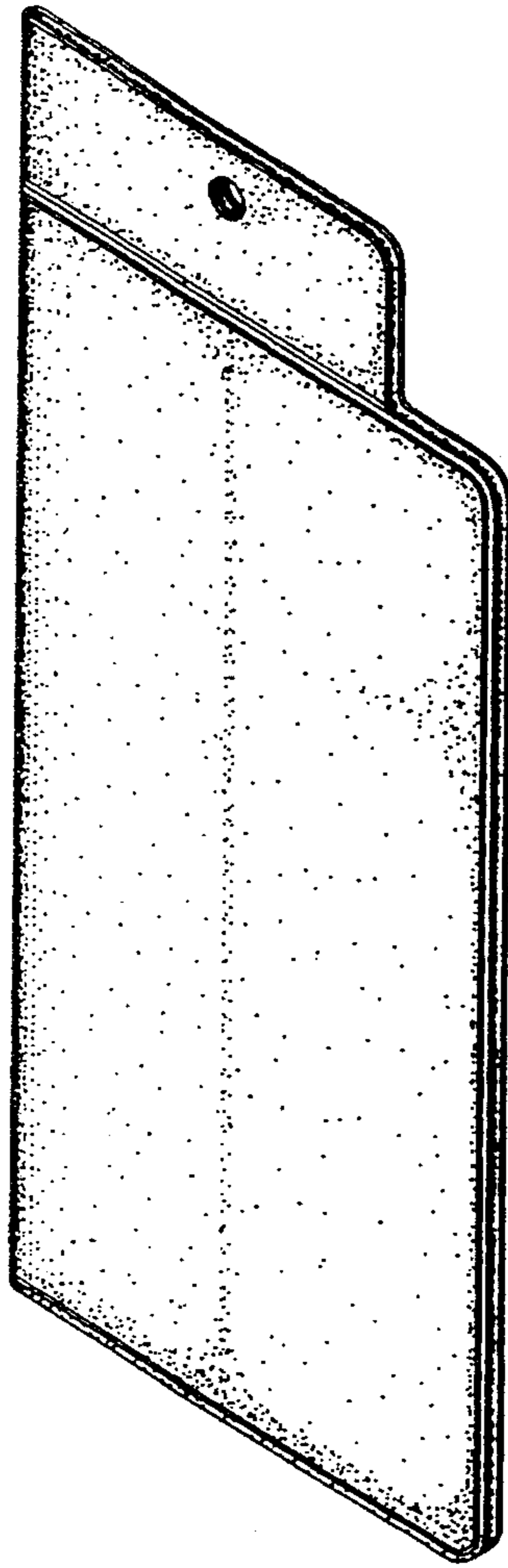

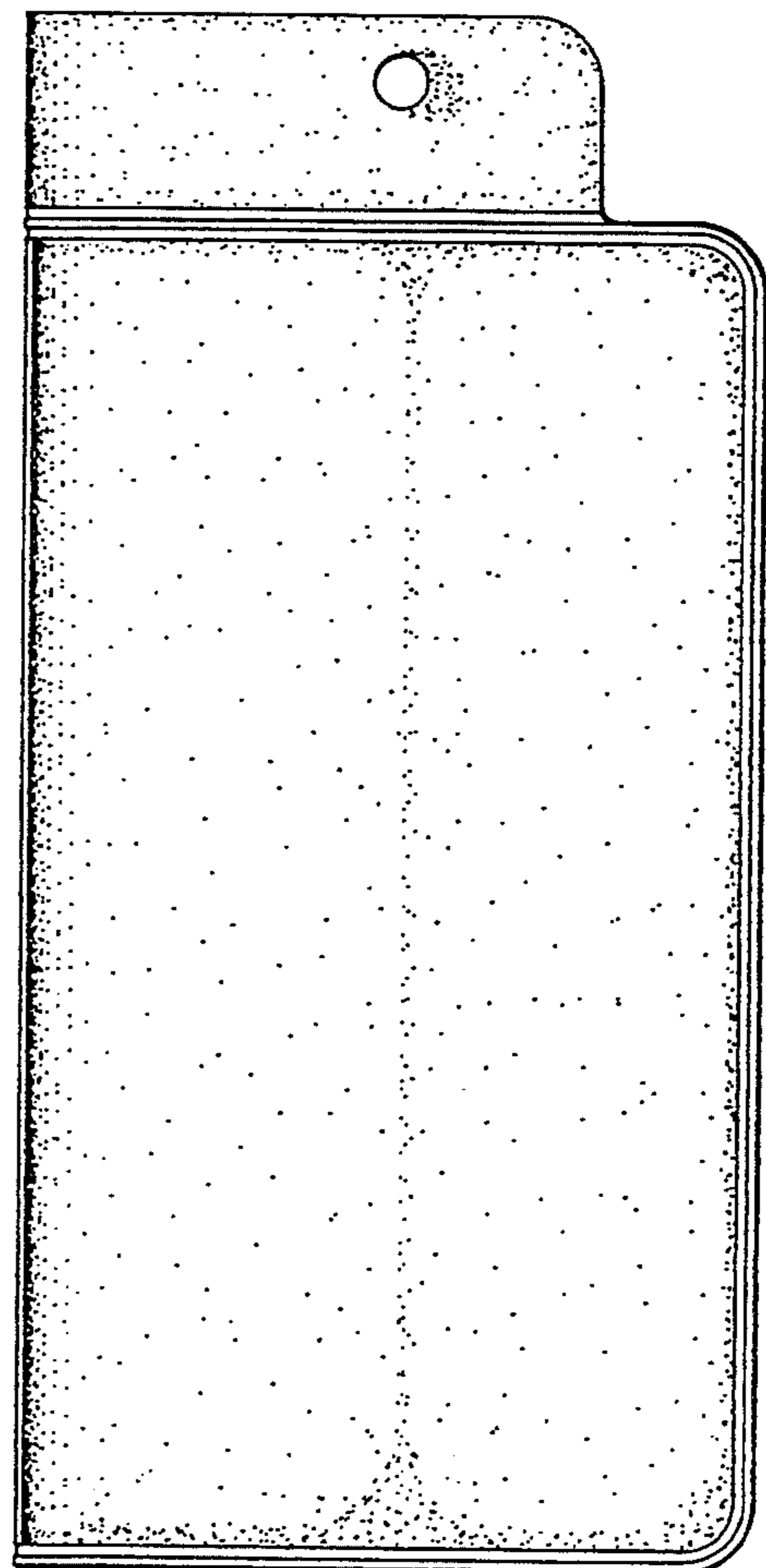

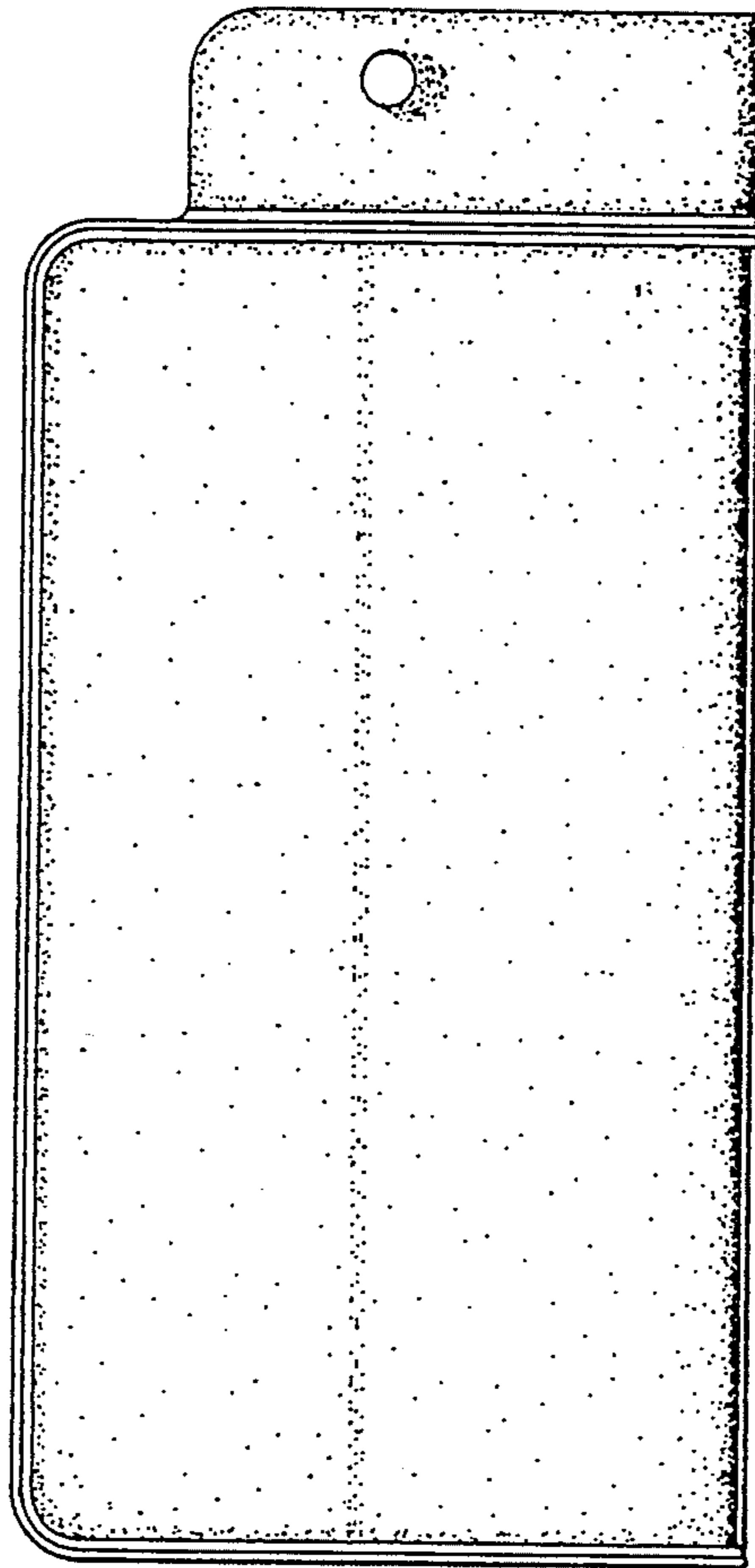

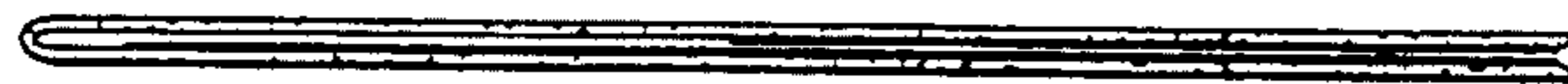

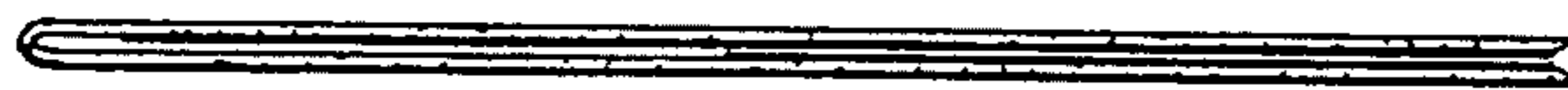

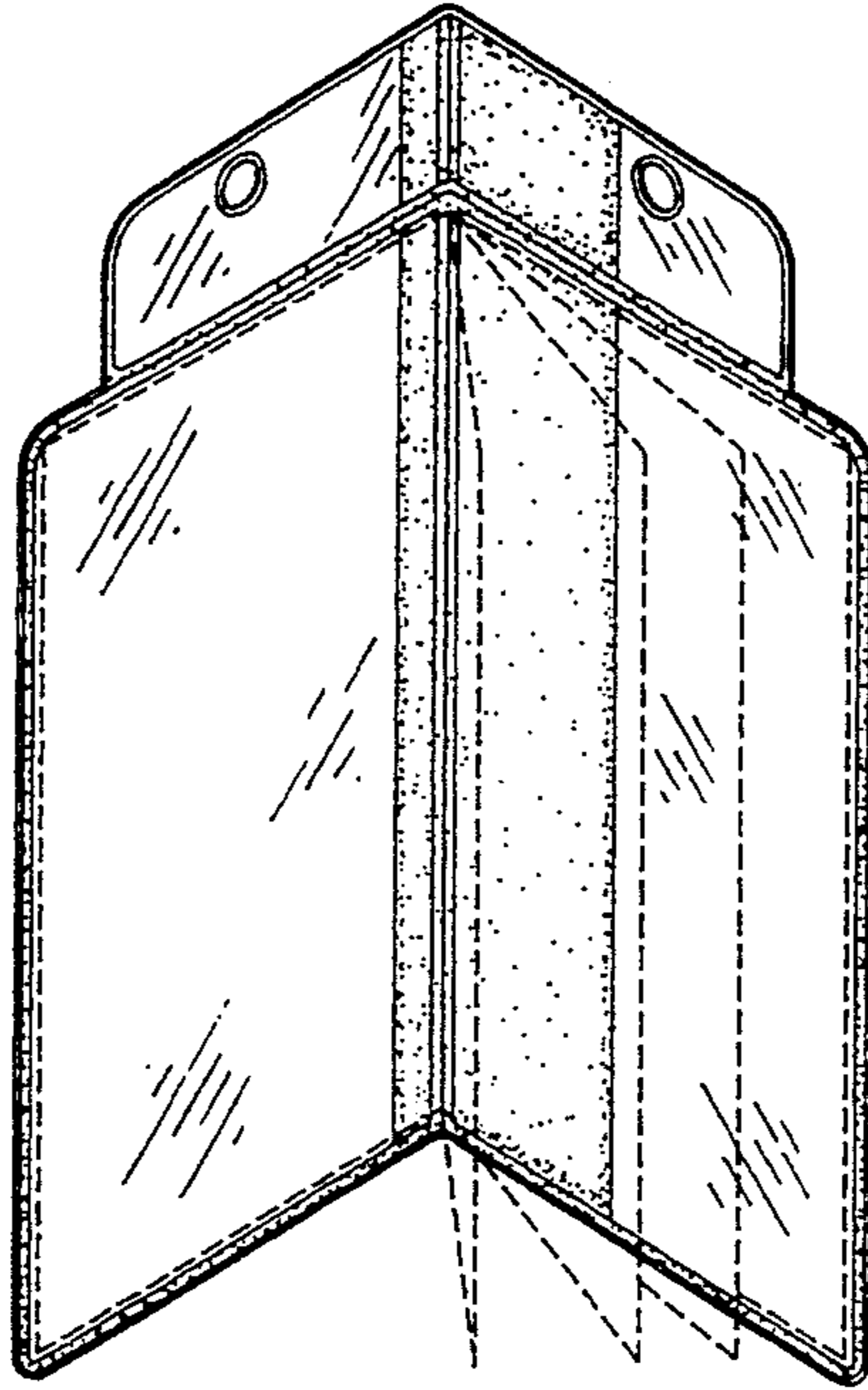

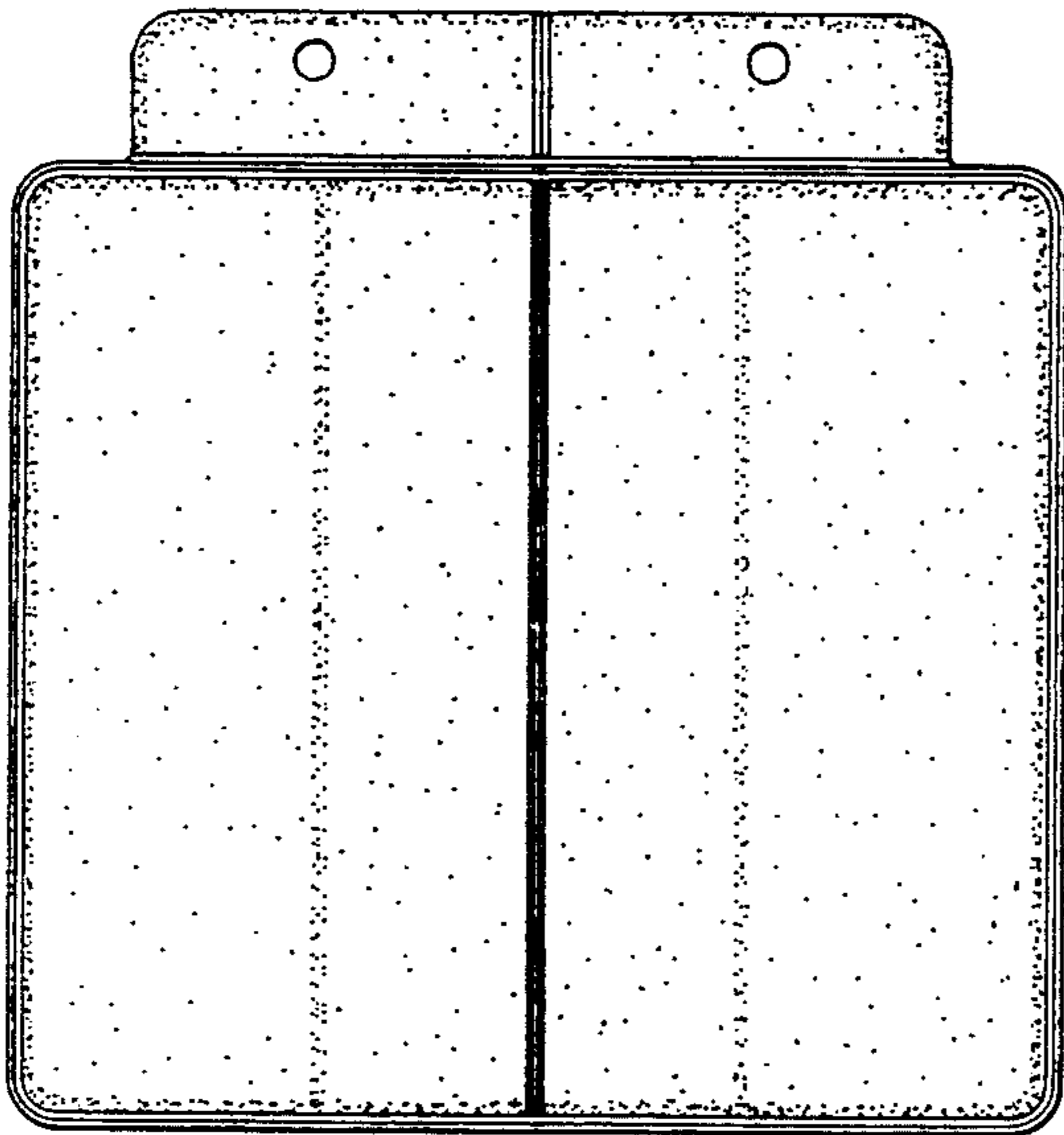

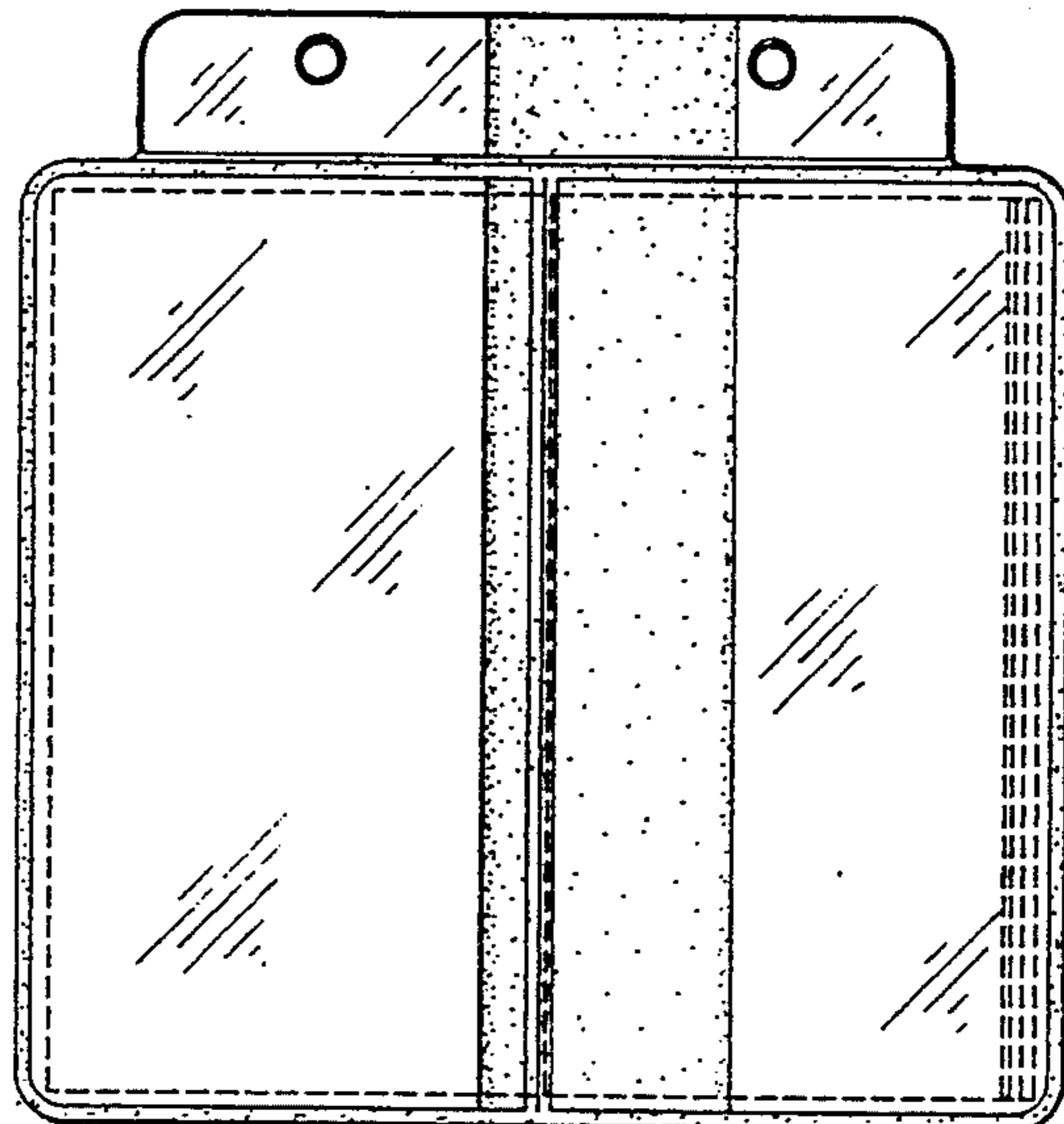
