## **DESCRIPTION**


FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined foldable label and perforated portion for barcodes showing my new design, with the dash lines indicating a folding area;


FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, with the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, with the design shown in an unfolded condition; and,

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof, with the opposite side being a mirror image.


