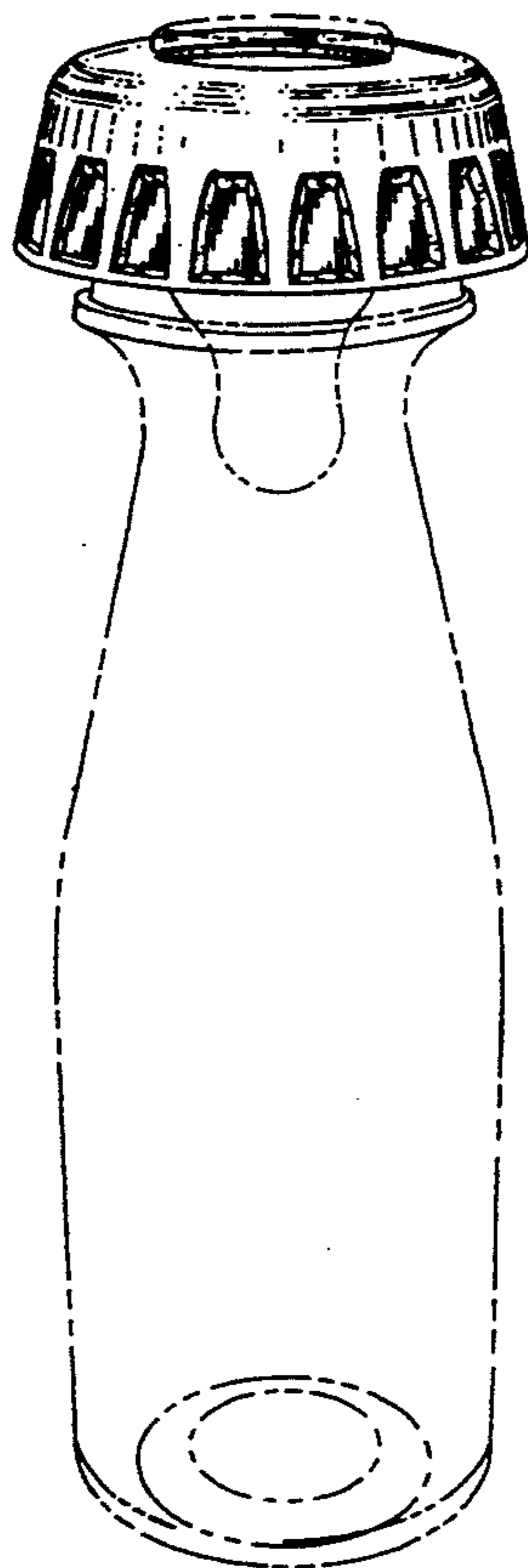

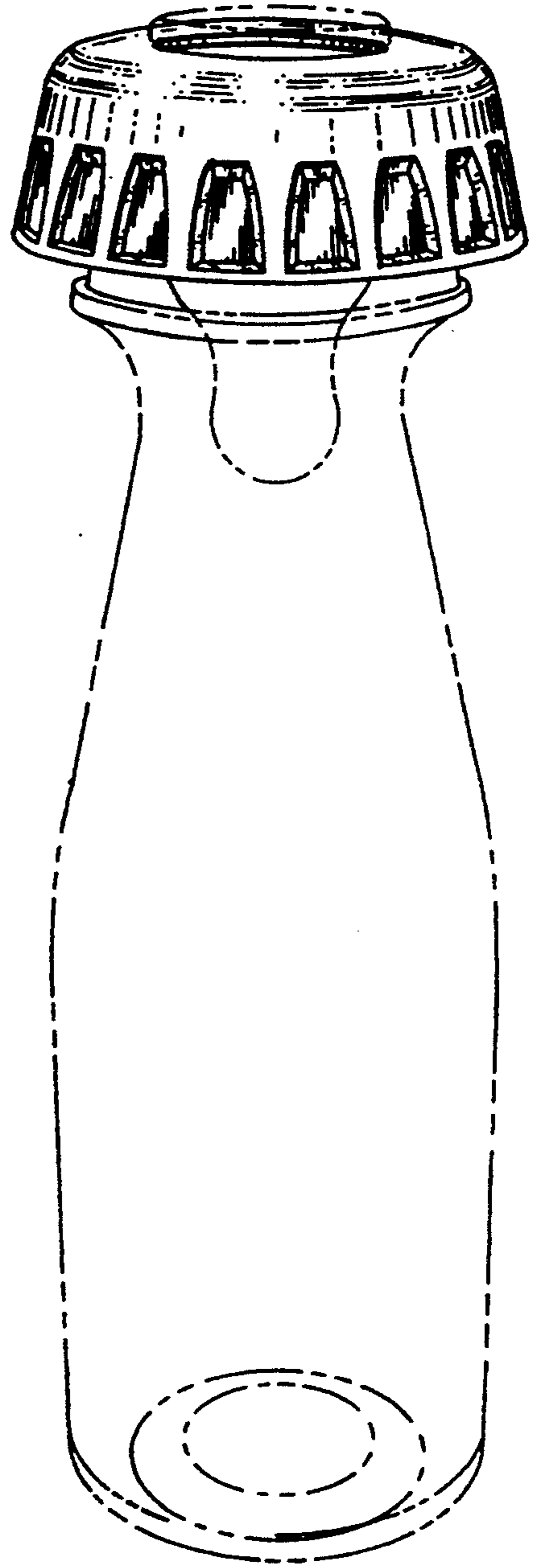
An ornamental design for a baby bottle cap, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

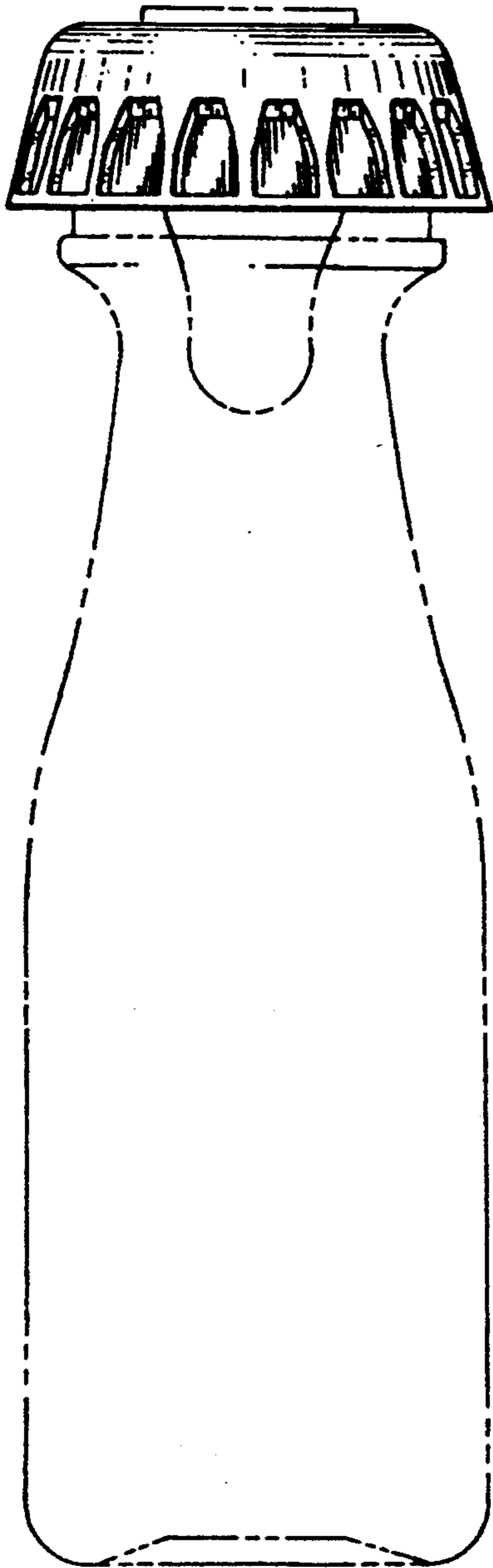
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a baby bottle cap according to a preferred embodiment of the design; FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the embodiment of the design that is depicted in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the embodiment of the design that is depicted in FIGS. 1 and 2; and, FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of the design that is depicted in FIGS. 1, 2 and 3. The broken line showing in the views is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



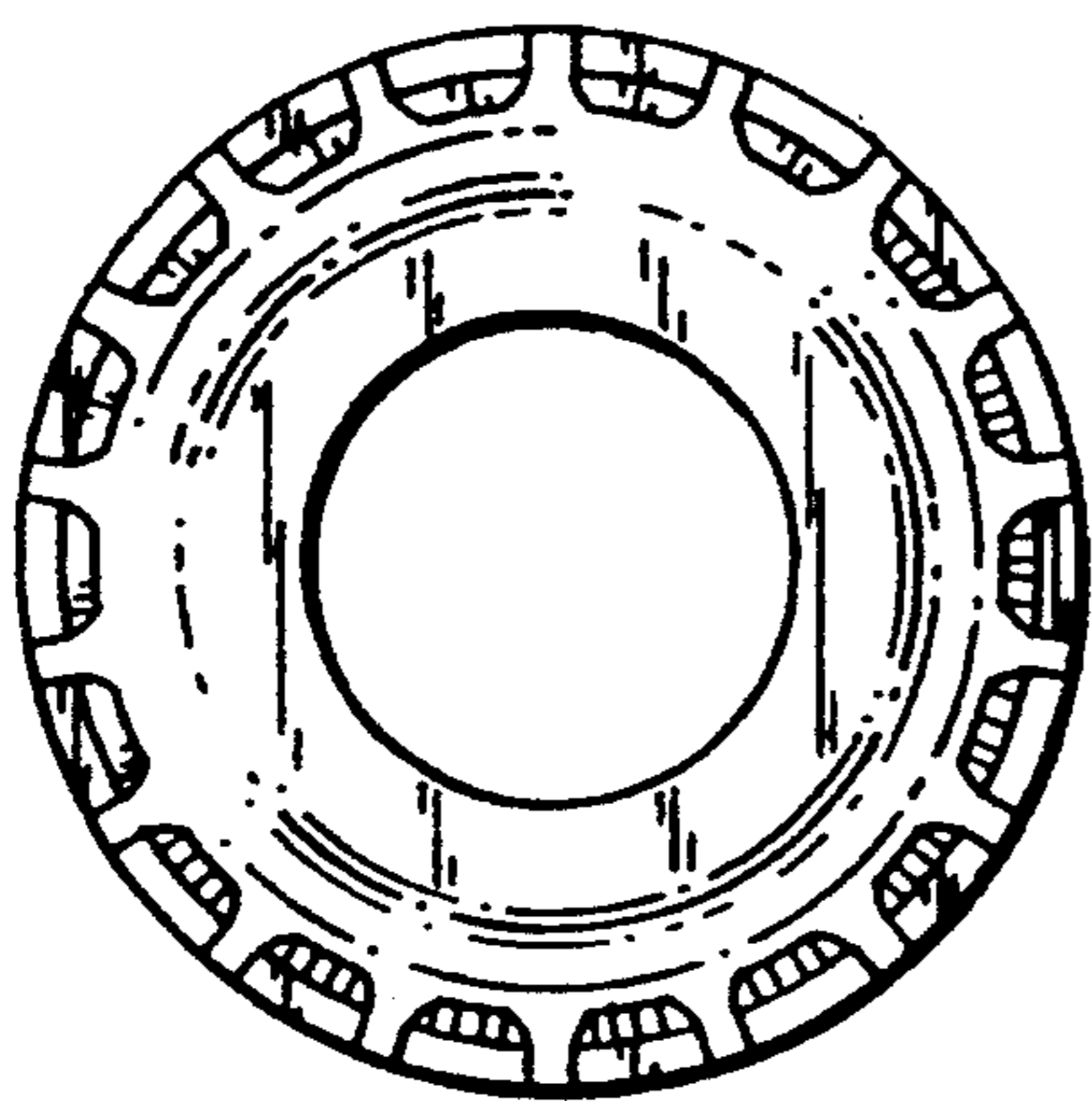
