[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a ski vest, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a ski vest showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top, rear and left side perspective view thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof.

The broken lines shown throughout the views are understood to represent conventional stitching.

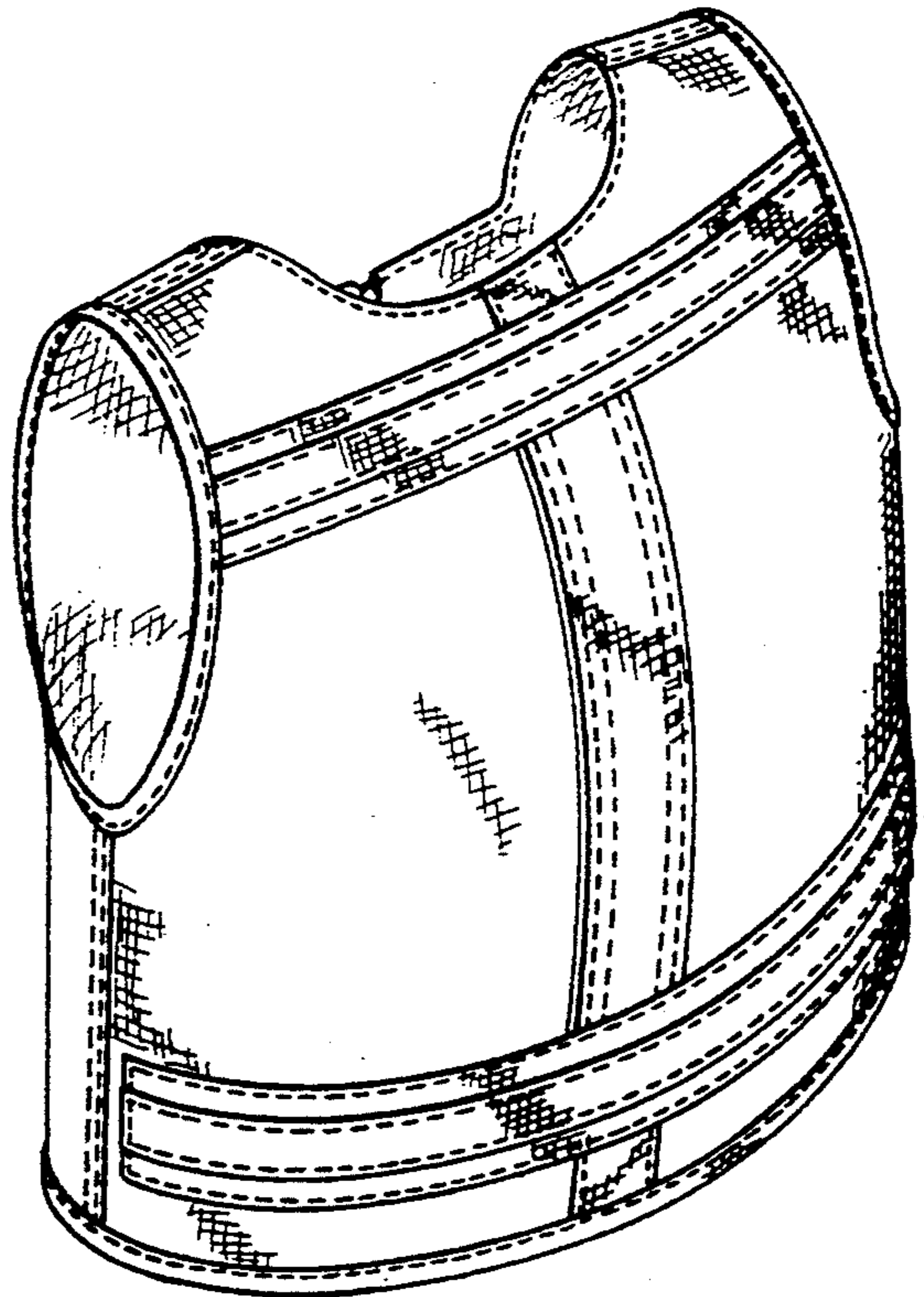
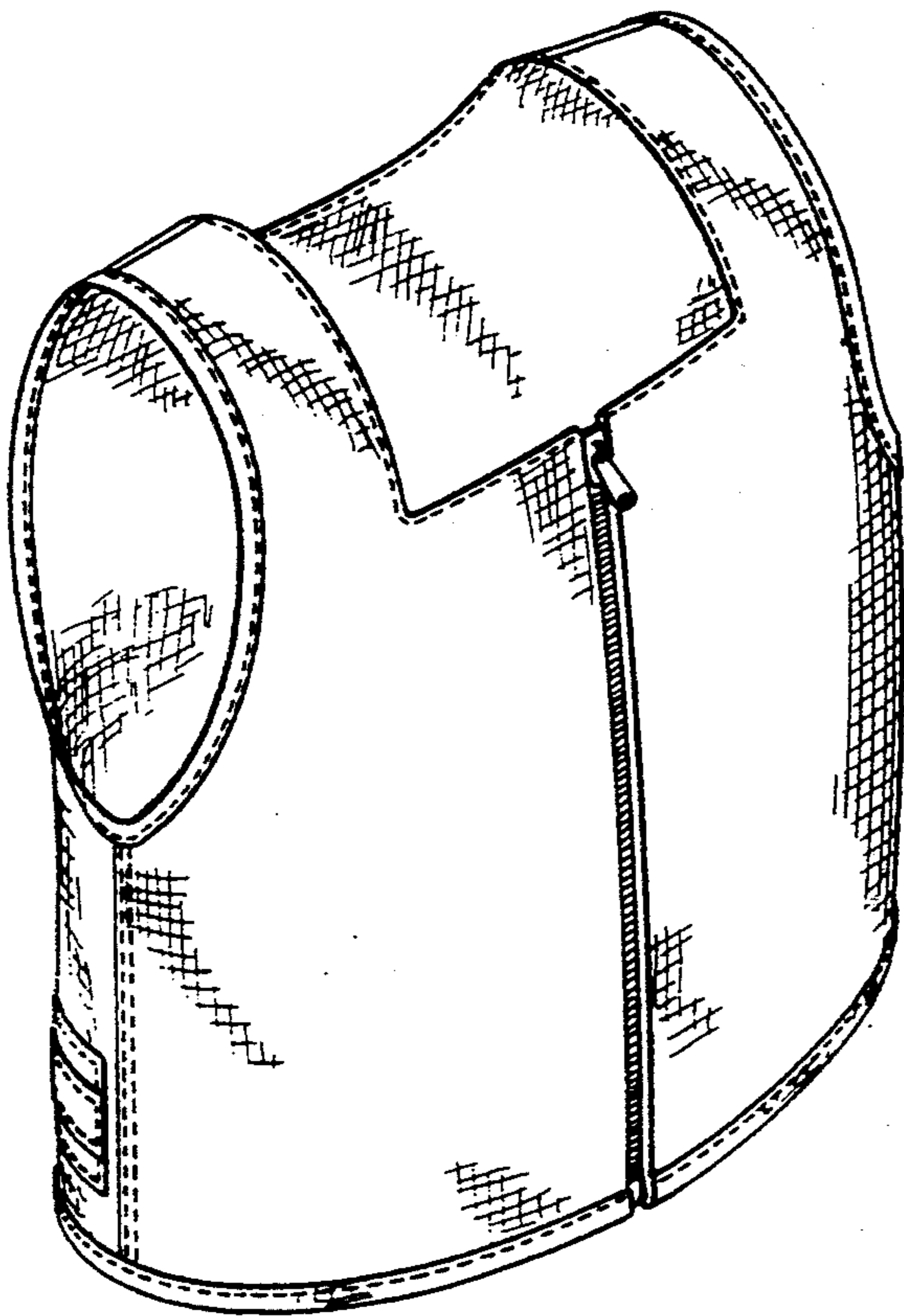

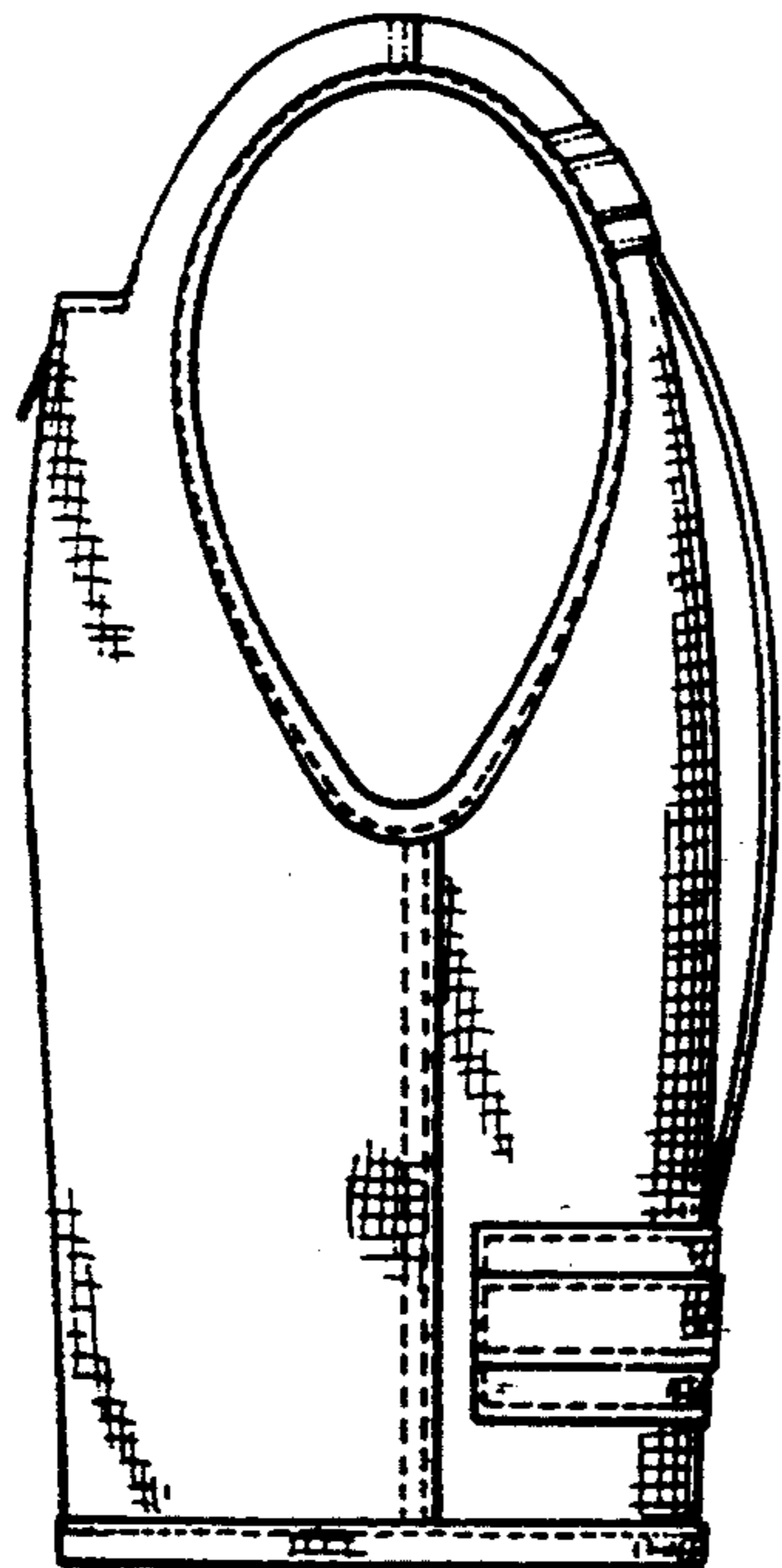
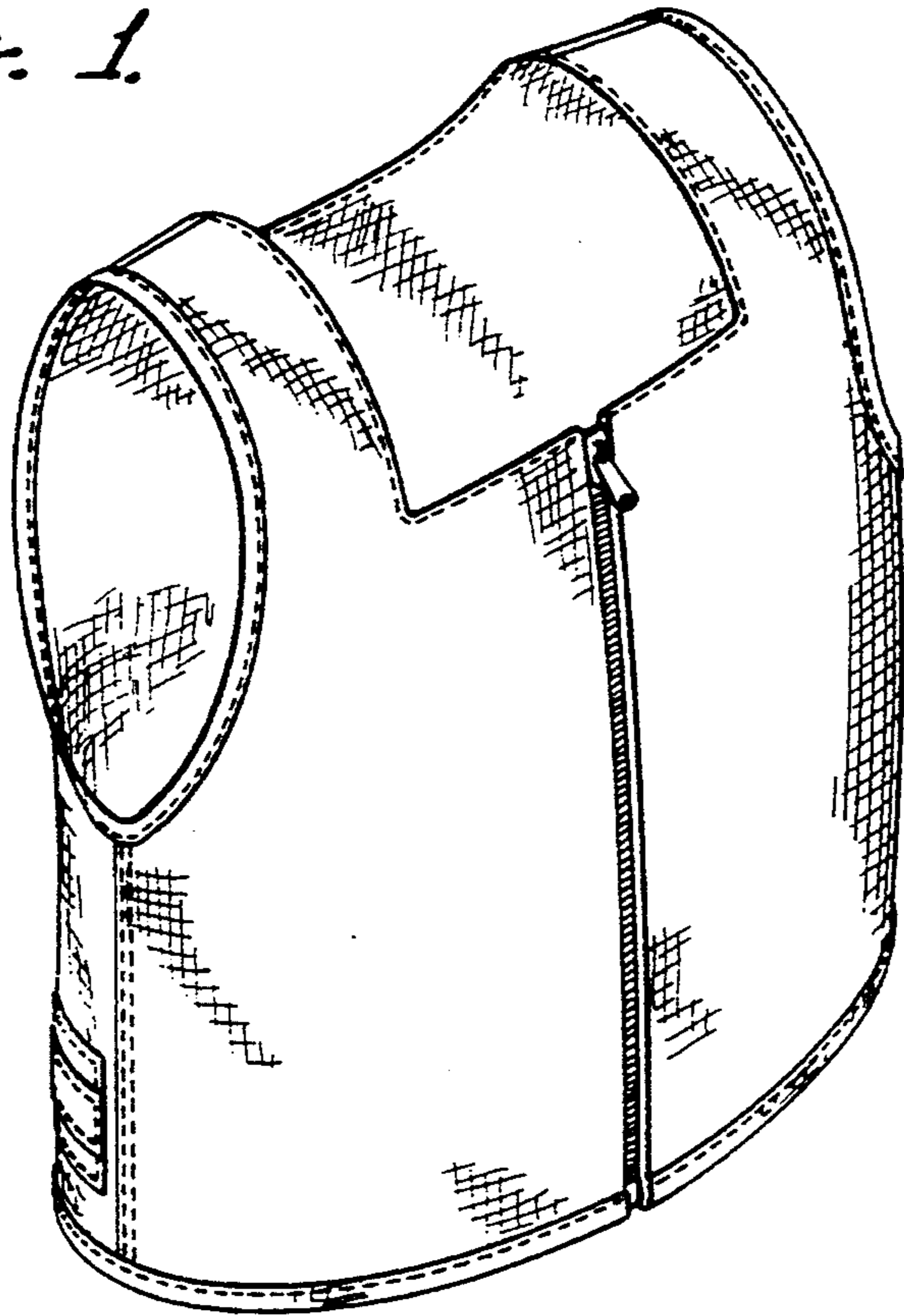

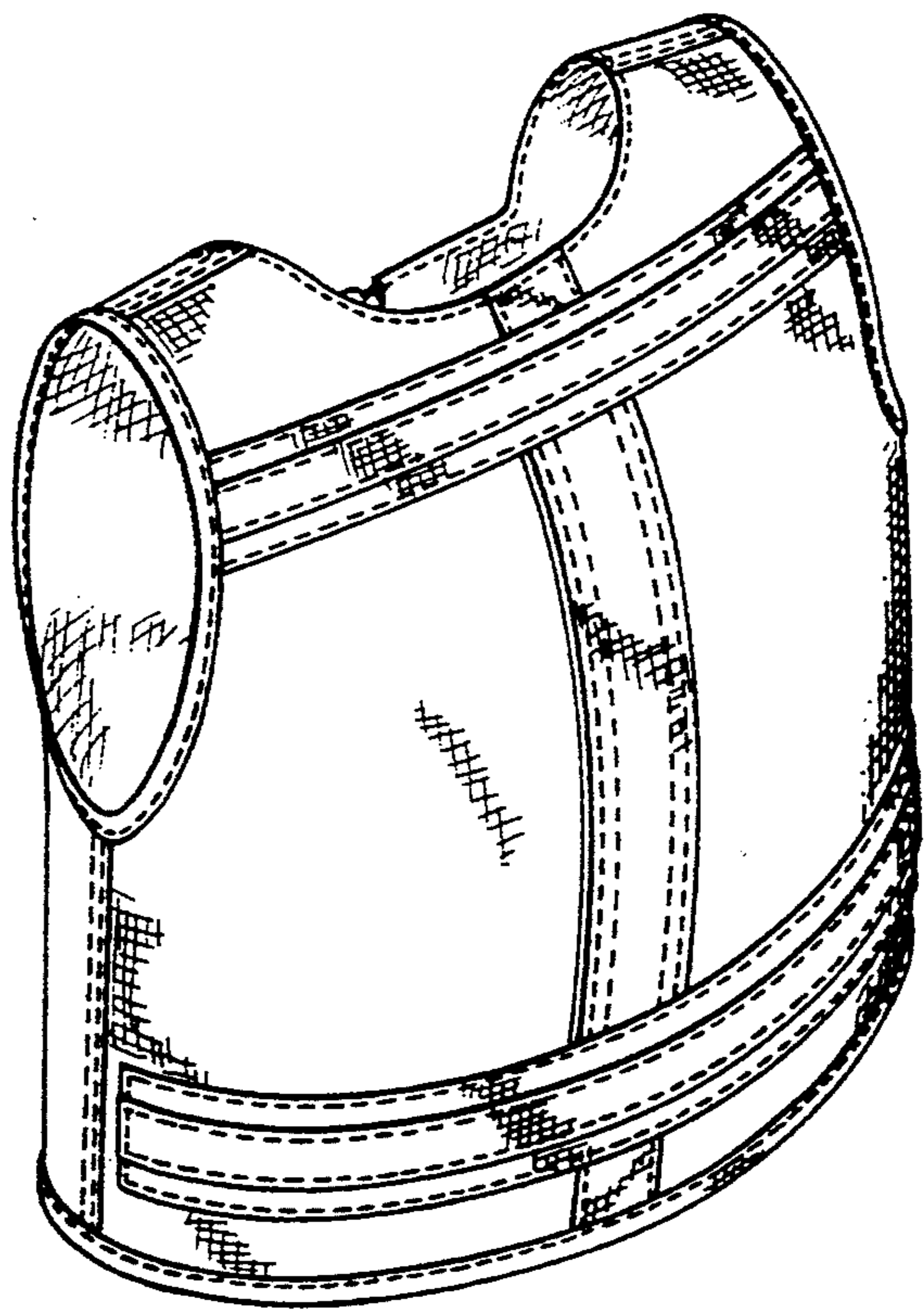
