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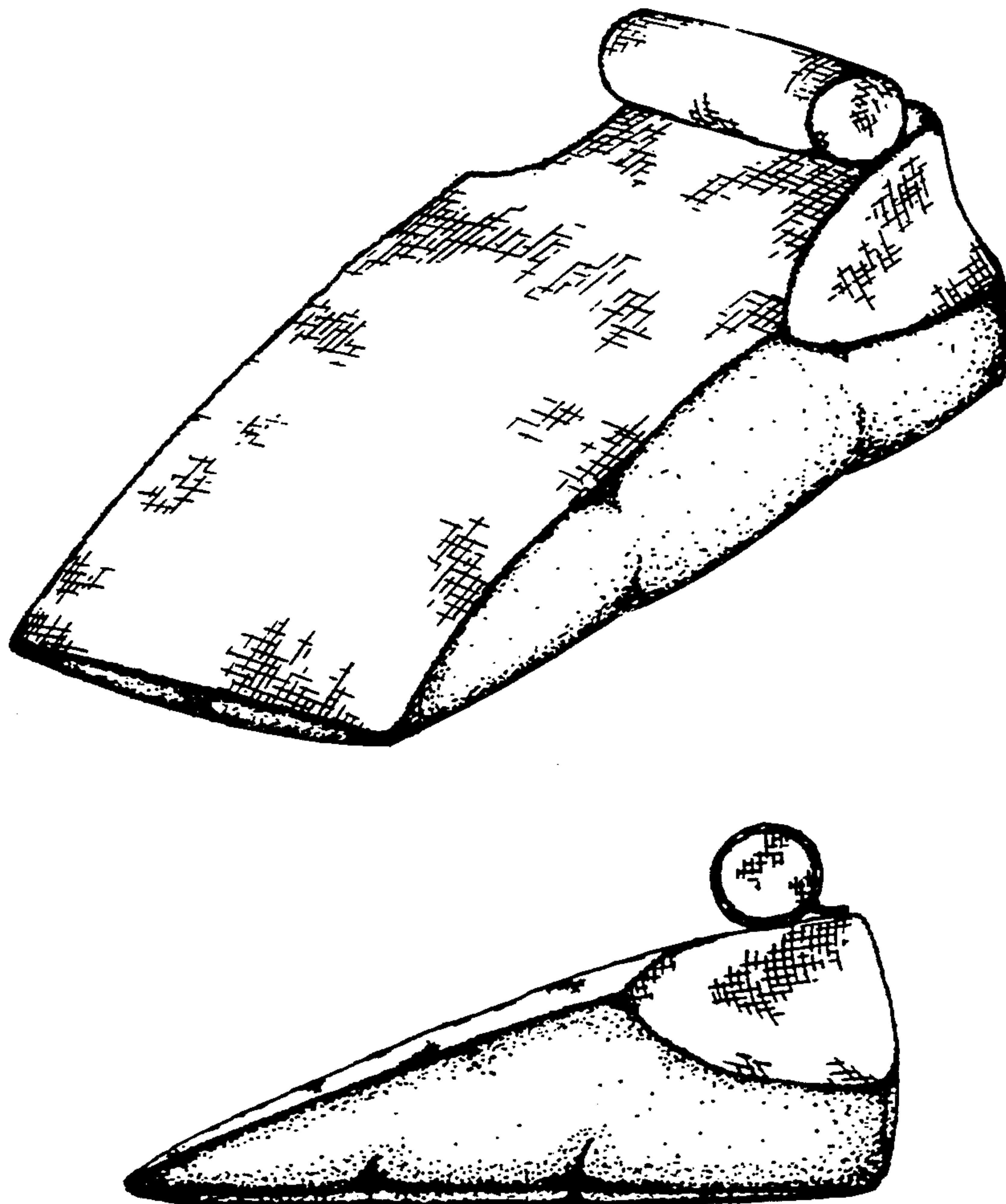

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the orthopedic pillow, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof with the two sides being the same;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The cross-hatching represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend throughout the areas represented.



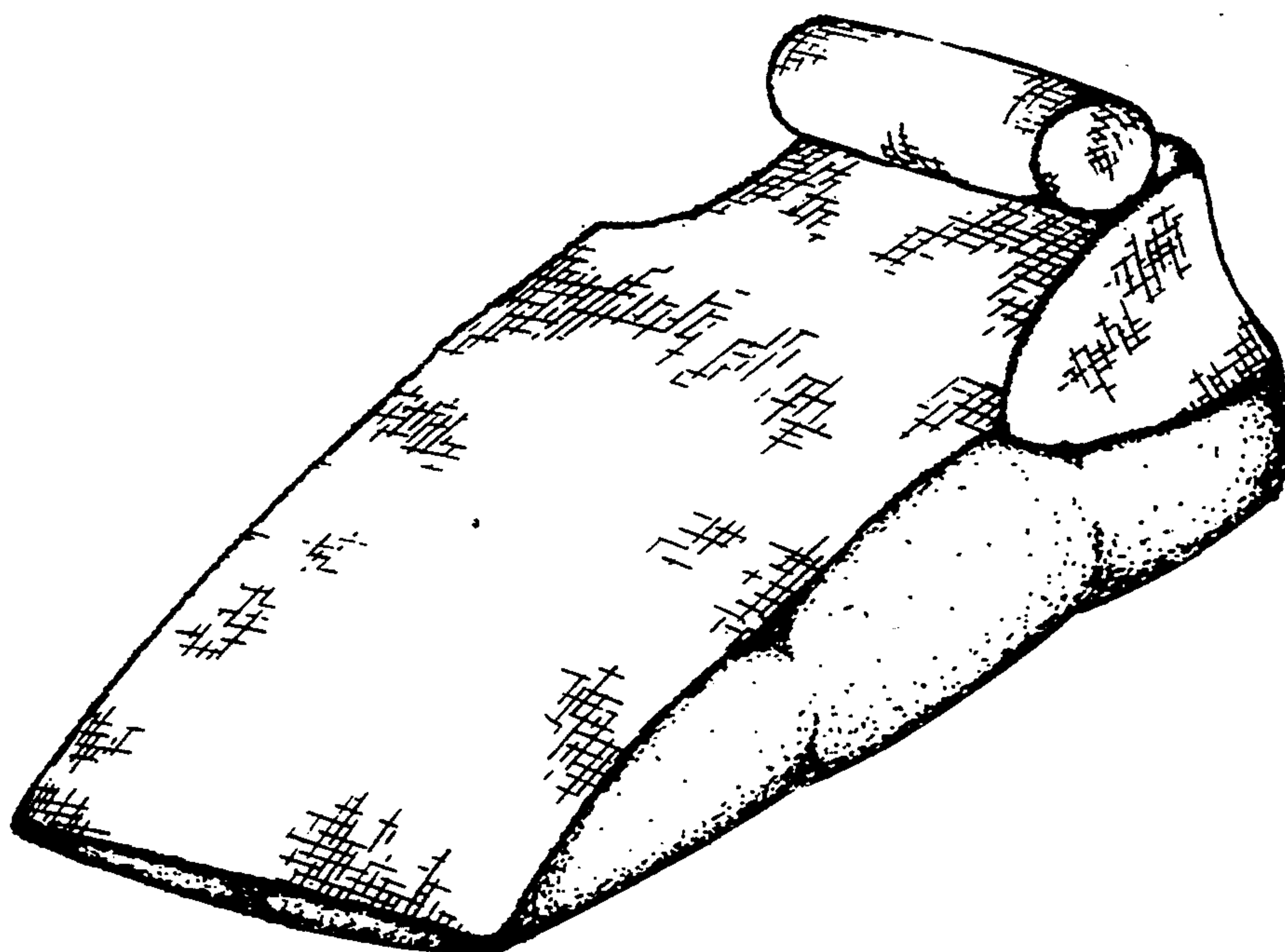

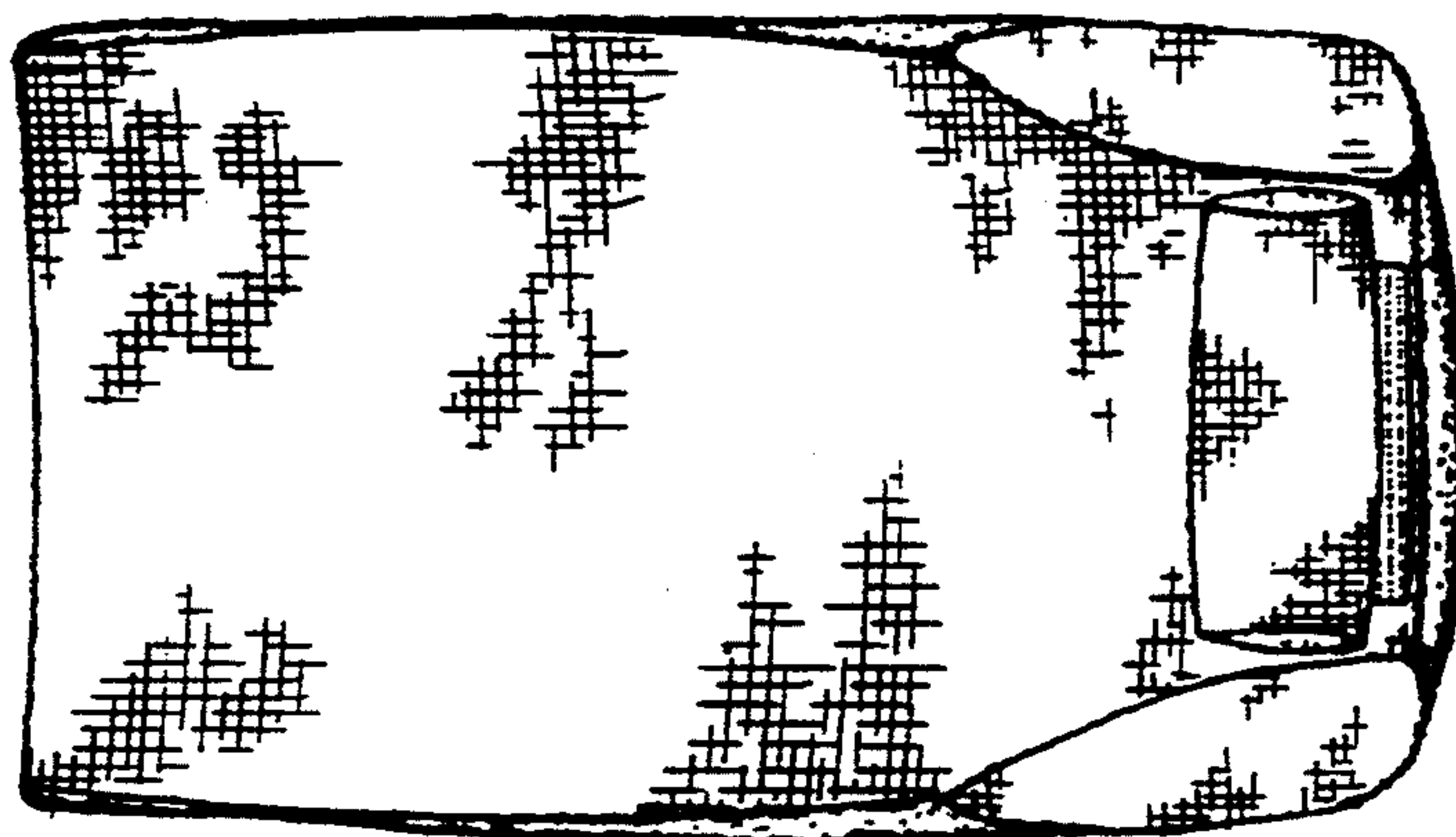

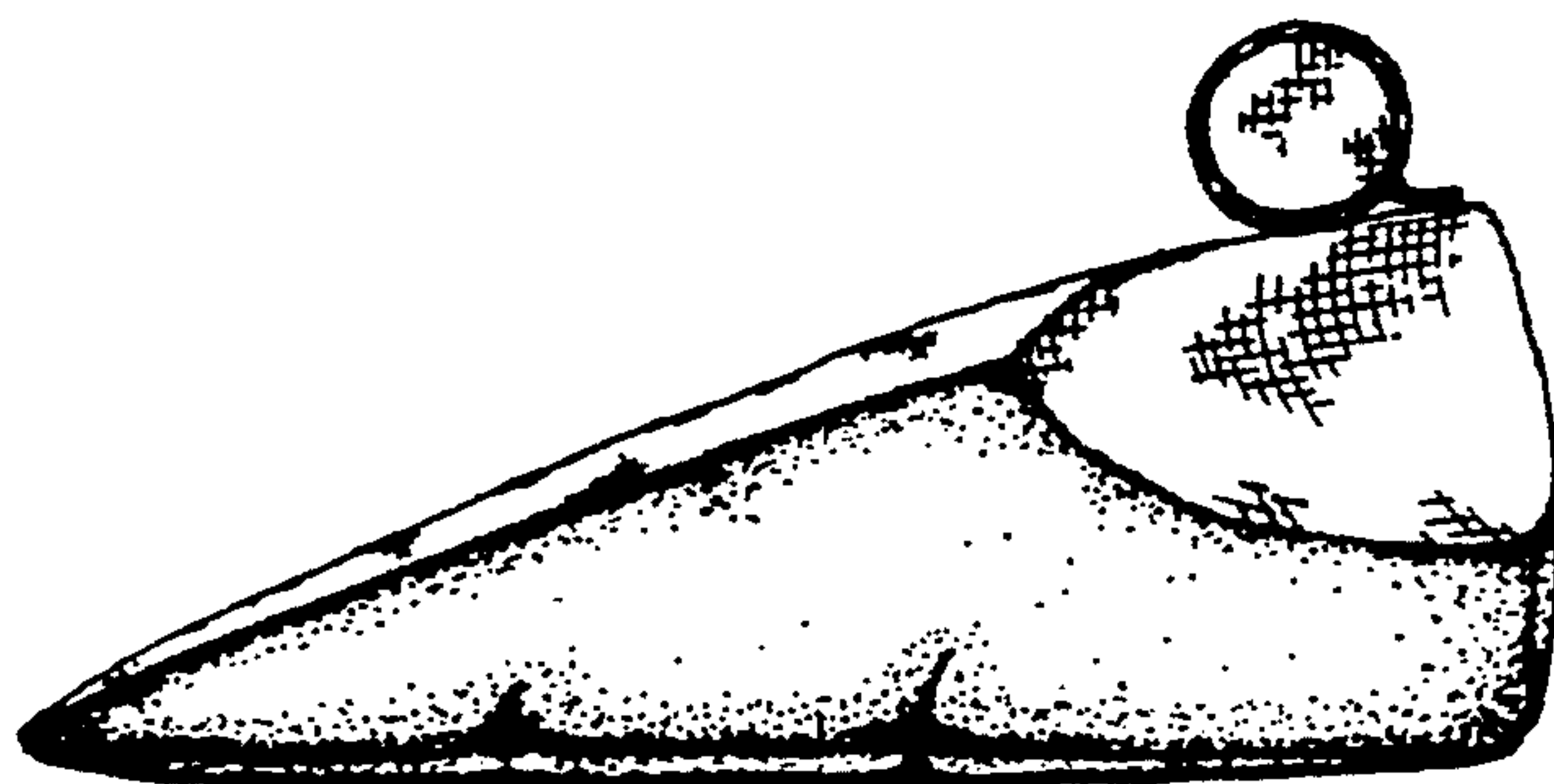

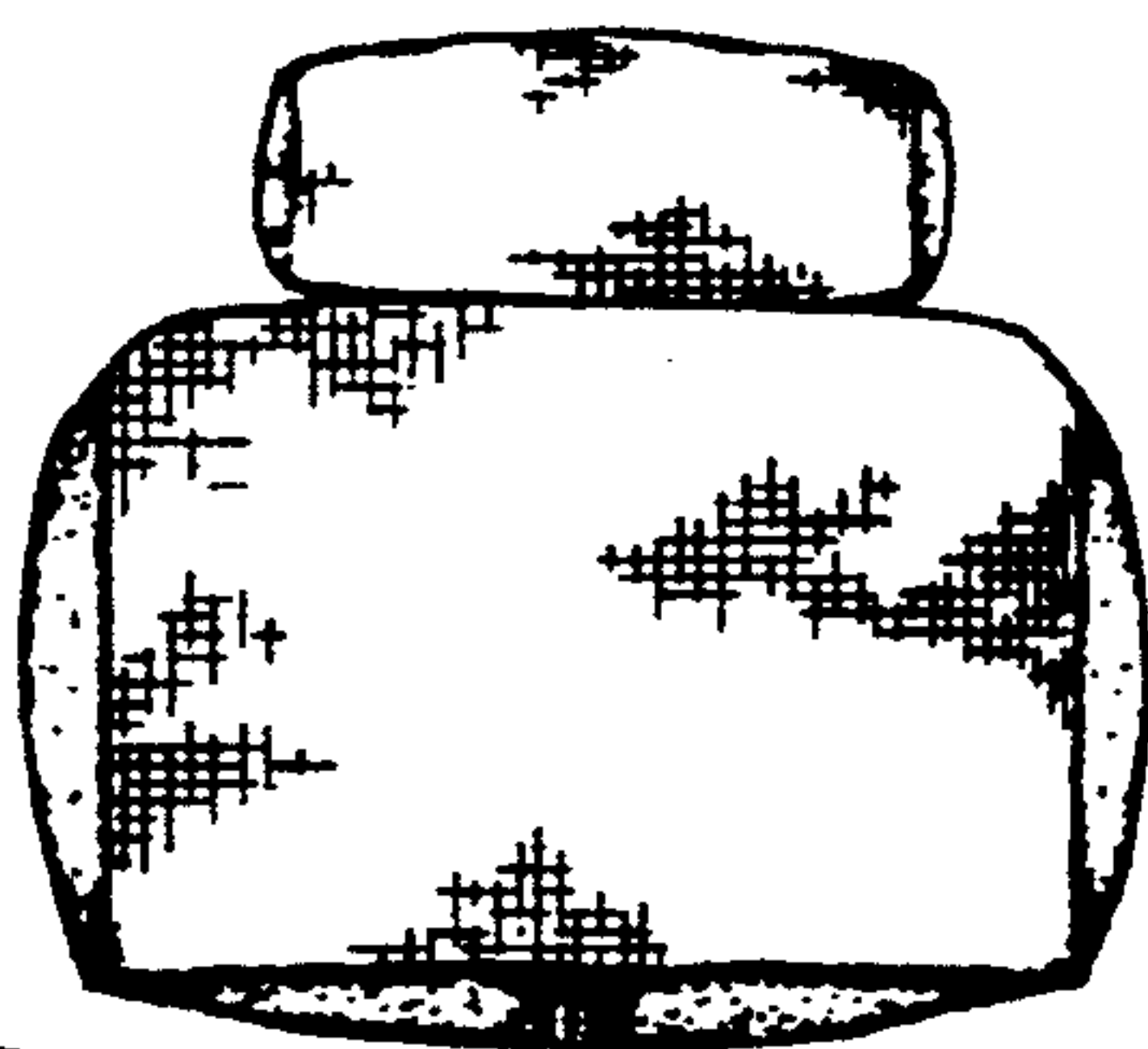

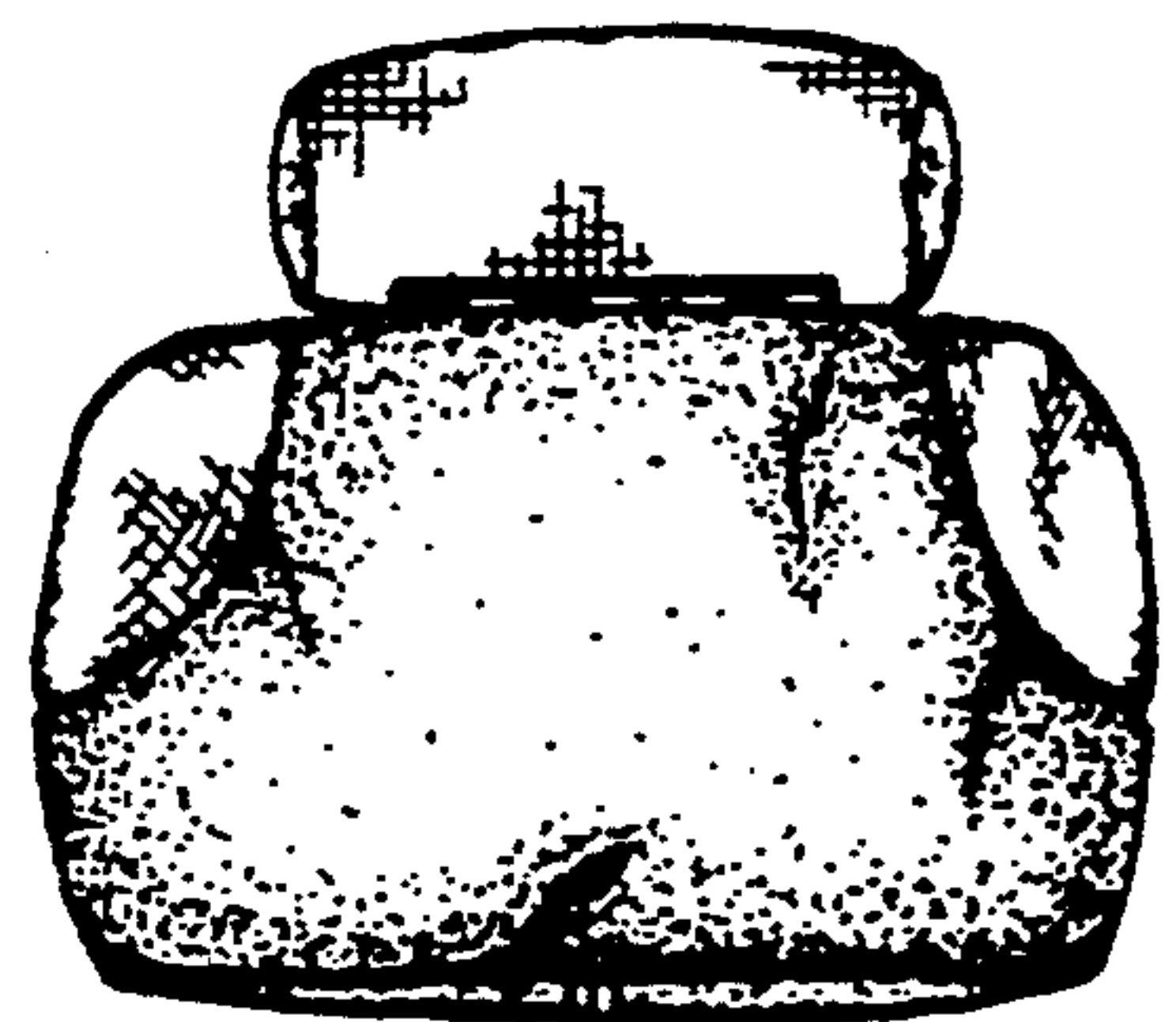

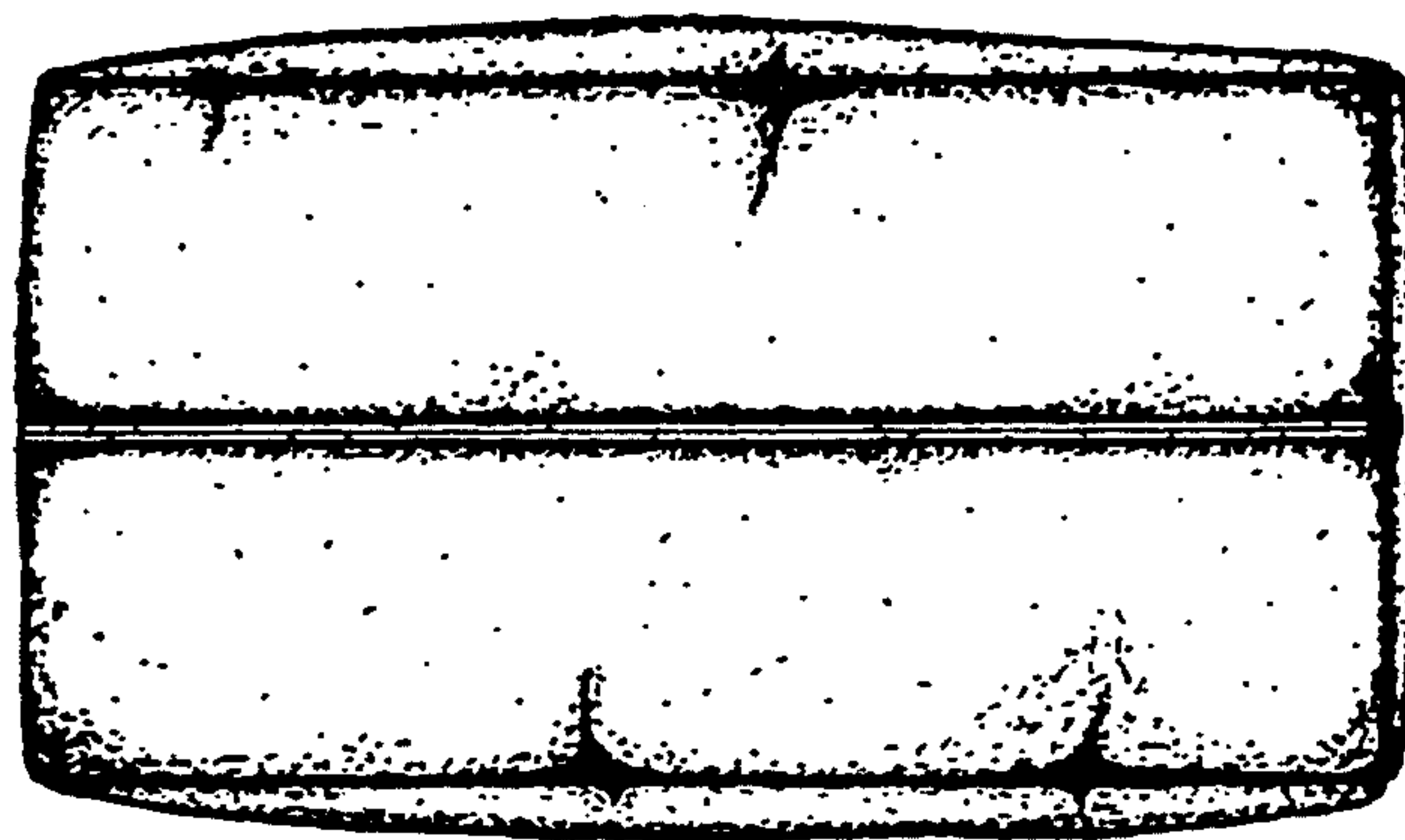
