The ornamental design for a label for computer disks, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the label for computer disks showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

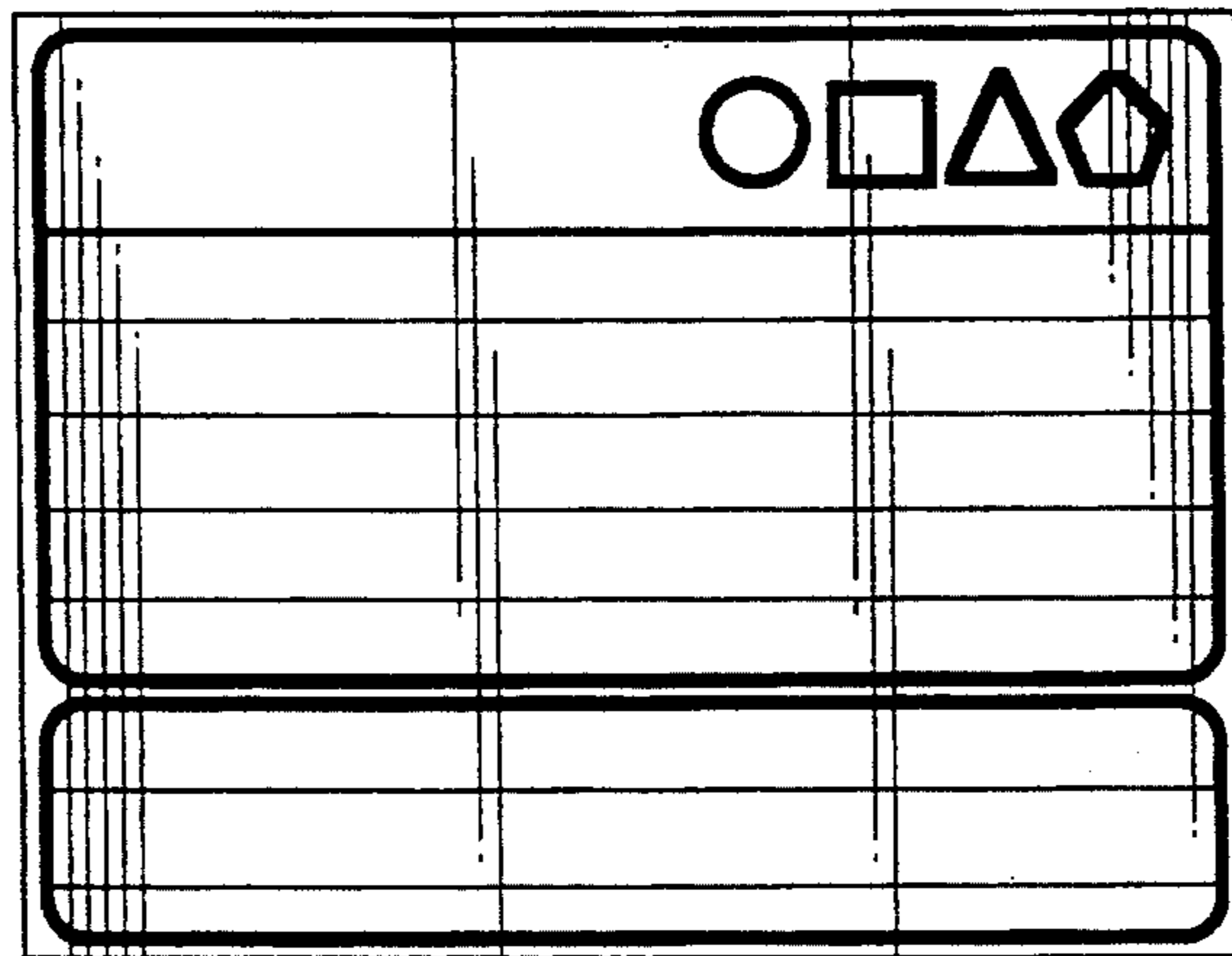

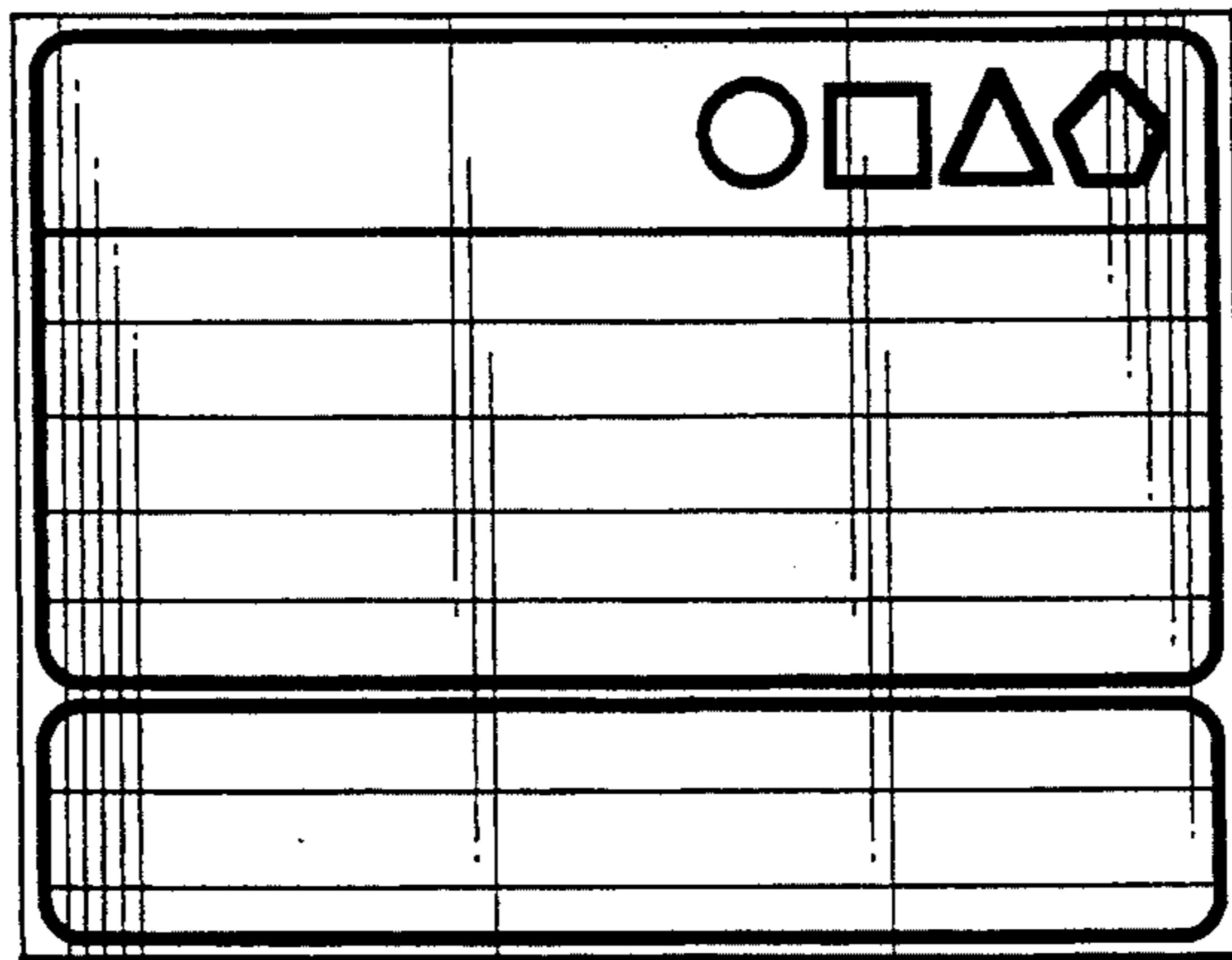

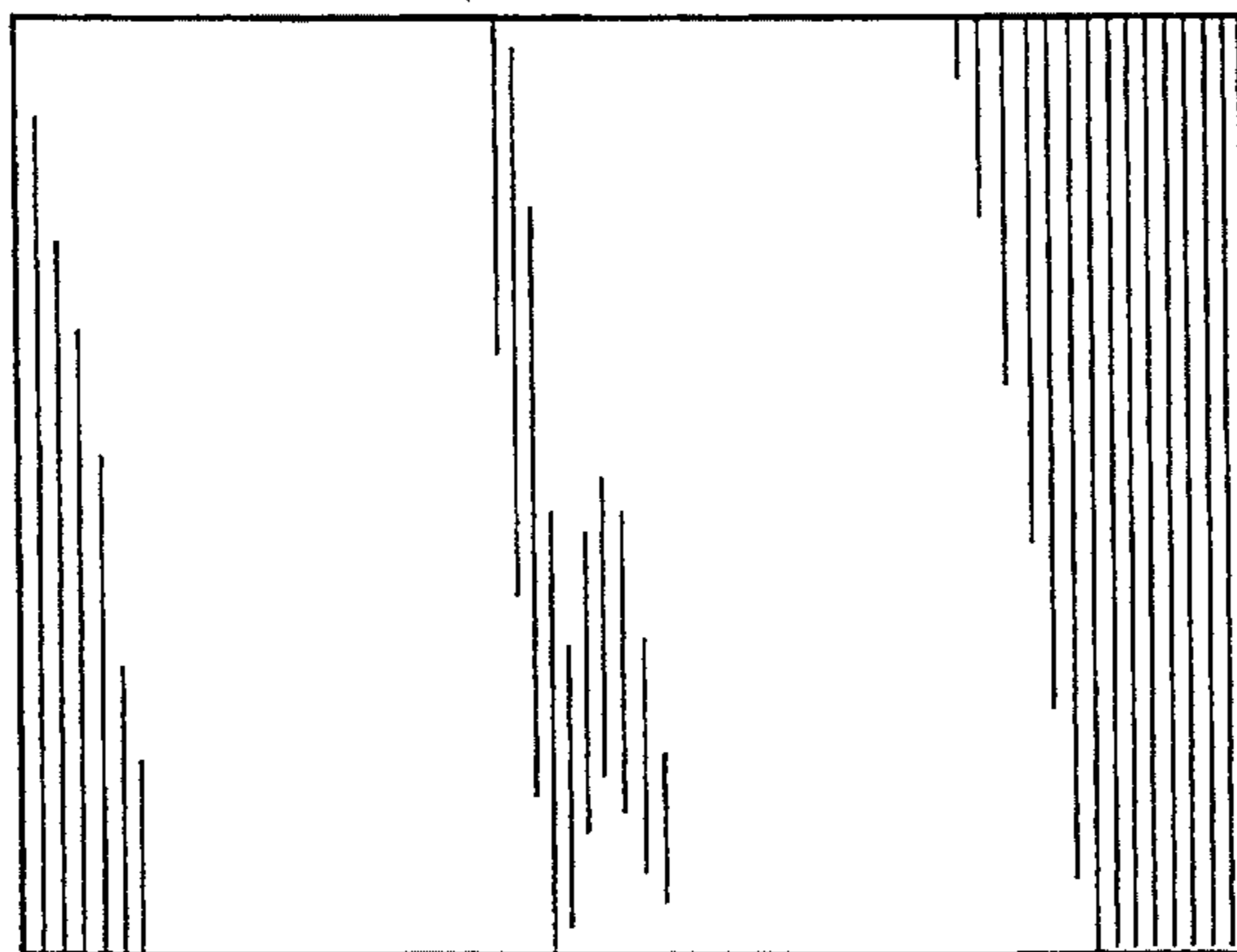
