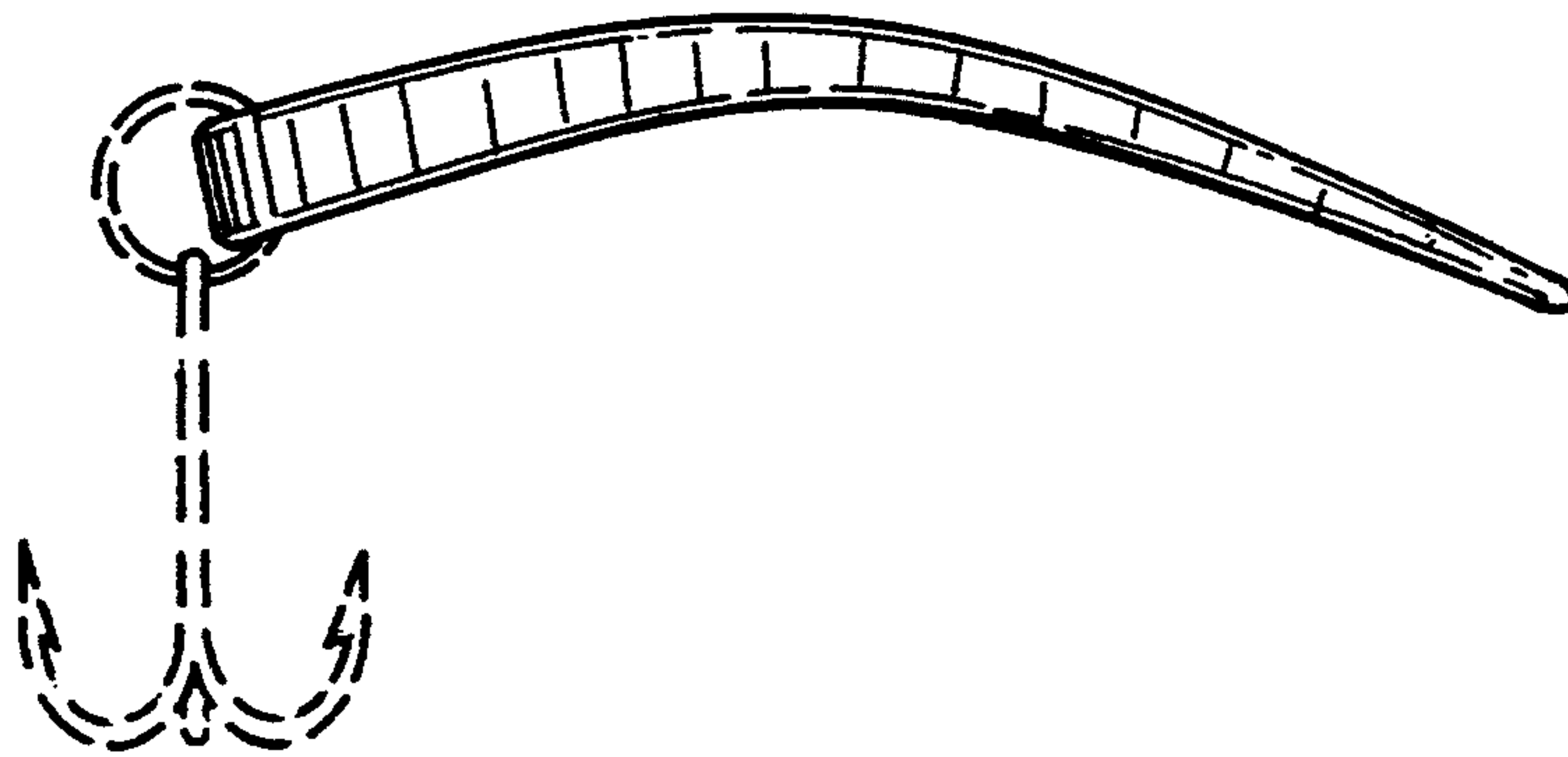

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fish lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fish lure showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is an end elevational view taken from the opposite end of FIG. 3; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.
The broken lines showing a hook in Figure are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



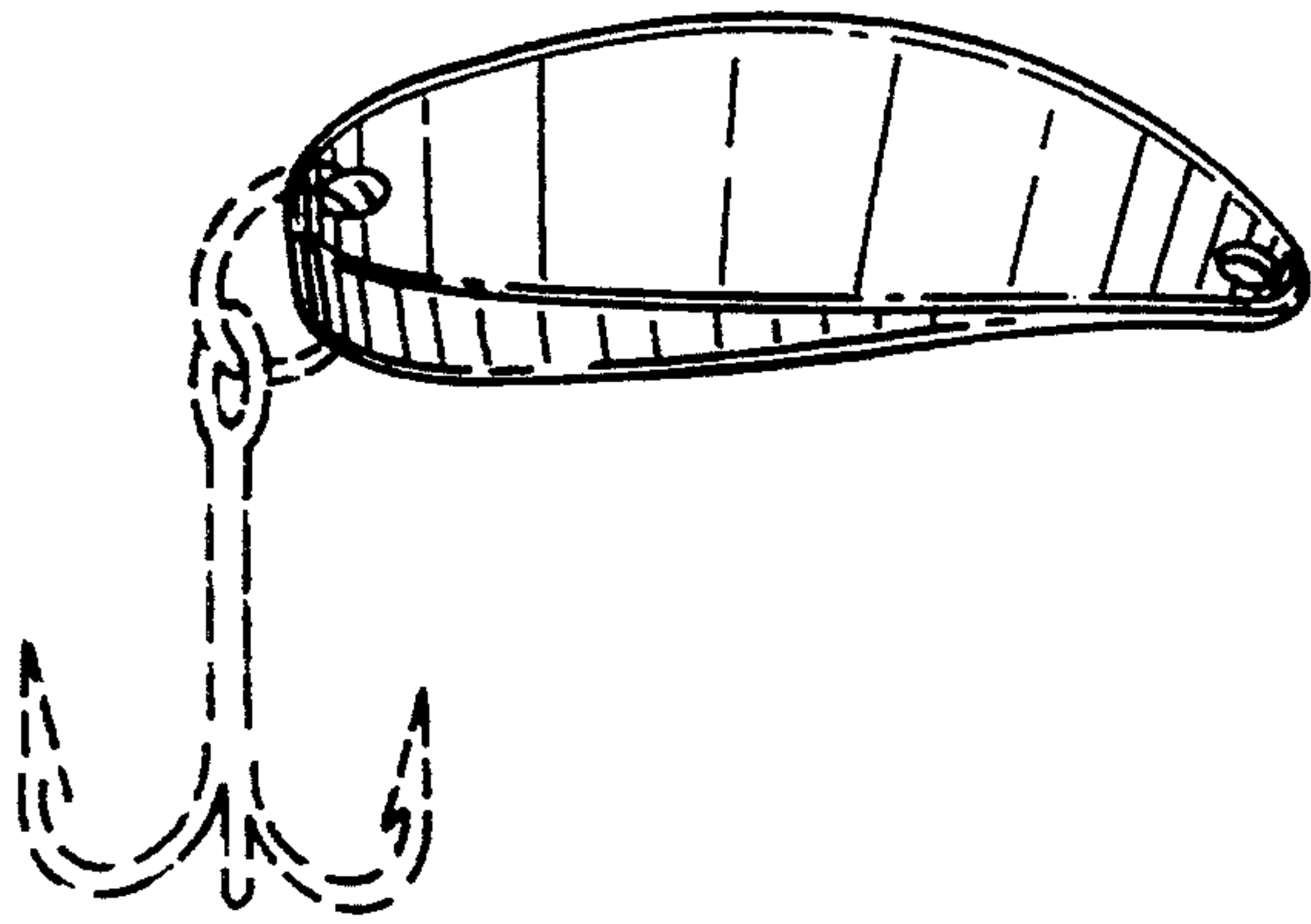

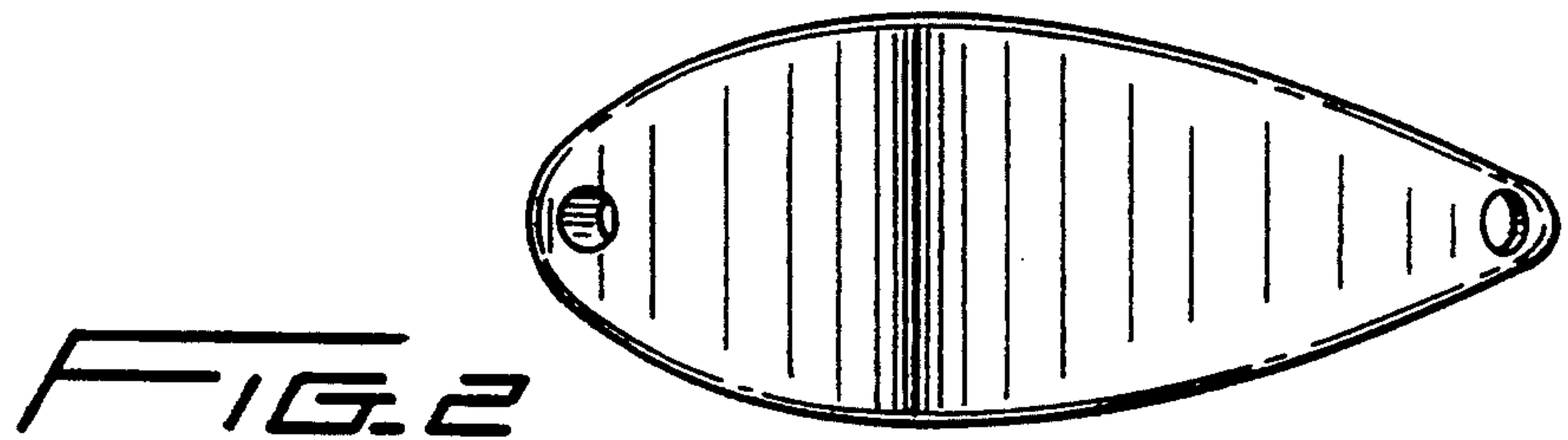

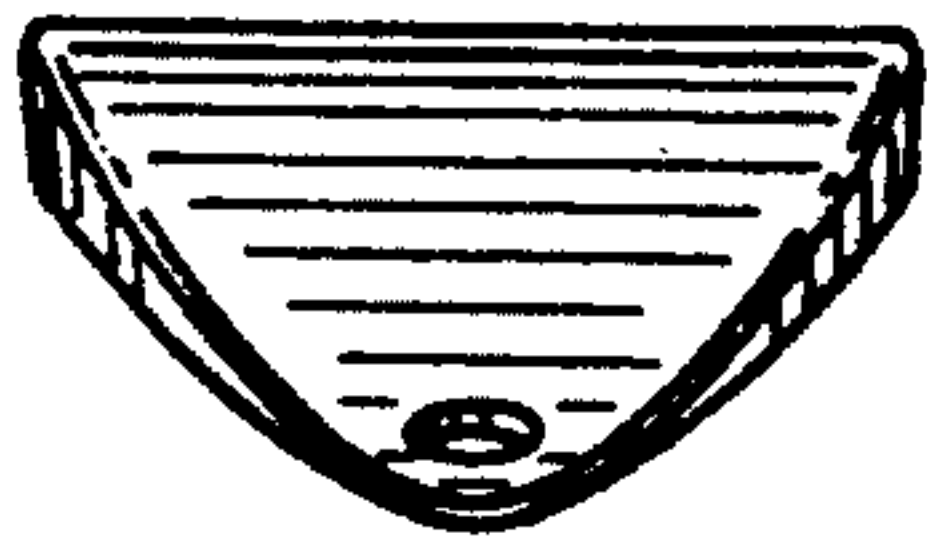

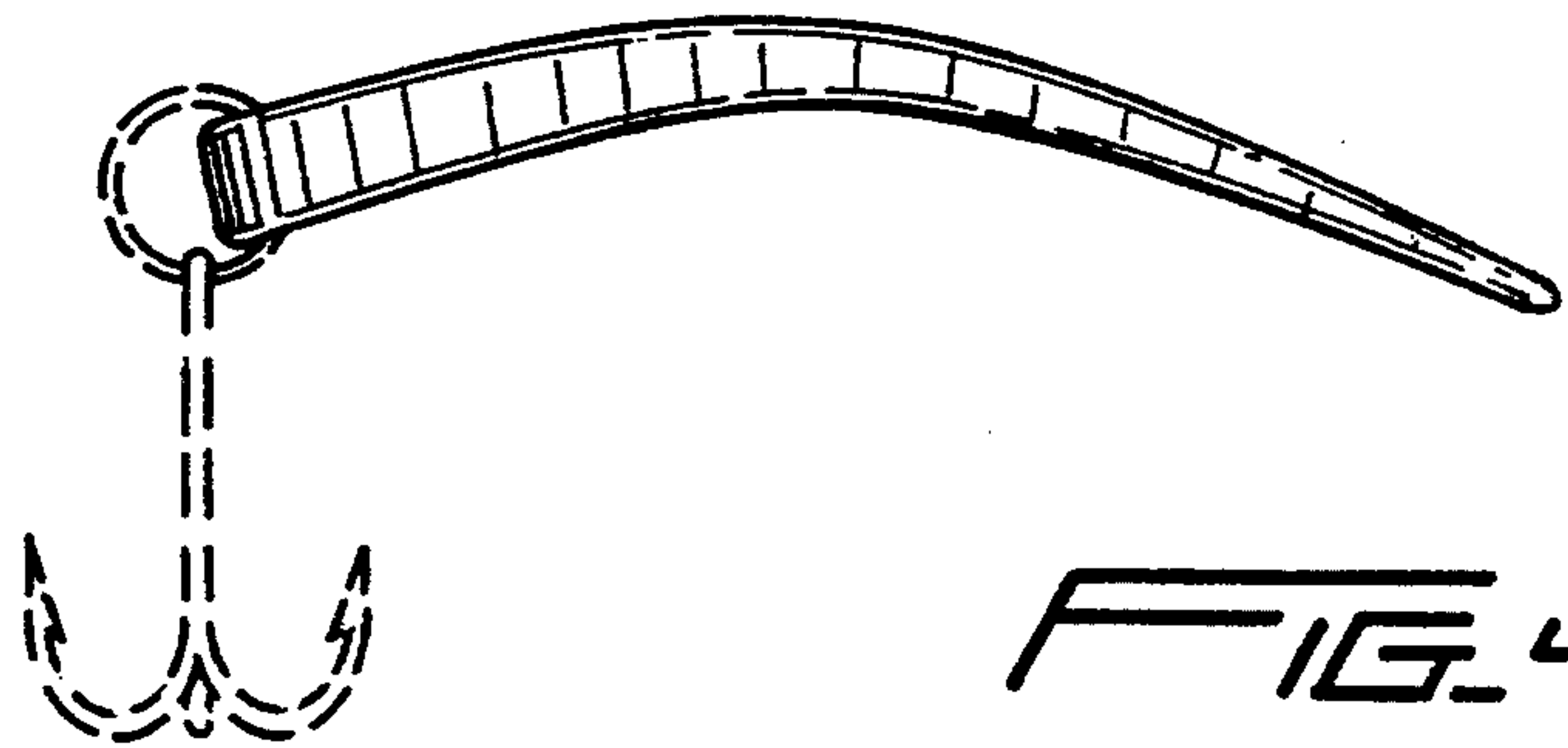

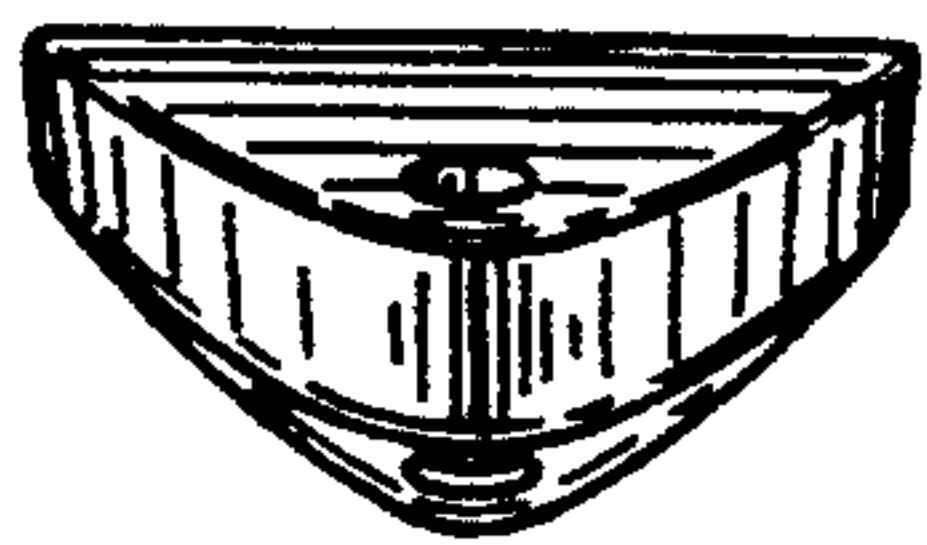

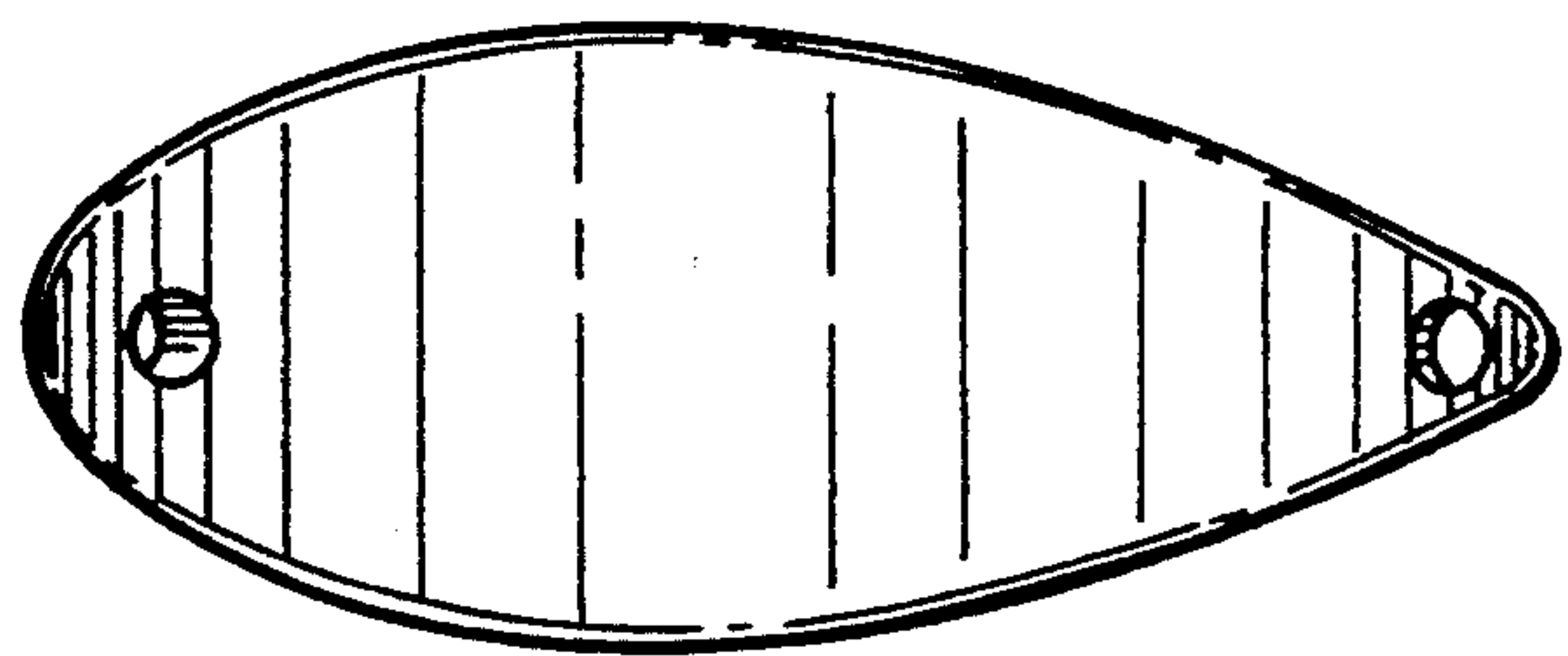
