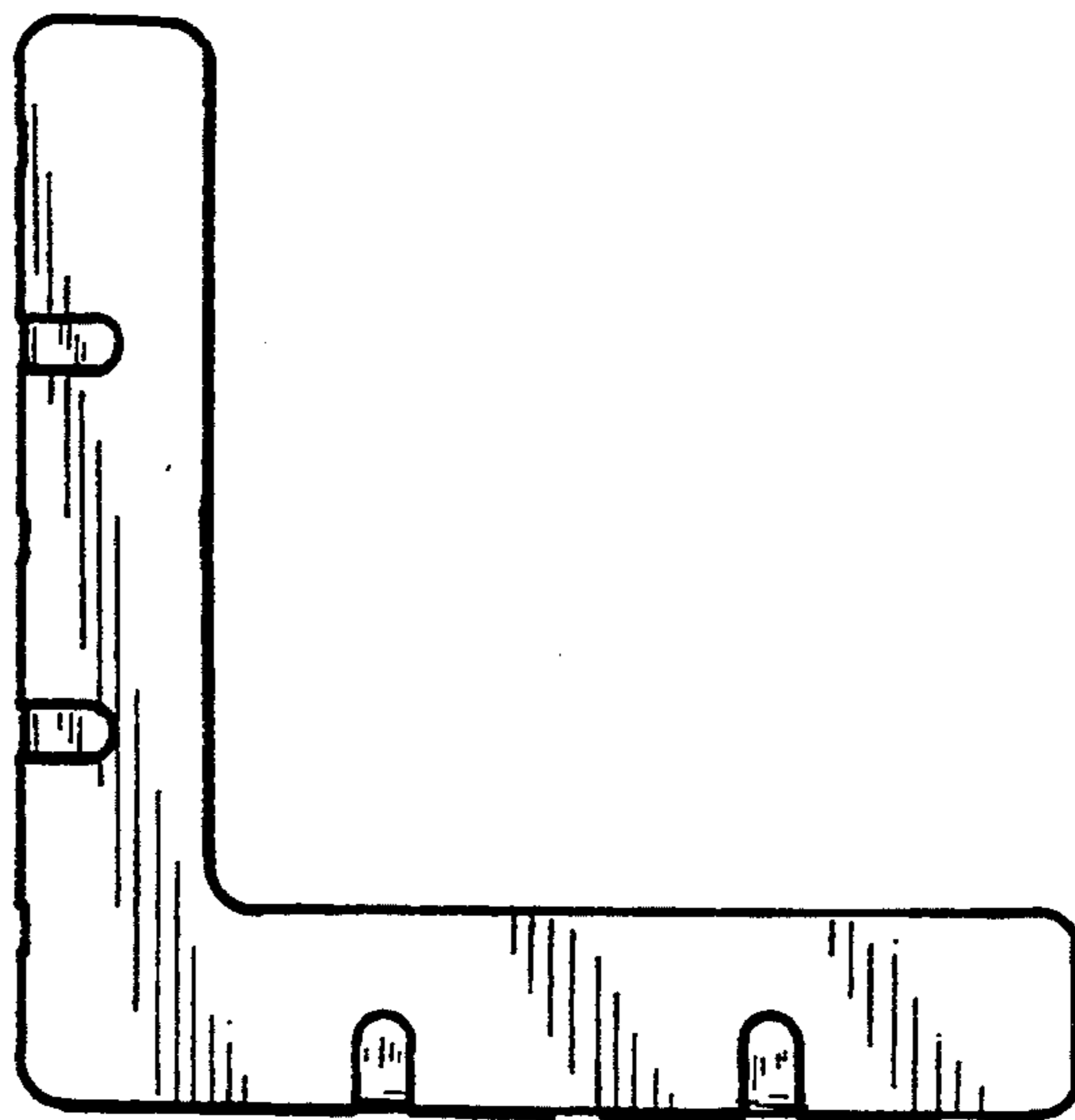

The broken line showing of environment in FIG. 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



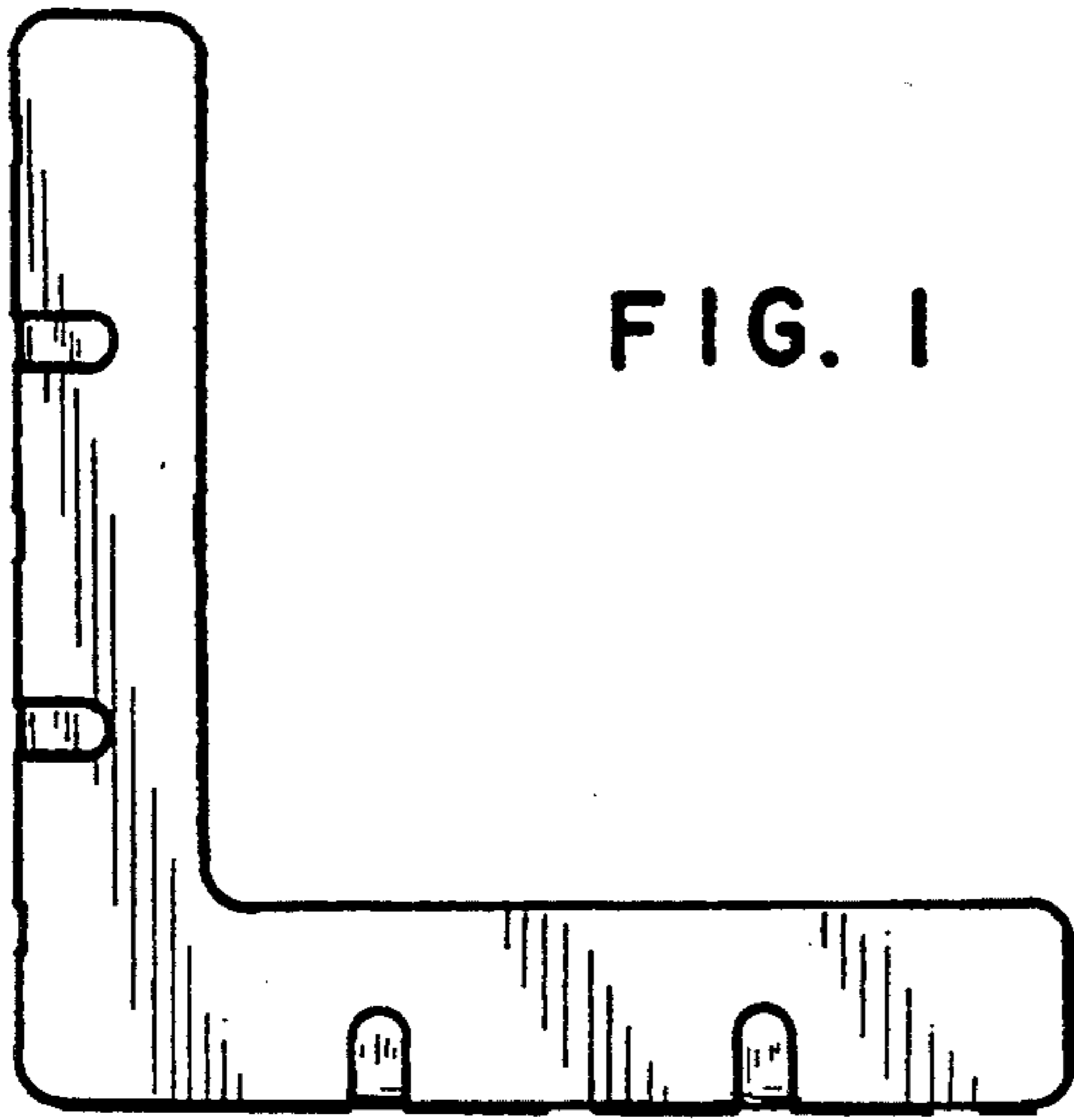

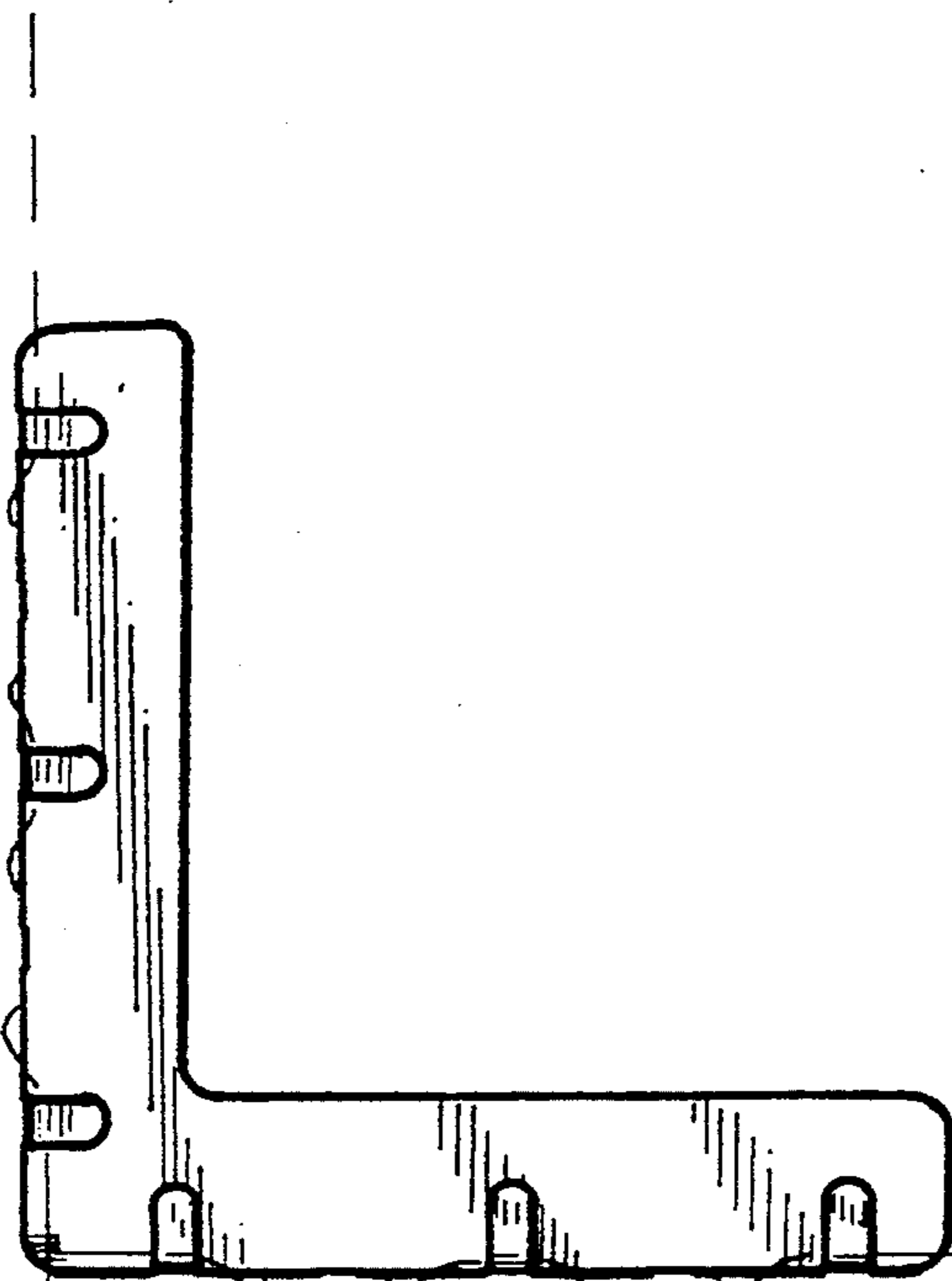
