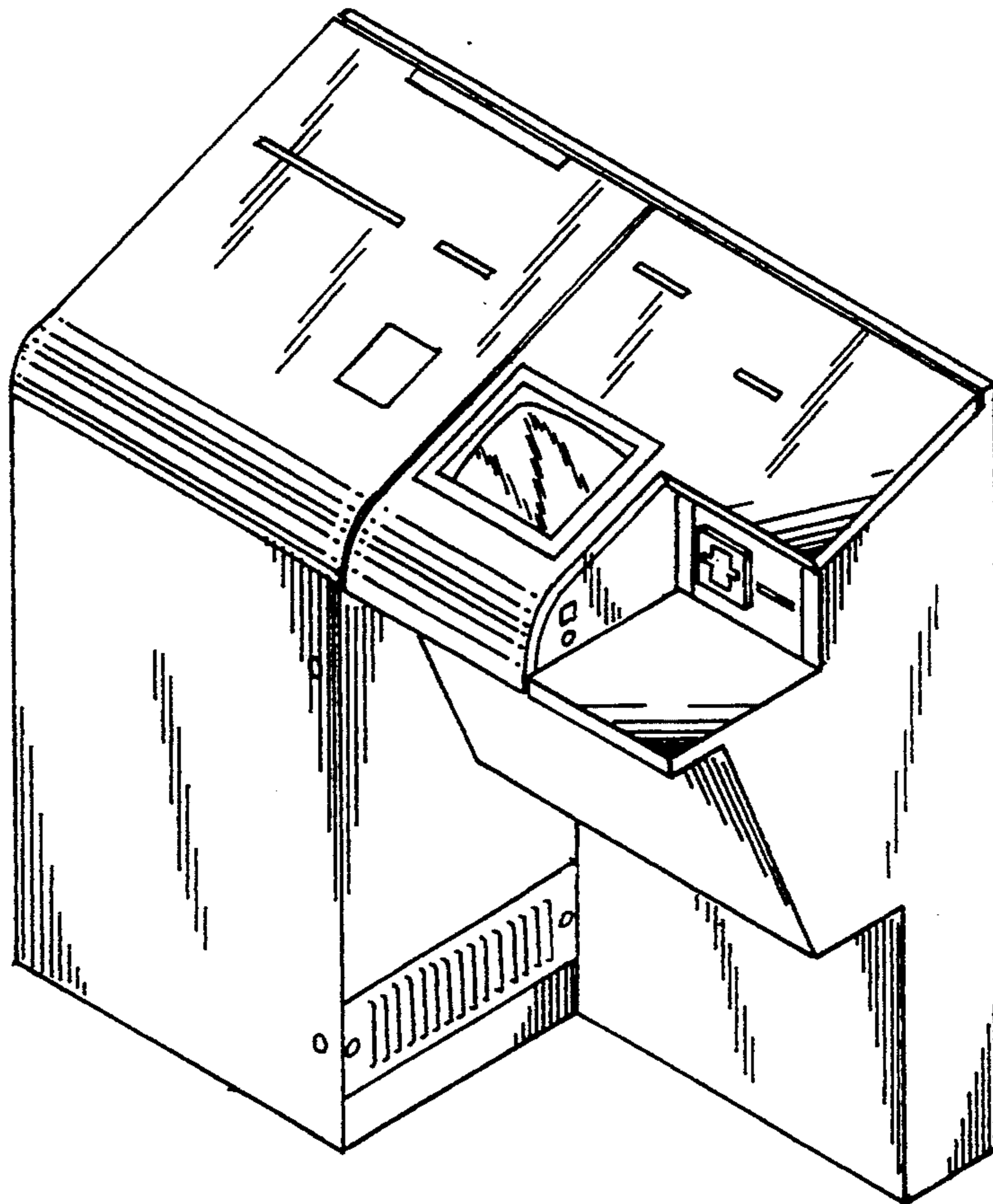

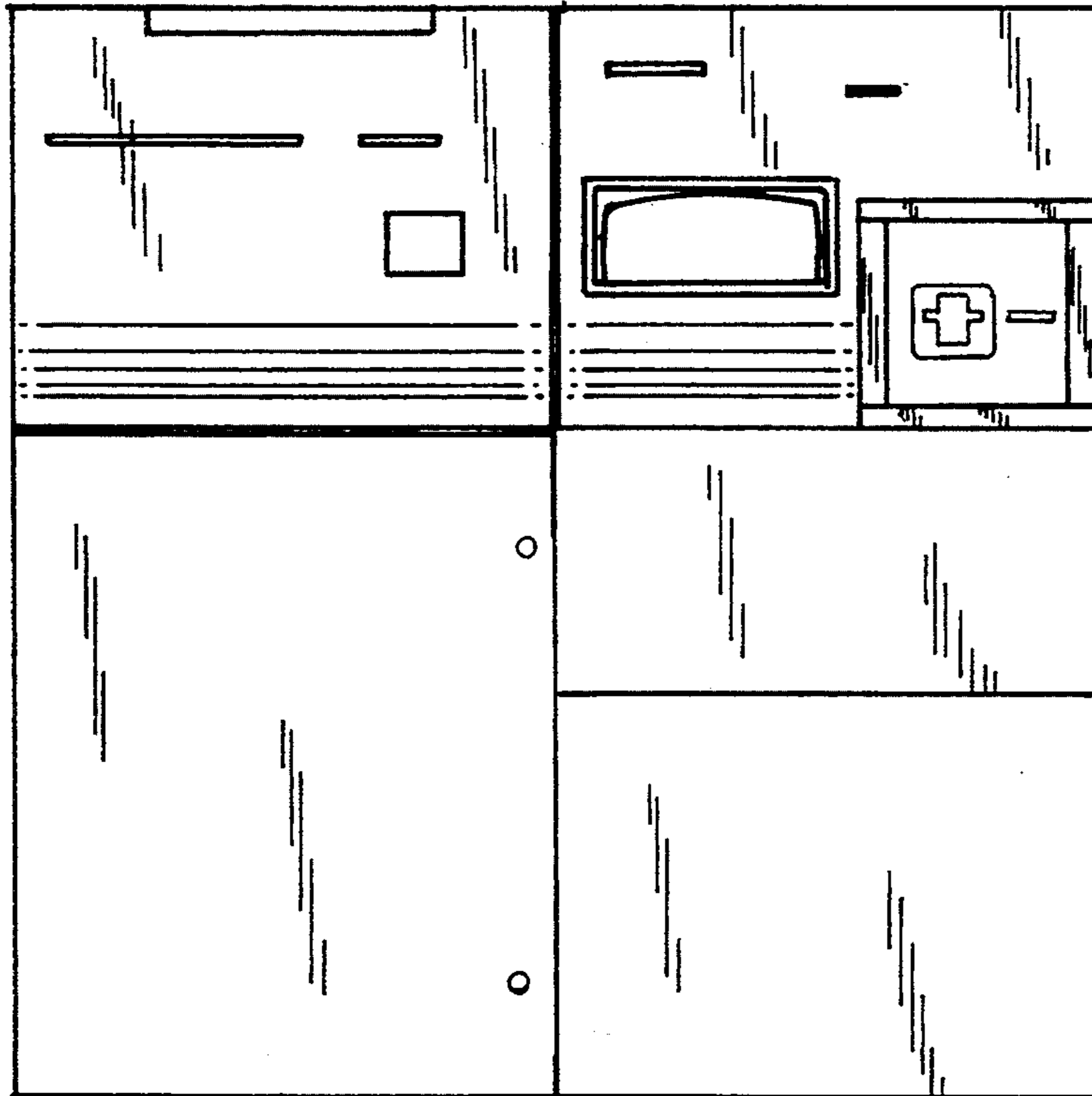

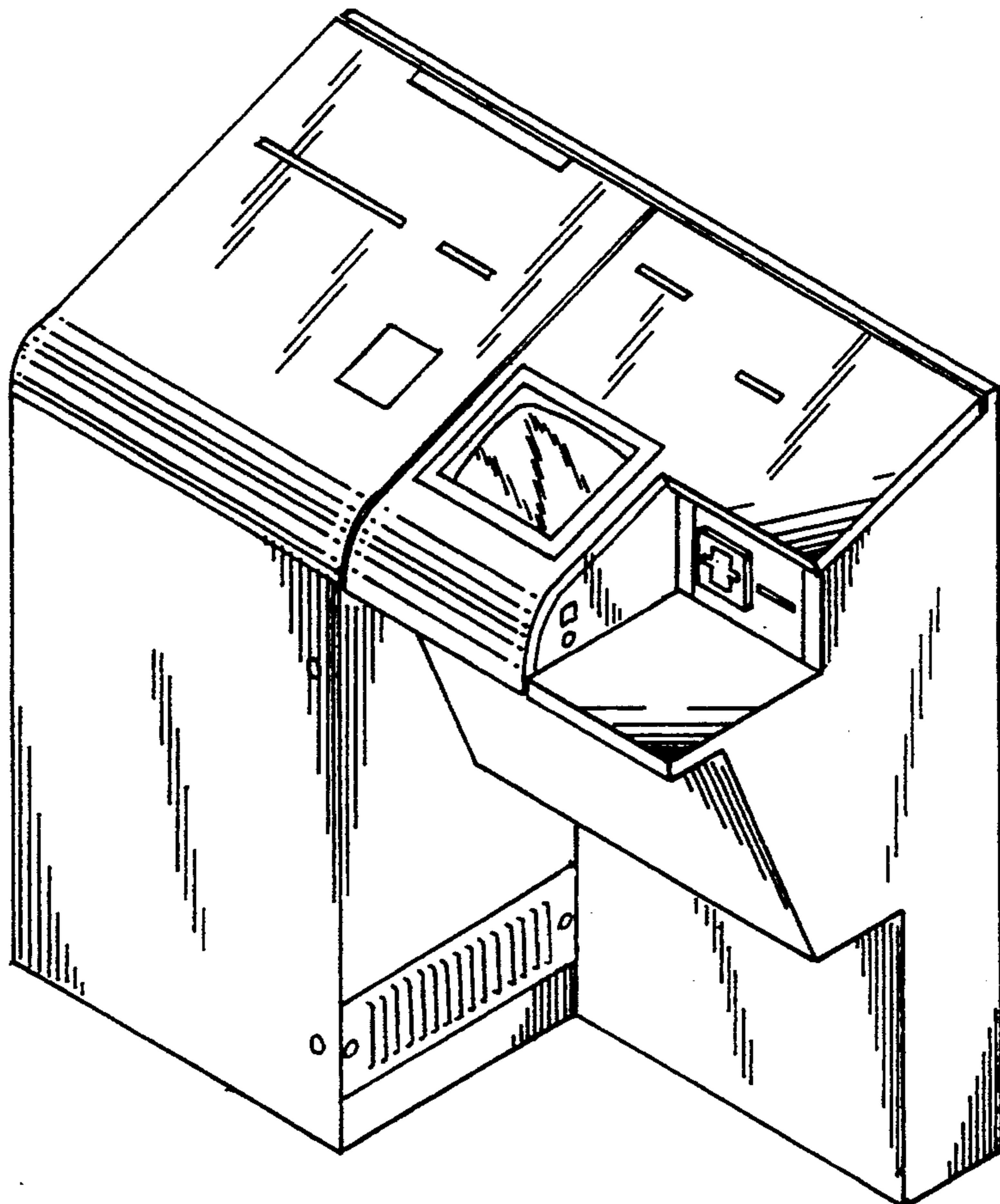
### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a rear-view thereof.

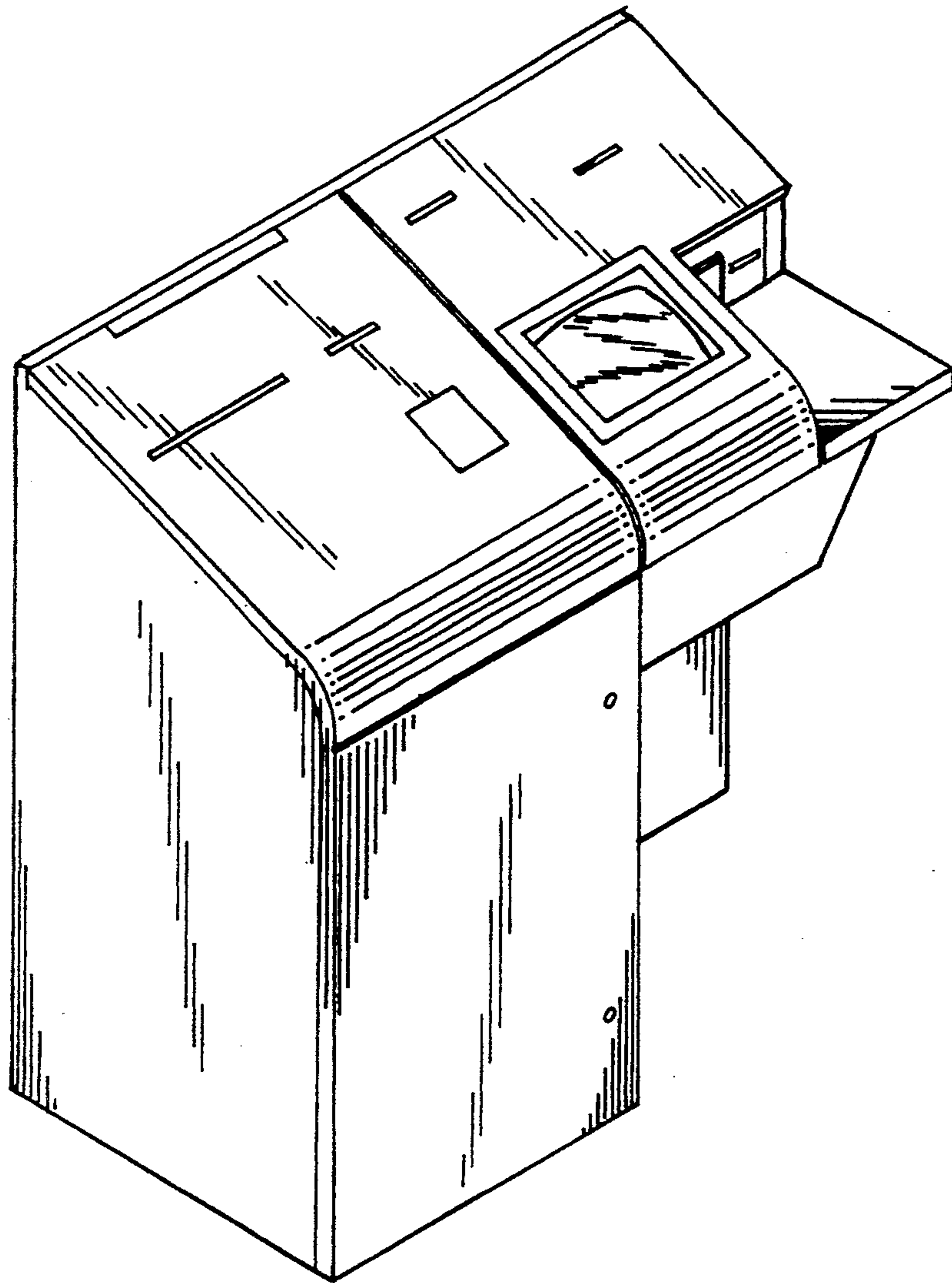




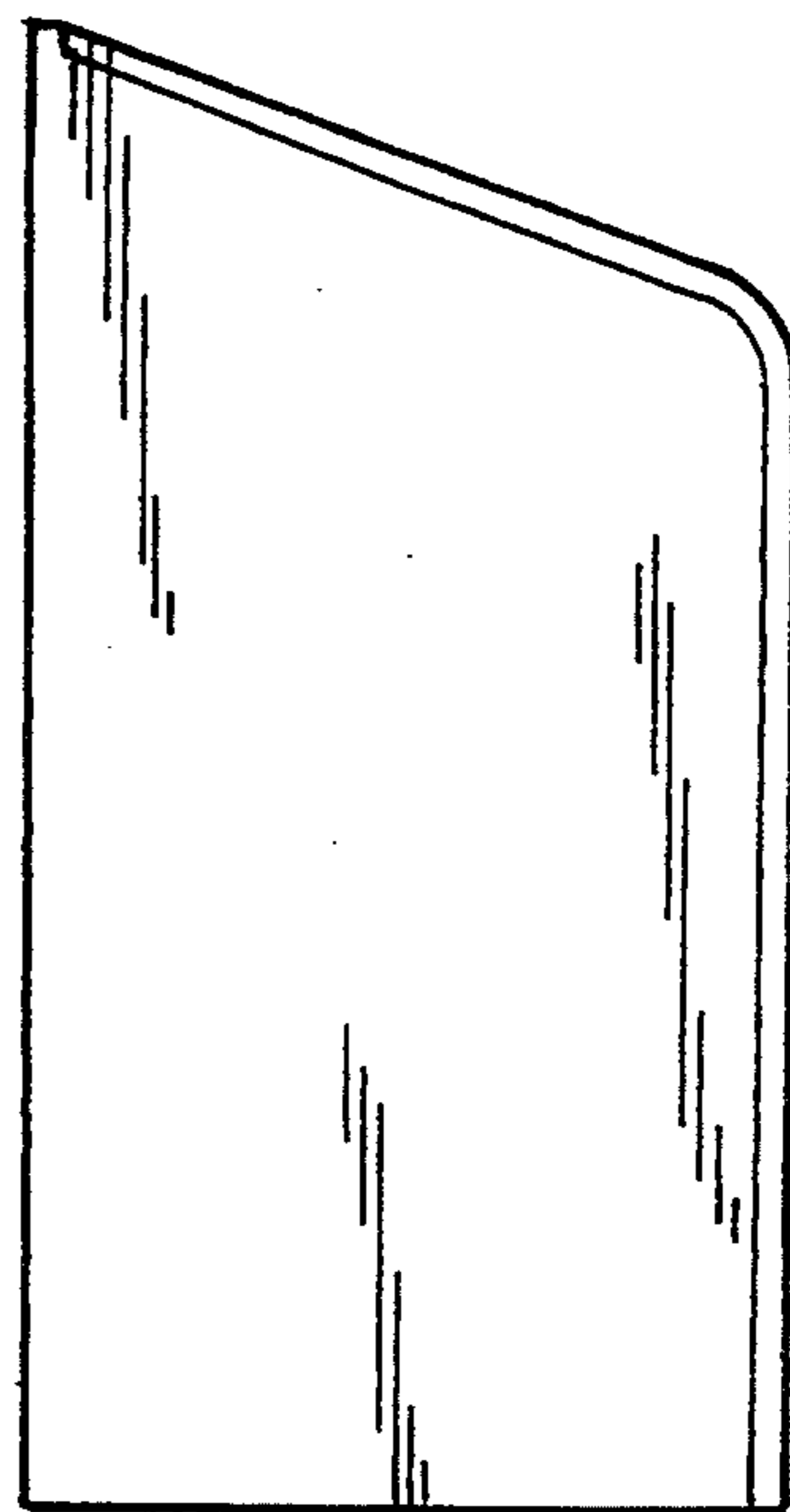

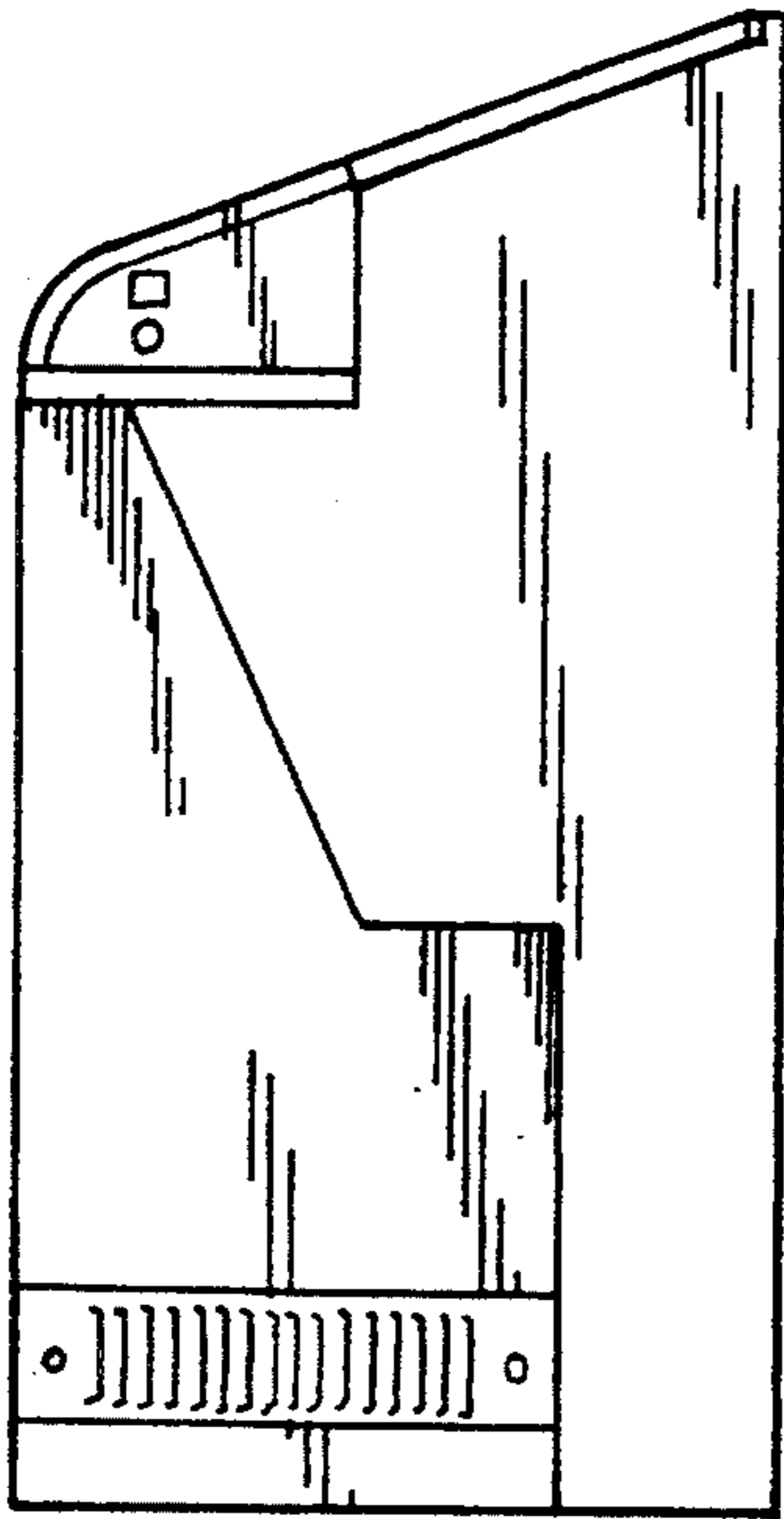

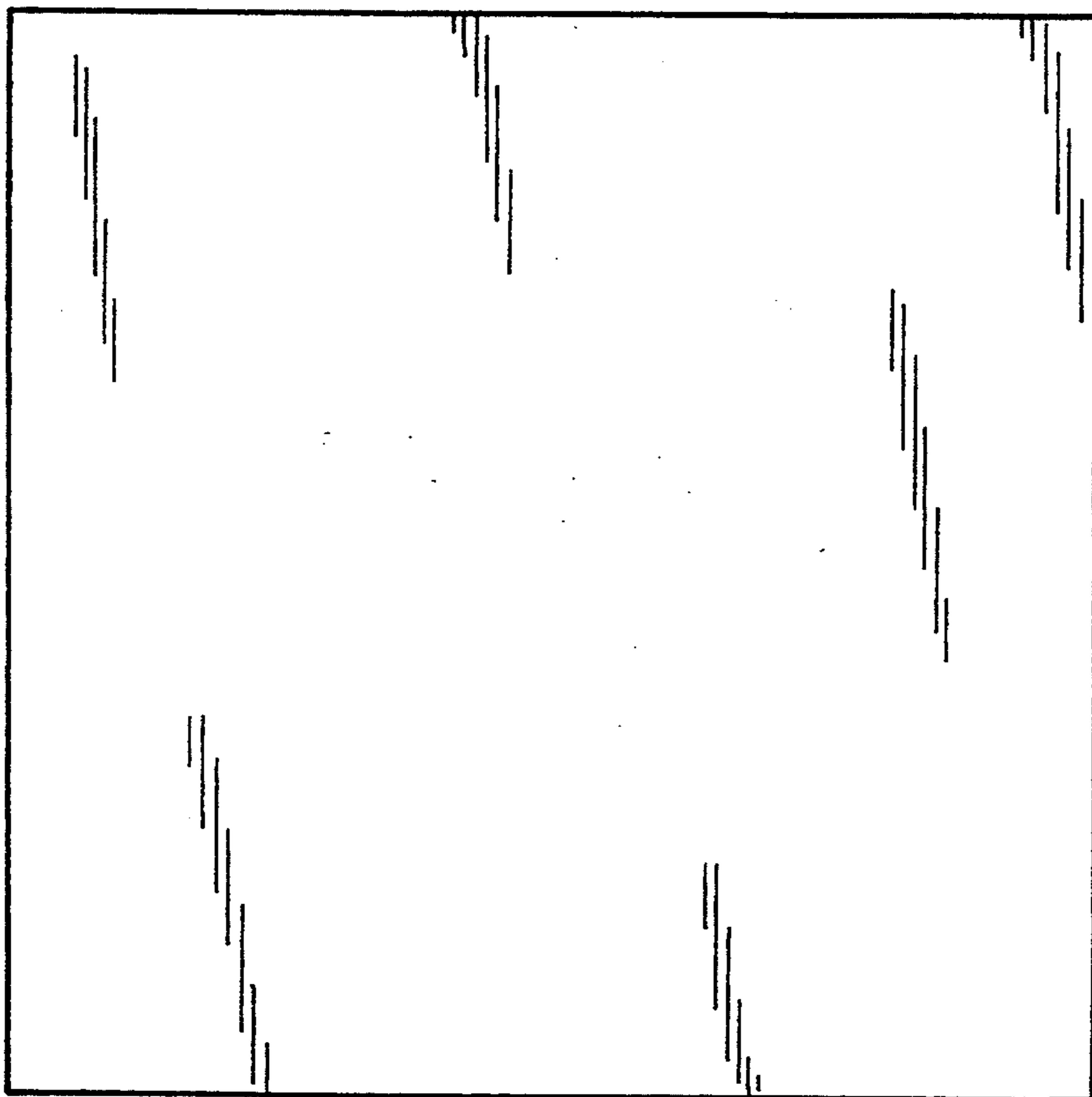
