The ornamental design for a shirt for the sport of paint ball, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shirt for the sport of paint ball showing my new design, the broken lines shown in both views being understood to represent conventional stitching; and, FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof, the wrist closures shown fastened.
