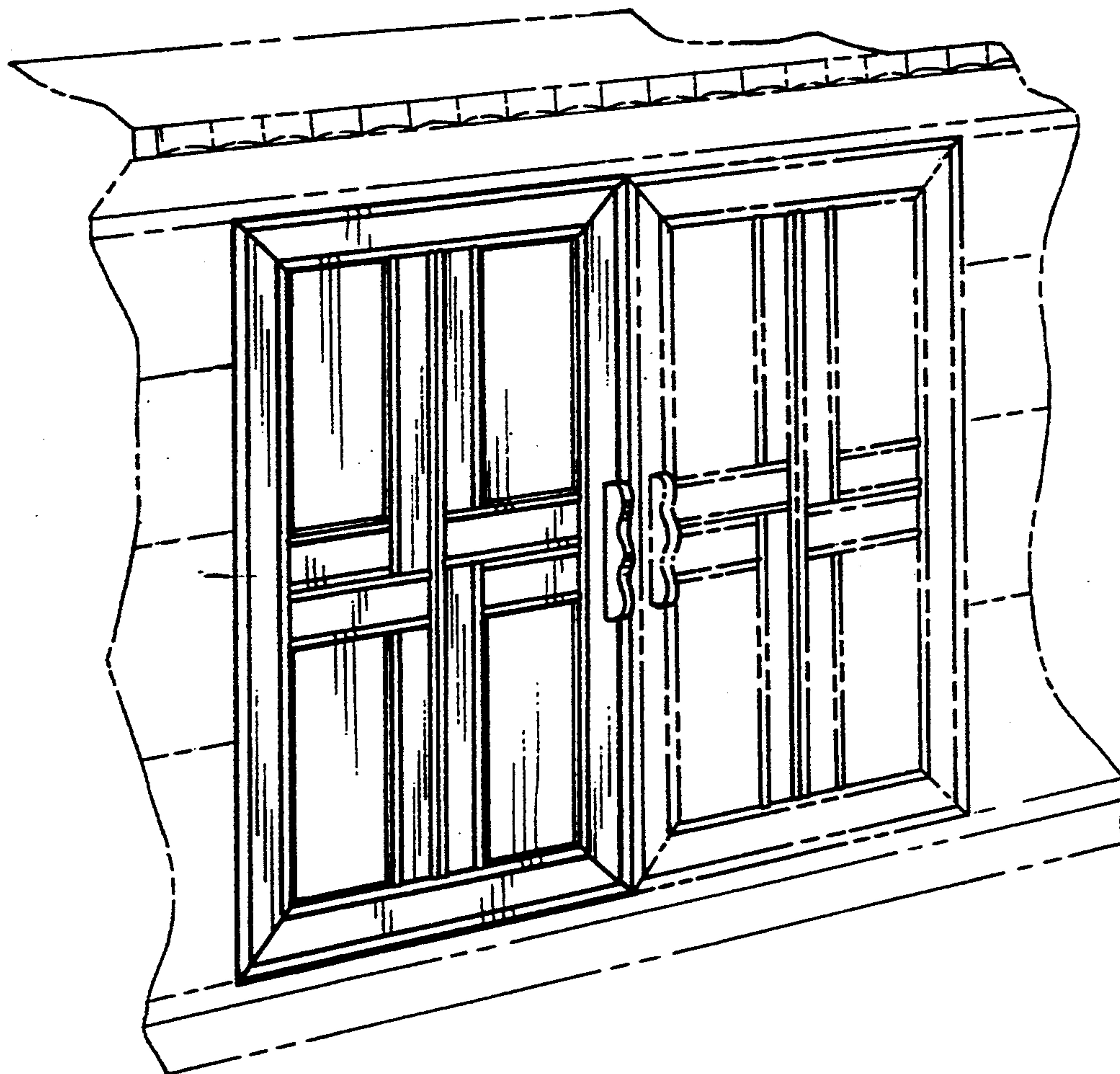

The rear of the design is plain and unornamented.



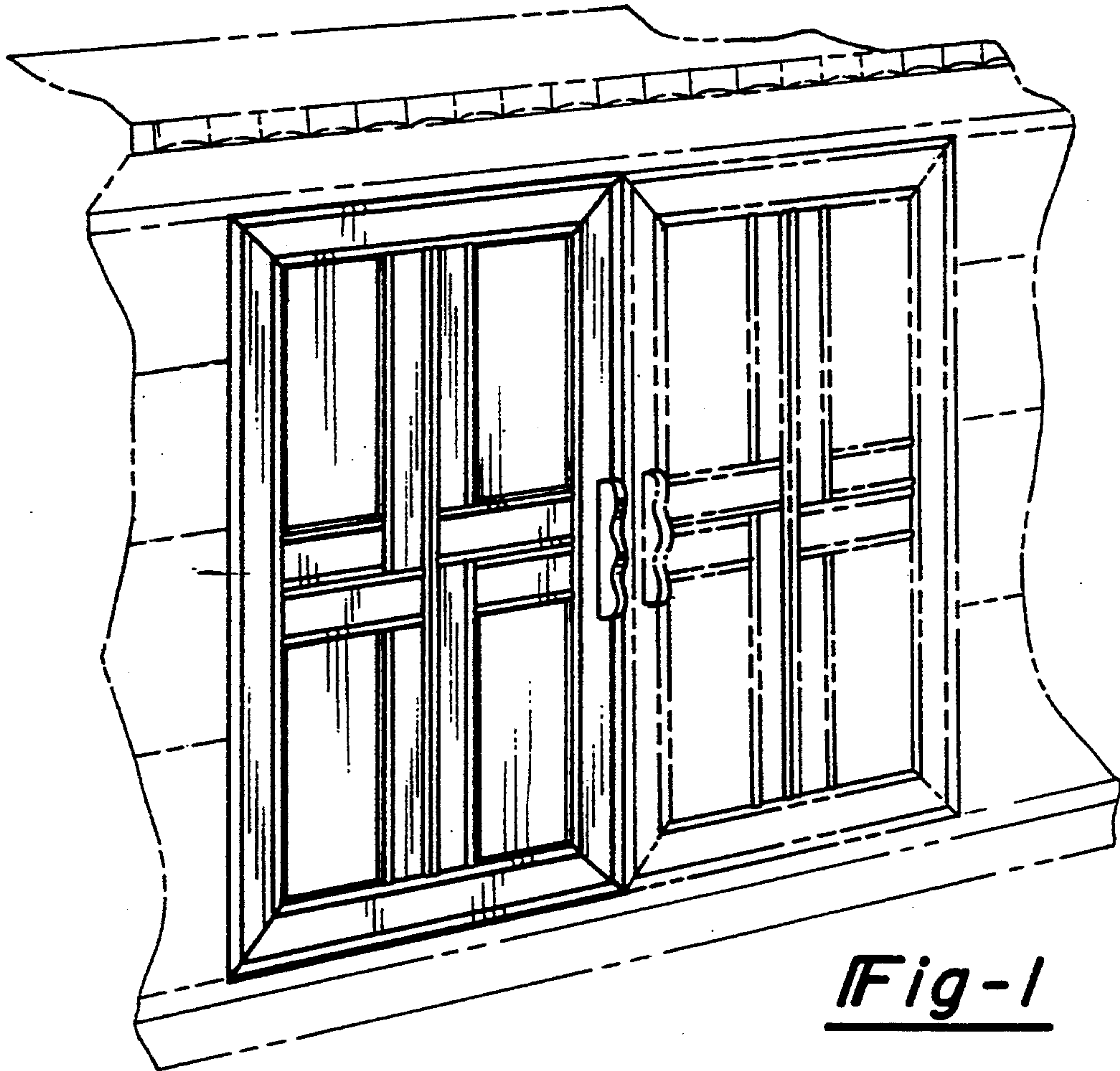
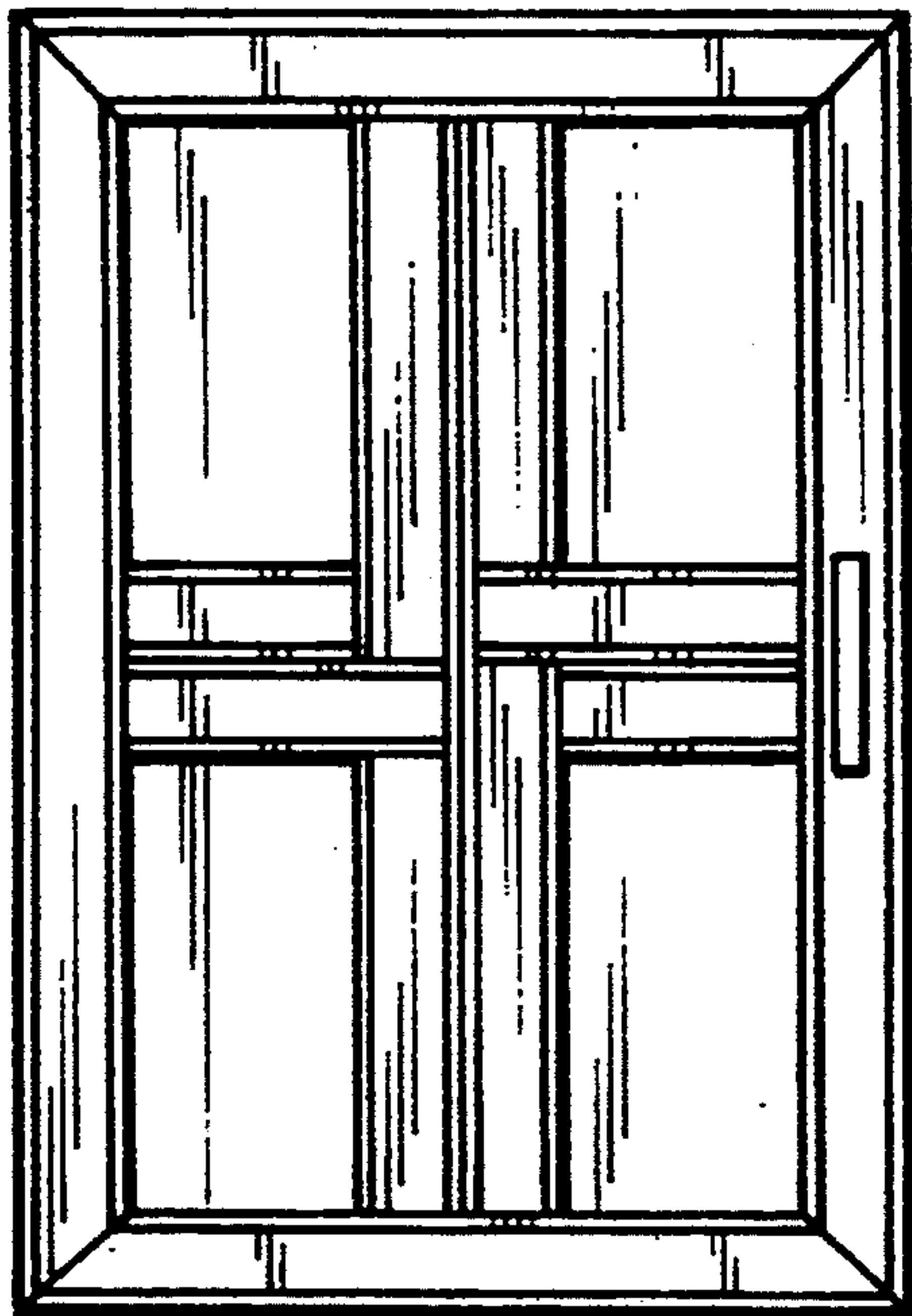
