[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a furniture door, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a furniture door, showing my new design, the broken lines are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 3—3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

- FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof; and,
- FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The rear of the design is plain and unornamented.
