[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combination toothbrush and cup holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combination toothbrush and cup holder showing my new design, the brok-

en-line disclosure of a cup being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the base/cup holder portion thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the base/cup holder portion shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the base/cup holder portion shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of the base/cup holder portion shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the base/cup holder portion shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the base/cup holder portion shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the base/cup holder portion shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the toothbrush holder portion shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the toothbrush holder portion shown in FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the toothbrush holder portion shown in FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view of the toothbrush holder portion shown in FIG. 9;

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of the toothbrush holder portion shown in FIG. 9;

FIG. 14 is a left side elevational view of the toothbrush holder portion shown in FIG. 9; and,

FIG. 15 is a right side elevational view of the toothbrush holder portion shown in FIG. 9.

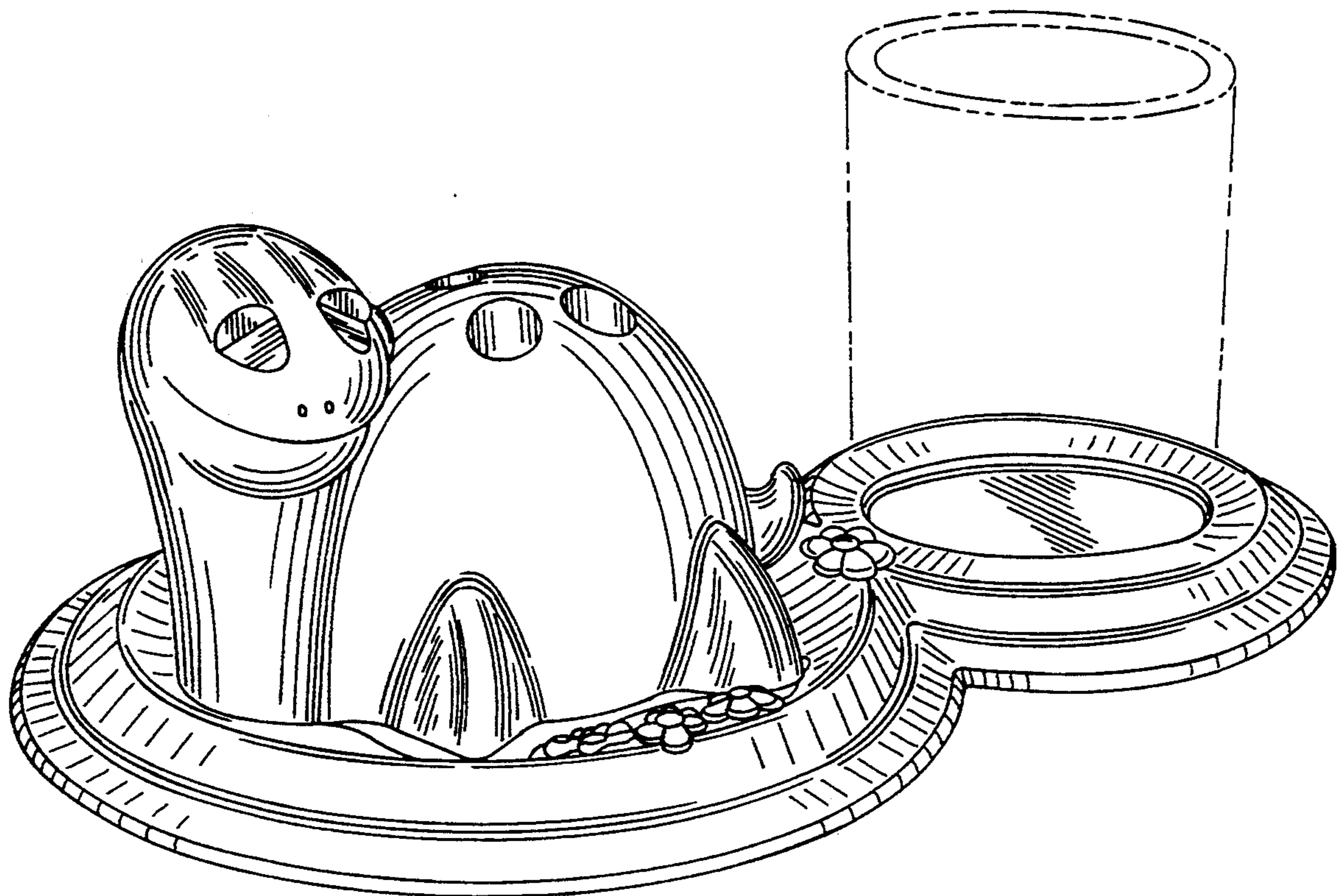

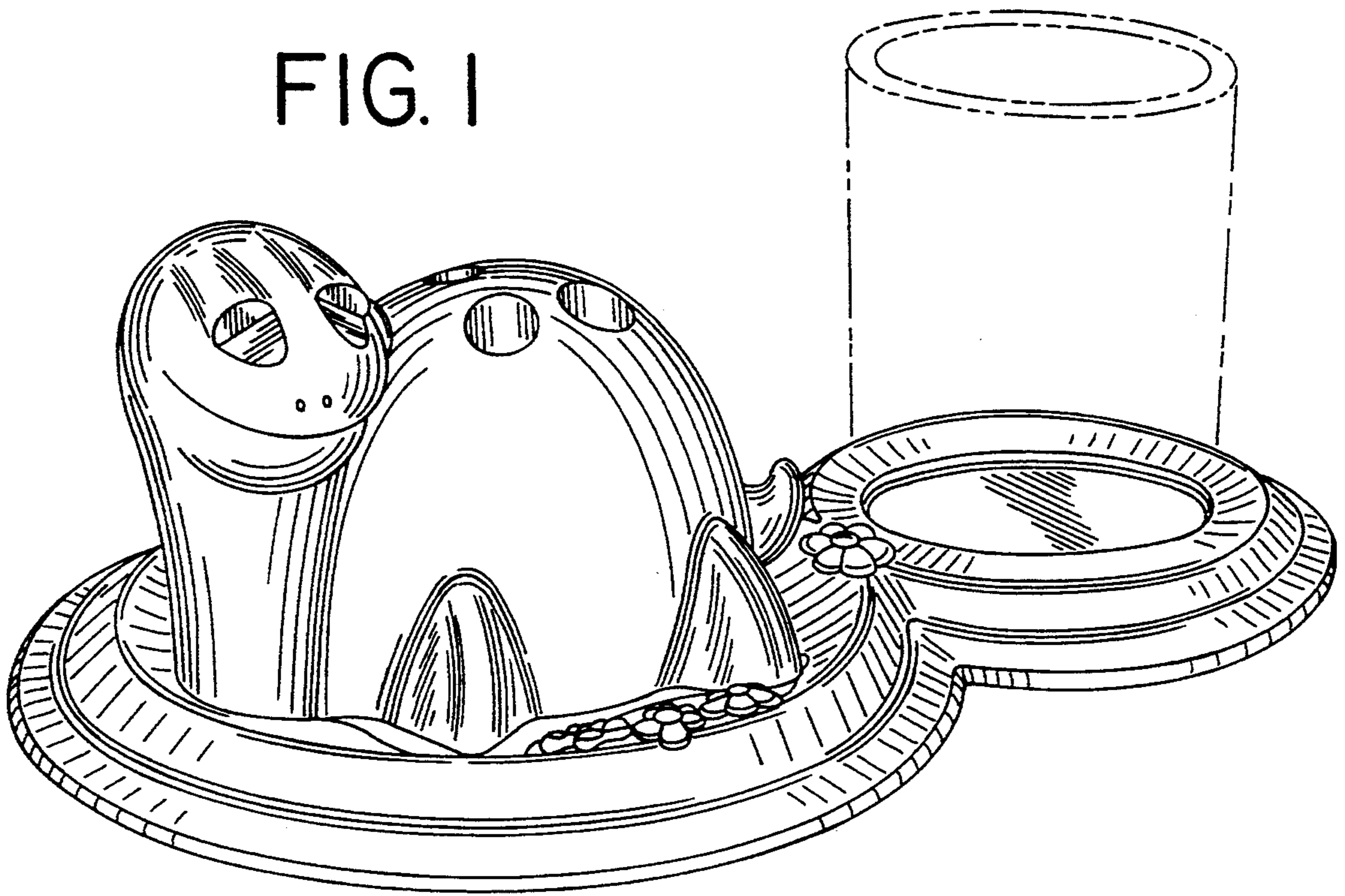

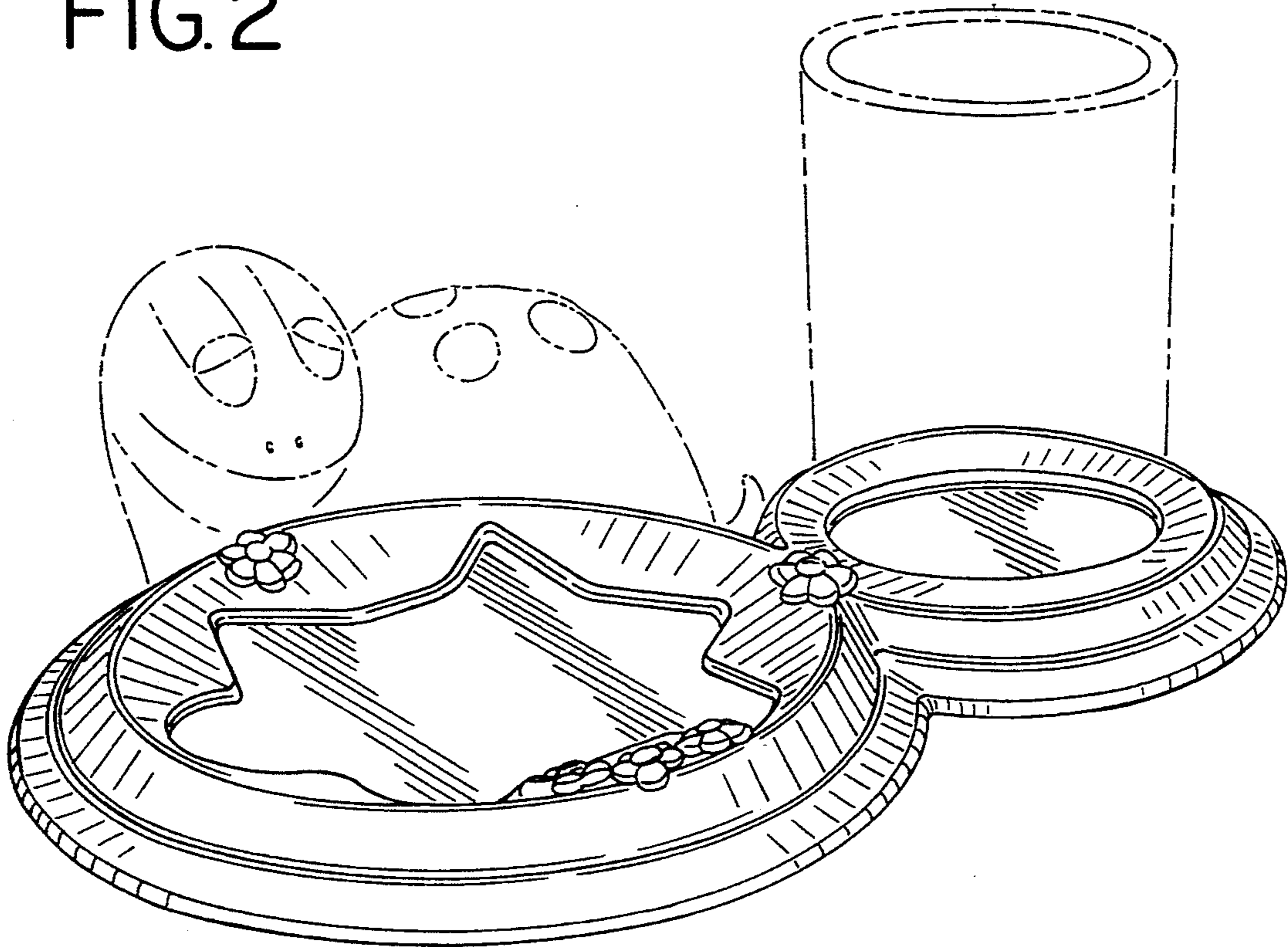

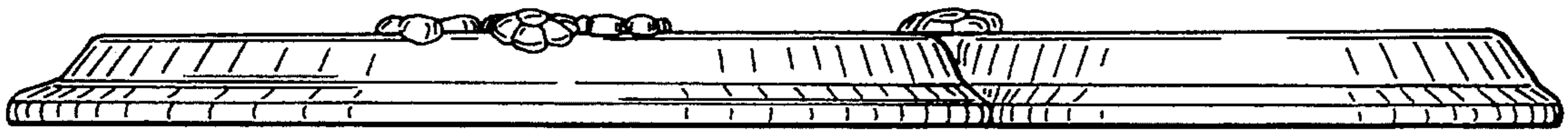

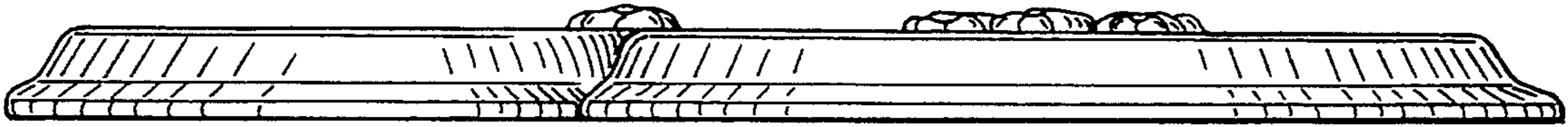

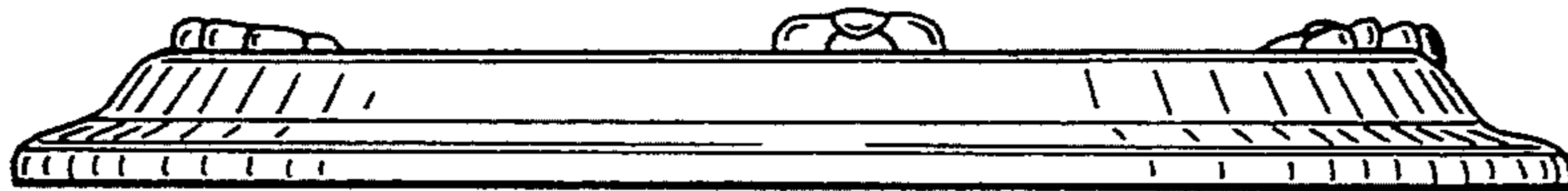

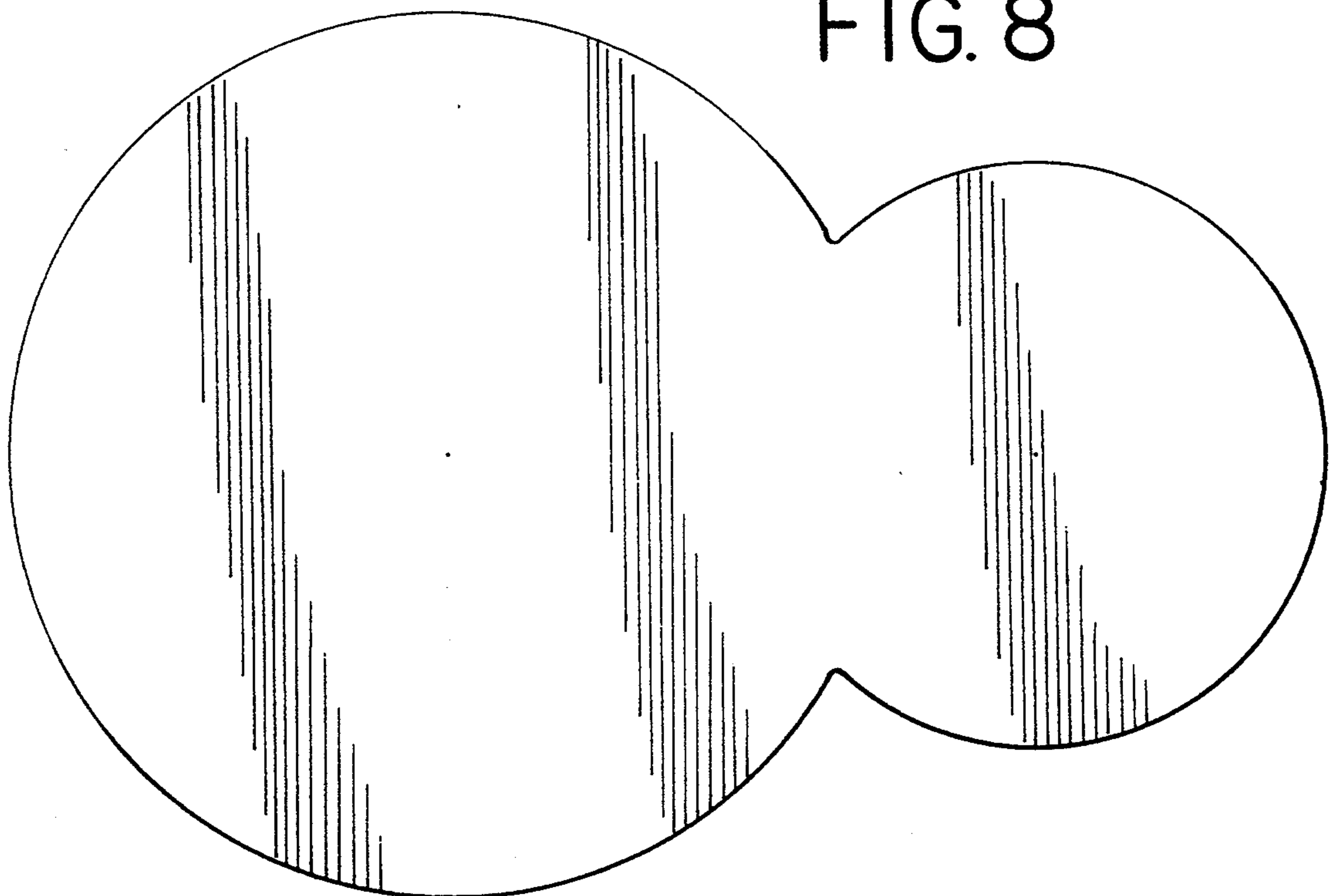
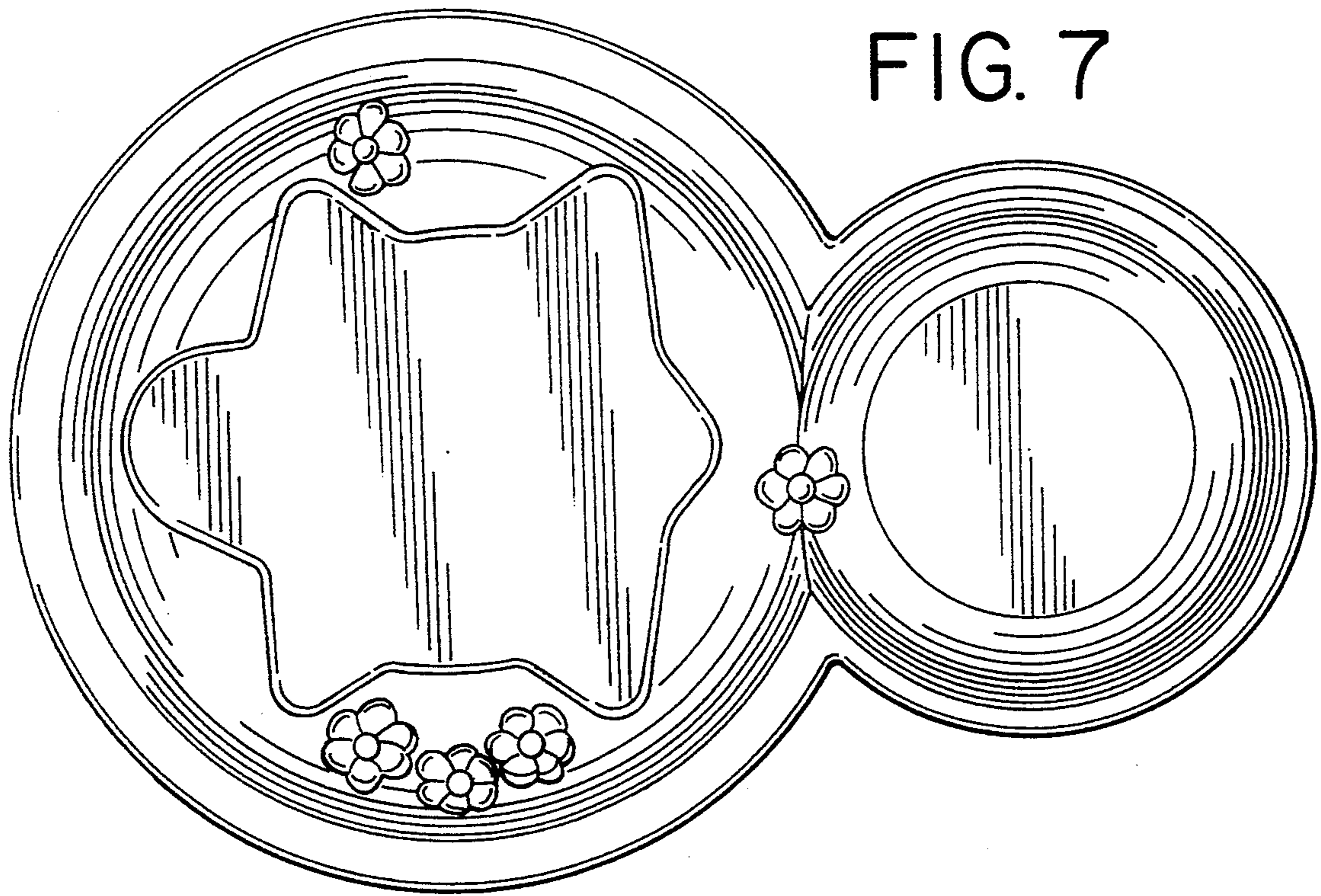

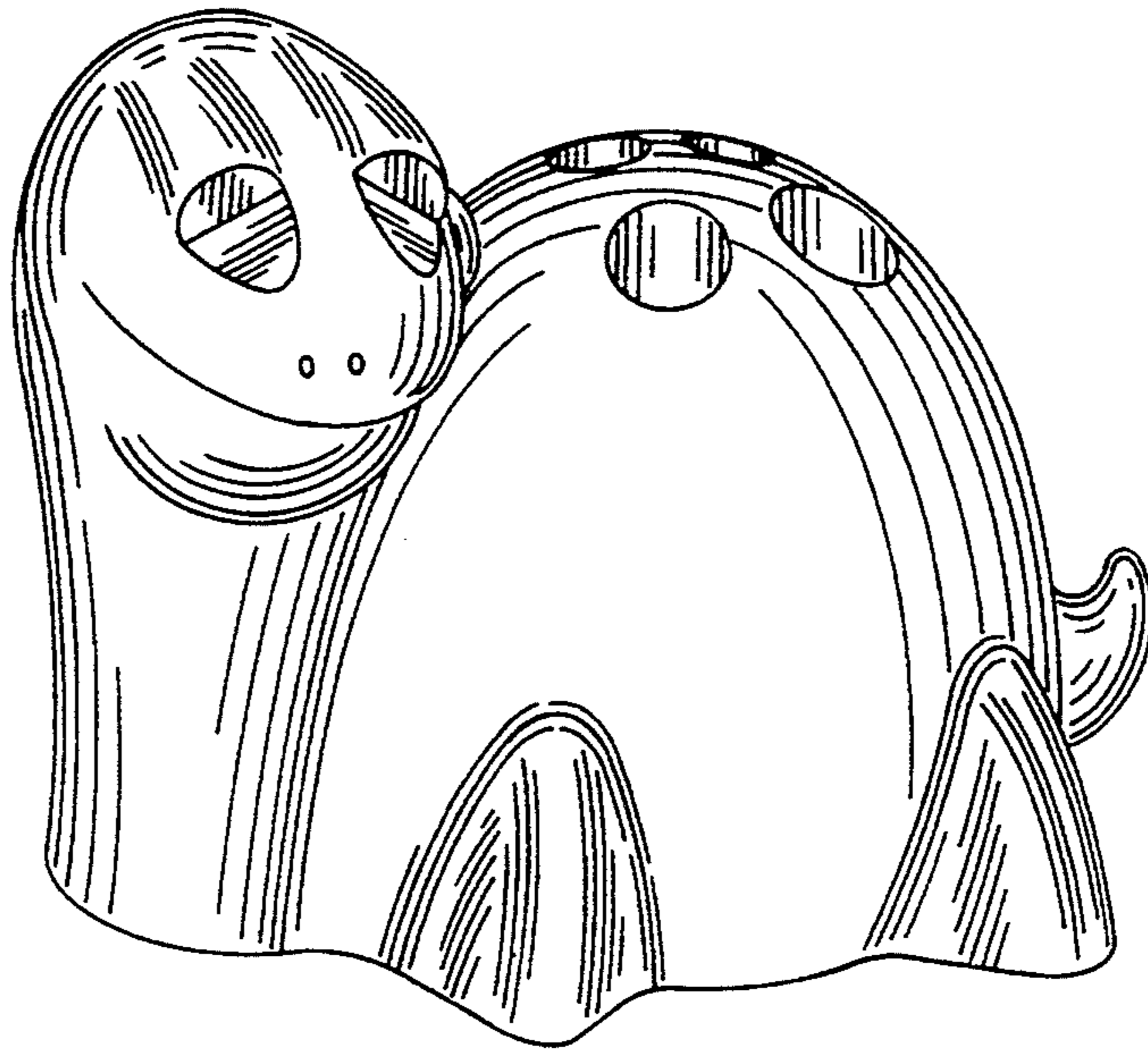

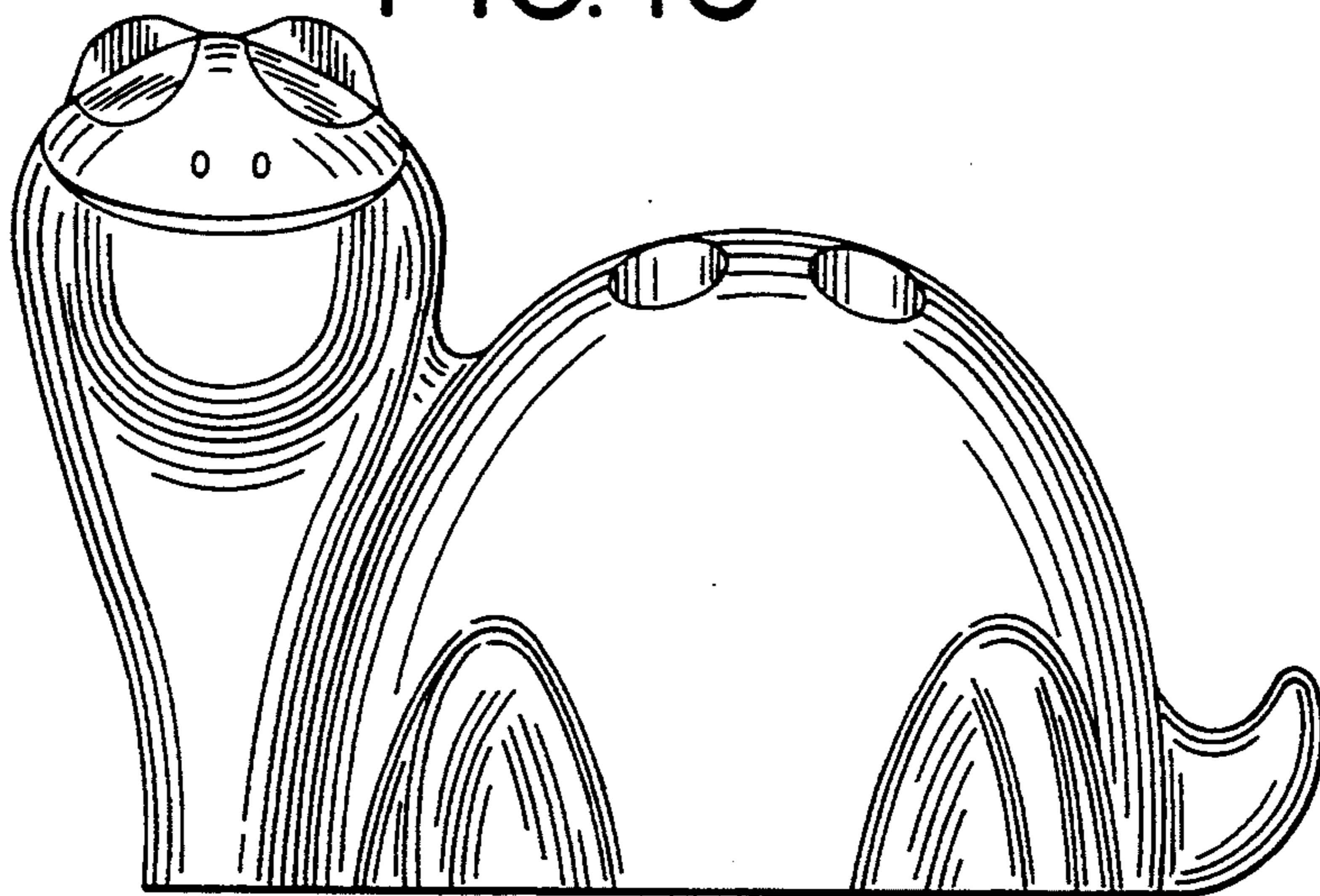

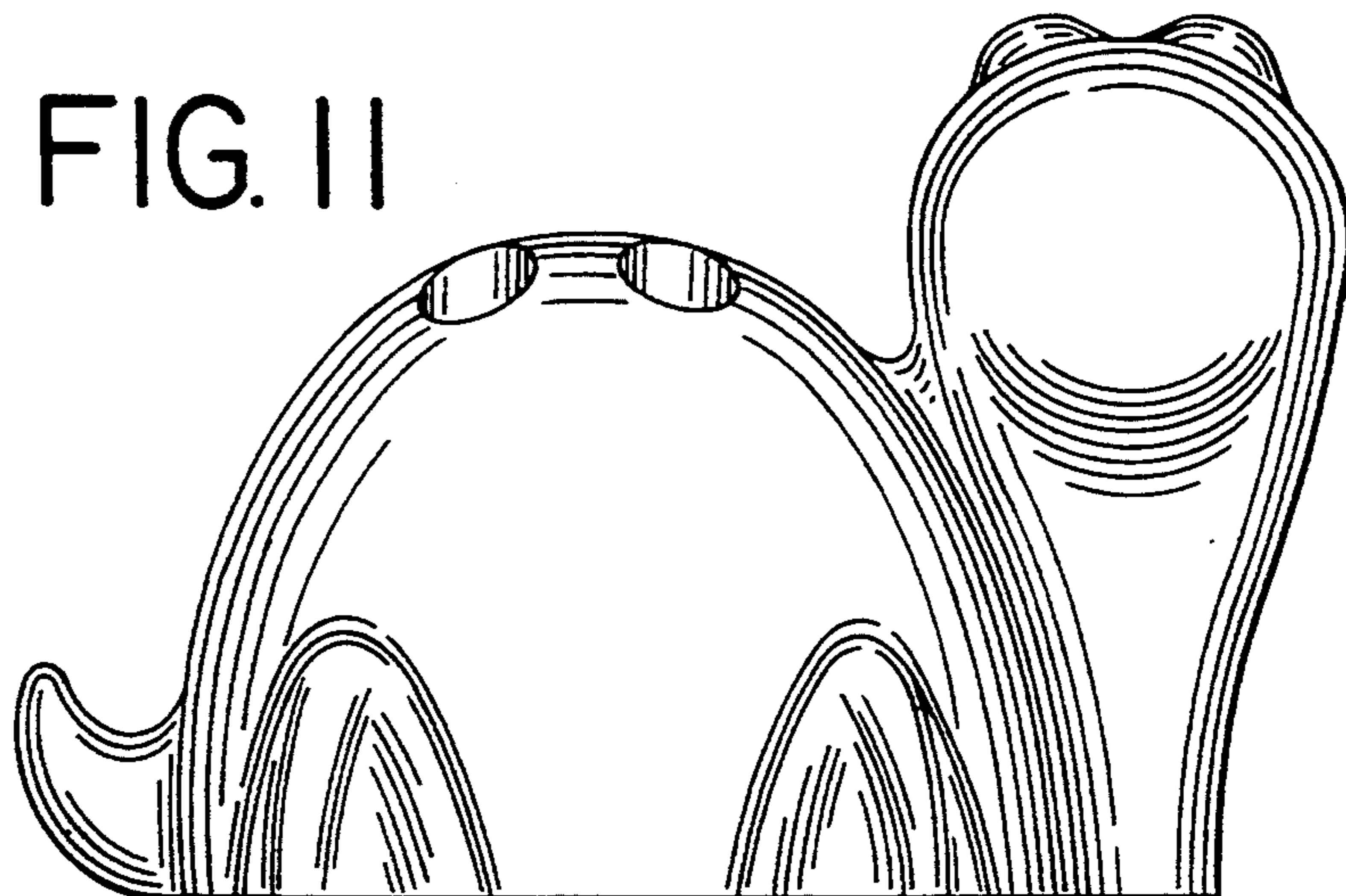

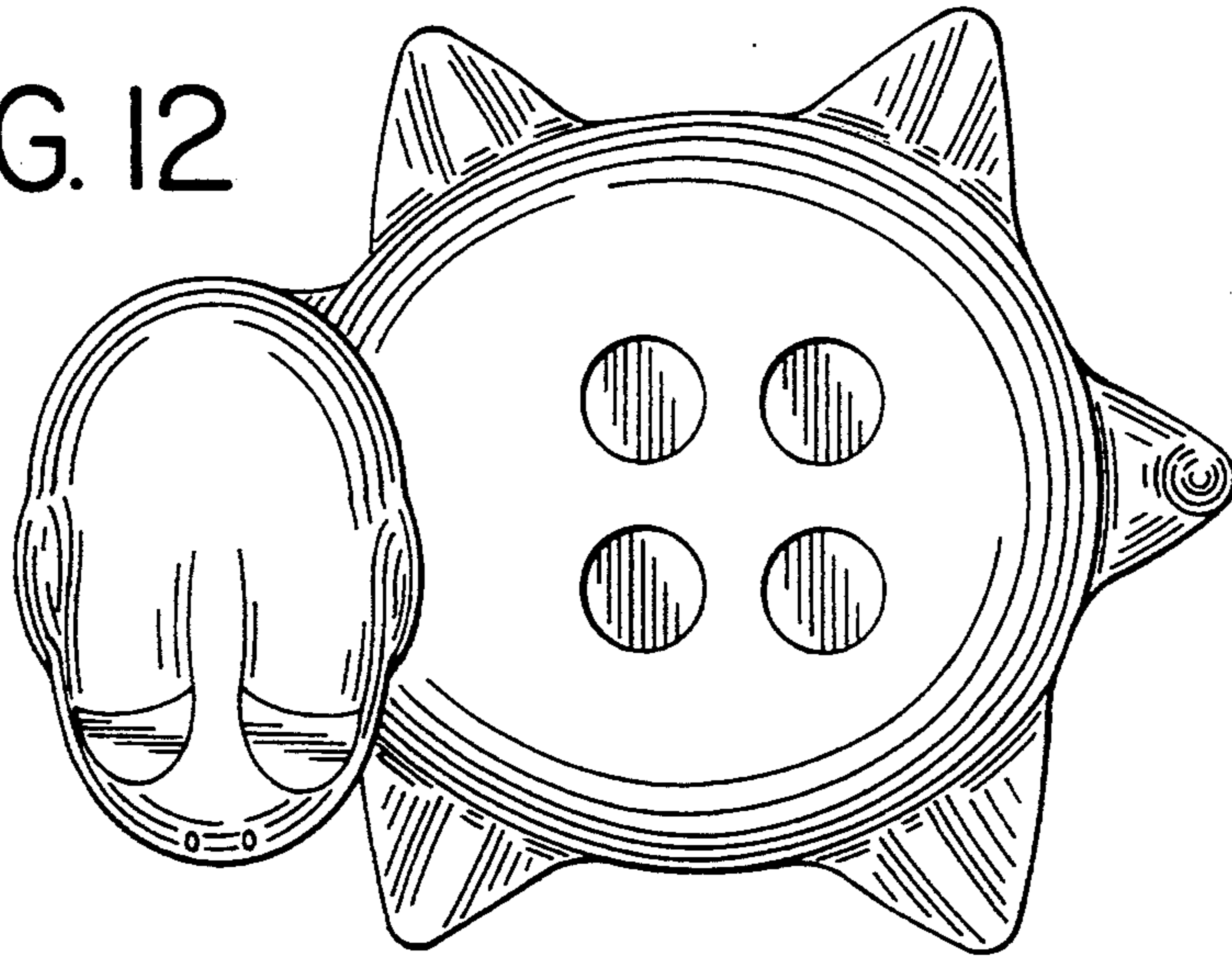

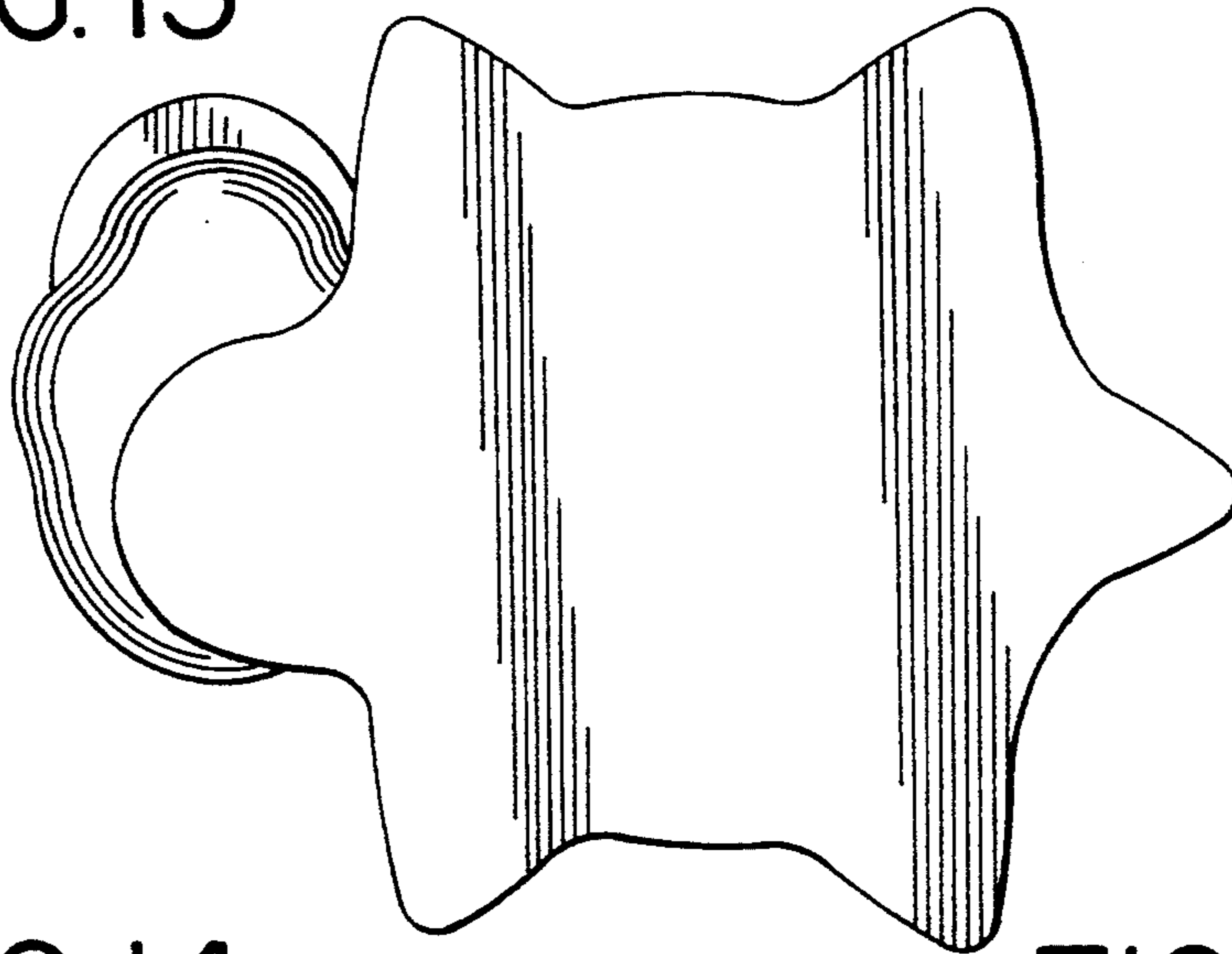

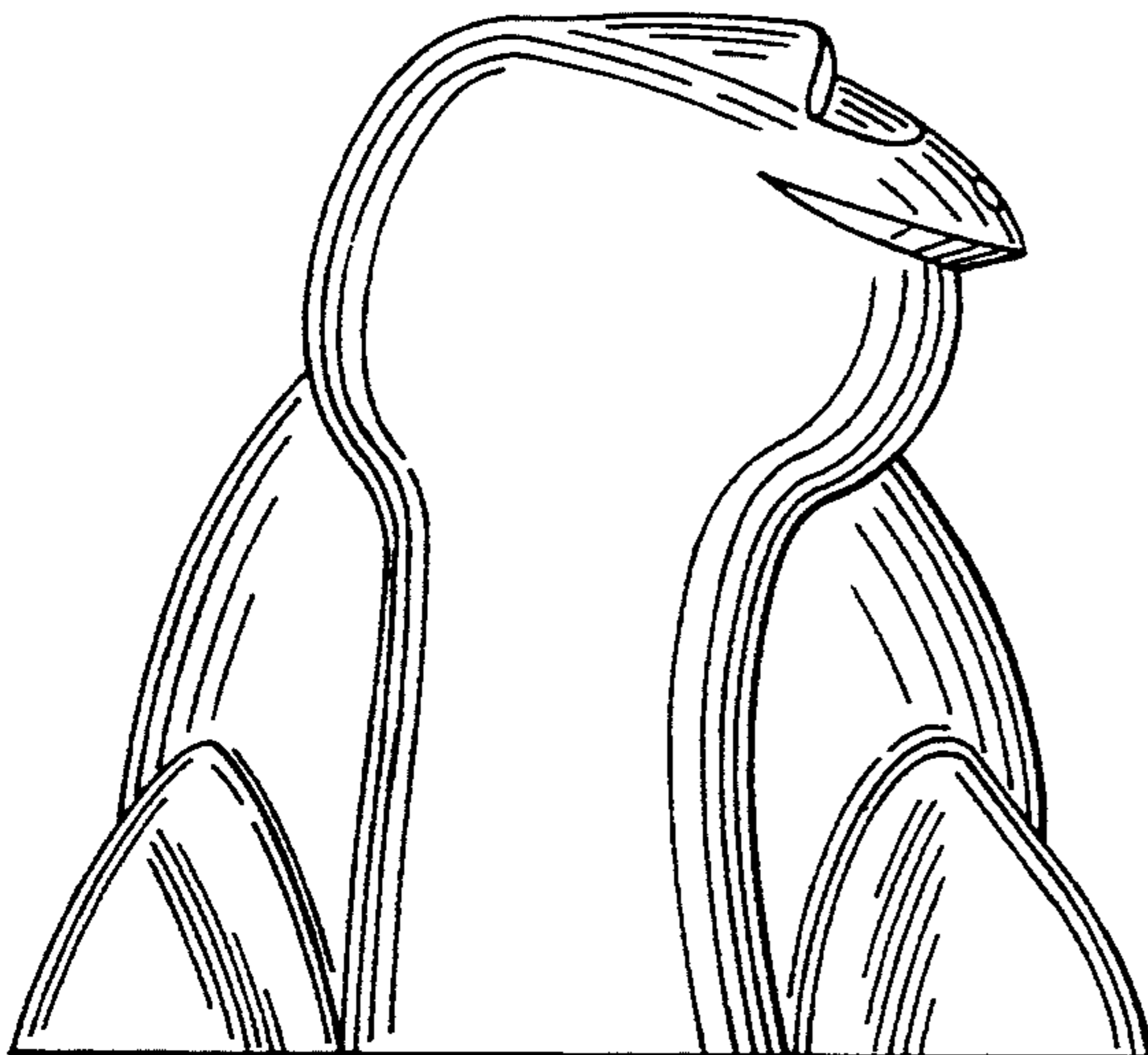
