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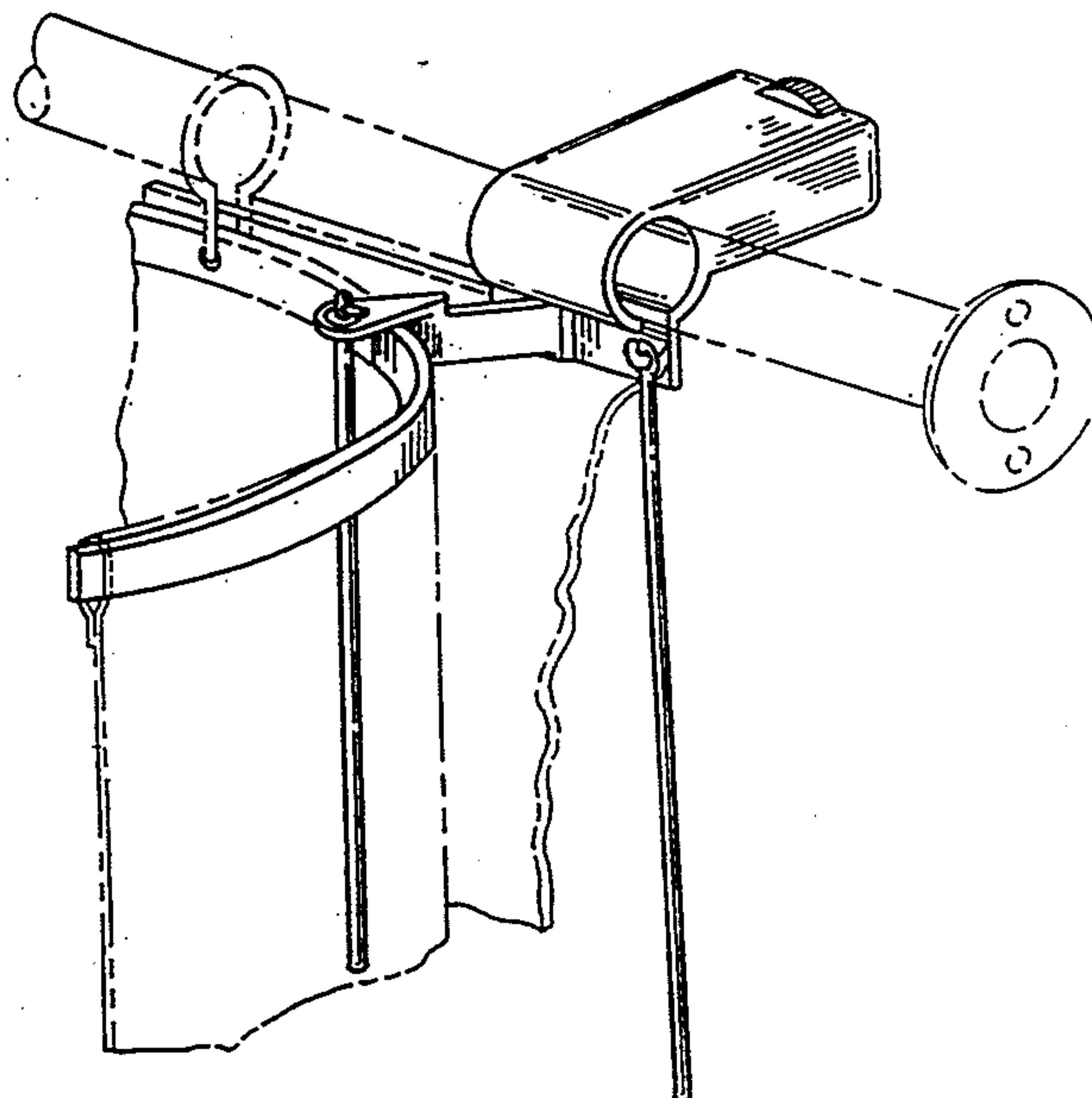

The ornamental design for a shower curtain support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the first embodiment of the shower curtain support according to my design as seen in use with a shower curtain rod and a shower curtain;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the shower curtain support according to my design;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 11 is a left side elevation thereof;
FIG. 12 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 13 is a right side elevation thereof; and,
FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken line showing of a shower curtain rod and shower curtain is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



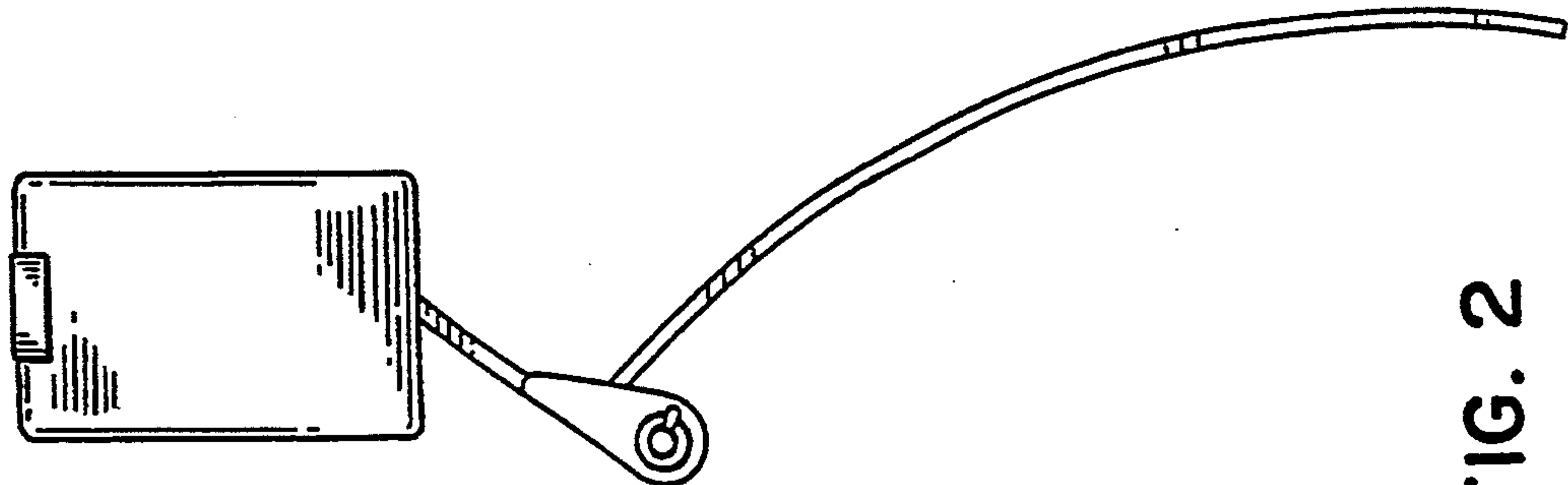

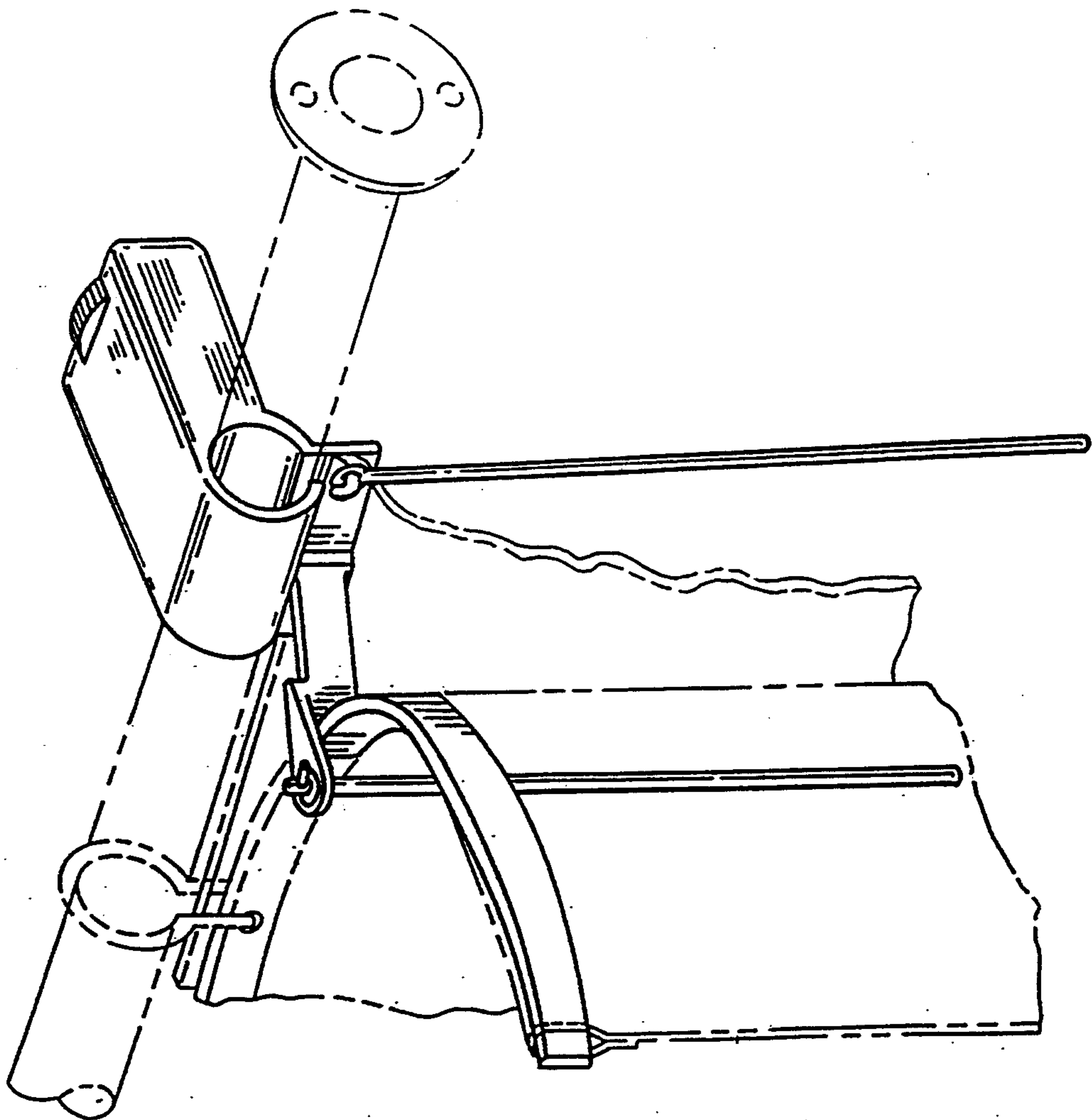

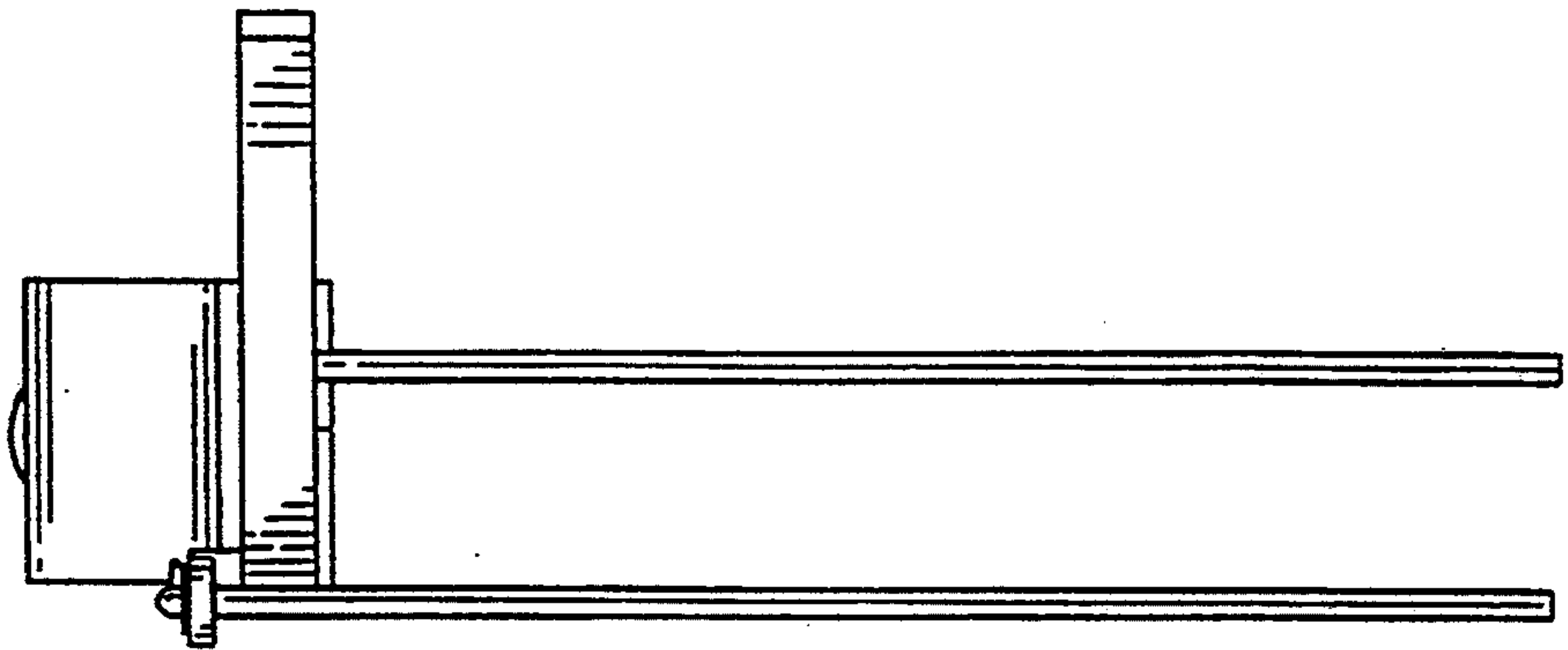

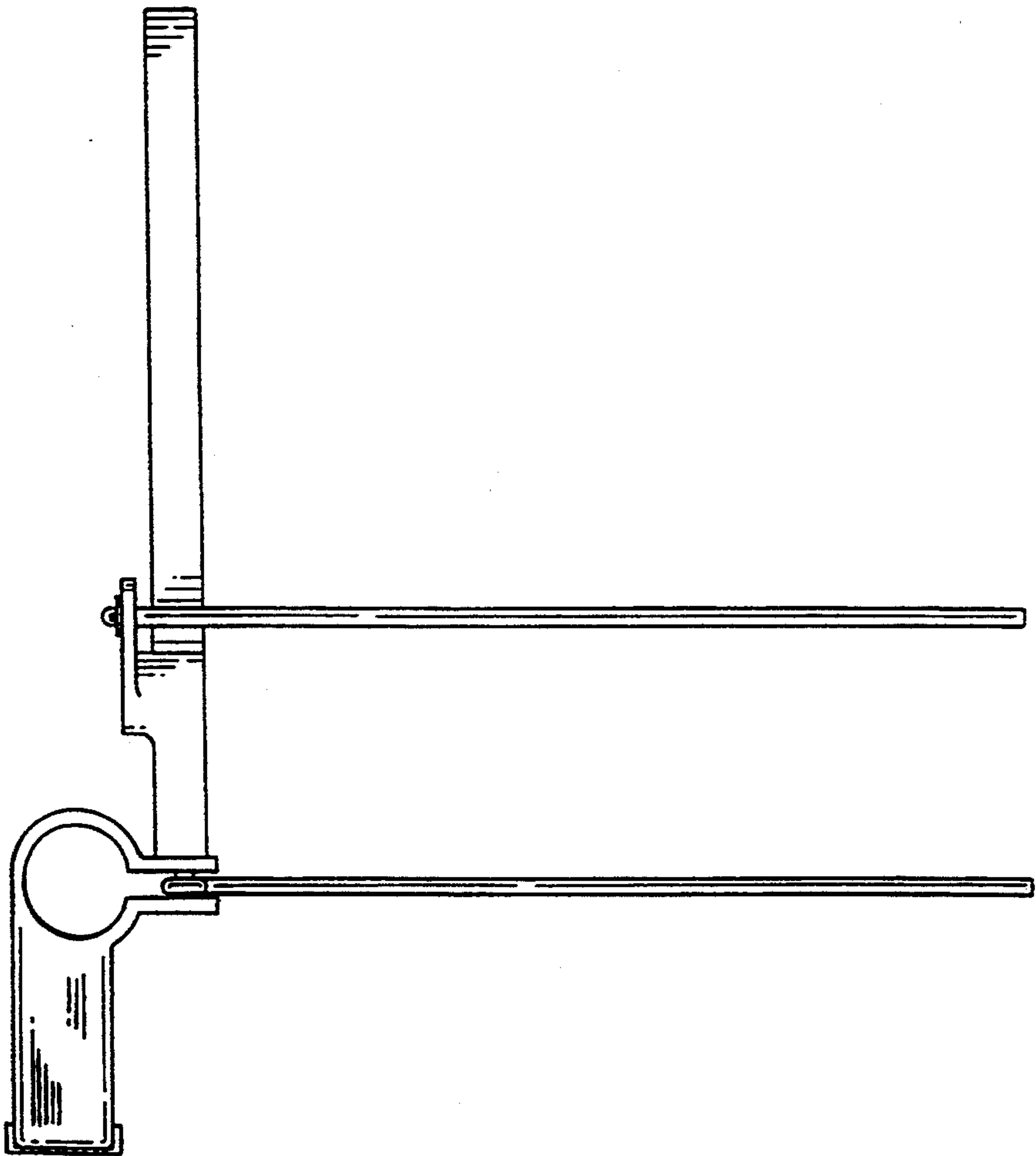

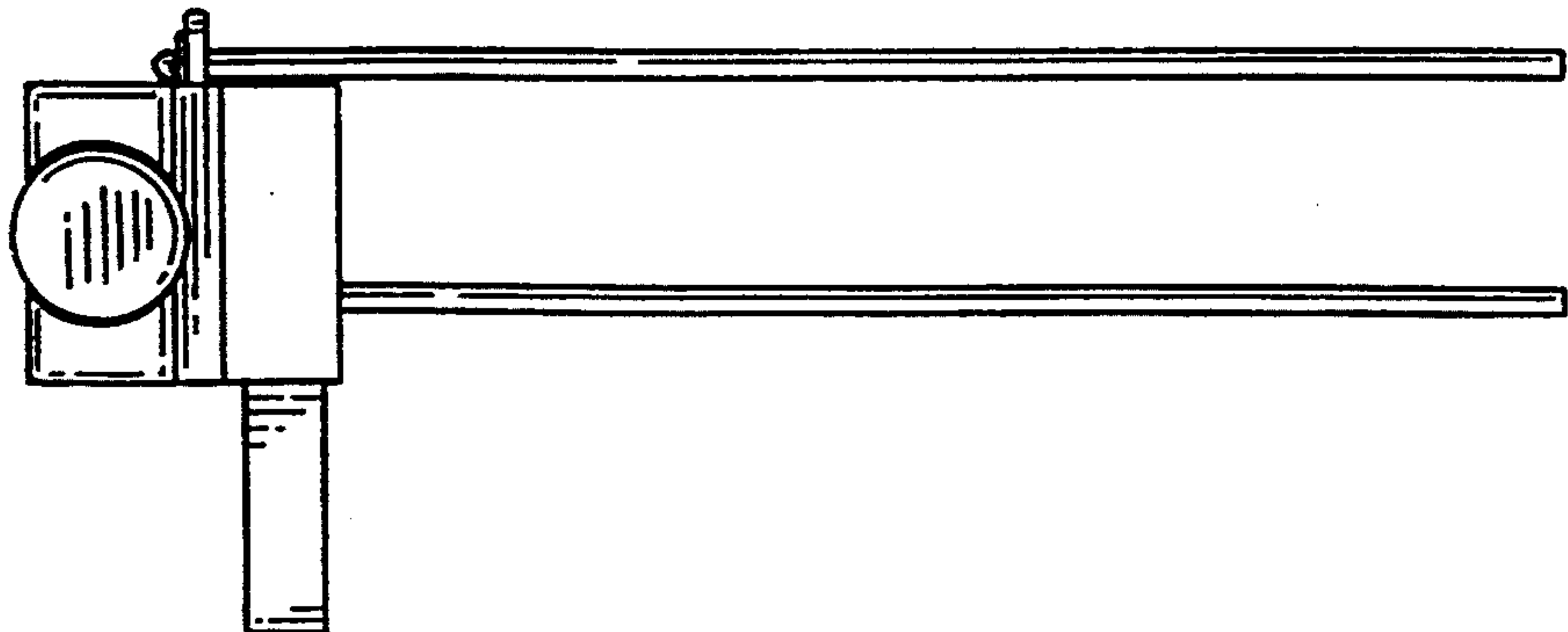
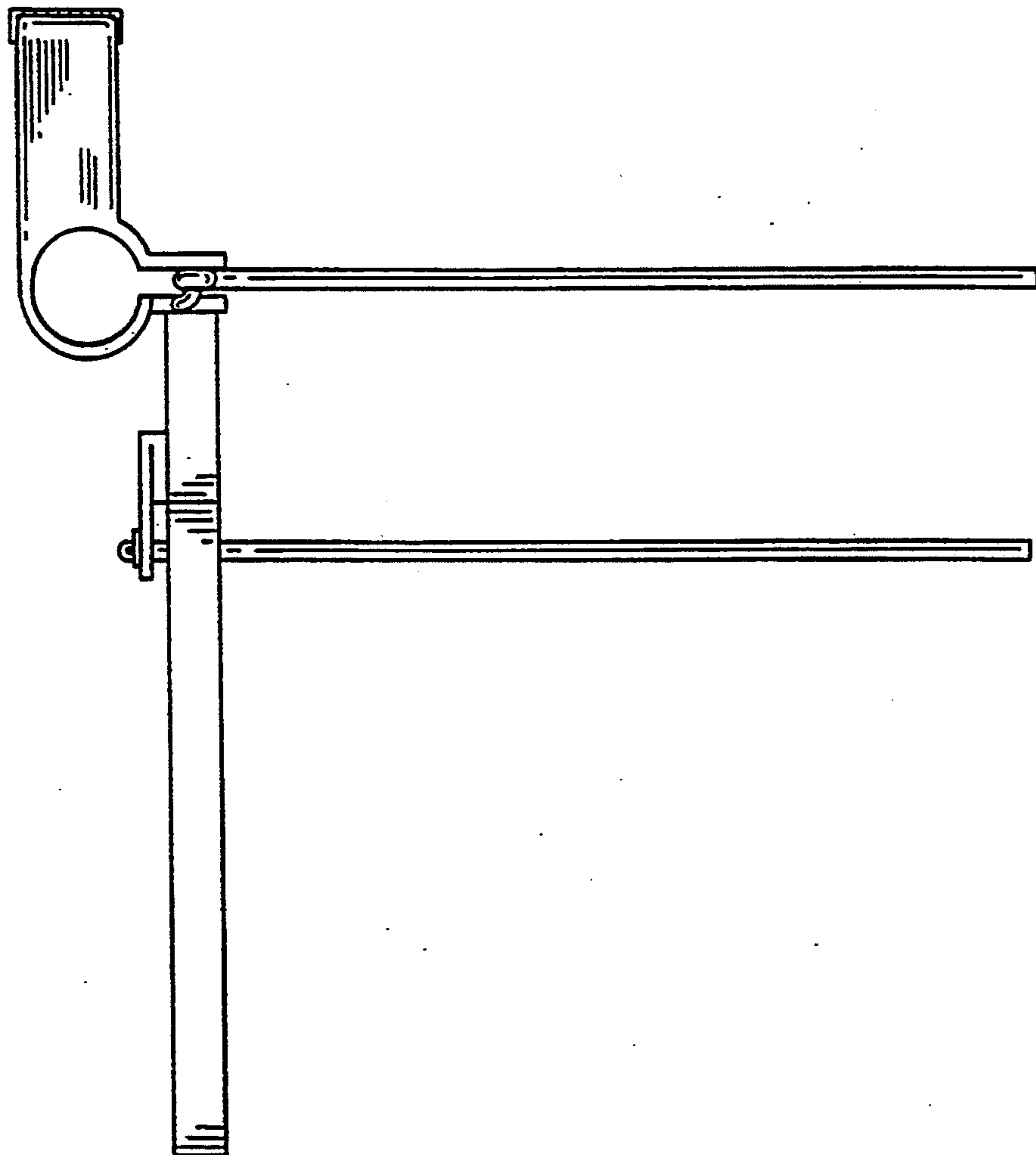
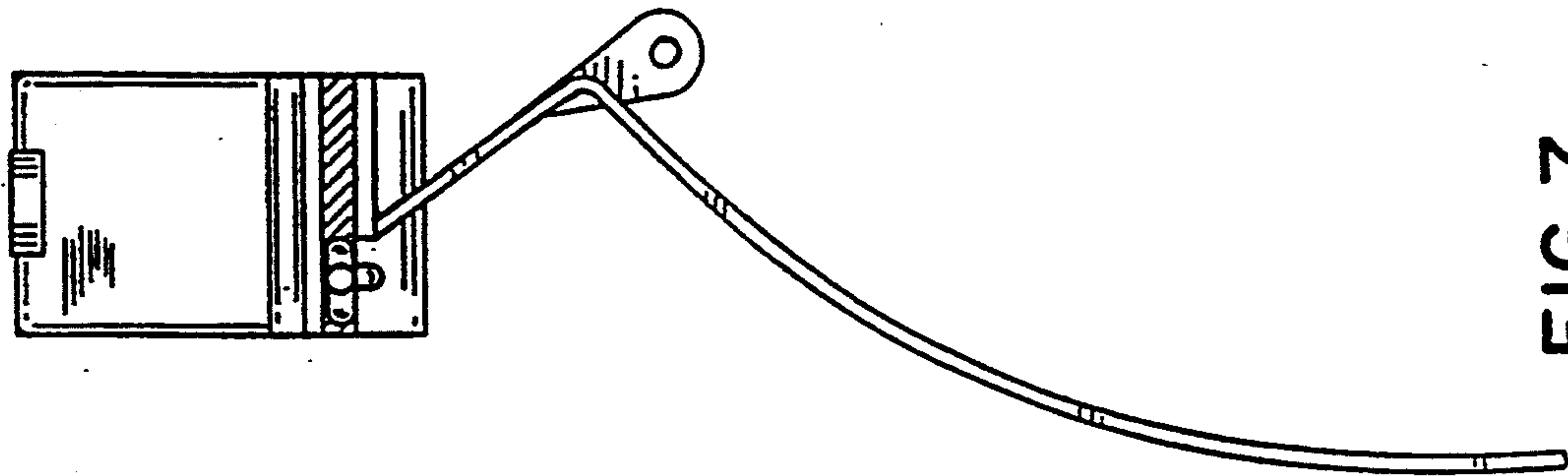

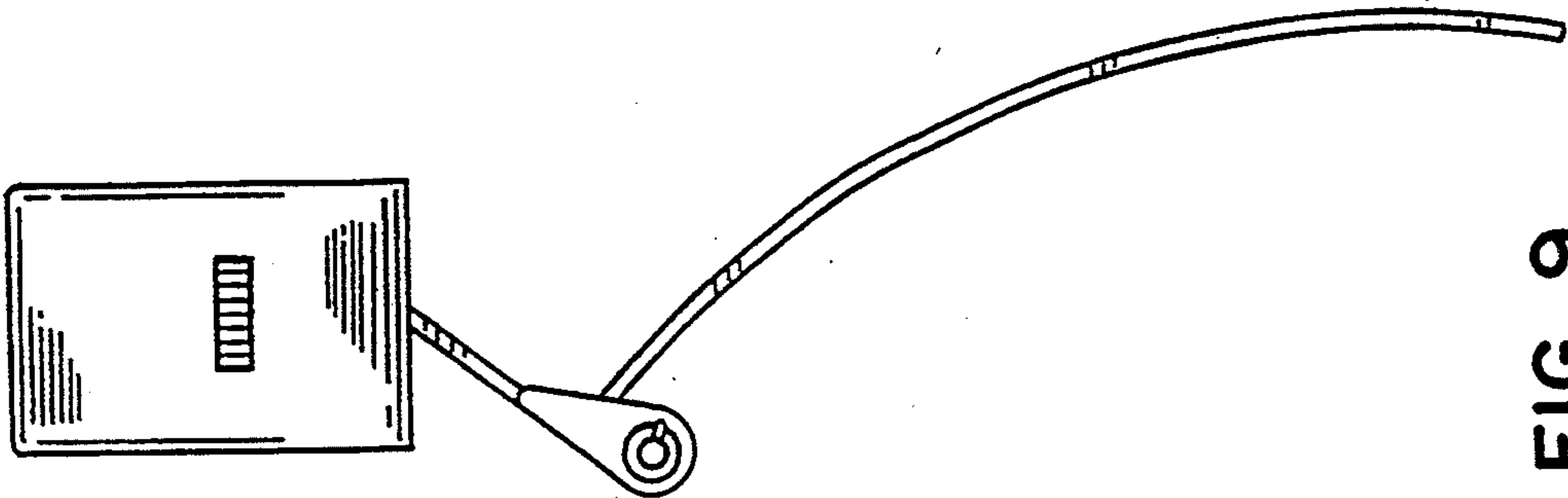

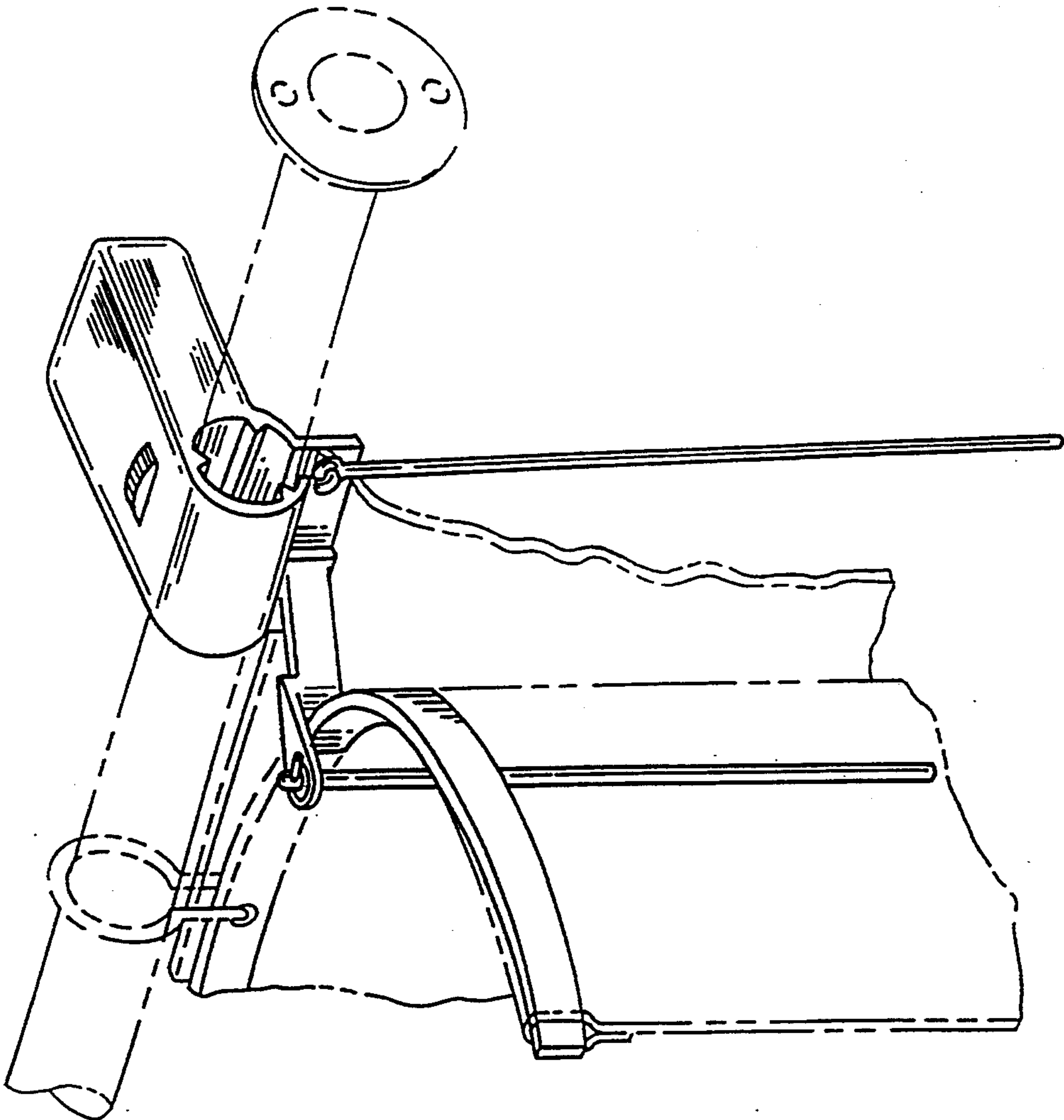

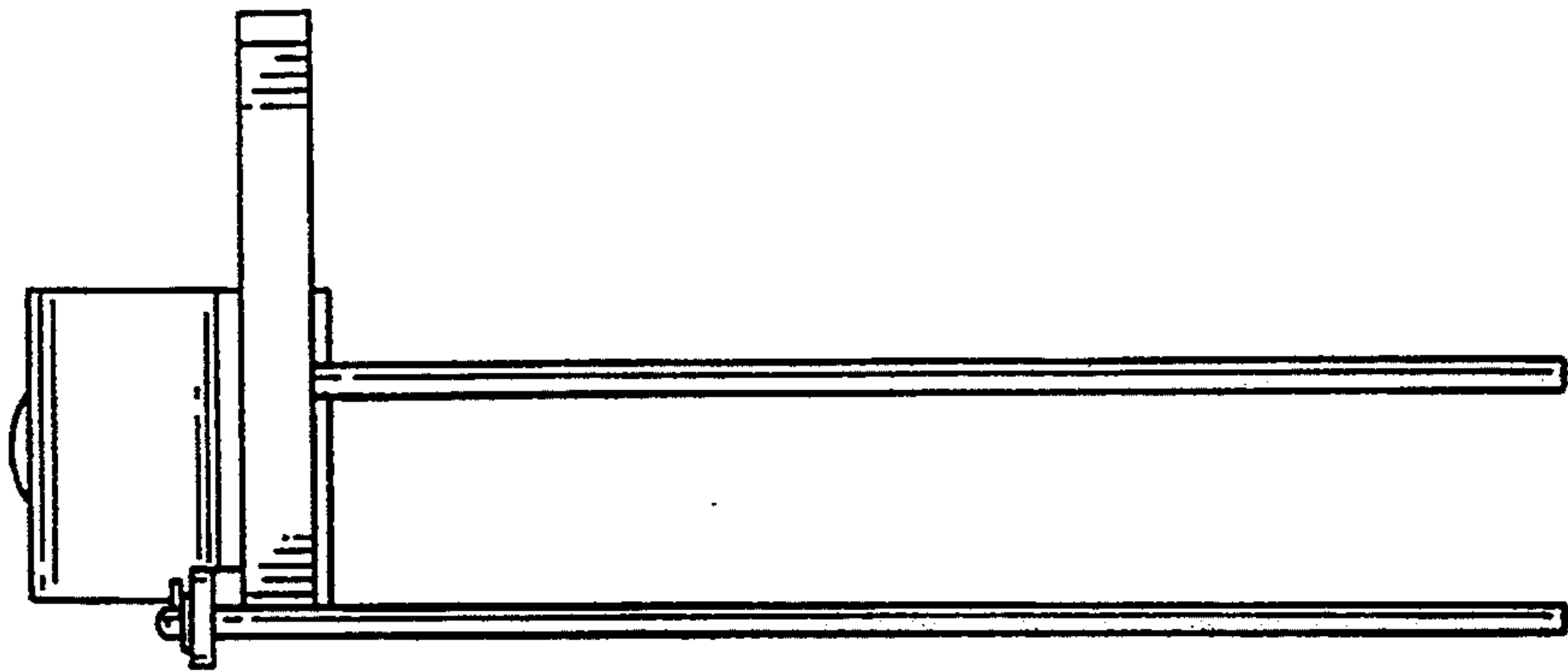

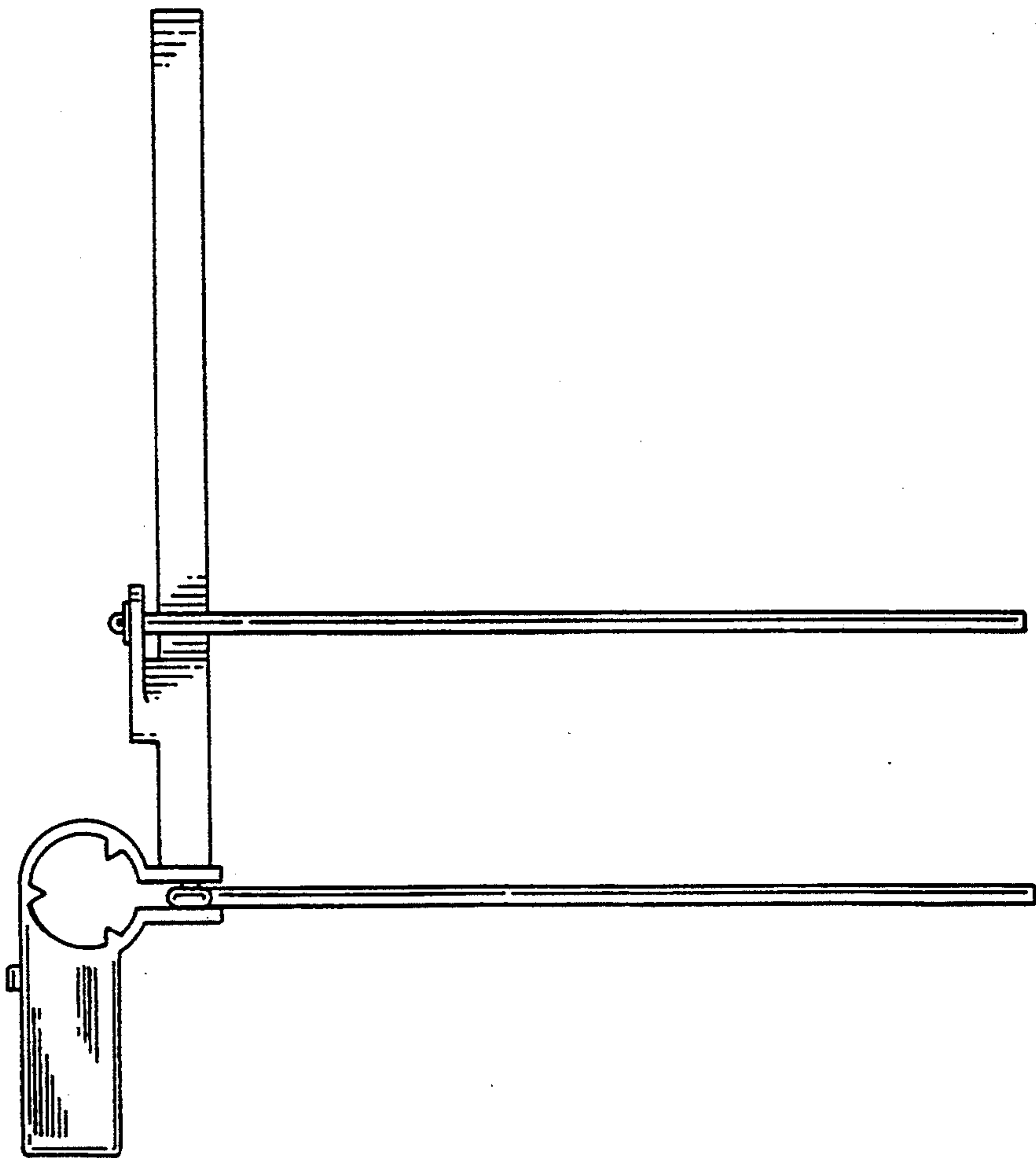

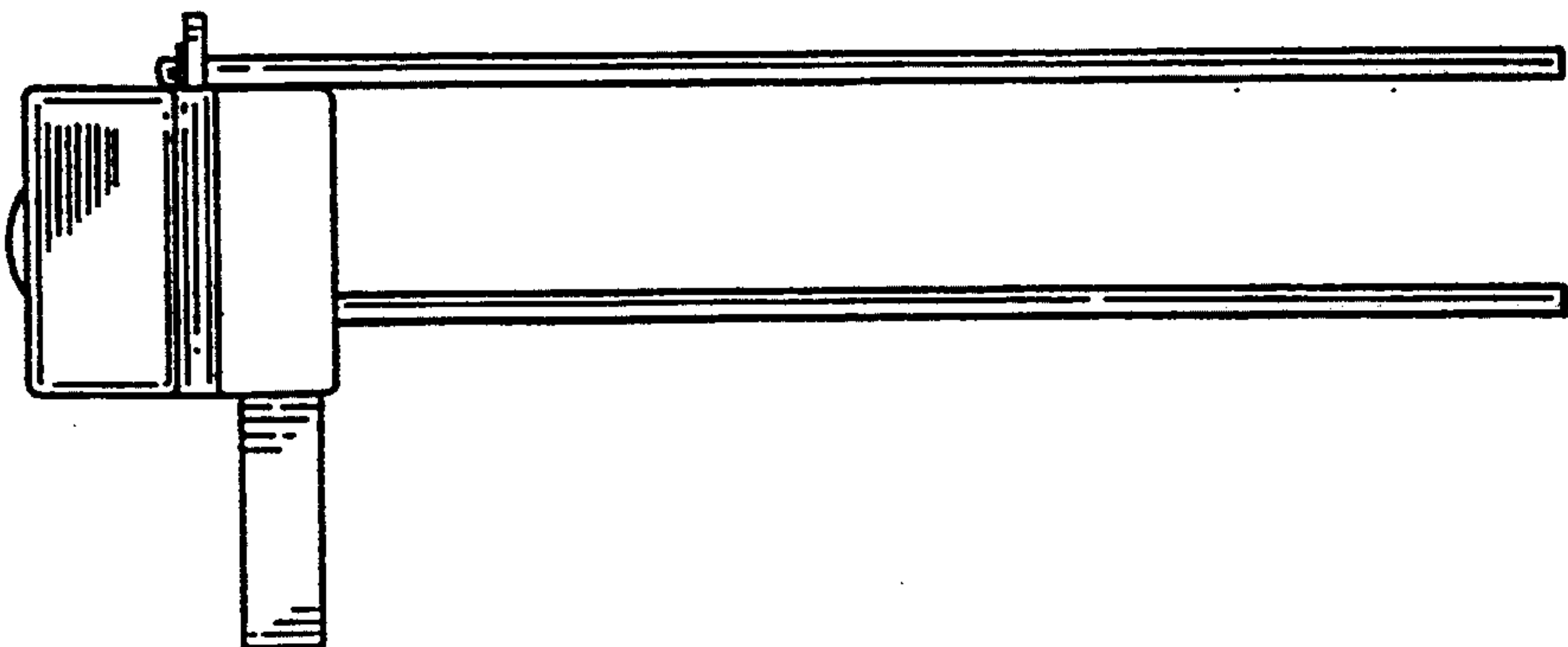

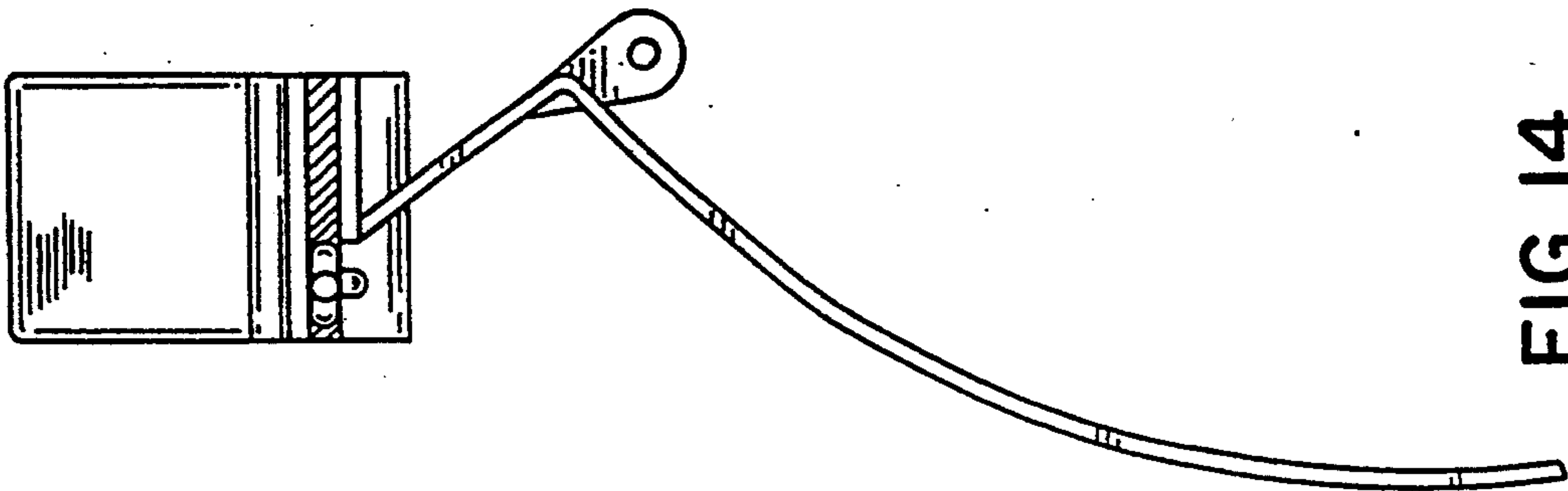

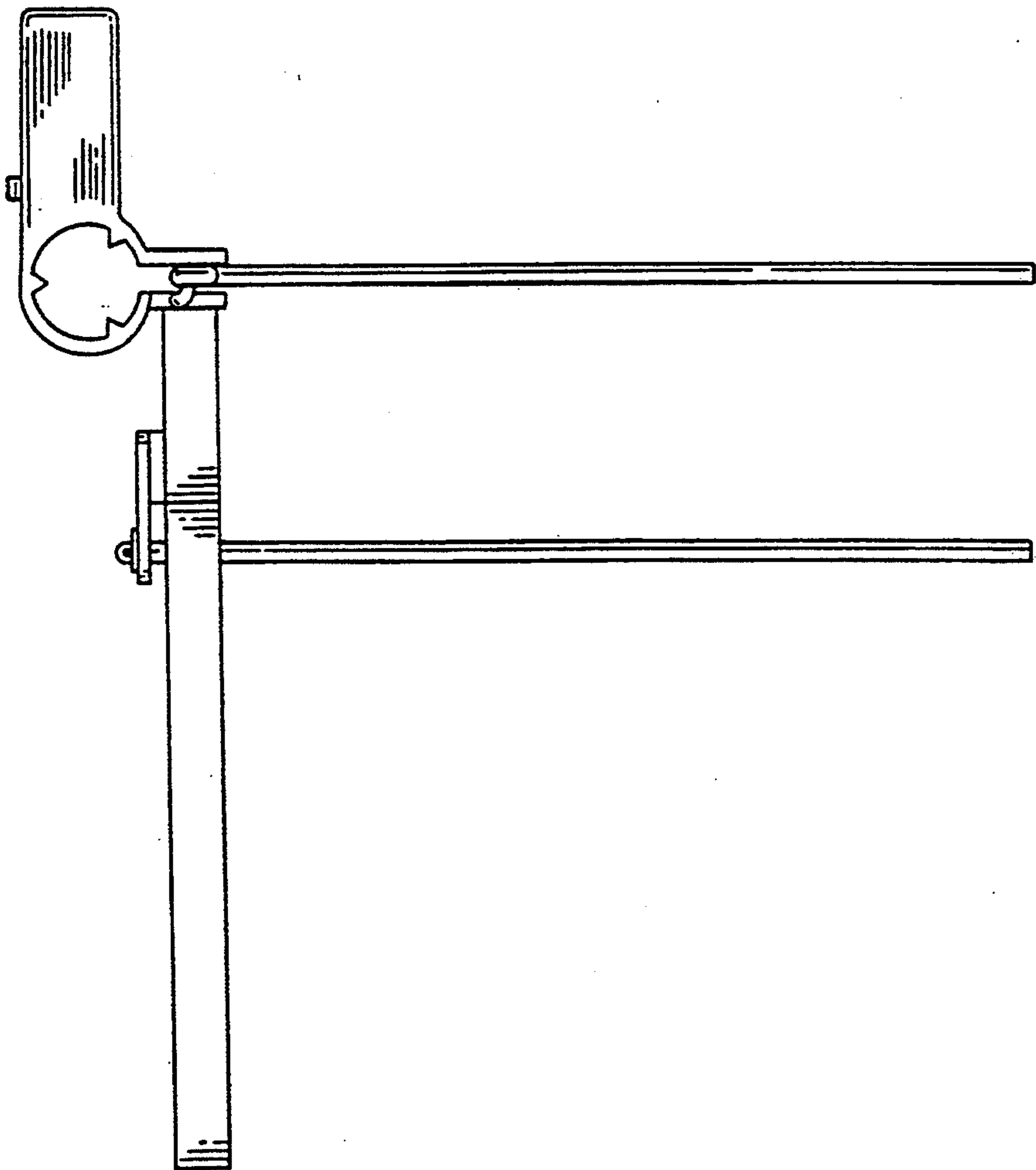
