The ornamental design for pavement marker, as shown and described.

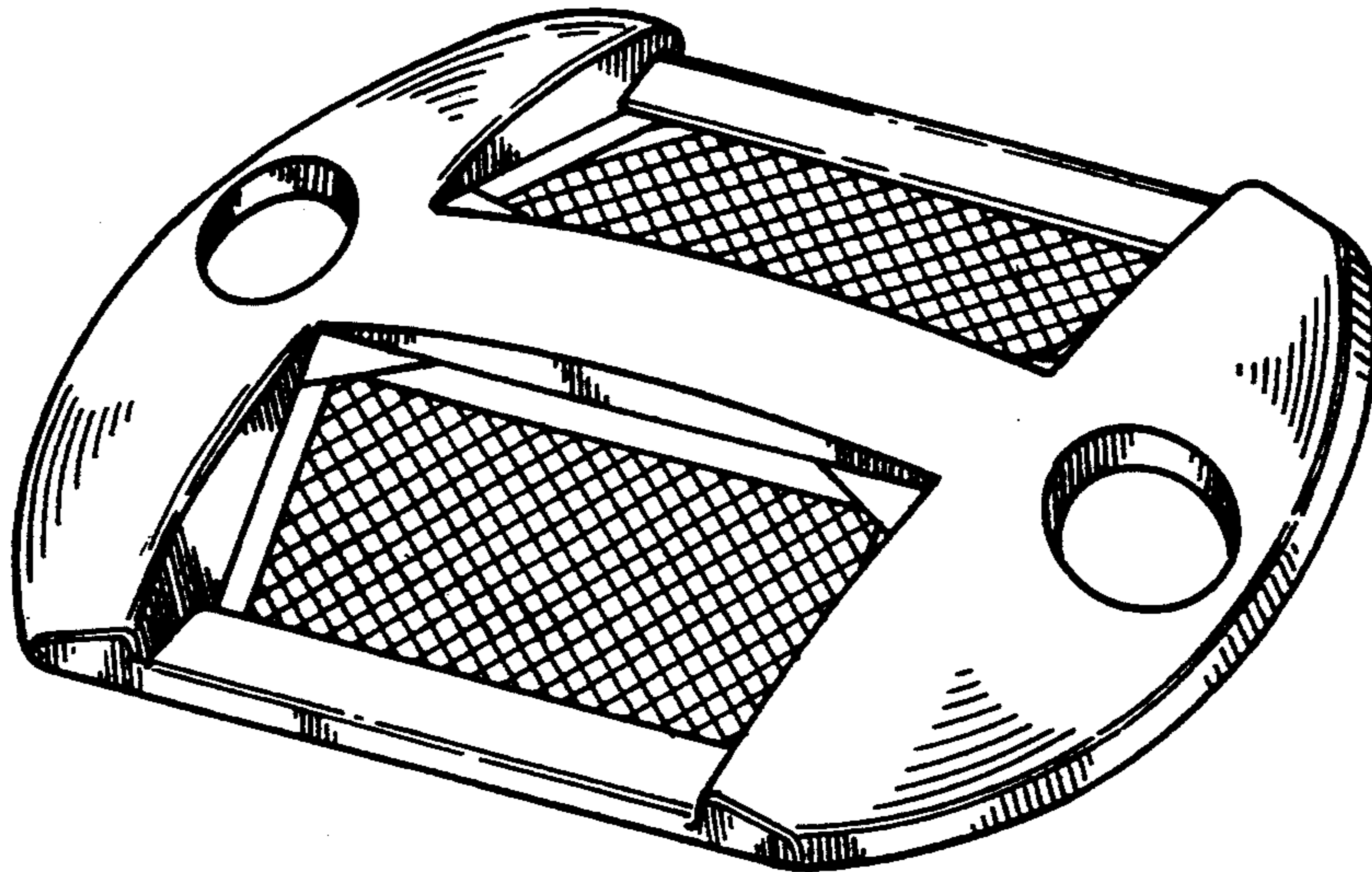
DESCRIPTION

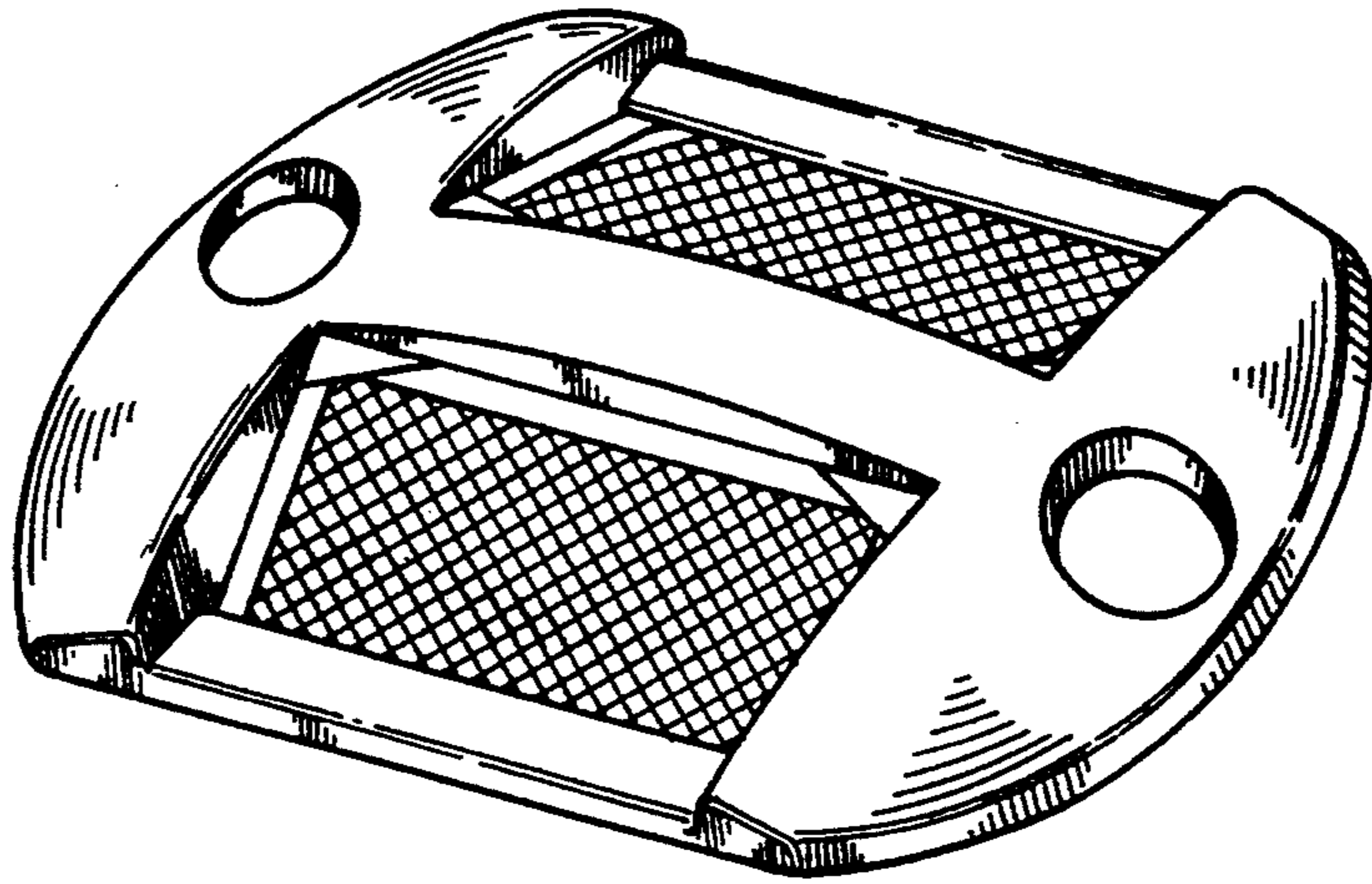

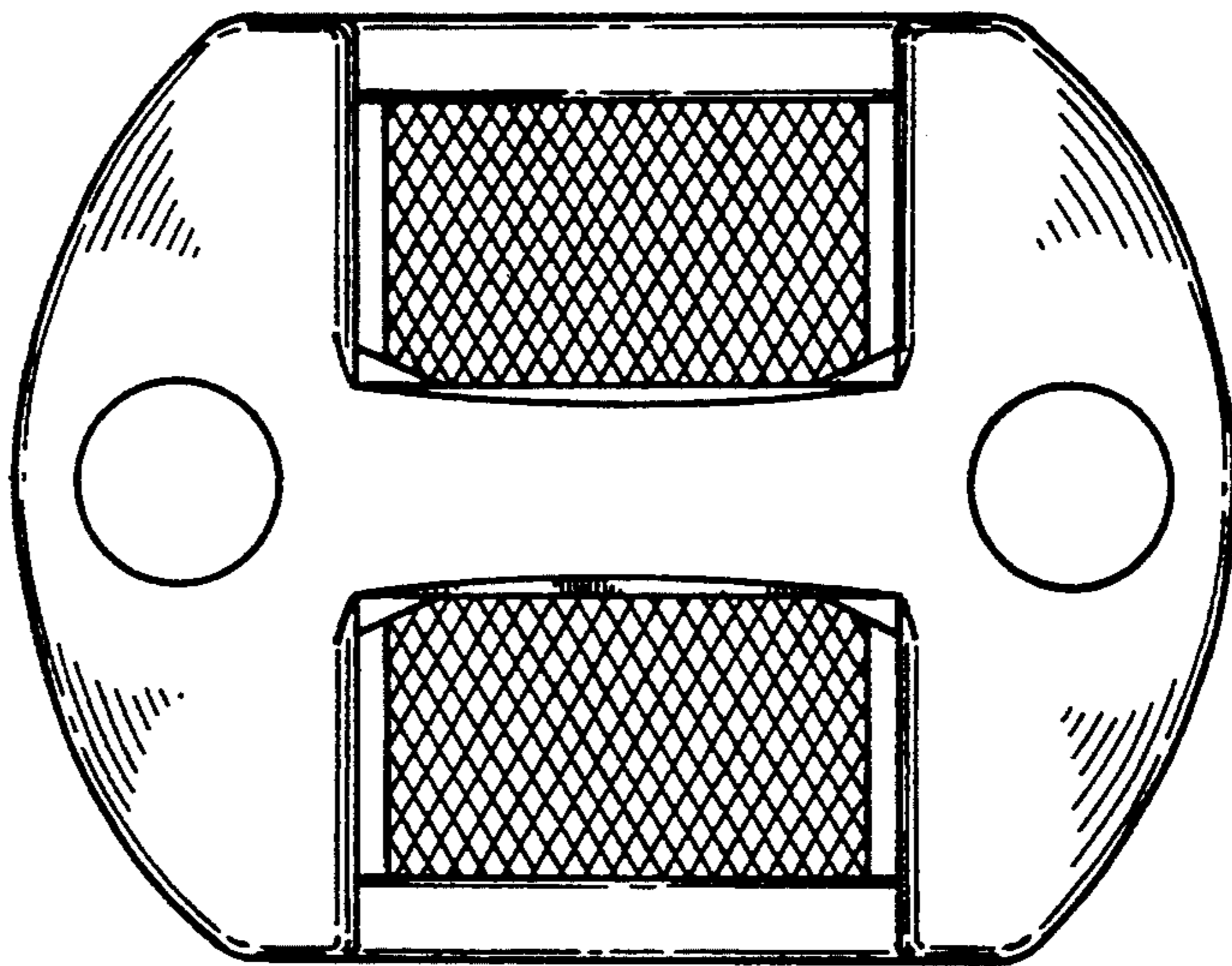

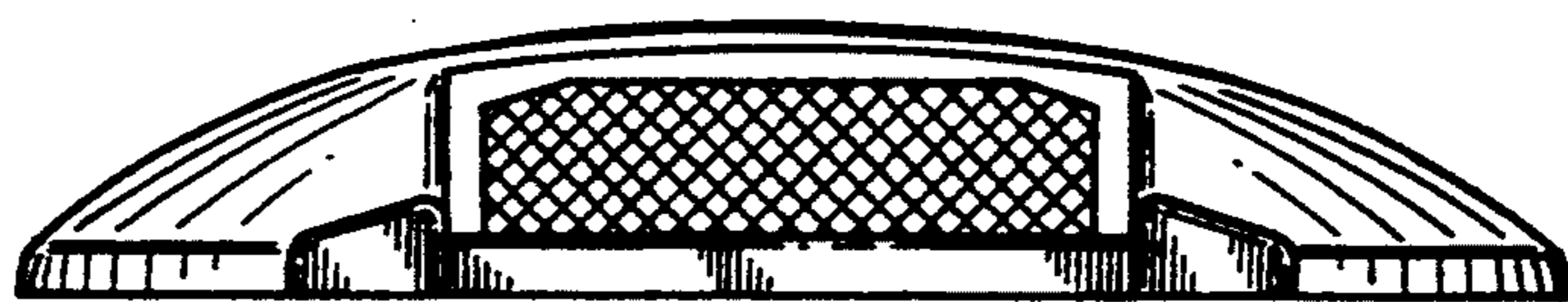

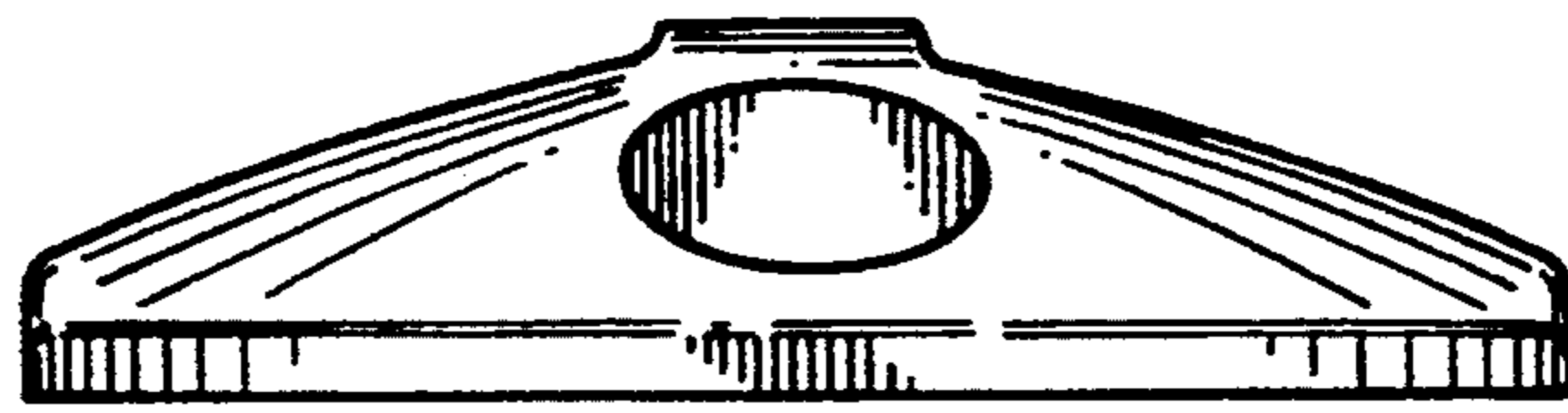

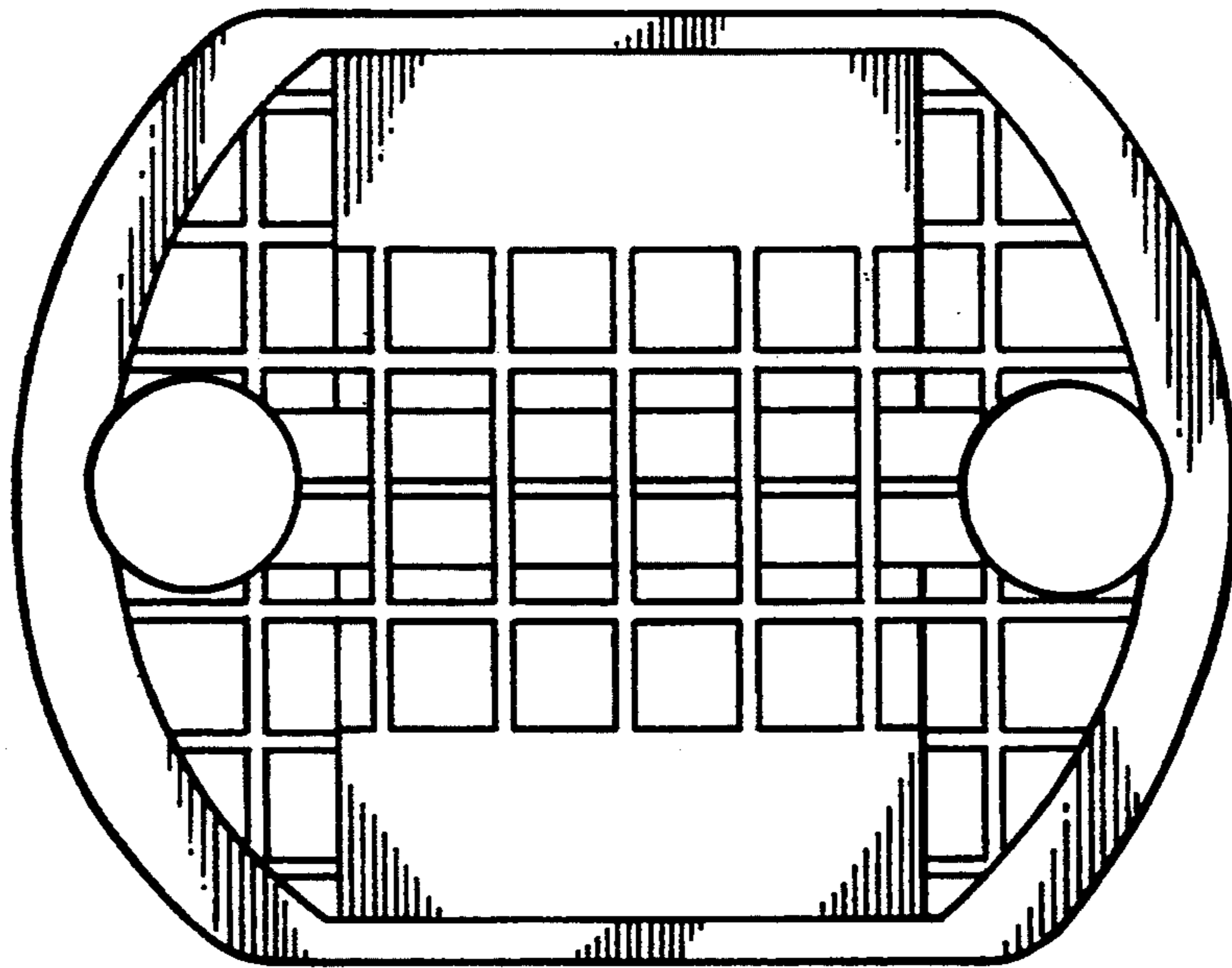
