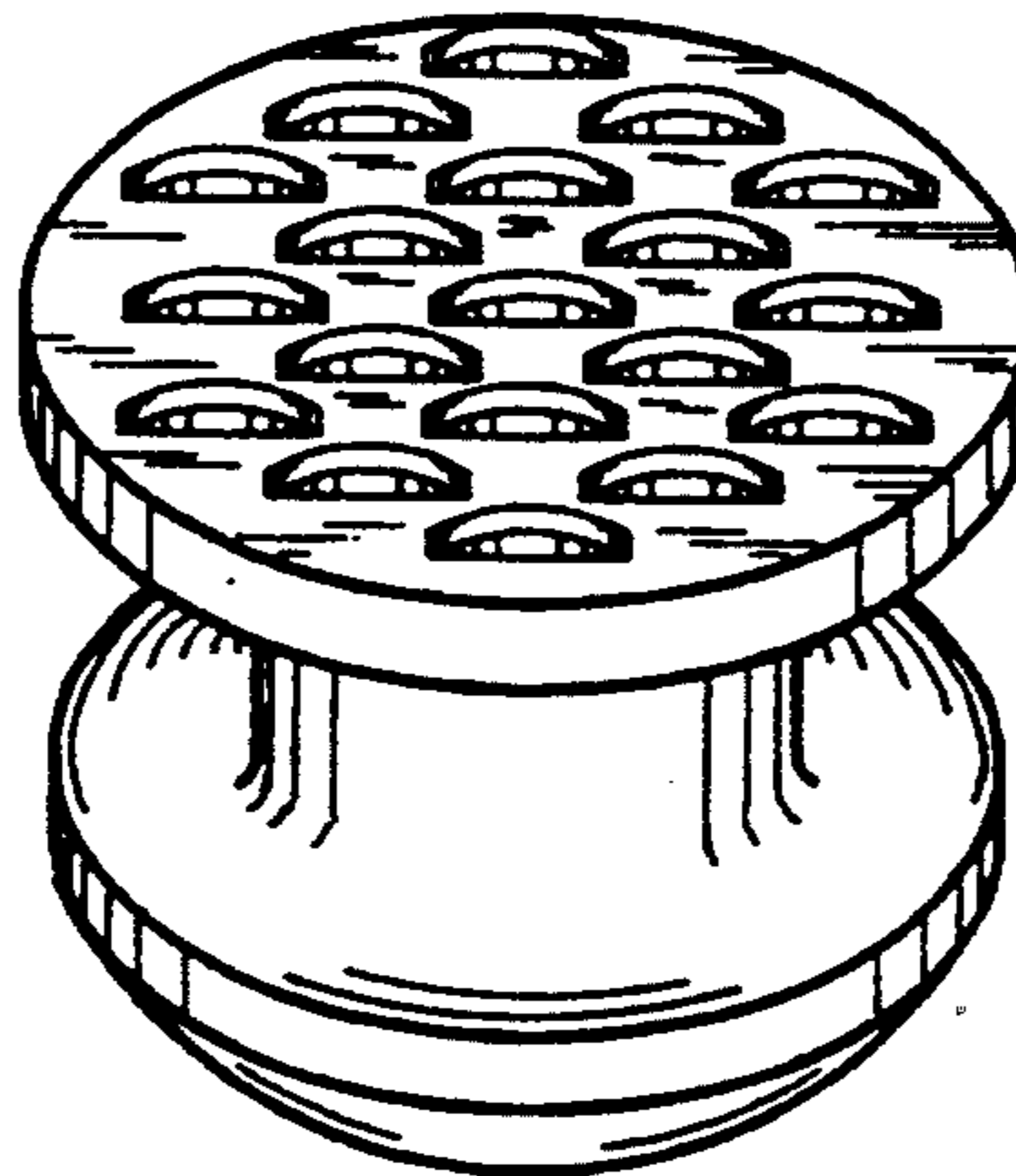
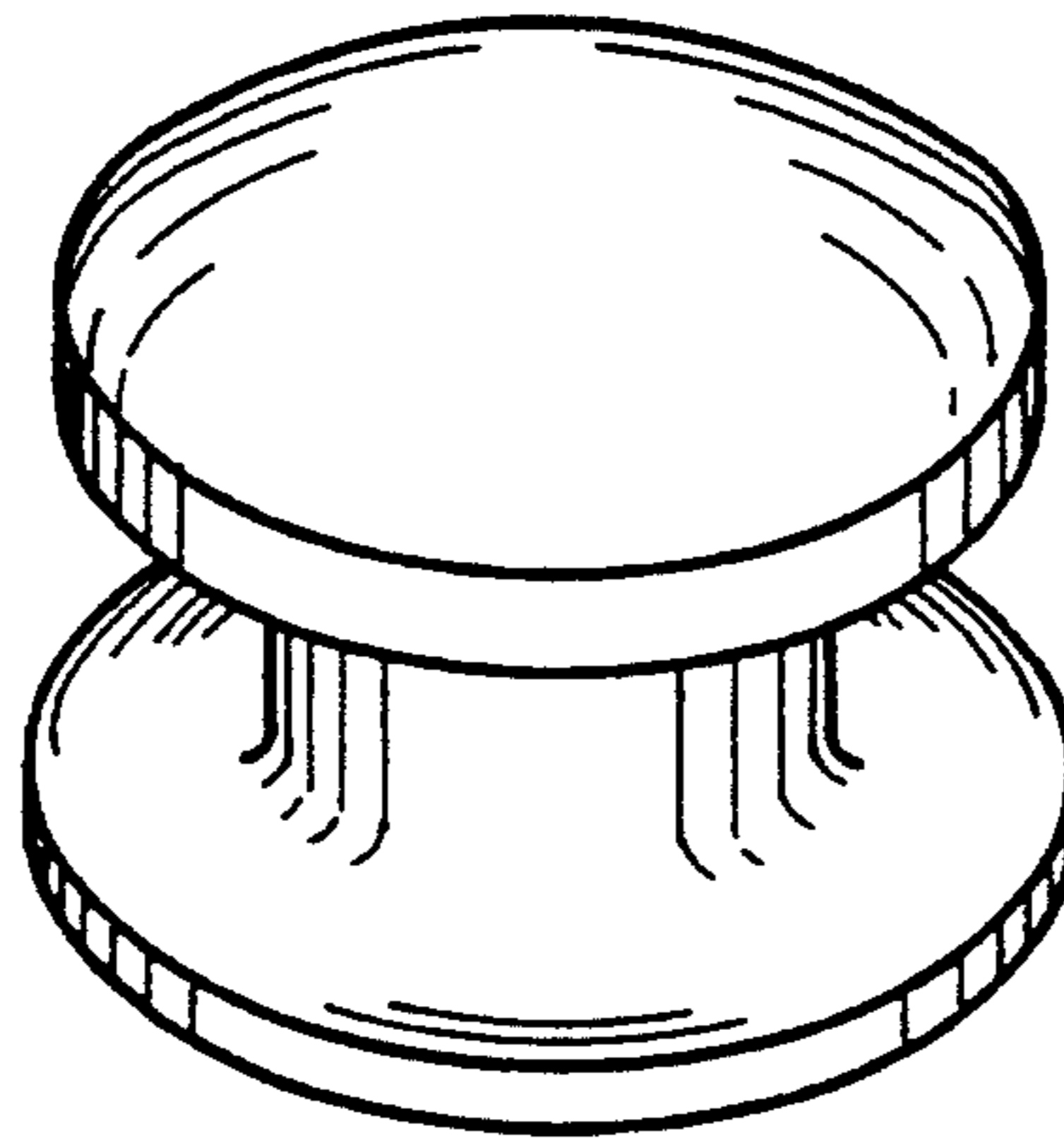

The ornamental design for a scalp massager, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top isometric view of a scalp massager, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom isometric view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top isometric view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom isometric view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 4 taken along line 7&8—7&8 of FIG. 10;
 FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1 taken along line 7&8—7&8 of FIG. 10;
 FIG. 9 is an exploded fragmented view showing the massaging nails;
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view of both embodiments;
 FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 8; and,
 FIG. 12 is a side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 8.



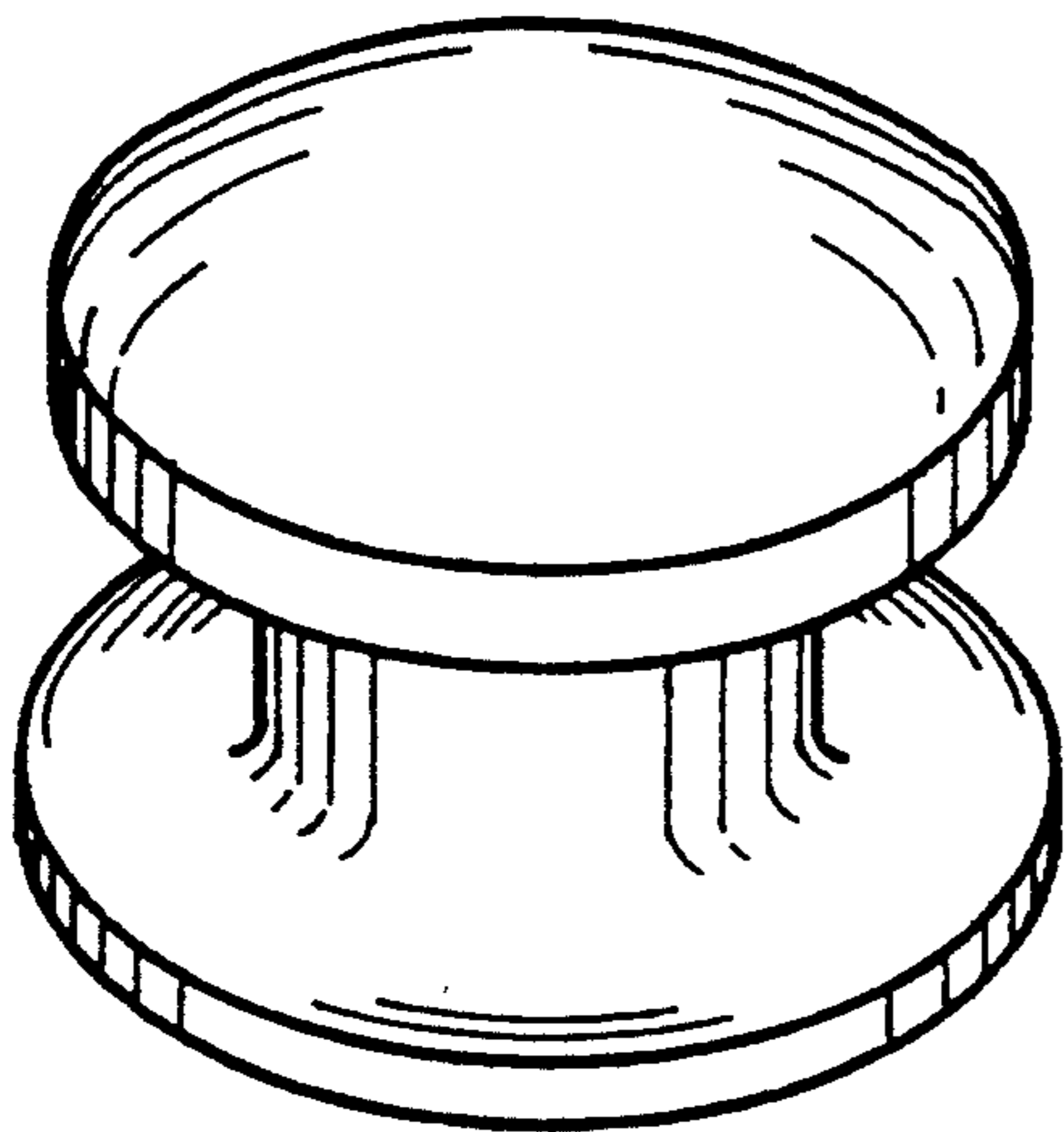

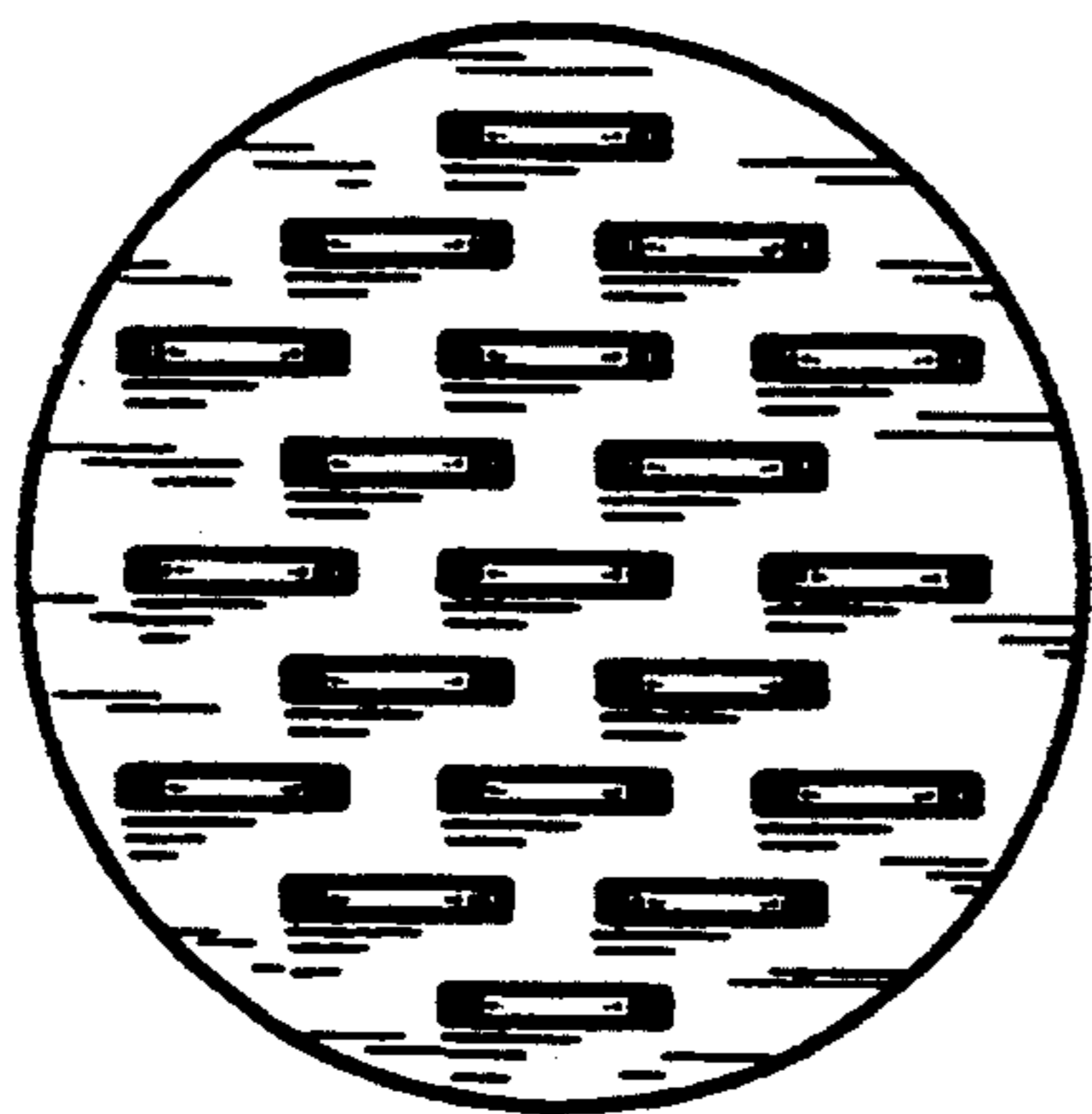

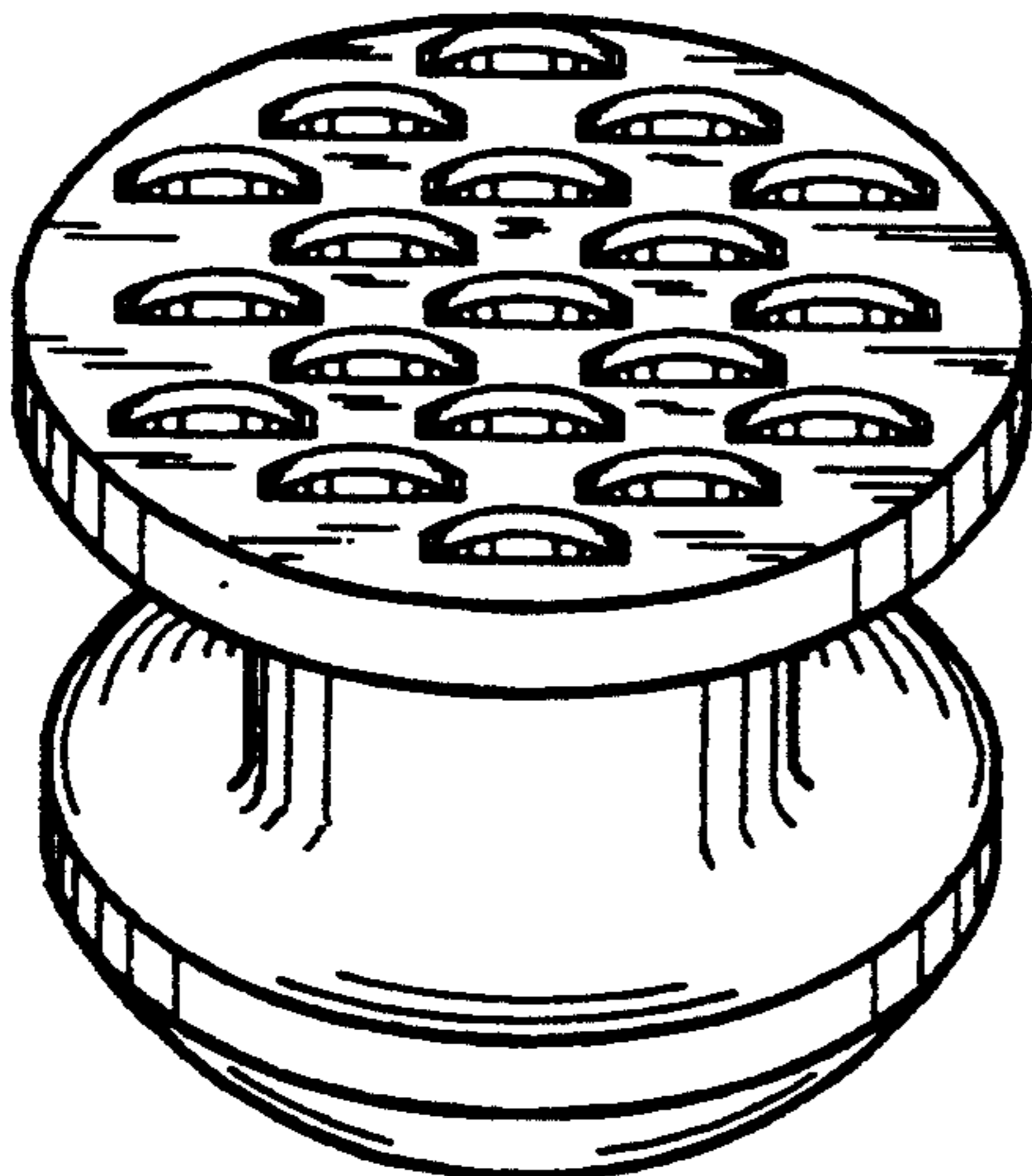

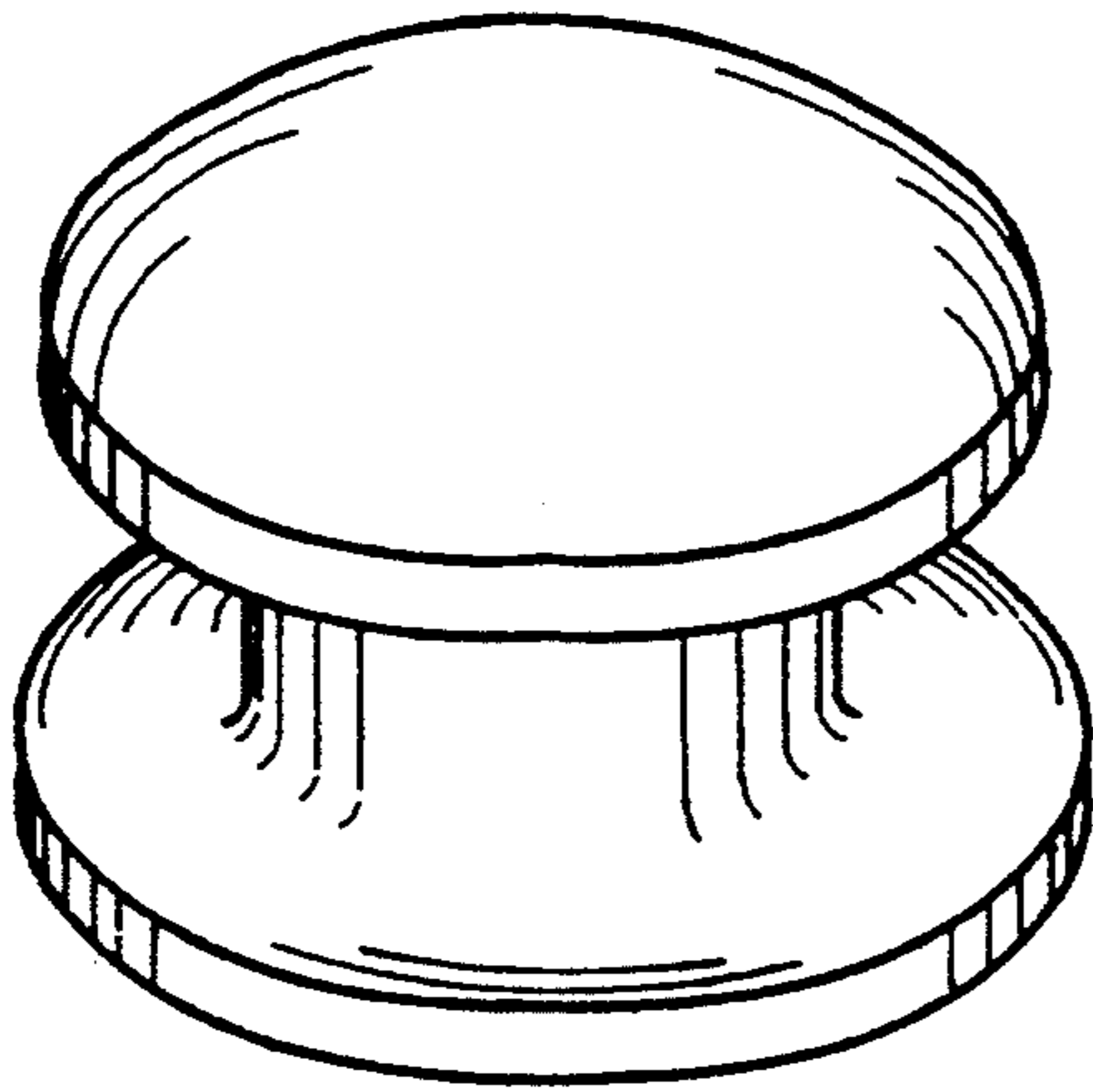

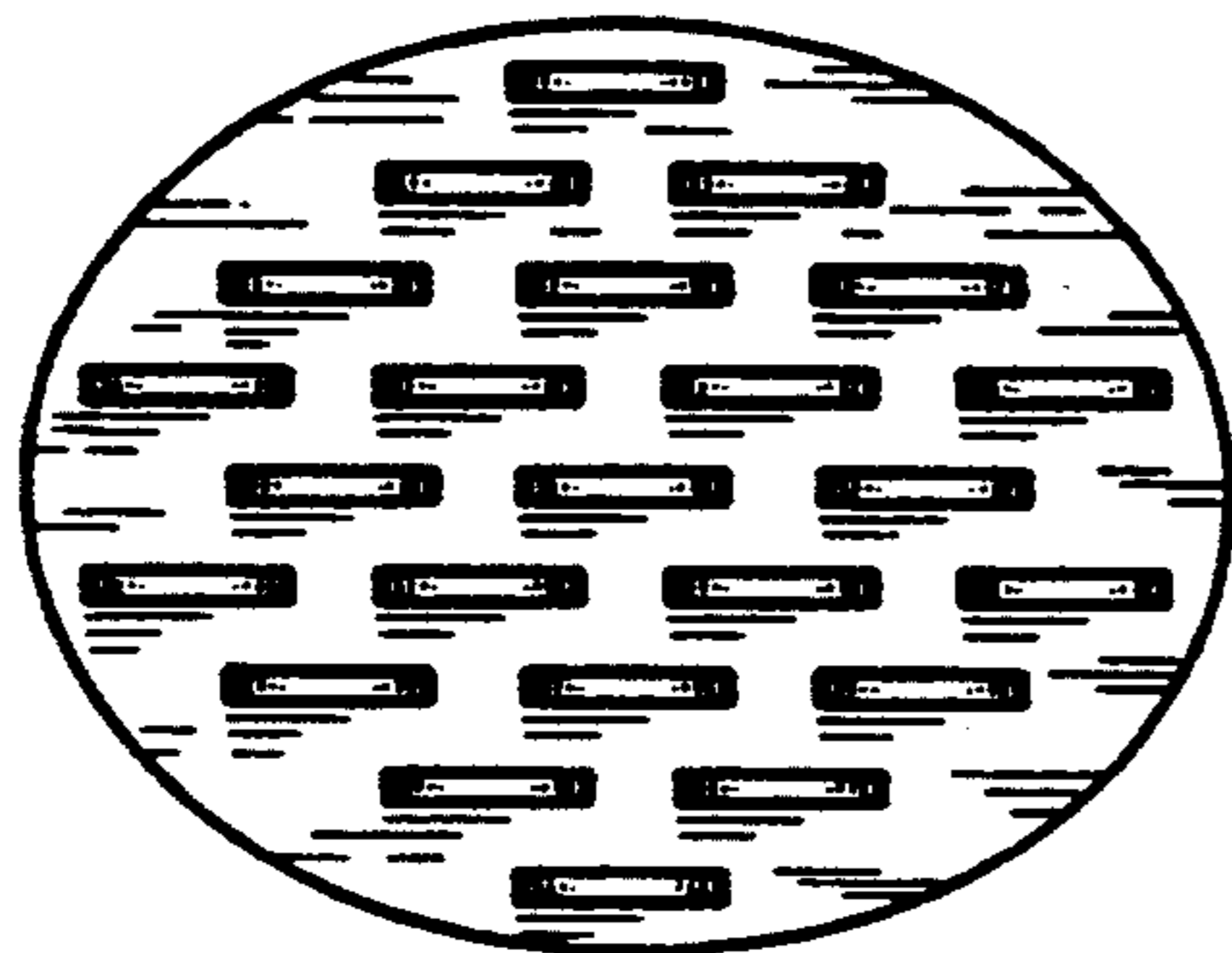

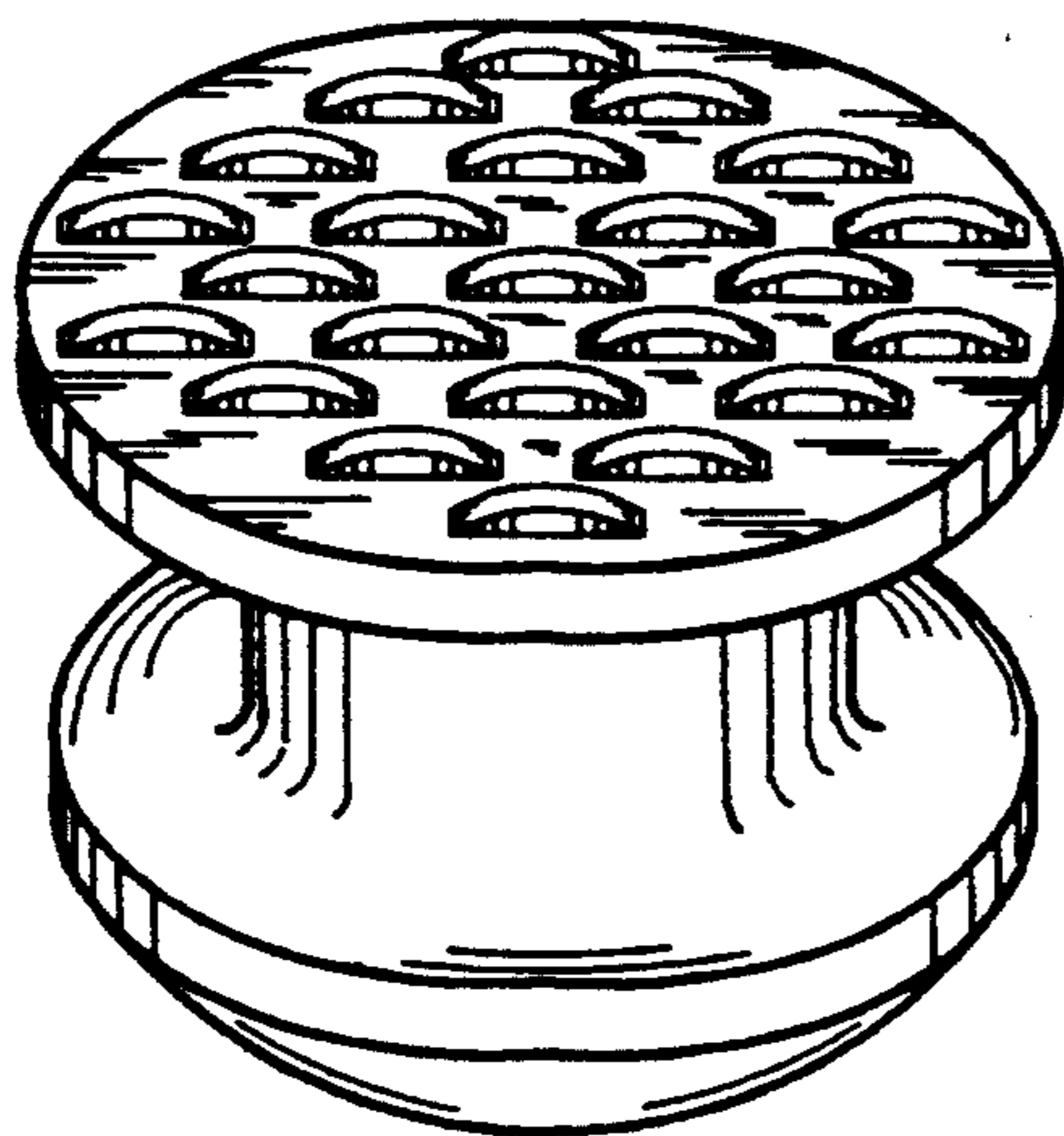

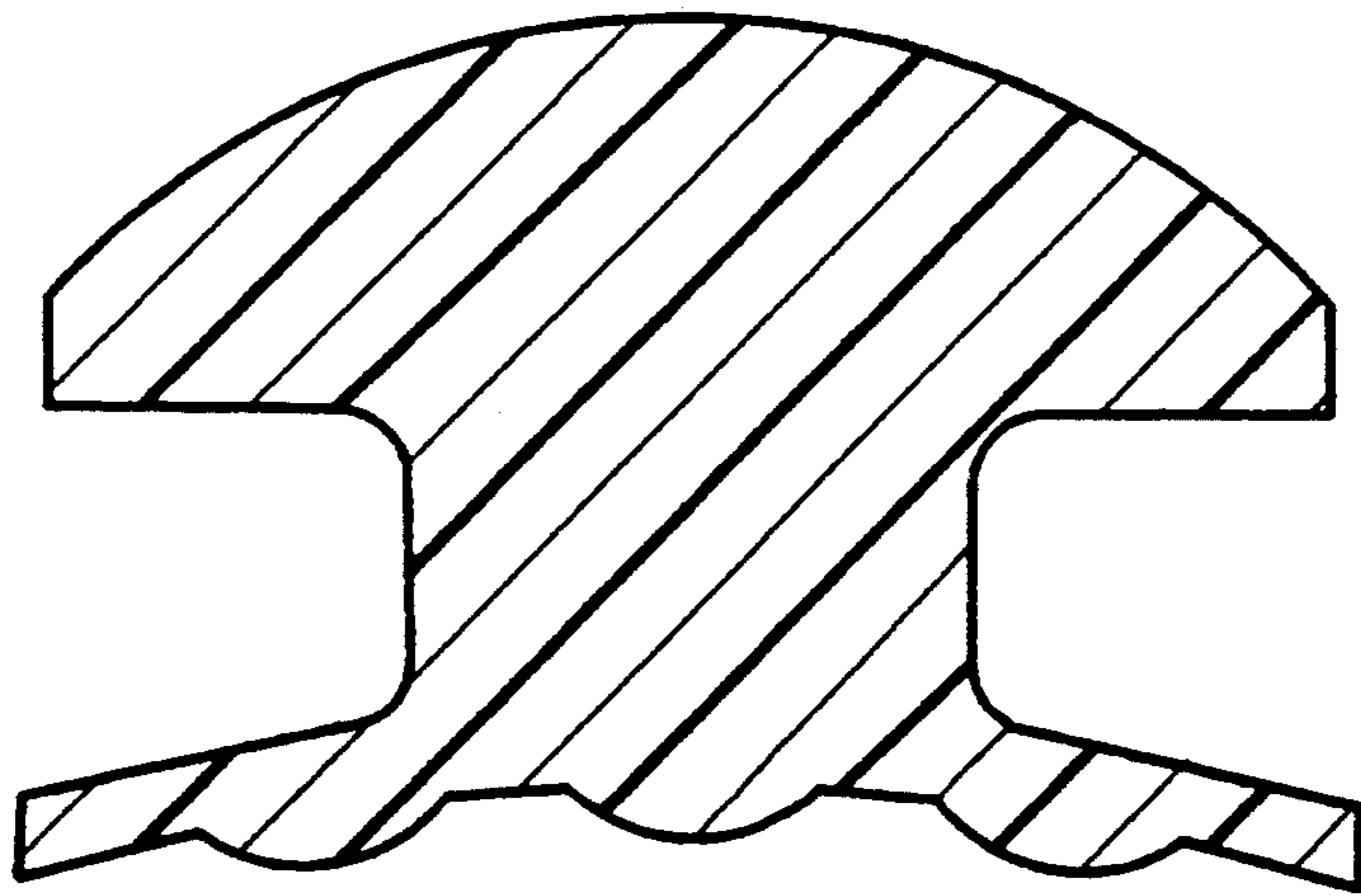

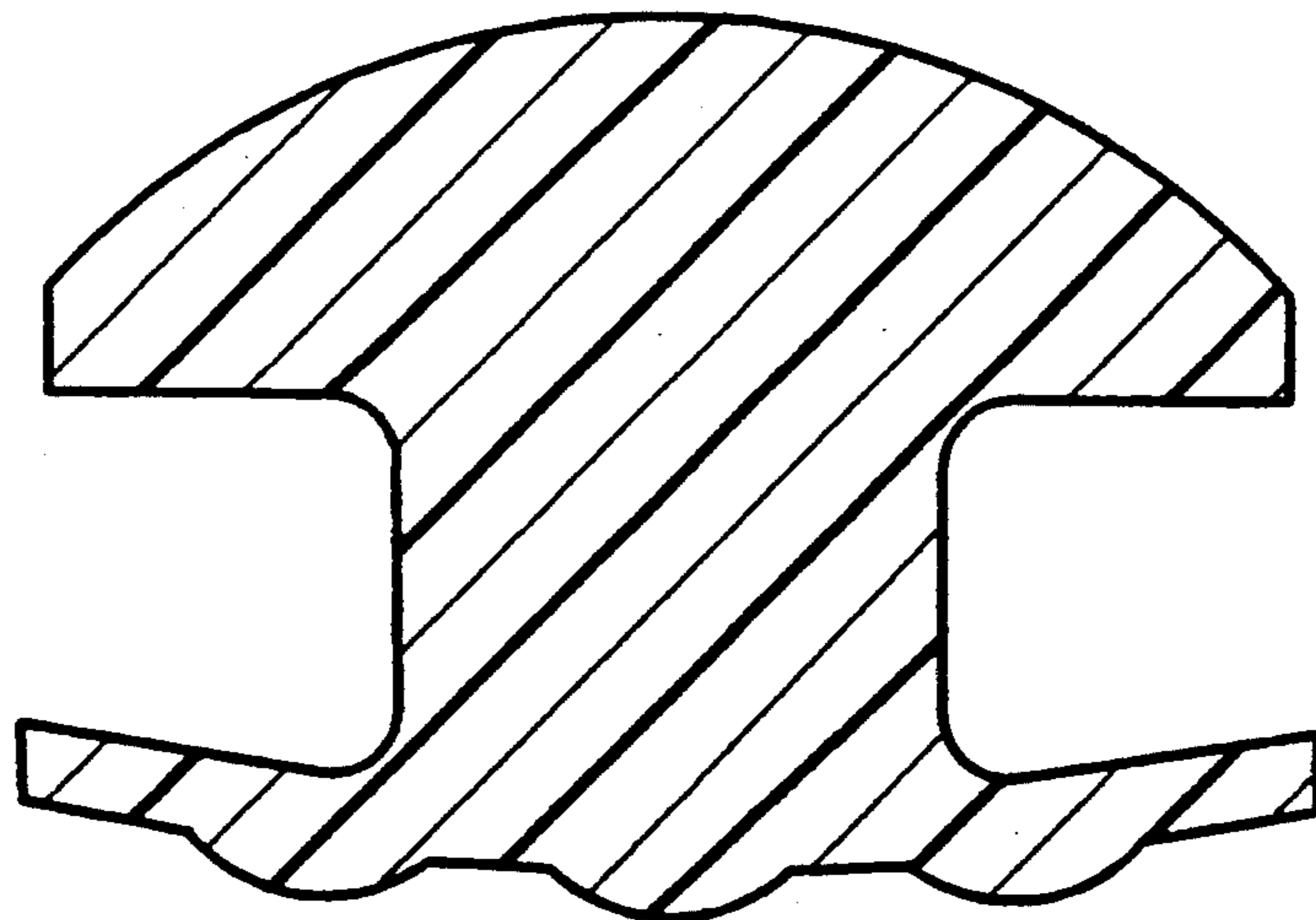

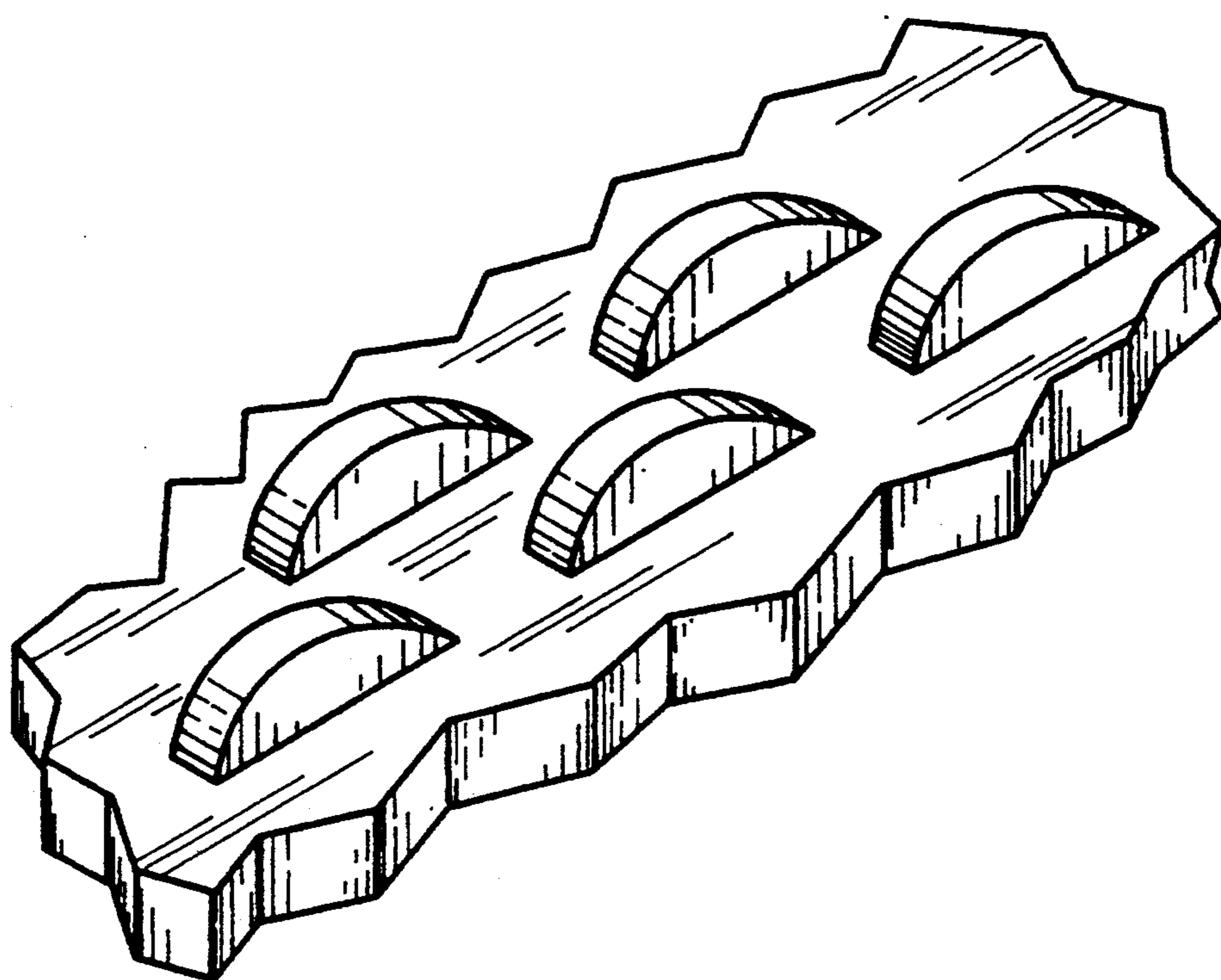

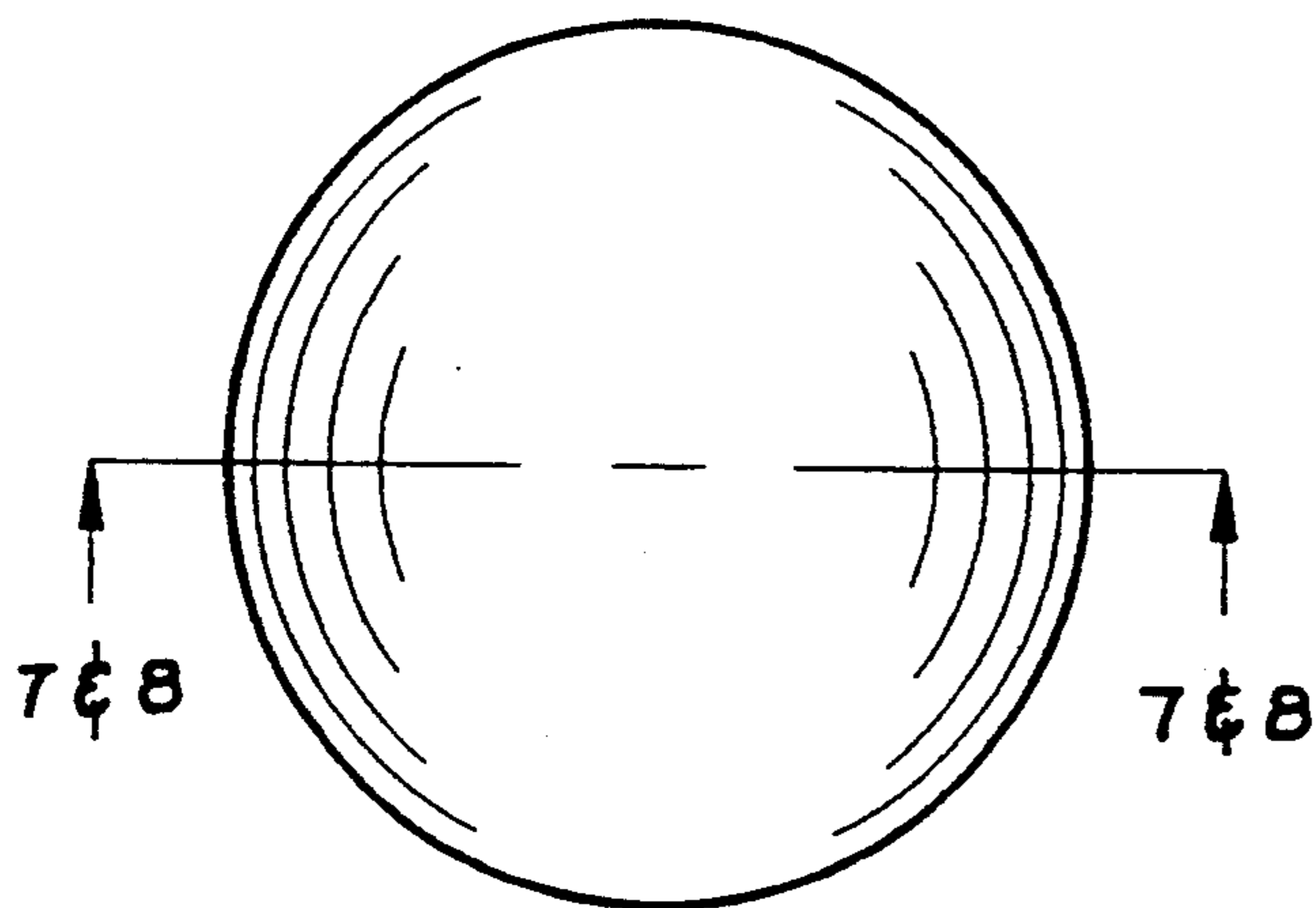

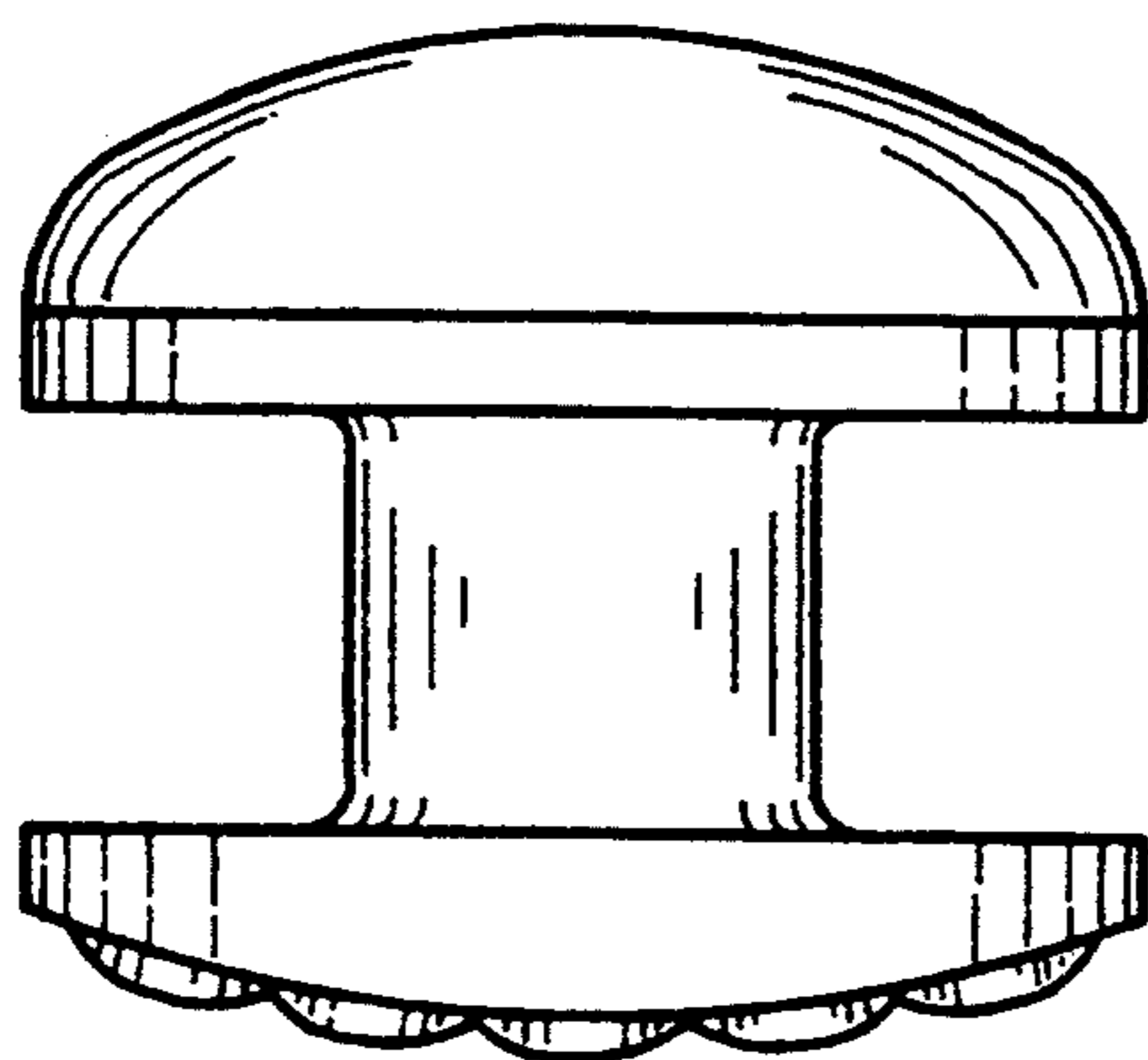

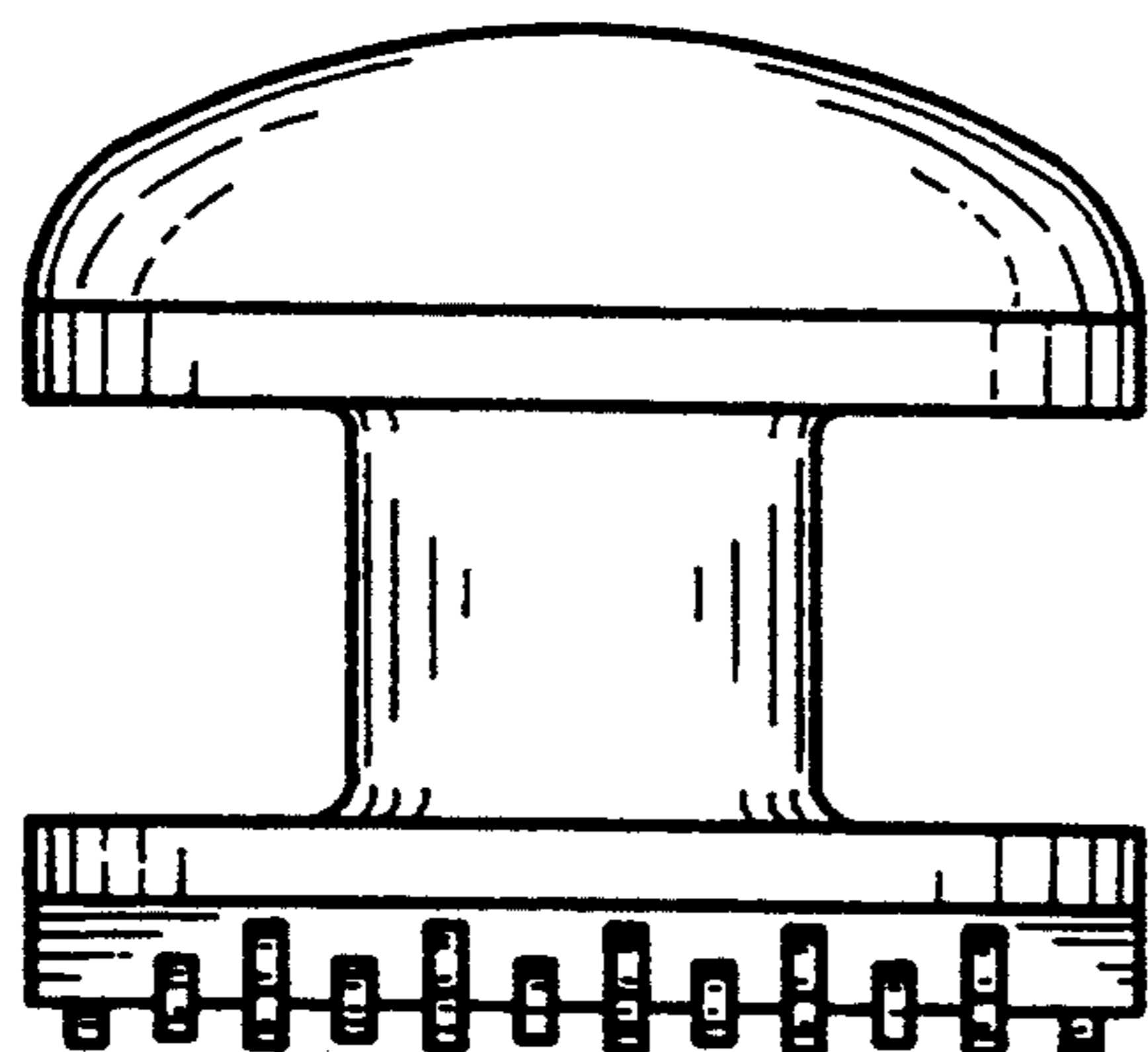
