FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an injection molding machine showing our new design;

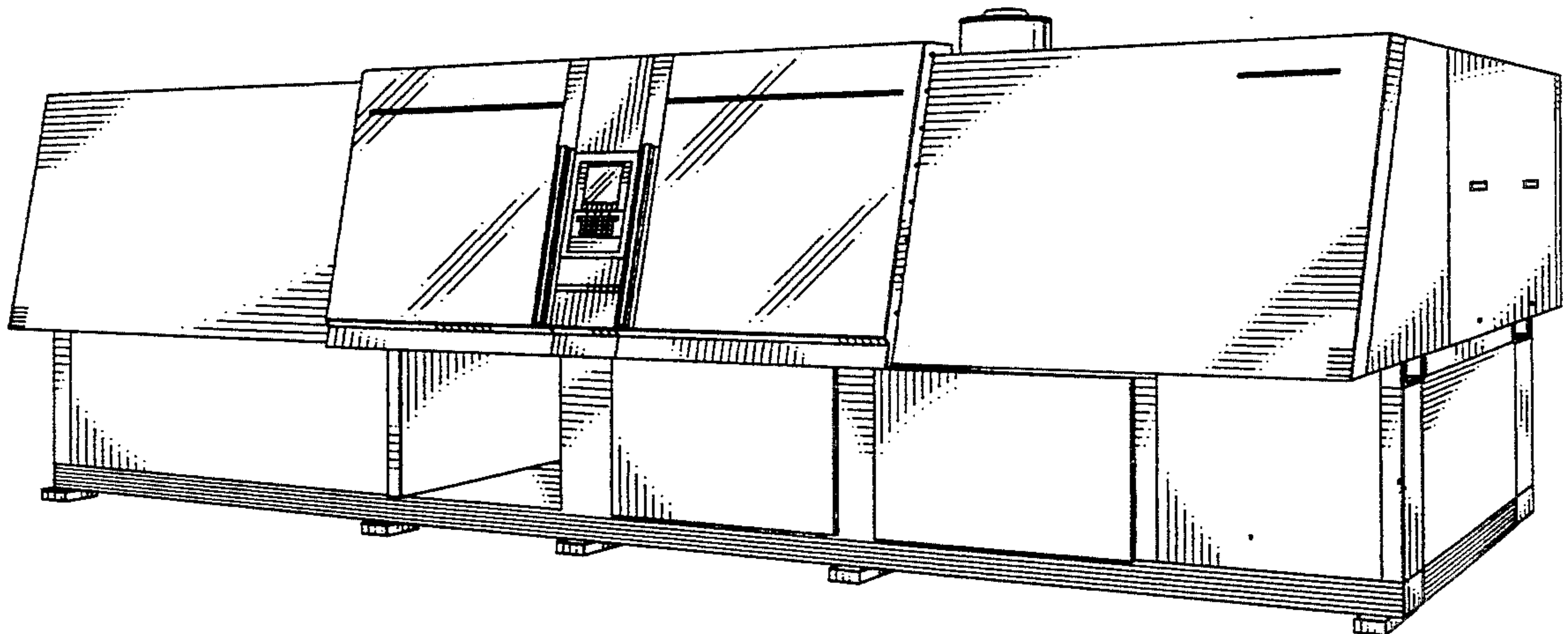
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



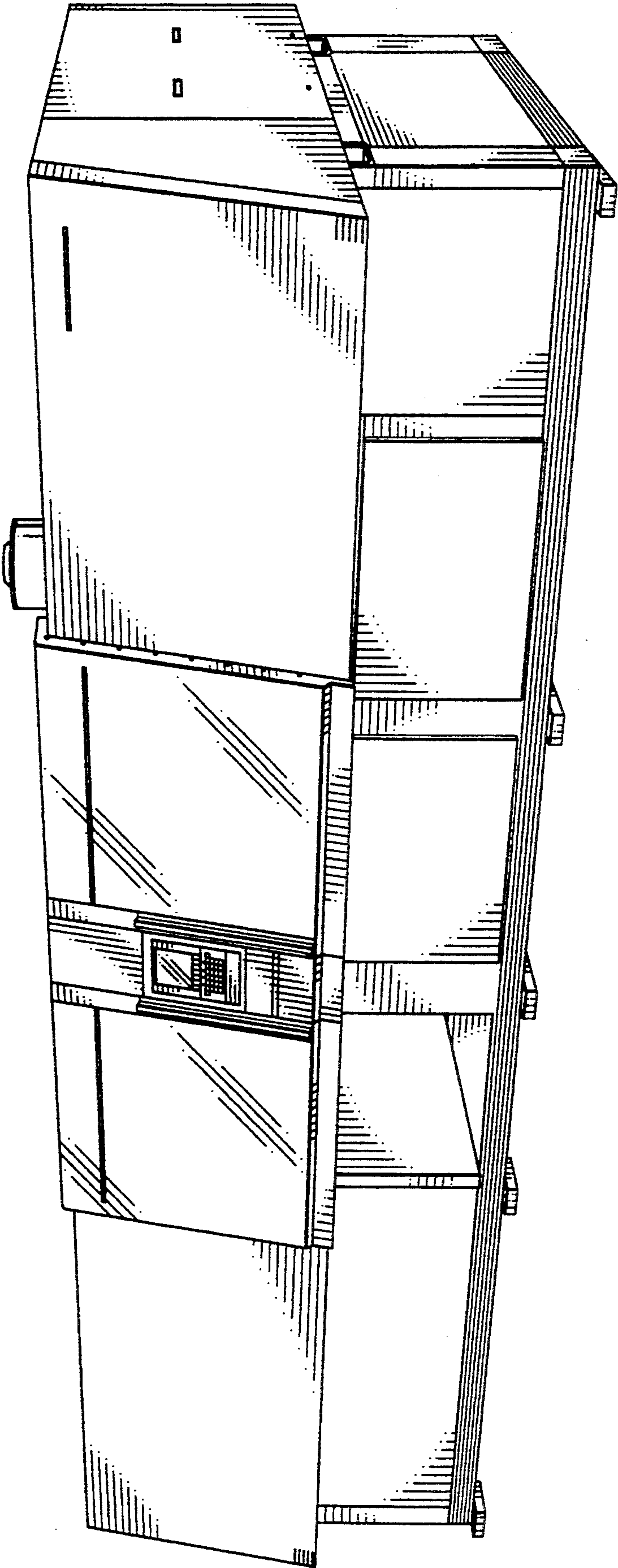

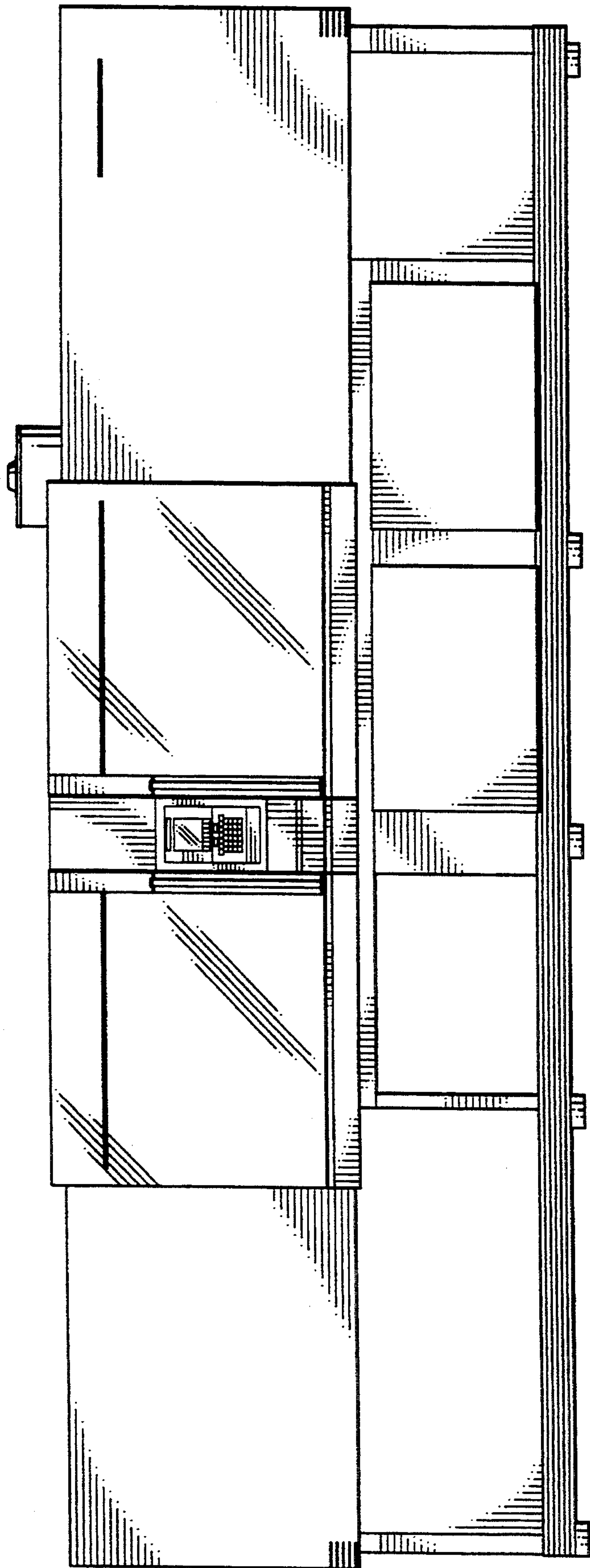

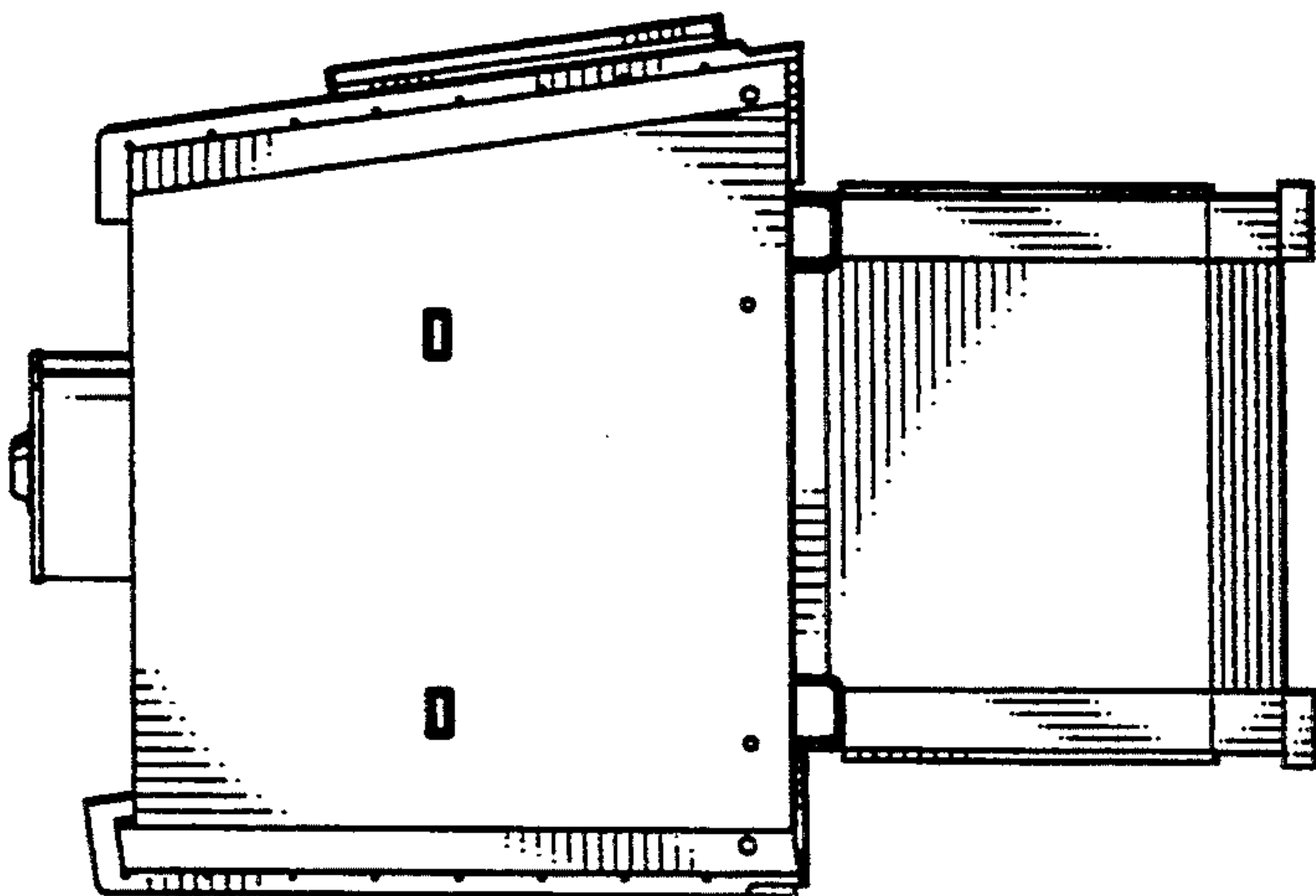

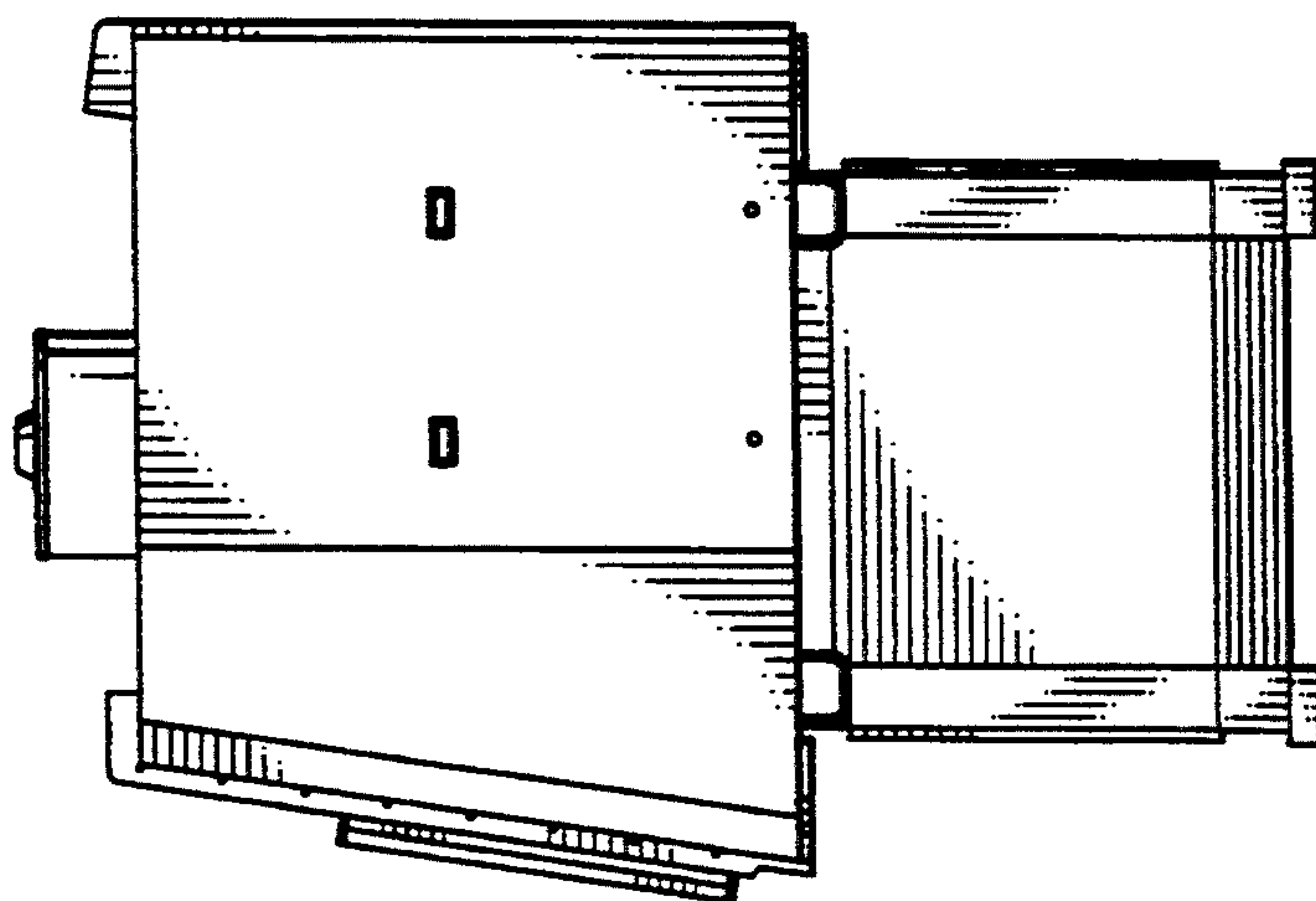

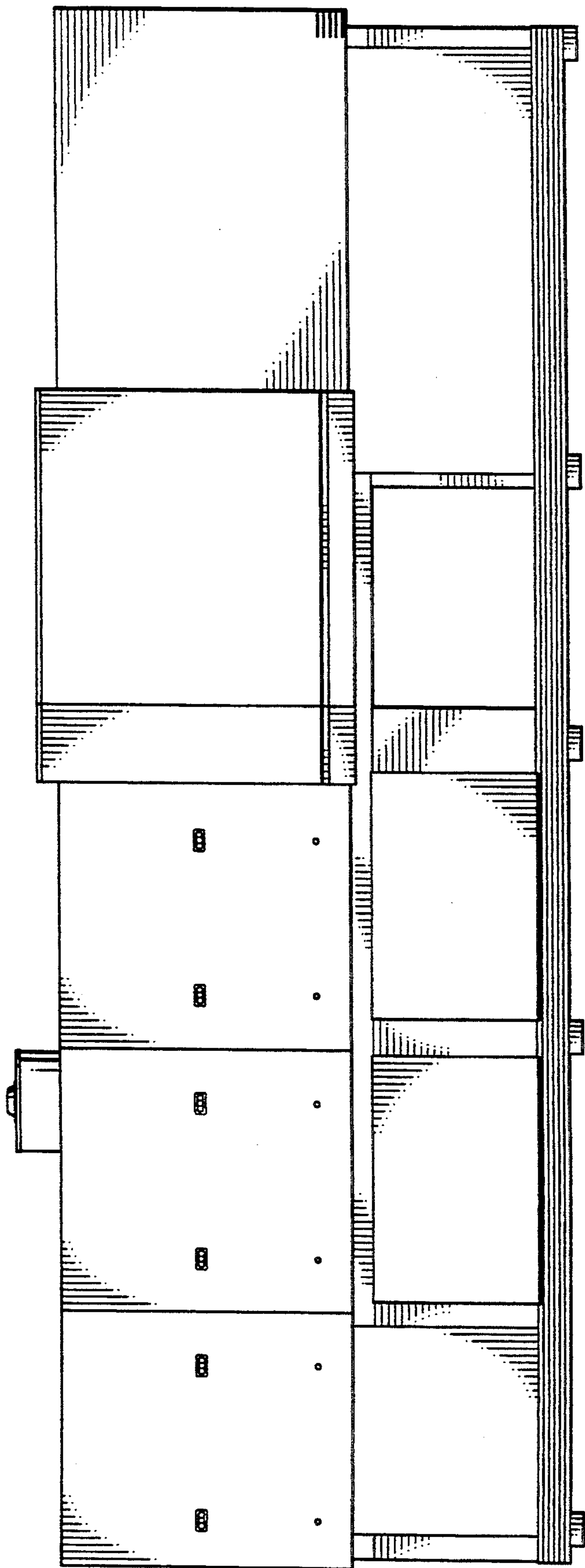

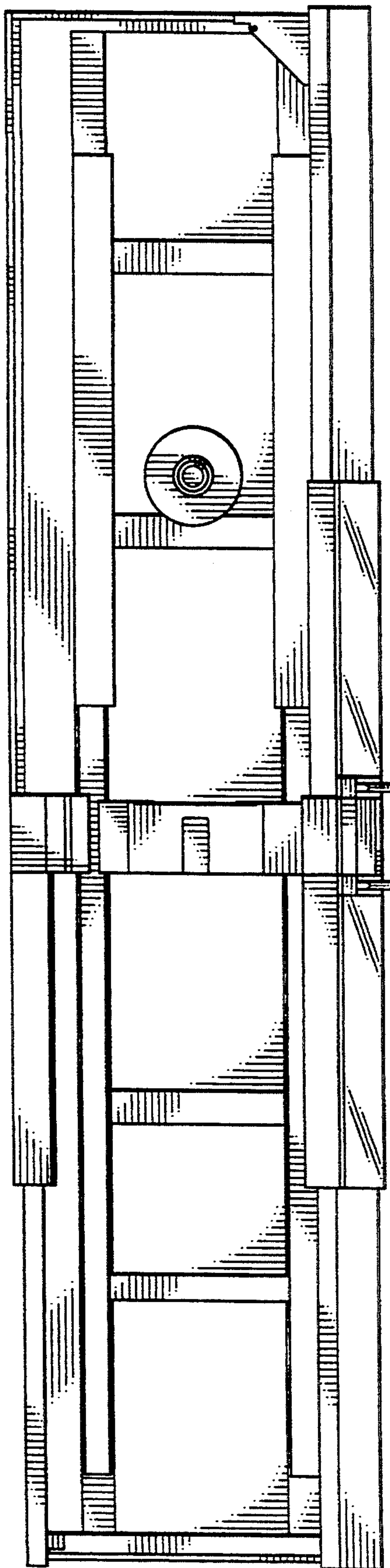
