FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the multi-function document scanner, taken from the front and right side;

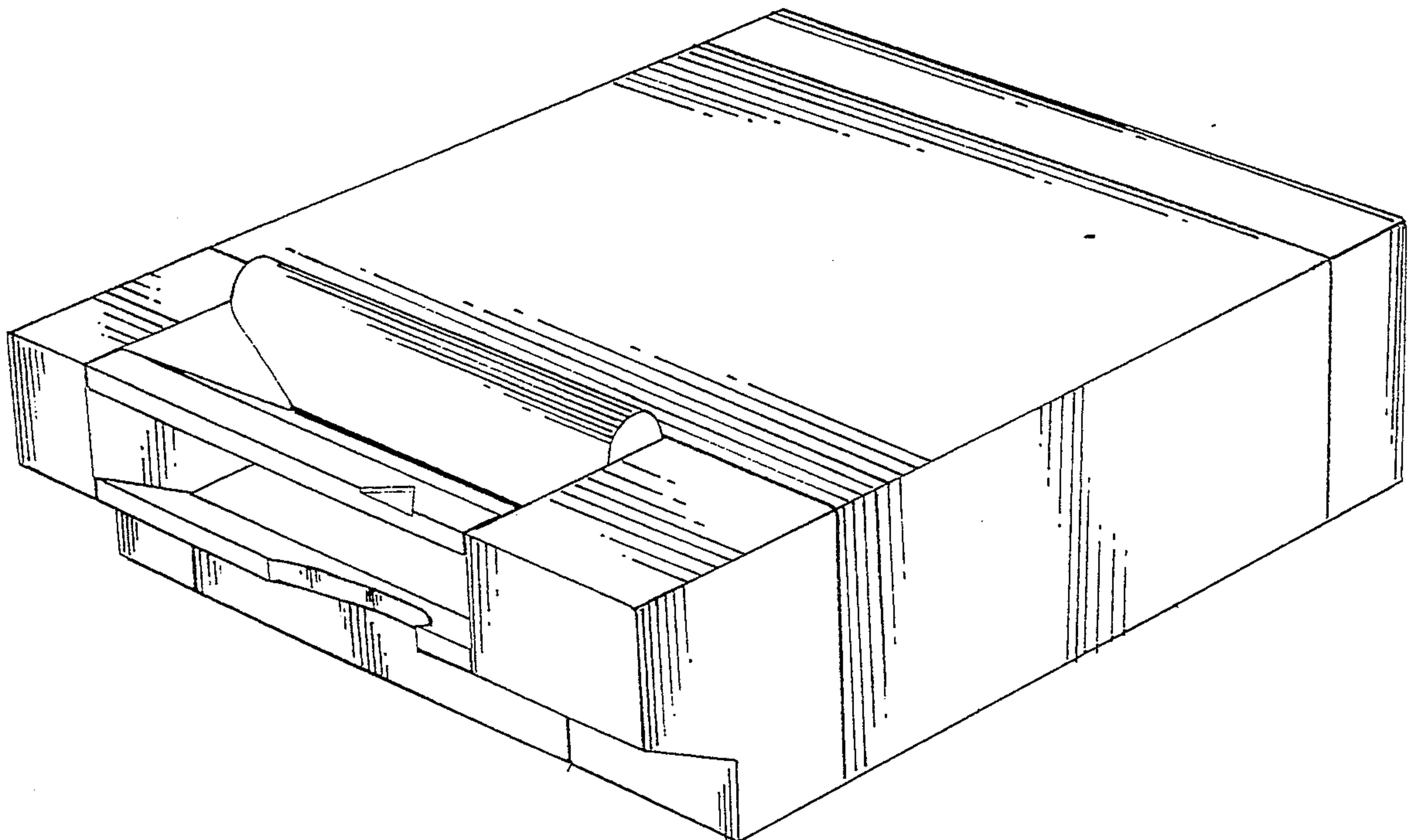
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being flat, plain and unornamented.



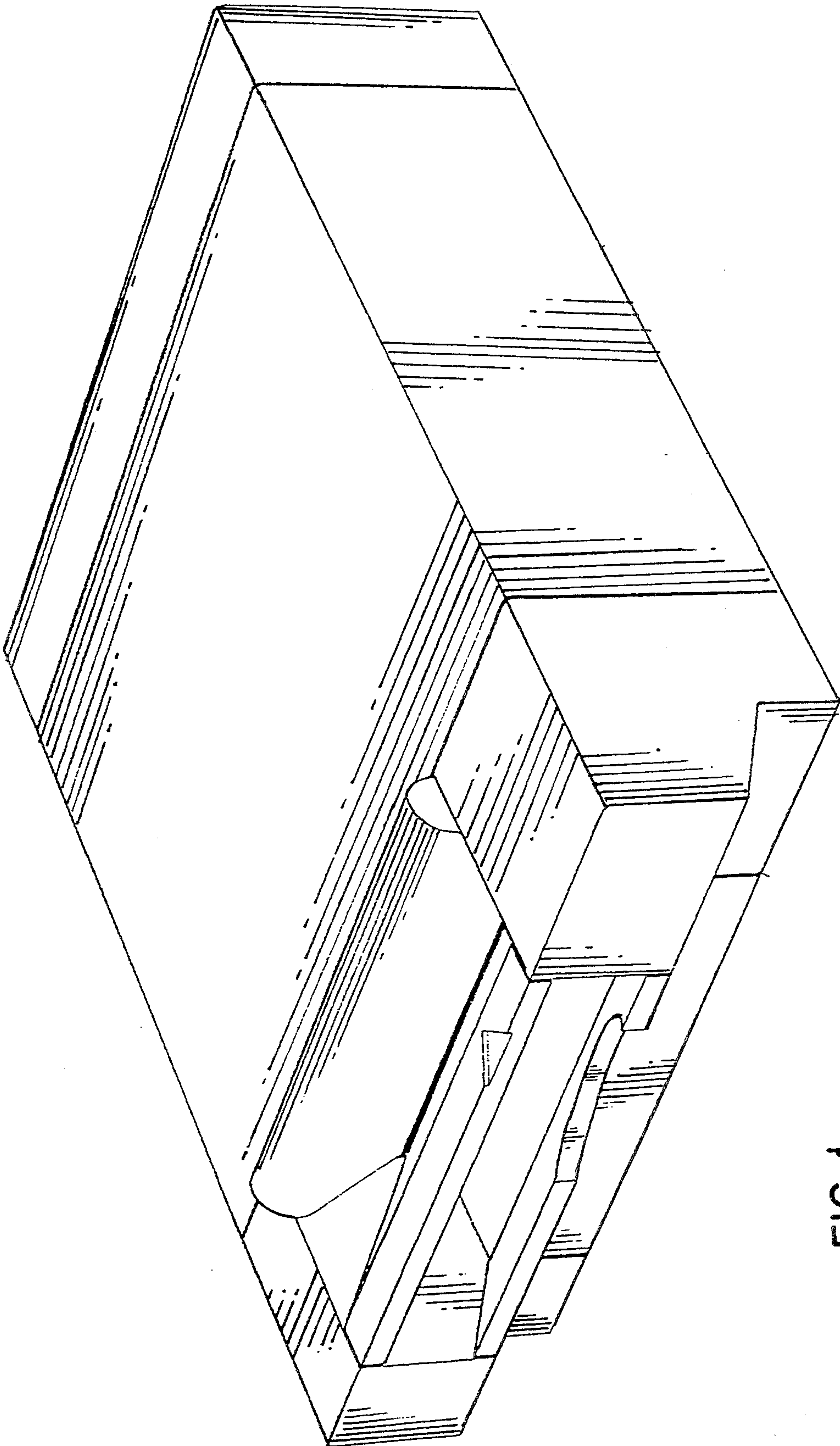

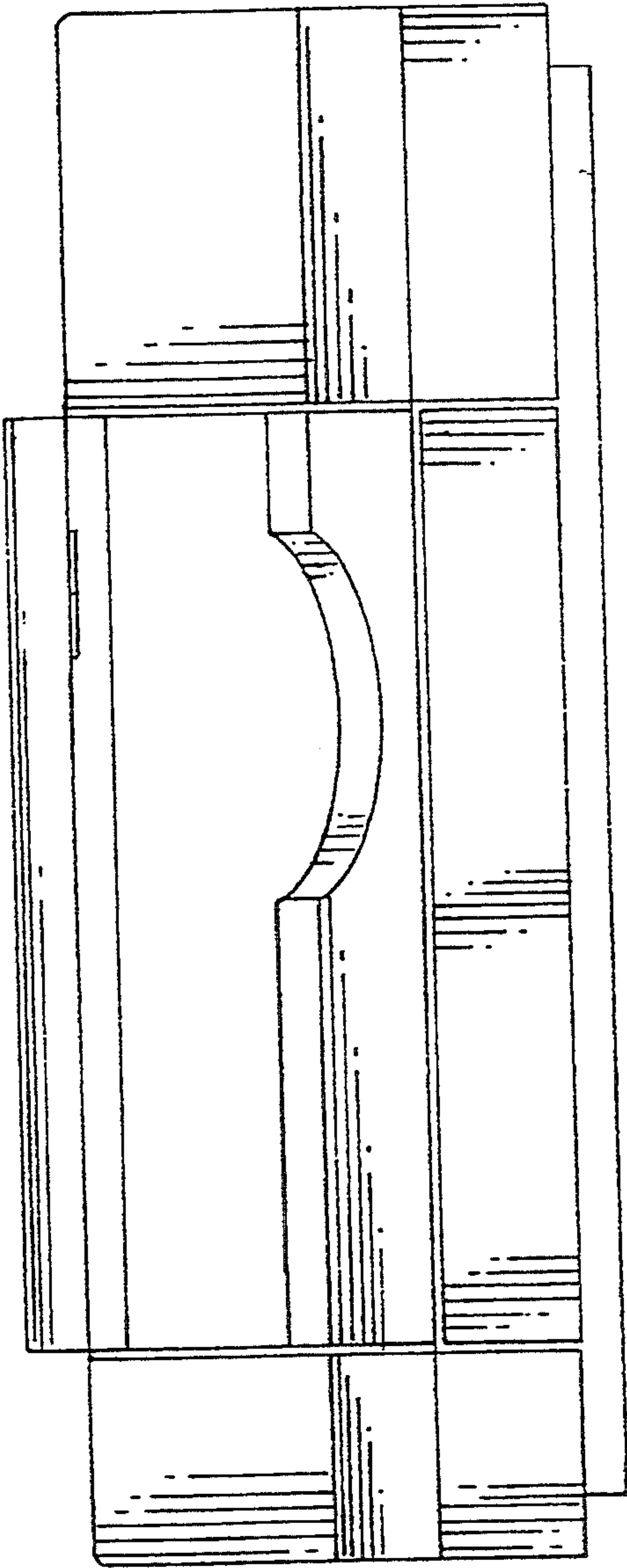

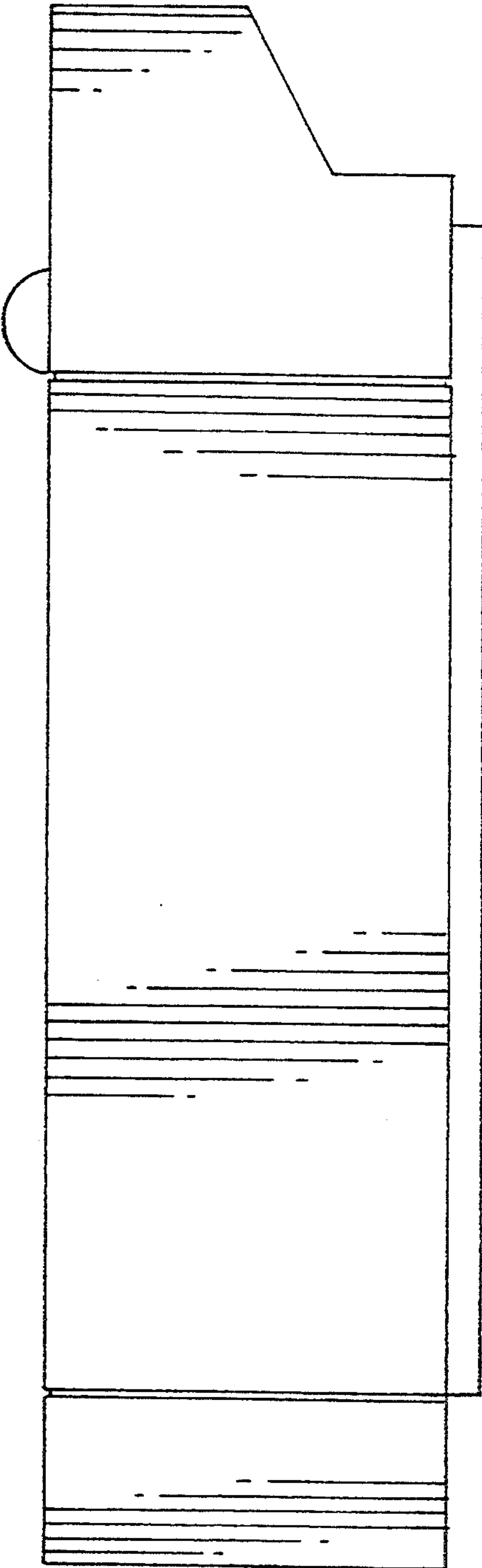

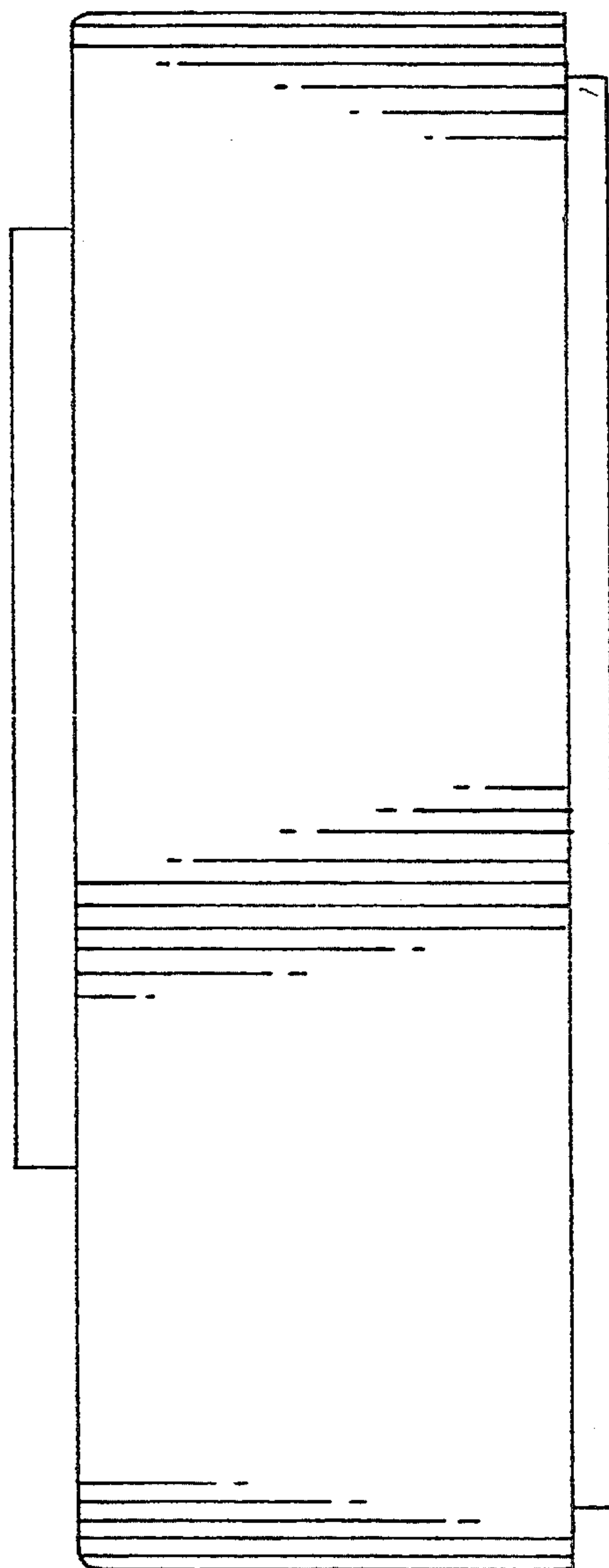

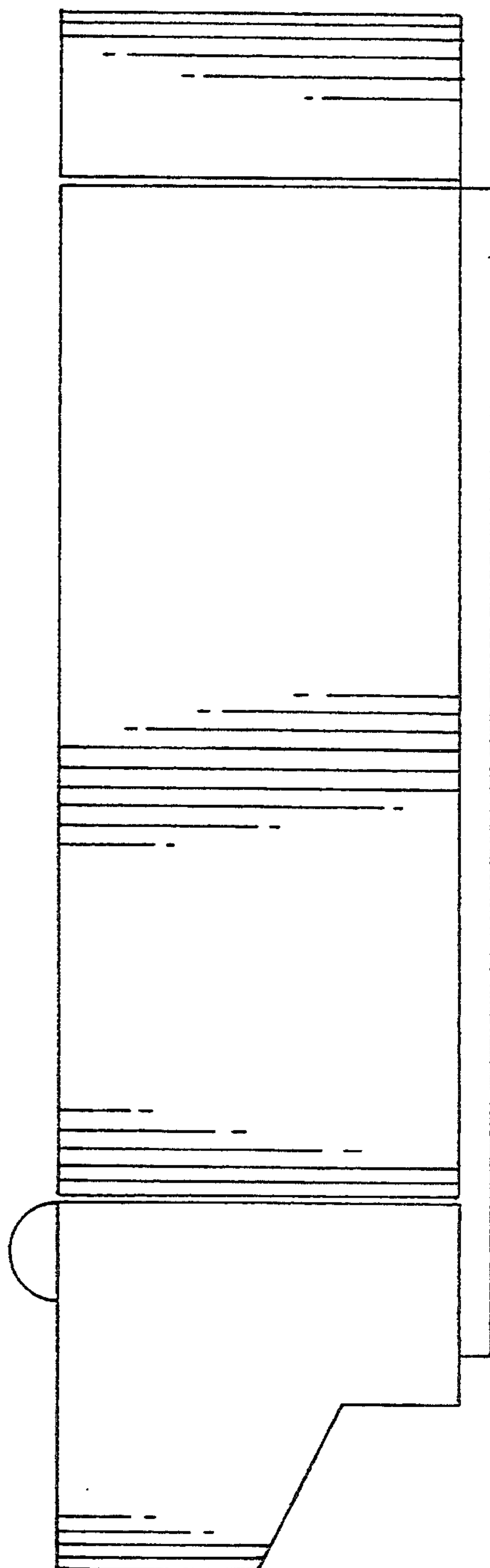
