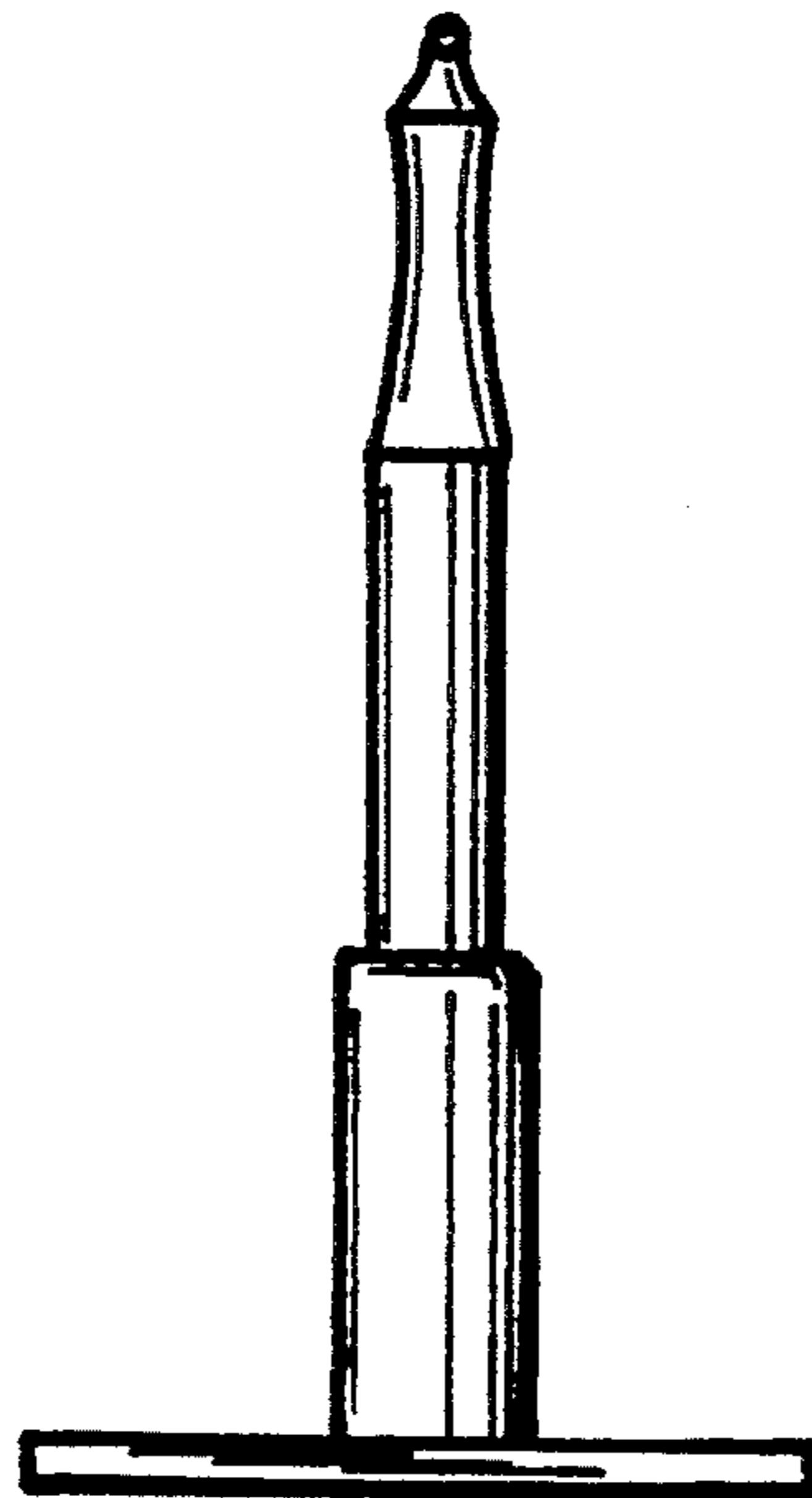
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a ball point pen desk set showing my new design, all other sides being identical thereto;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3.



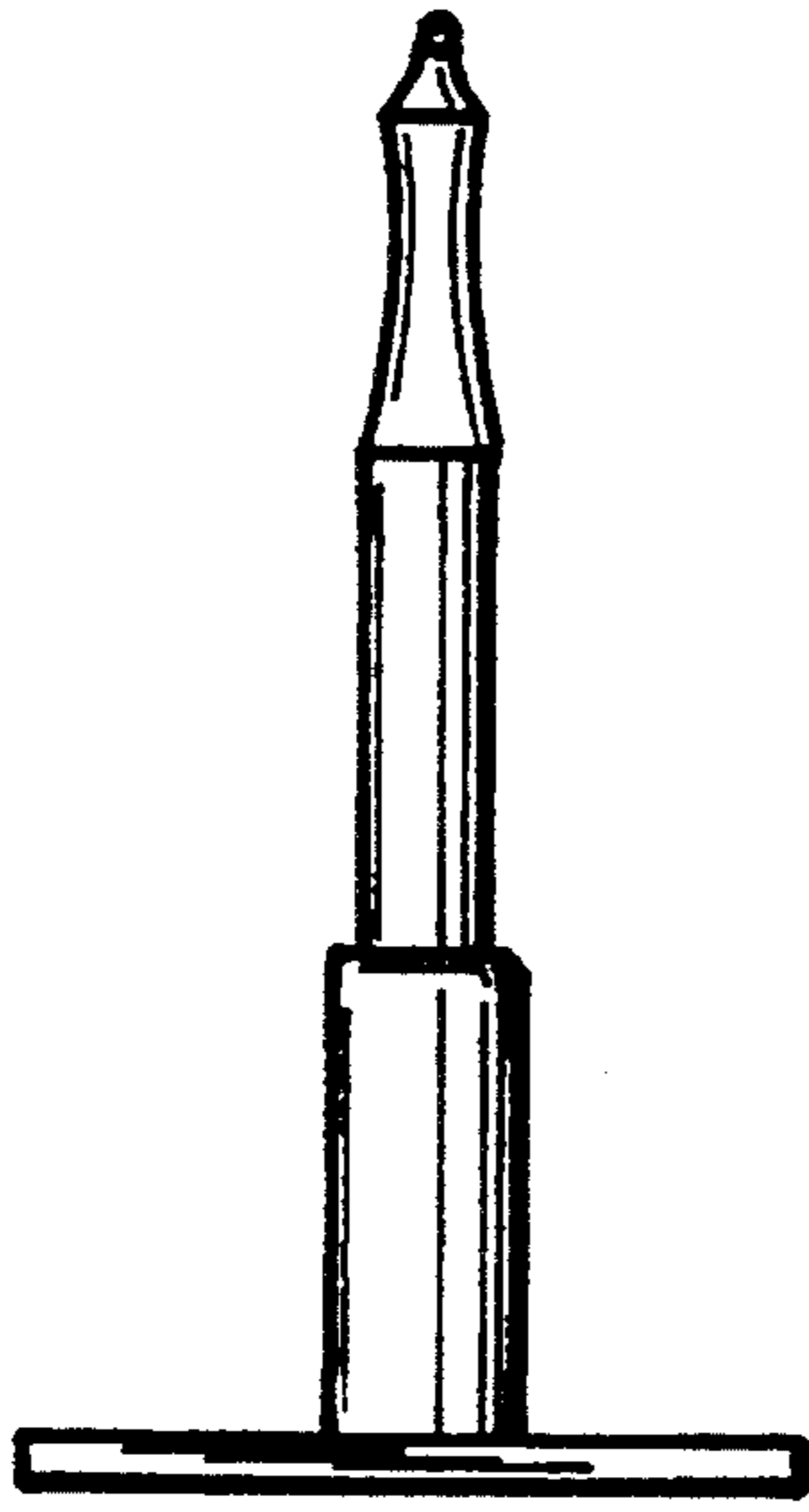

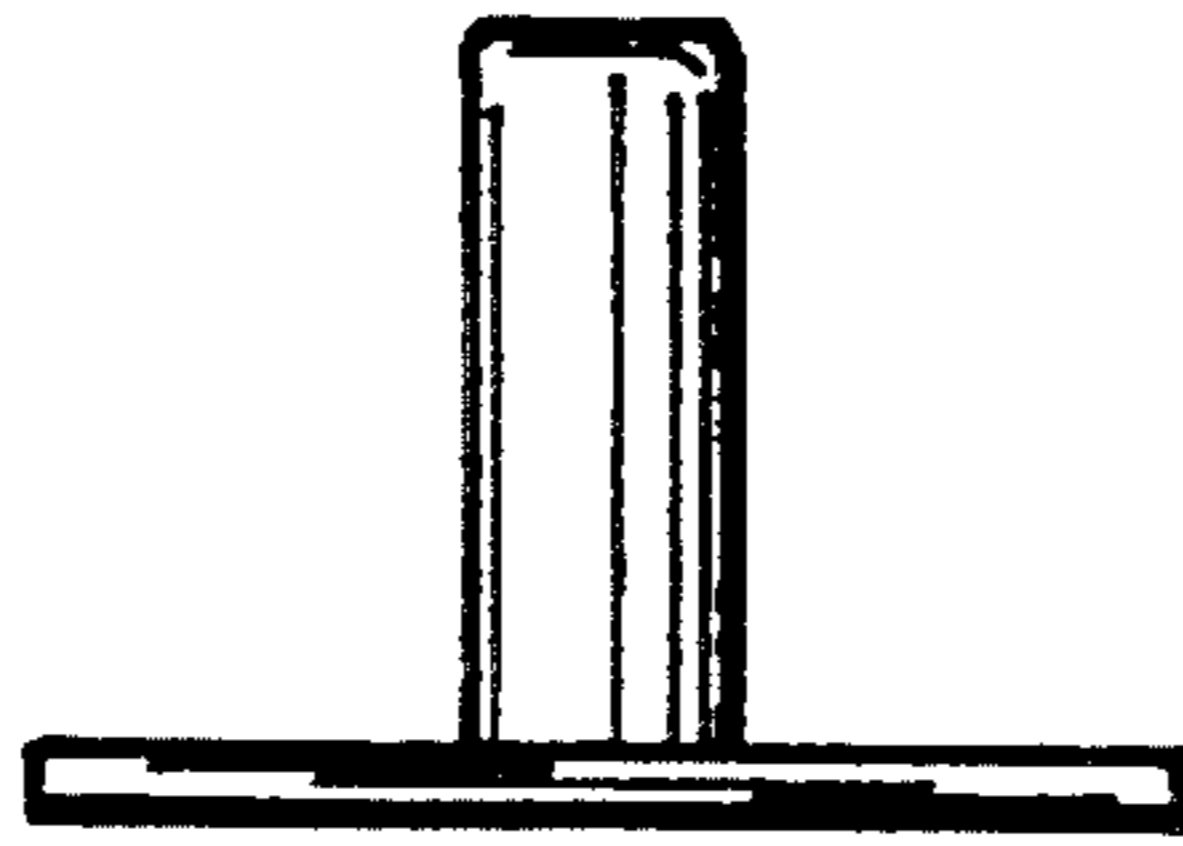

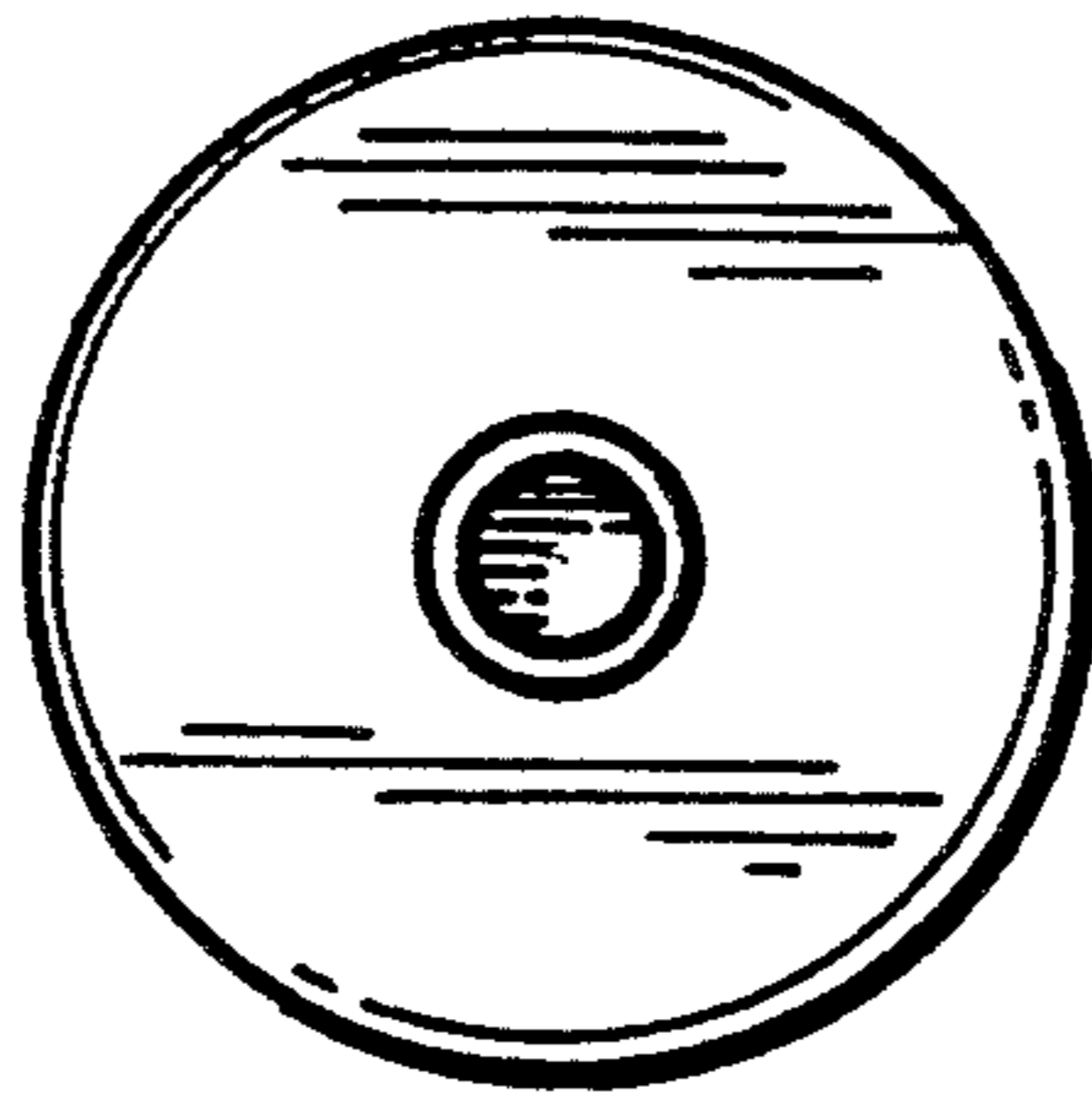
